FIG. 3 is a front view of the chair caddy as in FIGS. 1-2.

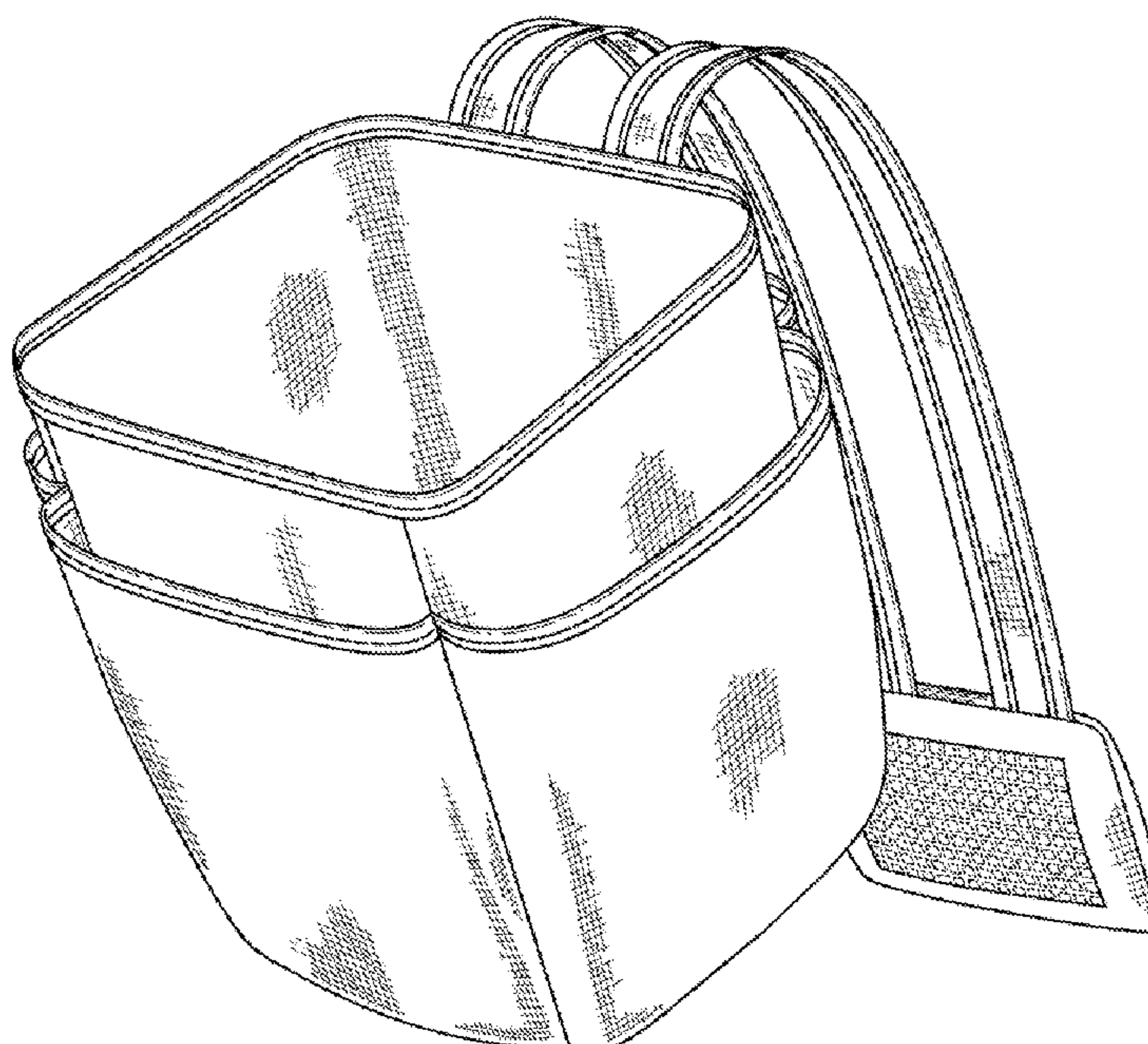
FIG. 4 is a rear view of the chair caddy as in FIGS. 1-3.

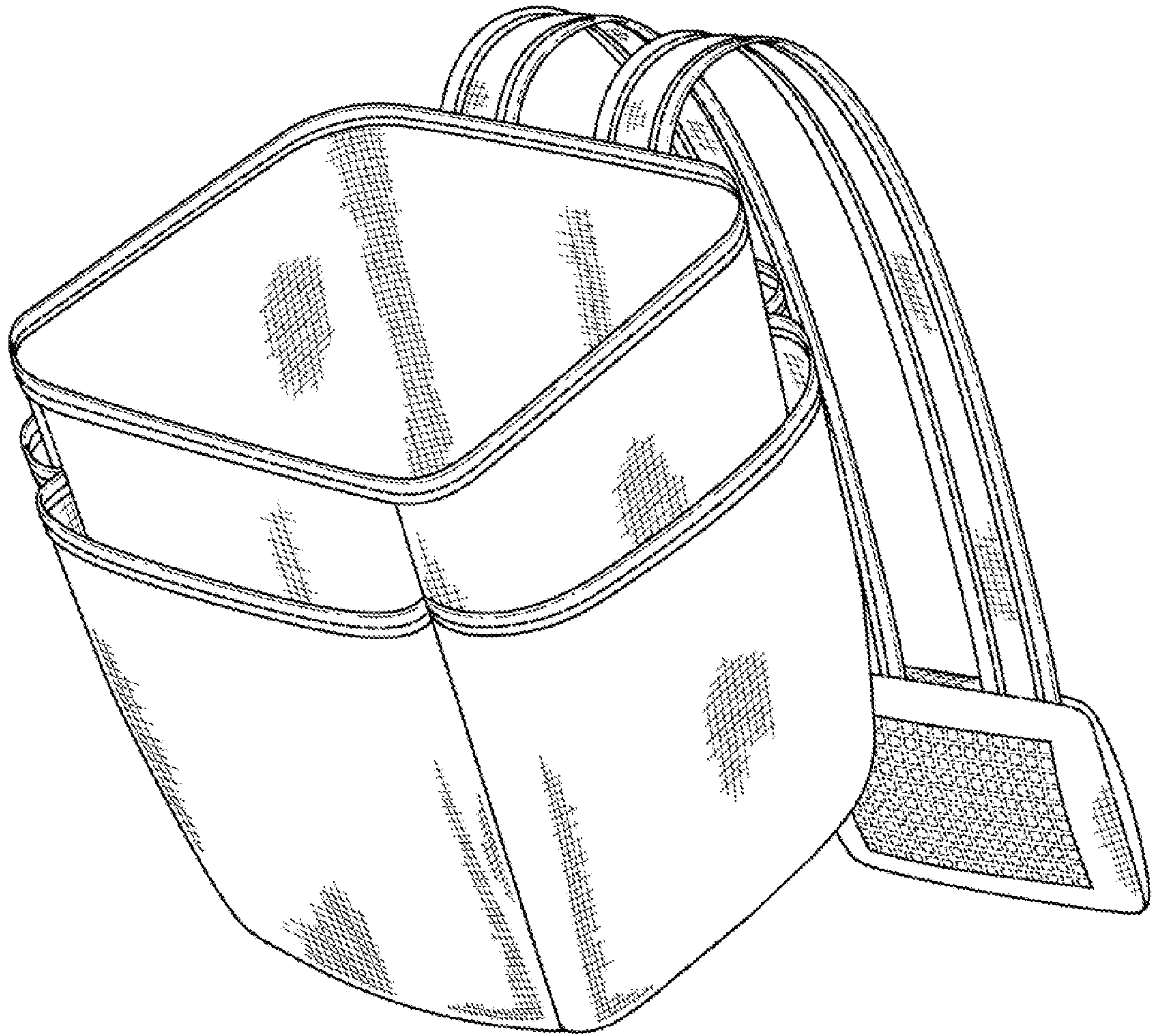

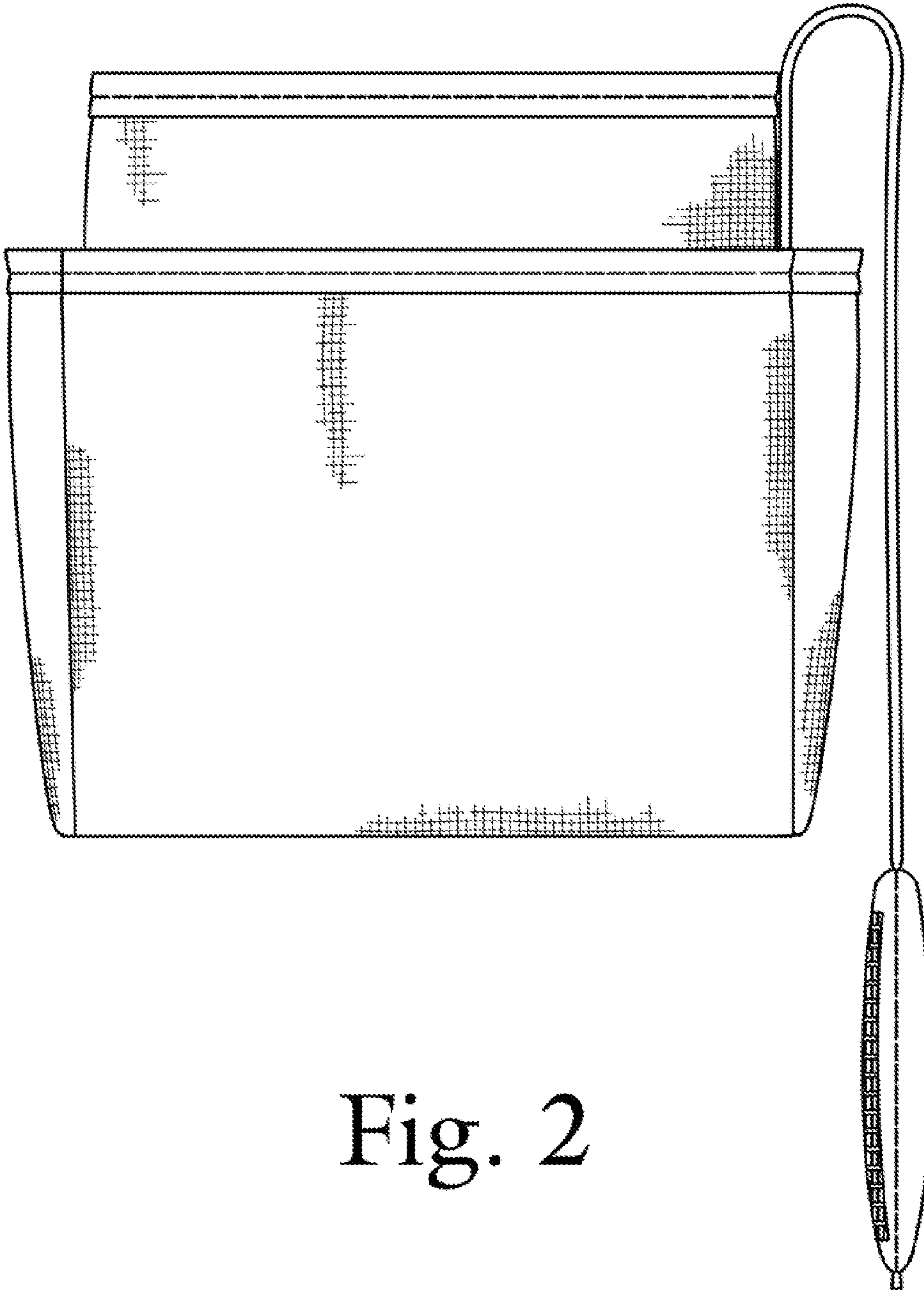

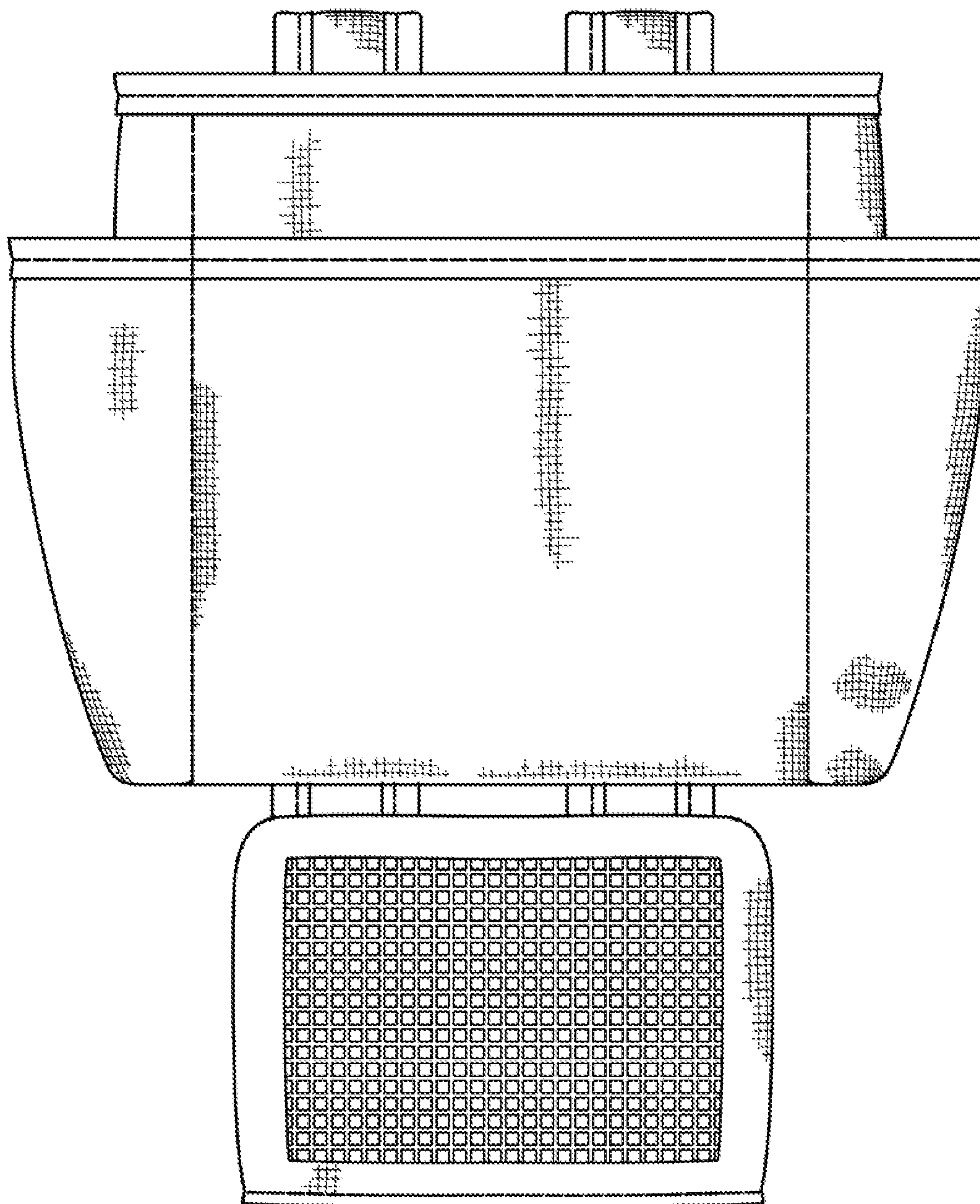

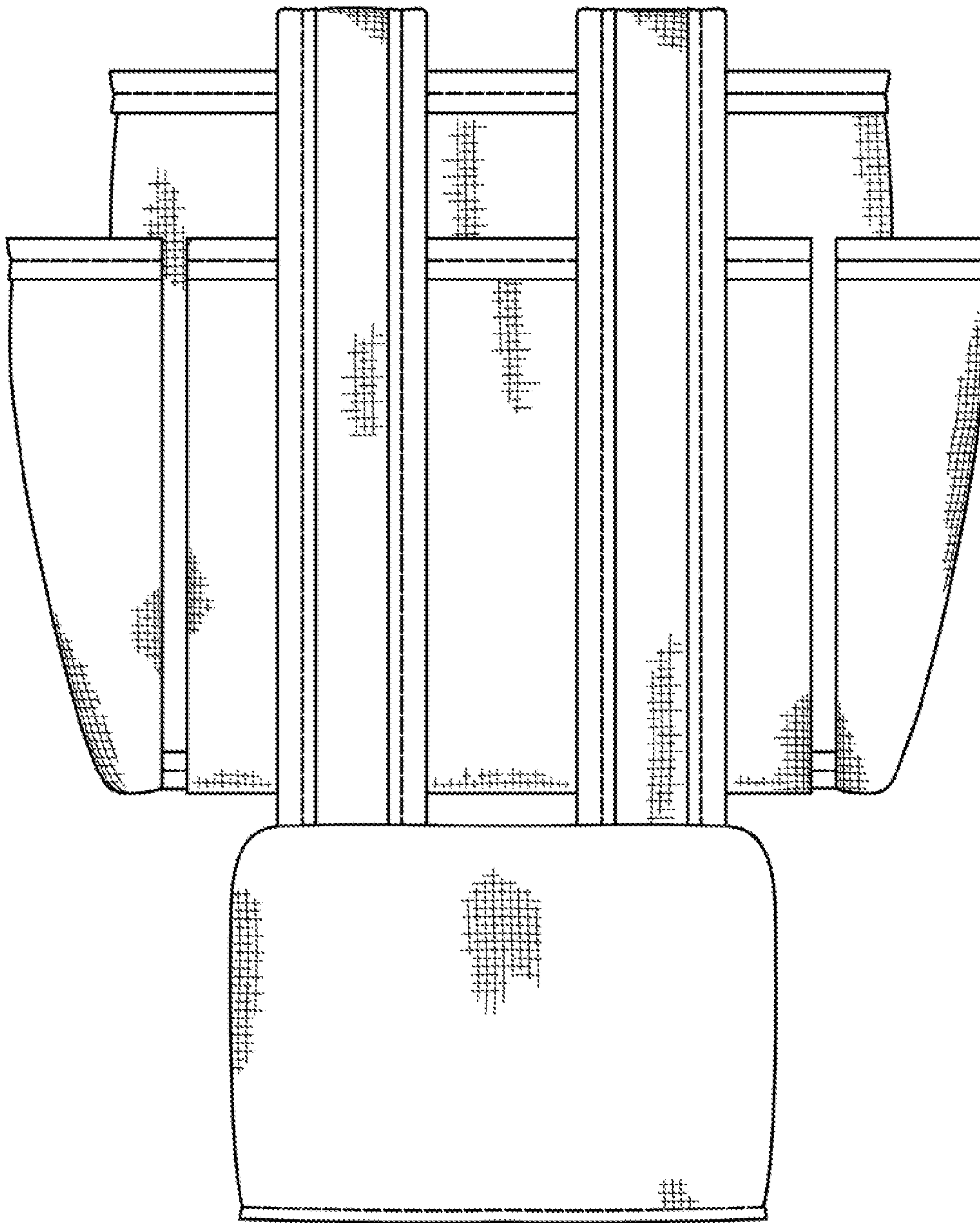

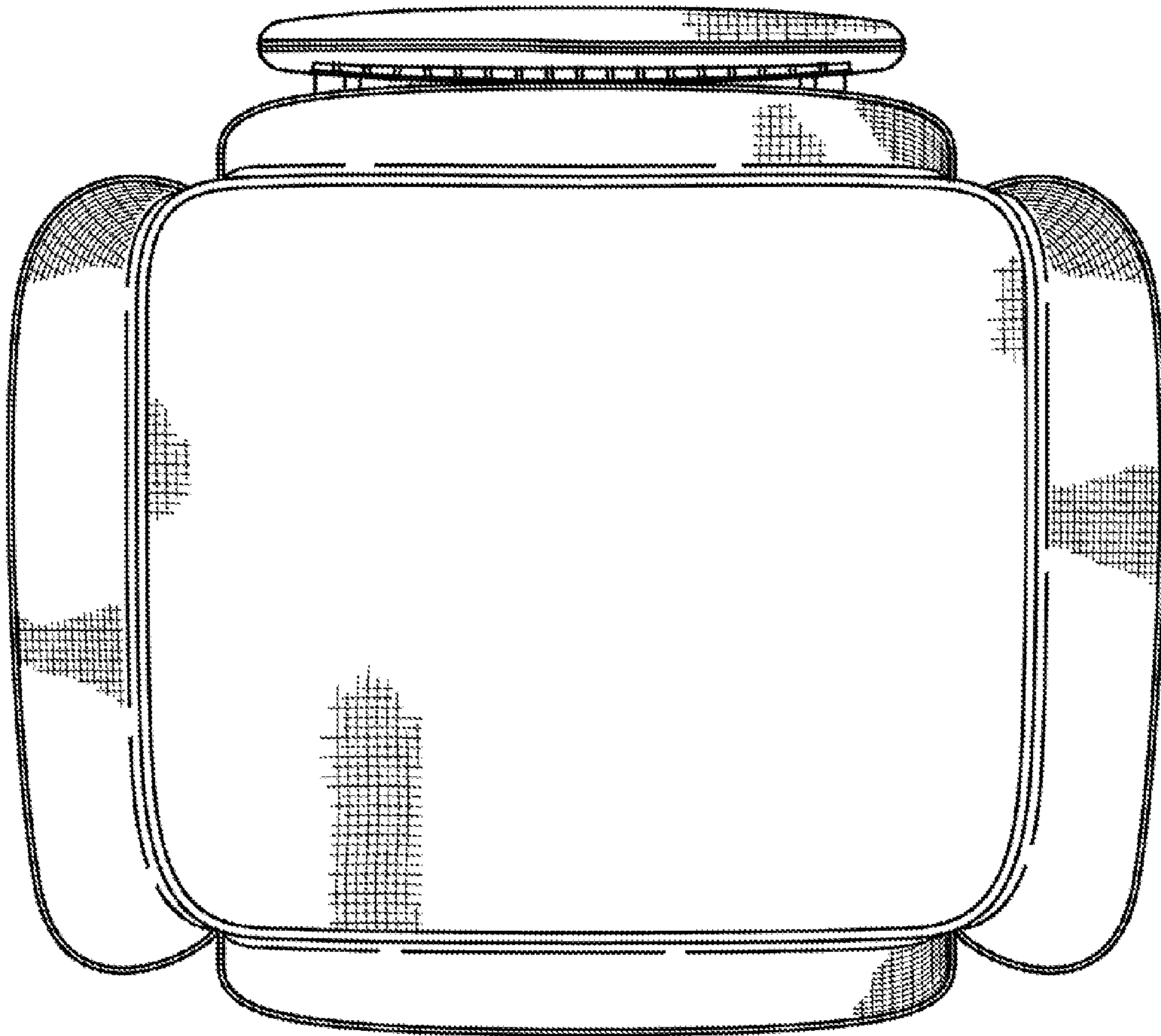

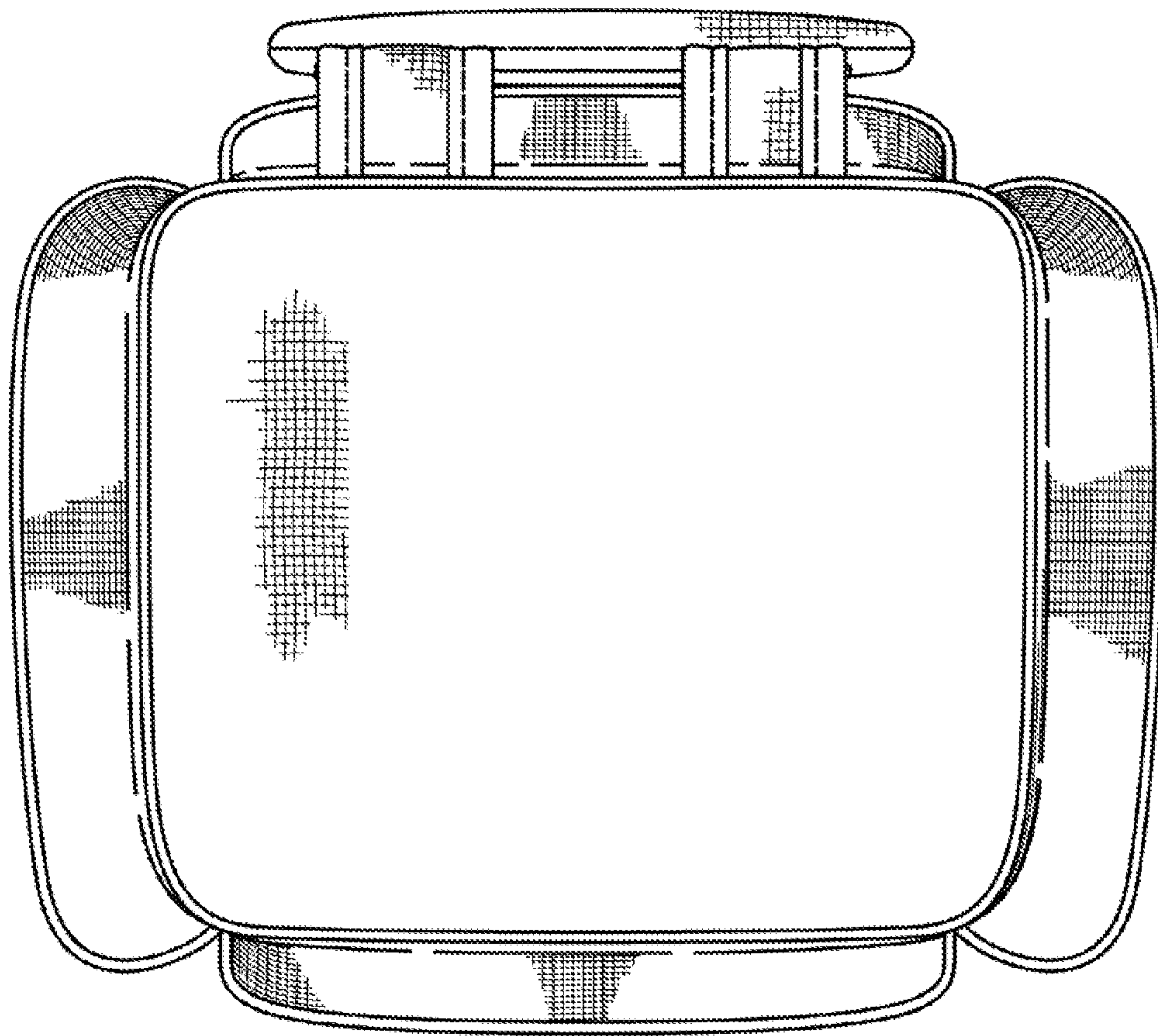
