(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a leaf ceiling fan blade, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a leaf ceiling fan blade, showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view with the bottom view being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a side view with the opposite side being a mirror image;

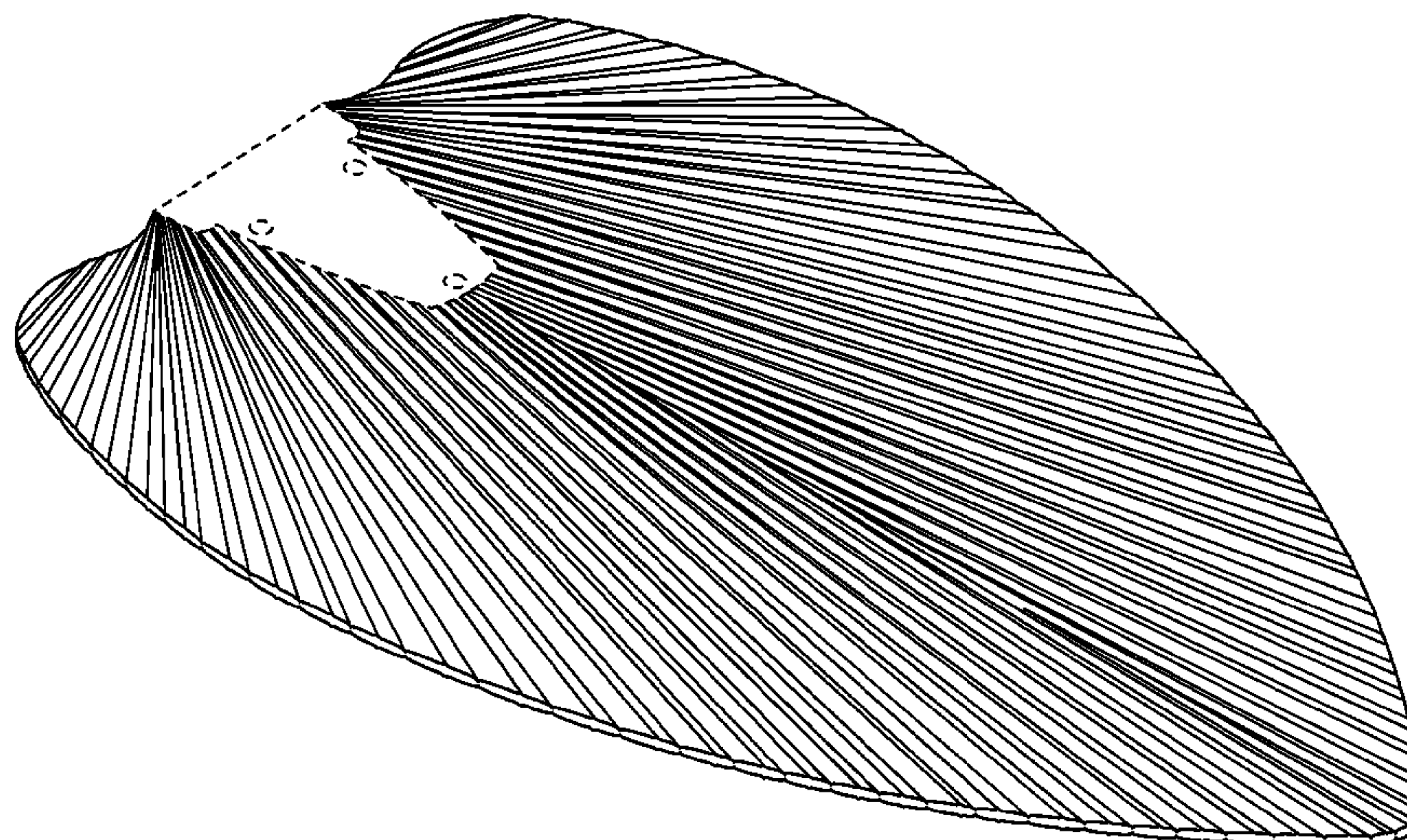
FIG. 4 is a front view;

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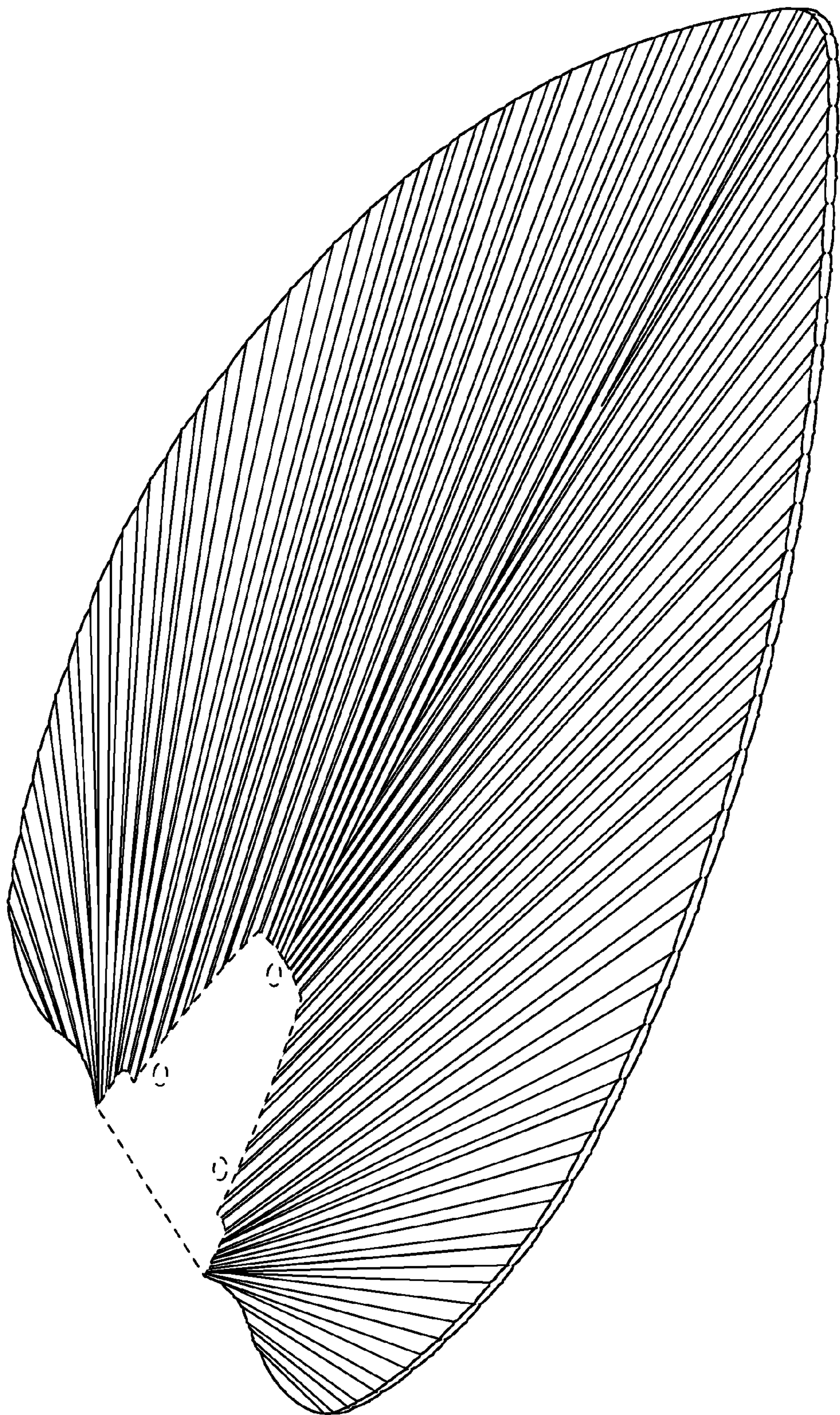

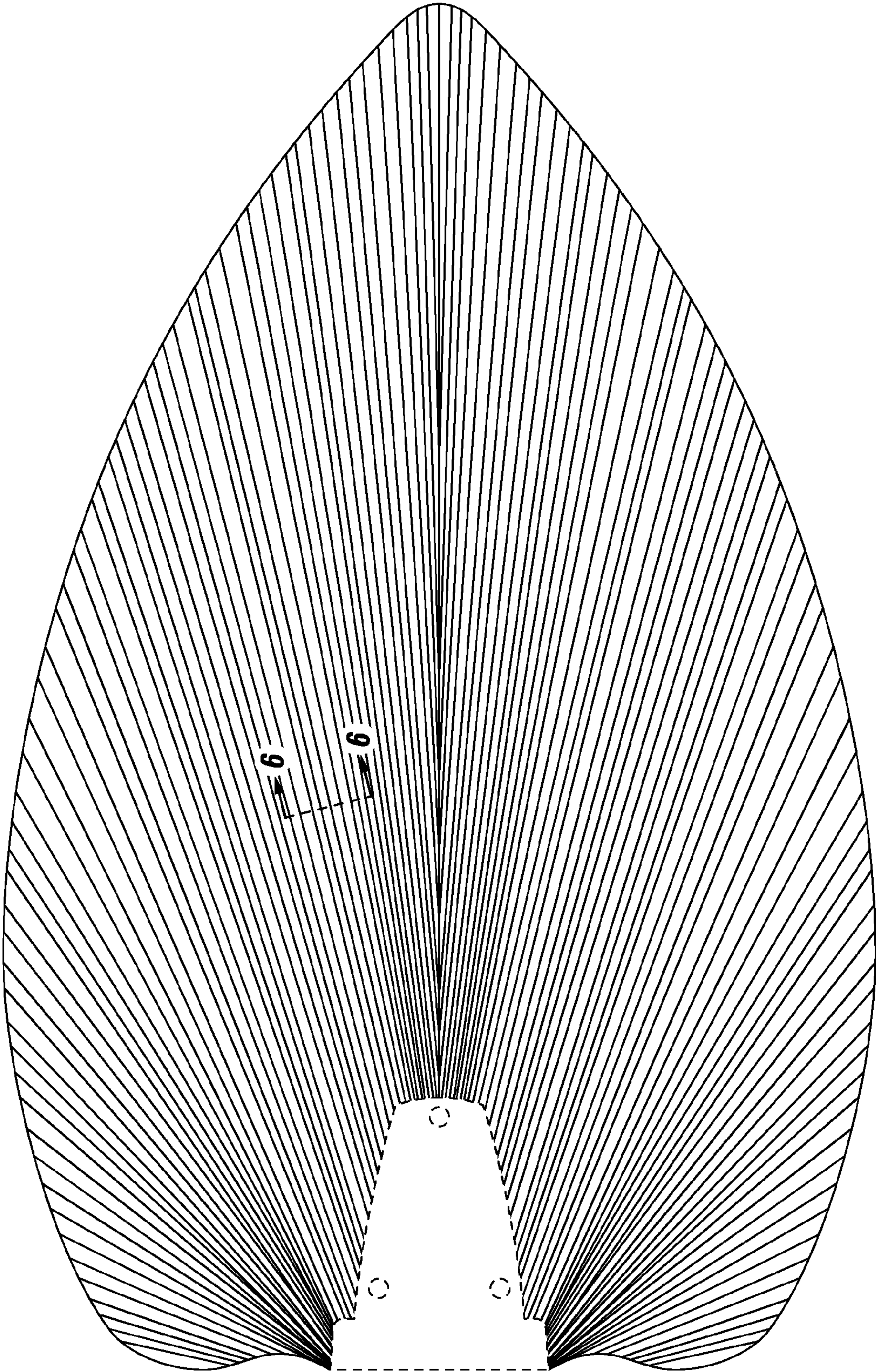

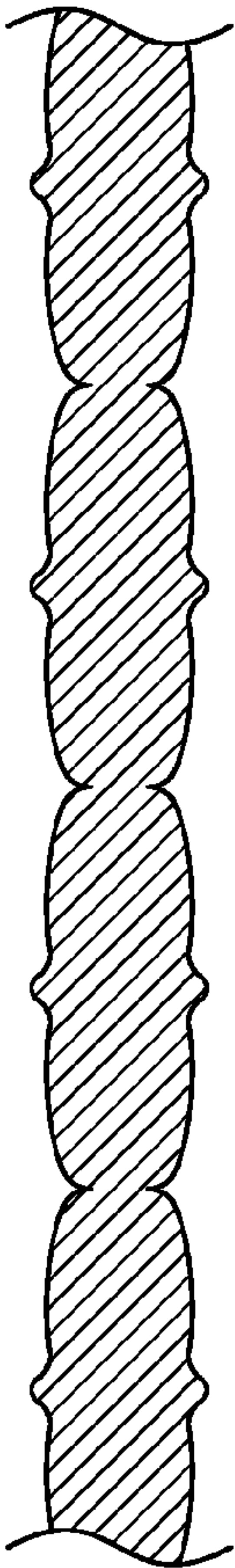
