(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a meat manipulation tool with a transparent grip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right, side-view of a meat manipulation tool with a transparent grip, illustrating a LOGO as visible through the transparent grip;

FIG. 2 is a left, side-view of a meat manipulation tool with a transparent grip, illustrating a LOGO as visible through the transparent grip;

FIG. 3 is a top, isometric view of a meat manipulation tool with a transparent grip, illustrating a LOGO as visible through the transparent grip;

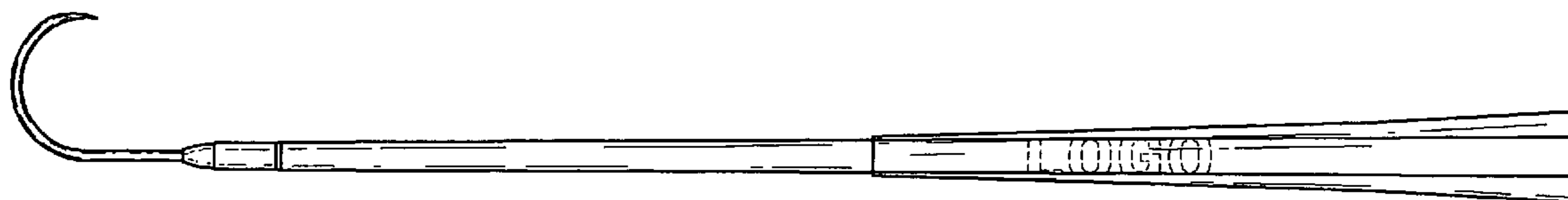
FIG. 4 is a bottom, isometric view of a meat manipulation tool with a transparent grip, illustrating a LOGO as visible through the transparent grip;

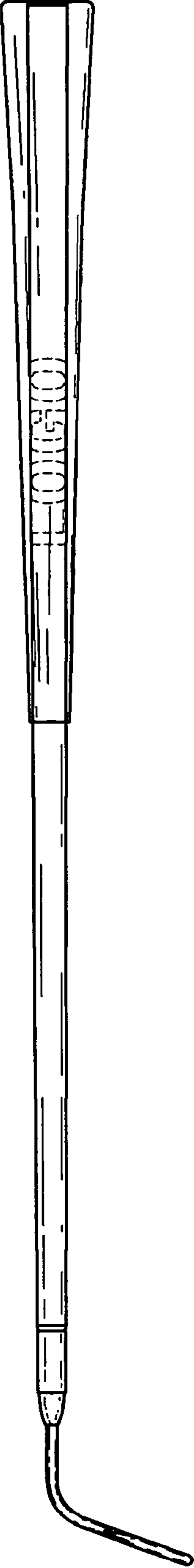

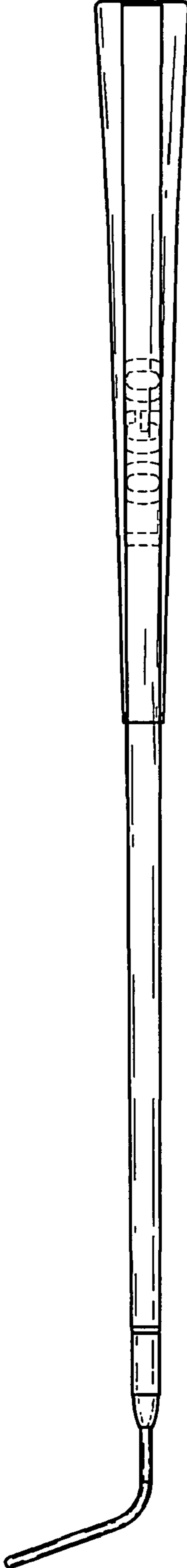

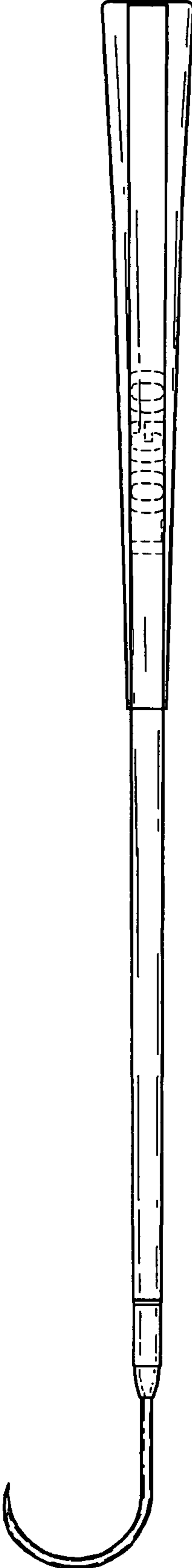

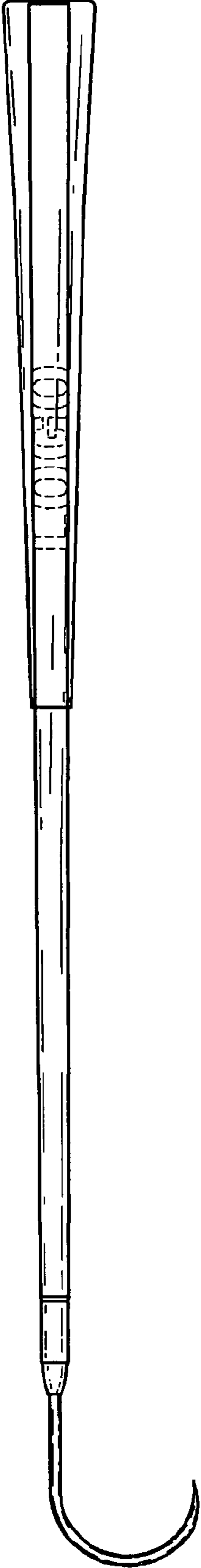

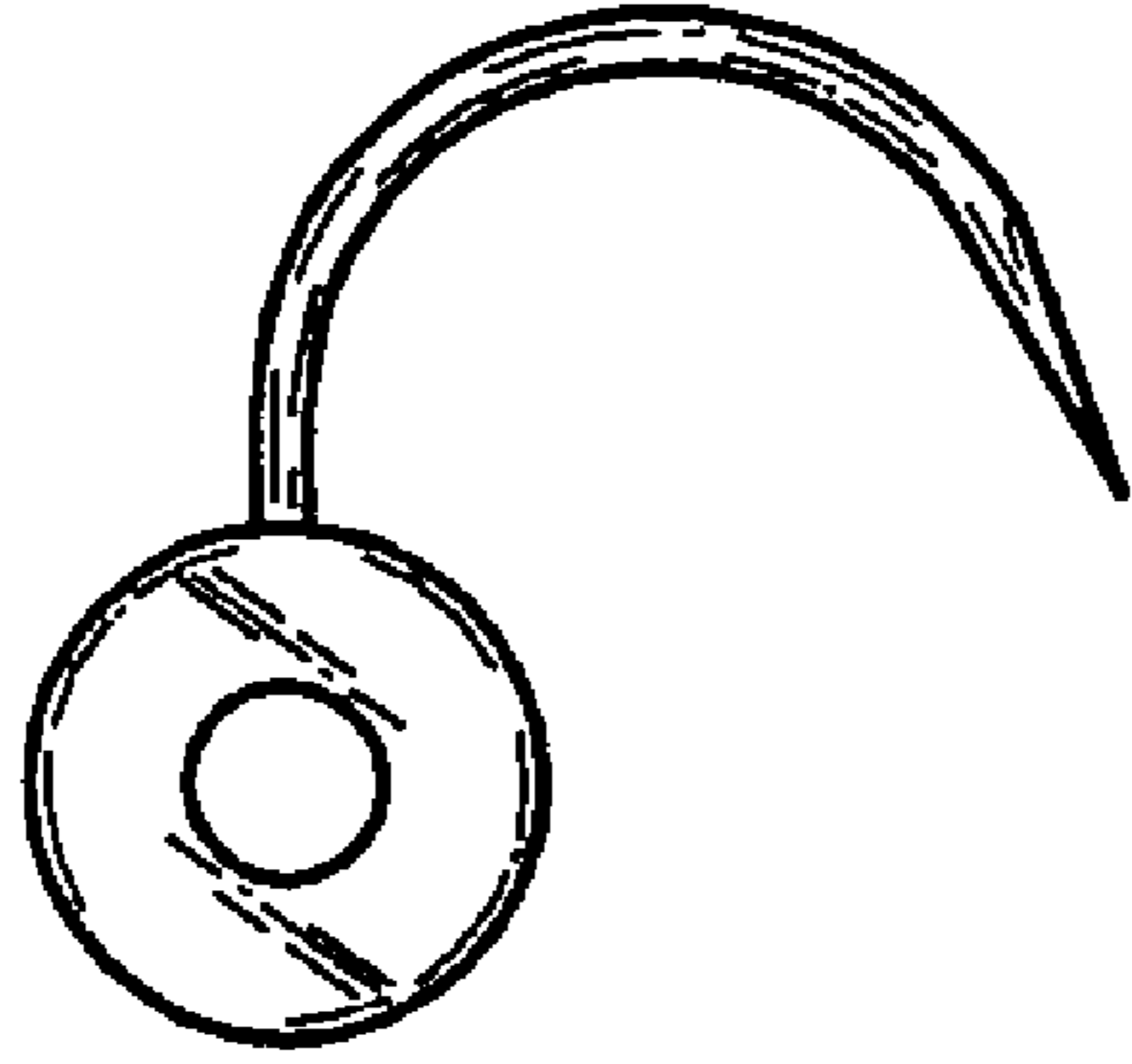

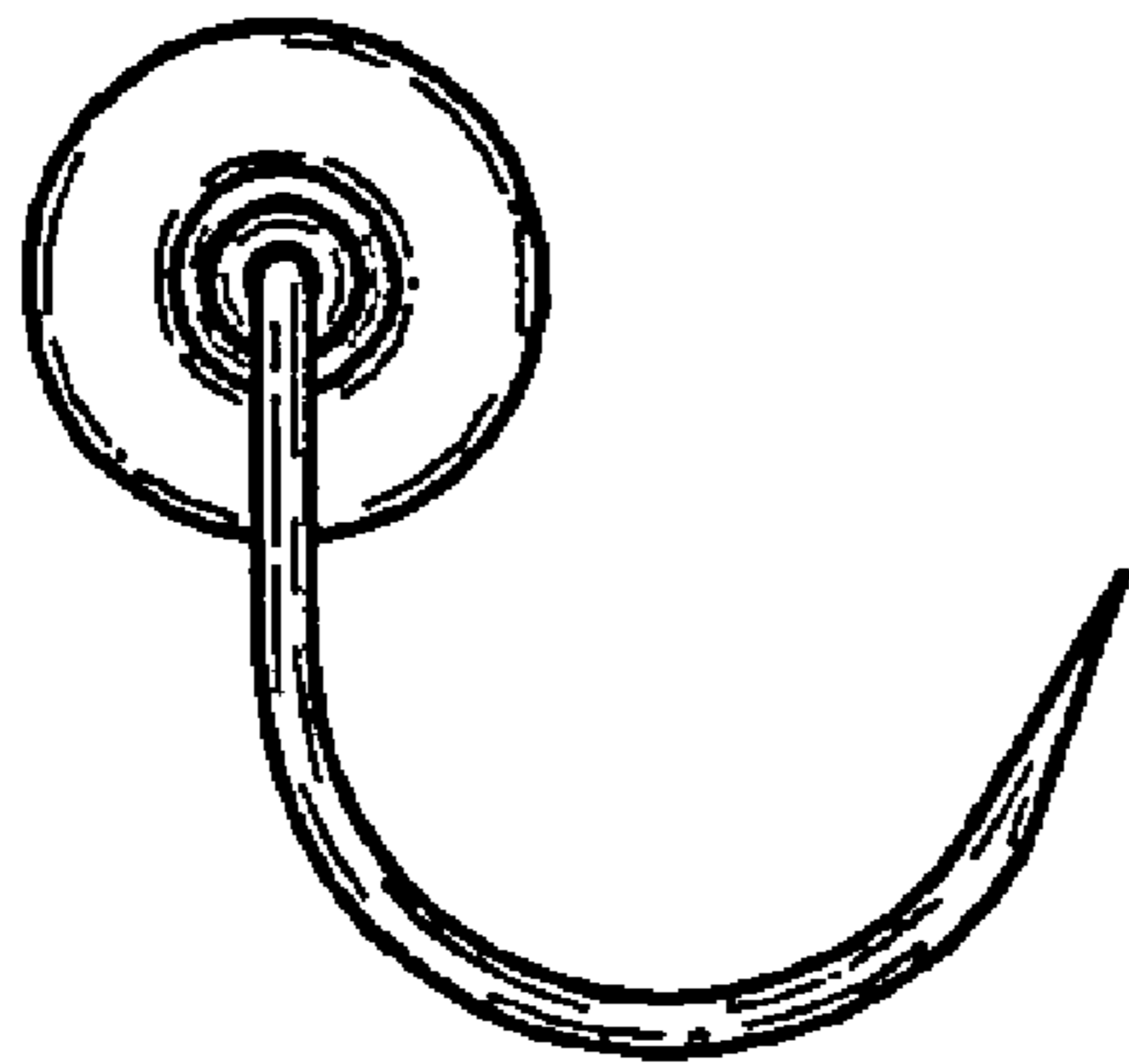
