The ornamental design for a portable wardrobe trunk, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portable wardrobe trunk showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a fragmentary enlarged view of the name tag assembly shown in FIG. 3 with the name tag shown in its outwardly slid position;

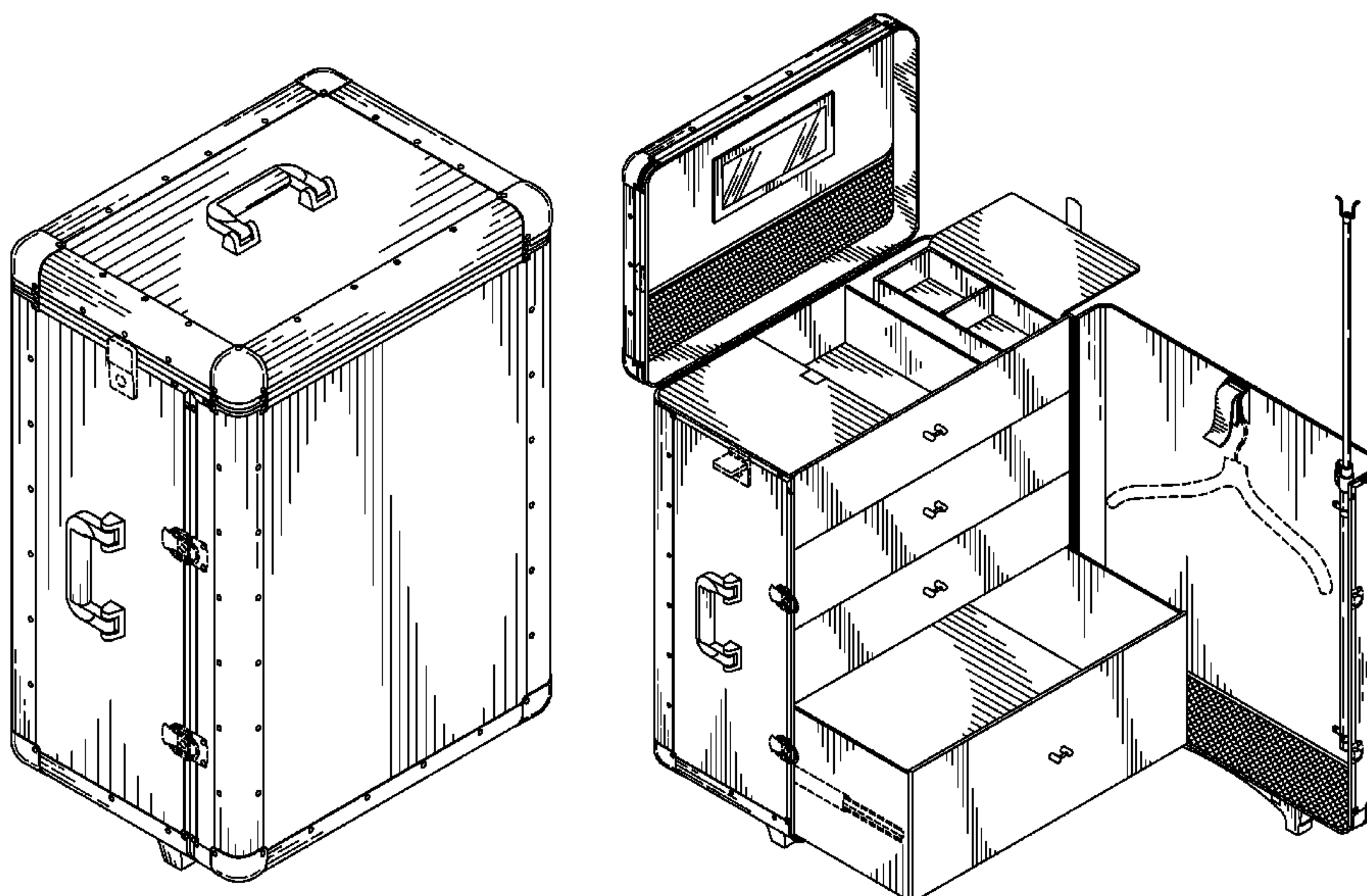
FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view showing the handle in its upwardly extending operative position;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view showing the handle in its operative position with the trunk being pulled along the ground; and,

FIG. 11 is a perspective view showing the trunk with its top and side wall swung to open position so as to expose the interior of the trunk.

The broken lines in FIGS. 8 and 11, showing a name tag and a hanger respectively, are illustrative of environment and form no part of the claimed design. All other broken lines in the figures illustrate portions of the design that also form no part of the claim.

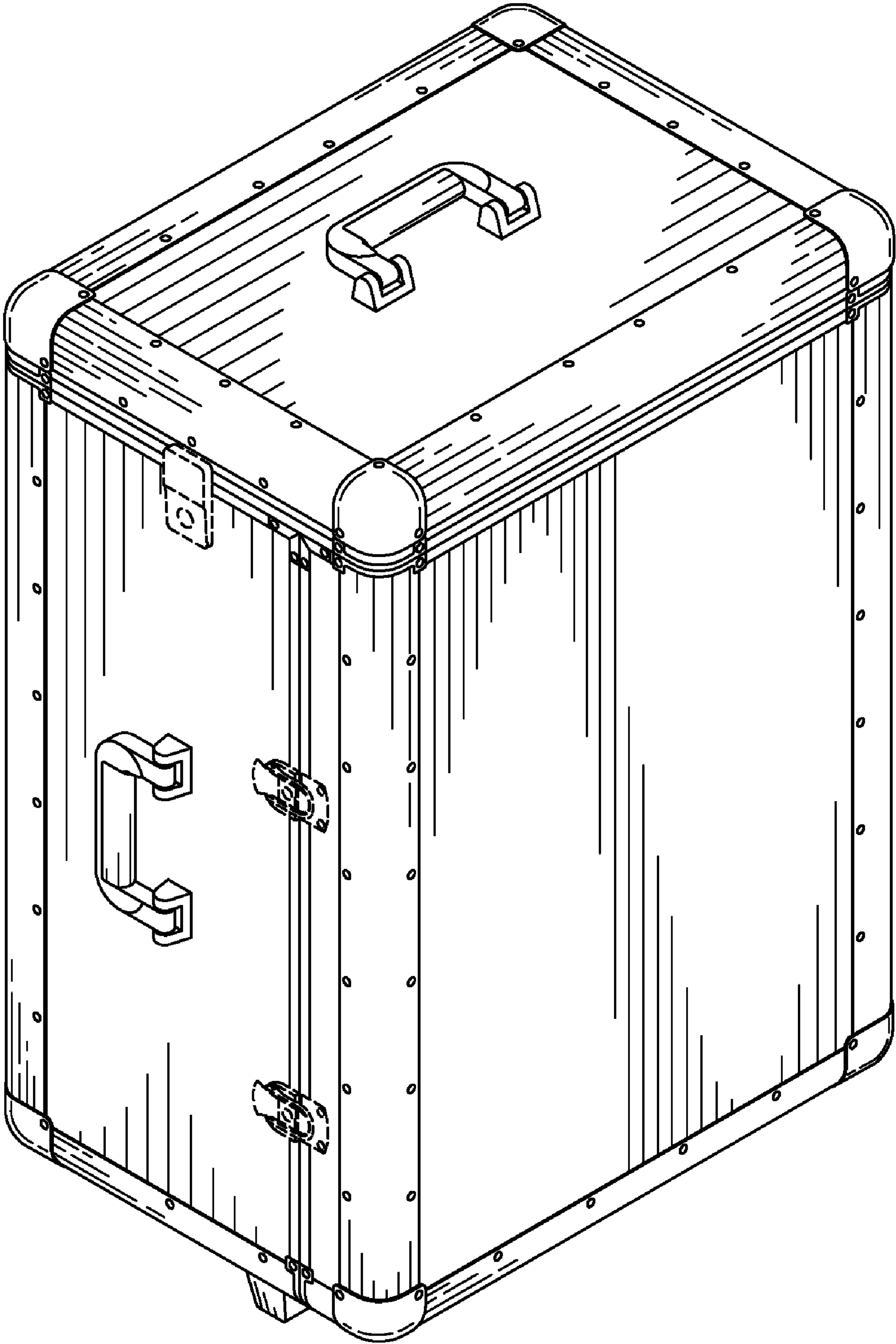

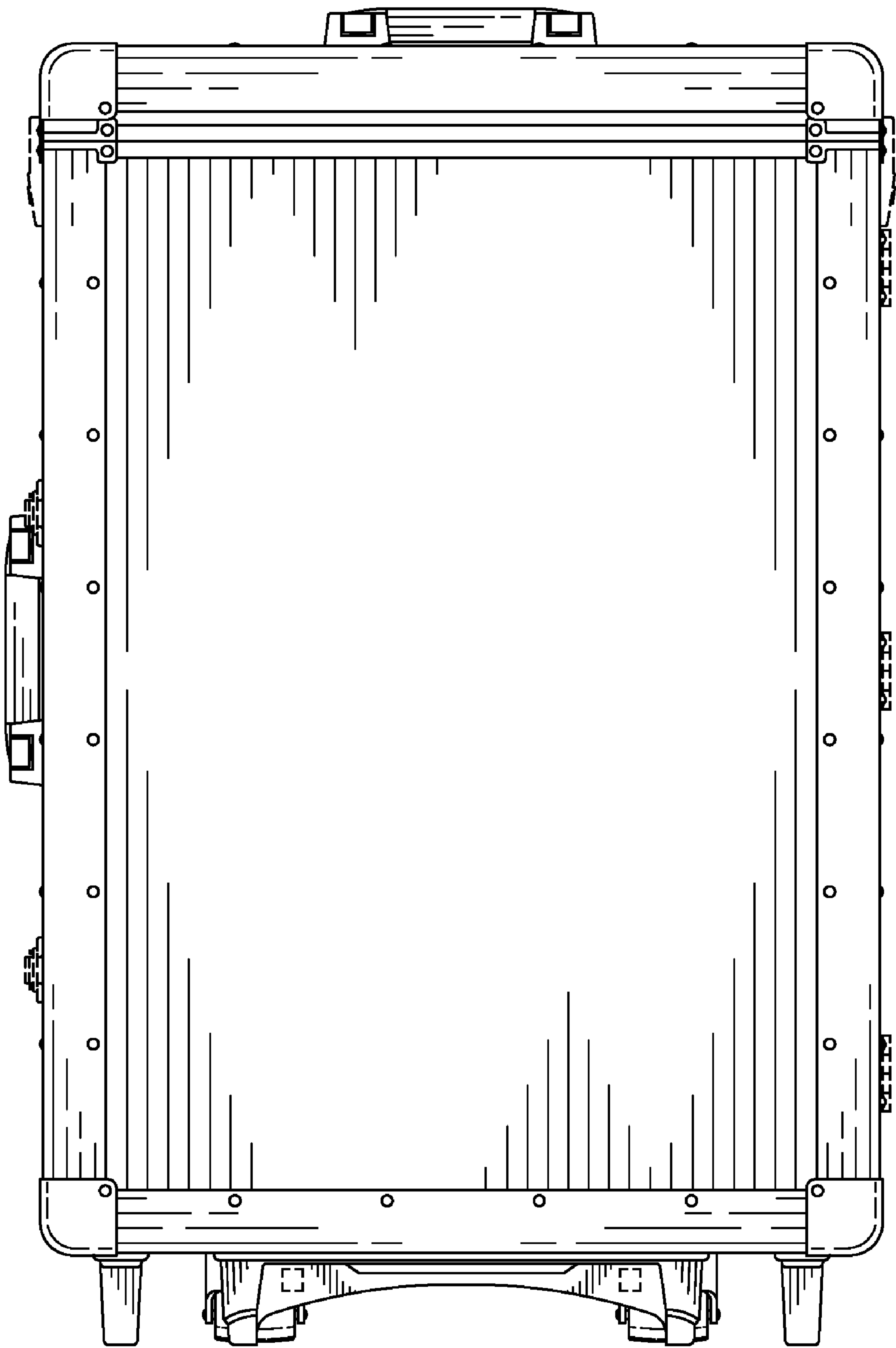

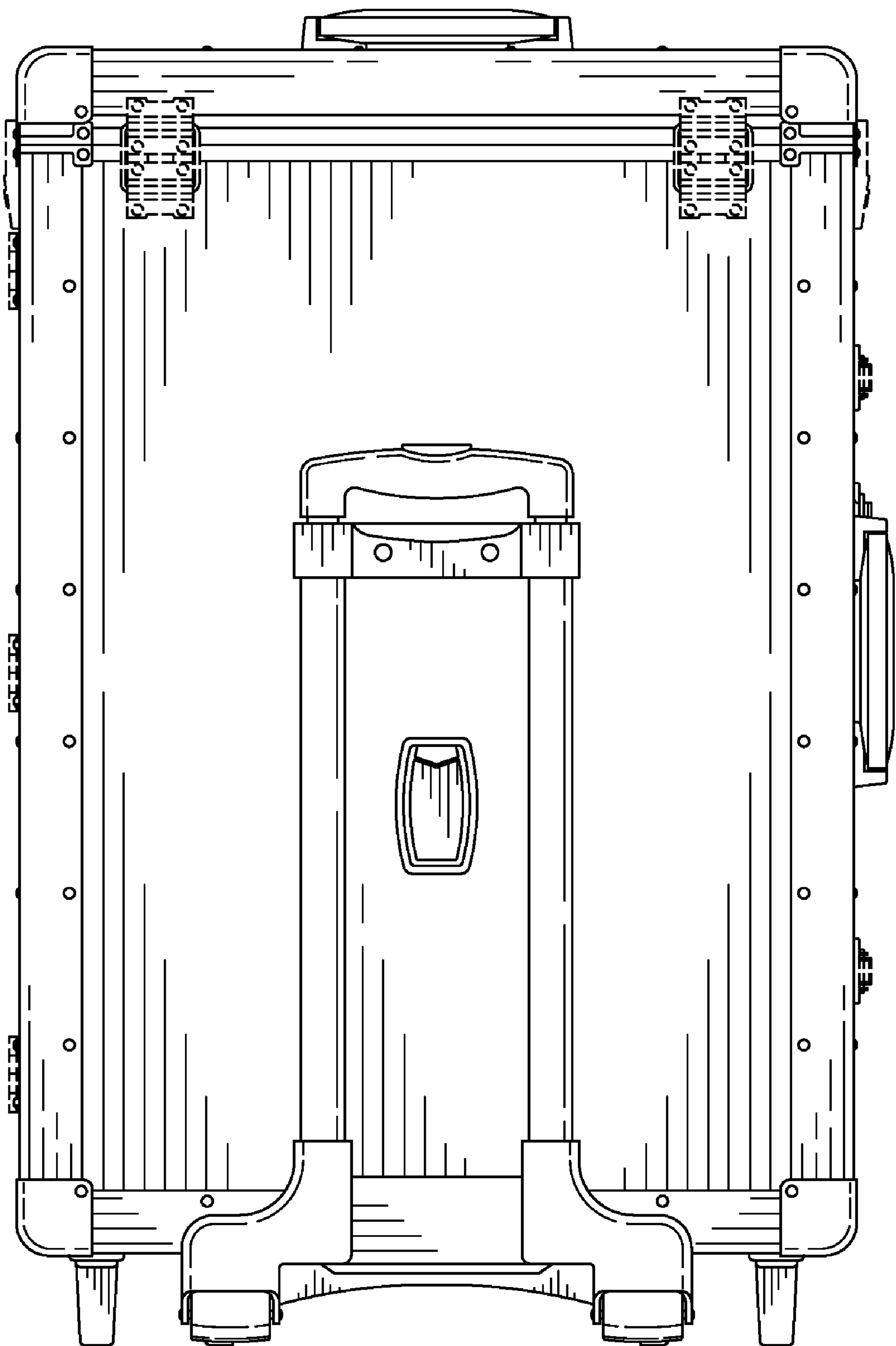

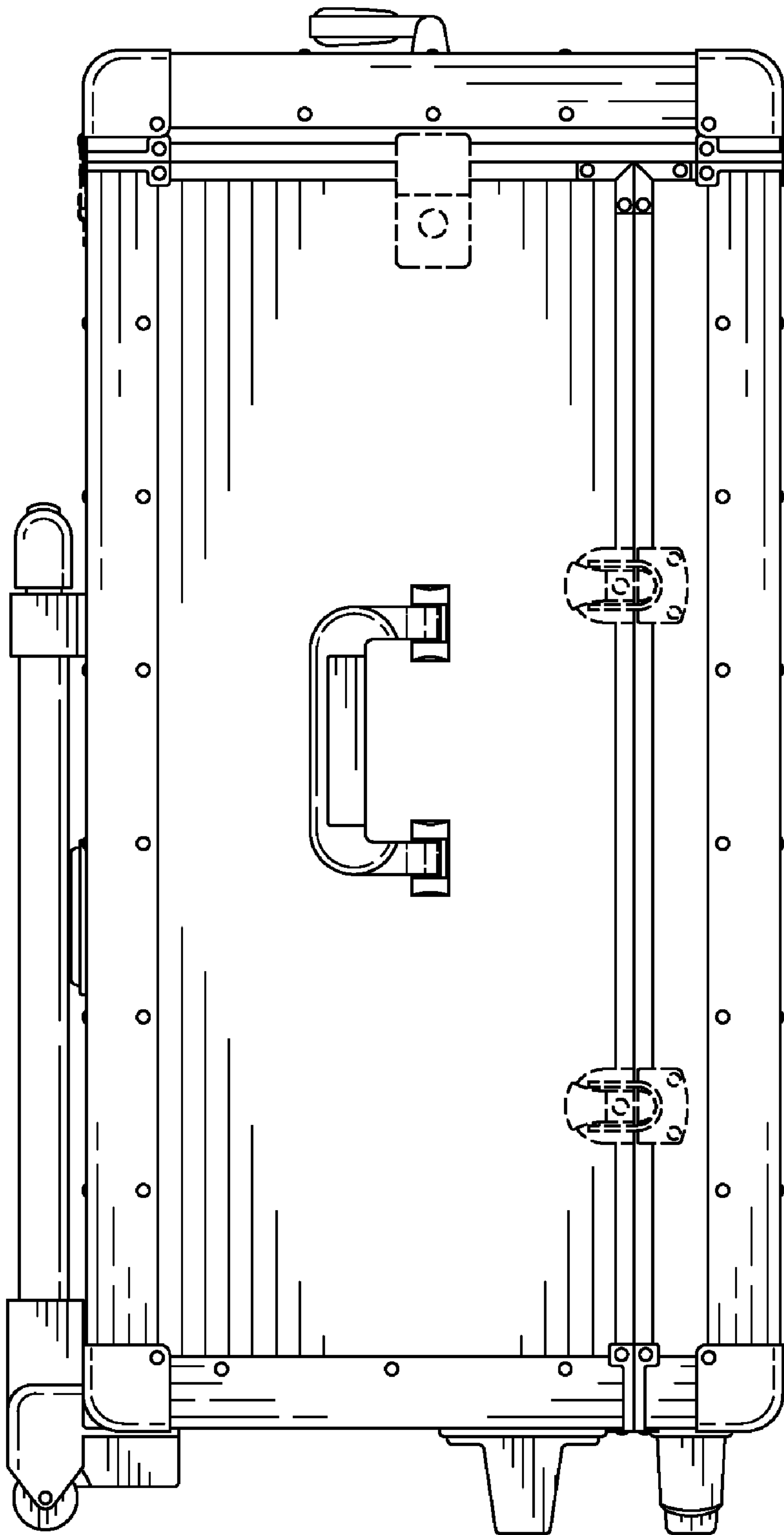

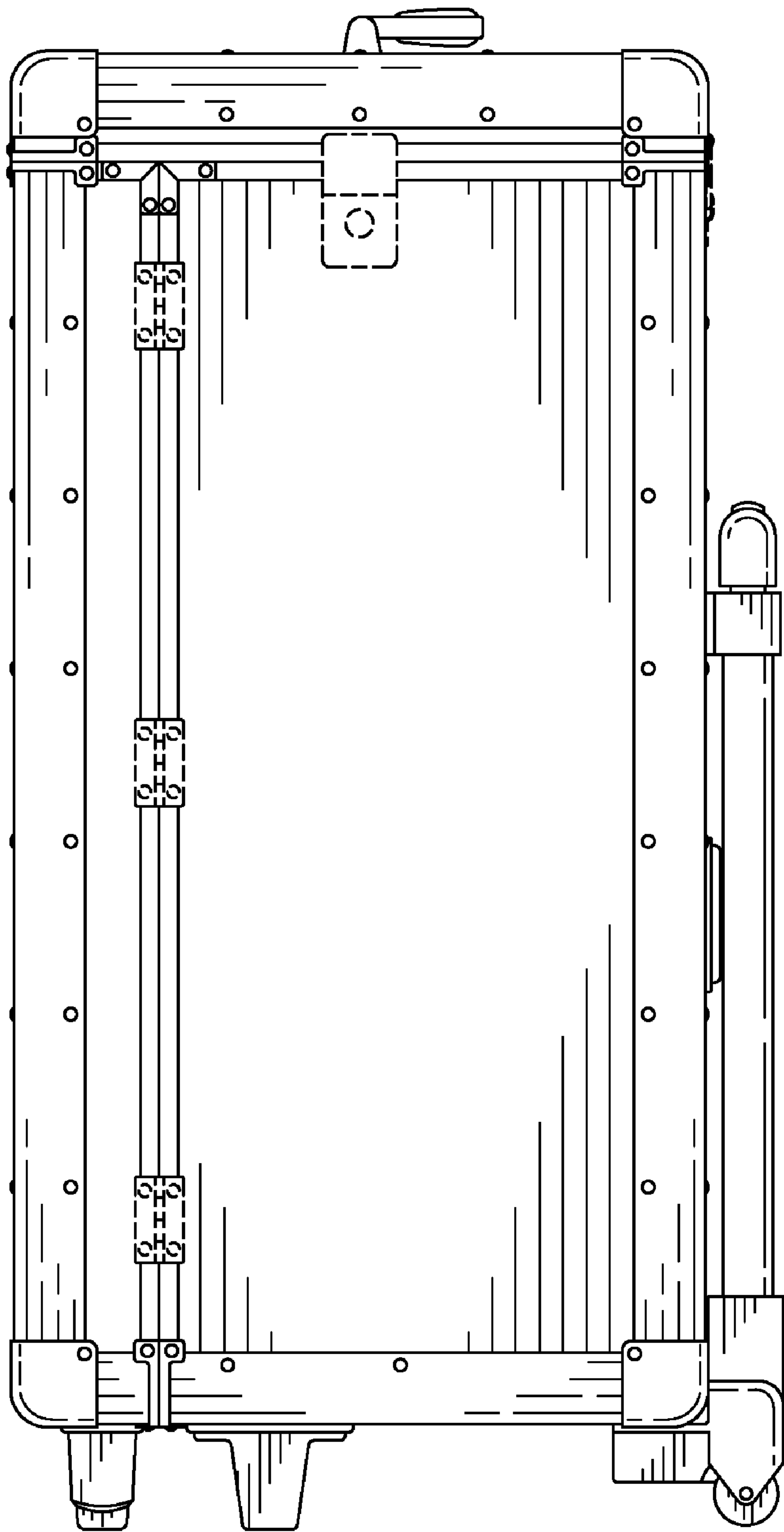

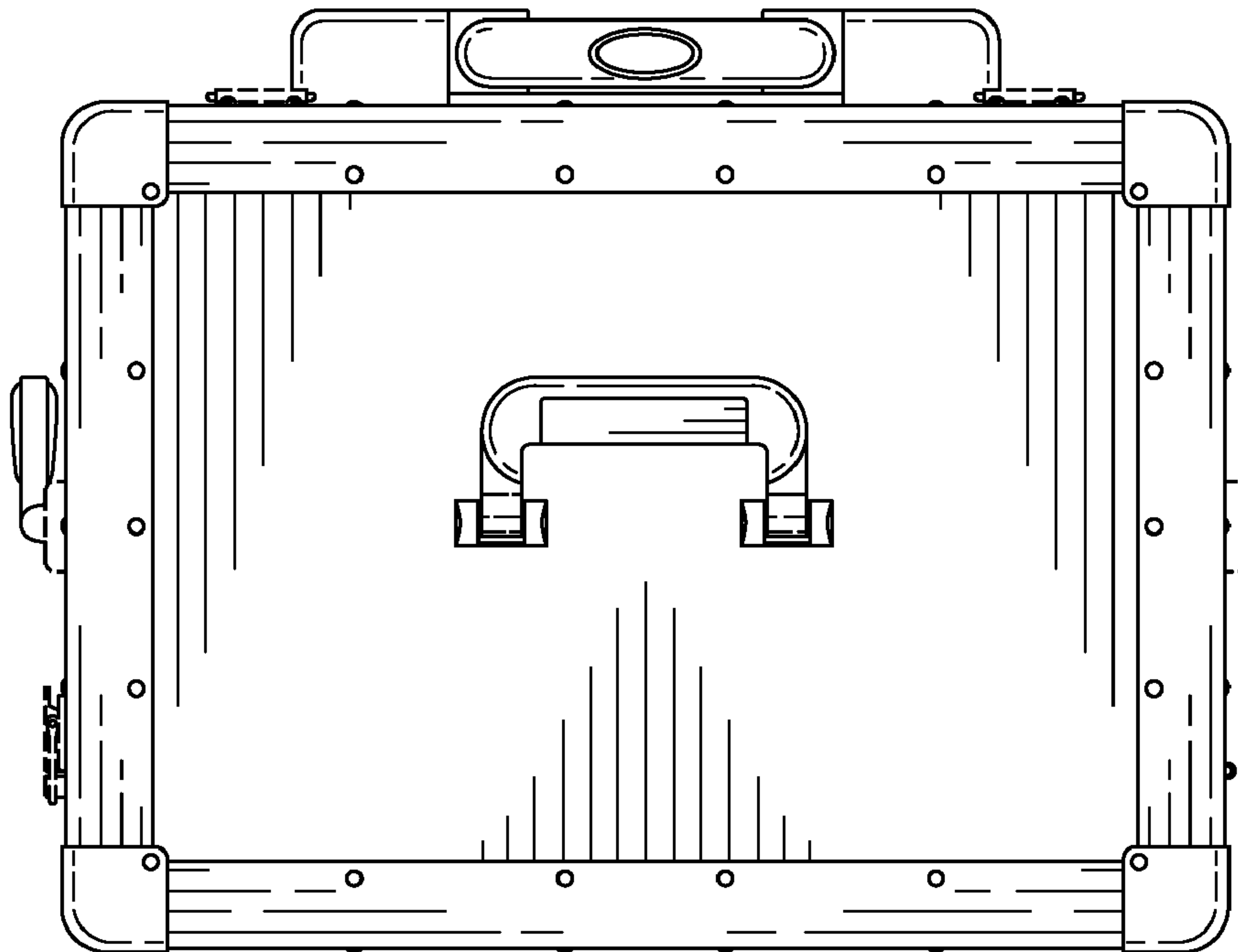

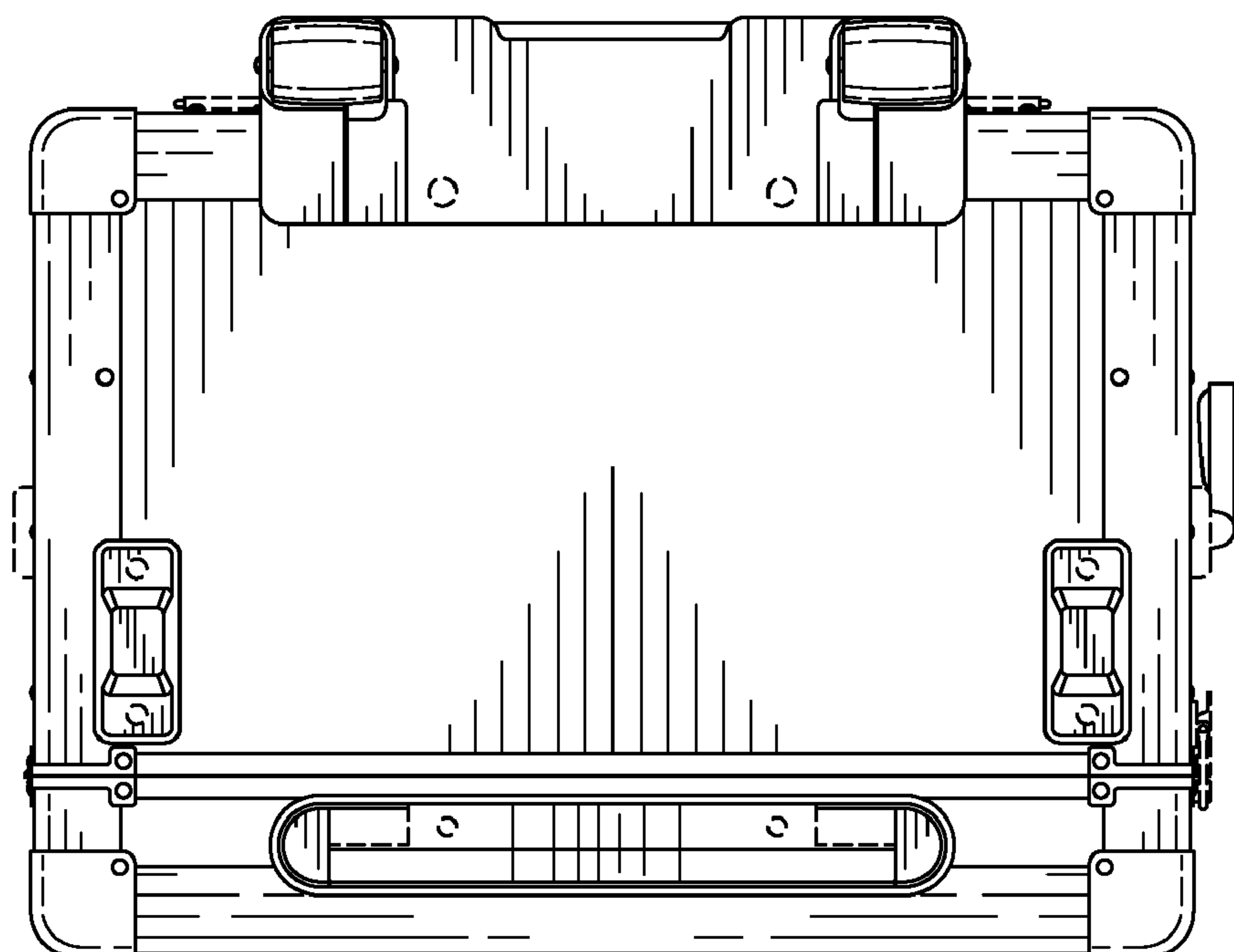

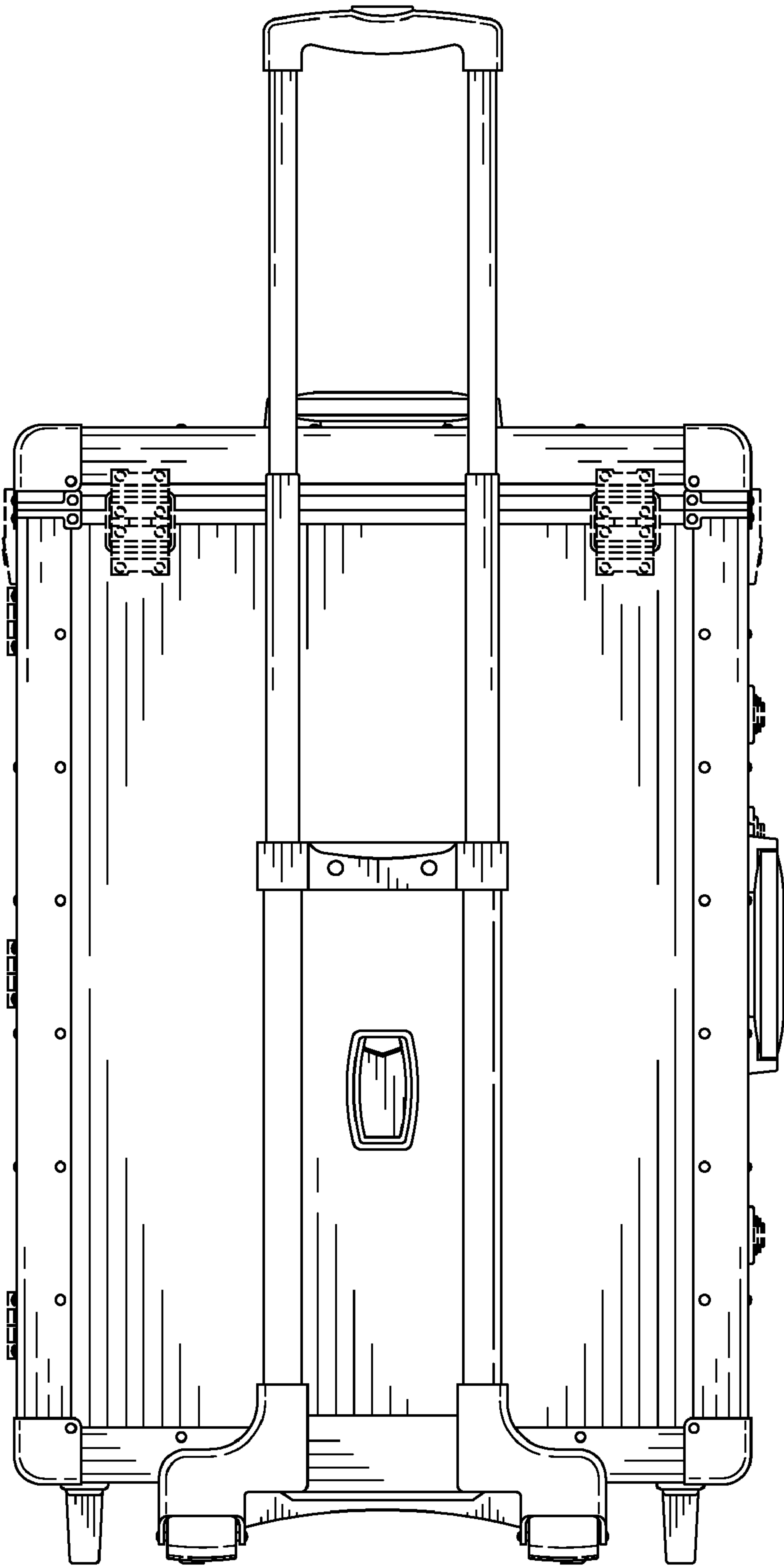

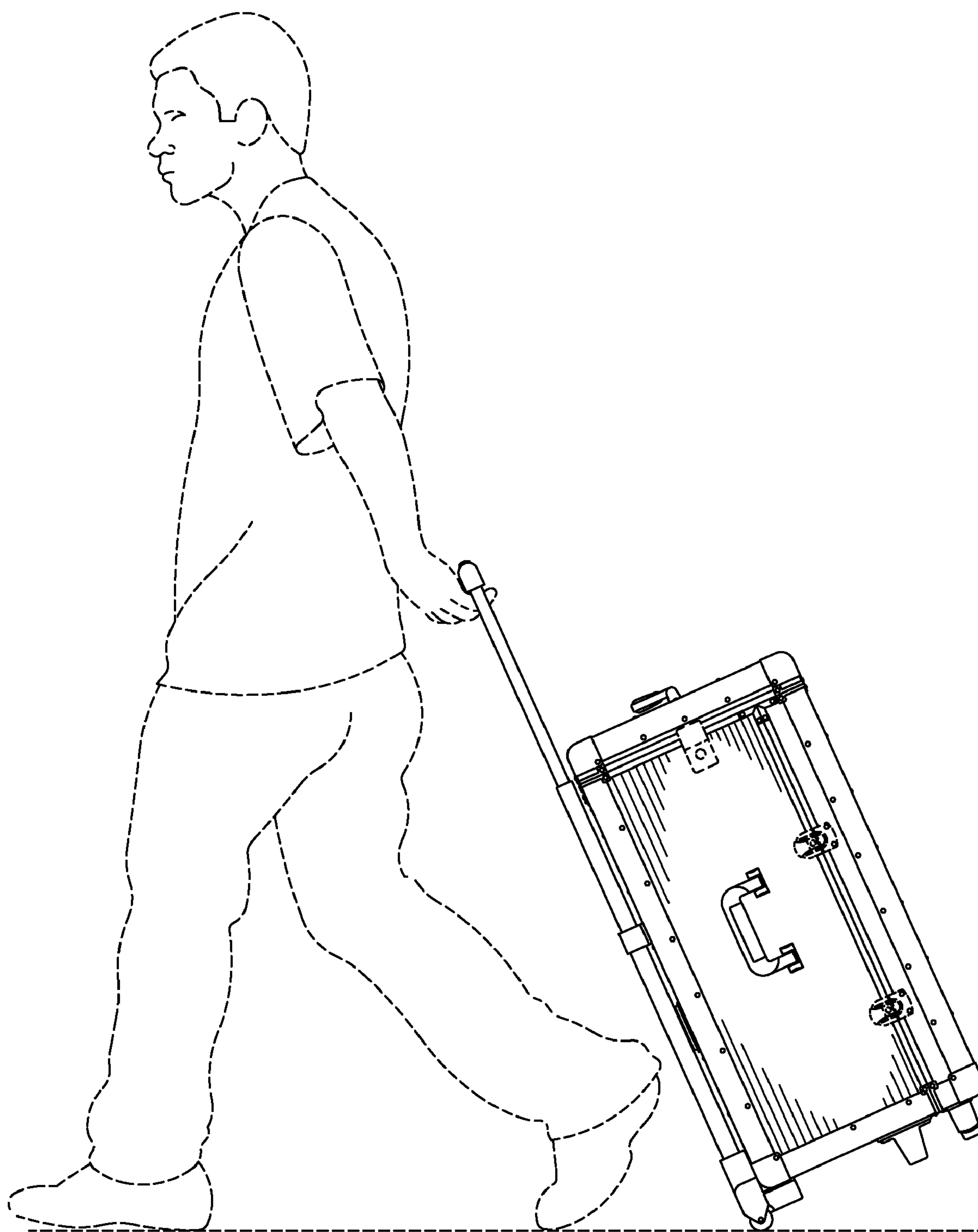

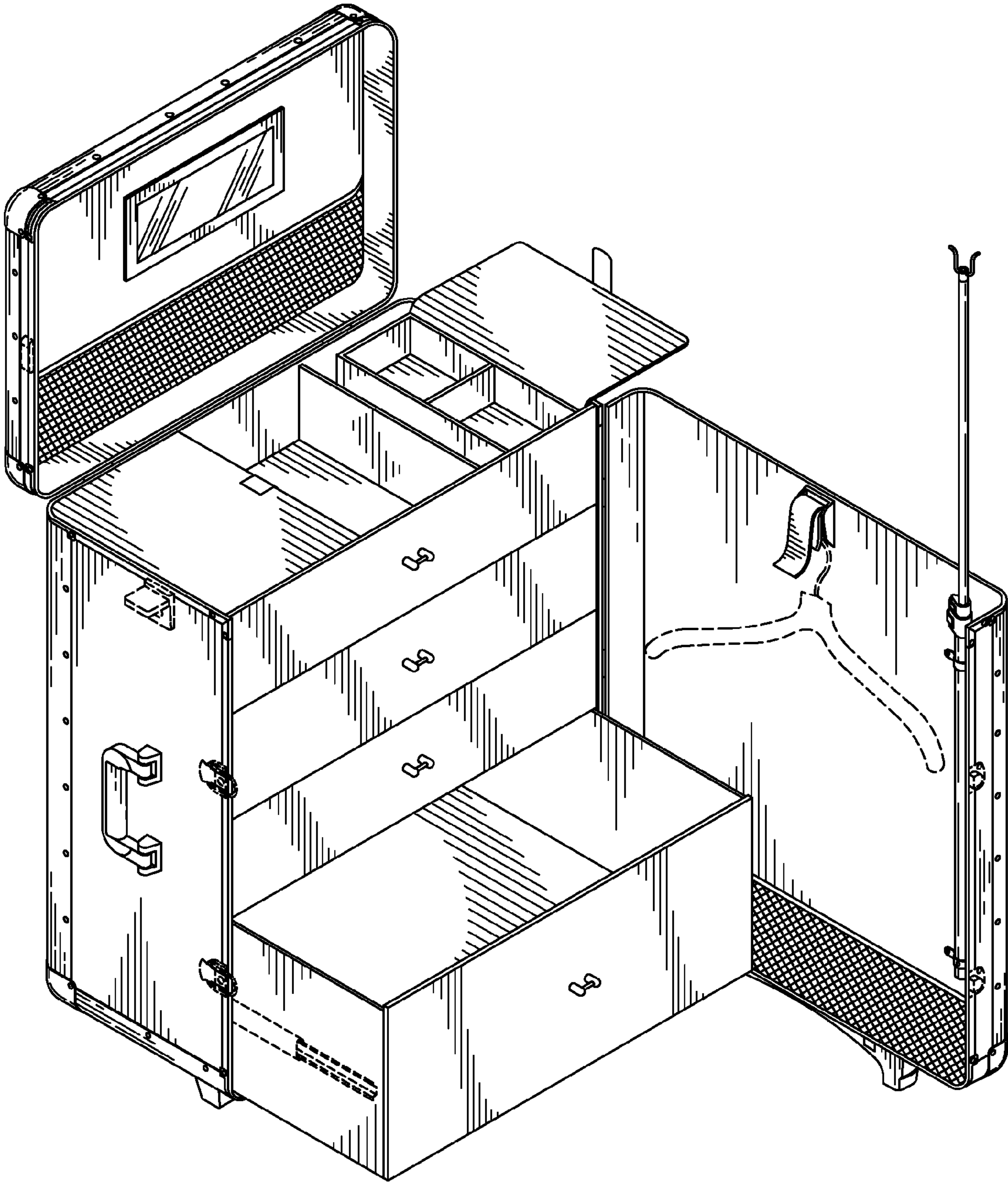
