The ornamental design for an absorbent article with releasable backsheet material, as shown and described.

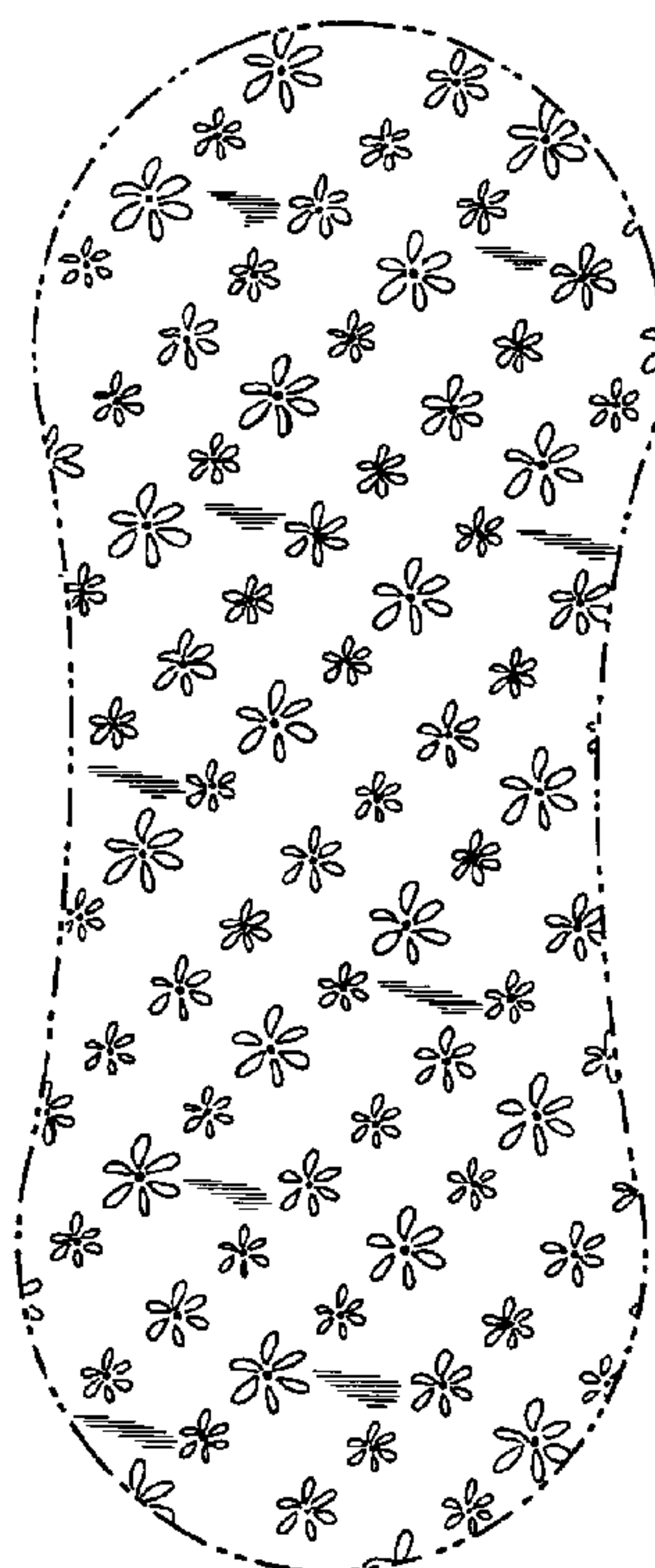
DESCRIPTION

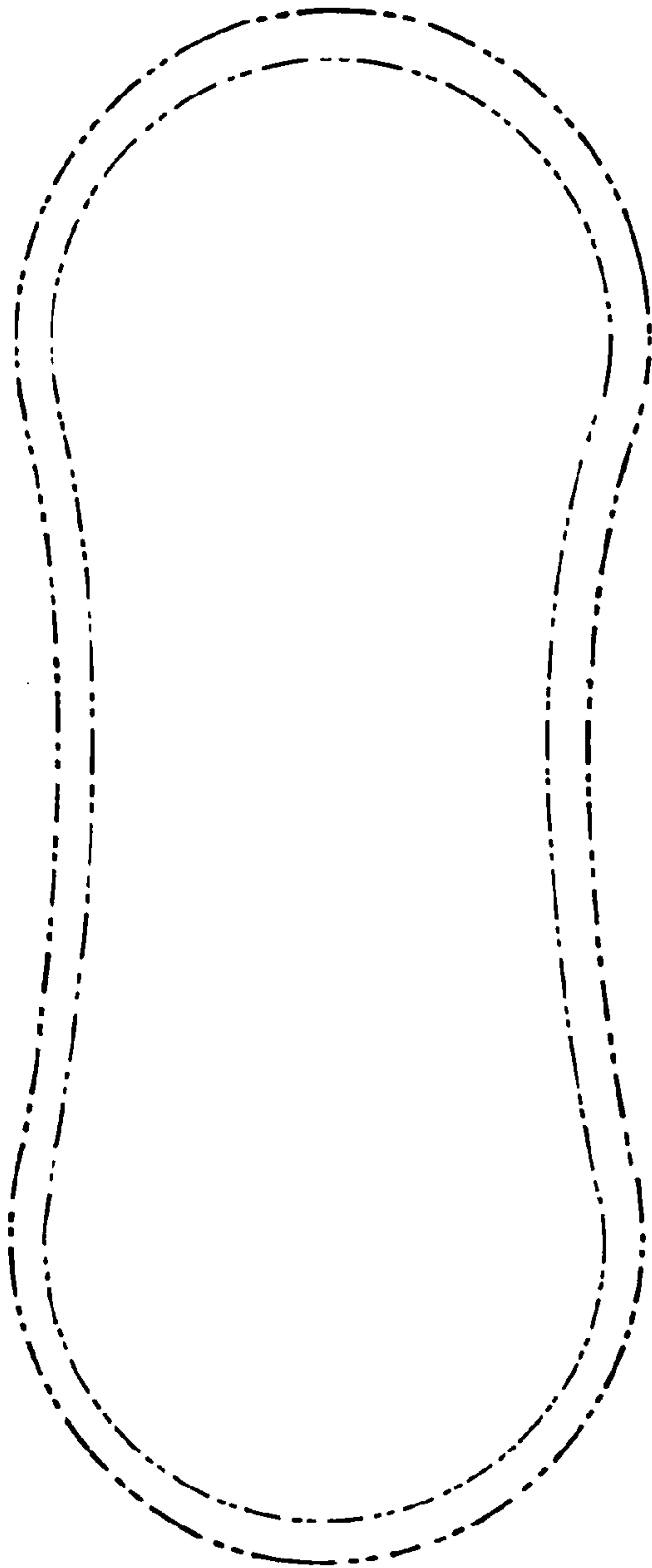

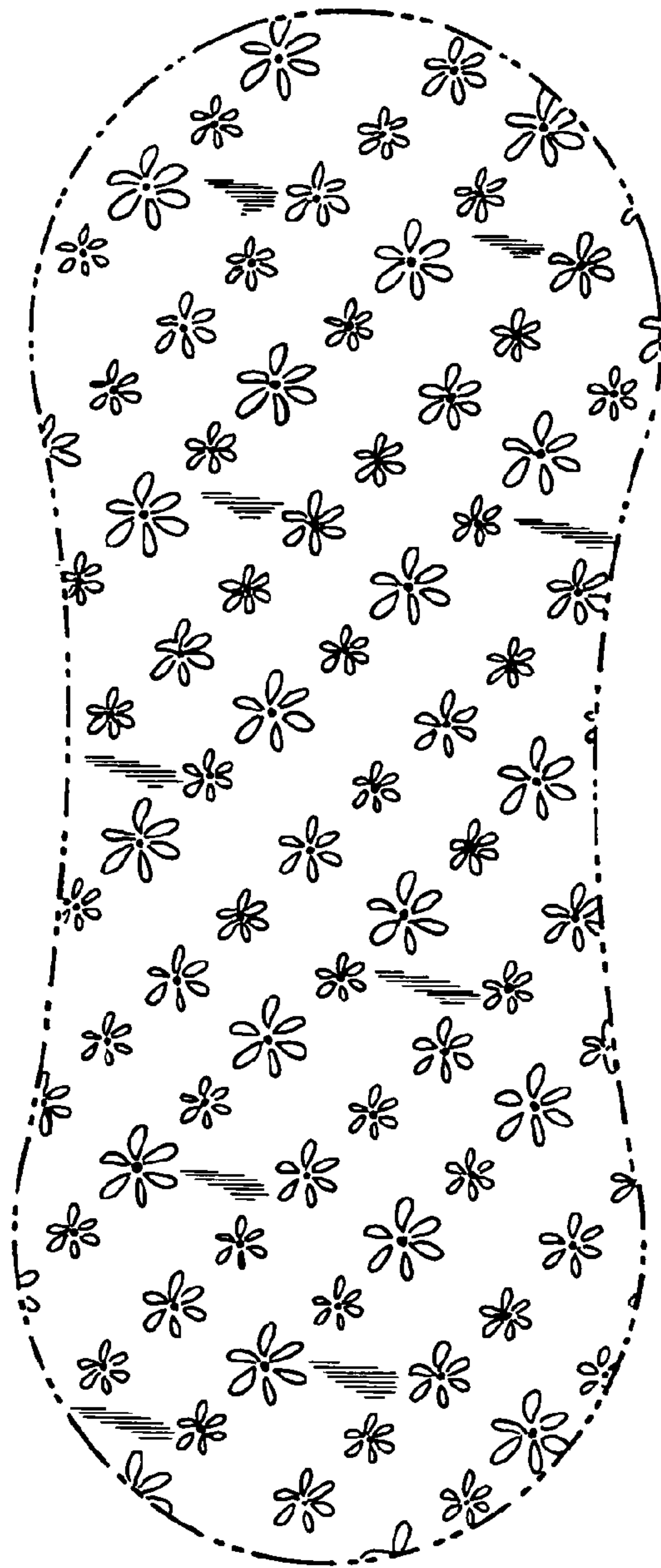
