(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adjustable head ground spike with flat rings, as shown, and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the adjustable head ground spike with flat rings;

FIG. 10 is a left-side view of an alternate embodiment of the adjustable head ground spike with flat rings;

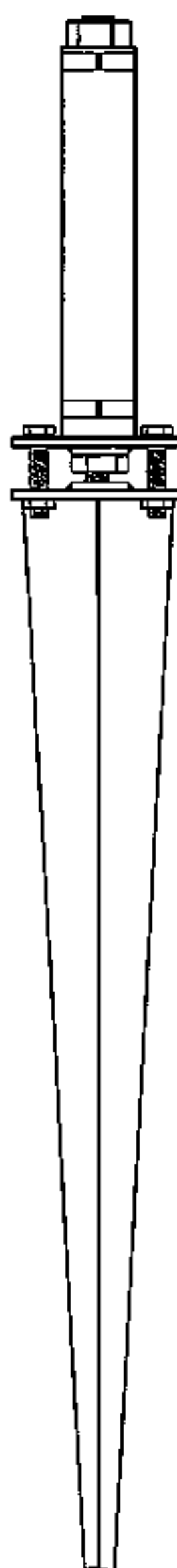
FIG. 11 is a right side view of an alternate embodiment of the adjustable head ground spike with flat rings;

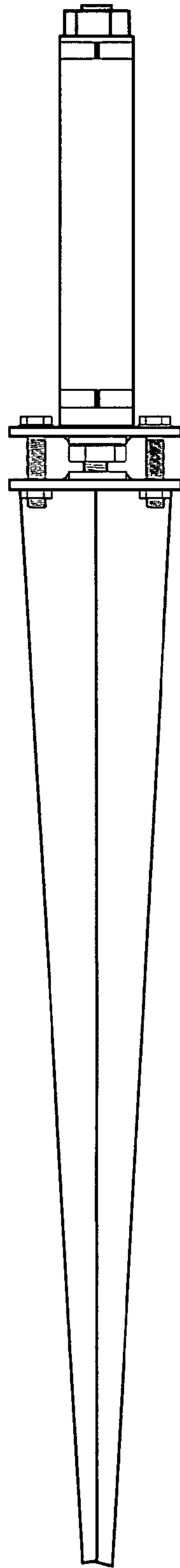

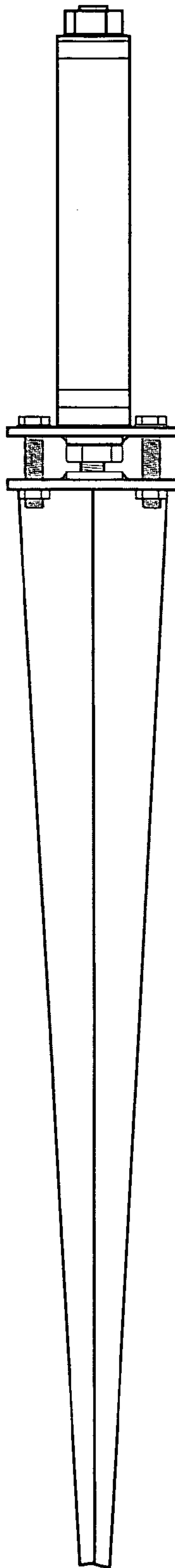

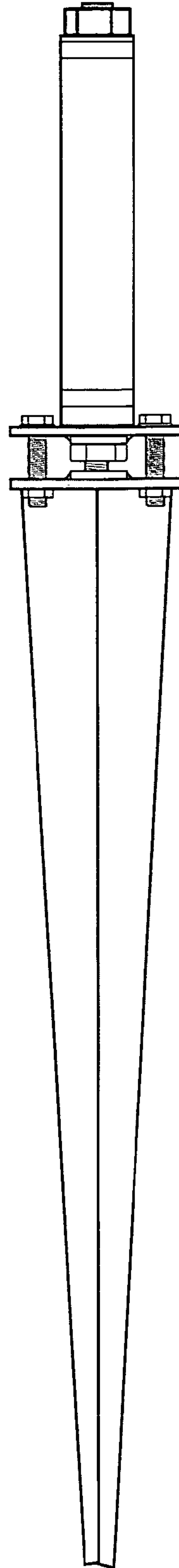

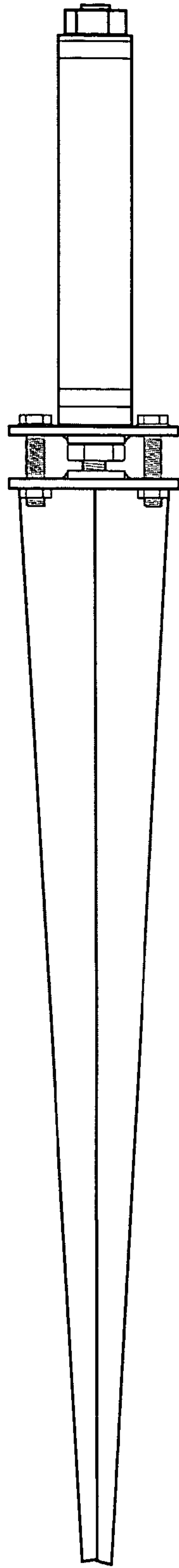

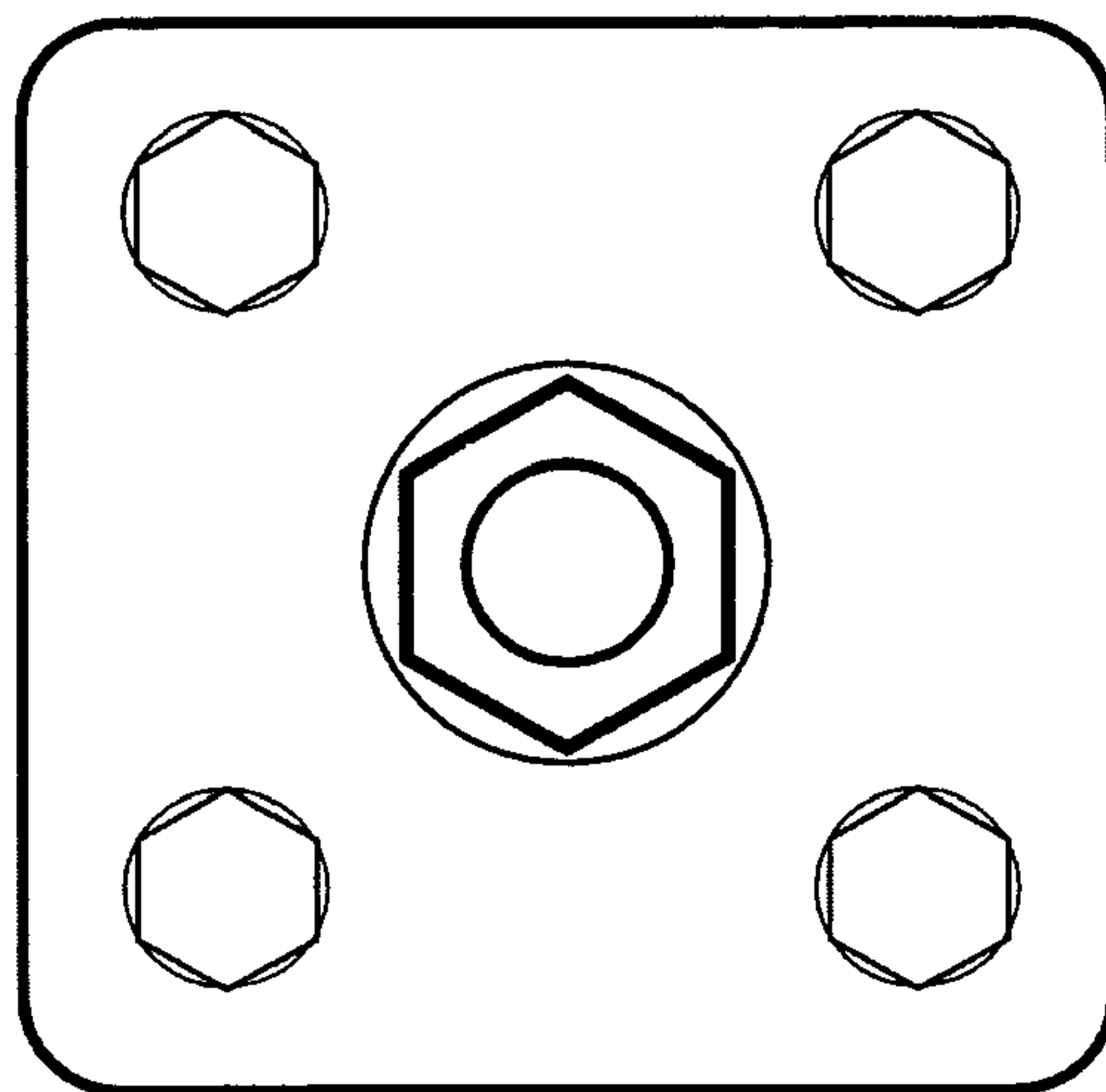

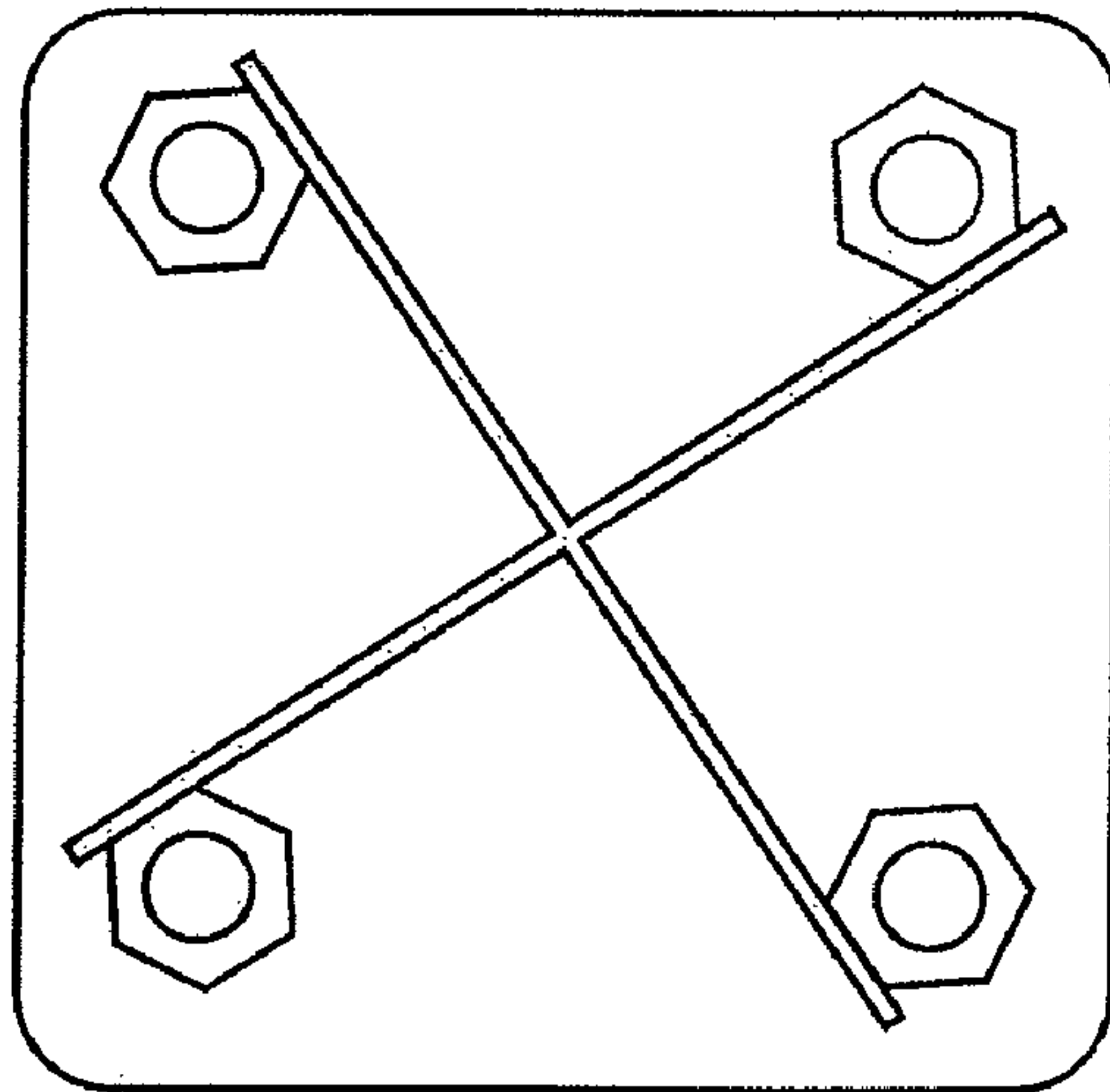

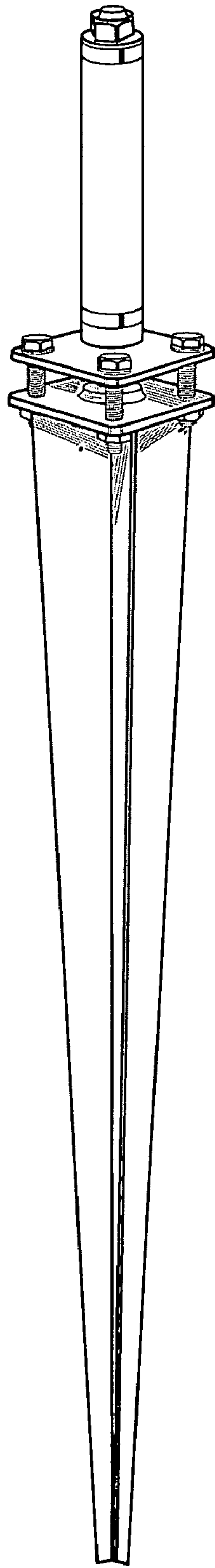

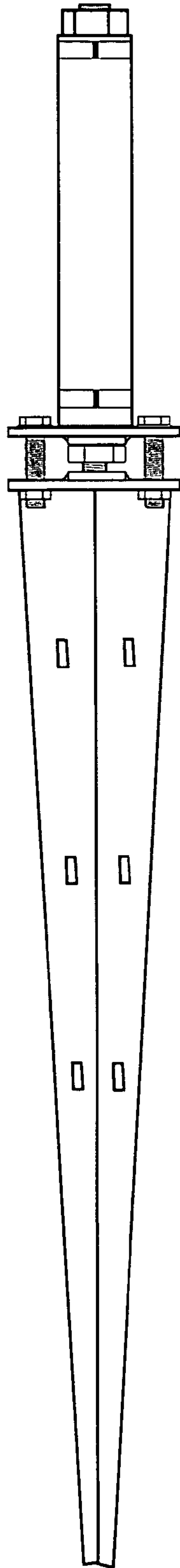

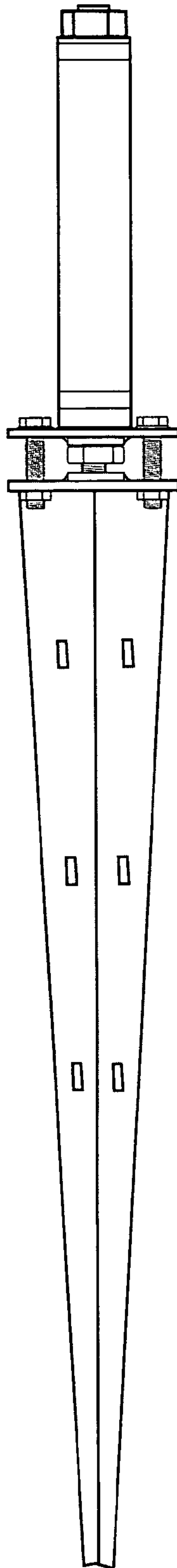

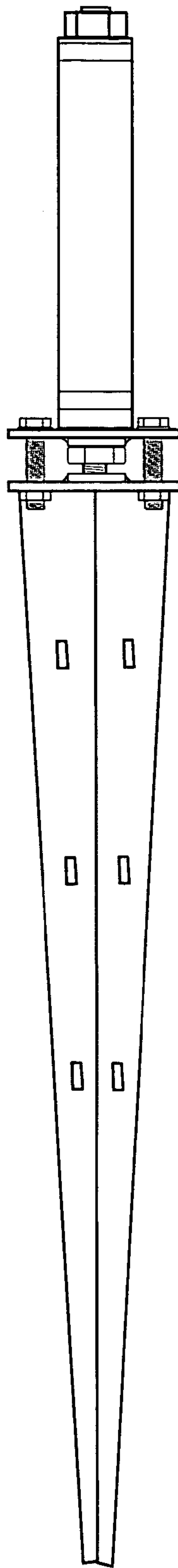

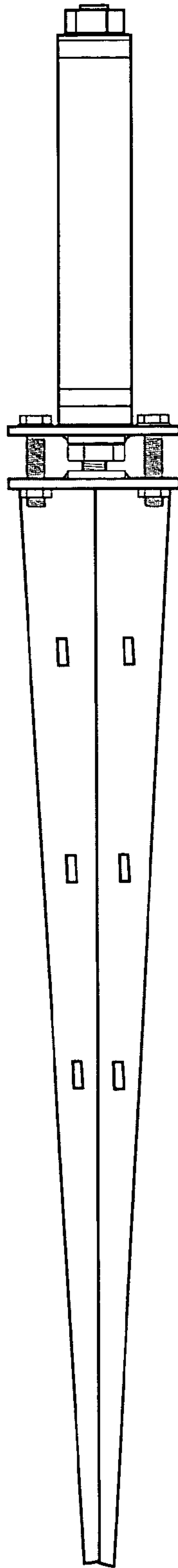

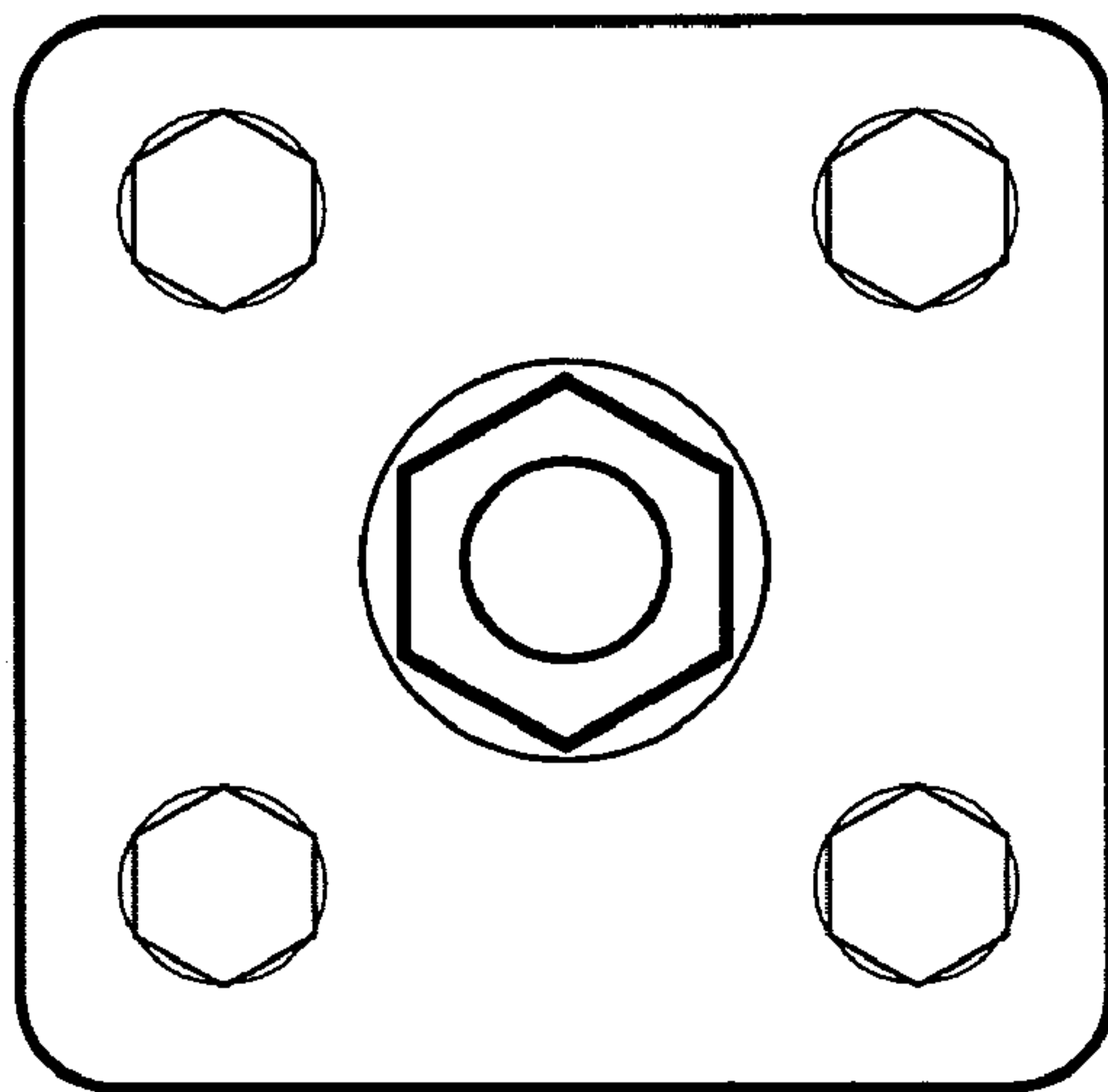

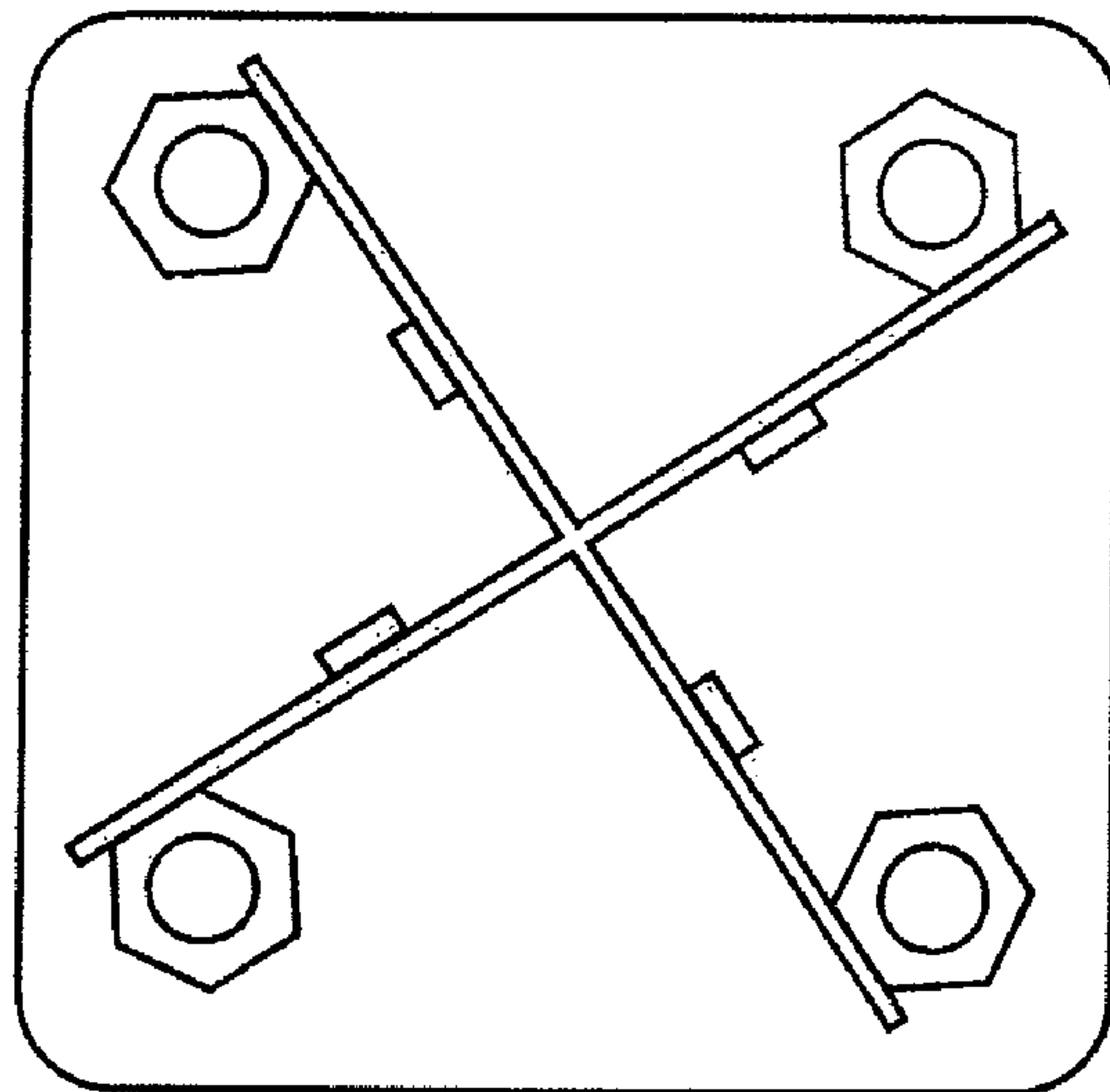

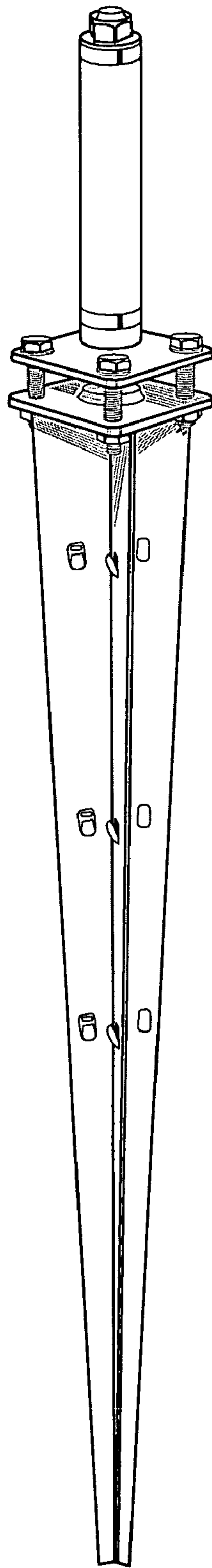
