FIG. 6 is a rear view of the flashlight.


FIG. 7 is a left side view of the flashlight. The right side view of the flashlight is a mirror image of the left side view.


FIG. 8 is a top view of the flashlight; and,


FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the flashlight.













