(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a nose cover for eyeglasses, sunglasses, goggles, or like eyewear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a nose cover for eyeglasses, sunglasses, goggles, or like eyewear showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

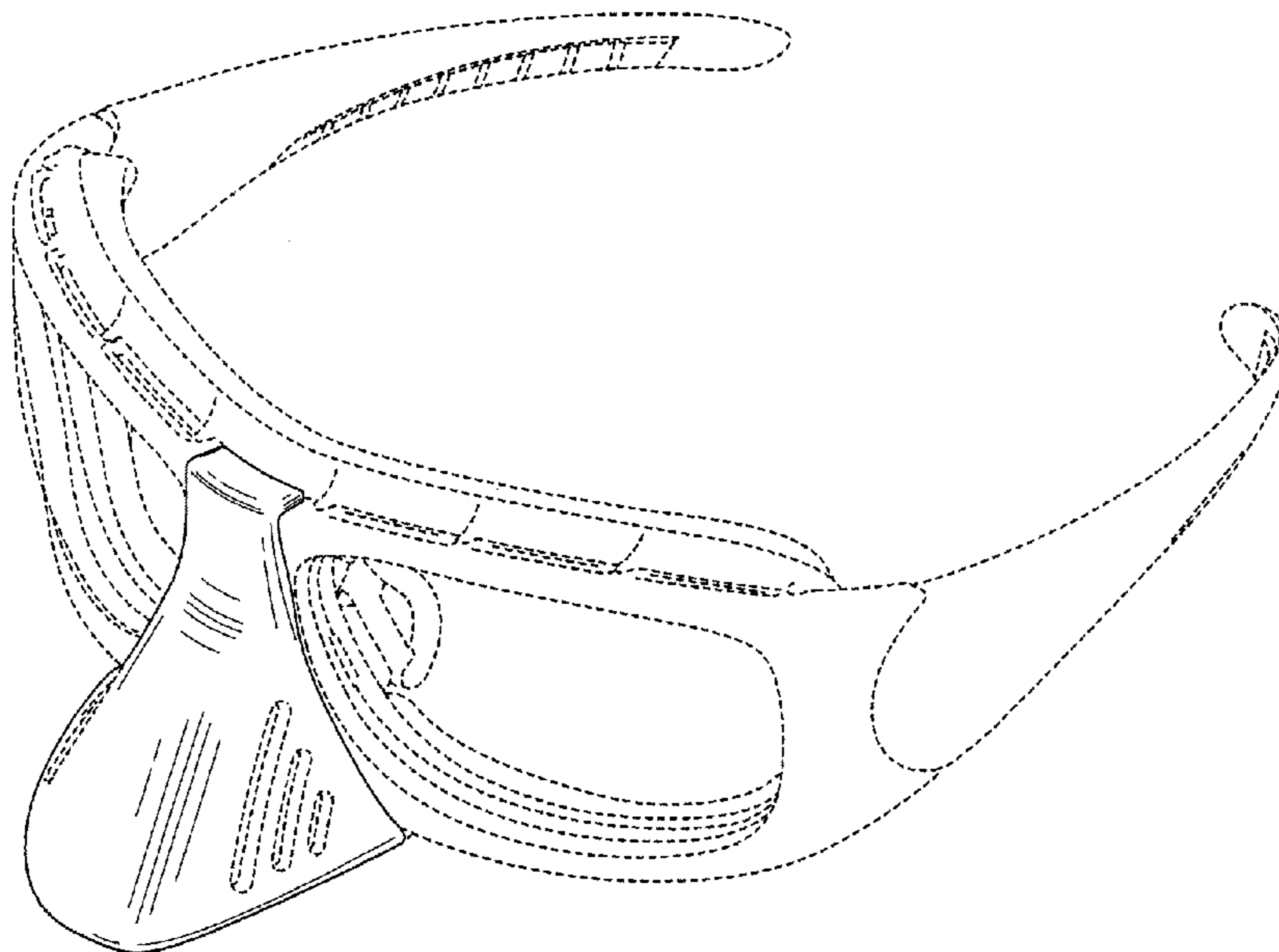
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

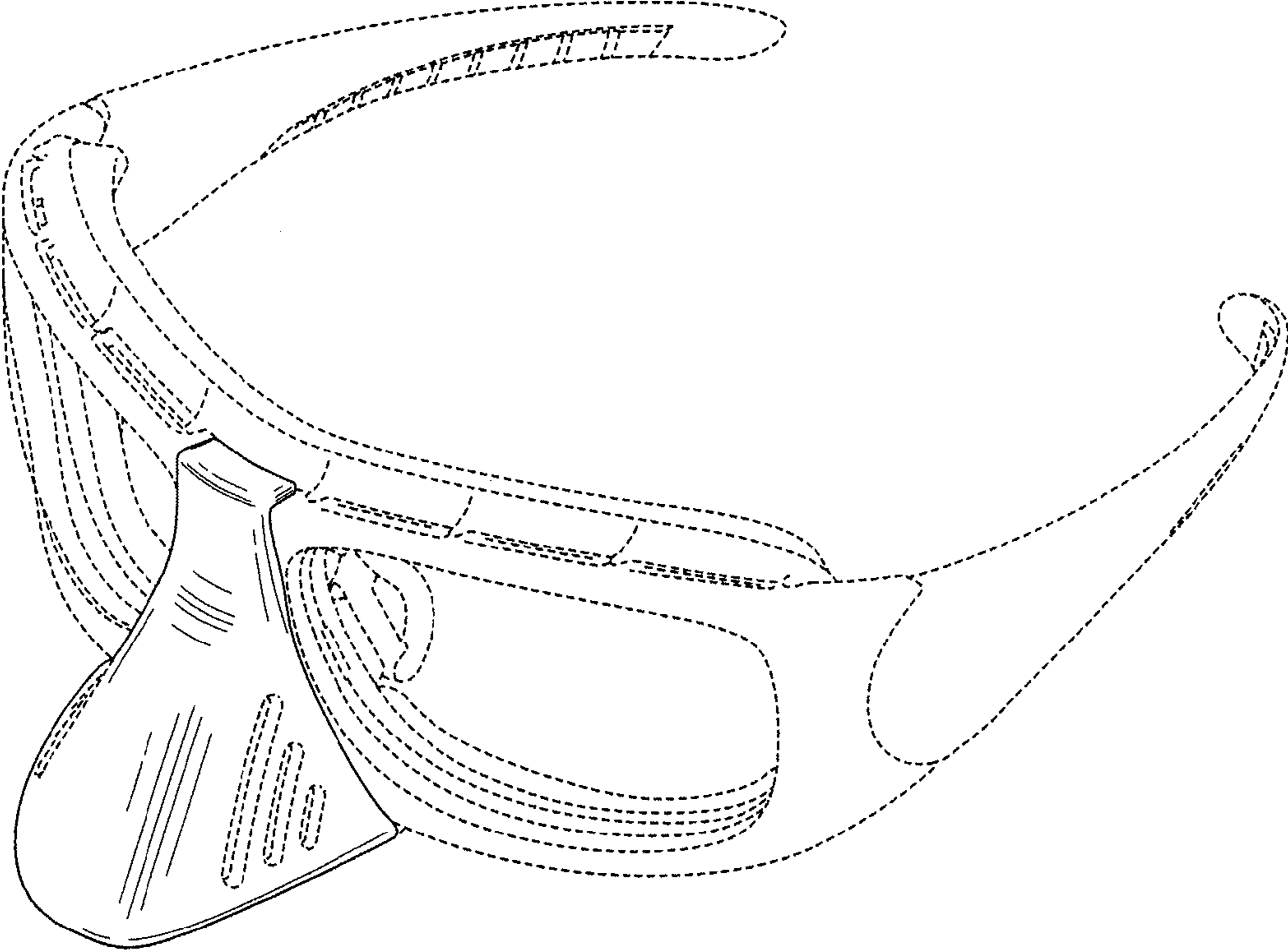

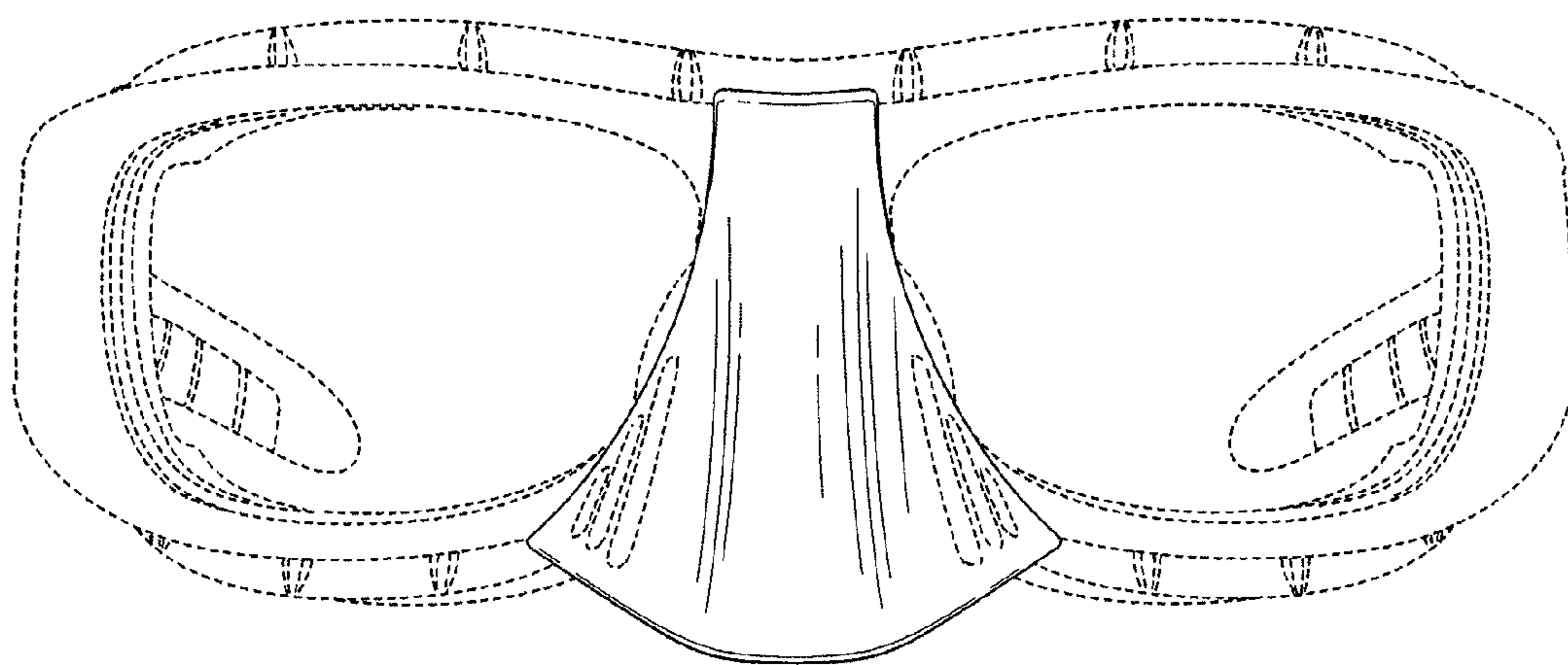

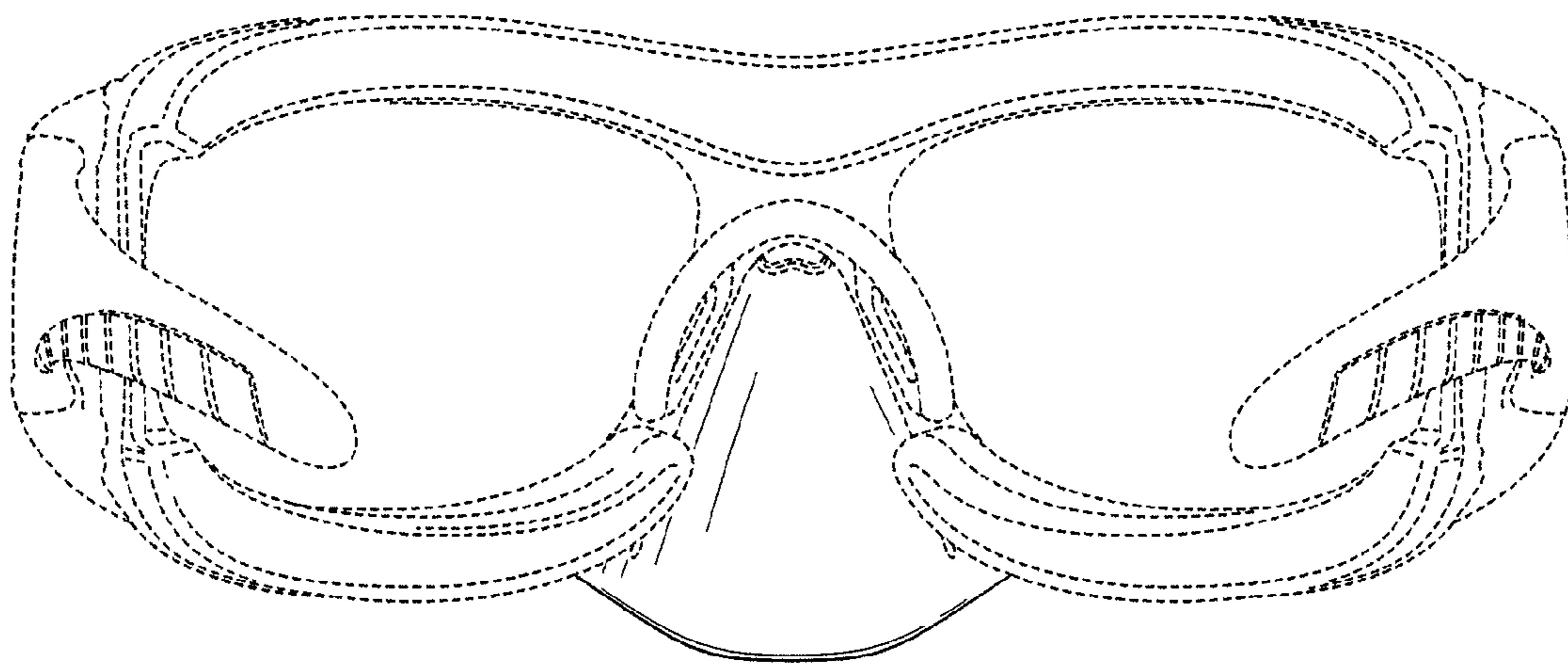

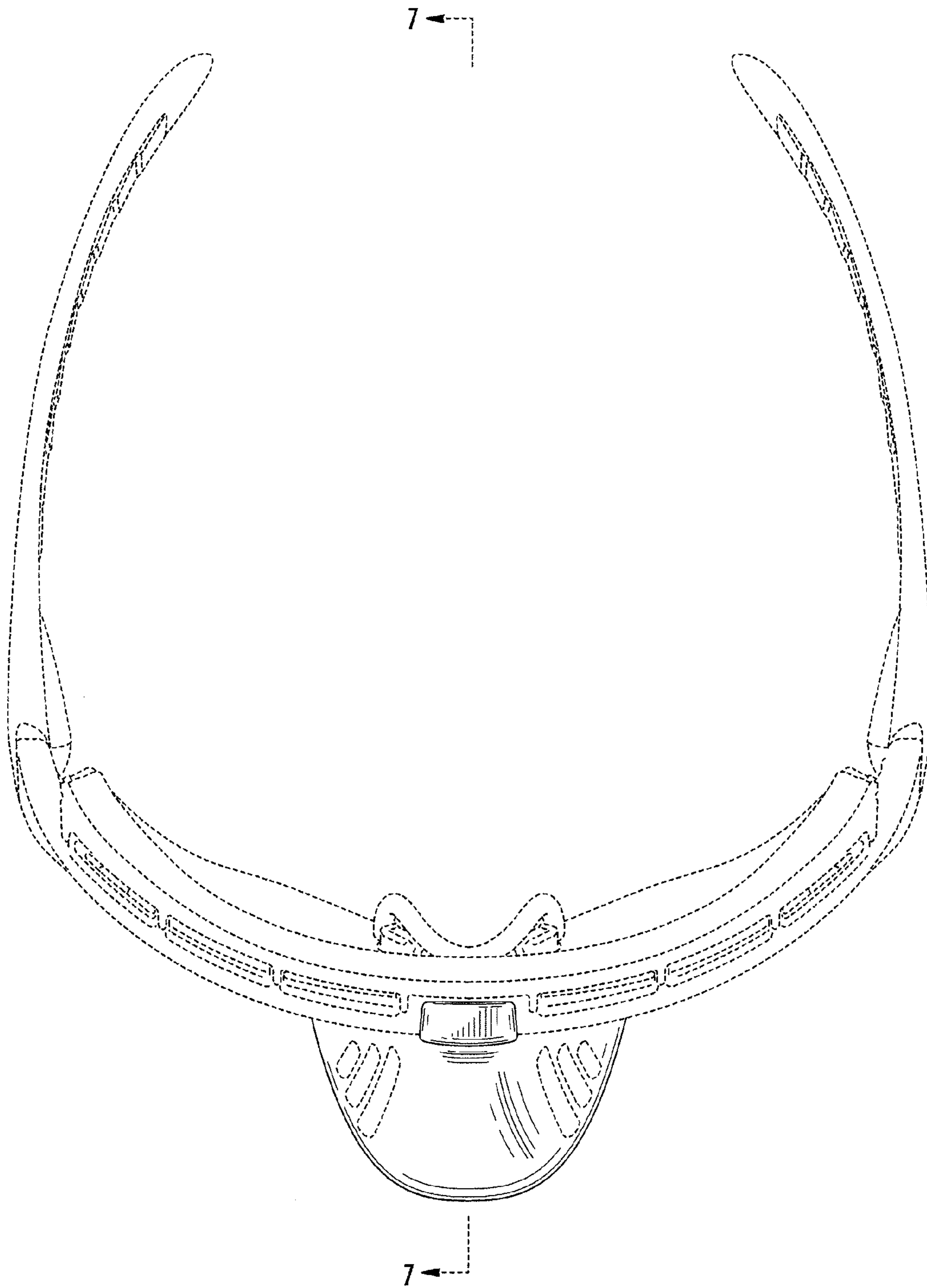

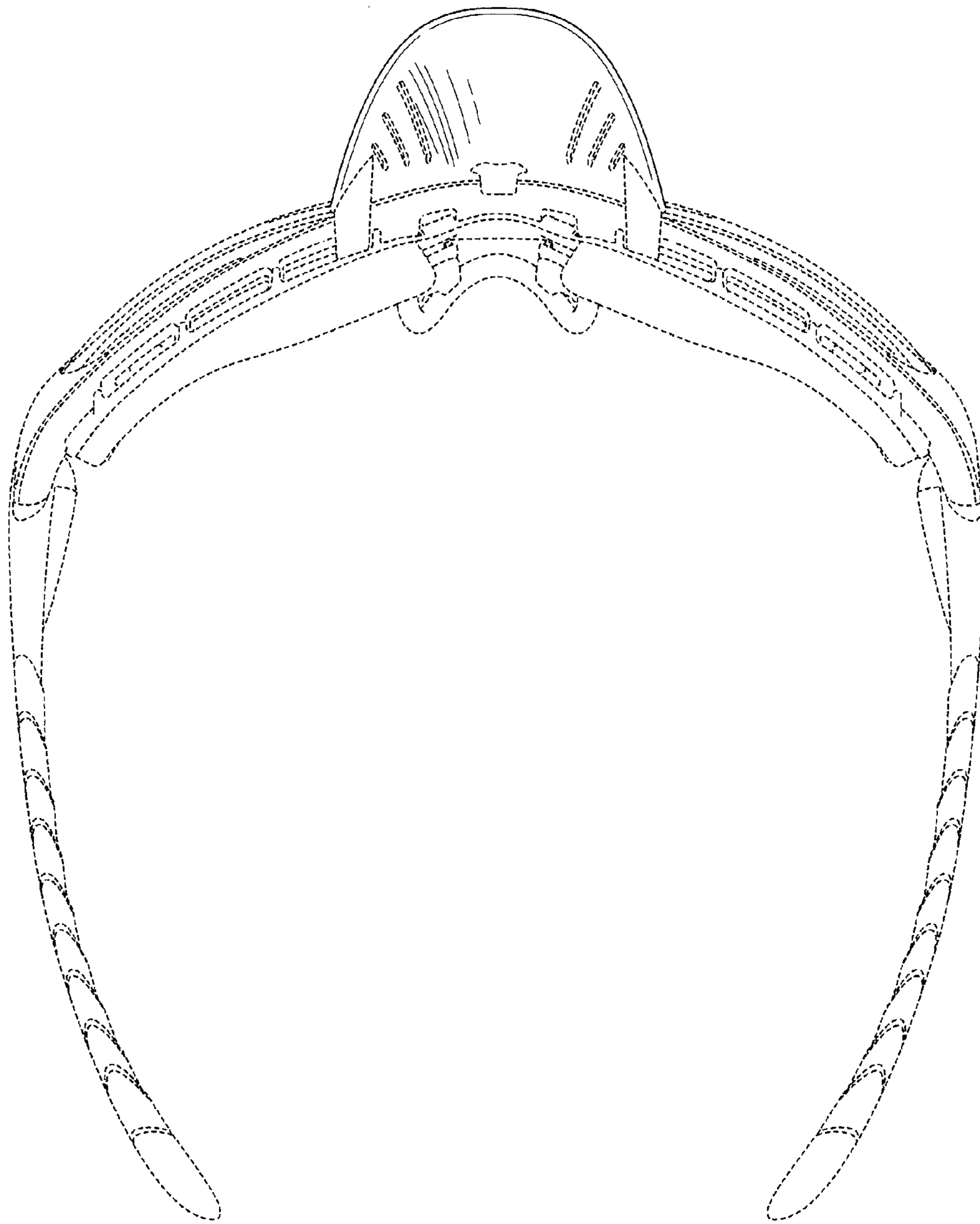

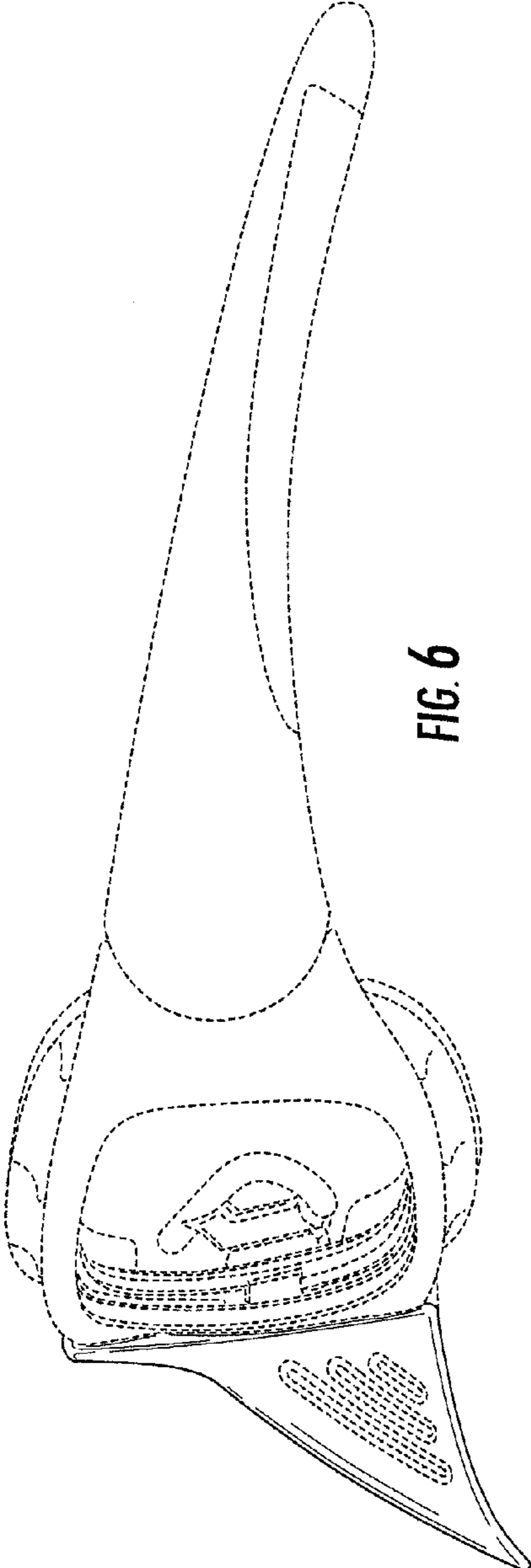

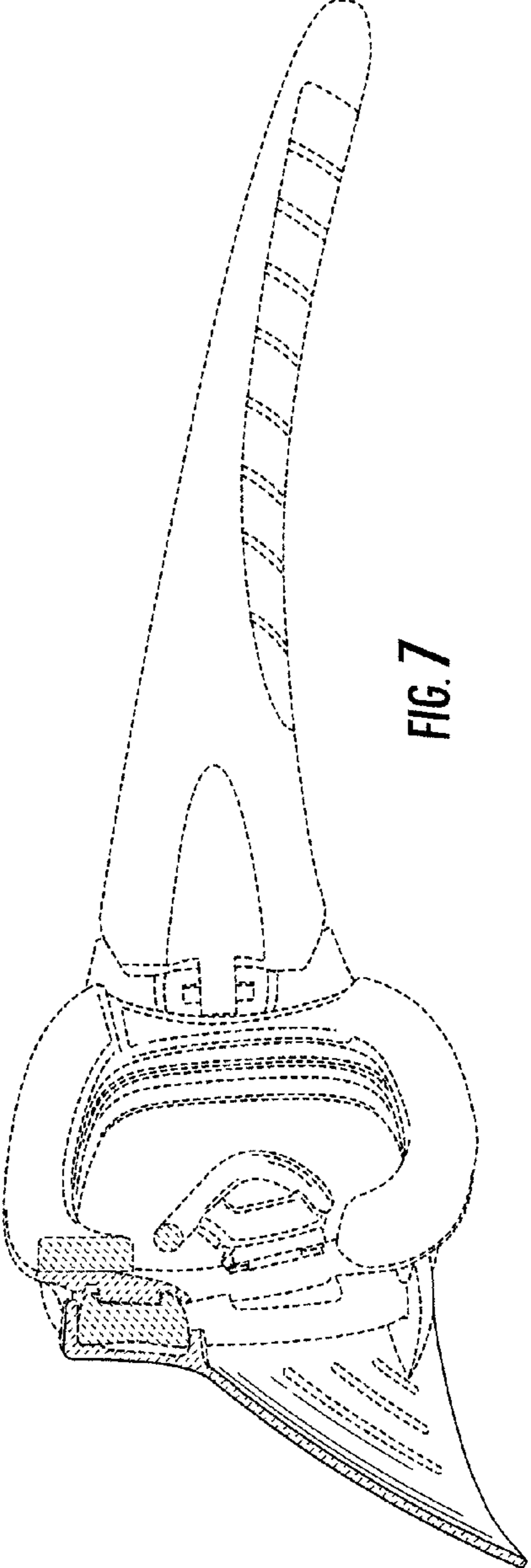
