FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;

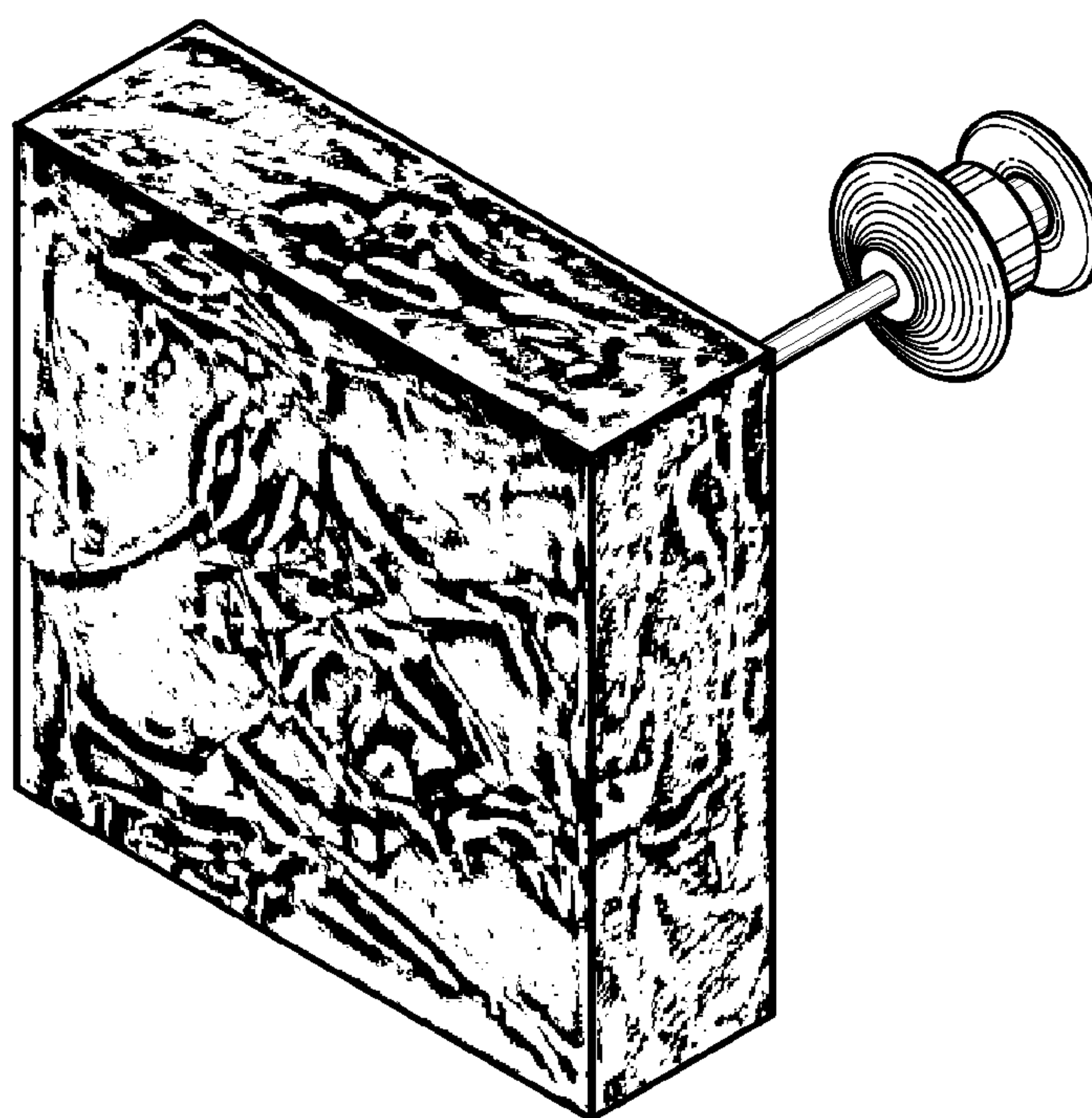
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

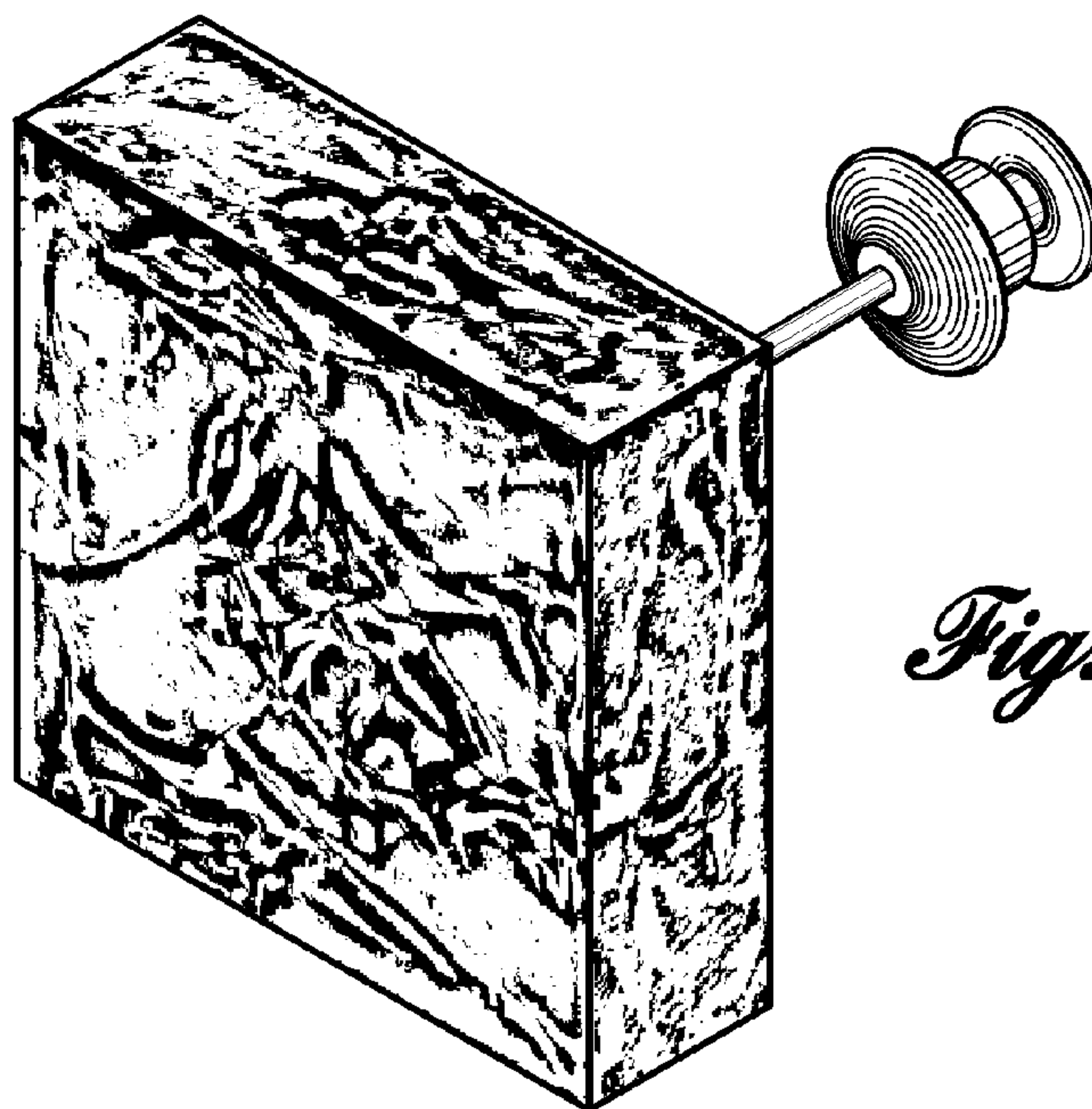

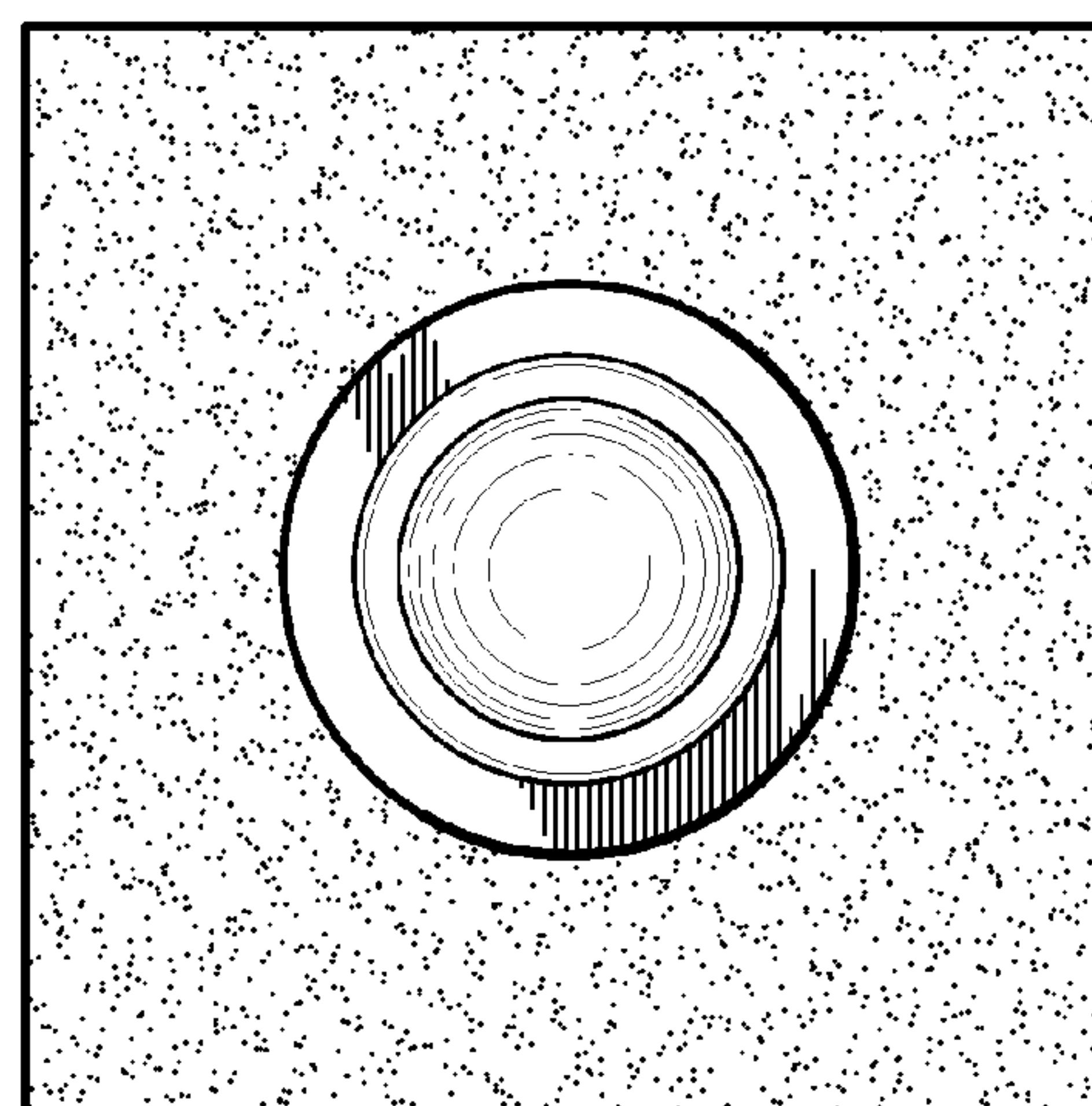

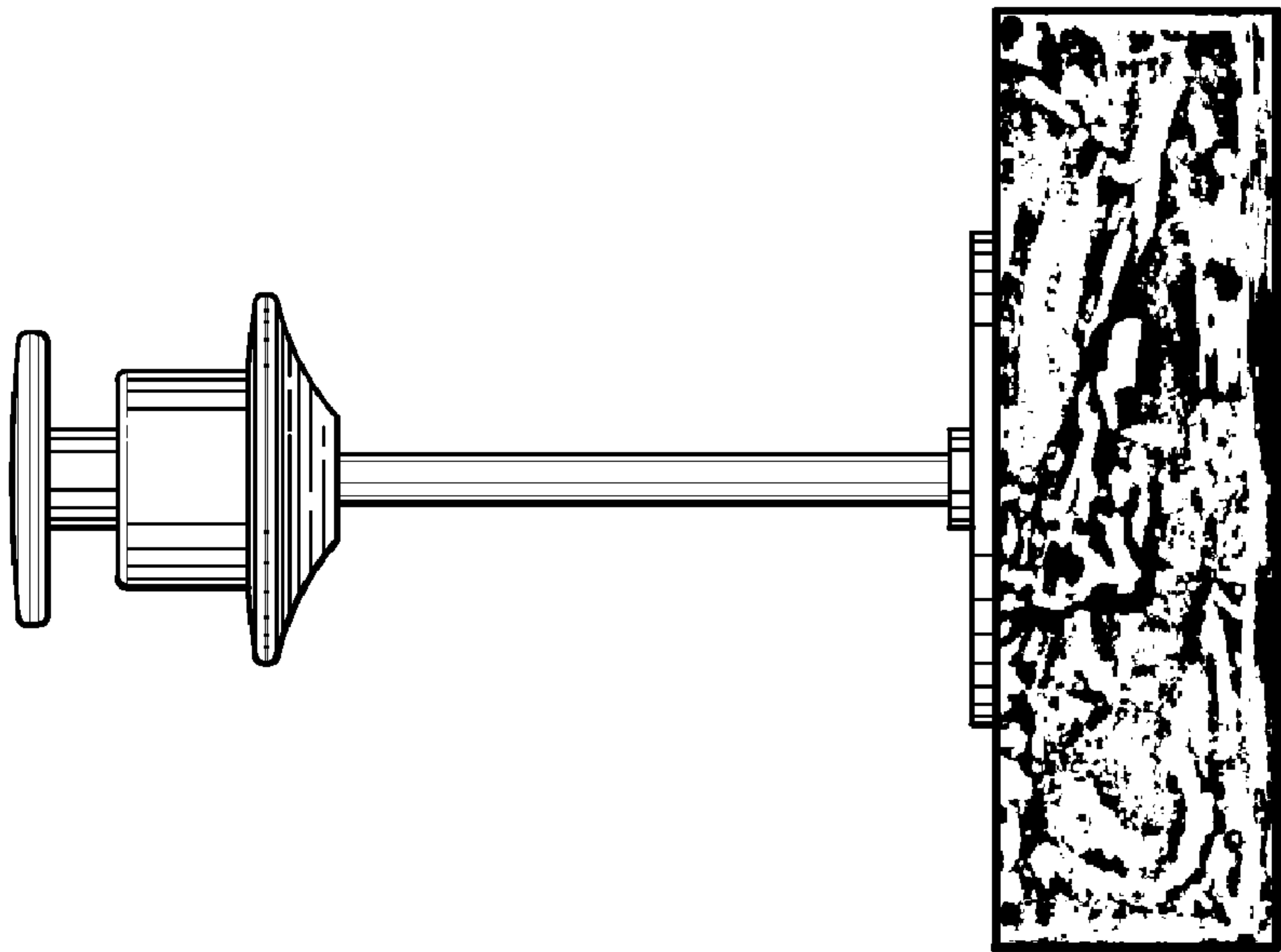

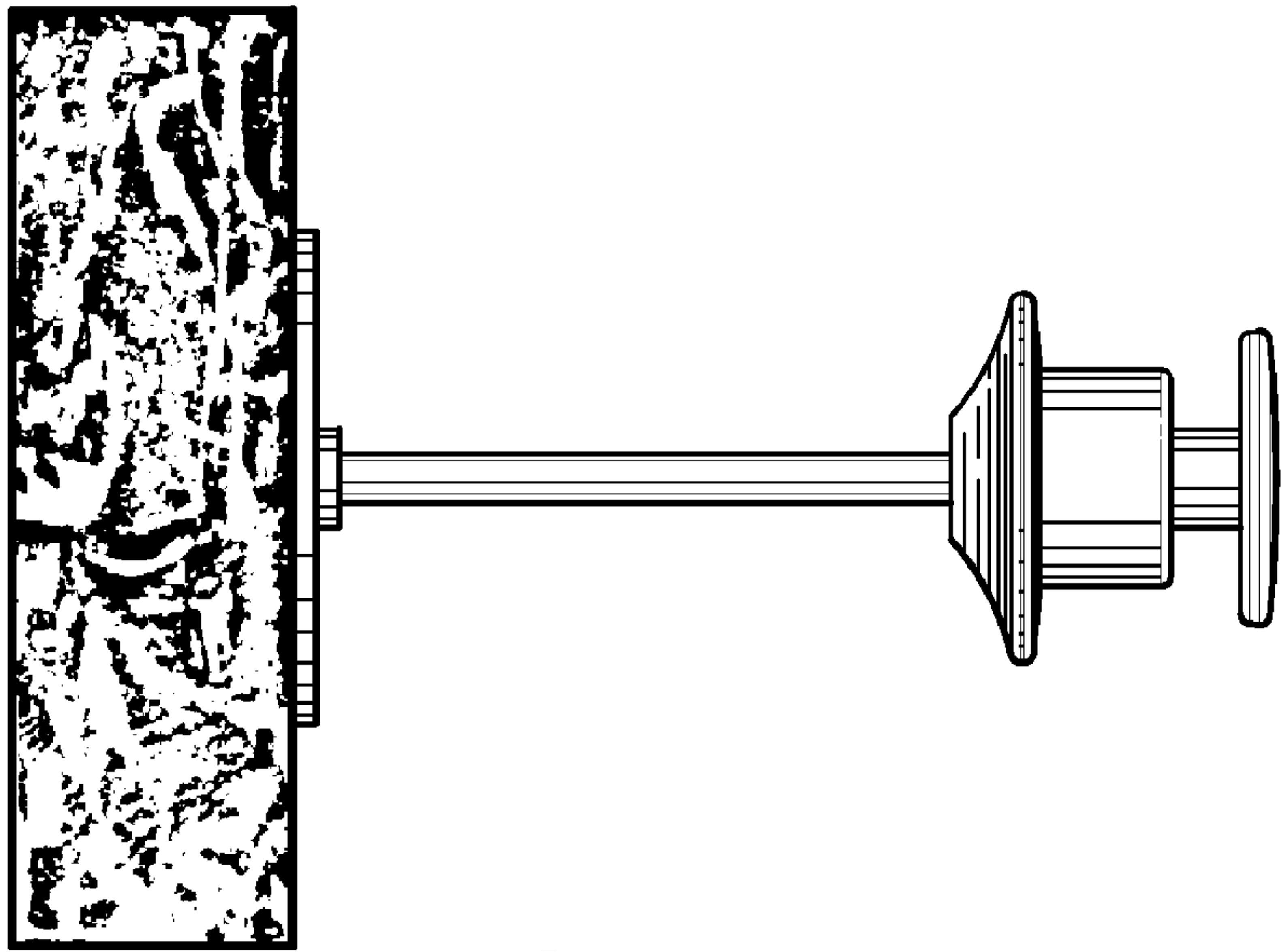

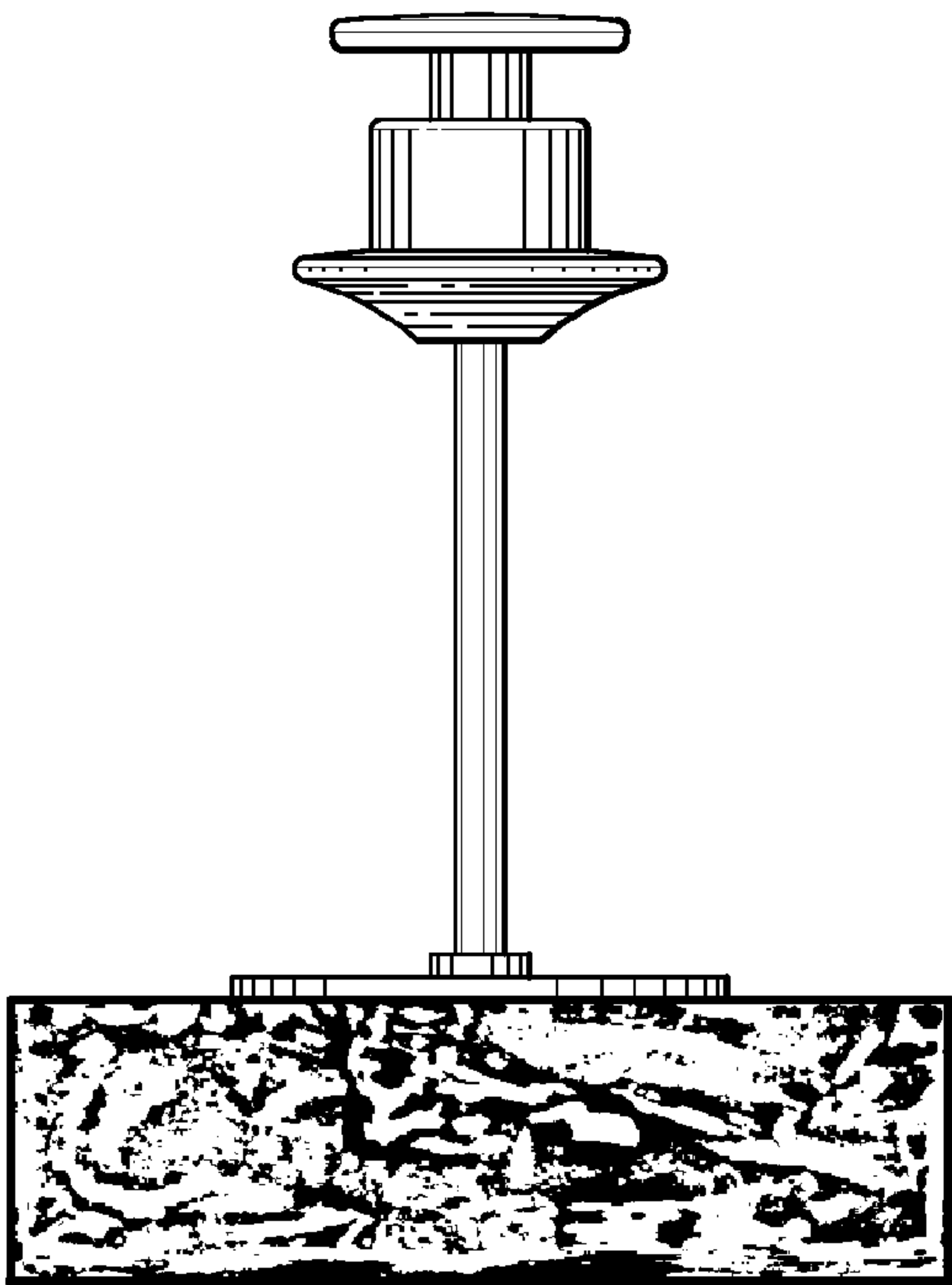

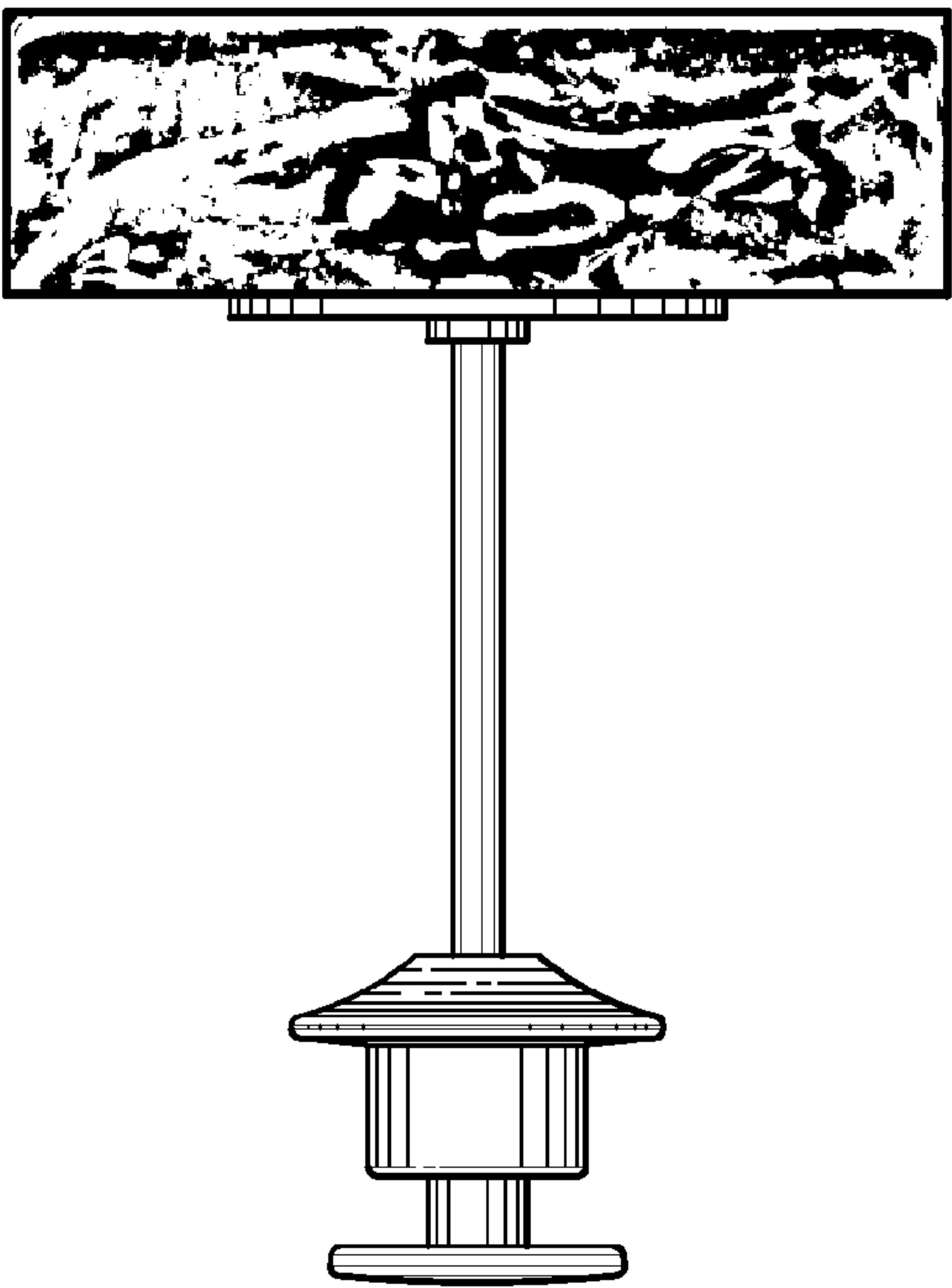
