FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

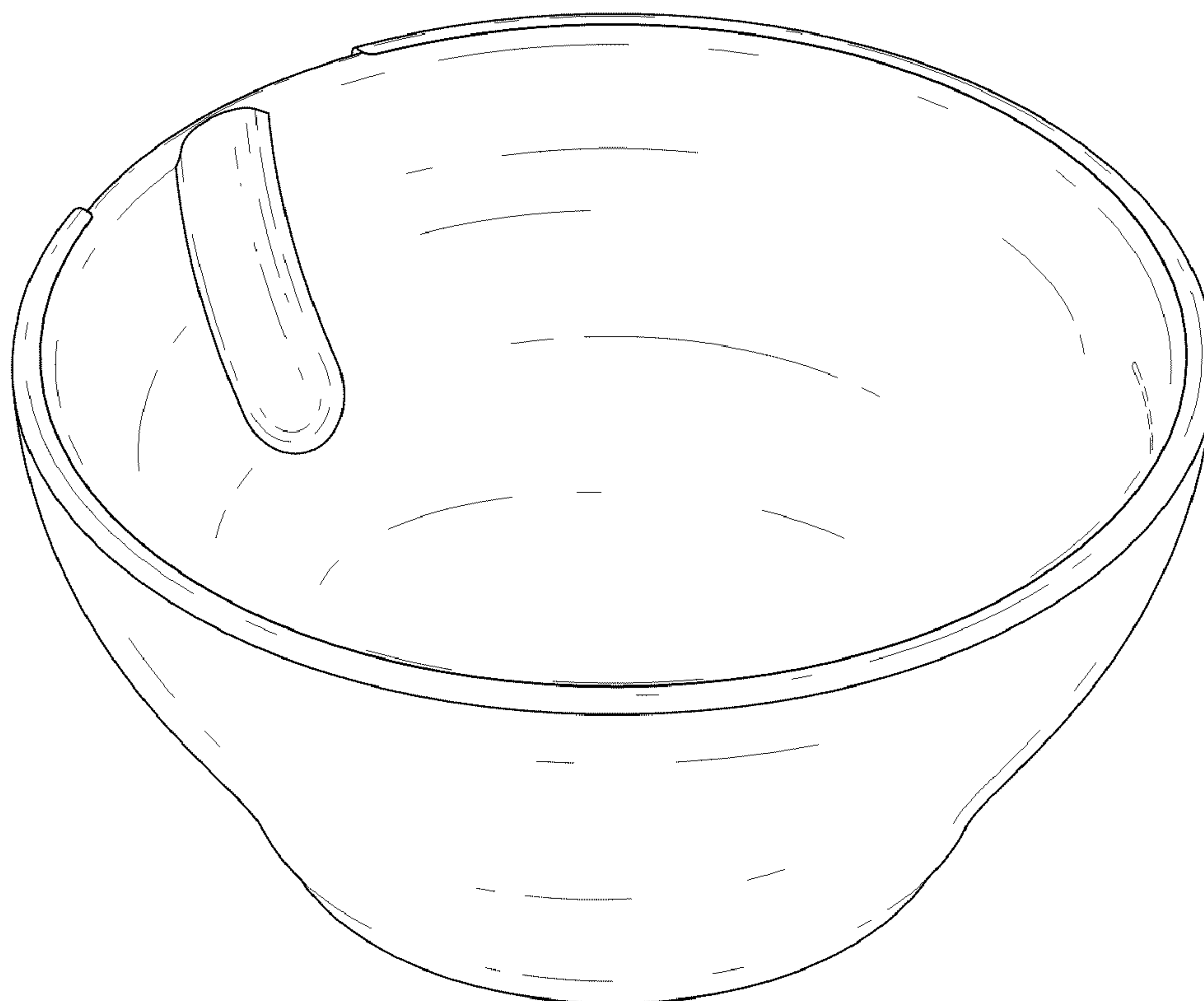
FIG. 5 is a bottom elevational view thereof.

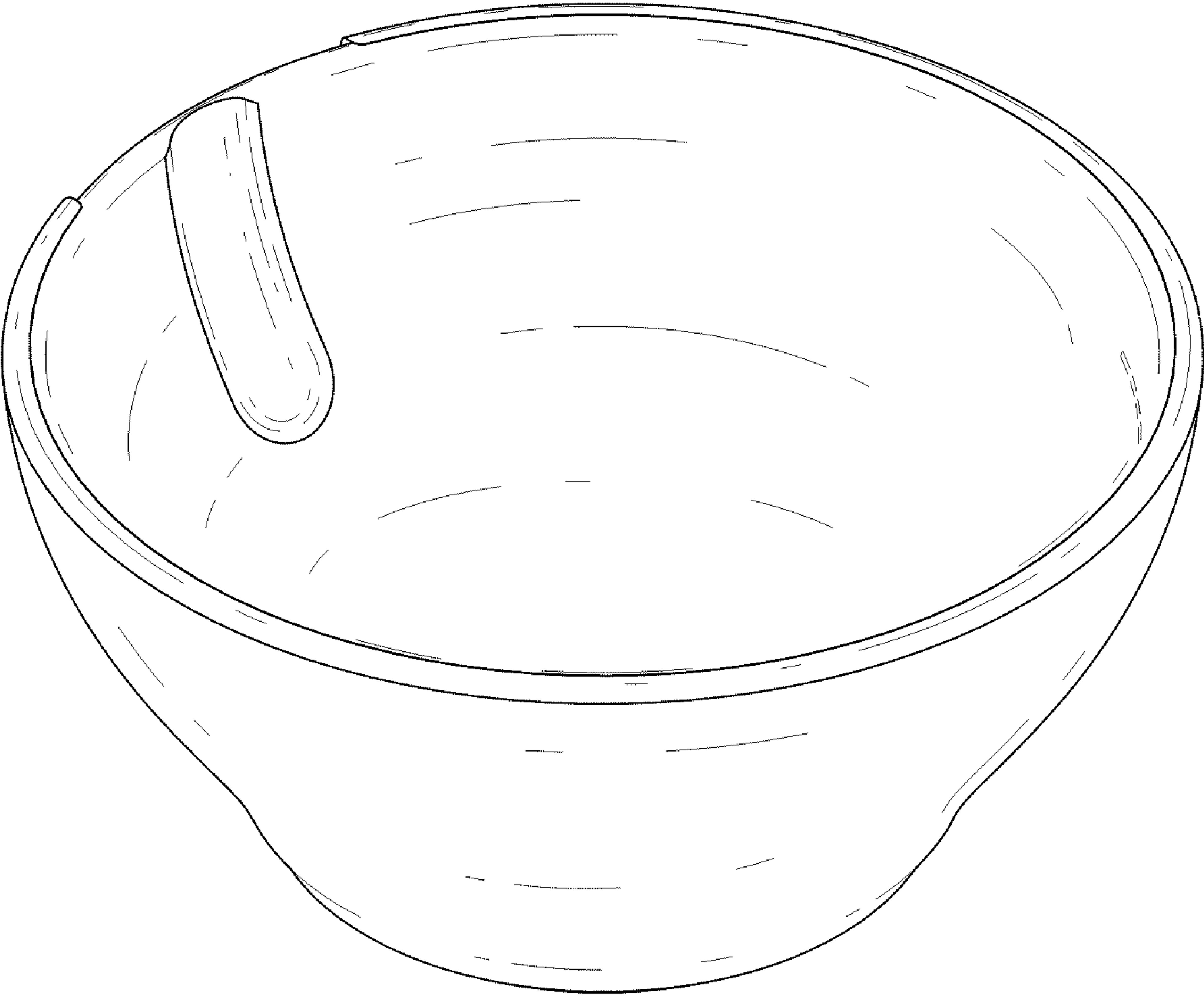
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

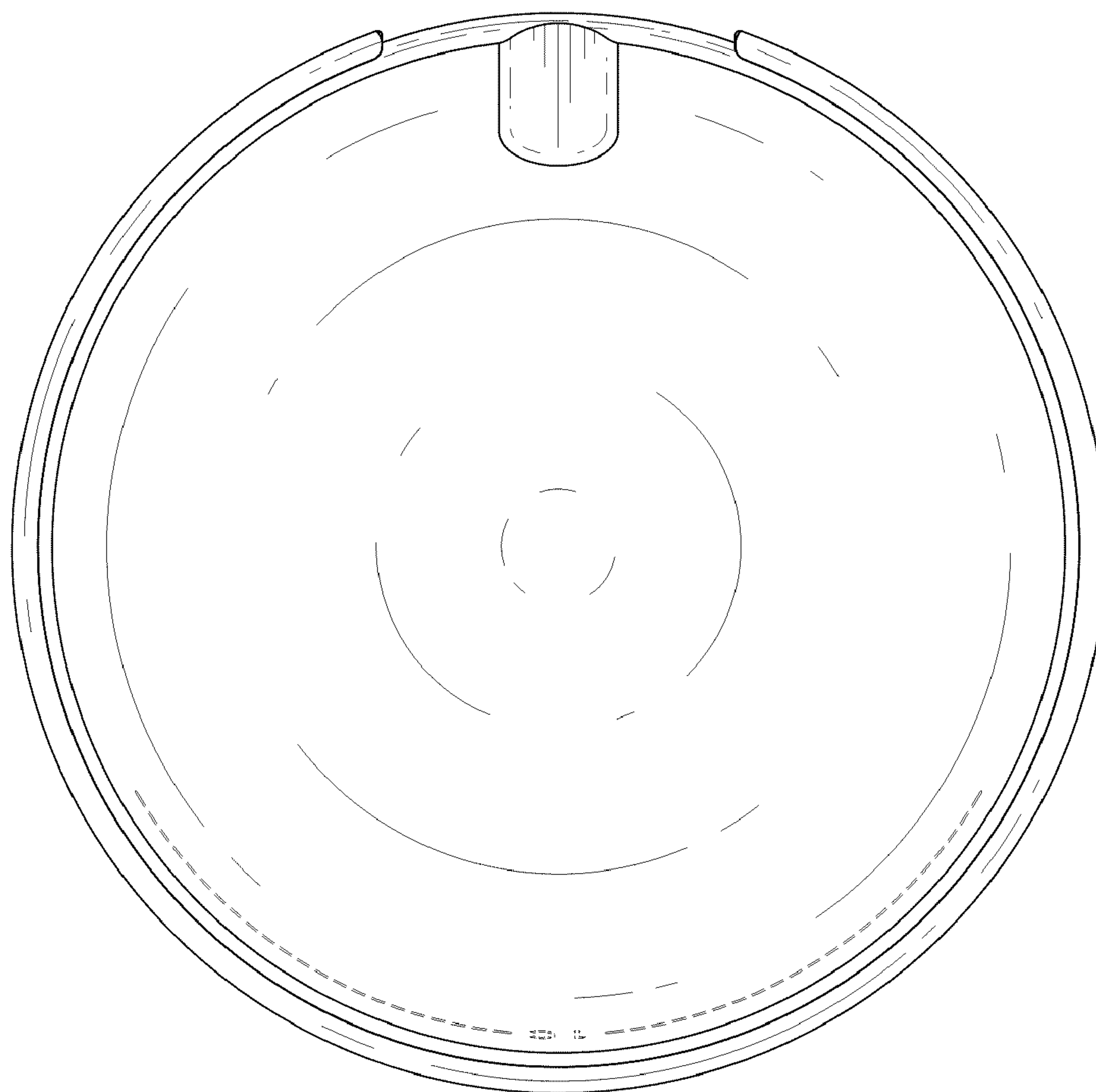

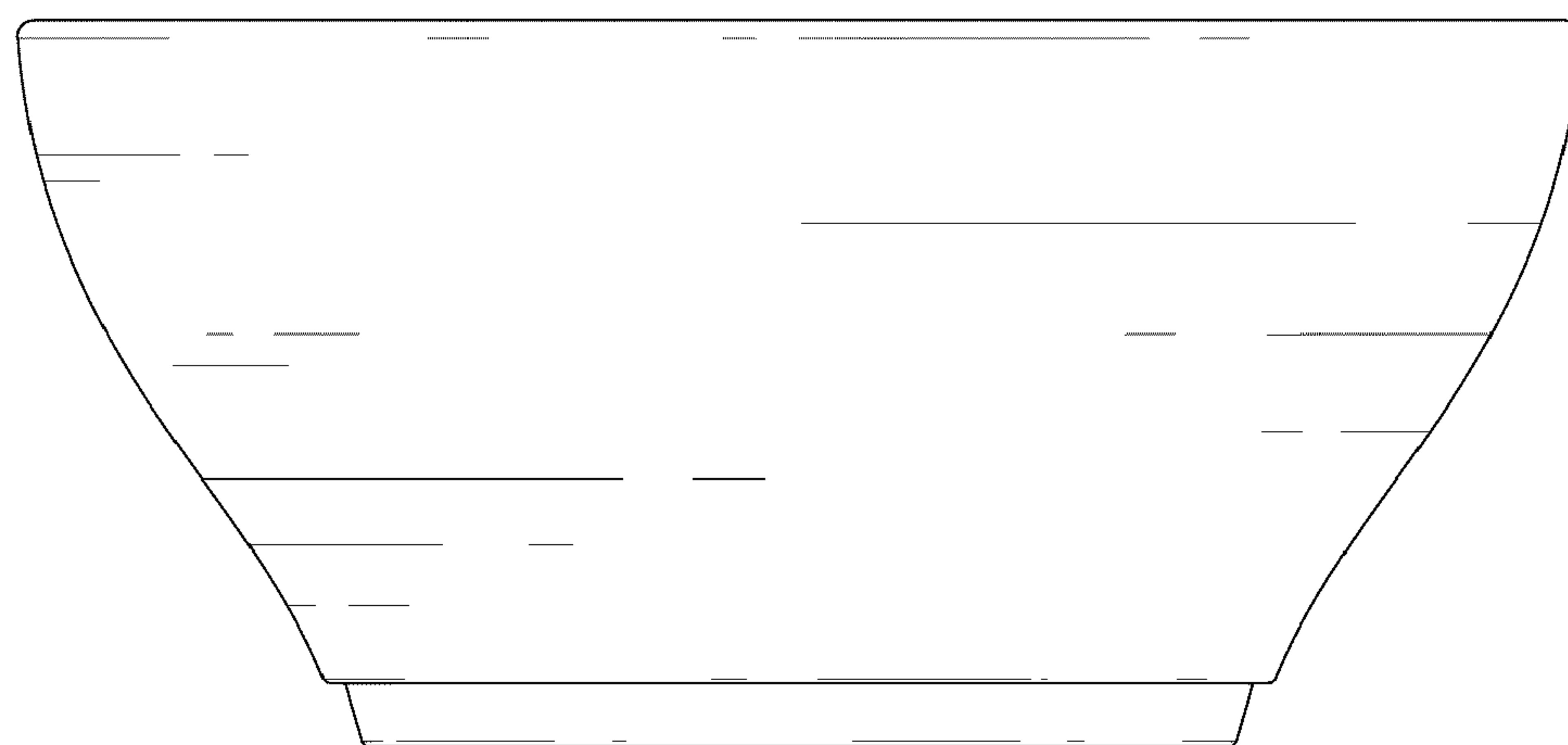




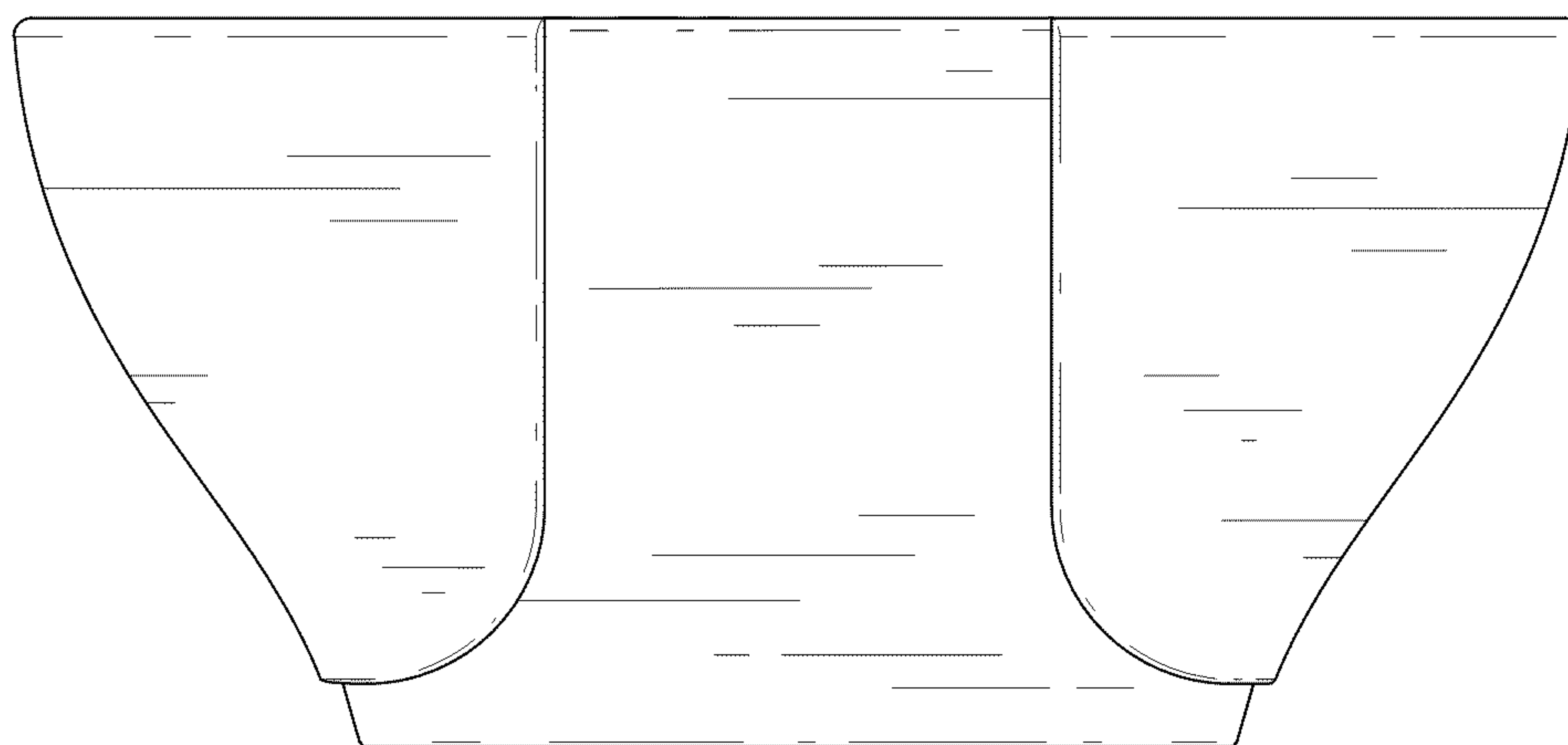

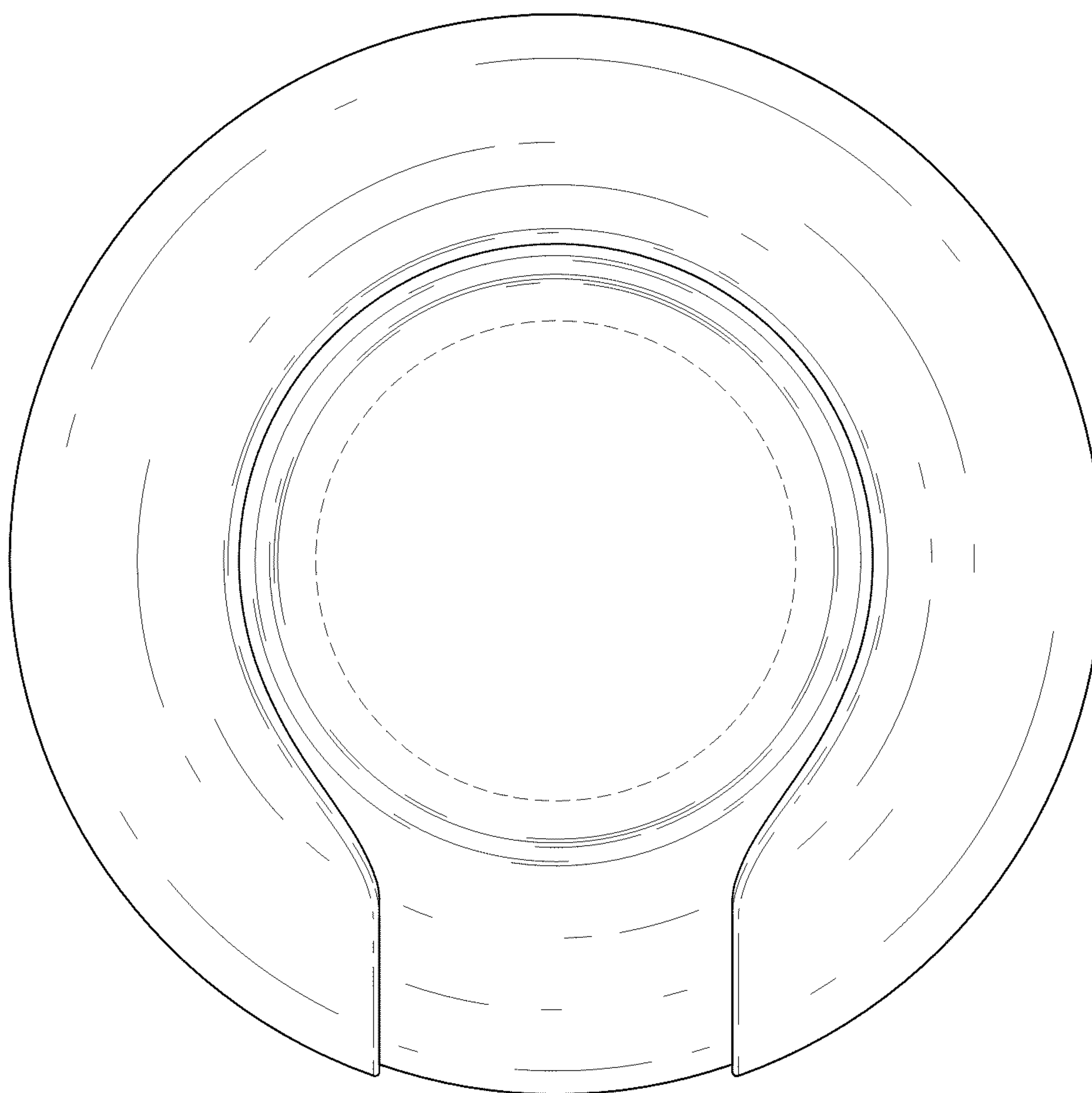

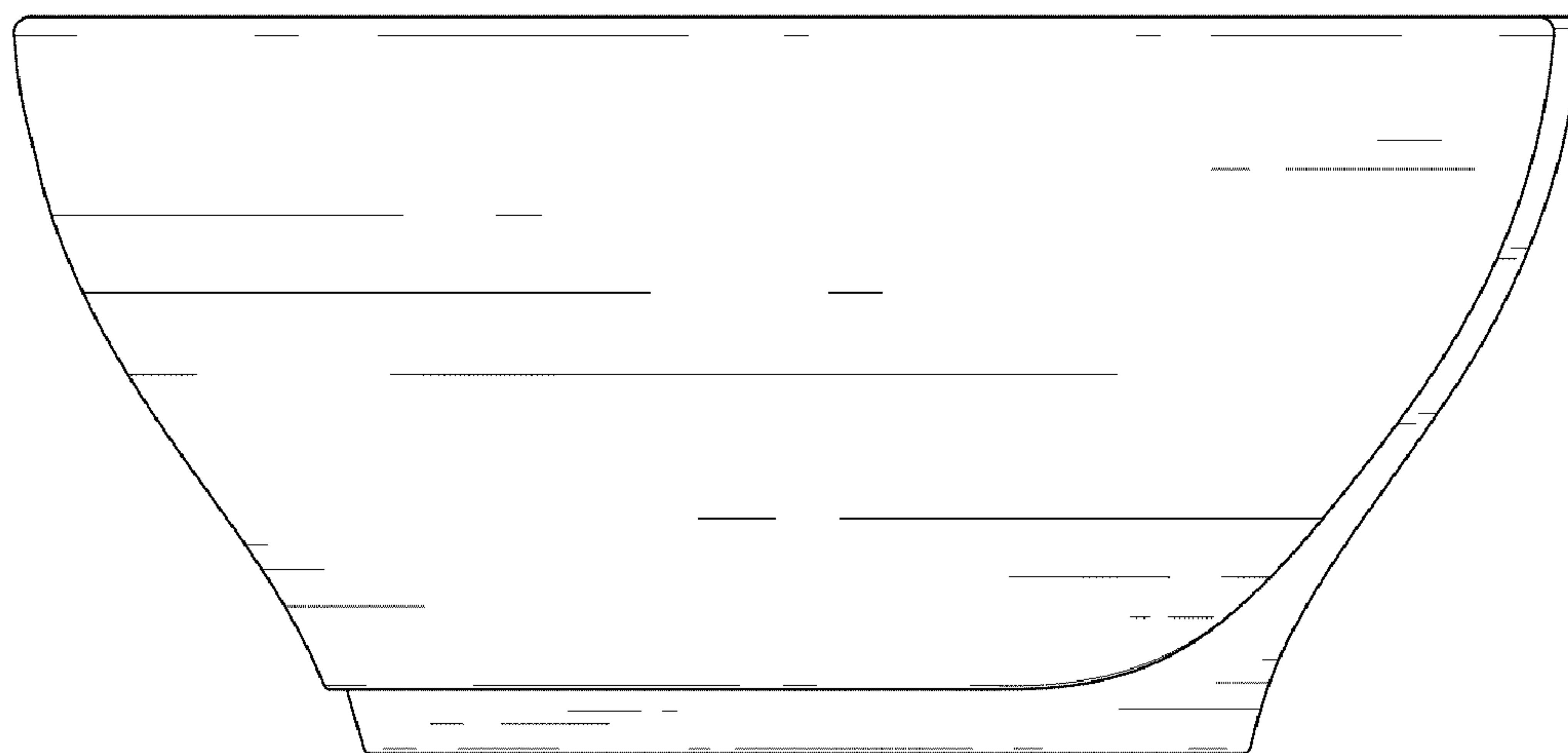

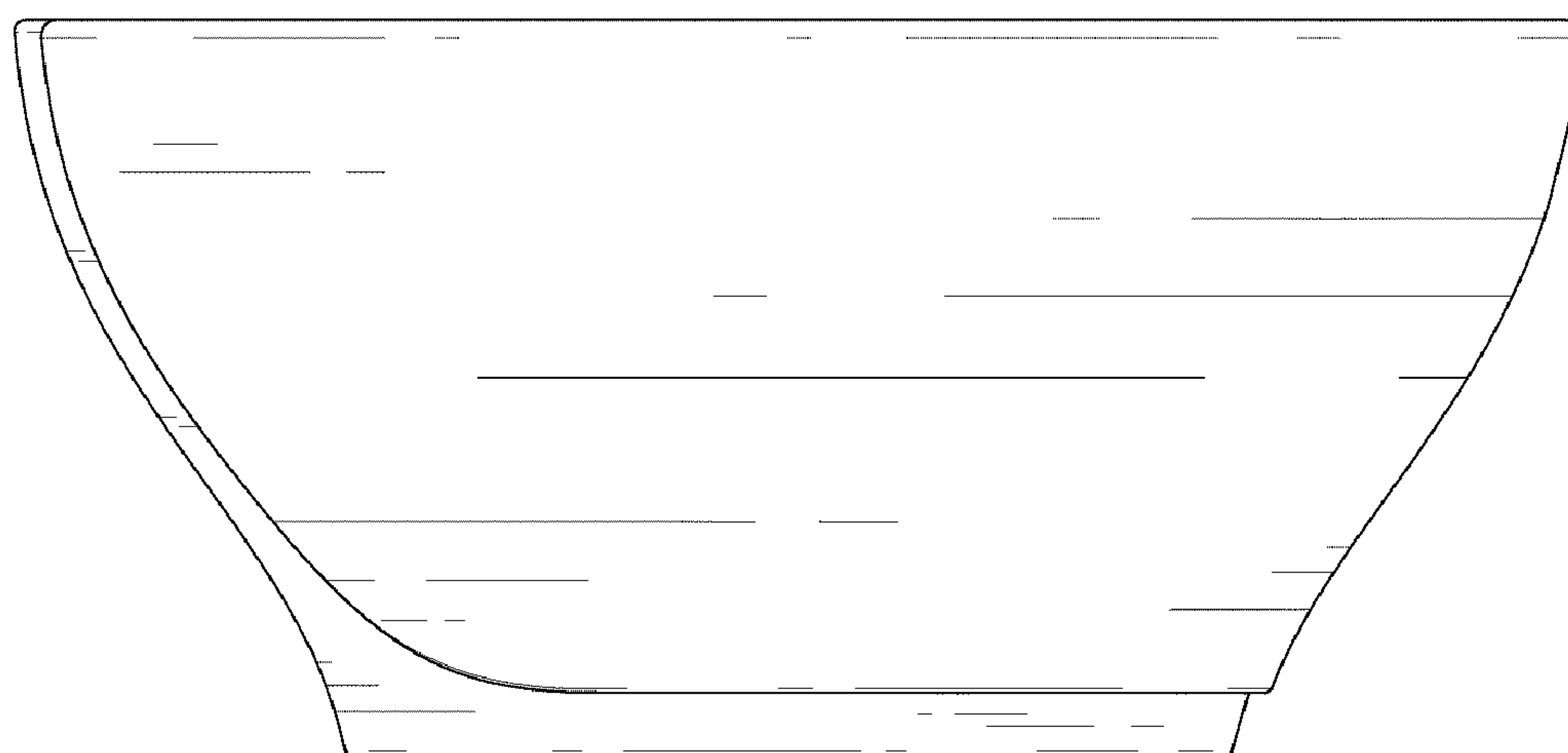
