(57) **CLAIM**

What is claimed is the ornamental design for a garment-attachable cape, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a garment-attachable cape, illustrated in a worn configuration, showing the new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, illustrated in a flat configuration;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

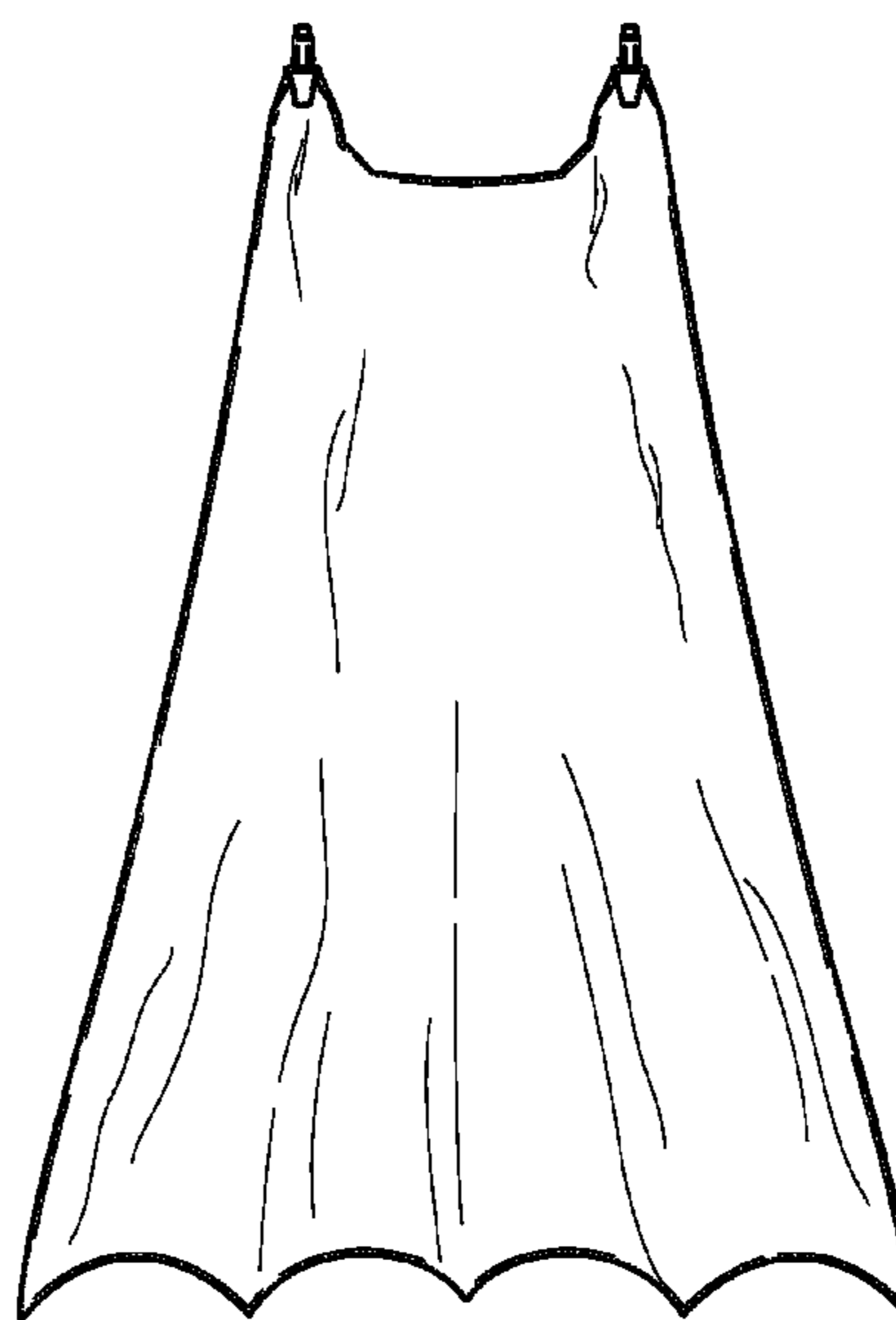
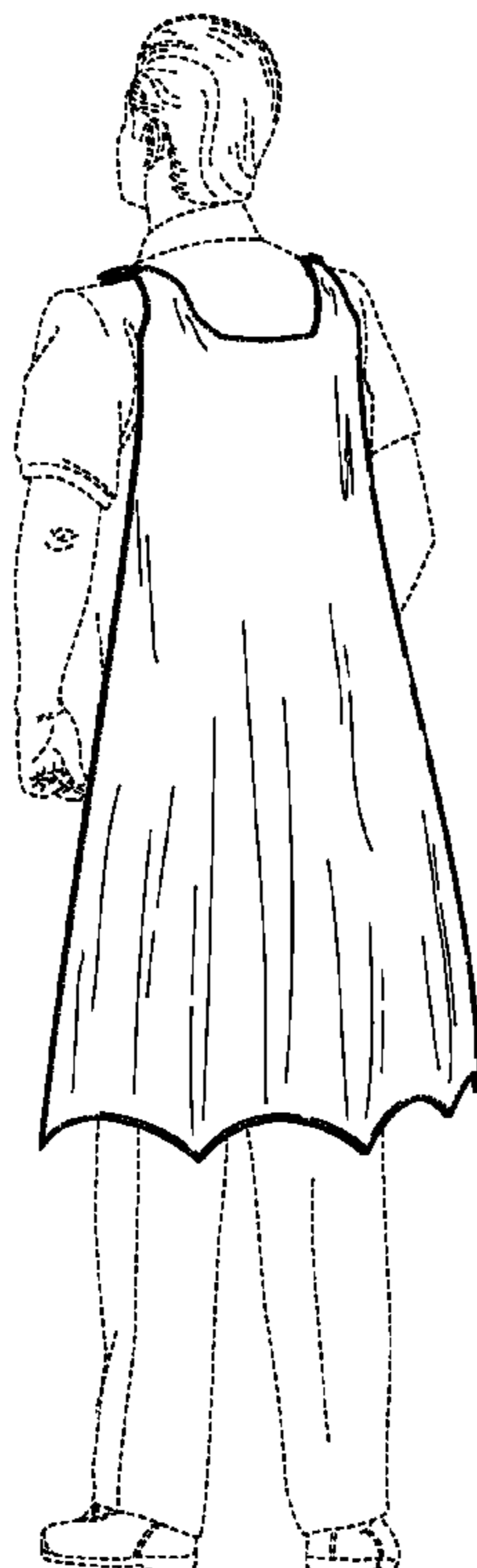
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

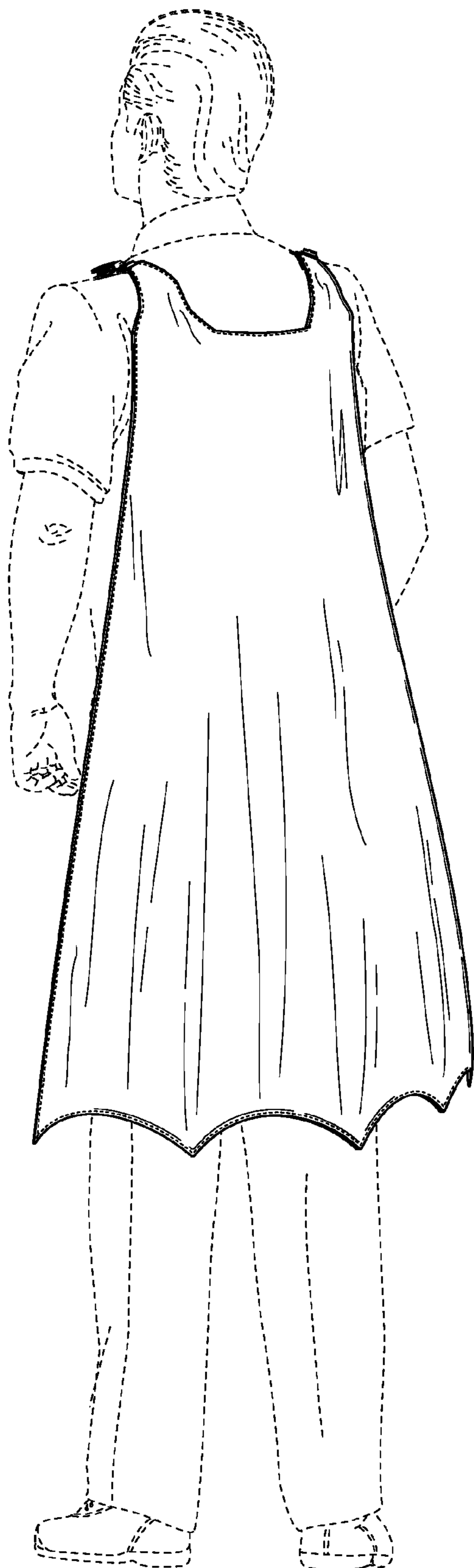

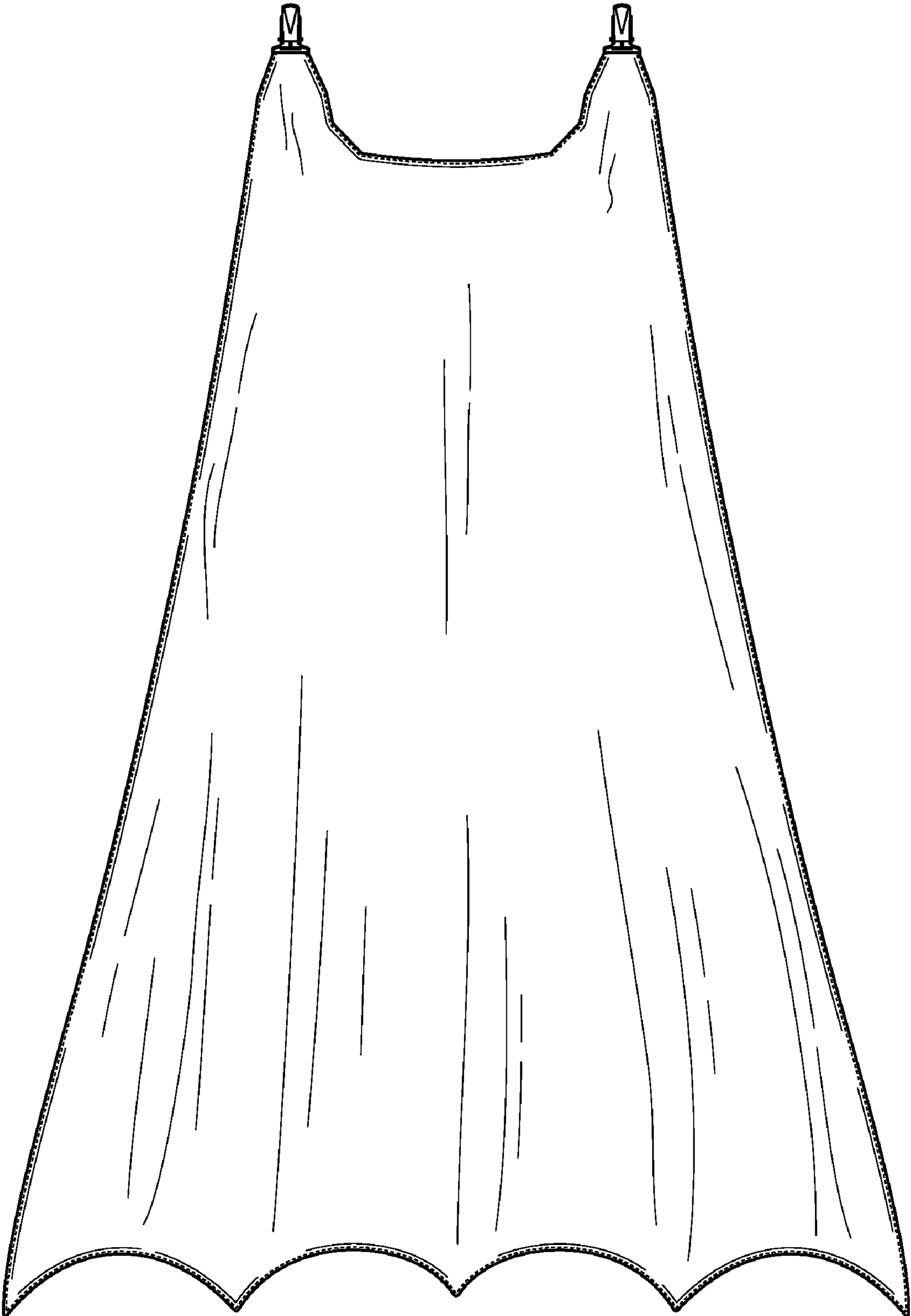

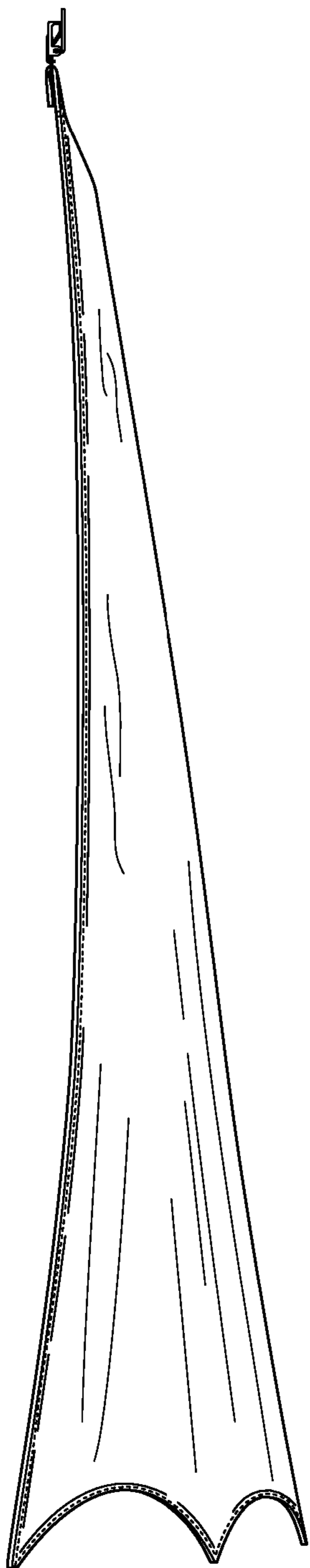

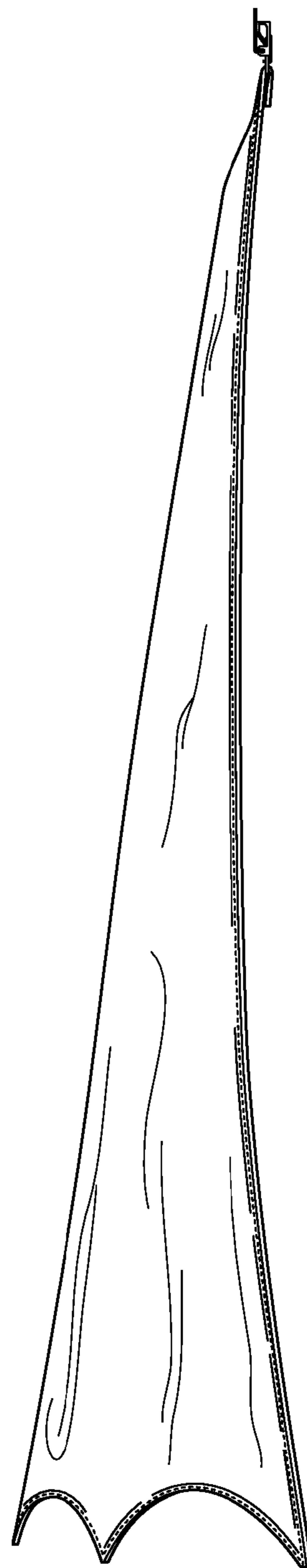

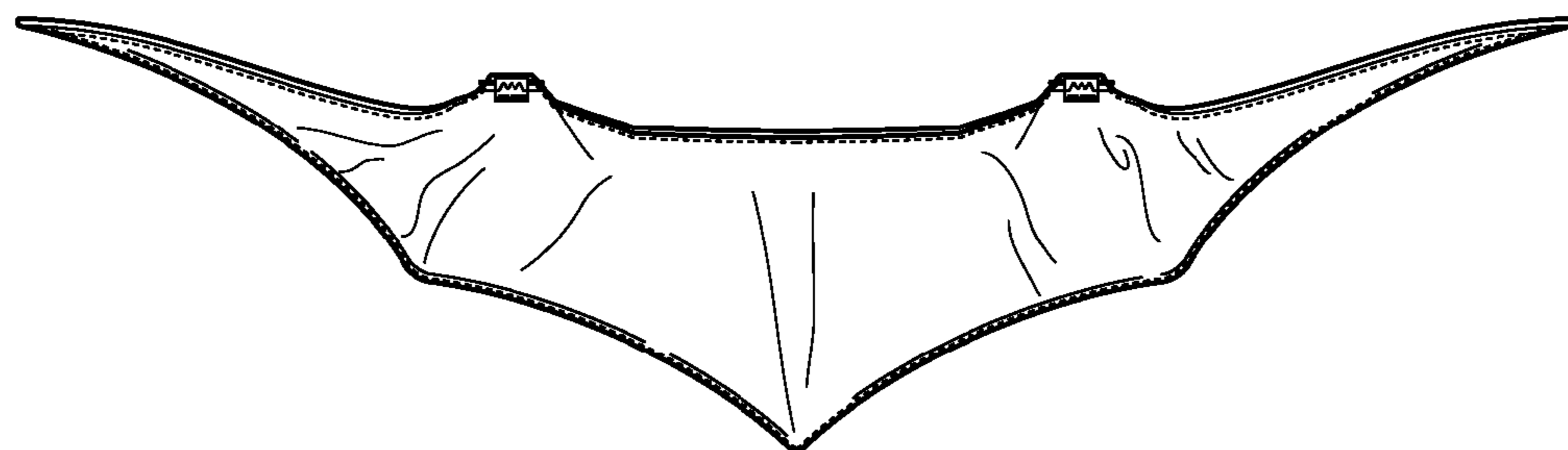

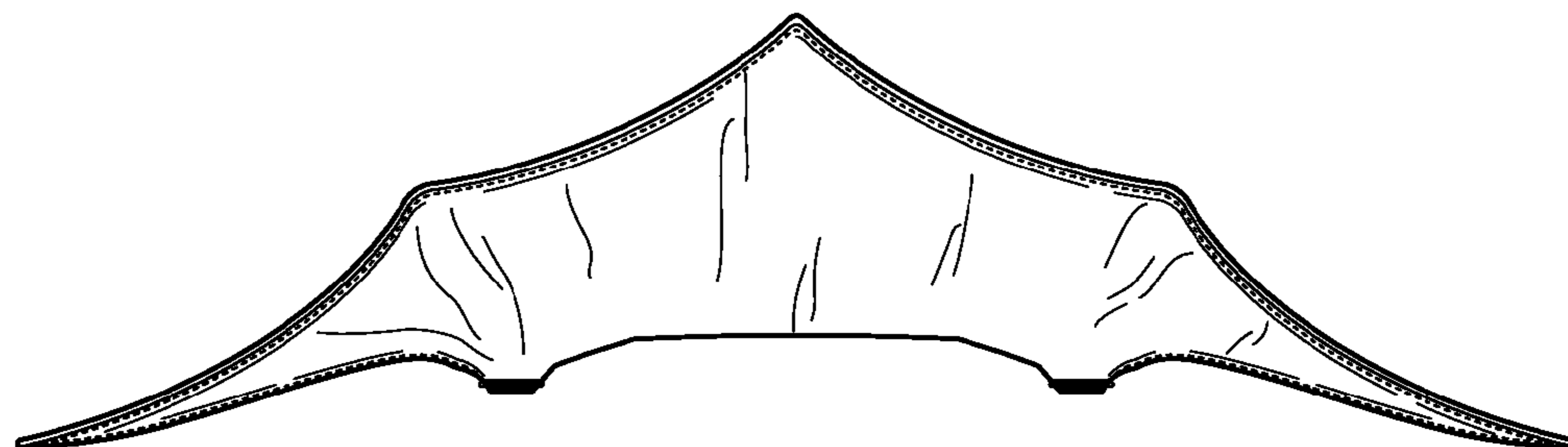
