FIG. 4 is a left-side view of my design shown in FIG. 1;

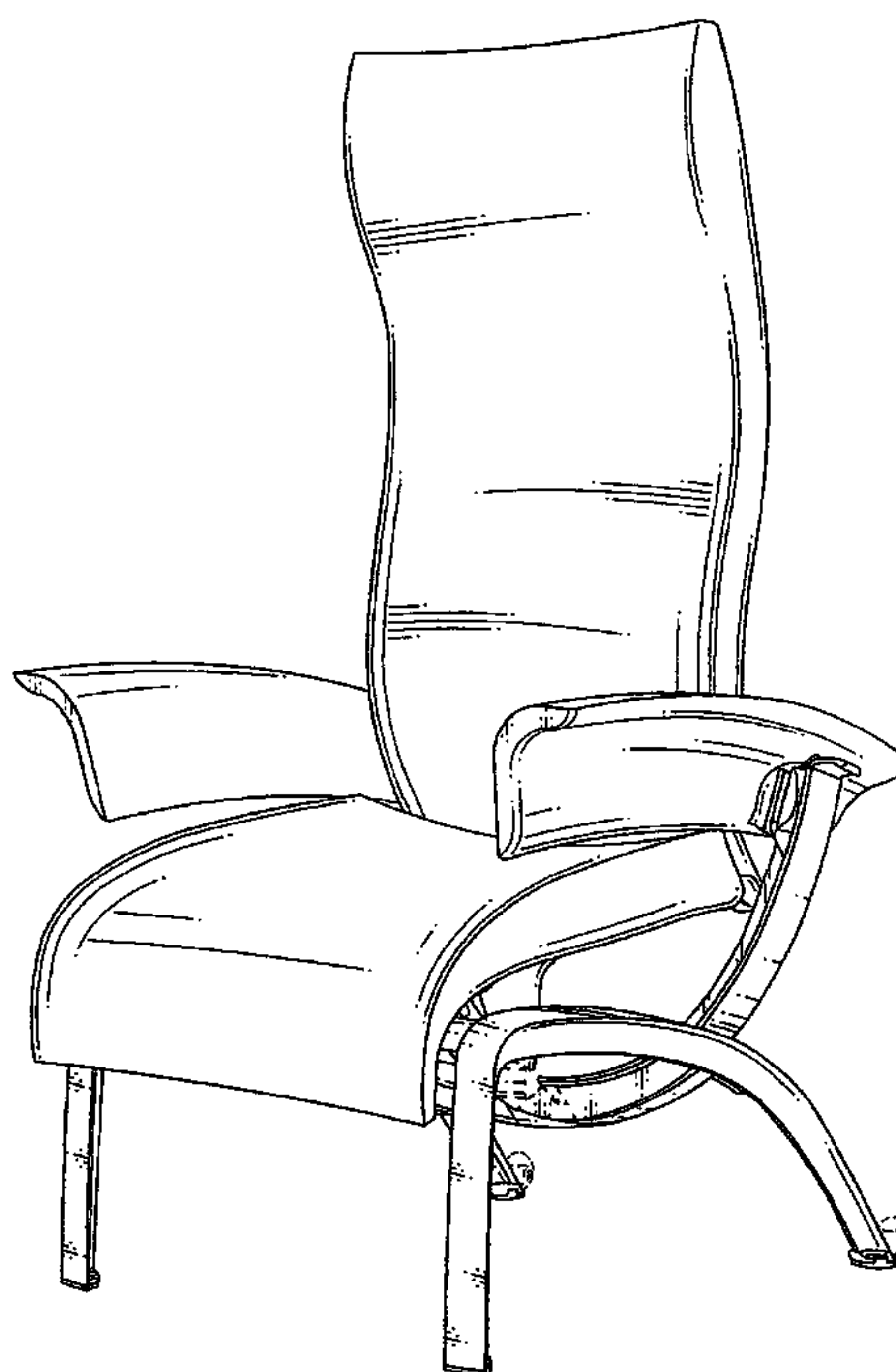
FIG. 5 is a right-side view of my design shown in FIG. 1;

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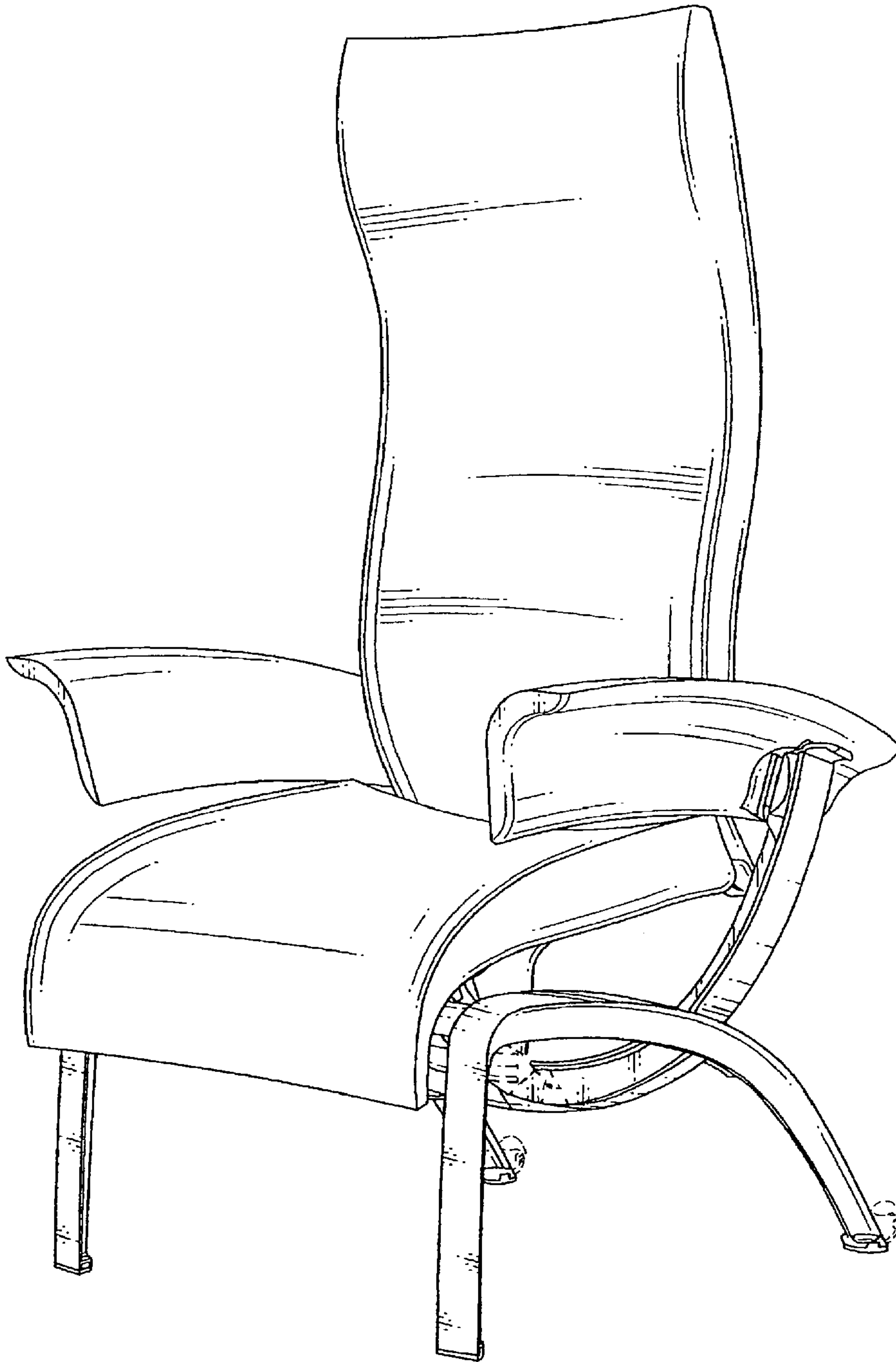

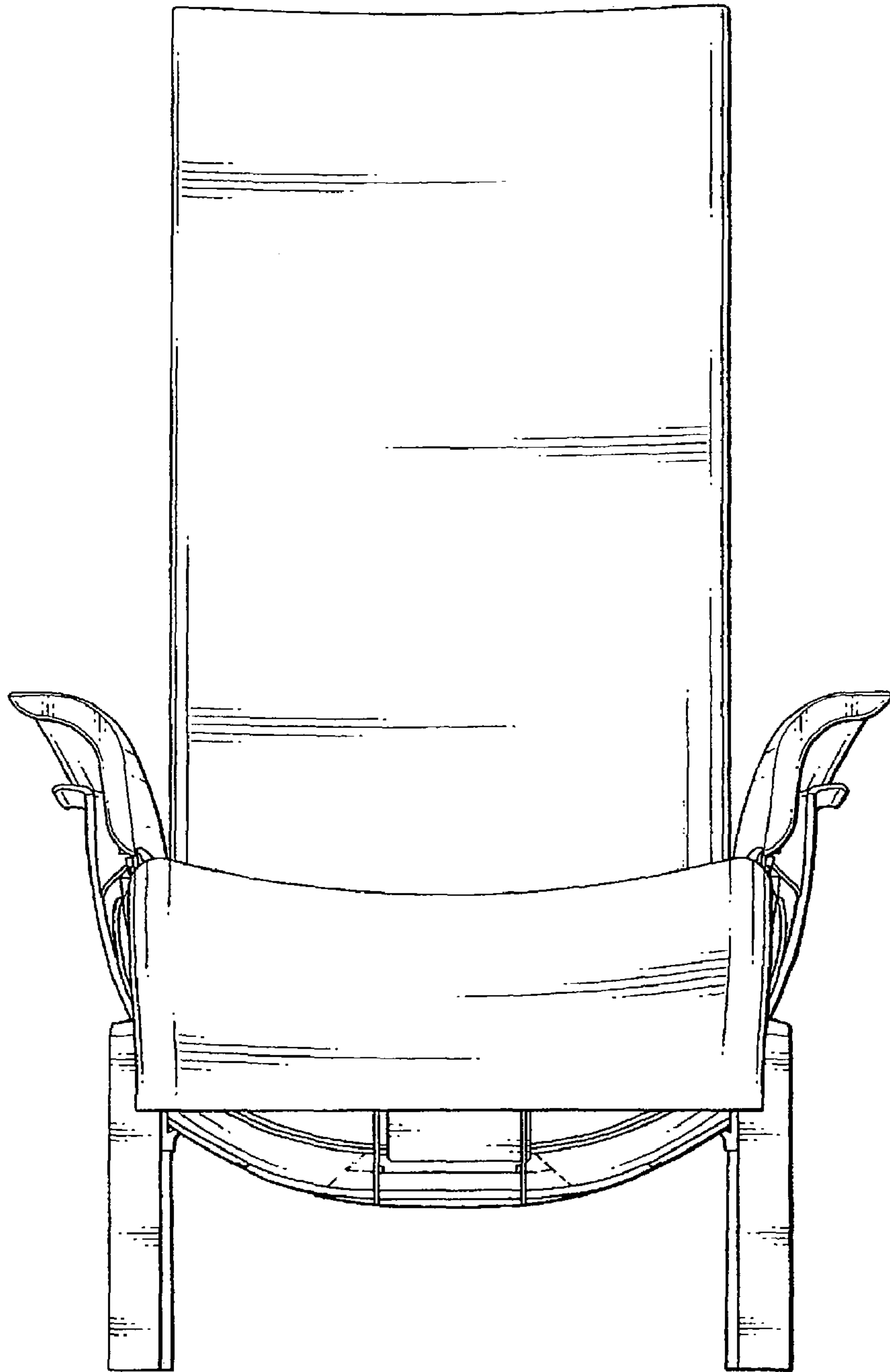

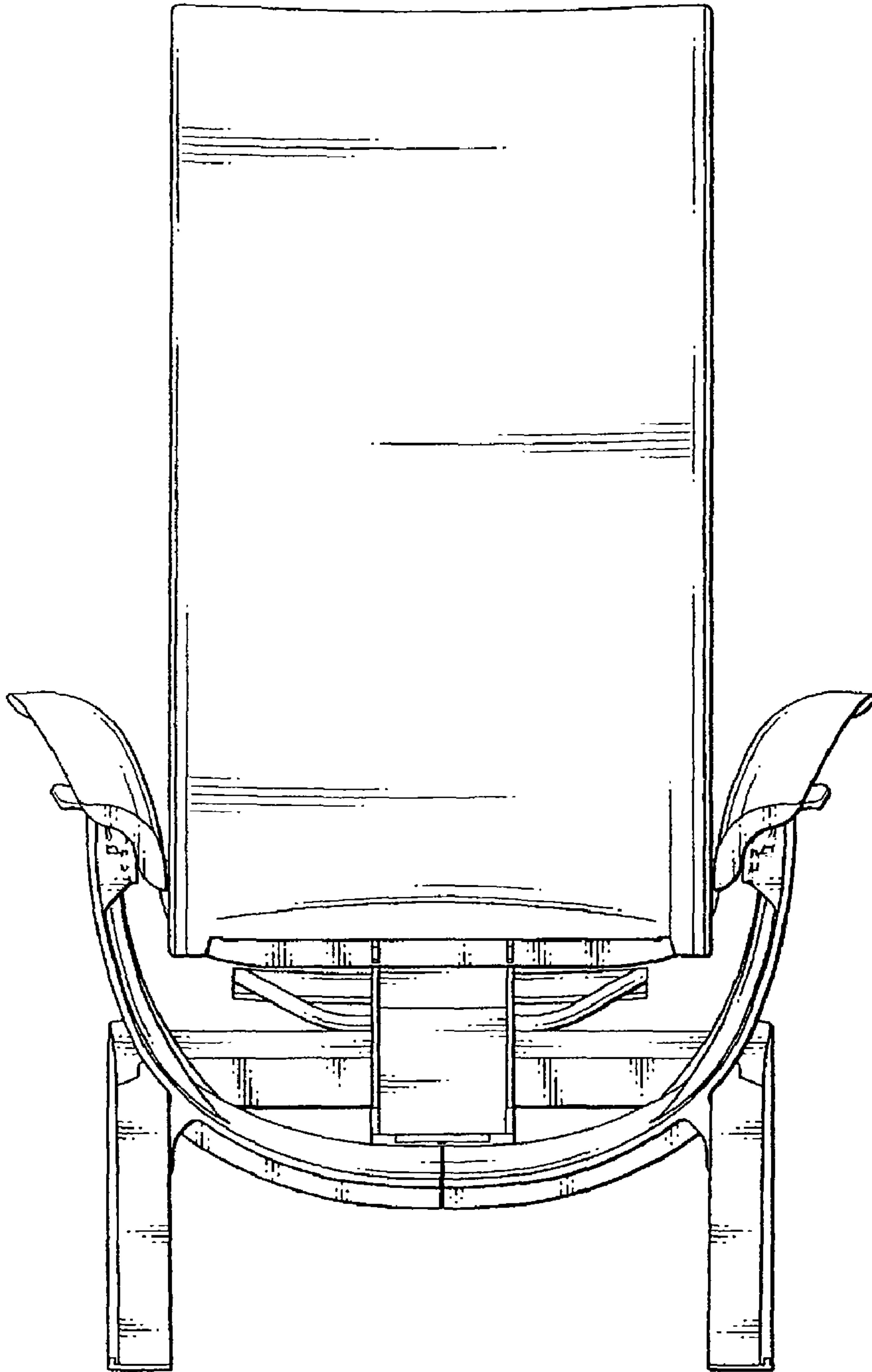

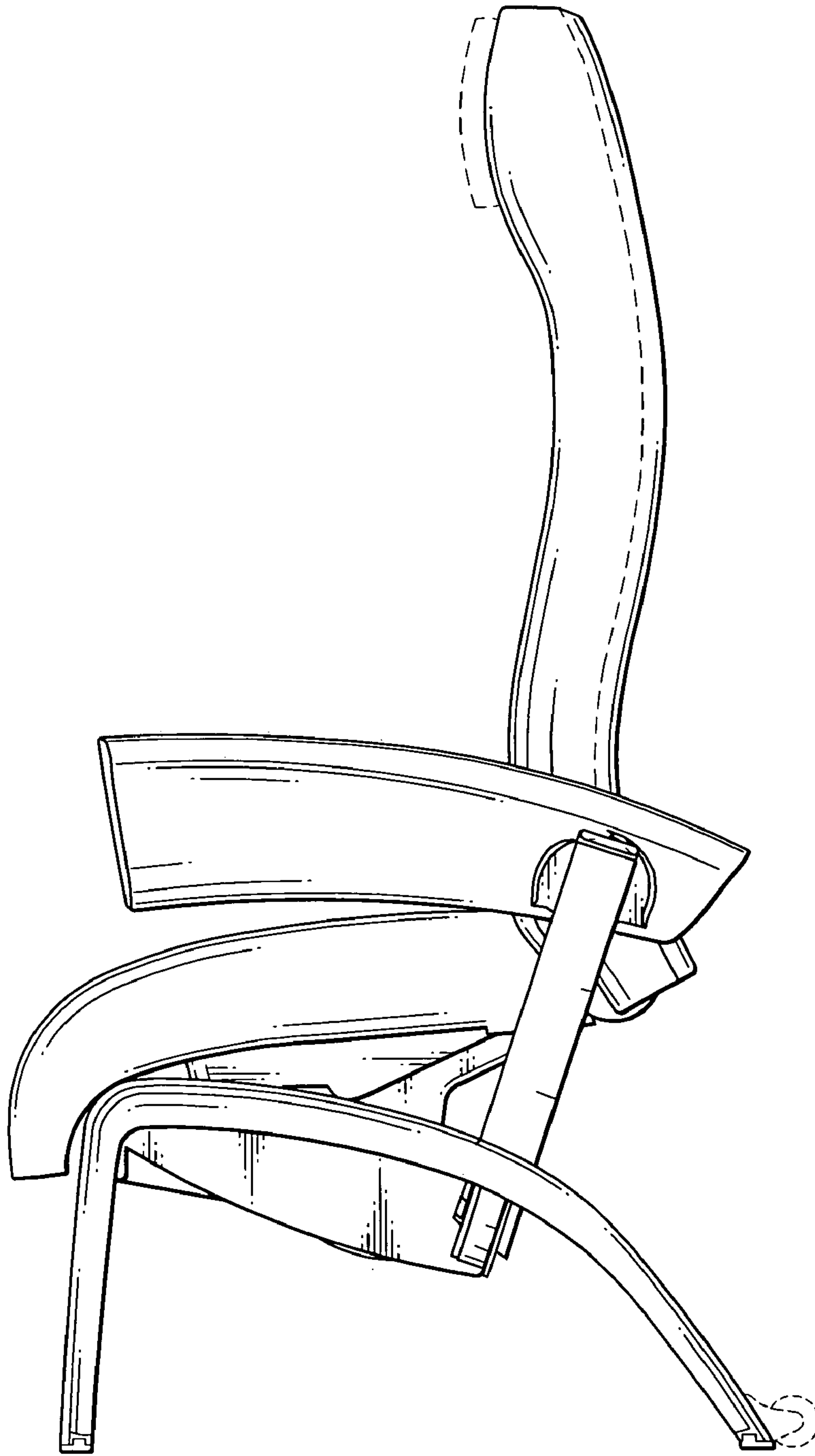

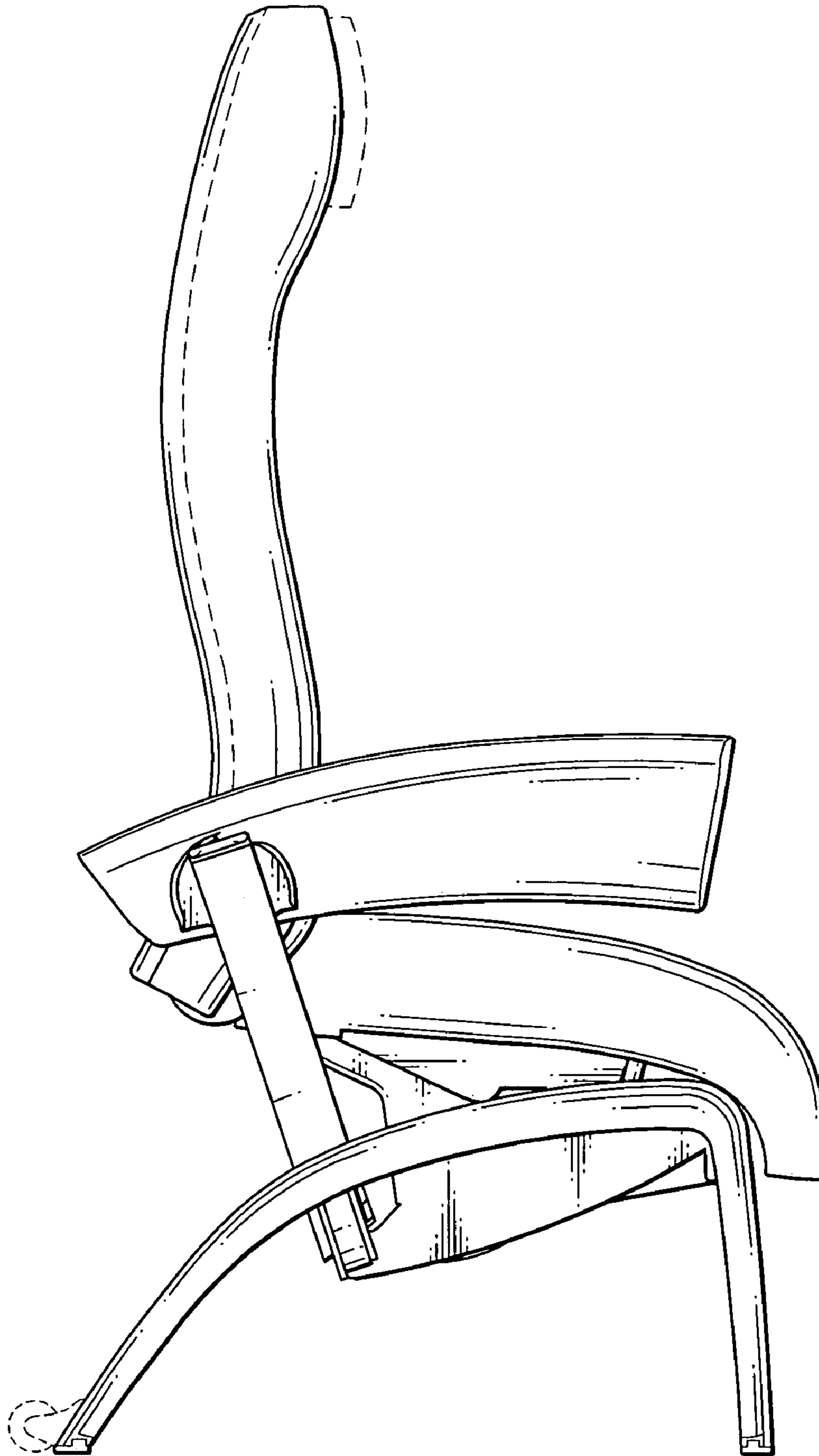

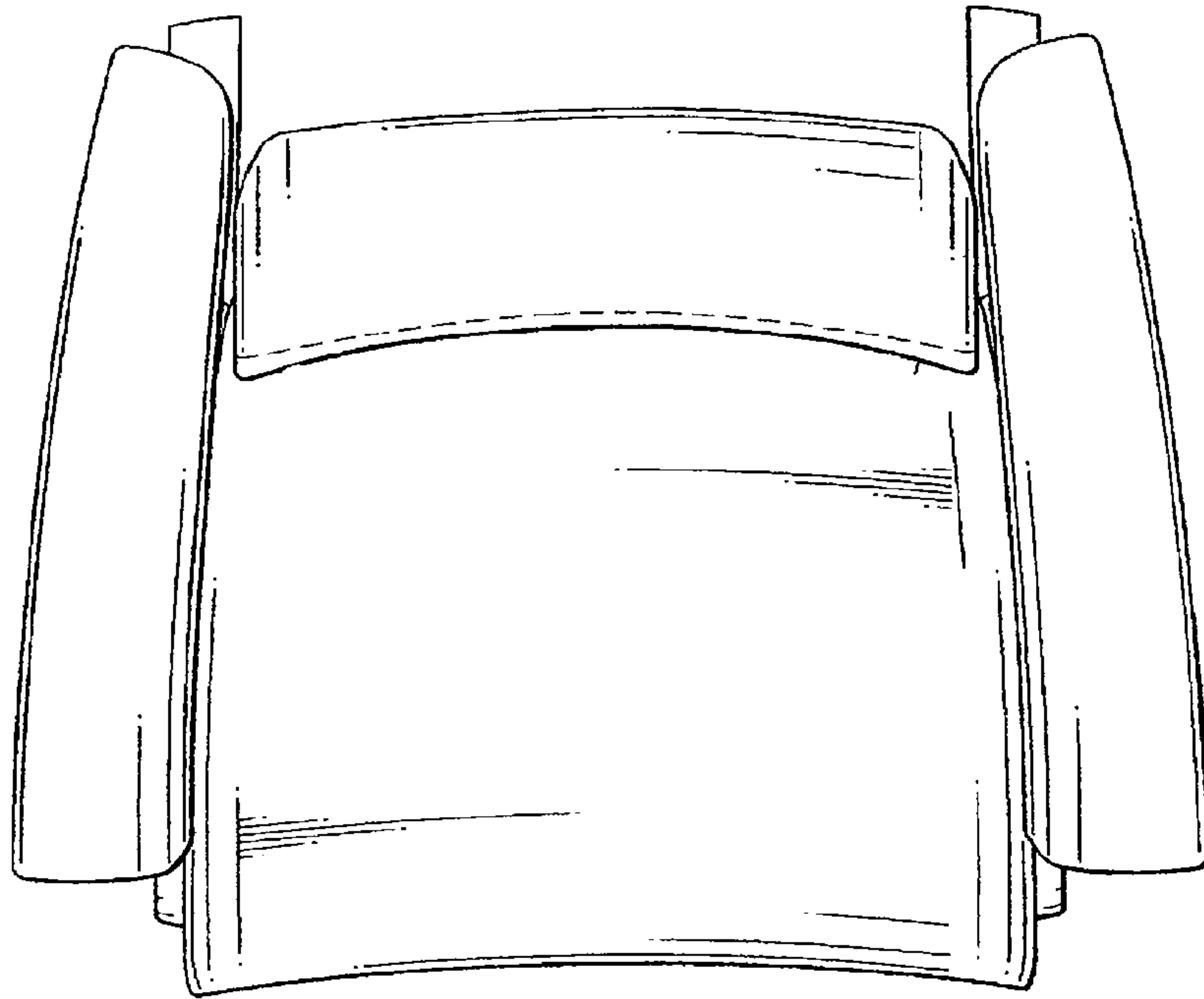

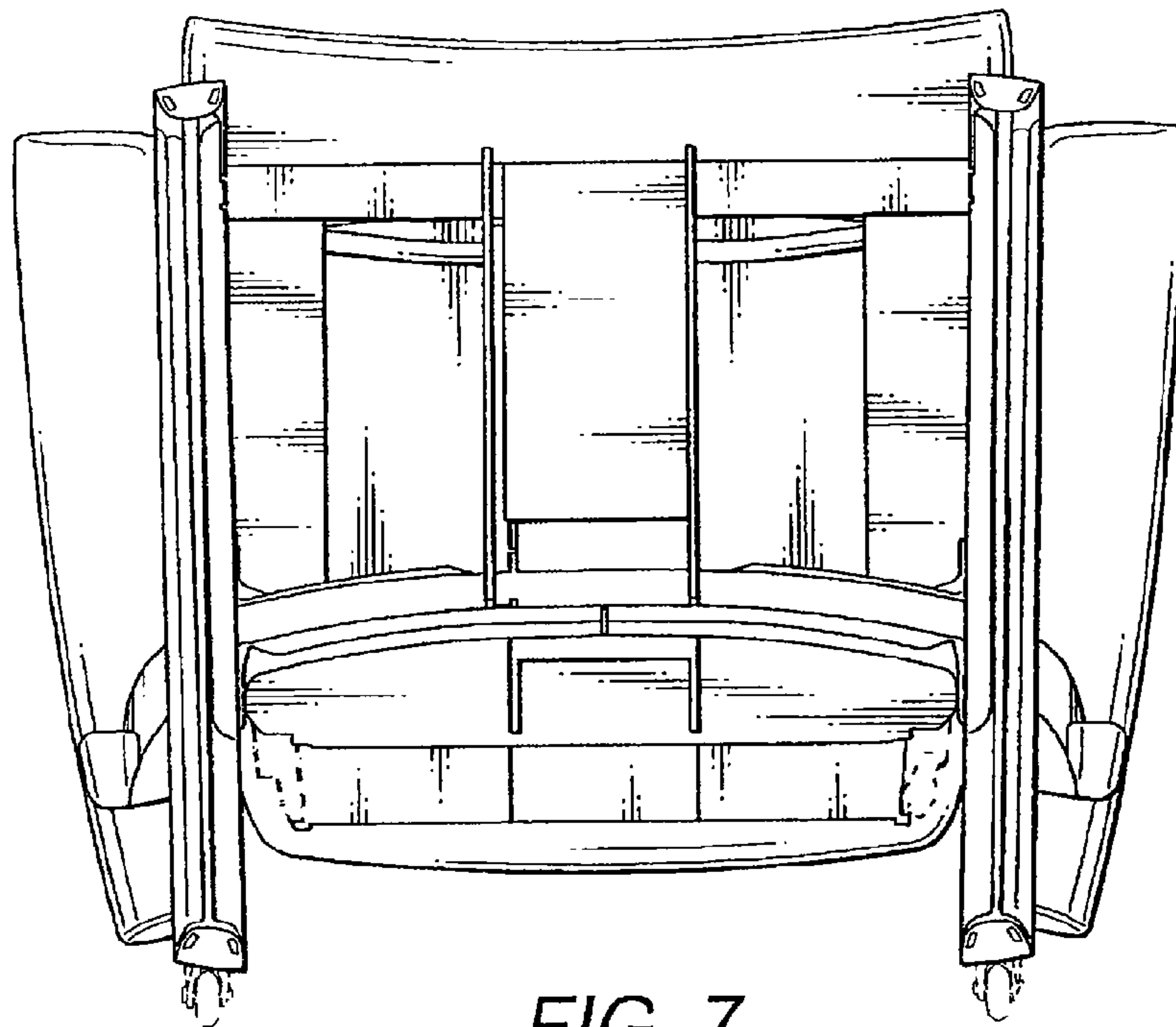
