#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a table support embodying our design including a broken line showing of a table top for mounting thereon;

FIG. 2 is a side perspective view of a table support embodying our design;

FIG. **3** is a top view thereof; and,

FIG. **4** is a front view thereof, views of the table support defined at directions labeled A and B in FIG. **3** being an identical image thereof.

The broken line showing of a table top in FIG. 1 forms no part of the claimed design. The broken line showing whereat the support legs join each other forms no part of the claimed design.
