FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof;

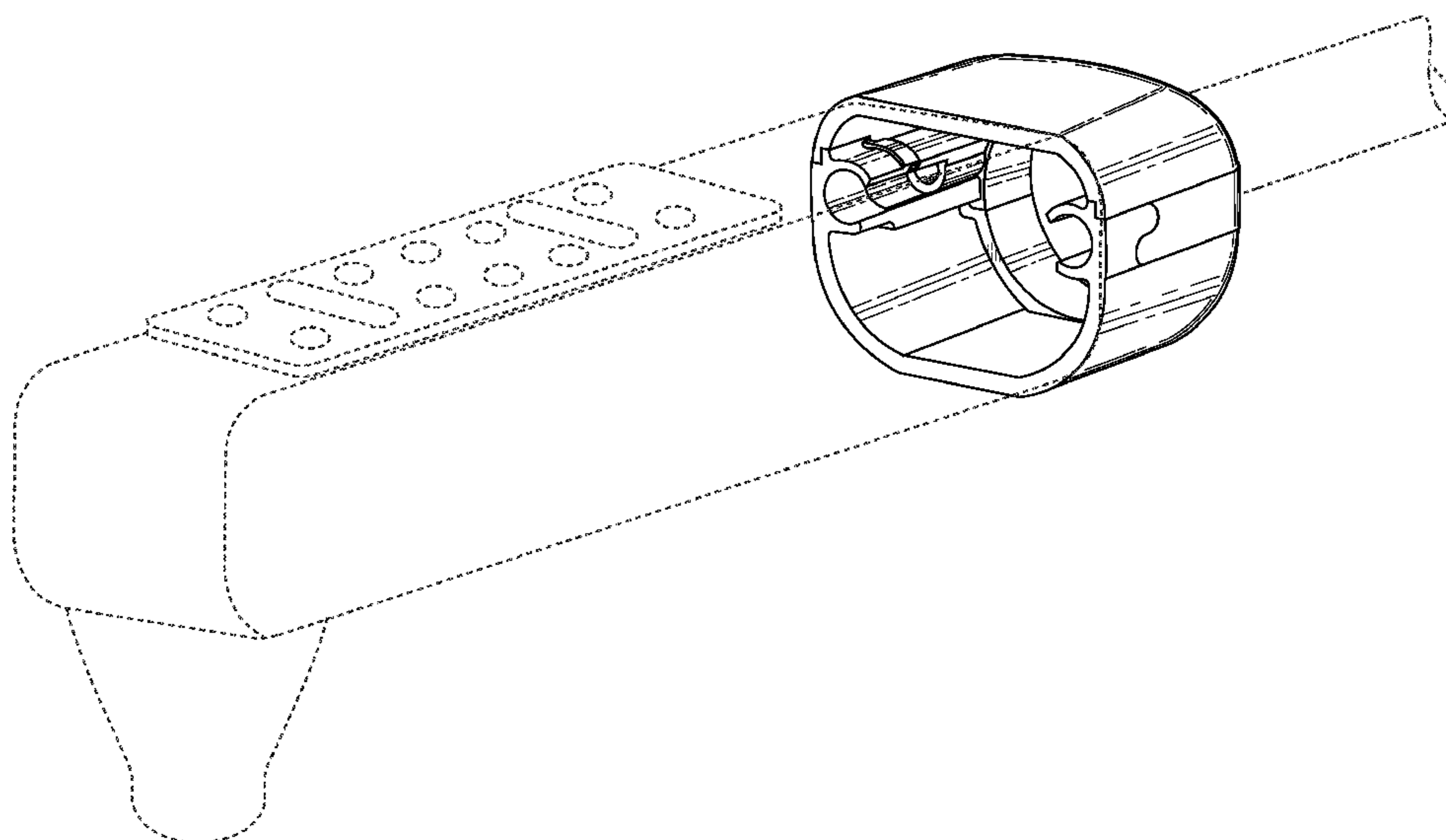
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof;

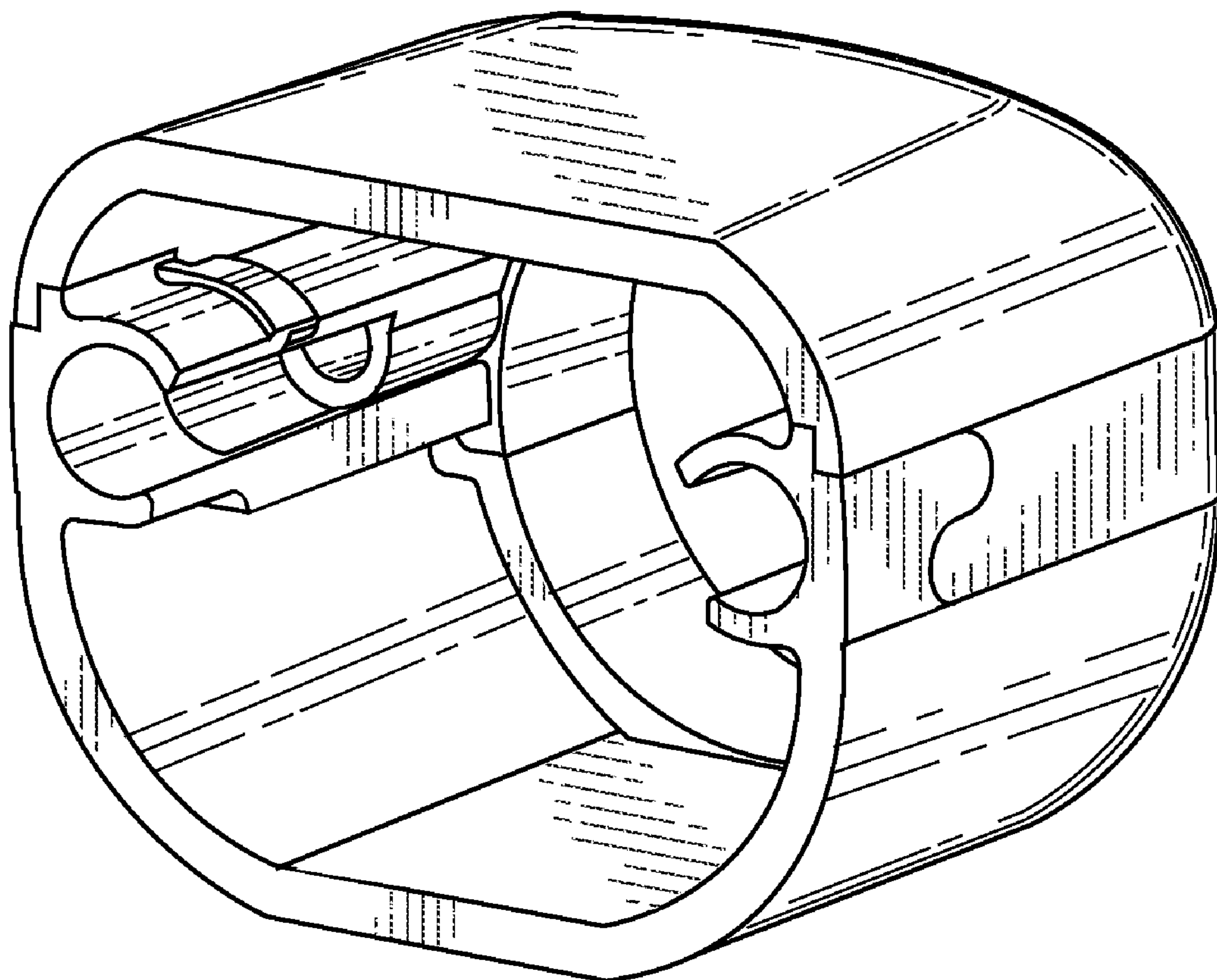

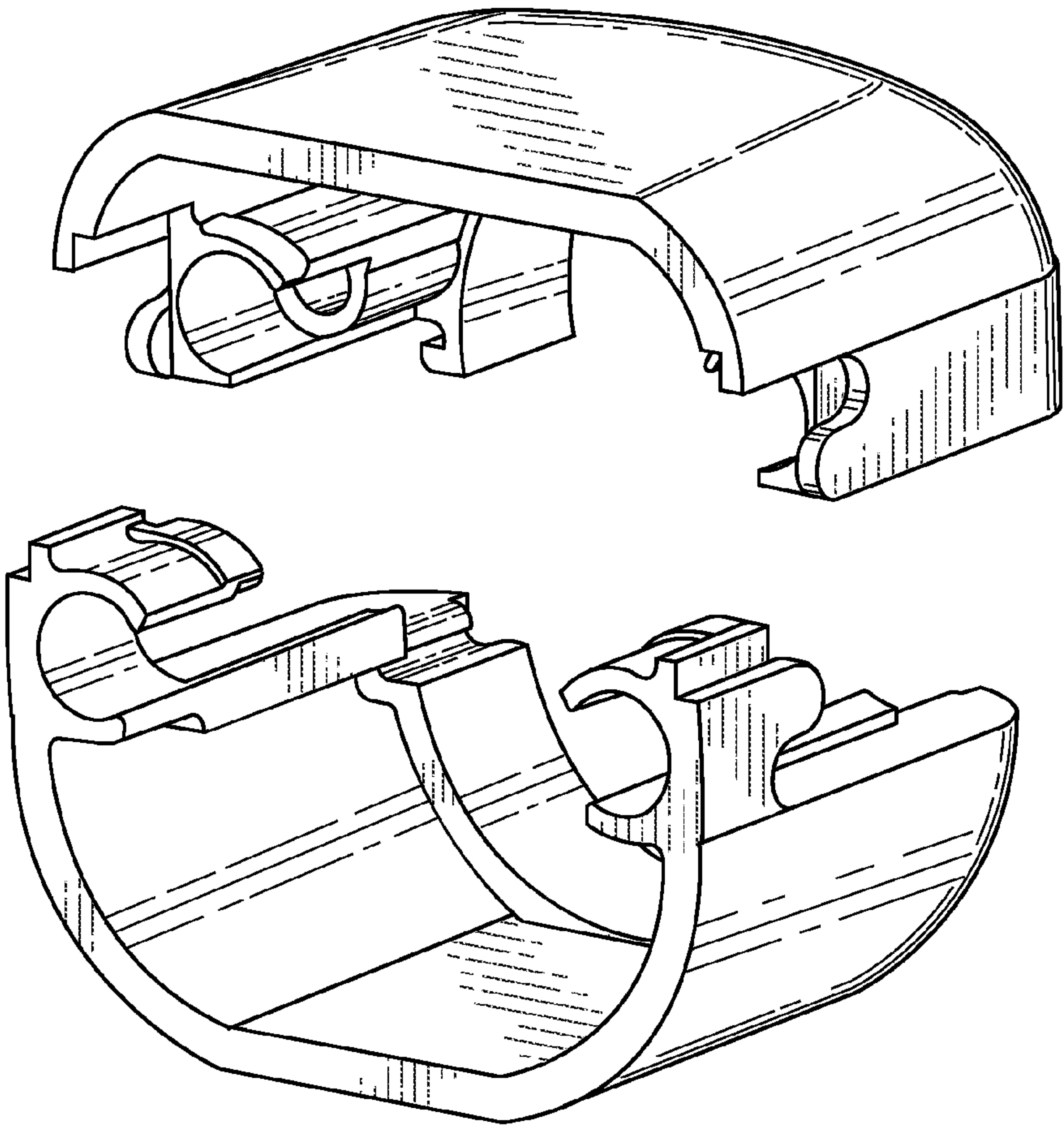

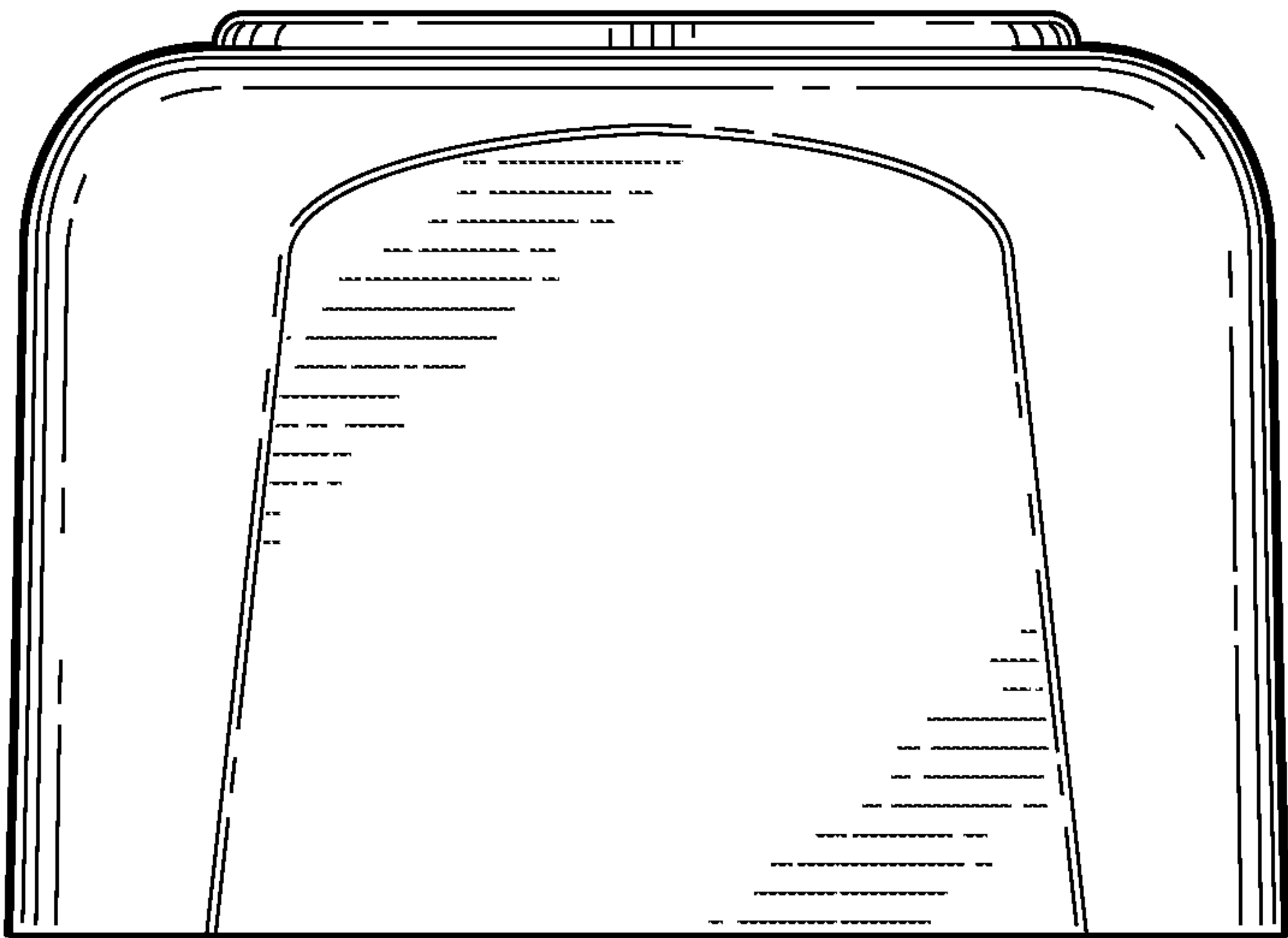

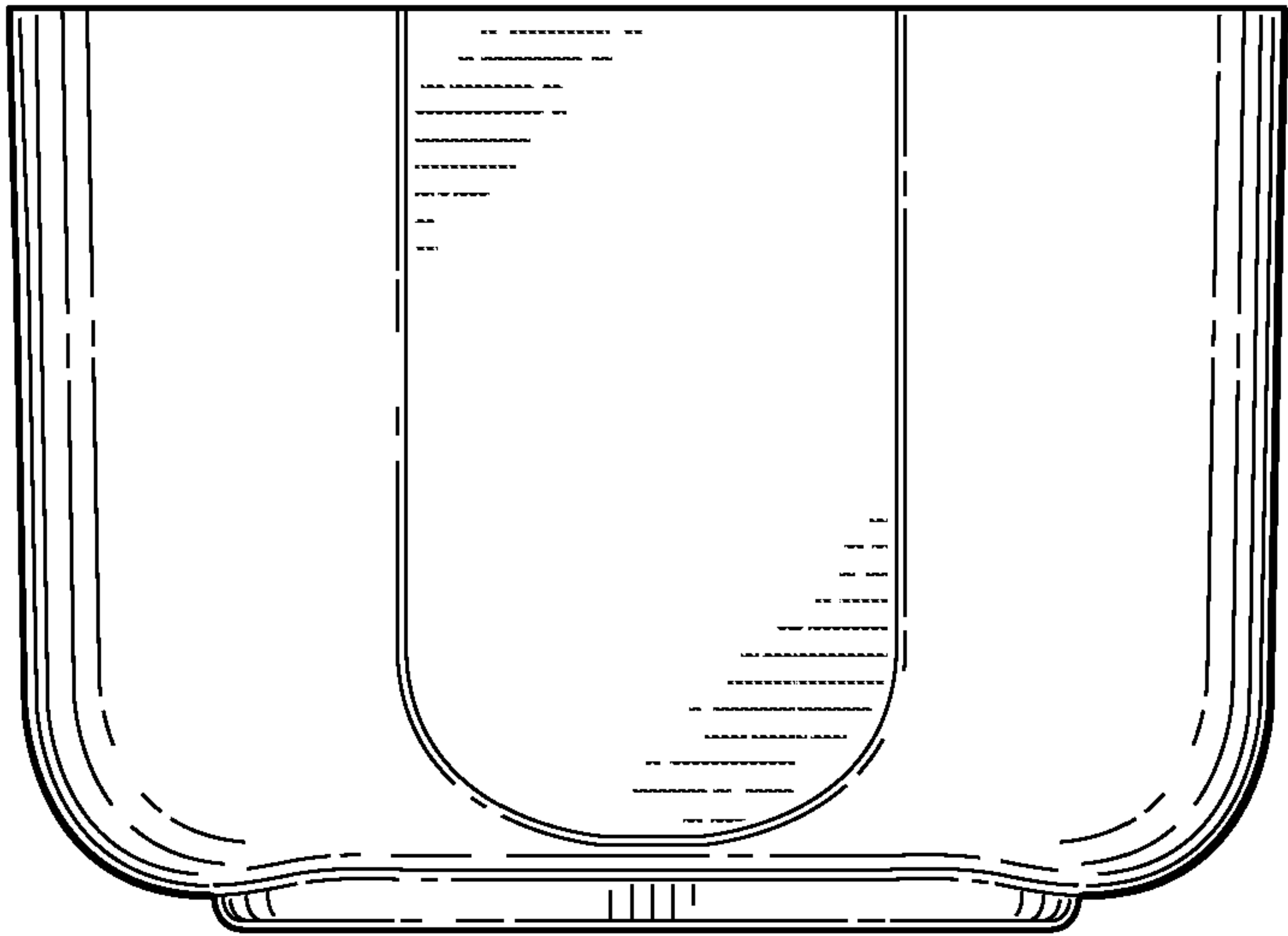

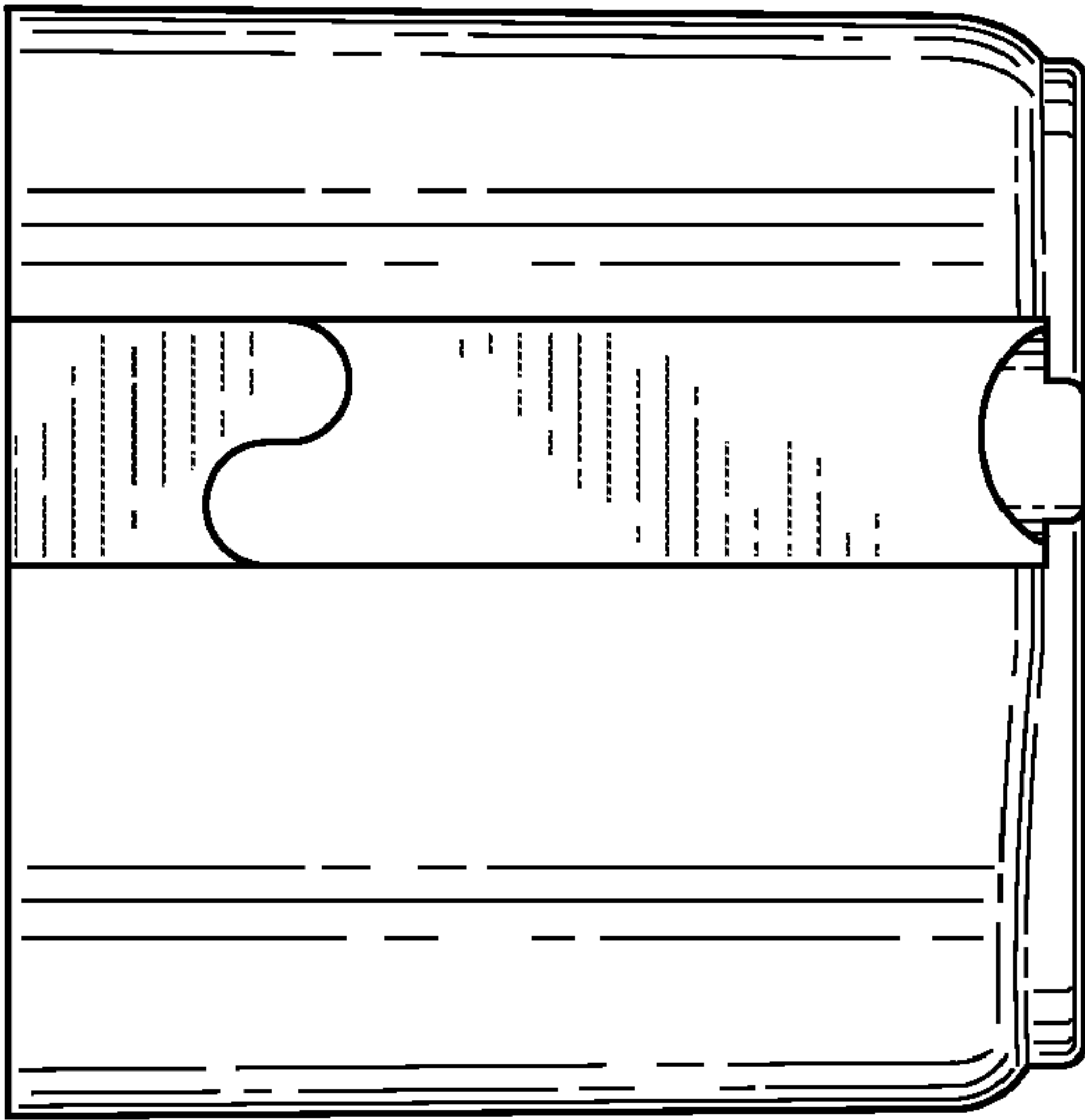

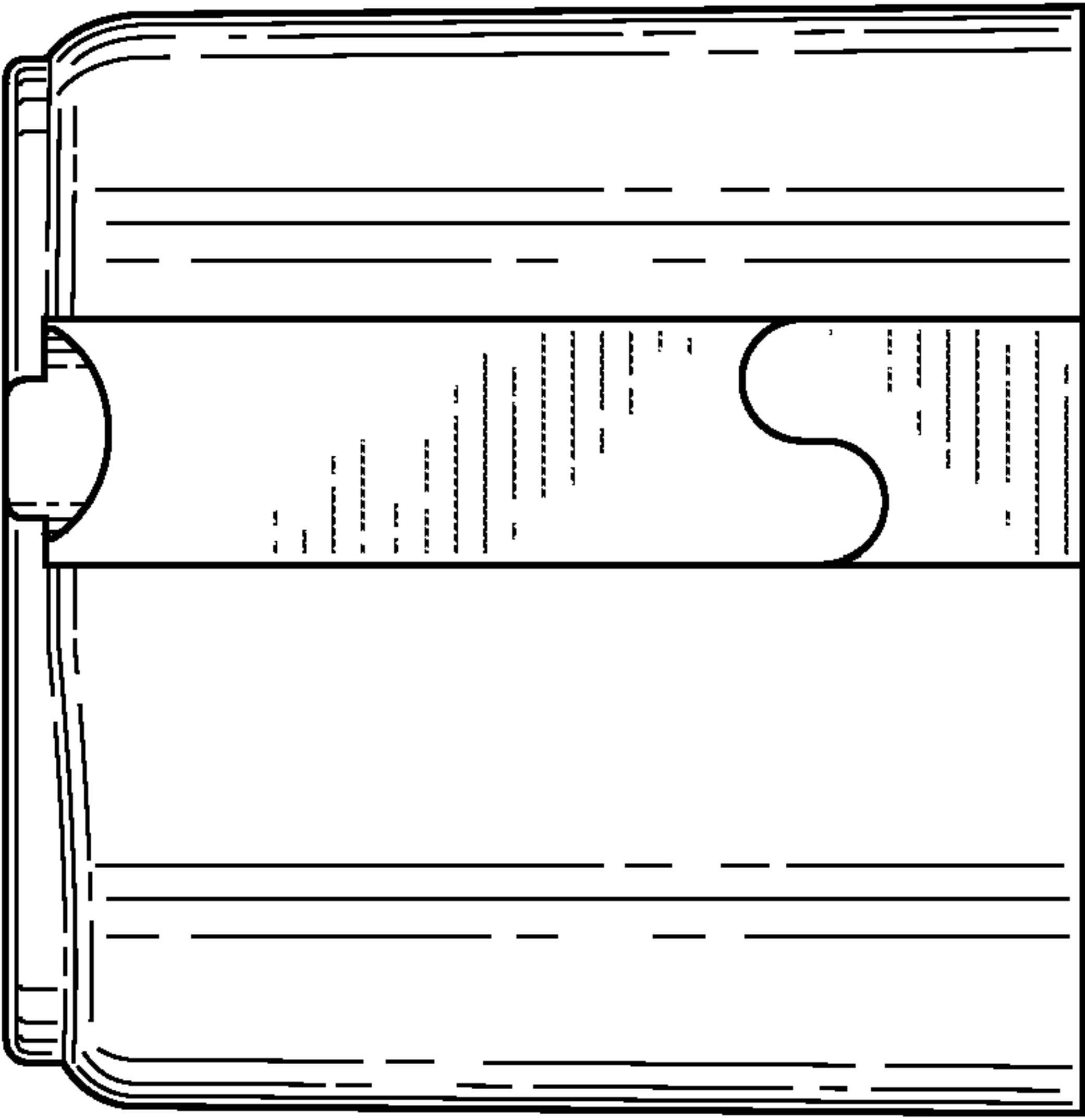

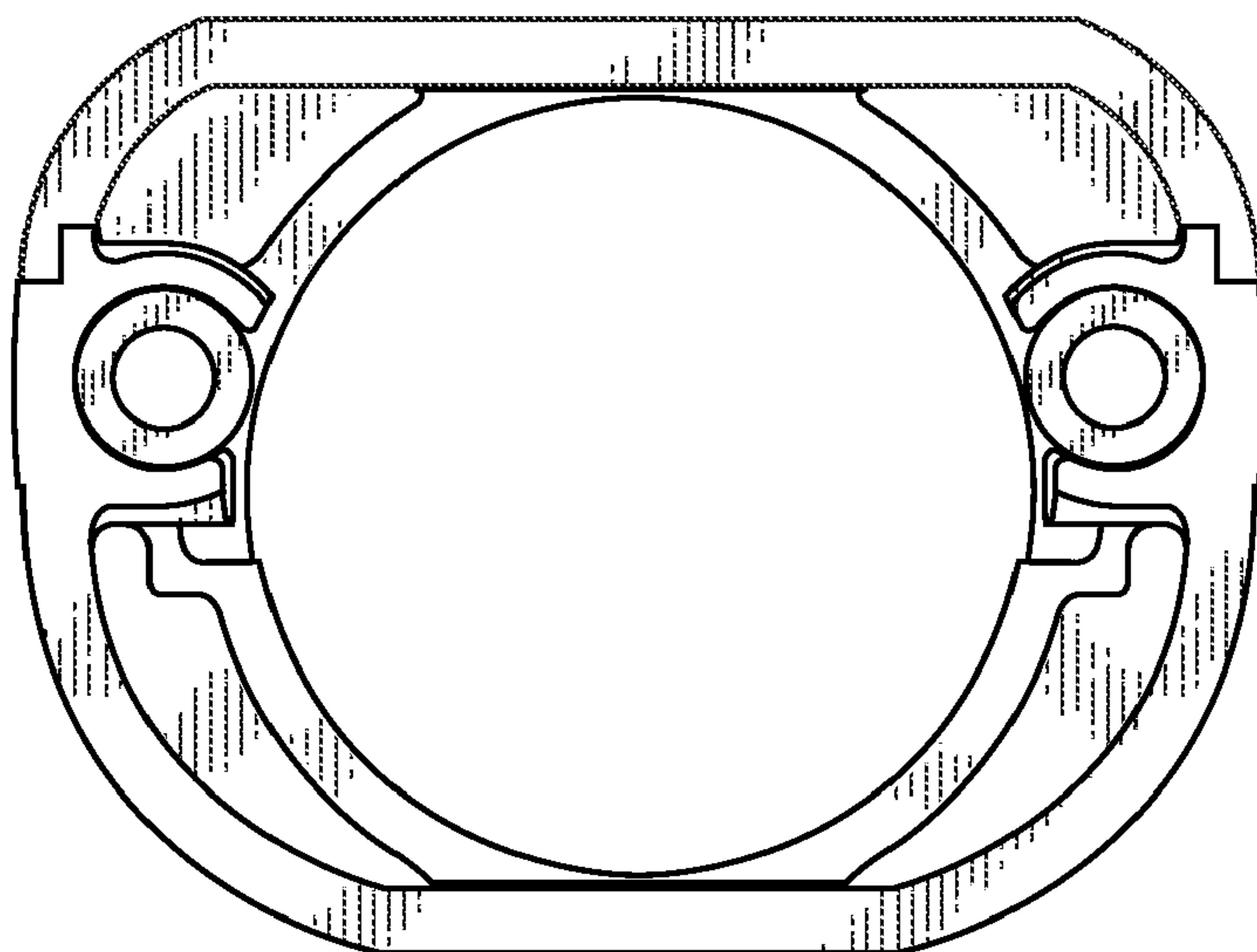

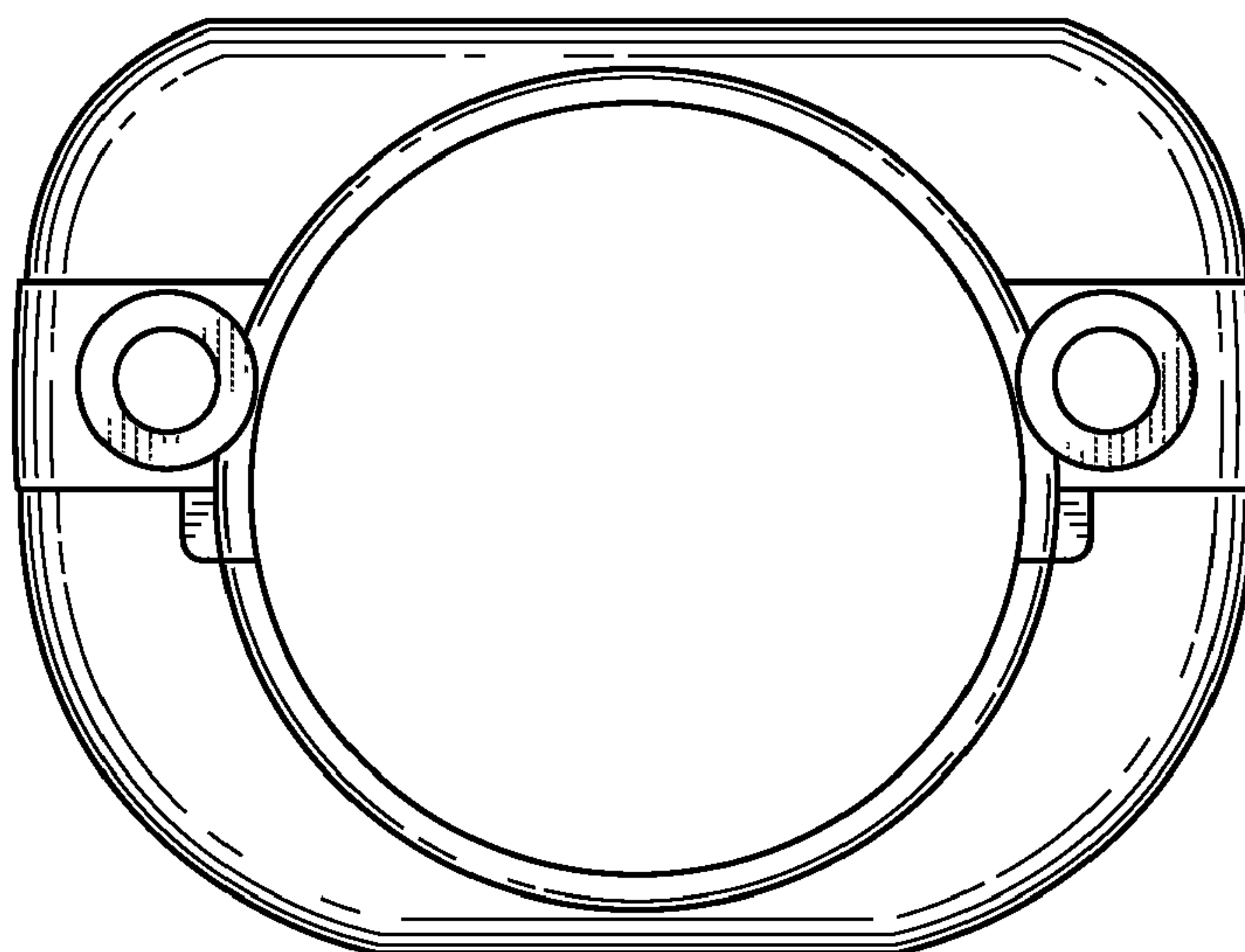

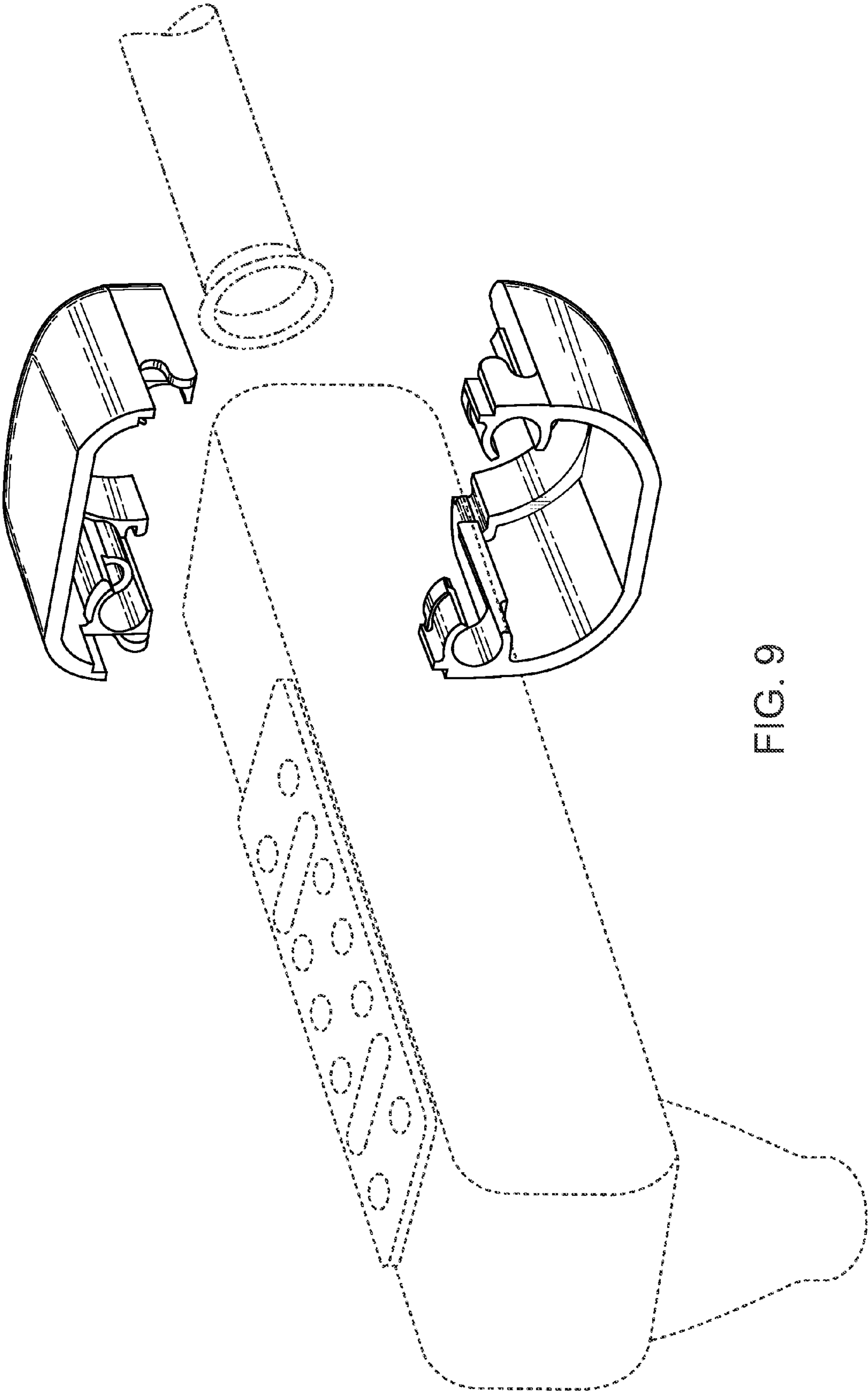

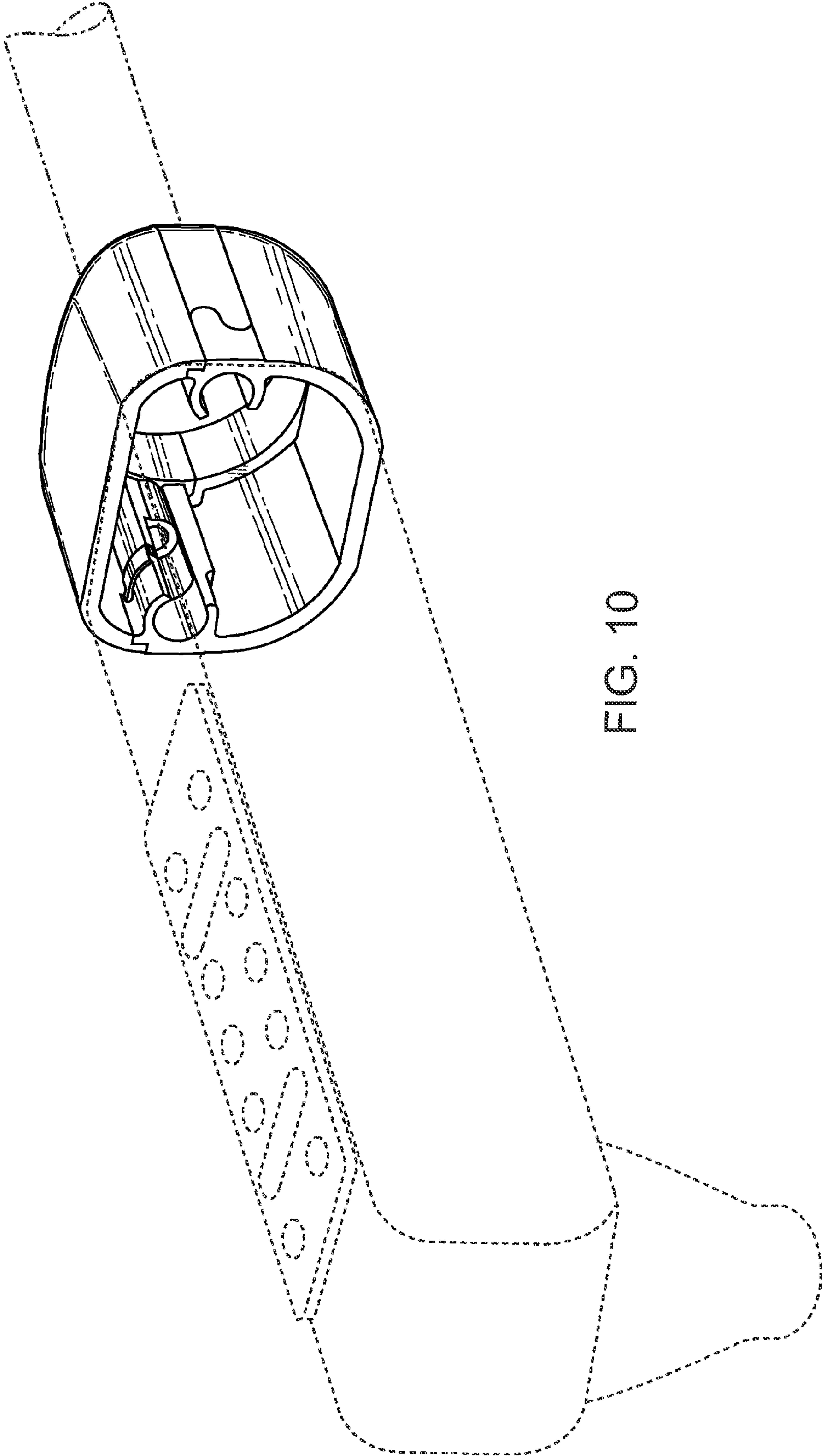
