FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 8;

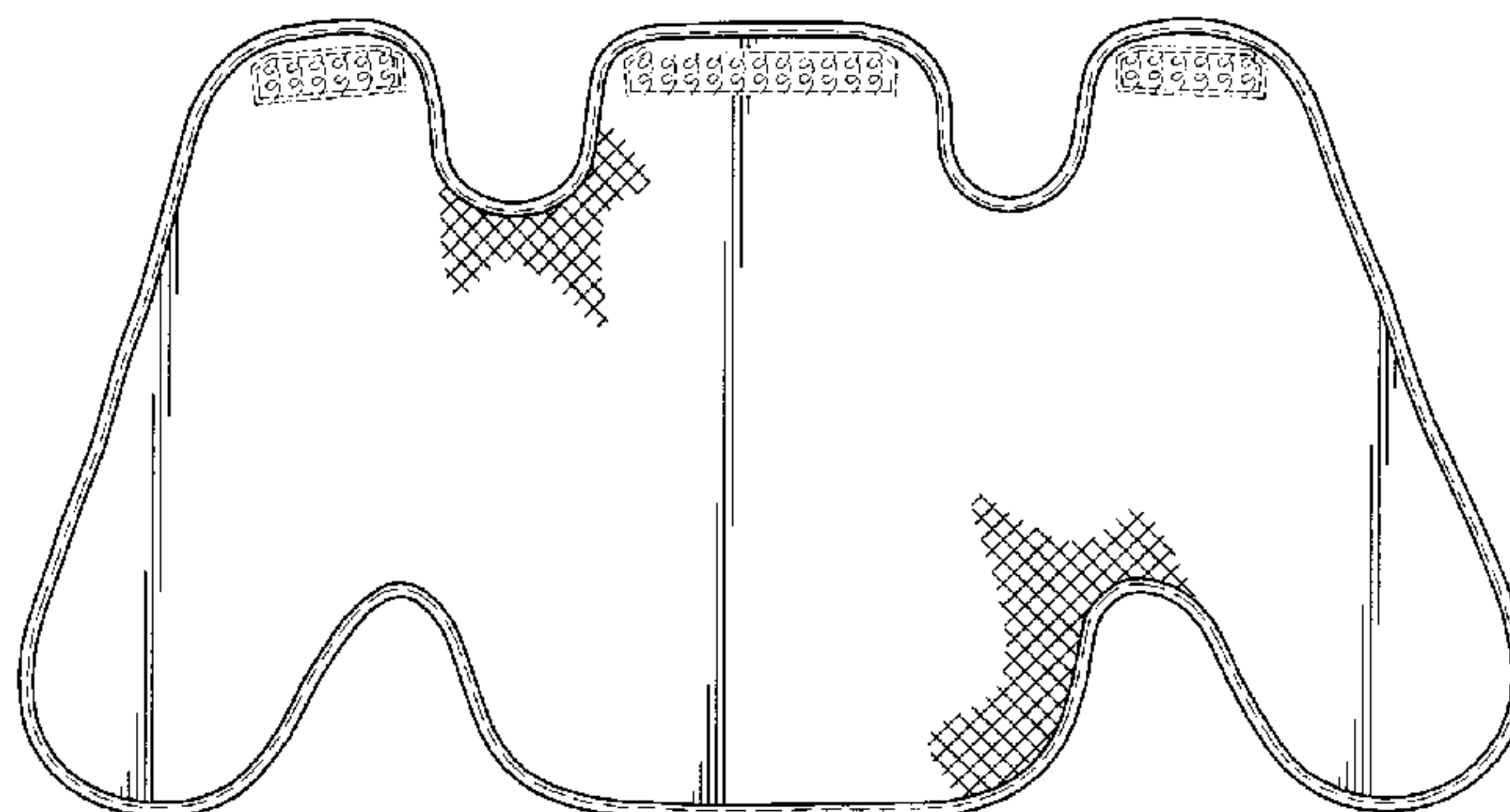
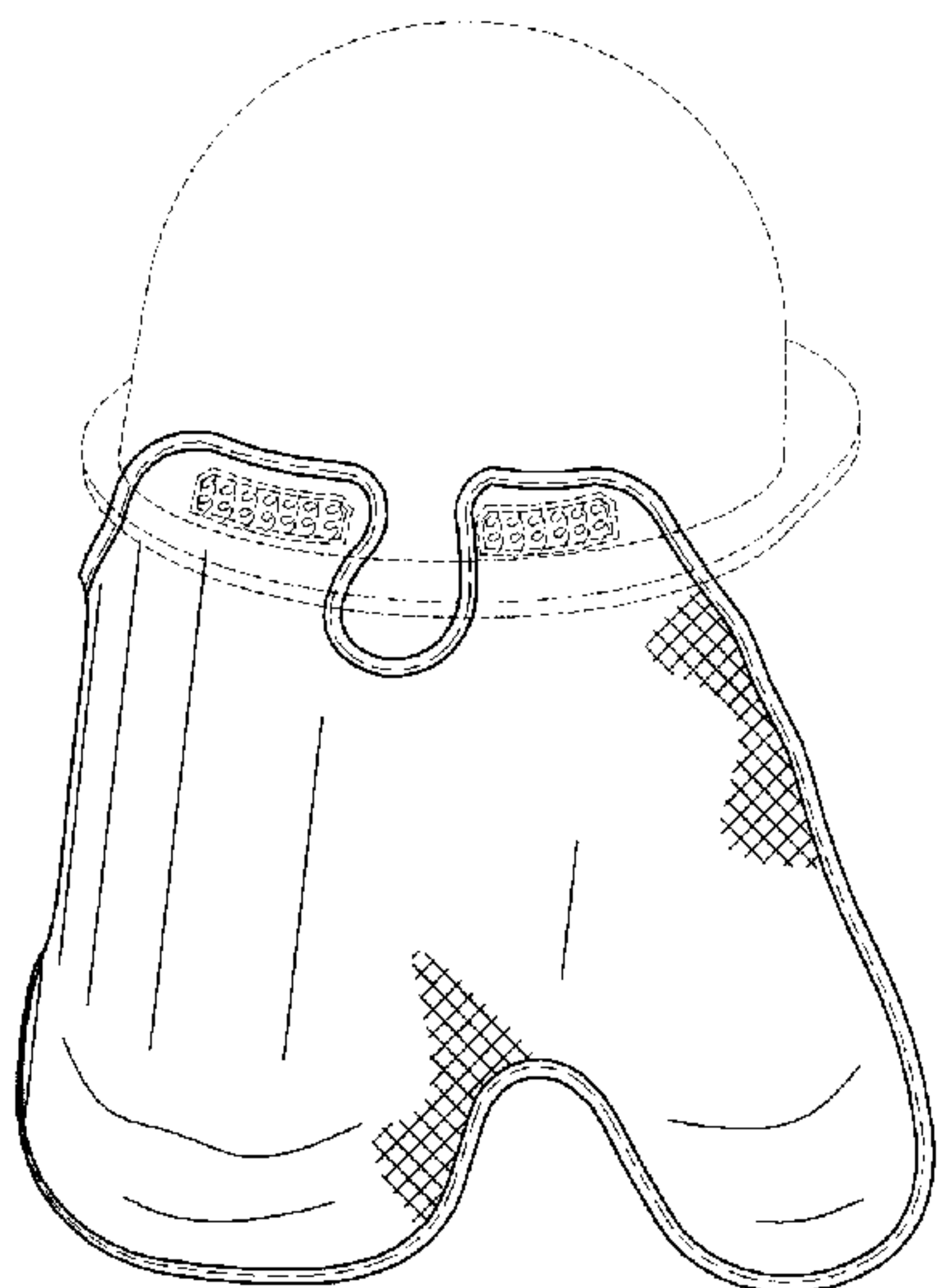
FIG. 11 is a side elevation view of FIG. 8;

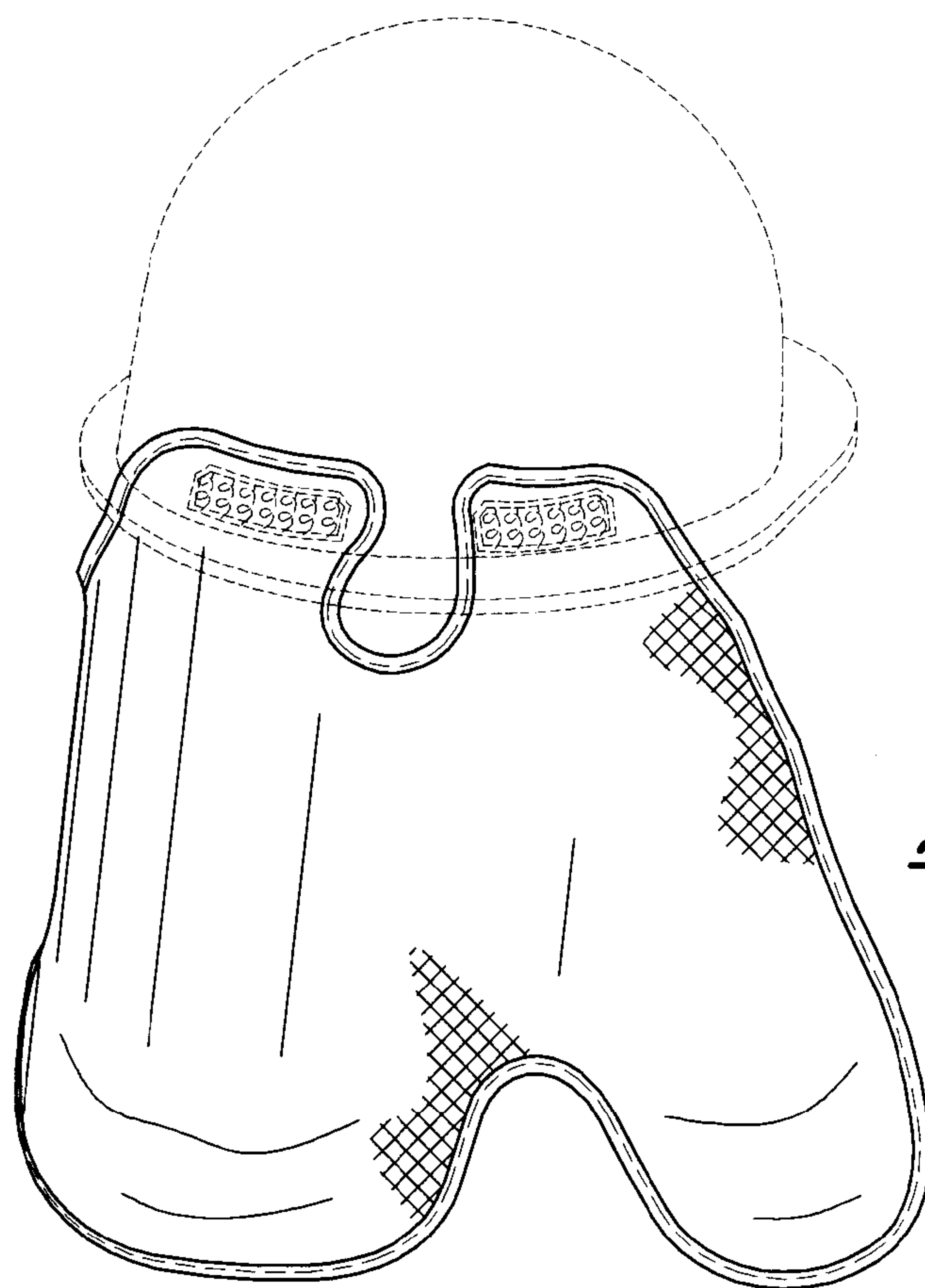

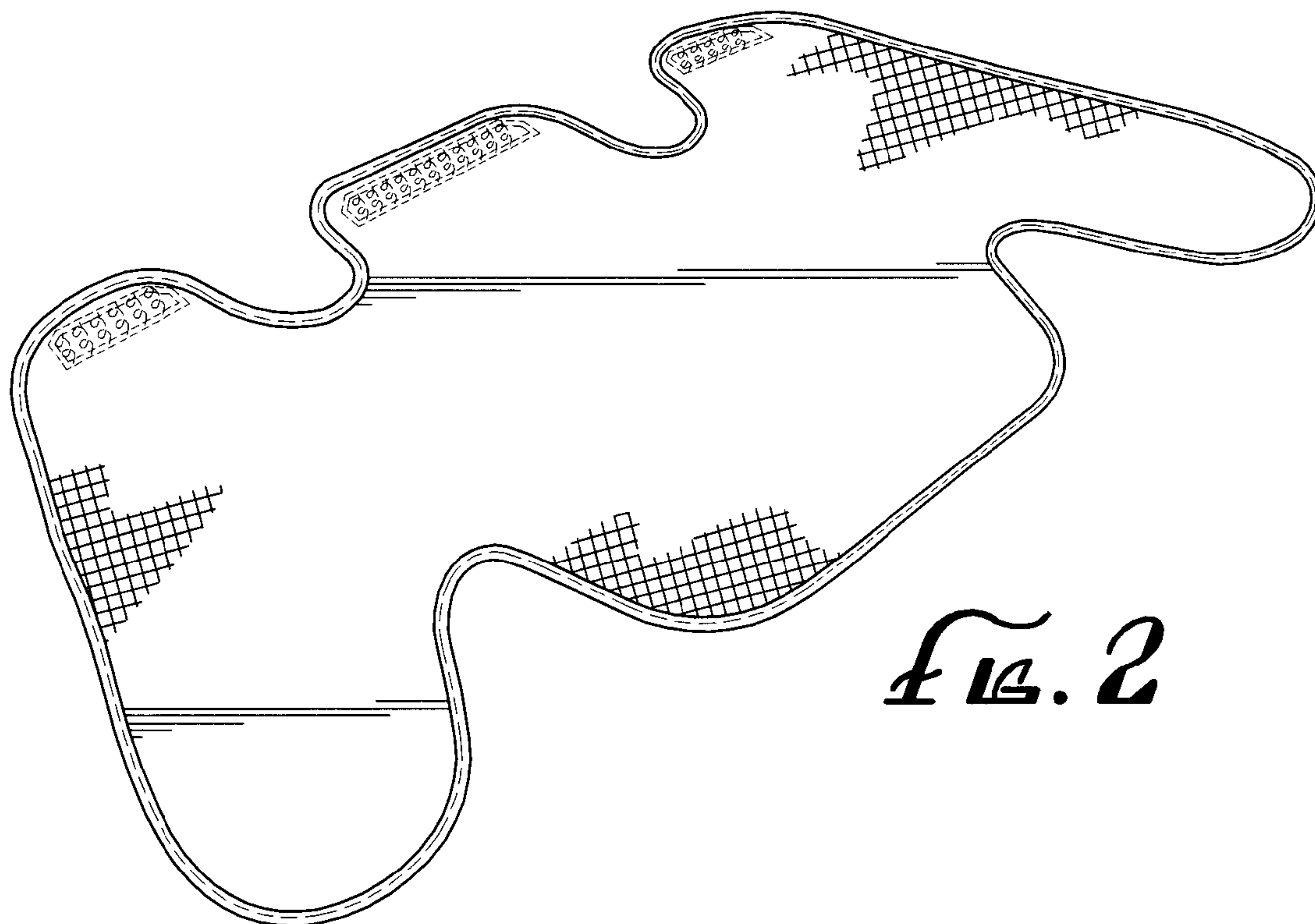

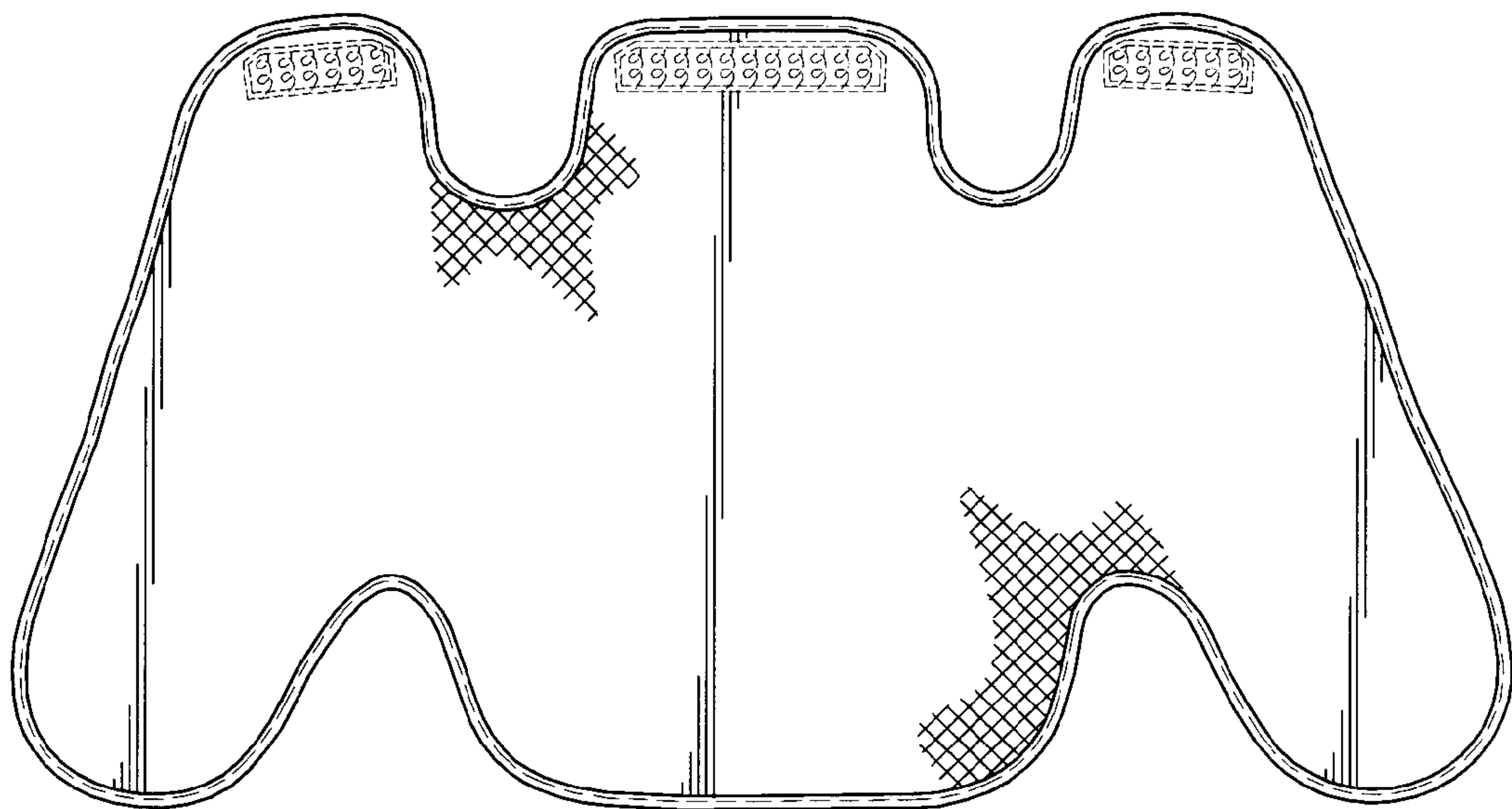

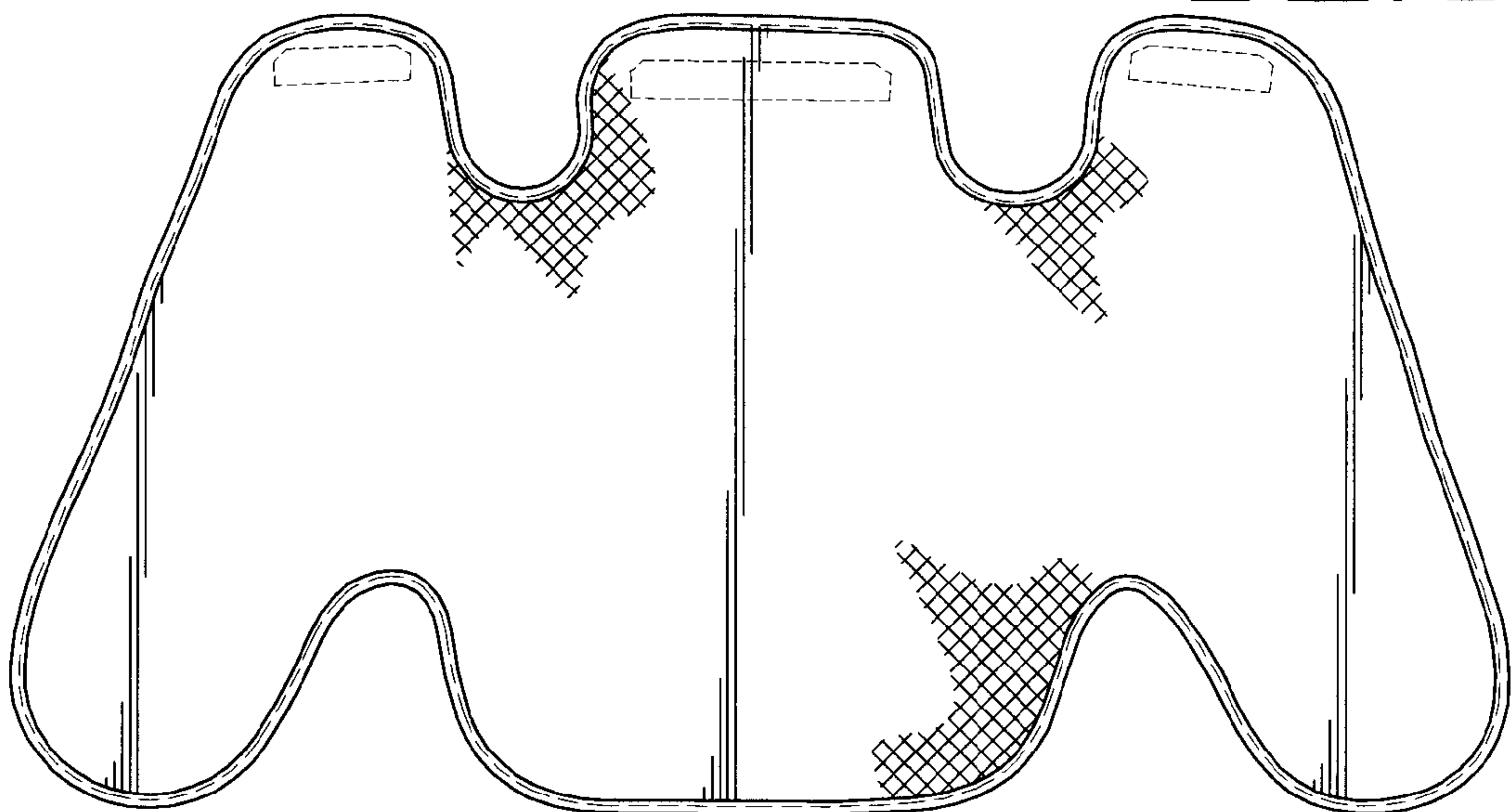

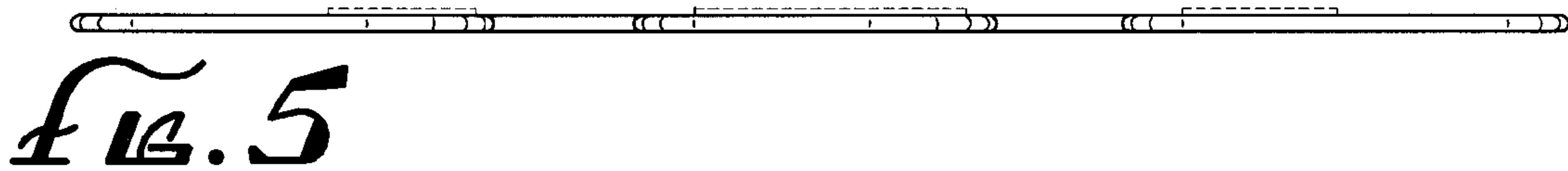

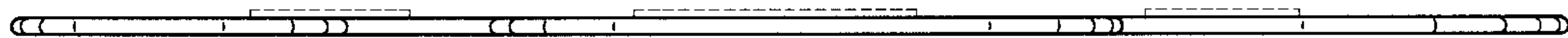

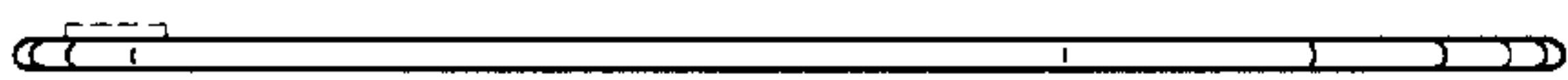

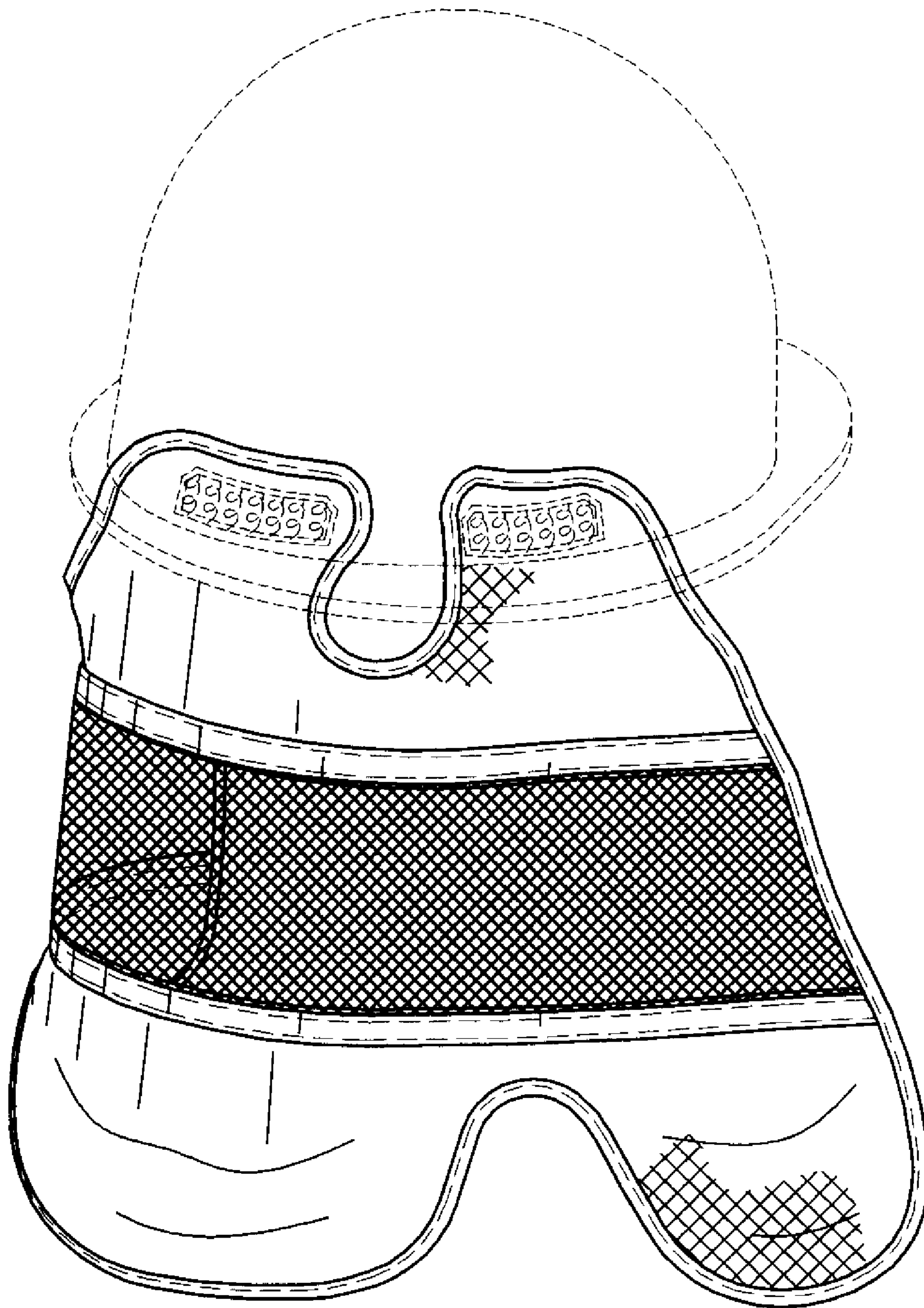

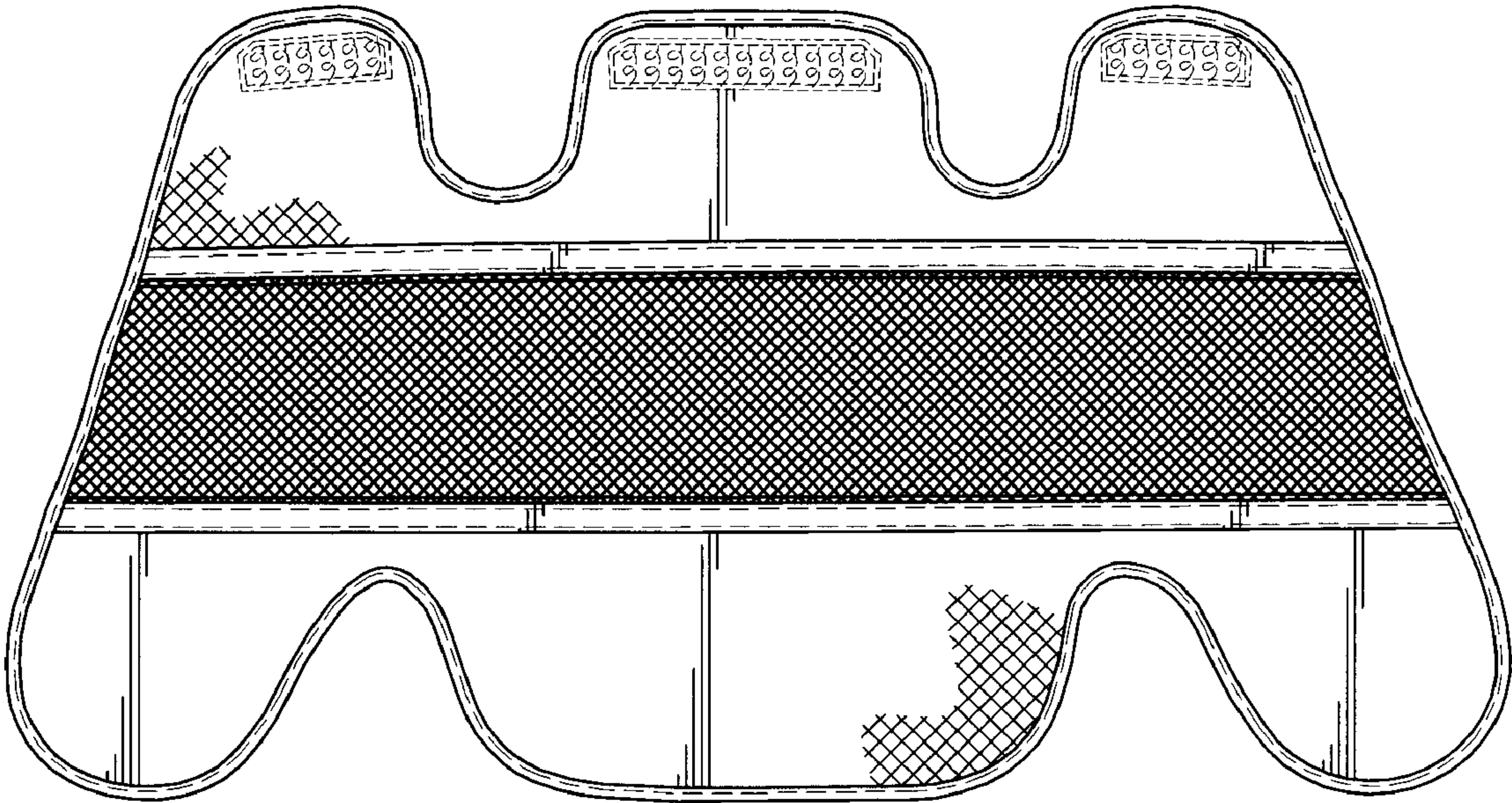

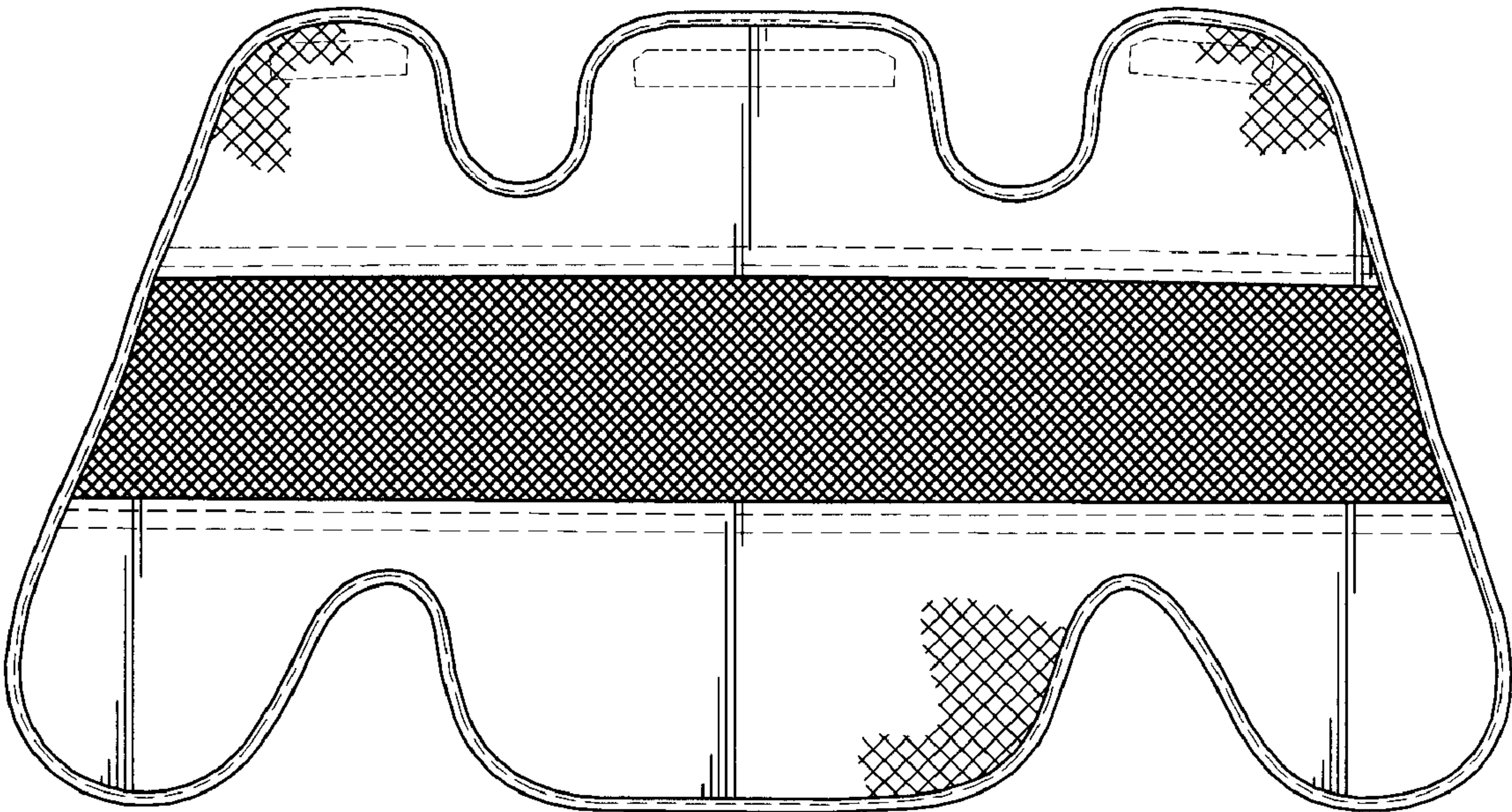

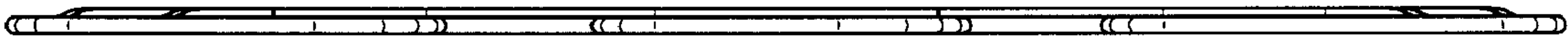

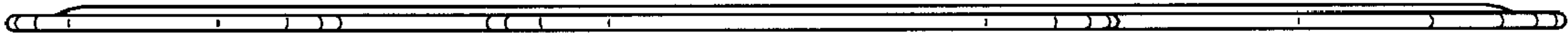

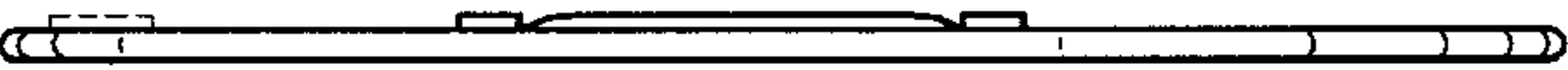
