FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof;

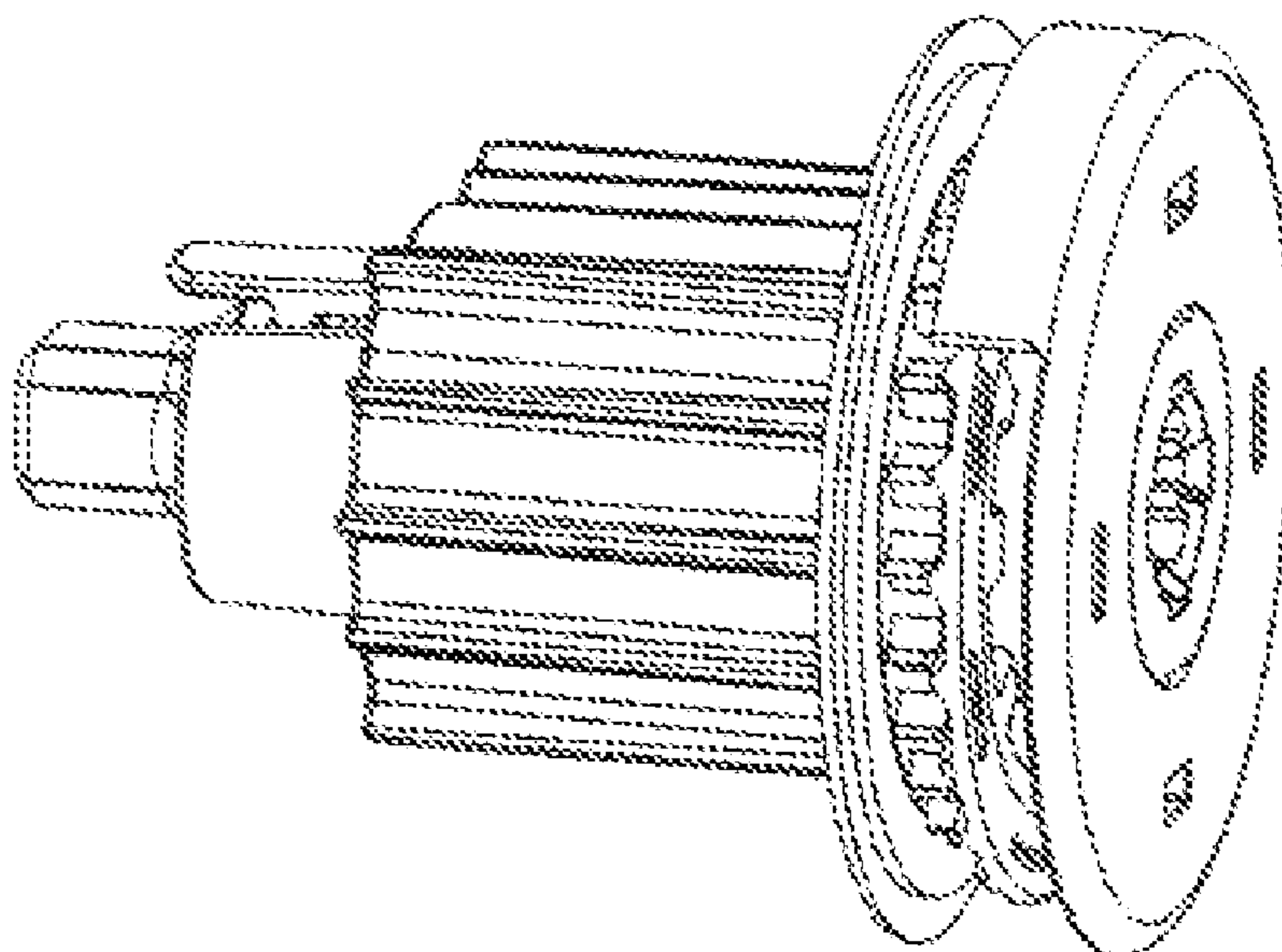
FIG. 7 is a first perspective view;

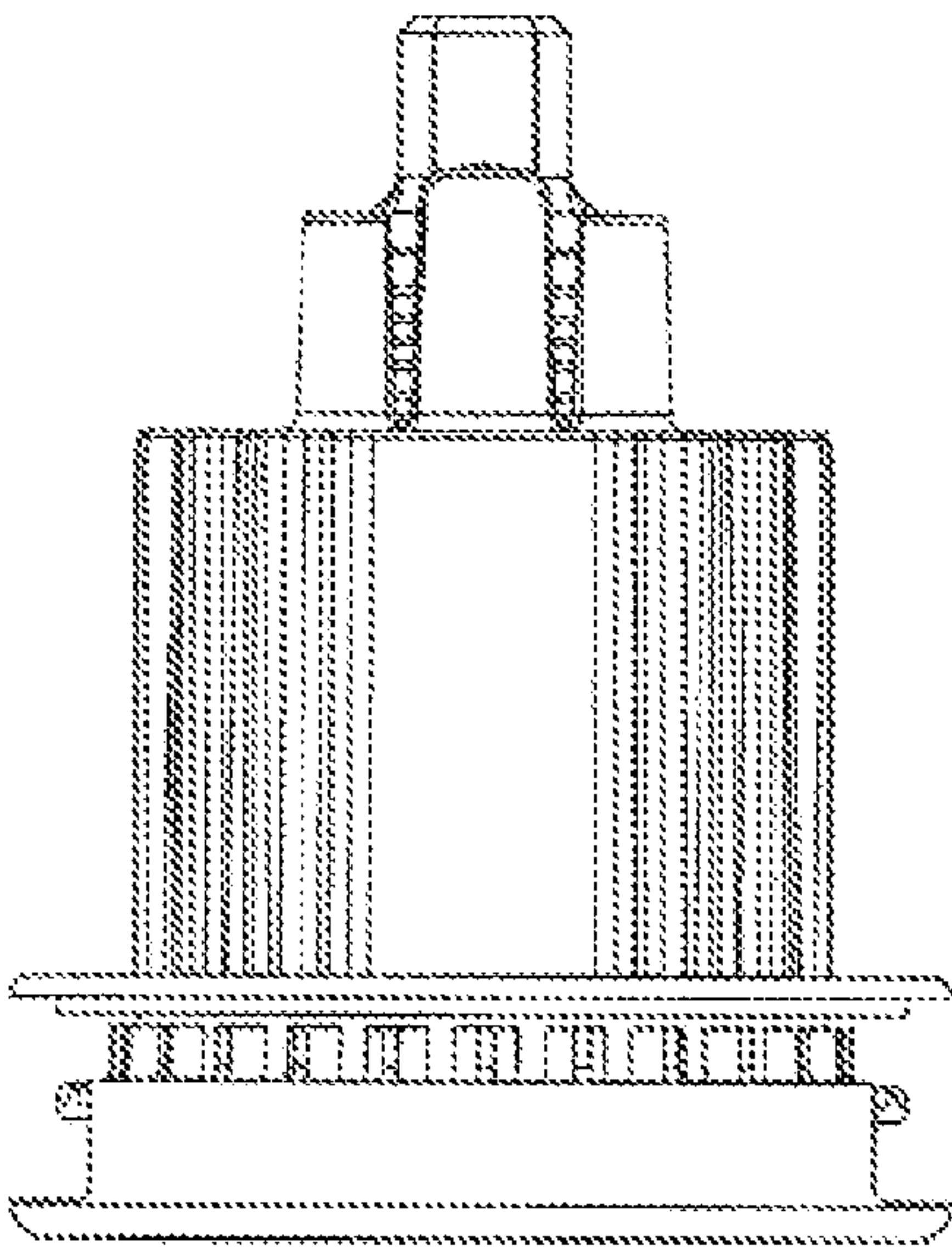

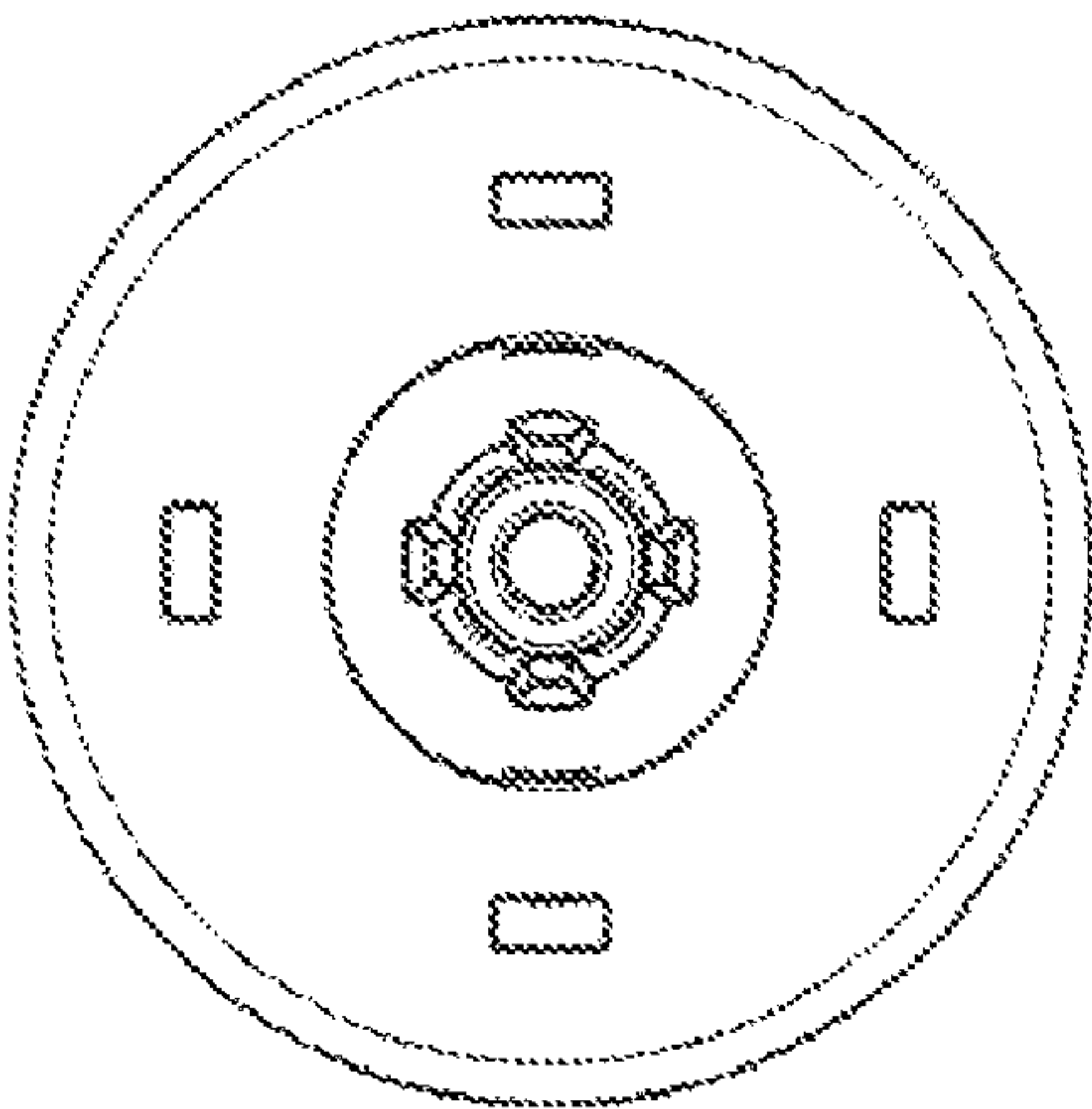

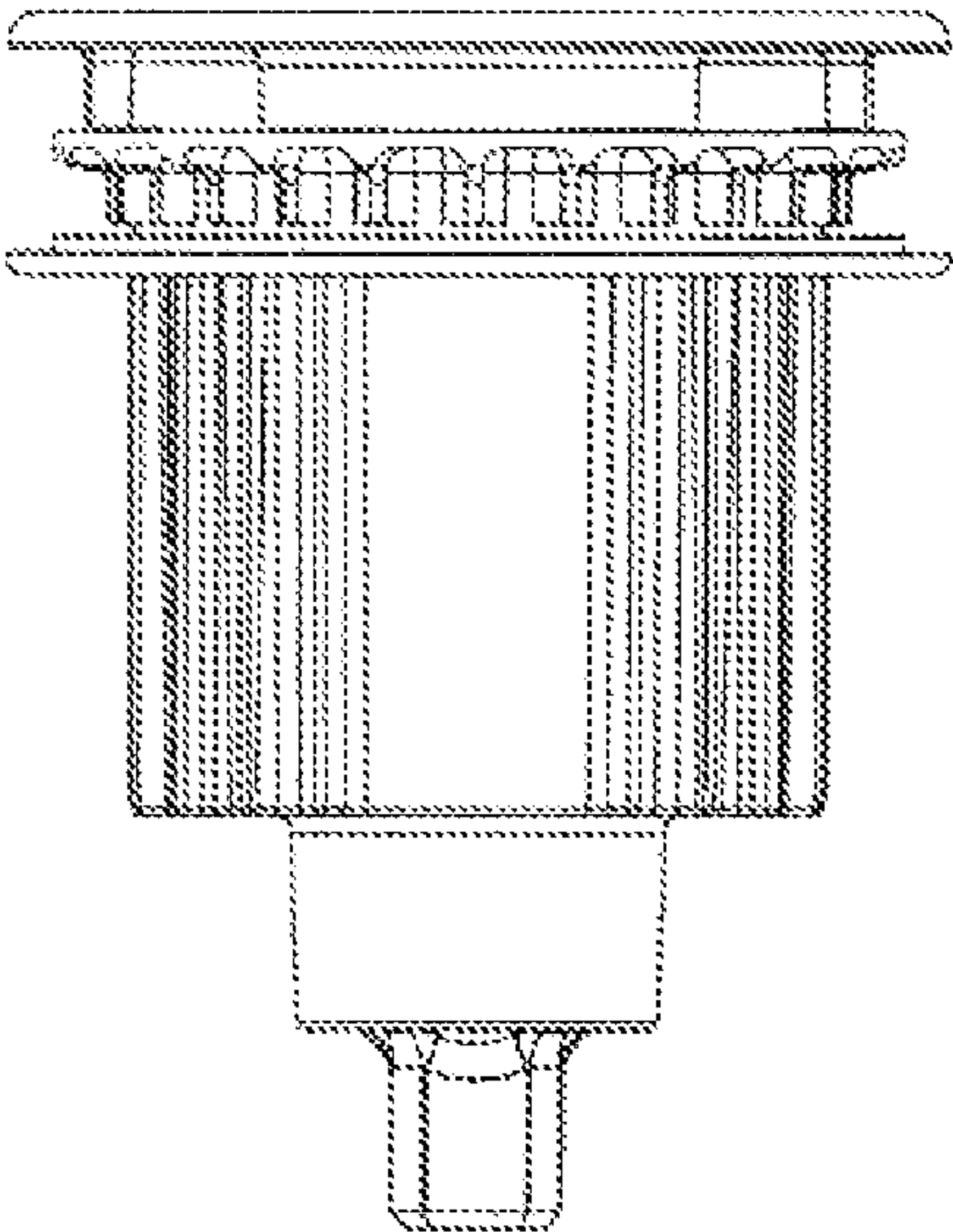

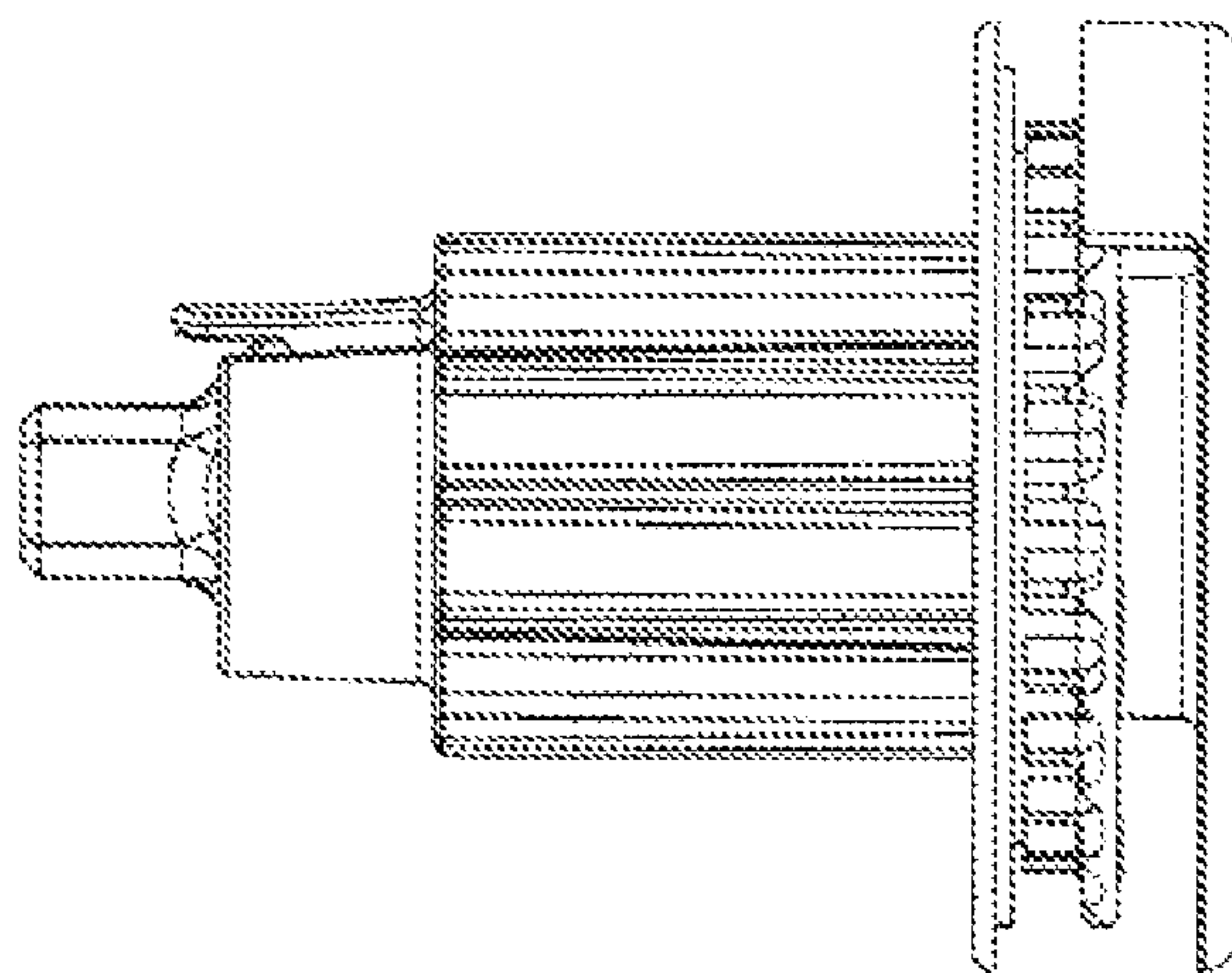

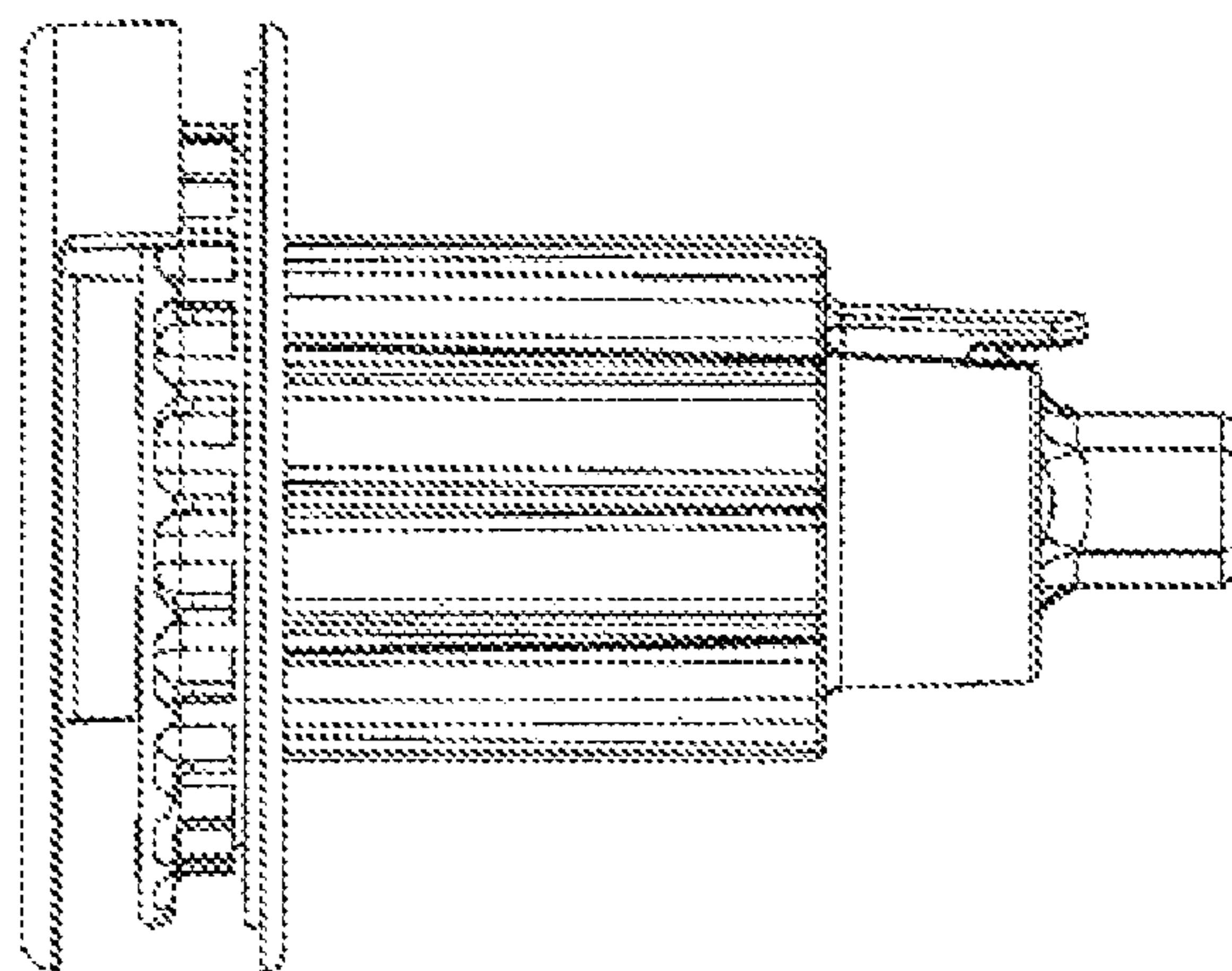

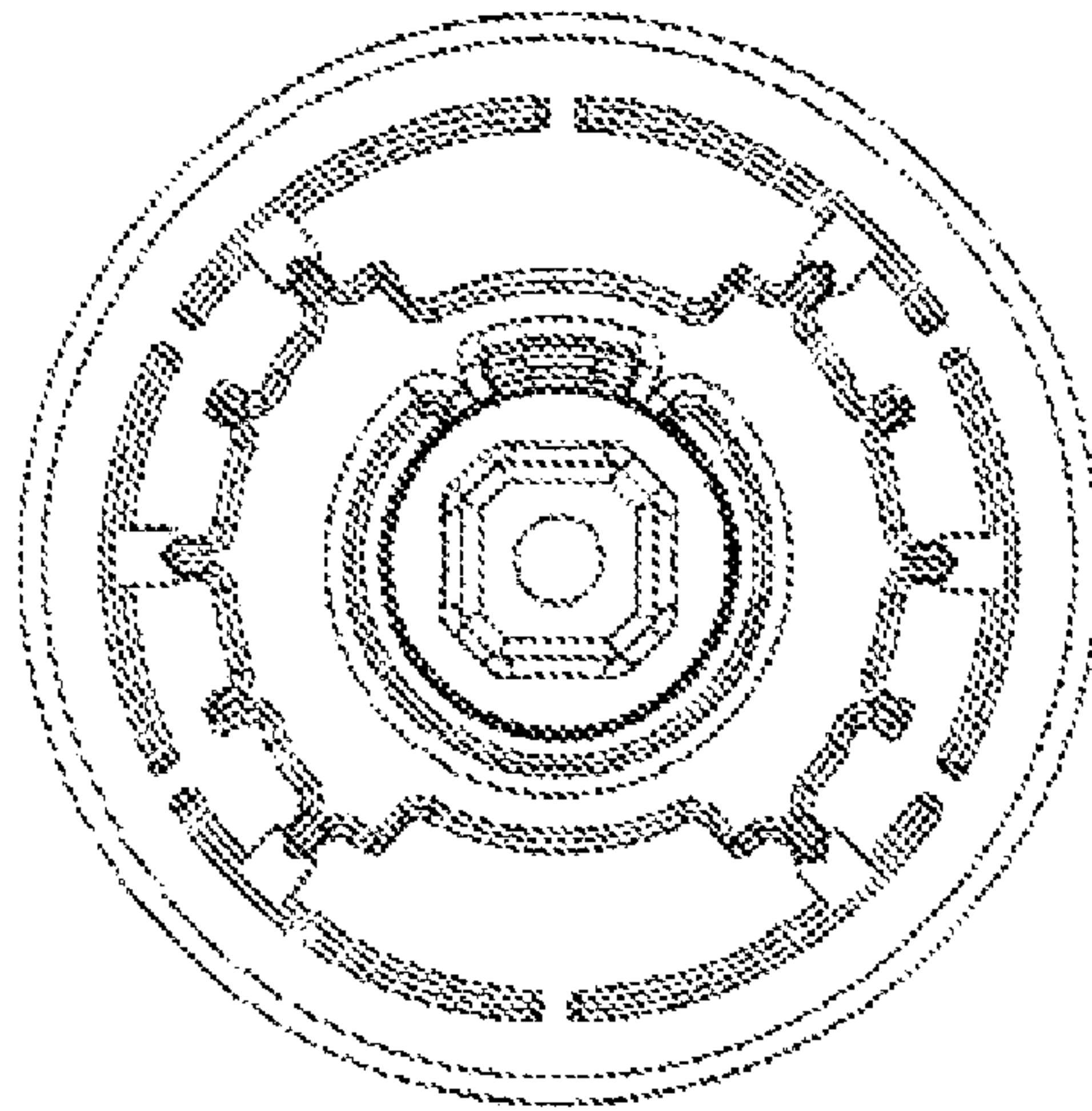

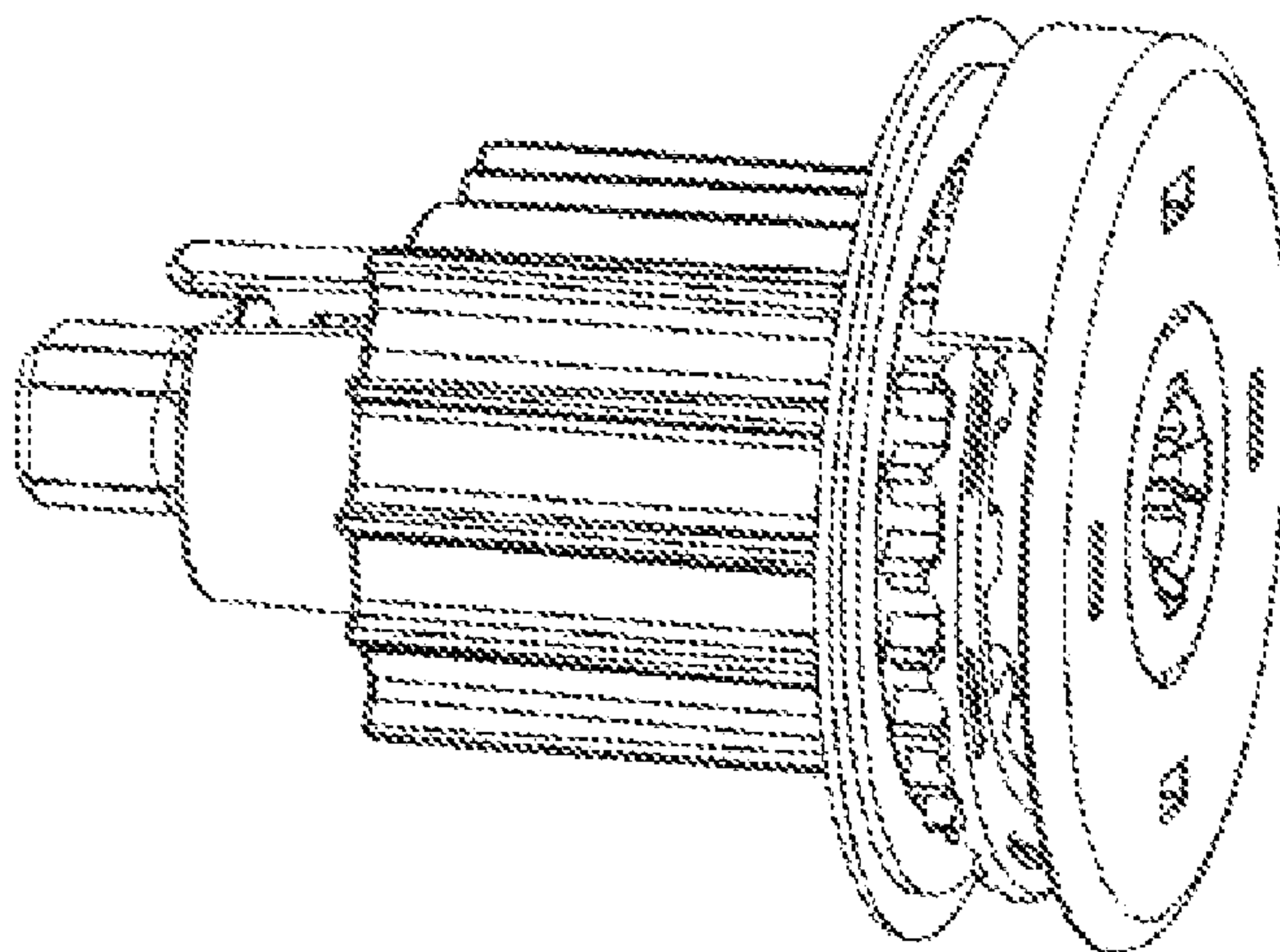

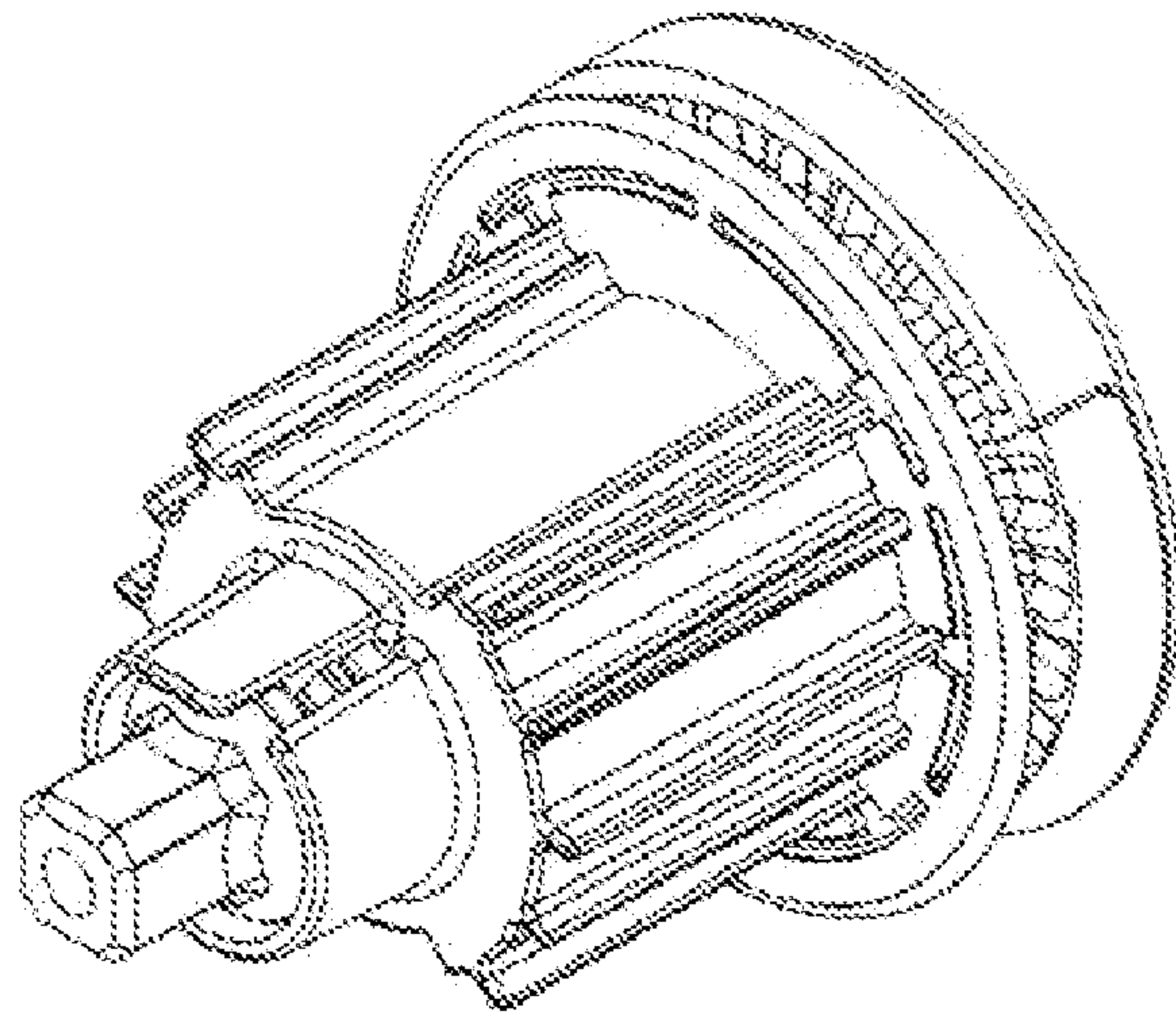

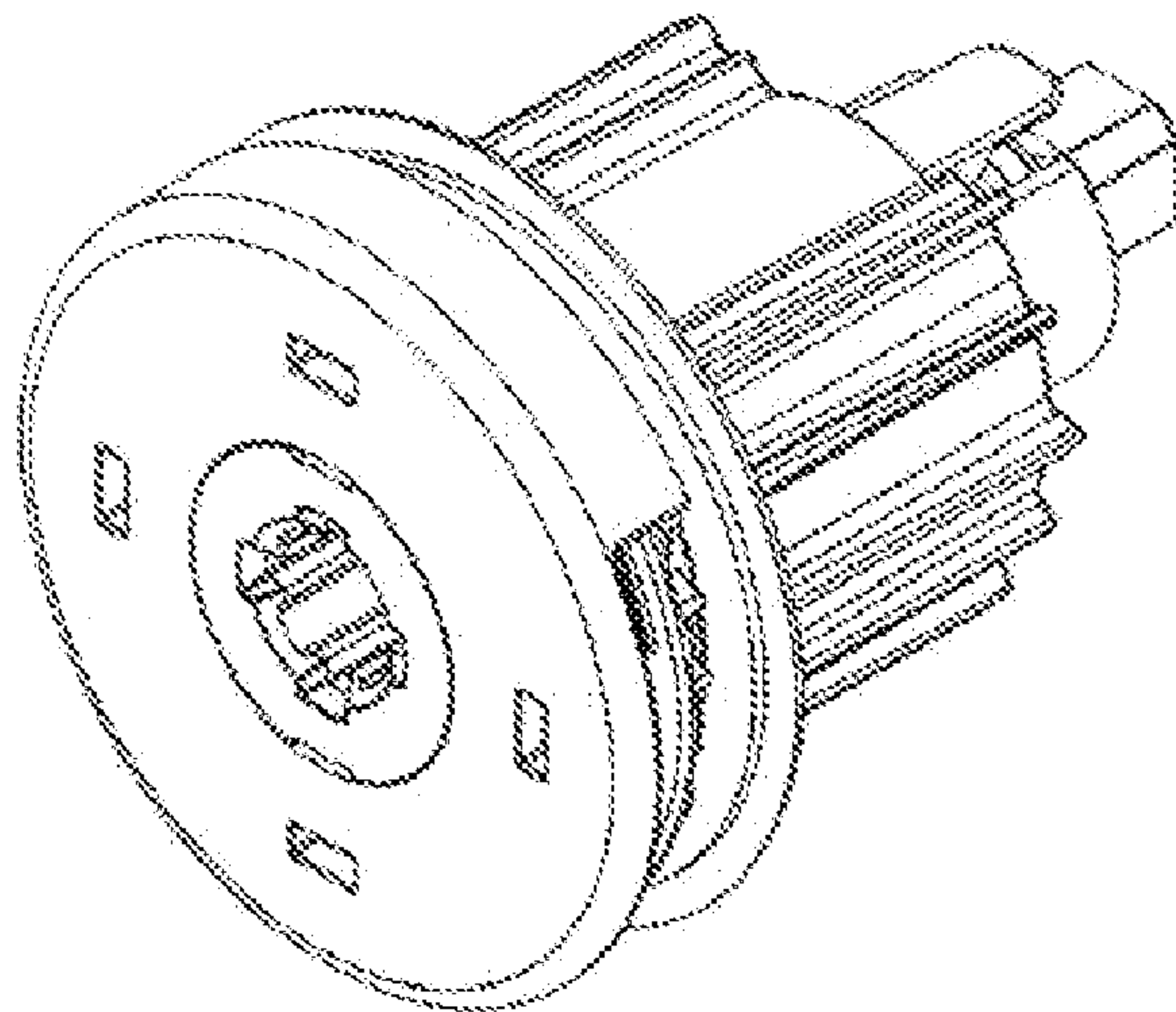
