FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof;

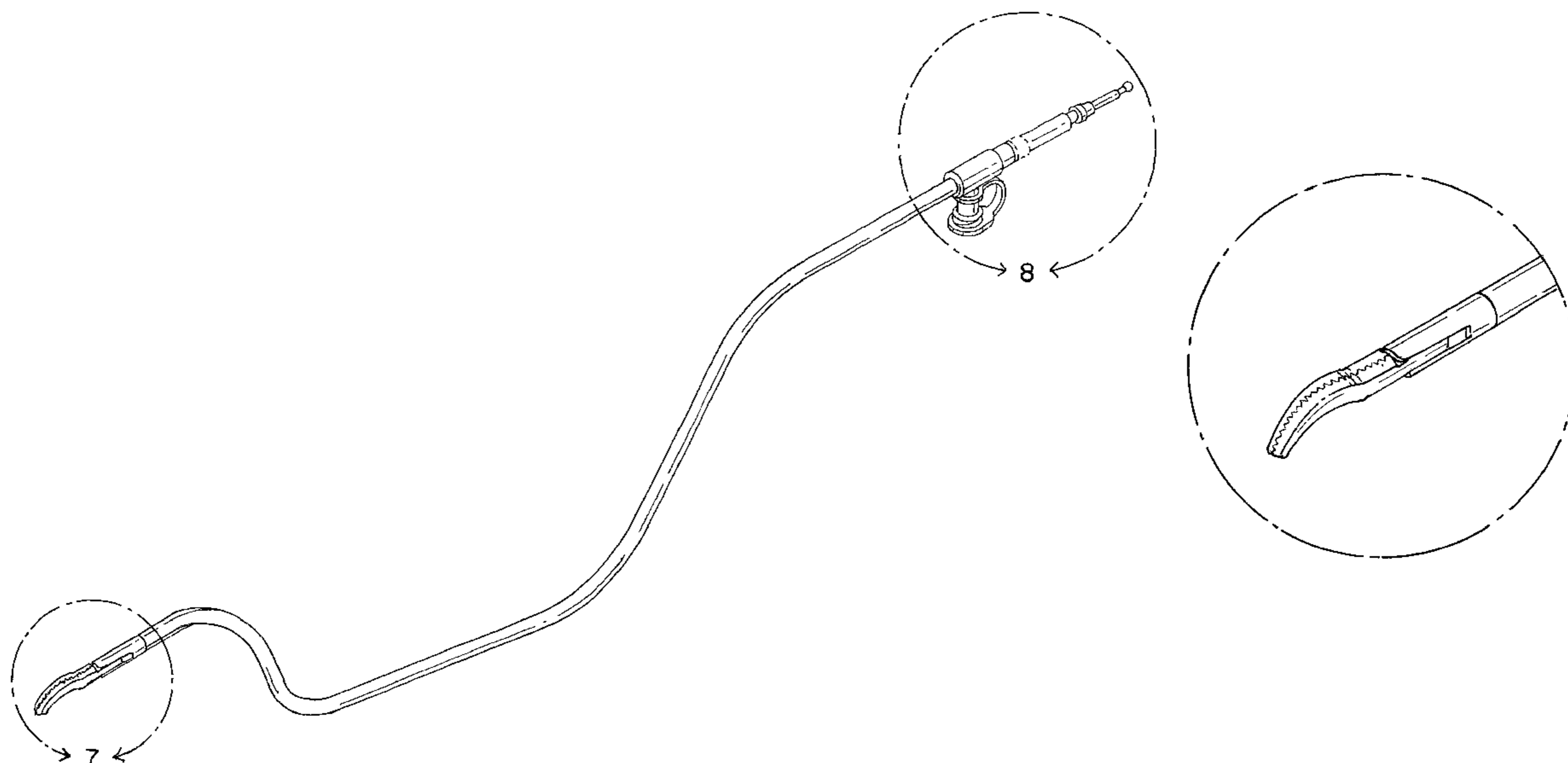
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof;

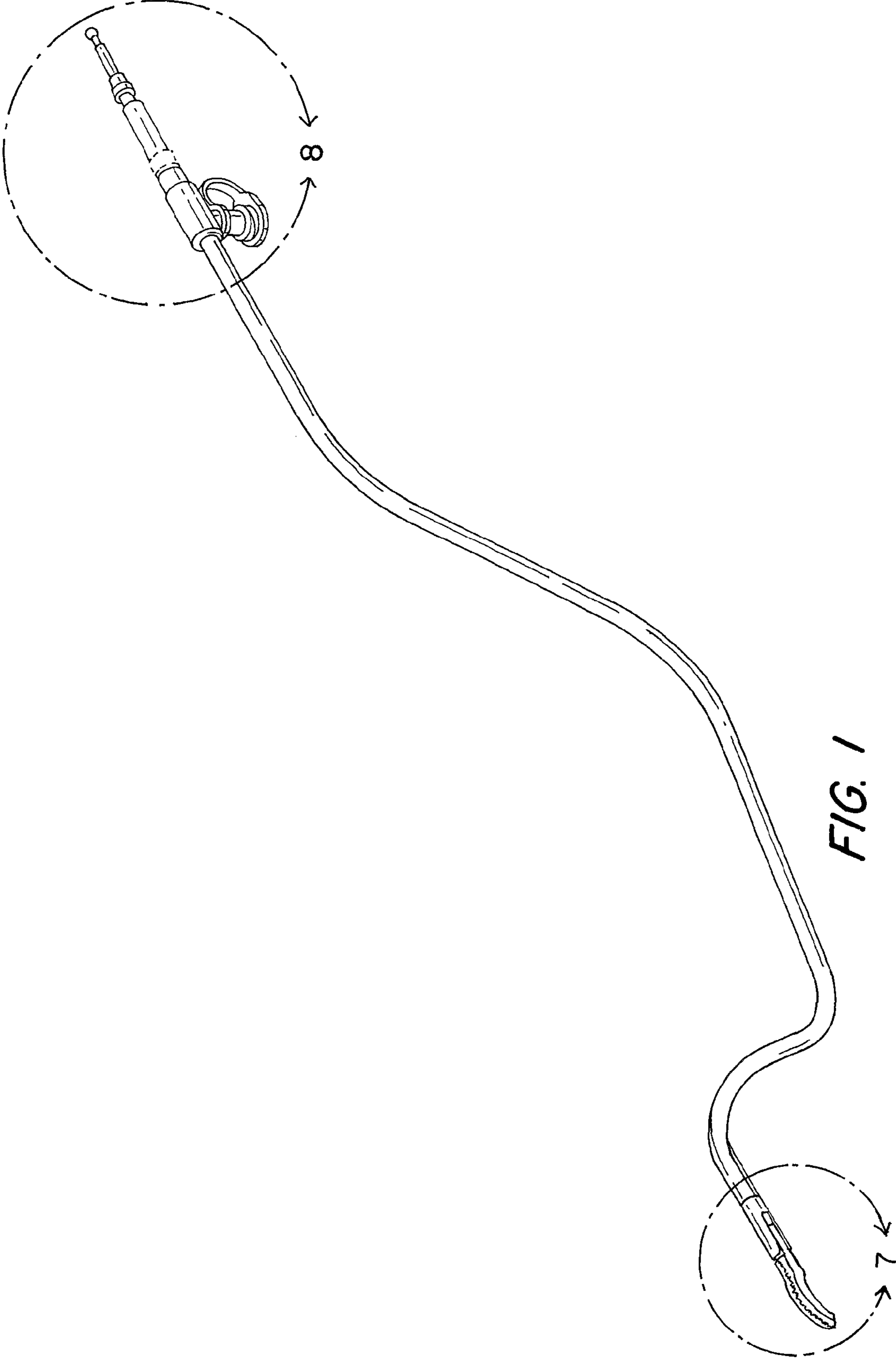
FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective view of the area labeled “7” in FIG. 1; and,

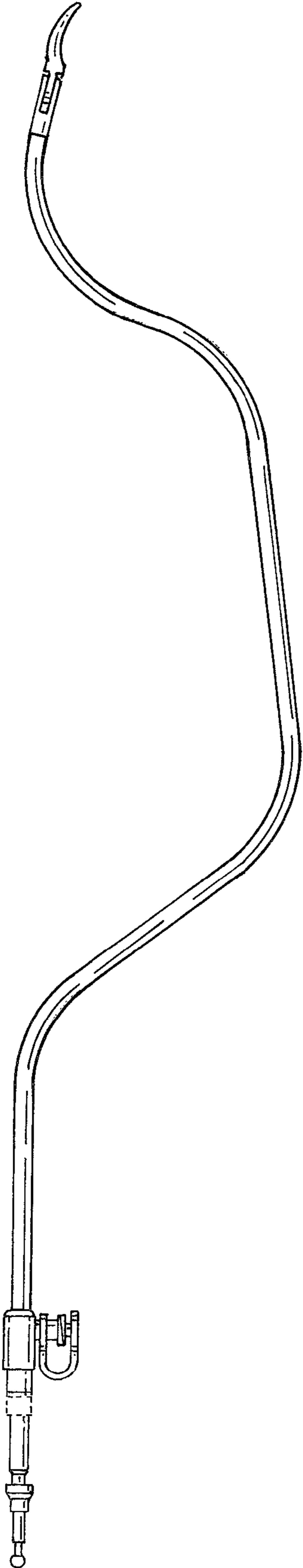

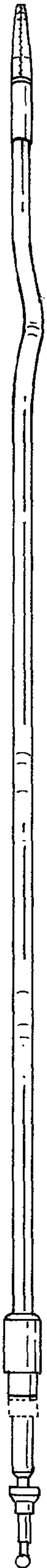

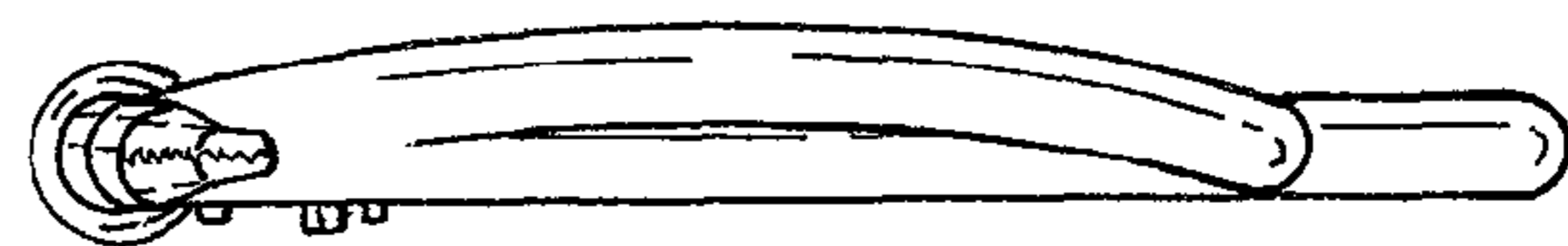

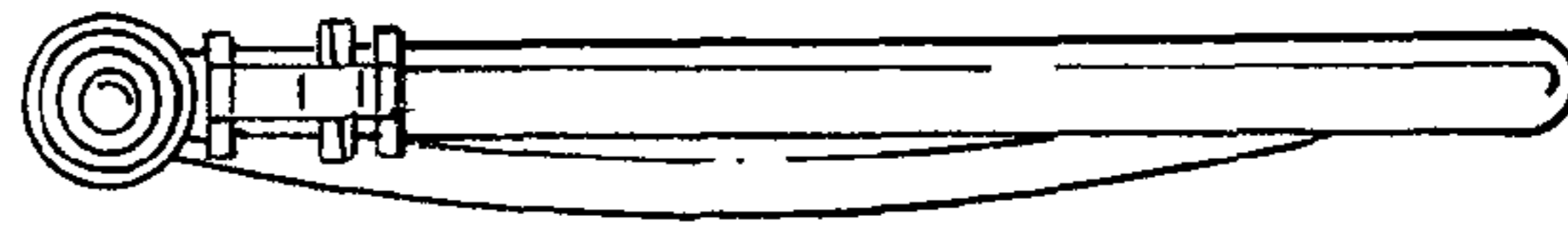

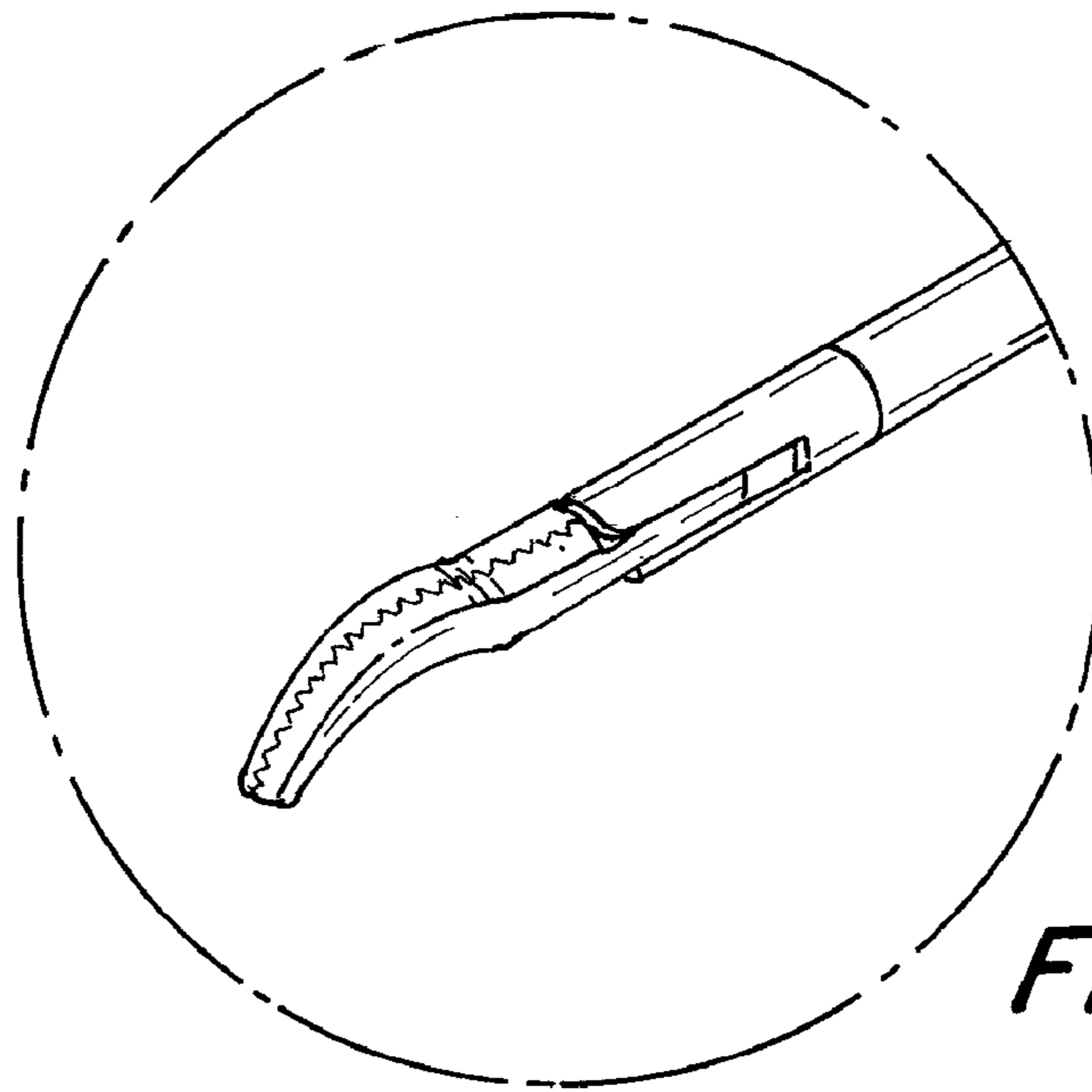

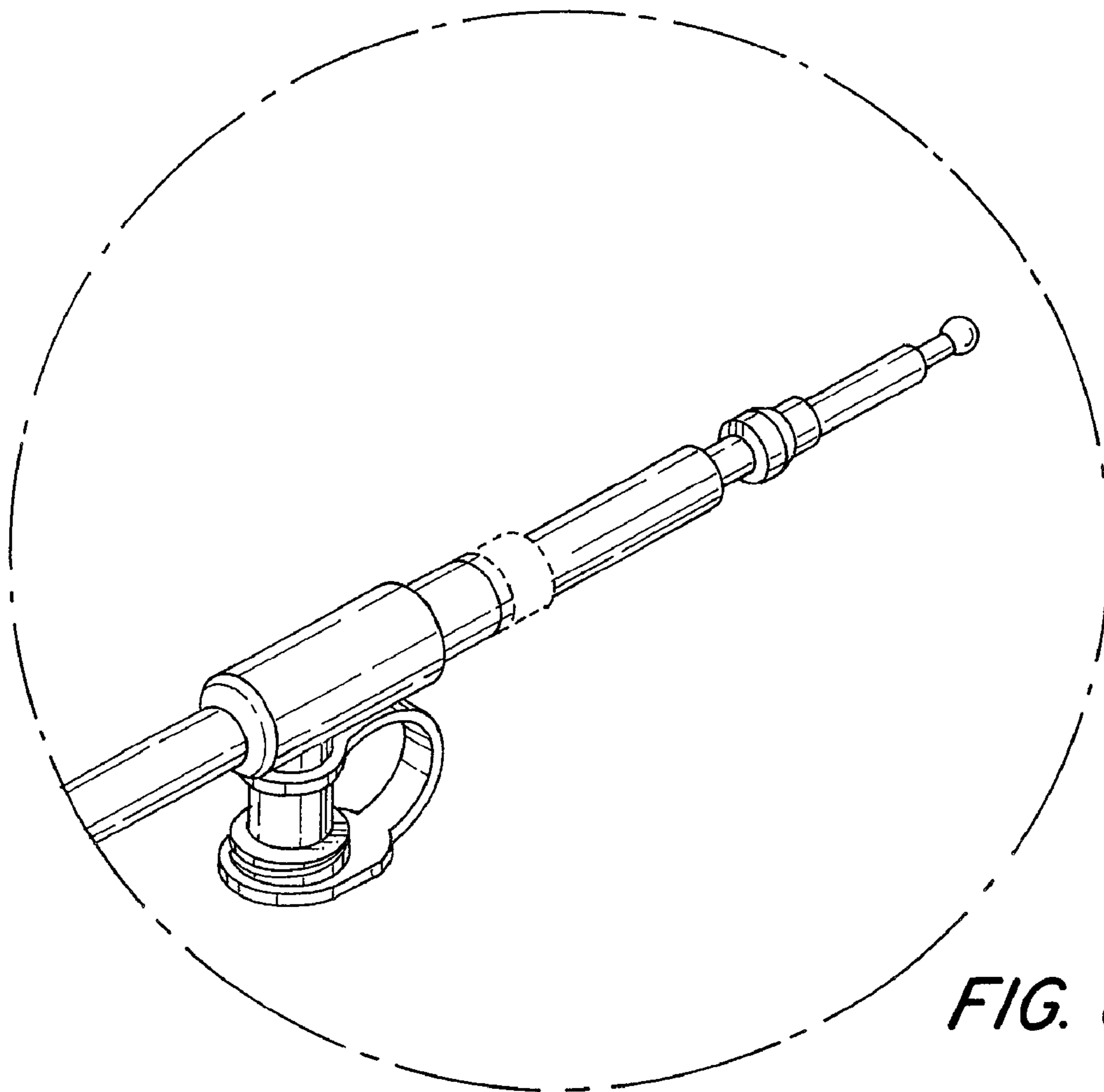
