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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cap visor with magnifier and
display unit mounting, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, right perspective view of a cap visor with
magnifier and display unit mounting showing my new design
therefor;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear top left perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear bottom right perspective view thereof;

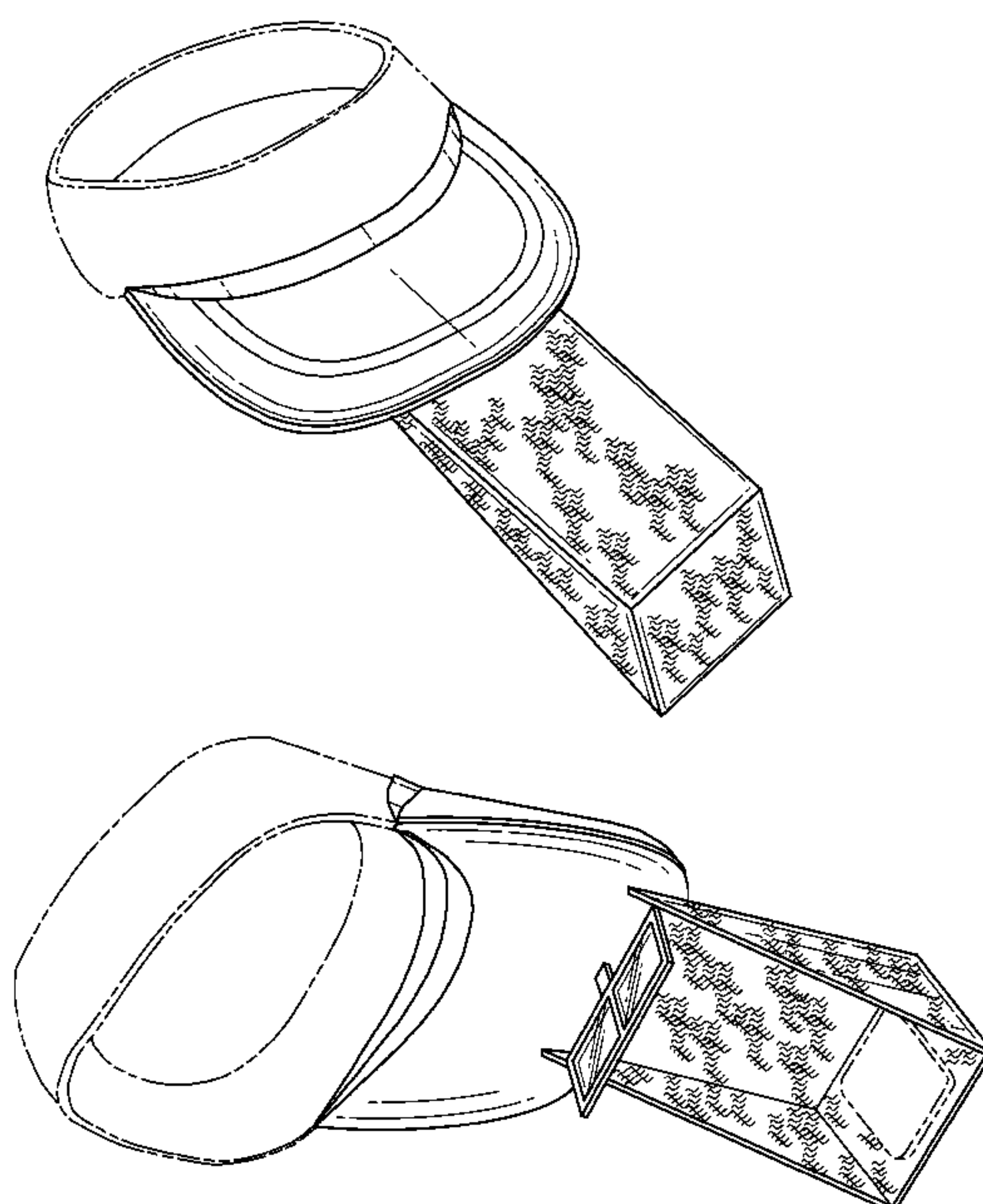
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

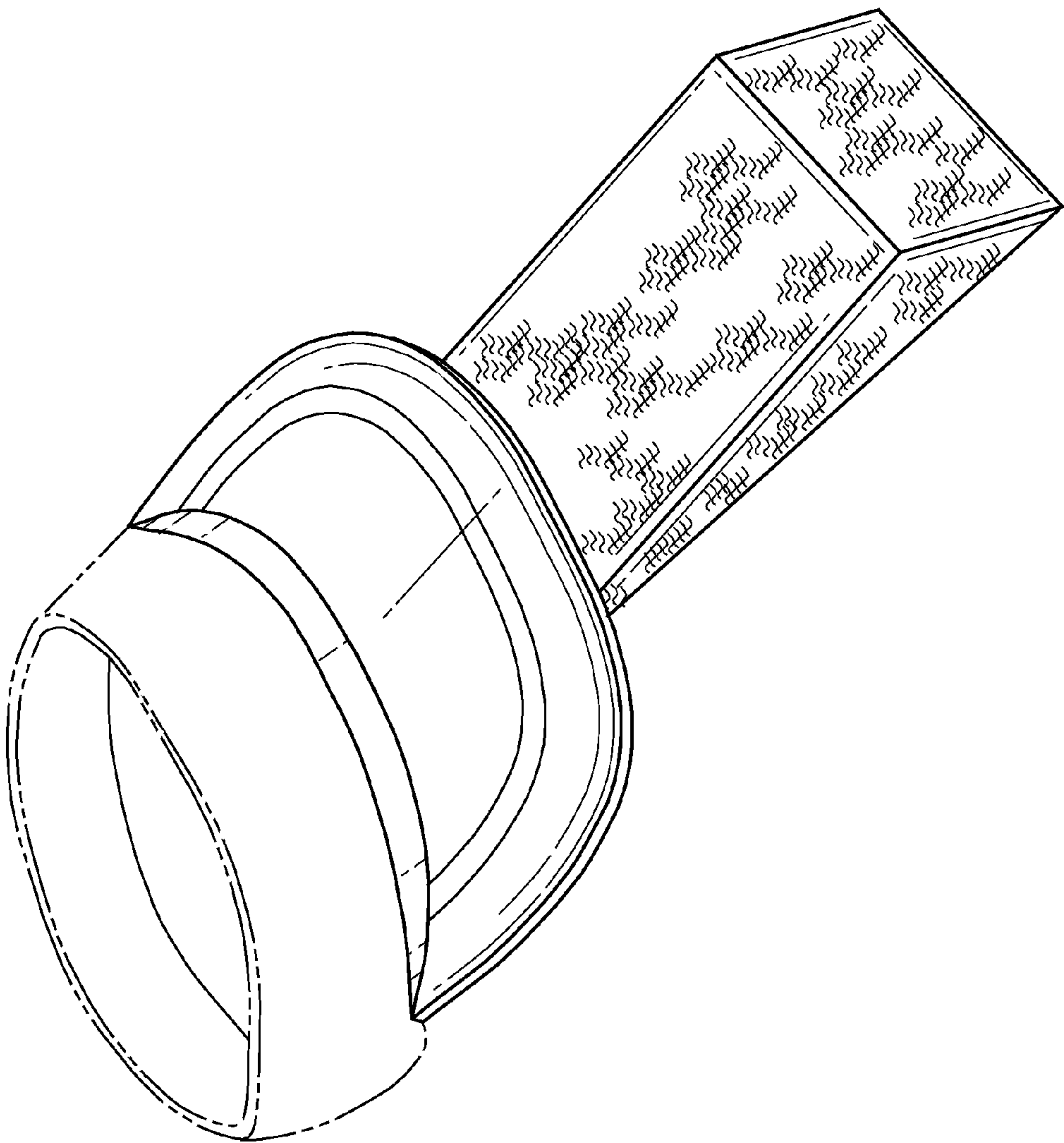

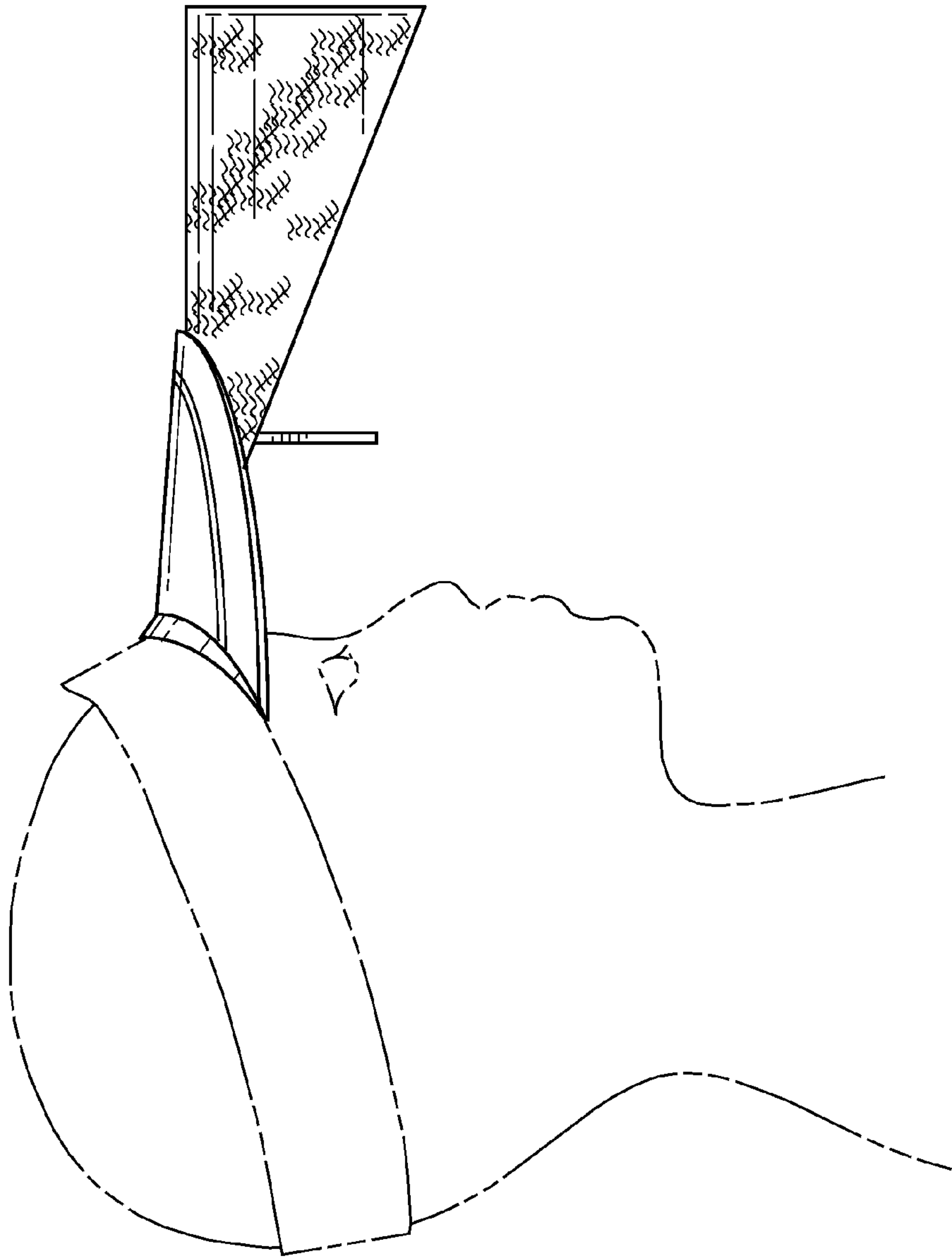

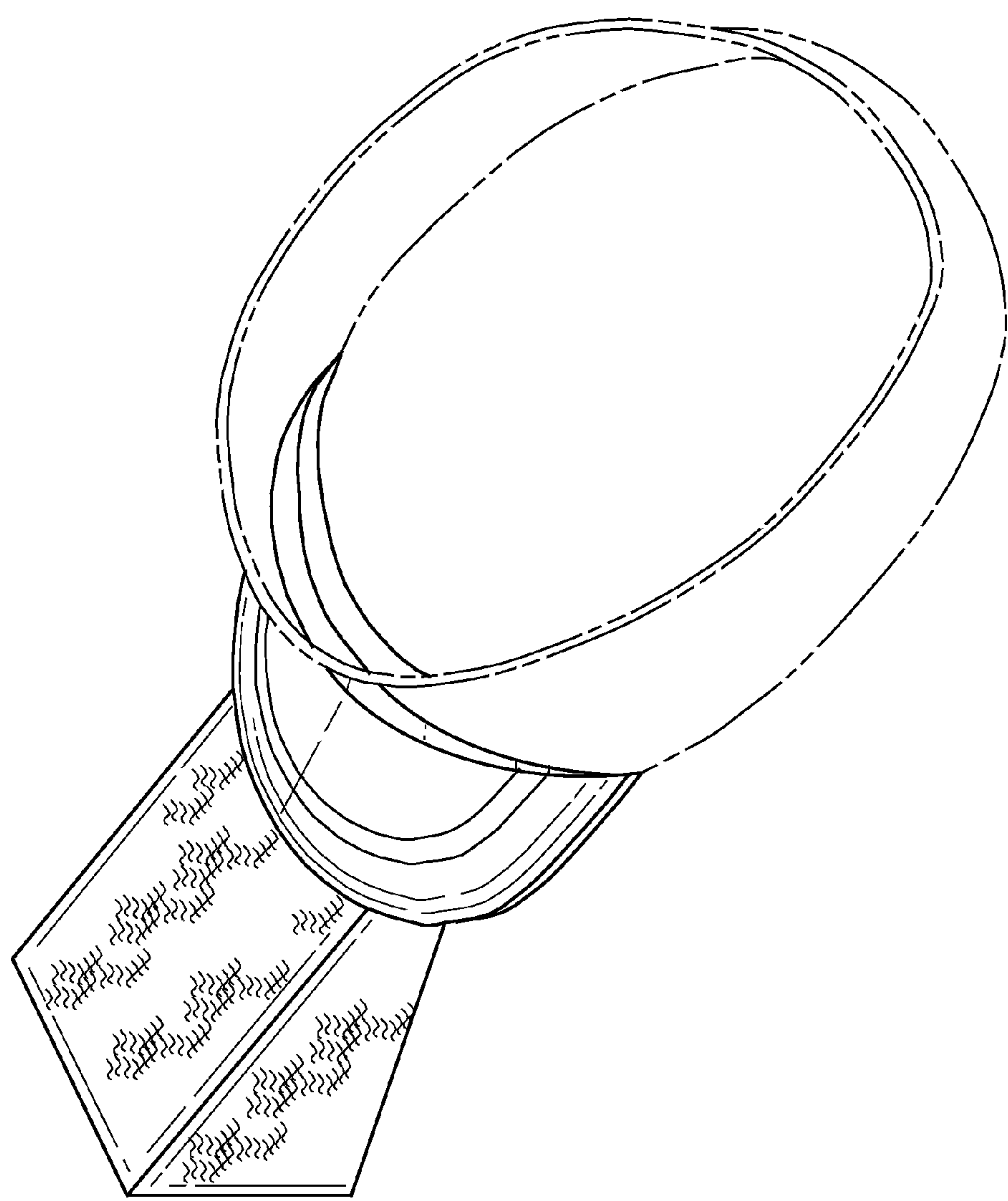

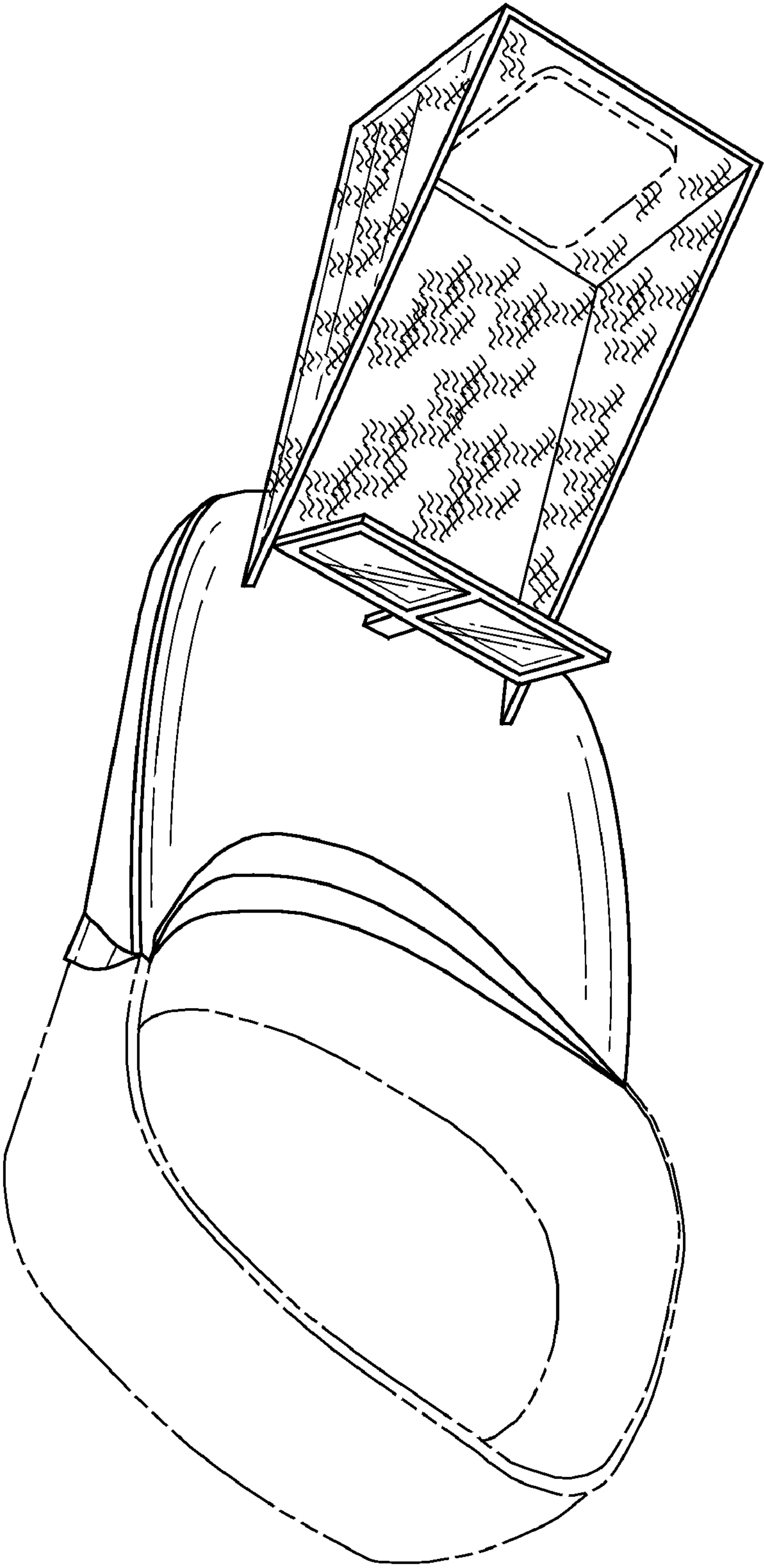

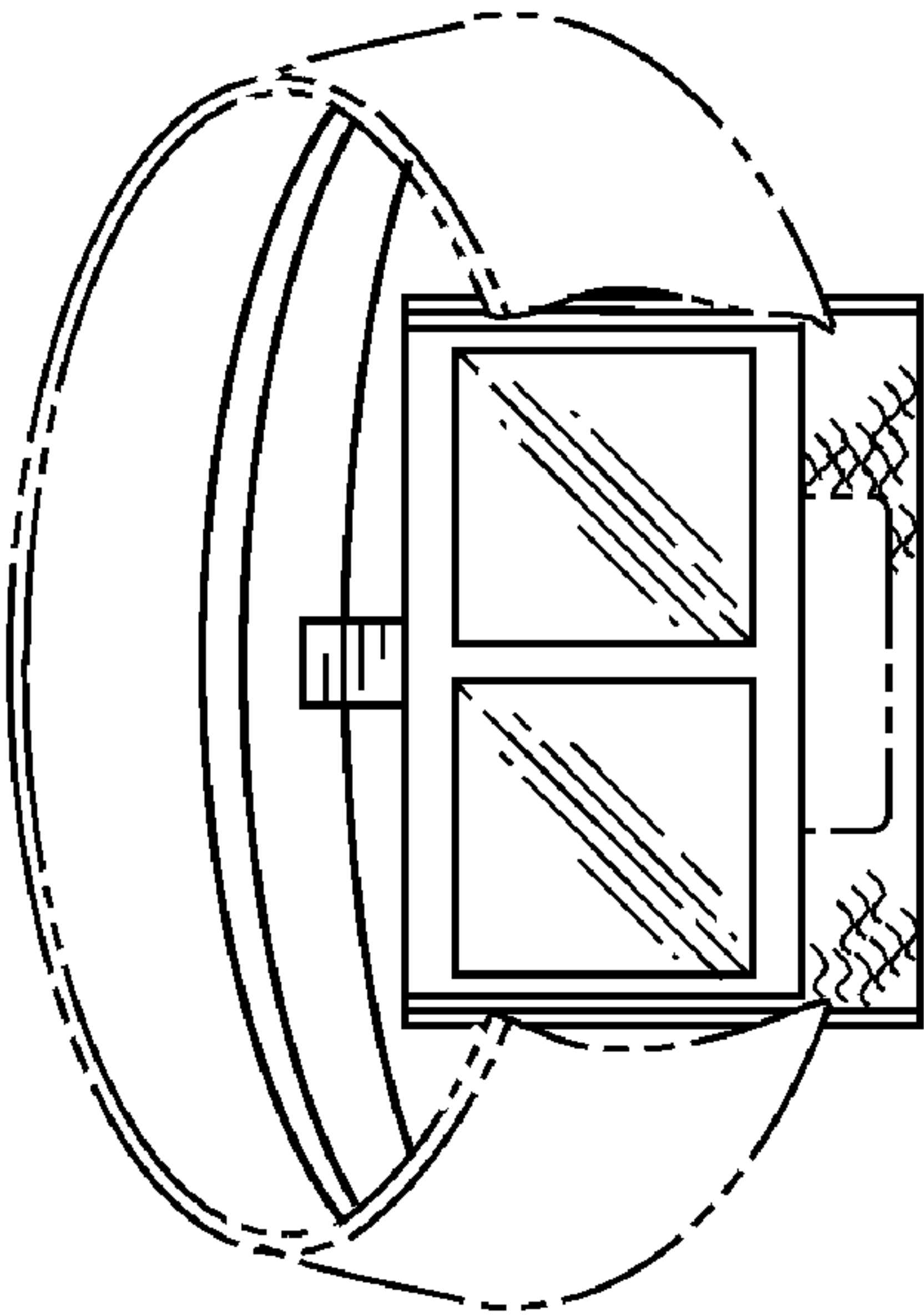

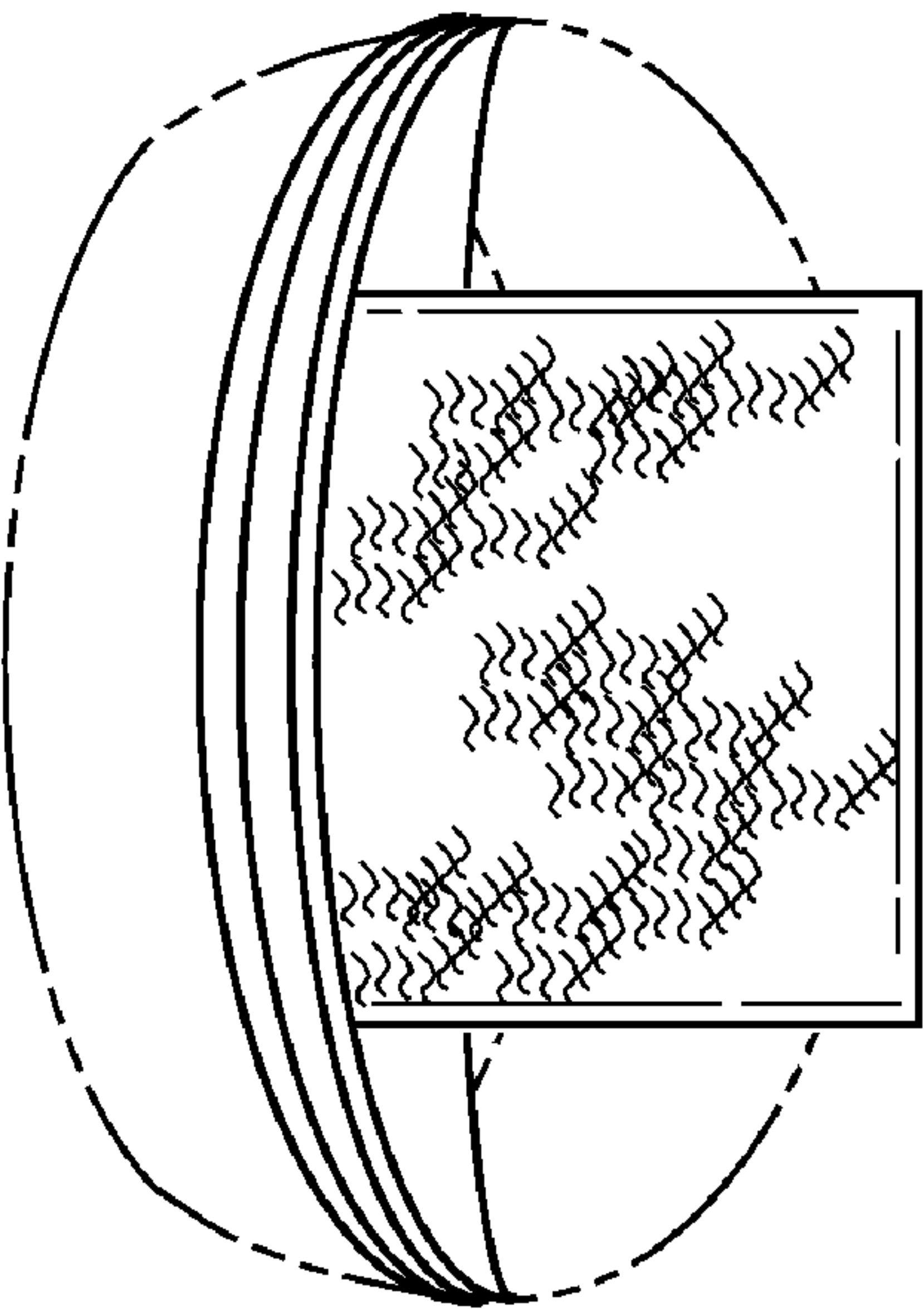

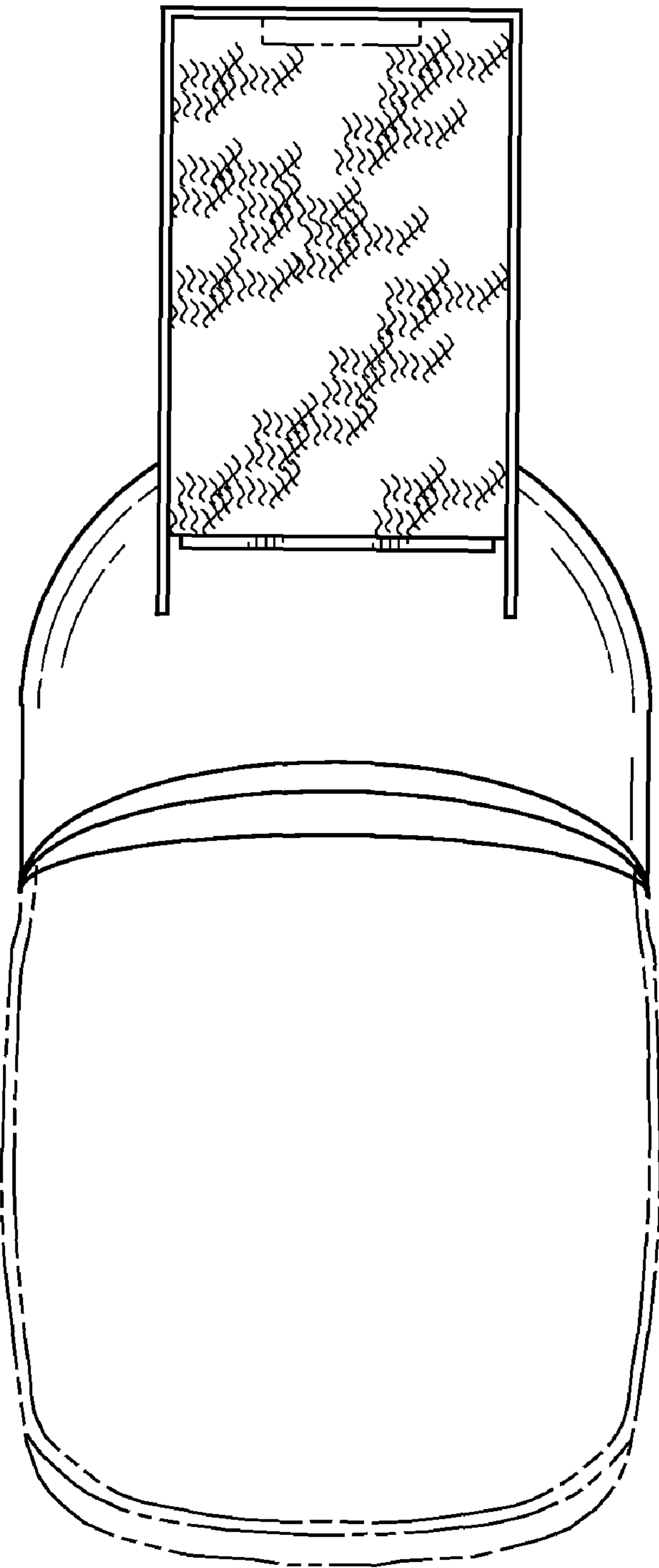
