FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

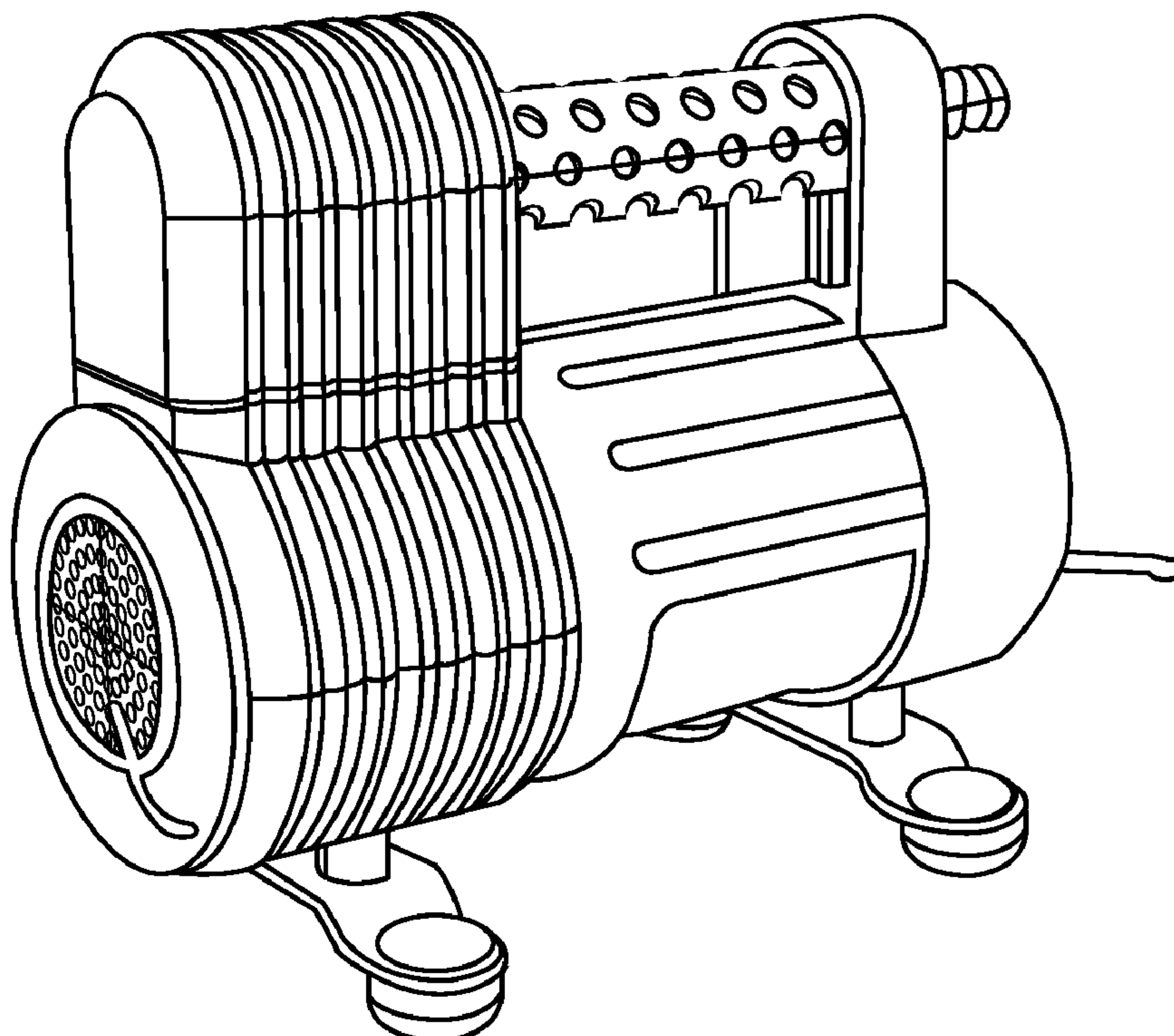
FIG. 6 is rear elevational view thereof;

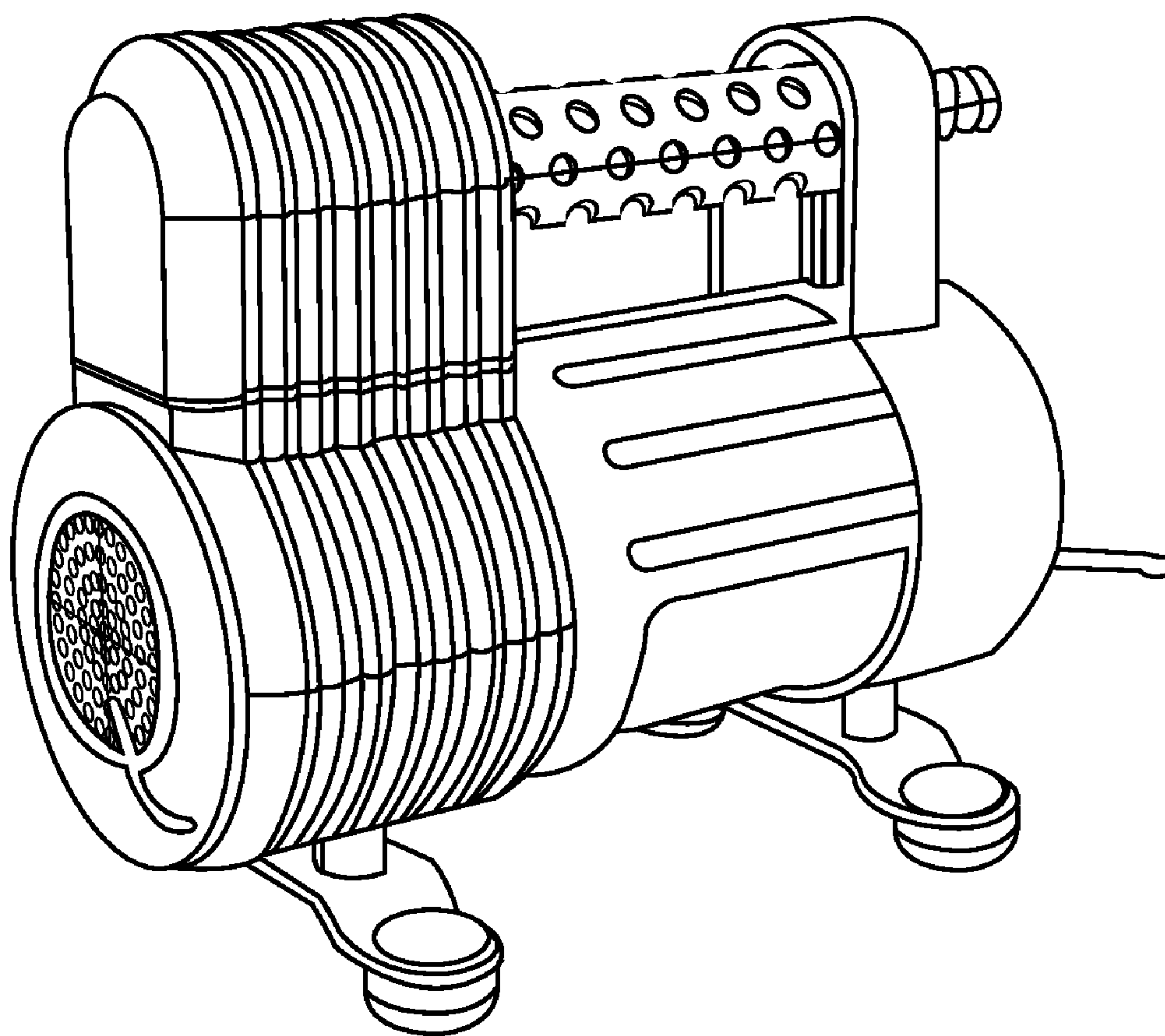

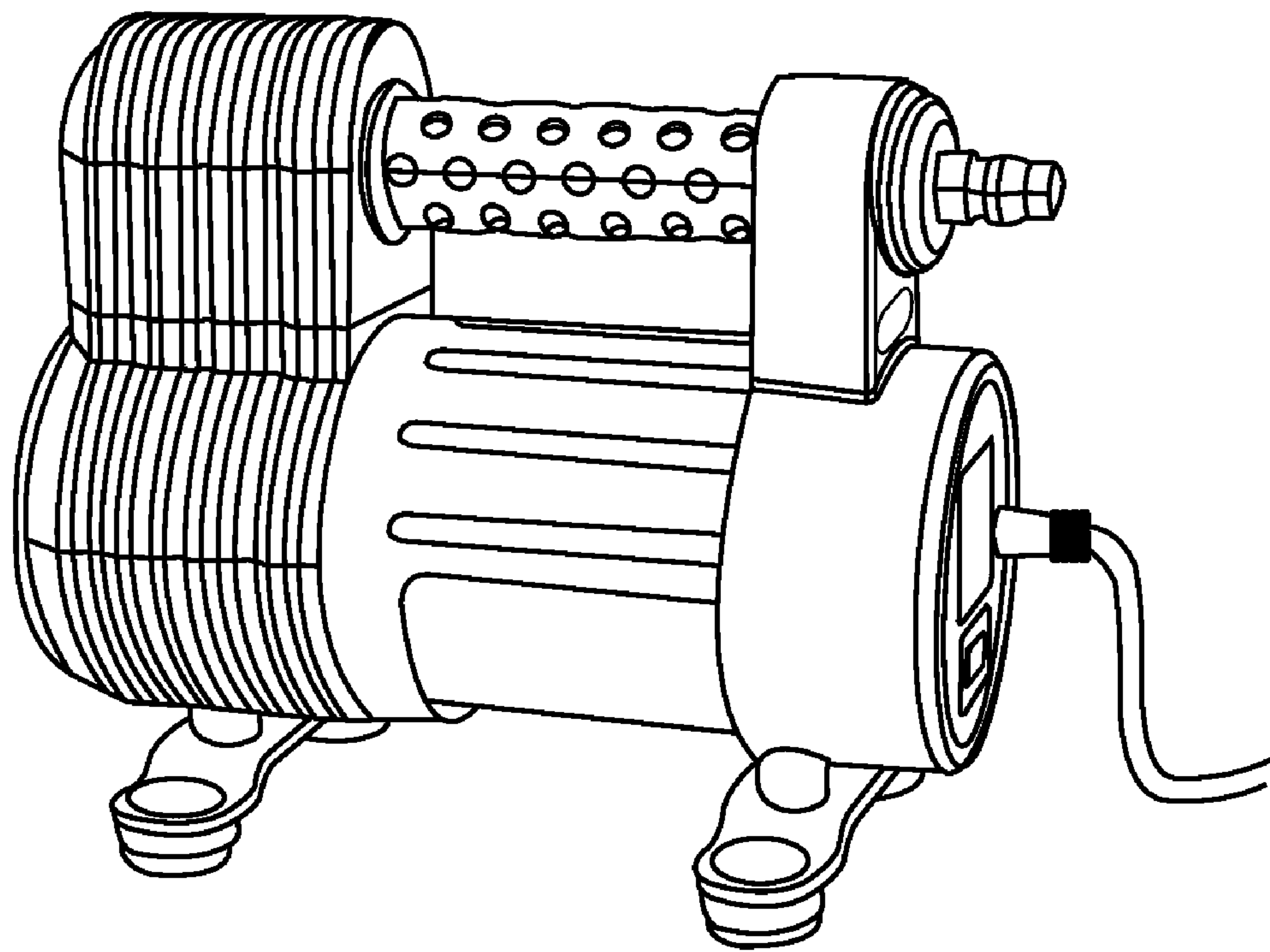

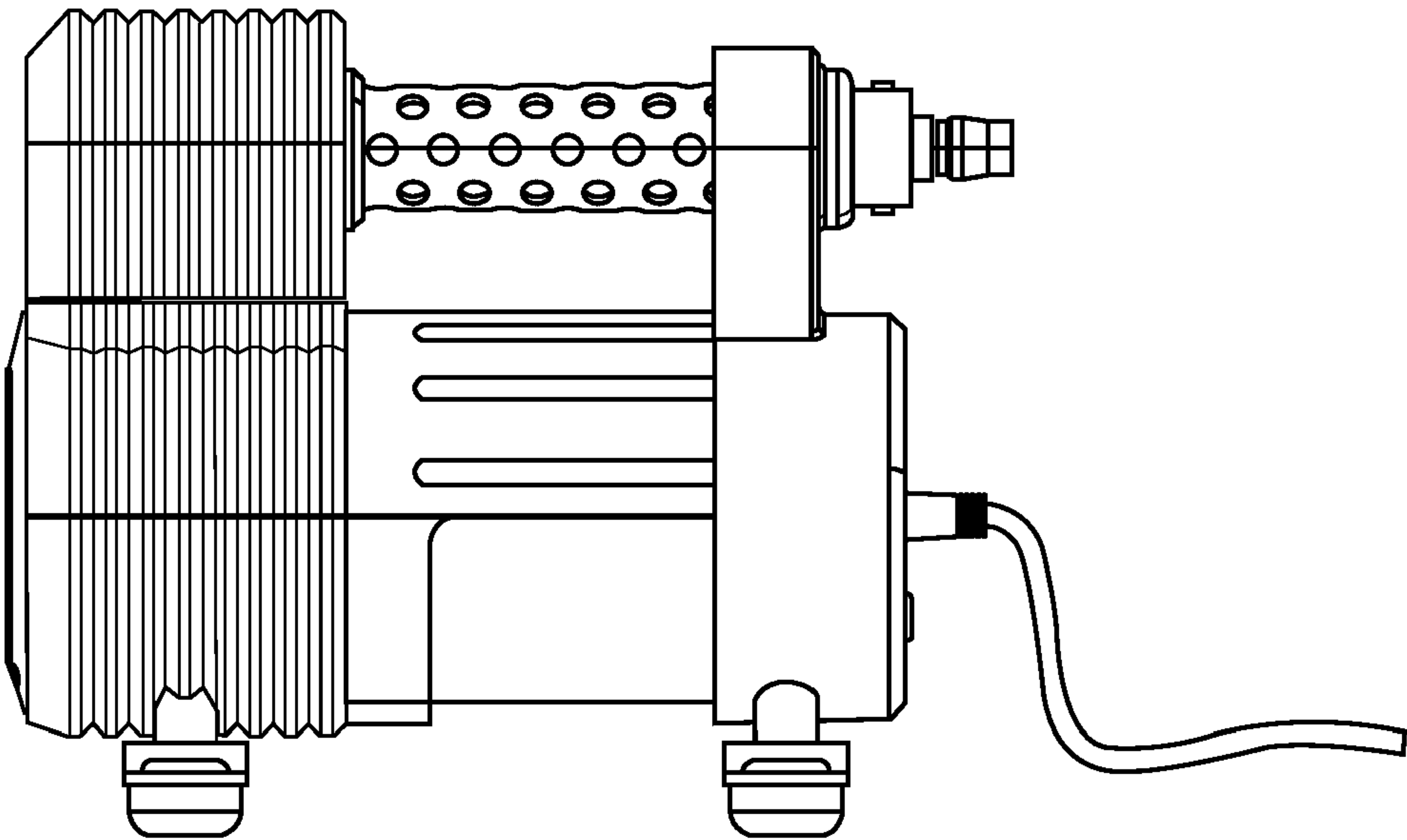

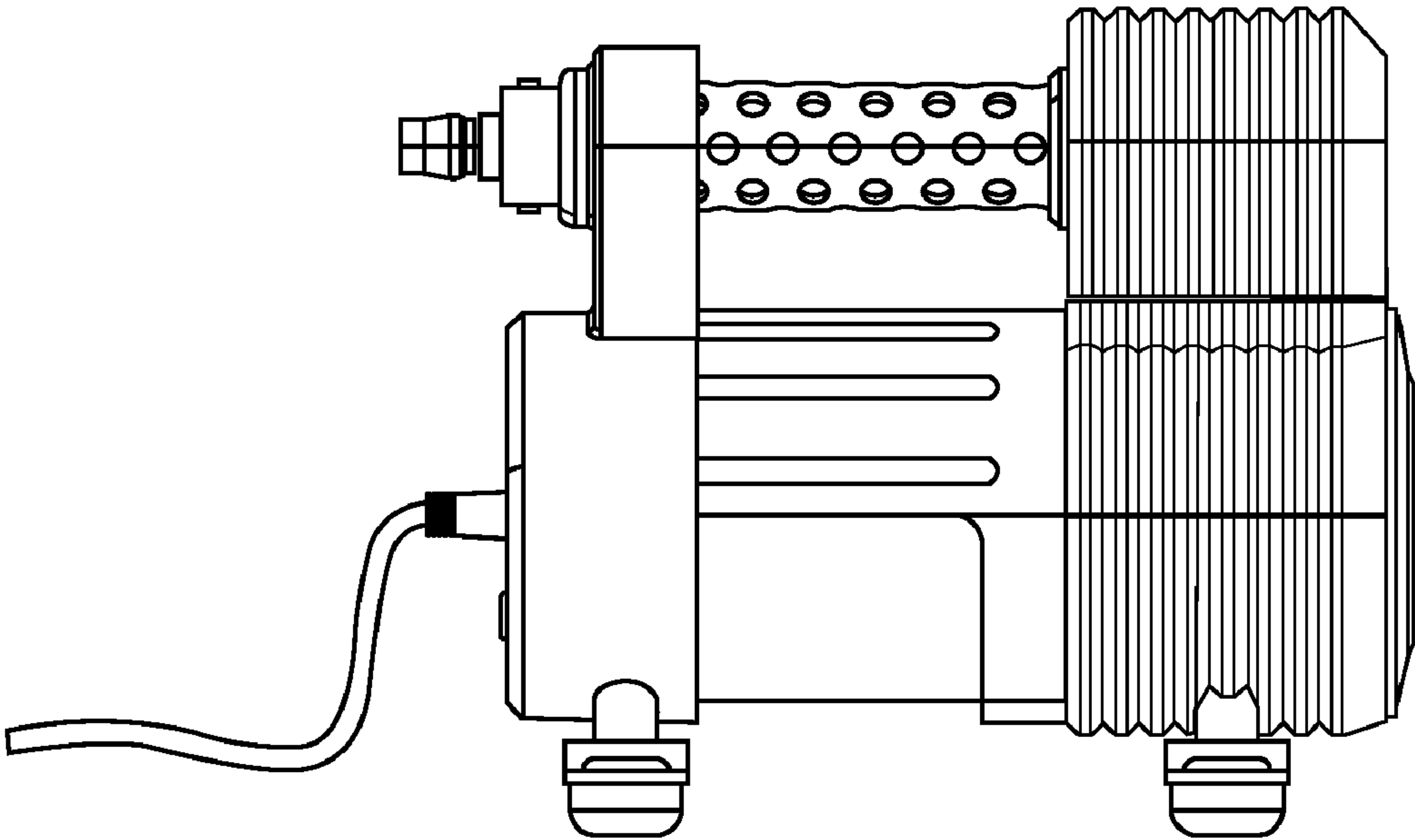

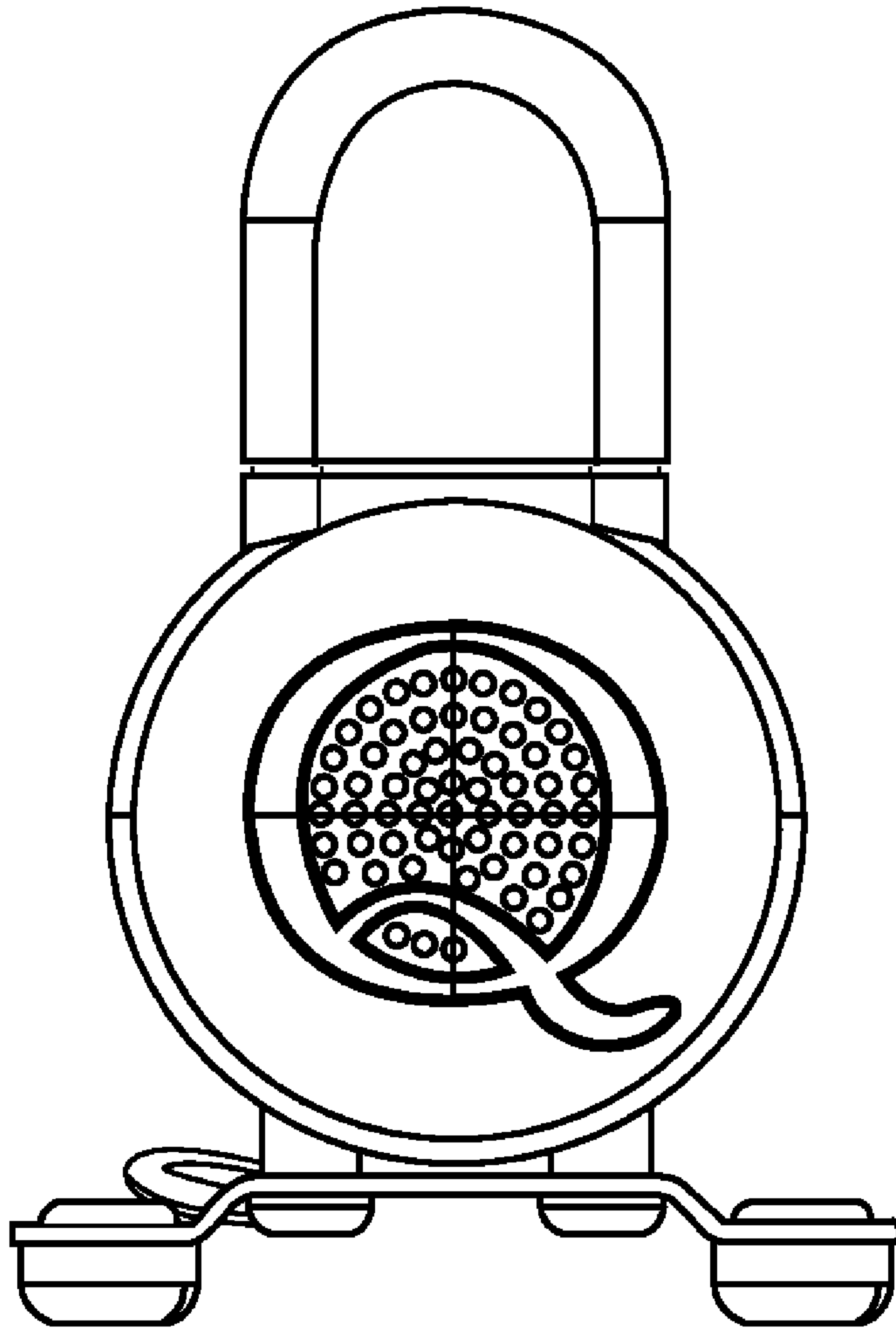

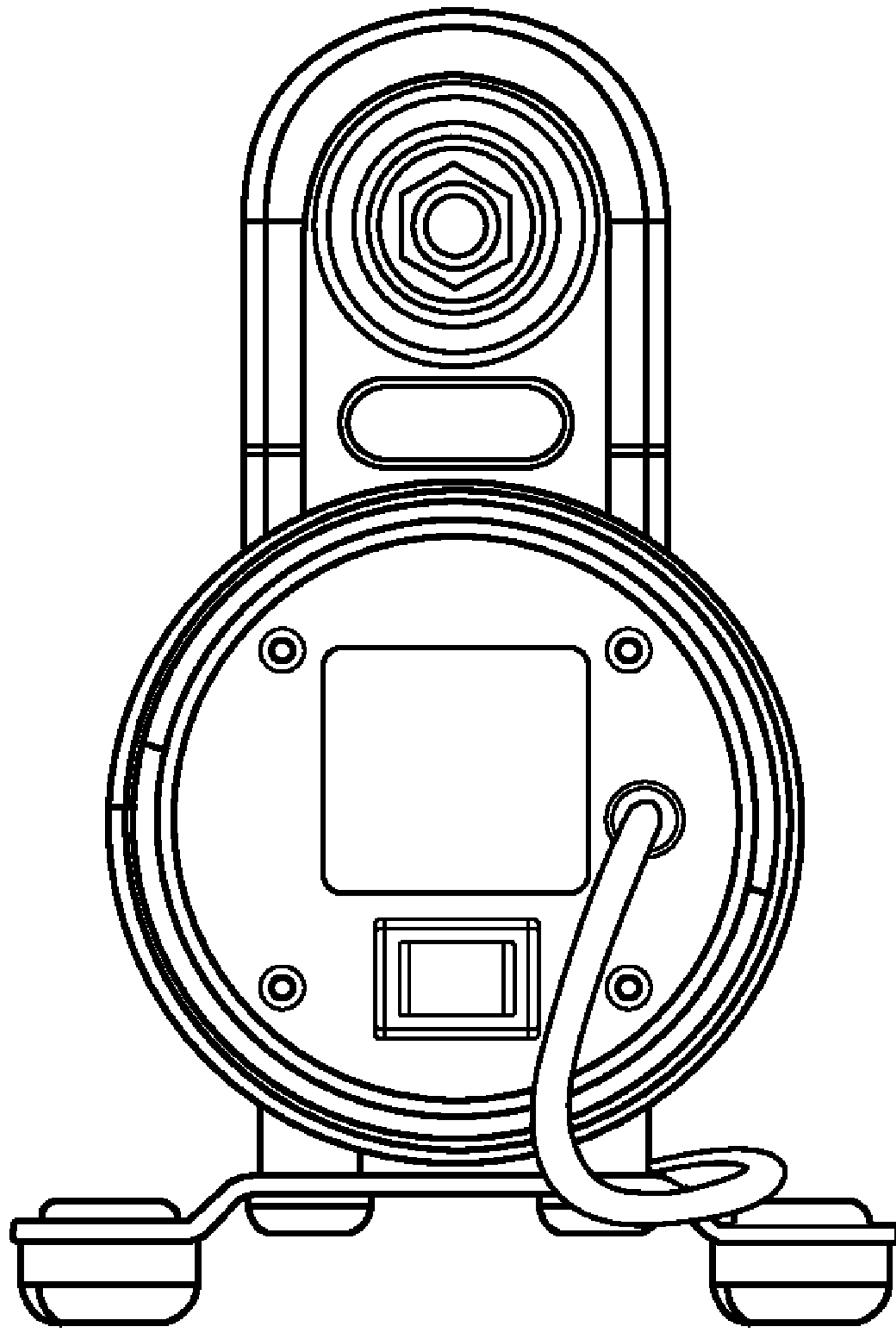

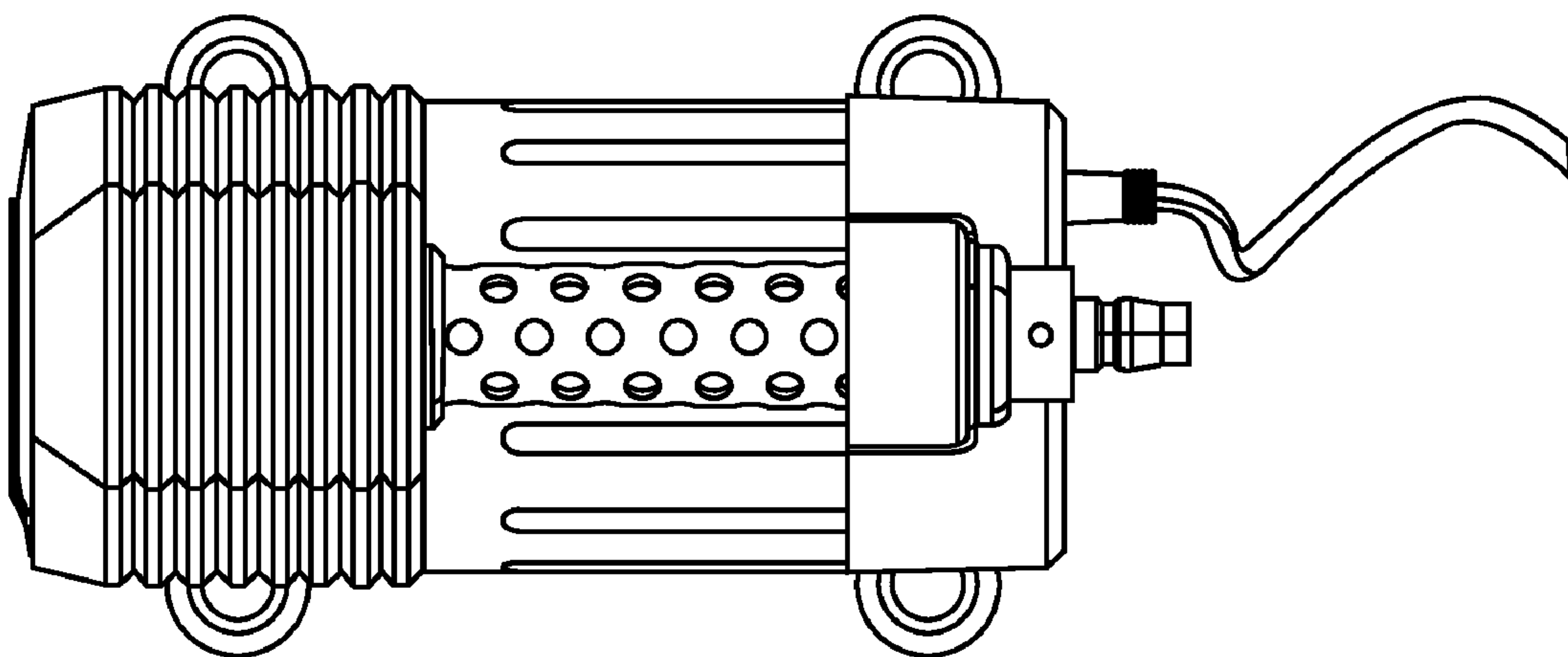

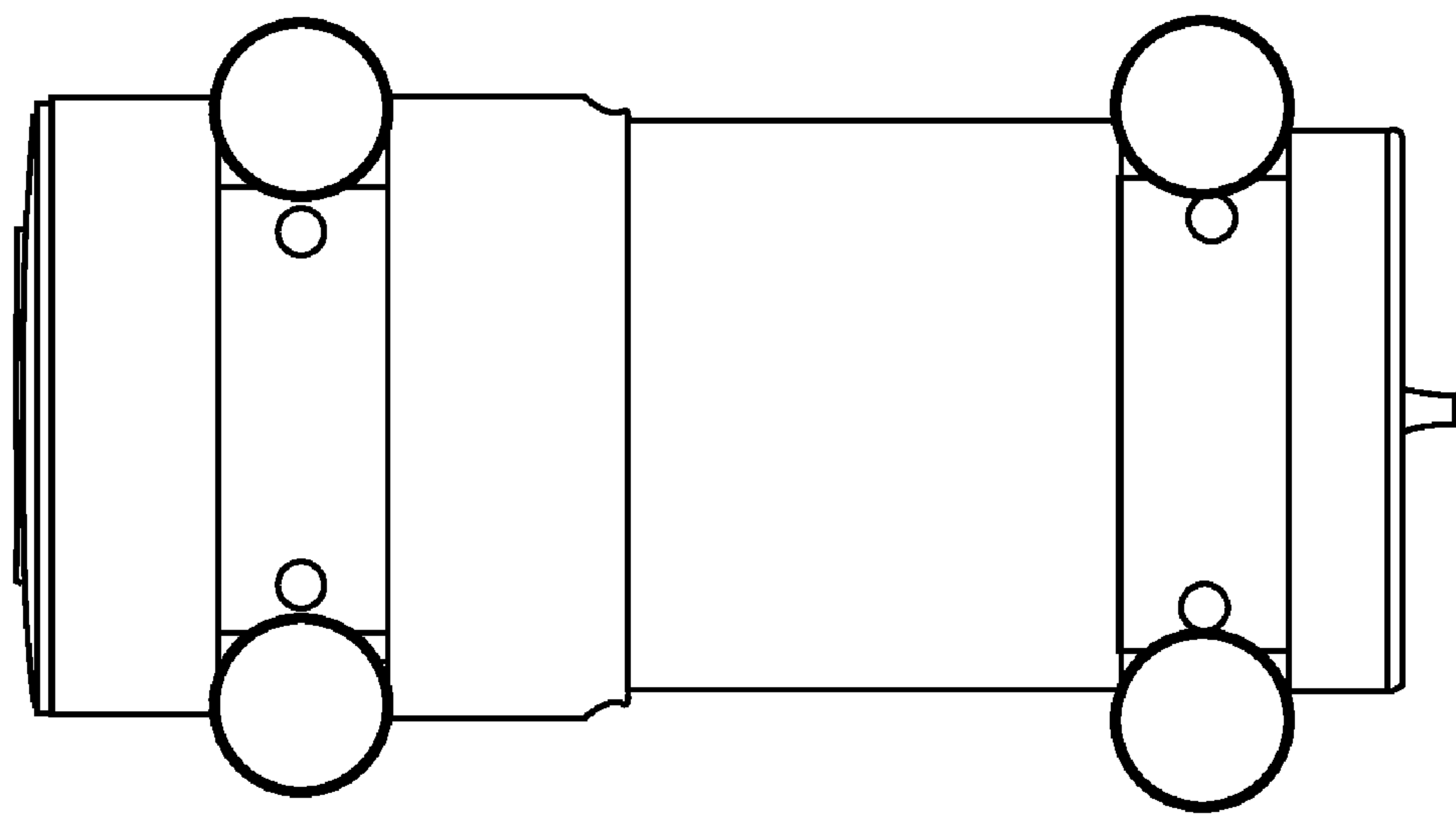
