(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a luminaire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a luminaire showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary perspective view thereof, taken where indicated by “B” in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof, shown broken-away for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, shown broken-away for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 5 is a vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line A—A of FIG. 3; and,

FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken where indicated by “C” in FIG. 5.
