(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a turkey decoy having multiple heads, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the turkey decoy having multiple heads with feathers and beard illustrated in phantom;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the turkey decoy illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the turkey decoy illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a first side elevational view of the turkey decoy illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a first side elevational view of the turkey decoy illustrated in FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a second side elevational view of the turkey decoy illustrated in FIG. 1;

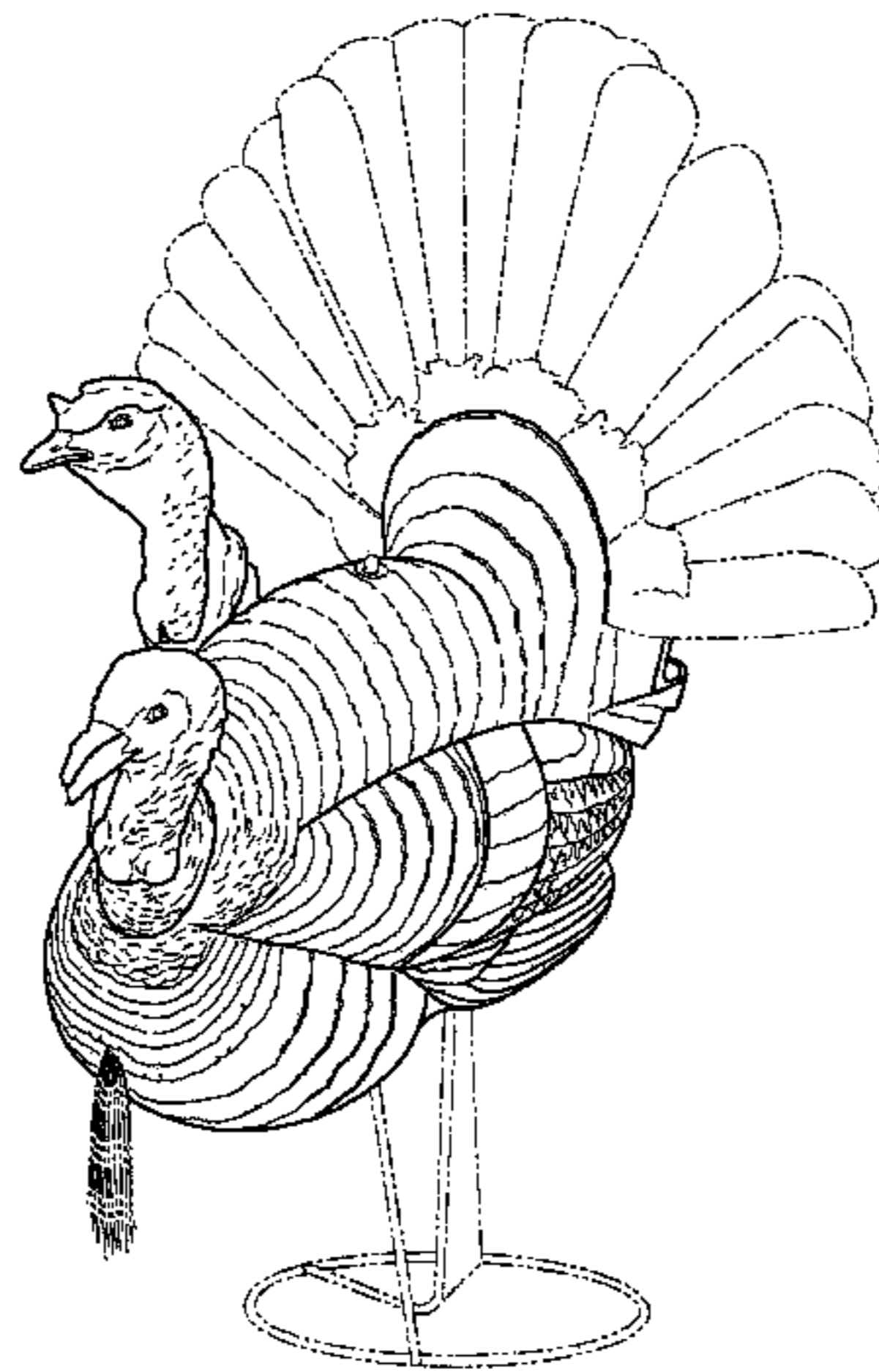


FIG. 7 is a second side elevational view of the turkey decoy illustrated in FIG. 2;

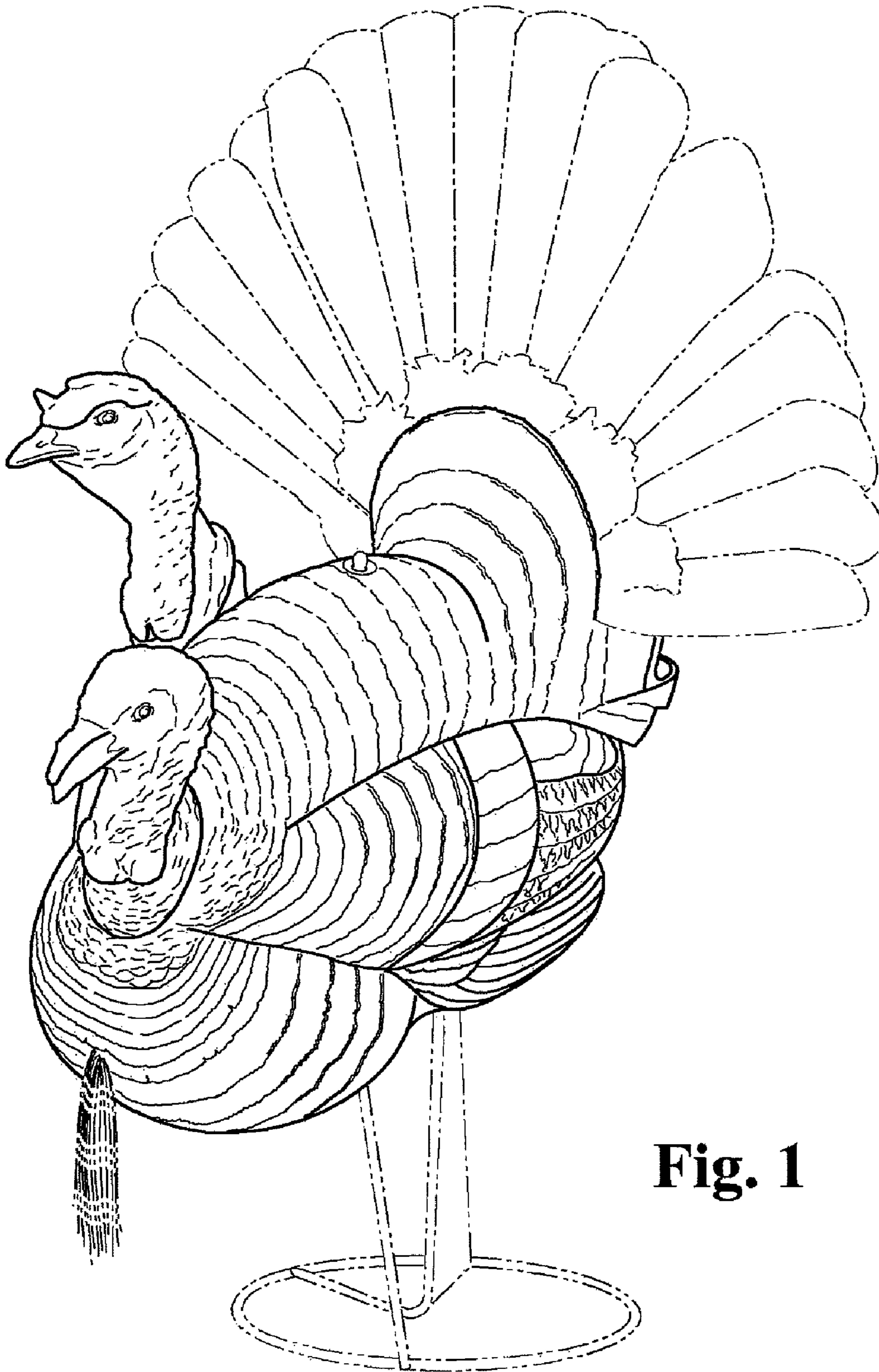

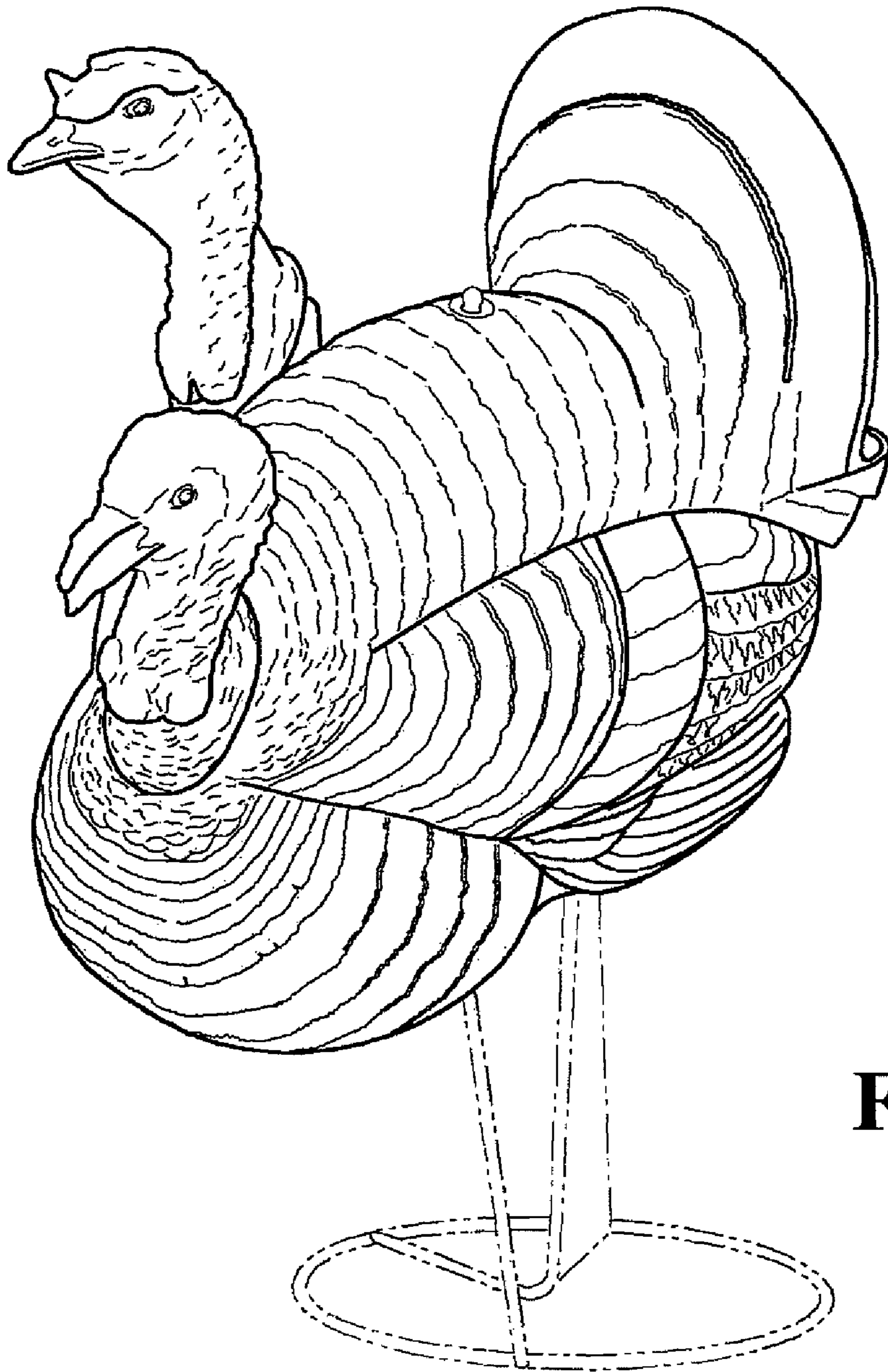

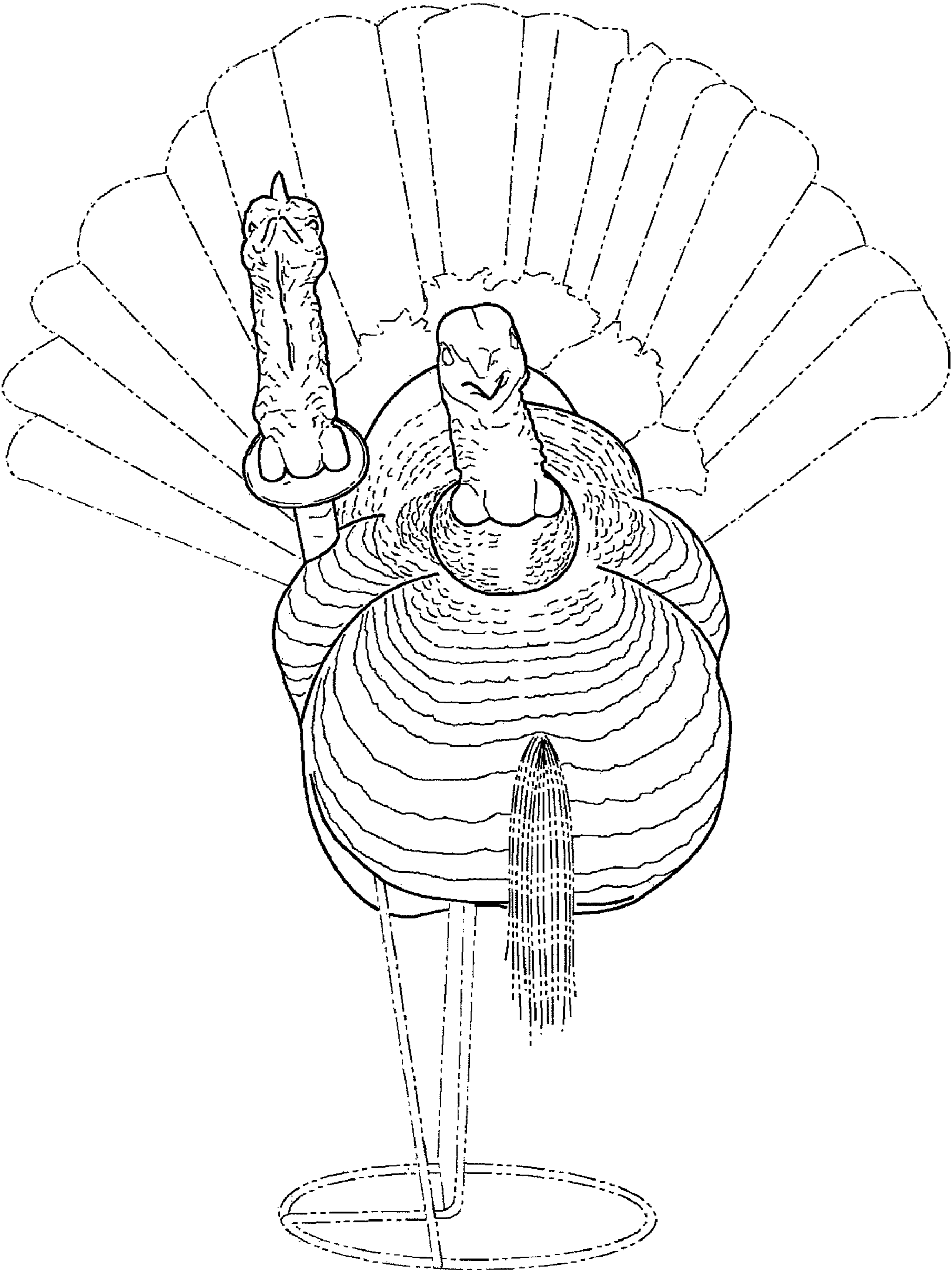

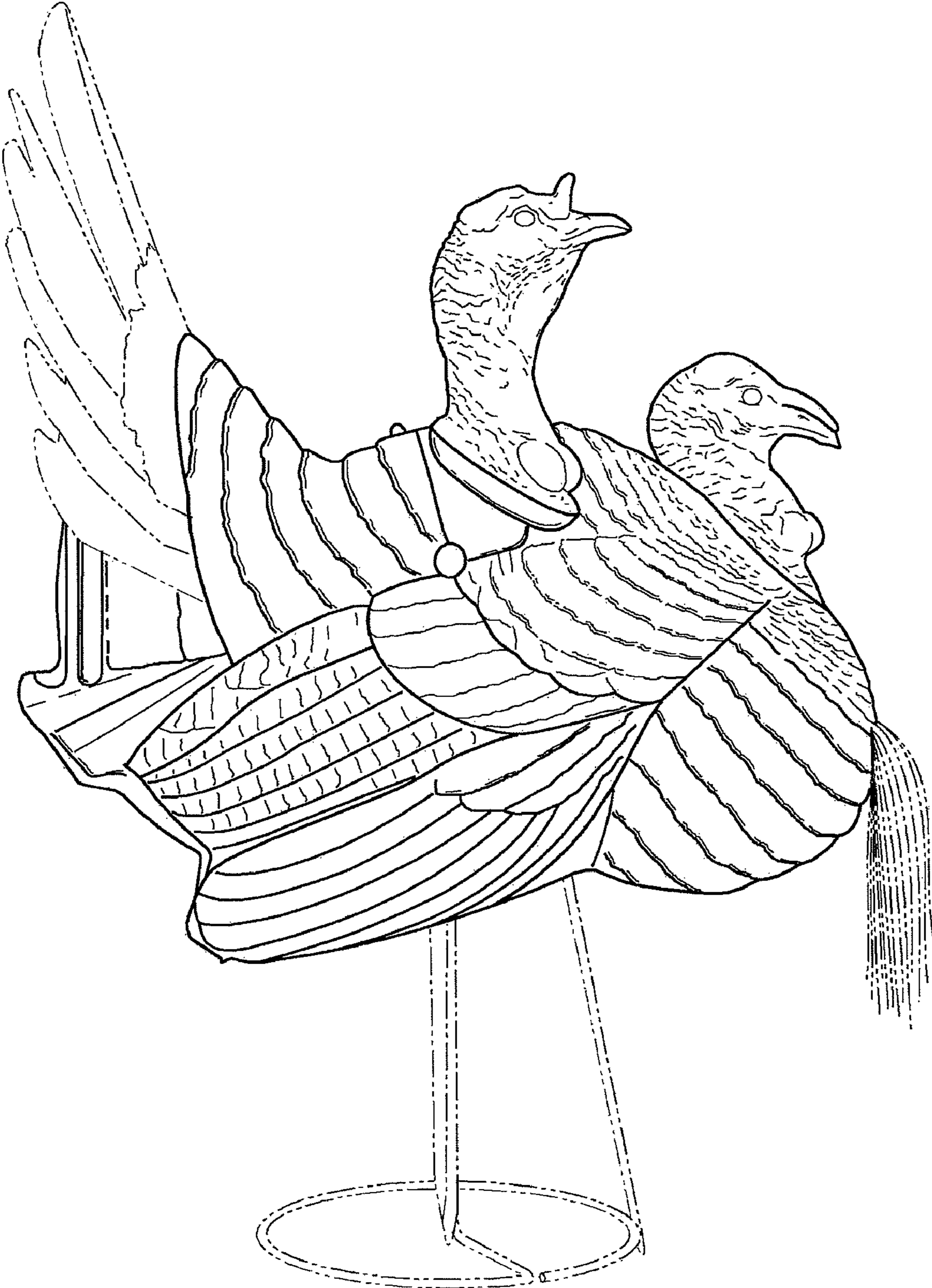

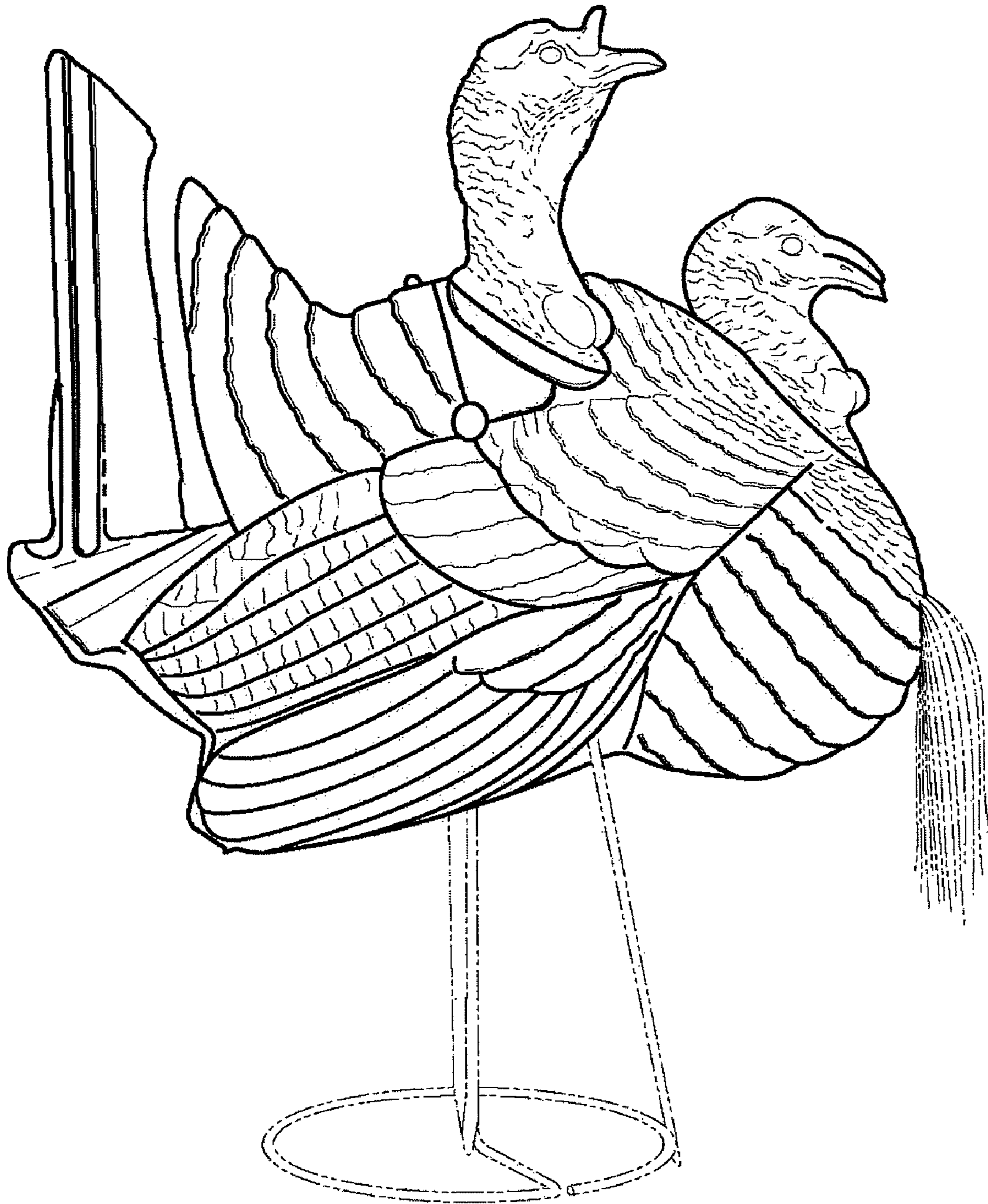

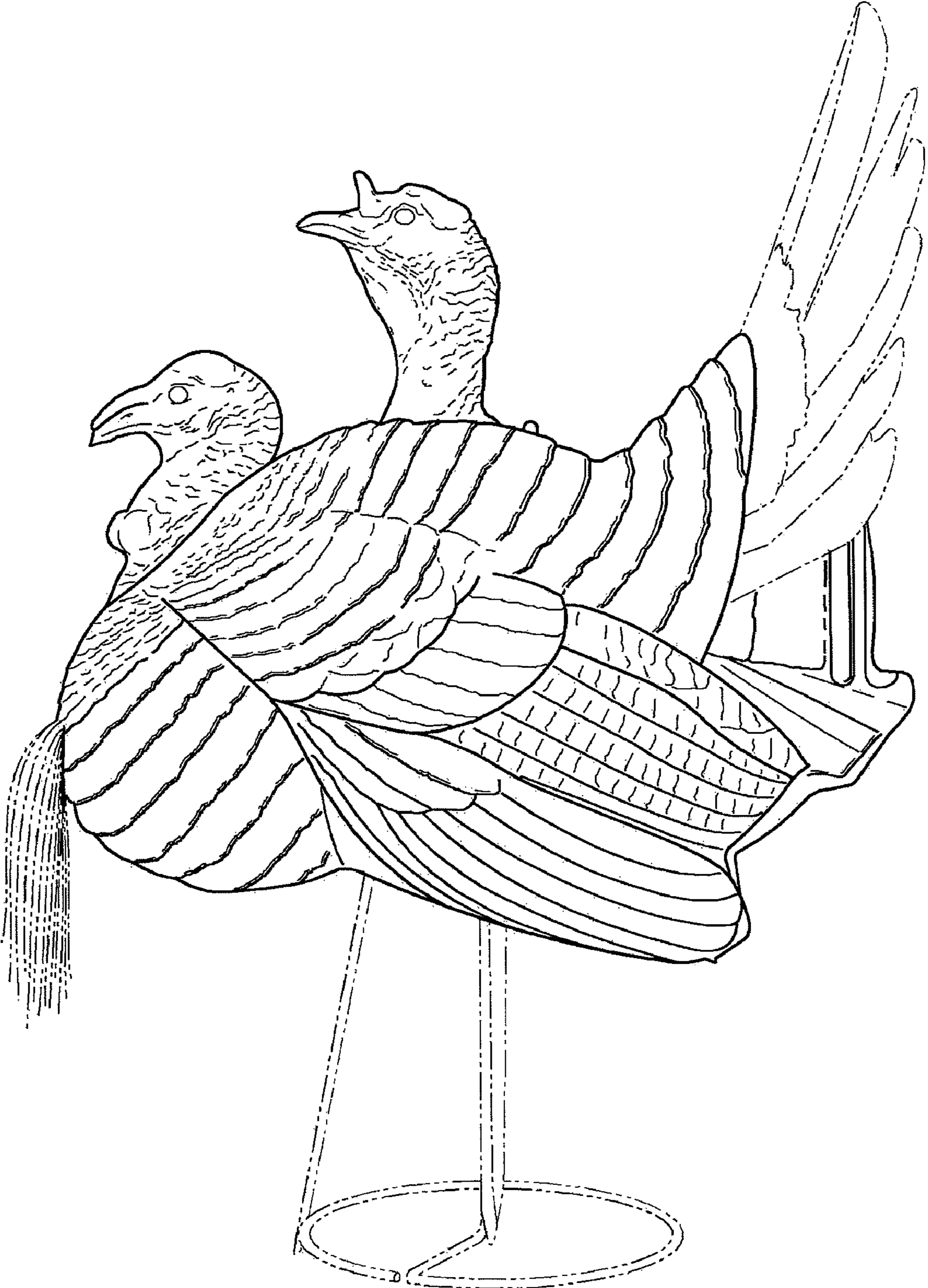

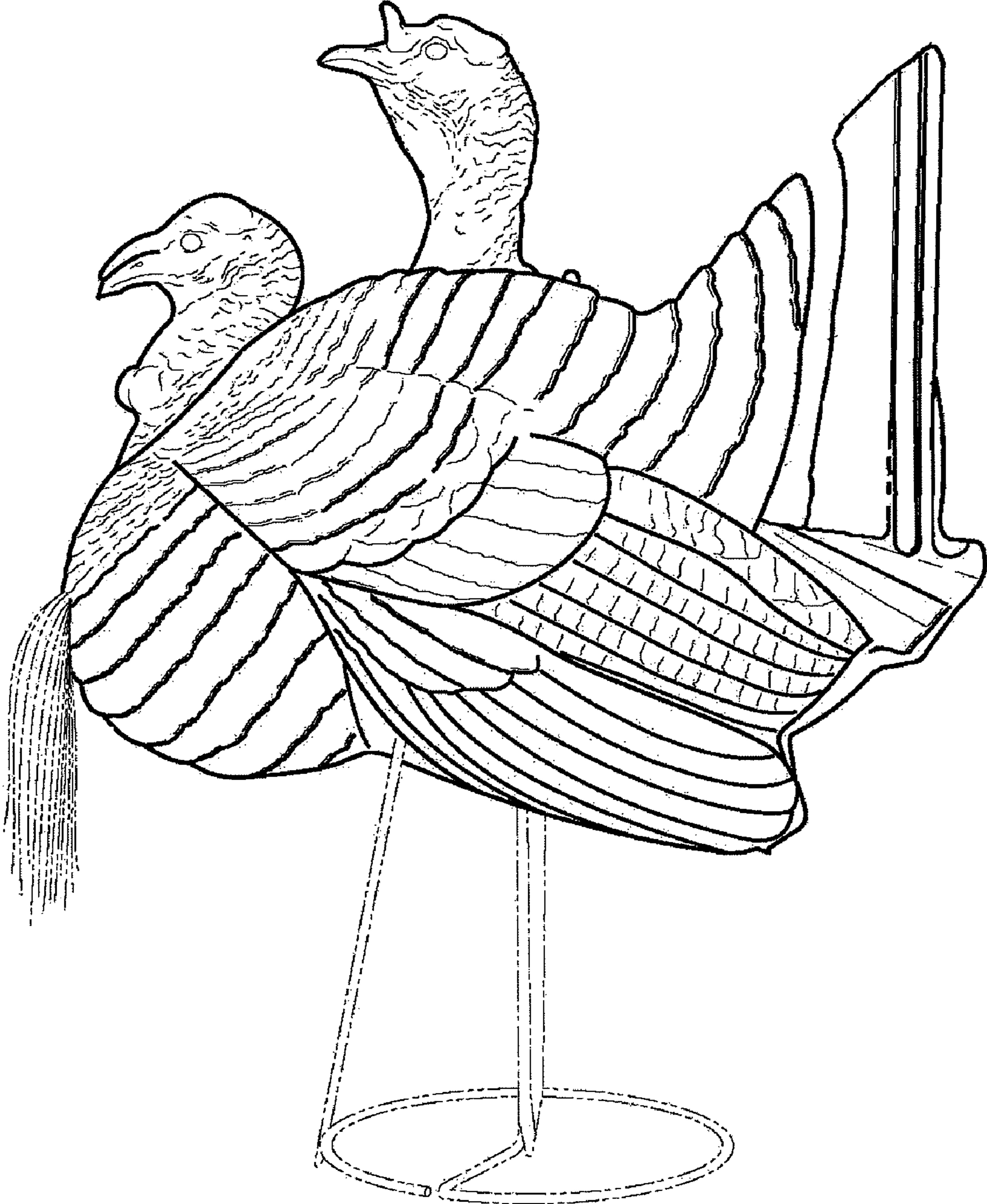

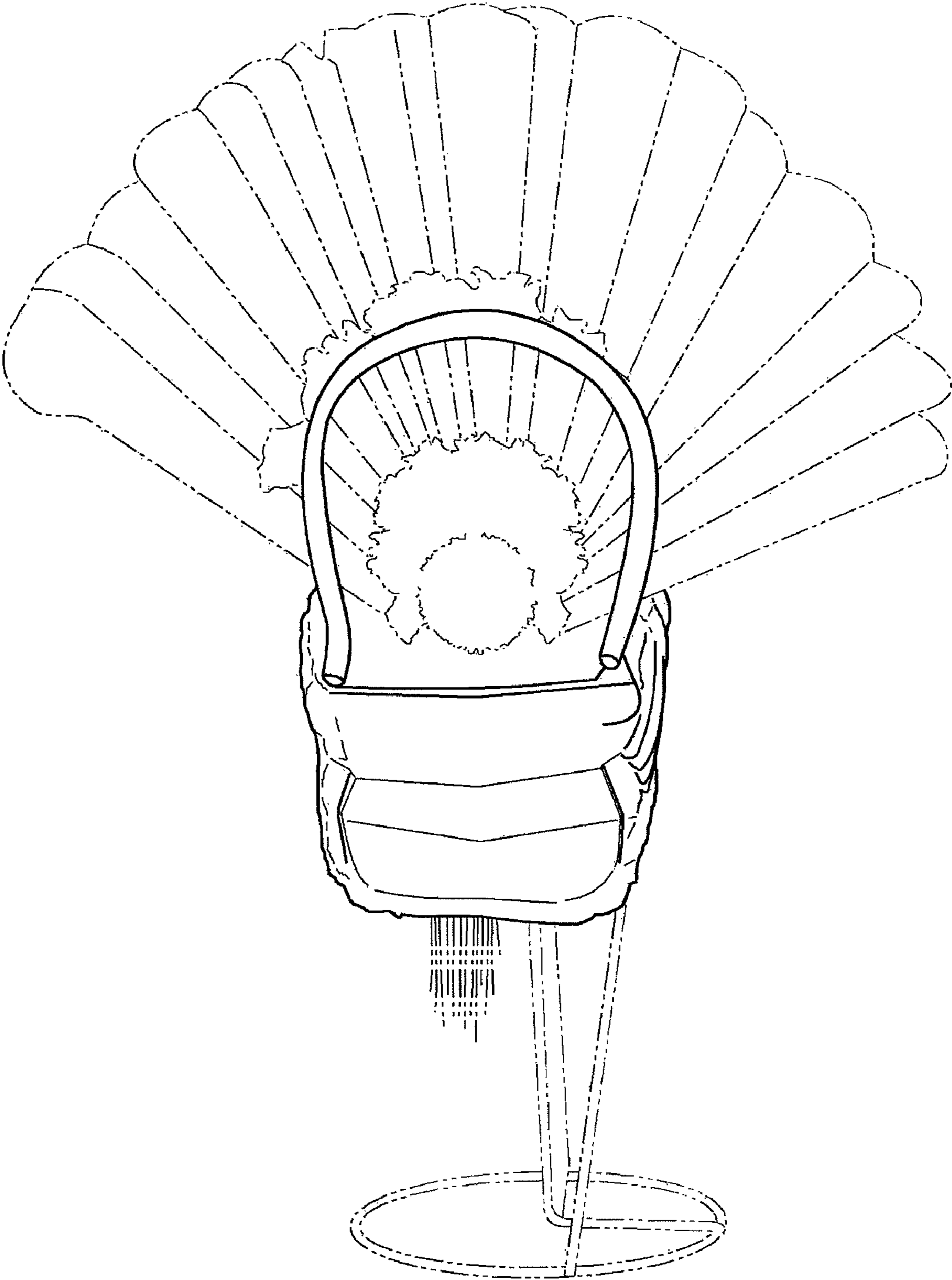

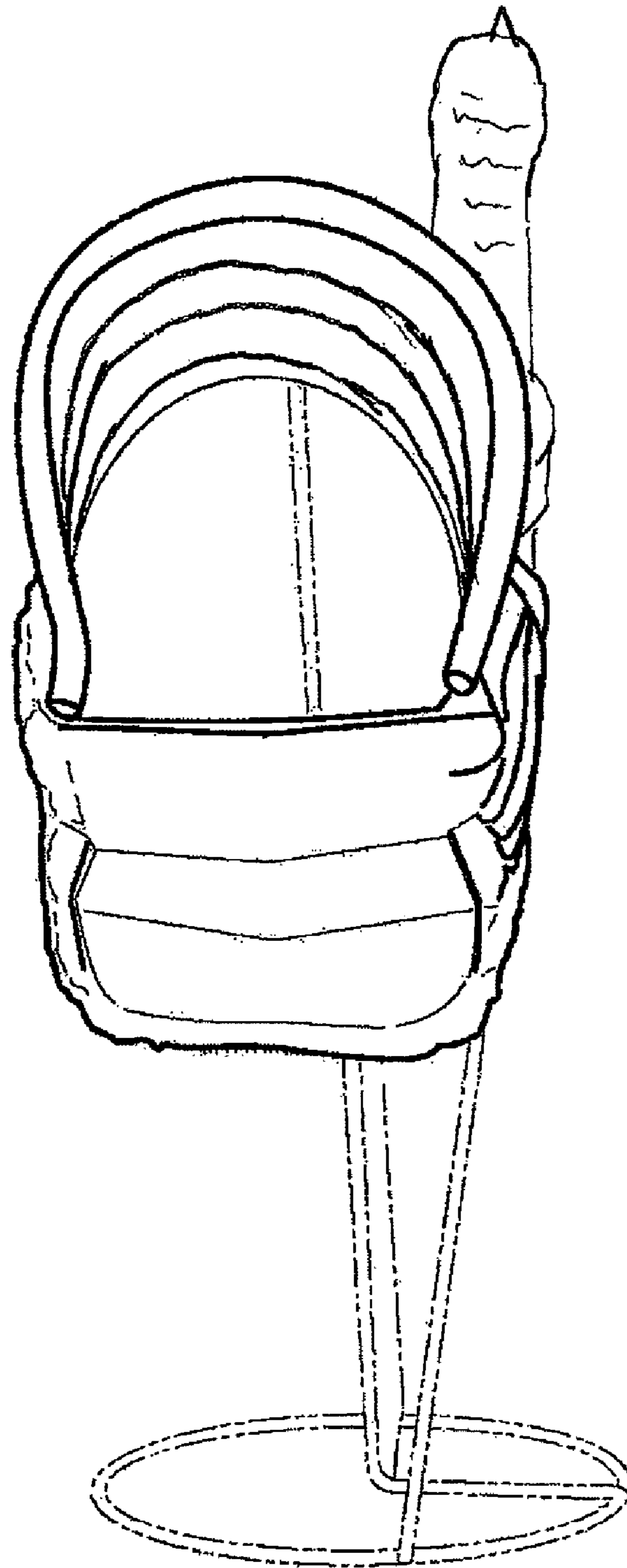

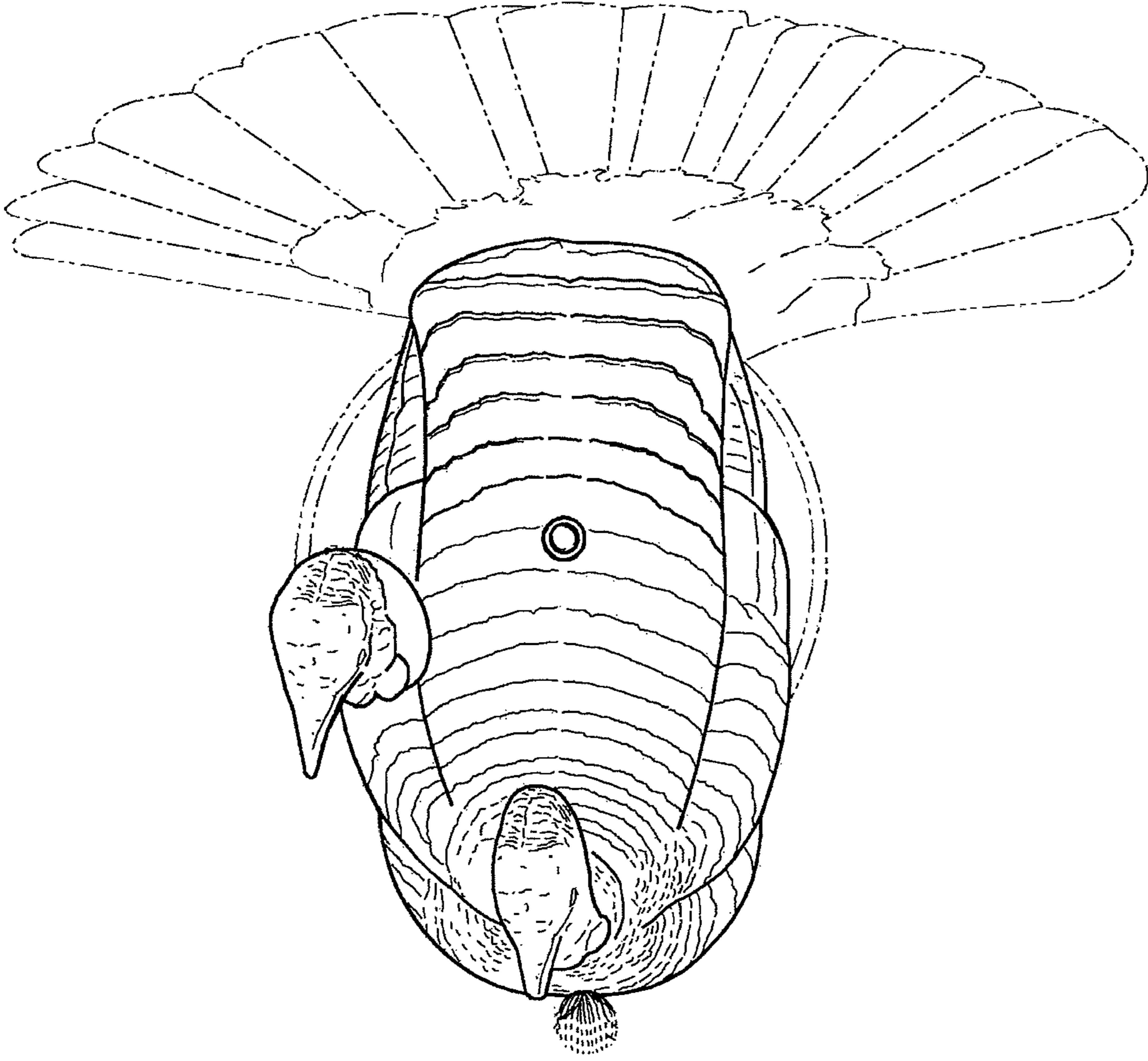

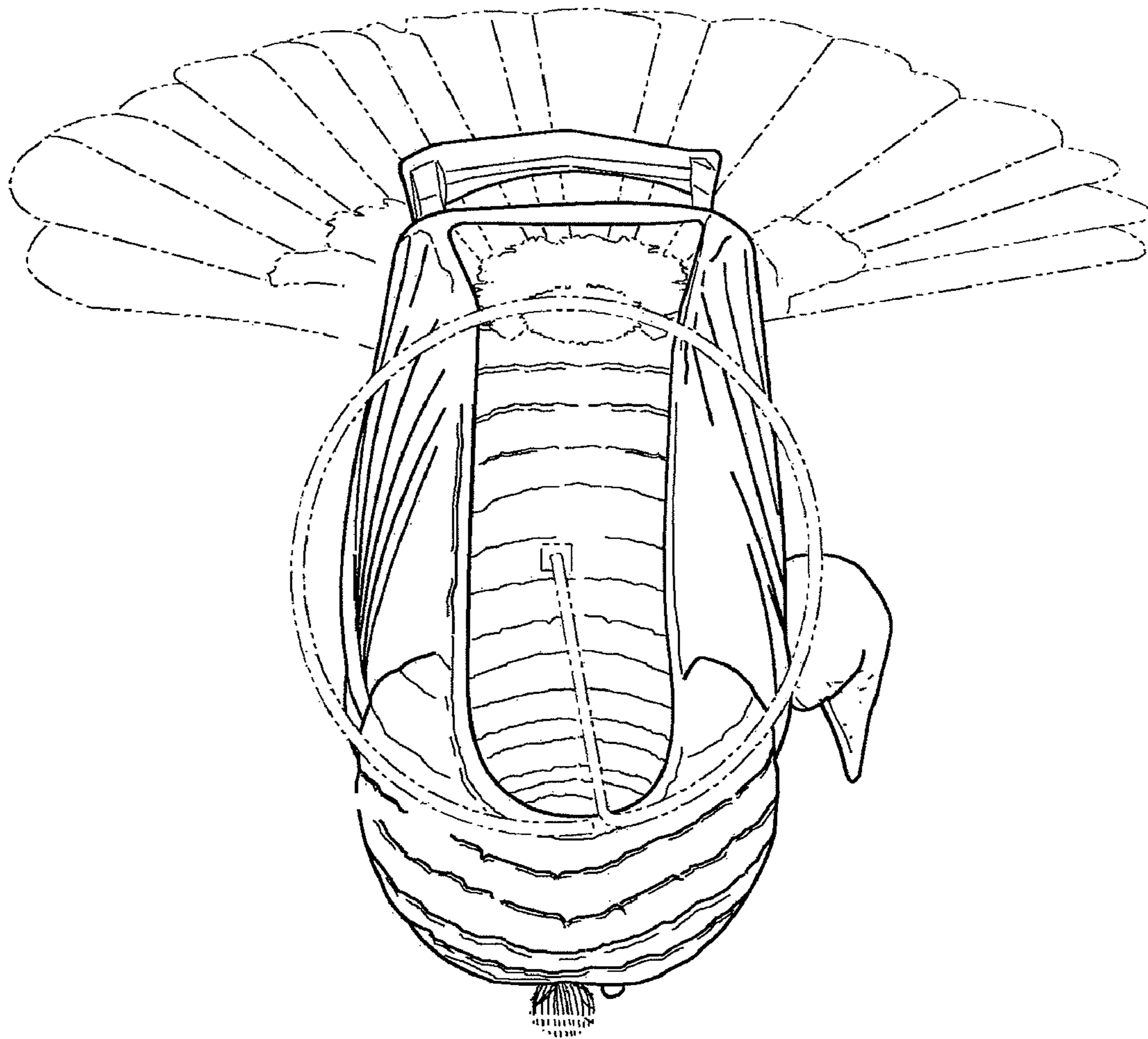

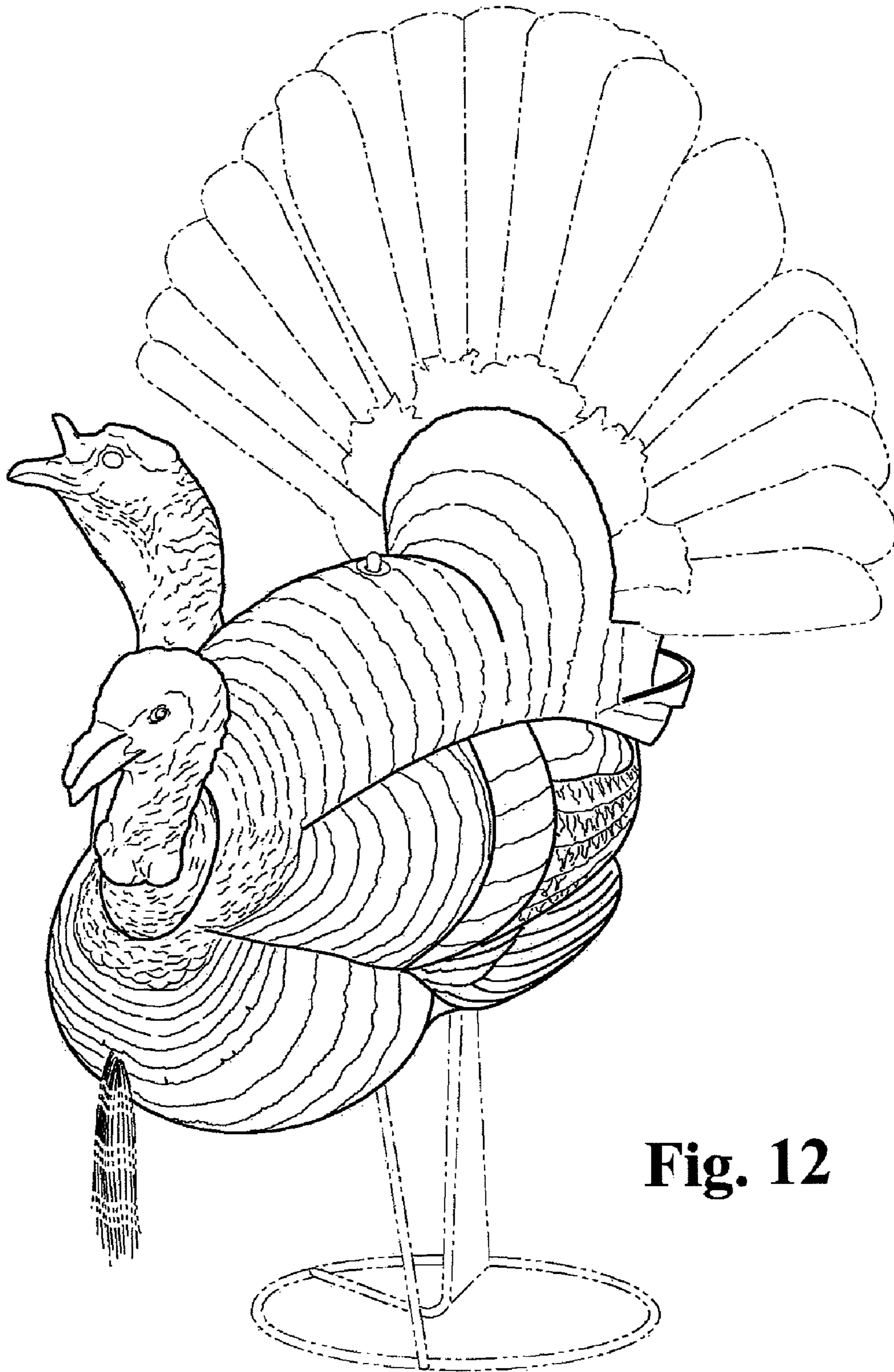

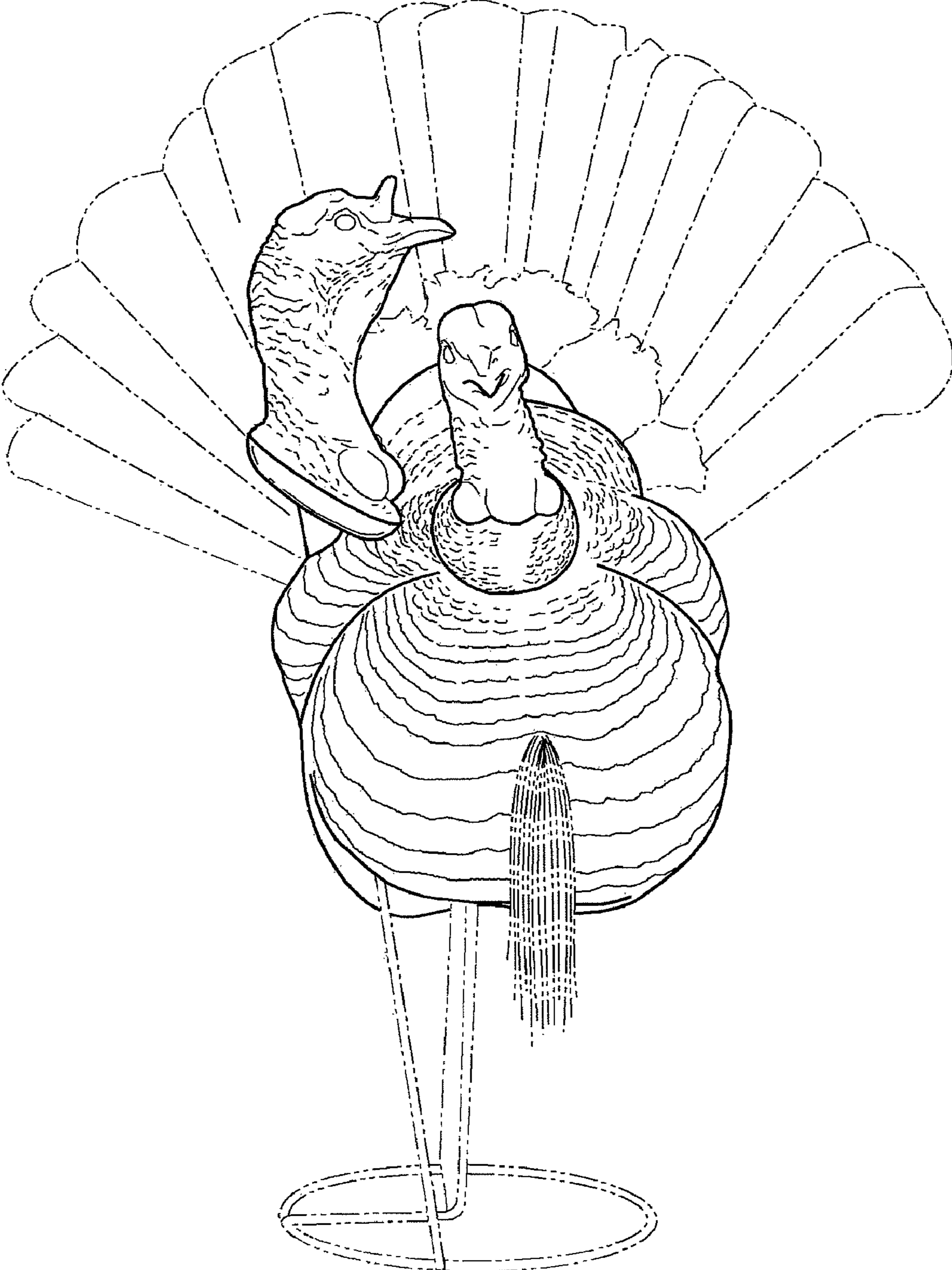

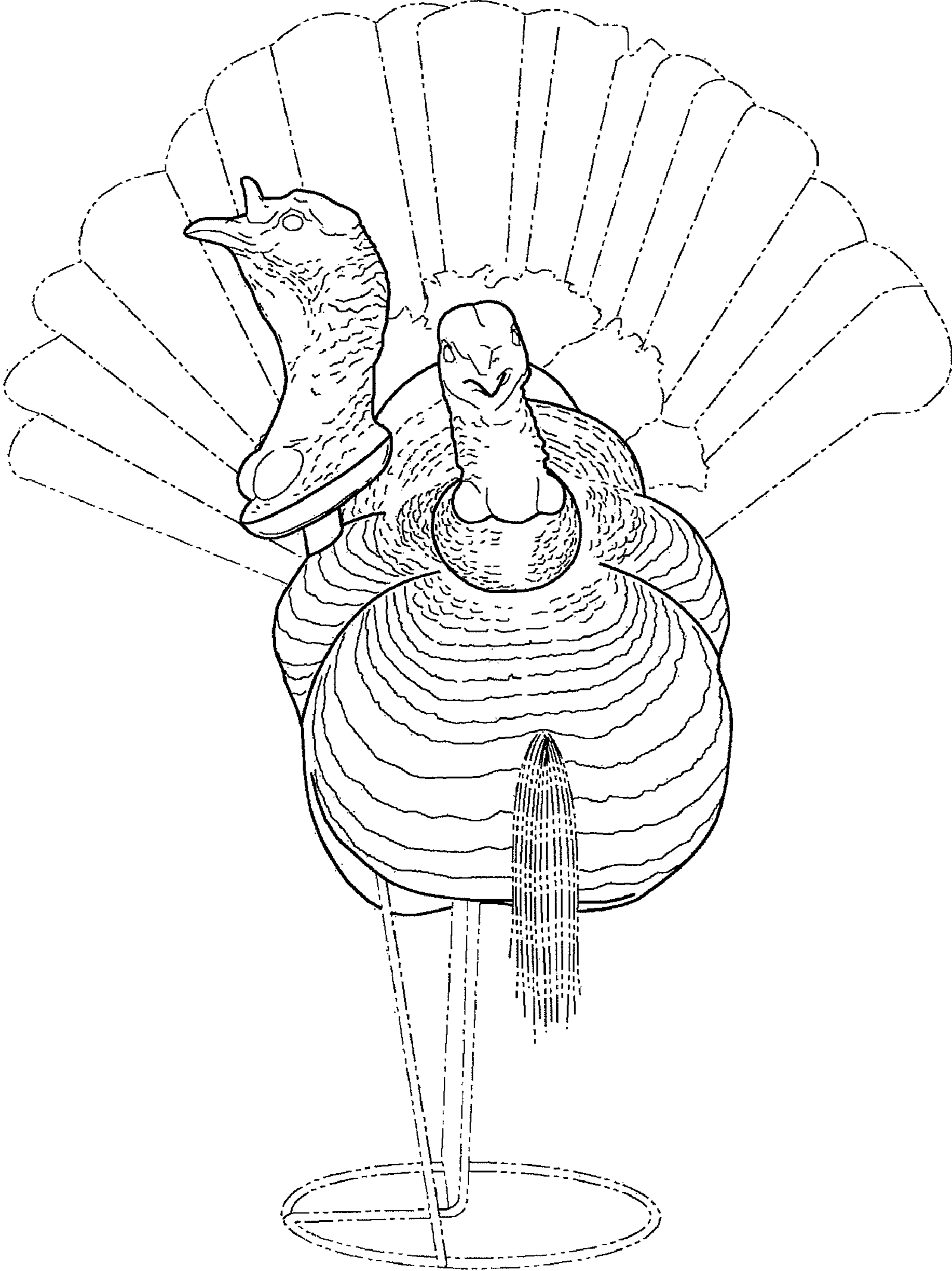

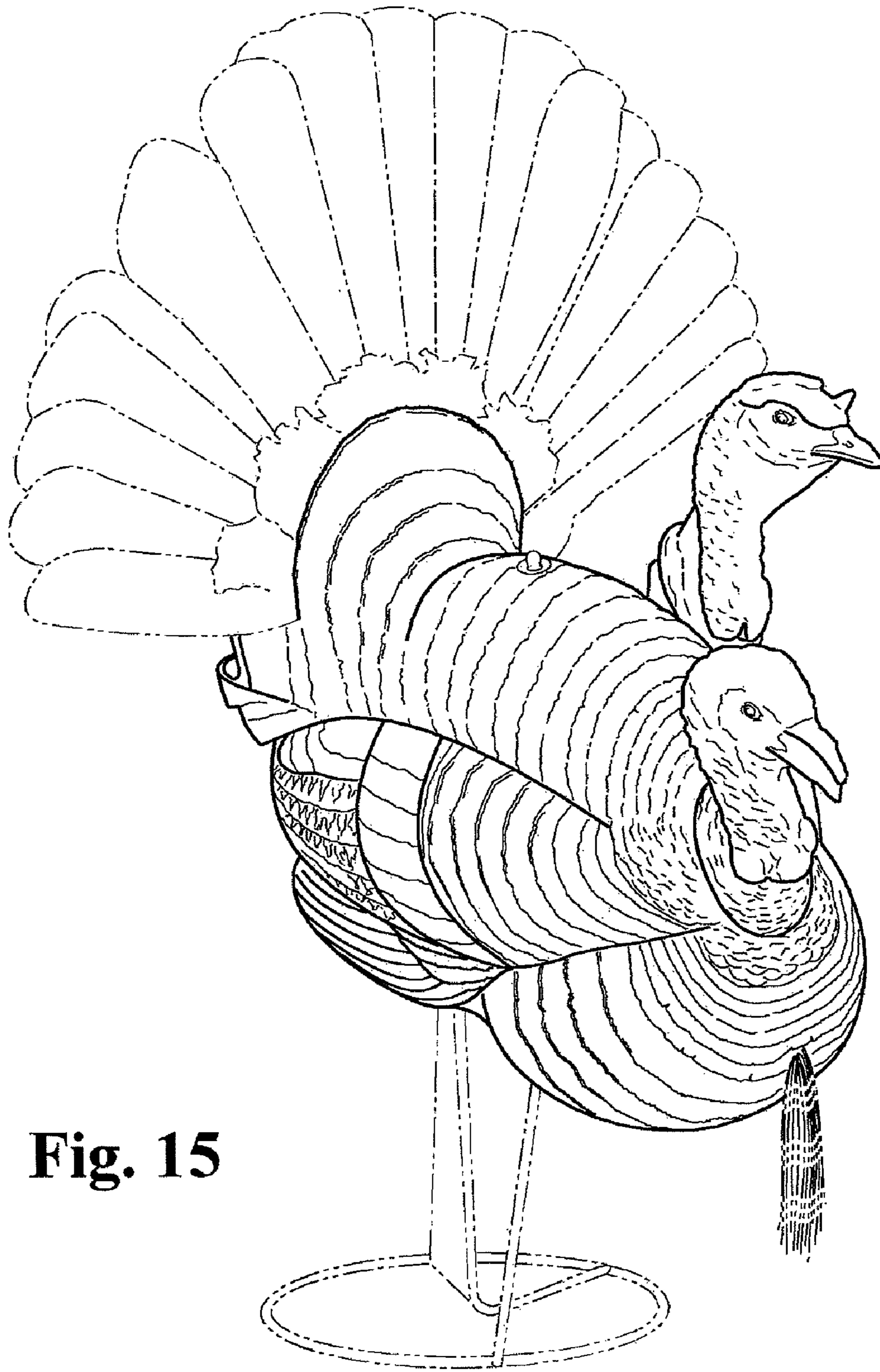

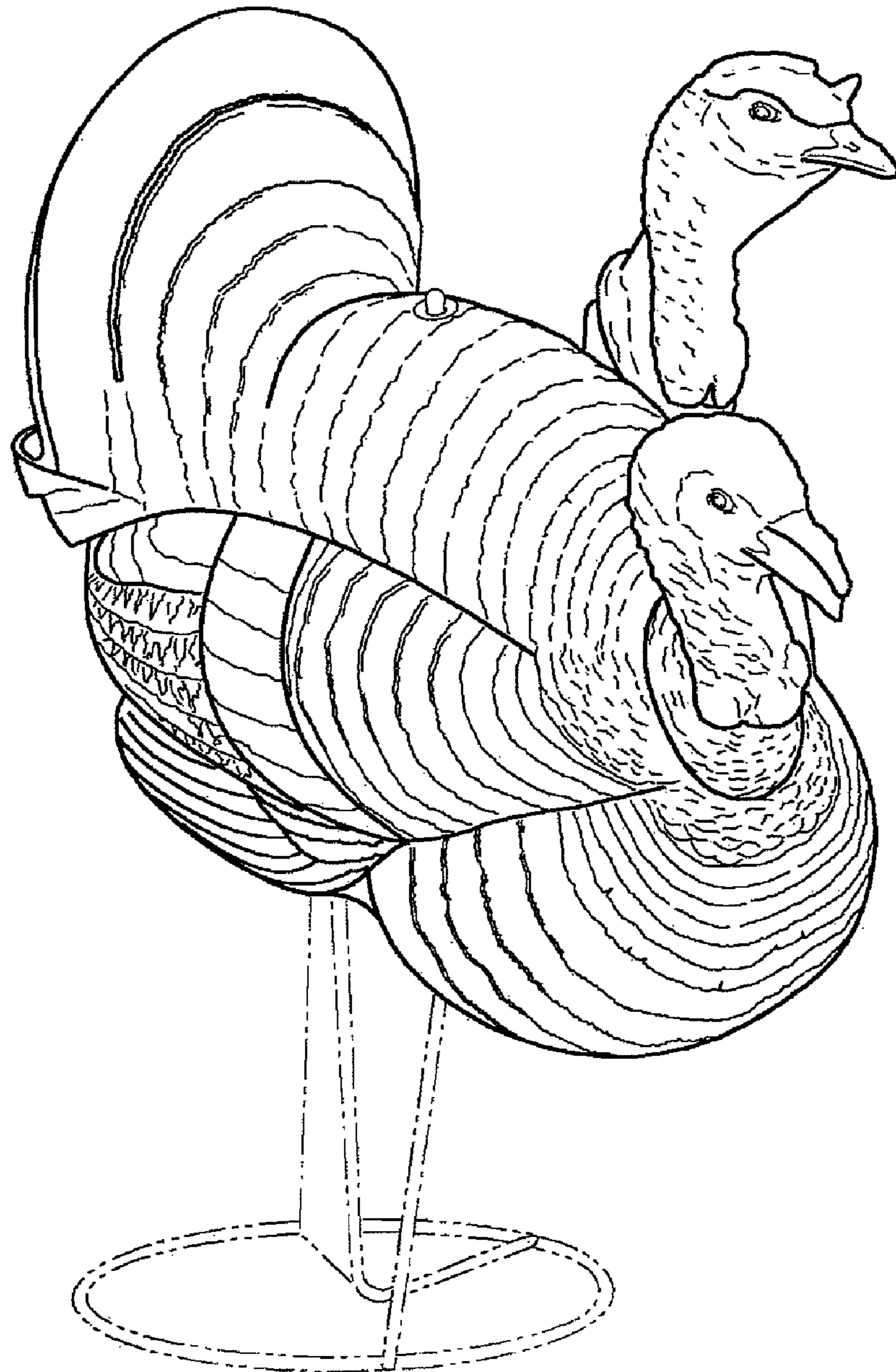

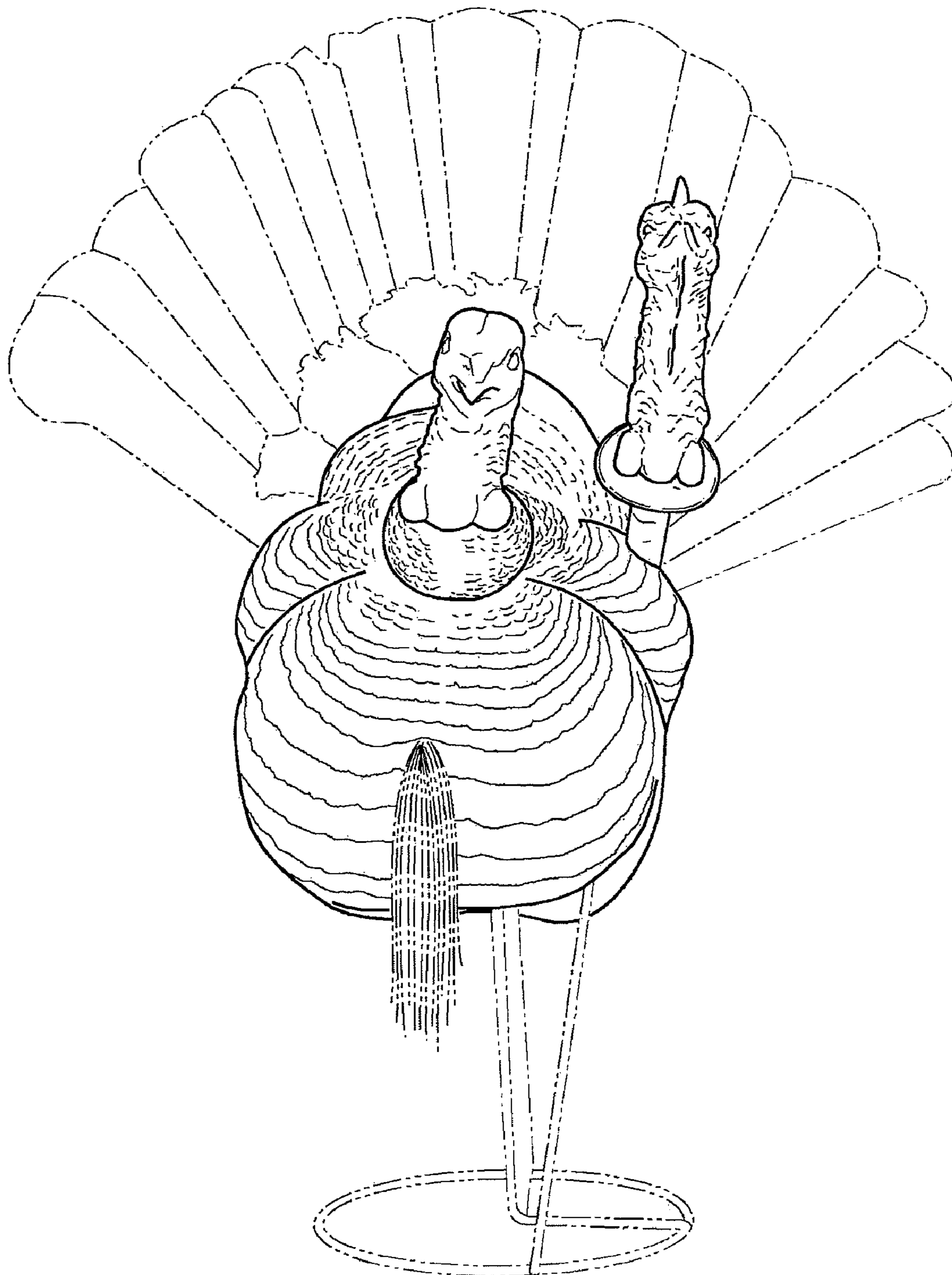

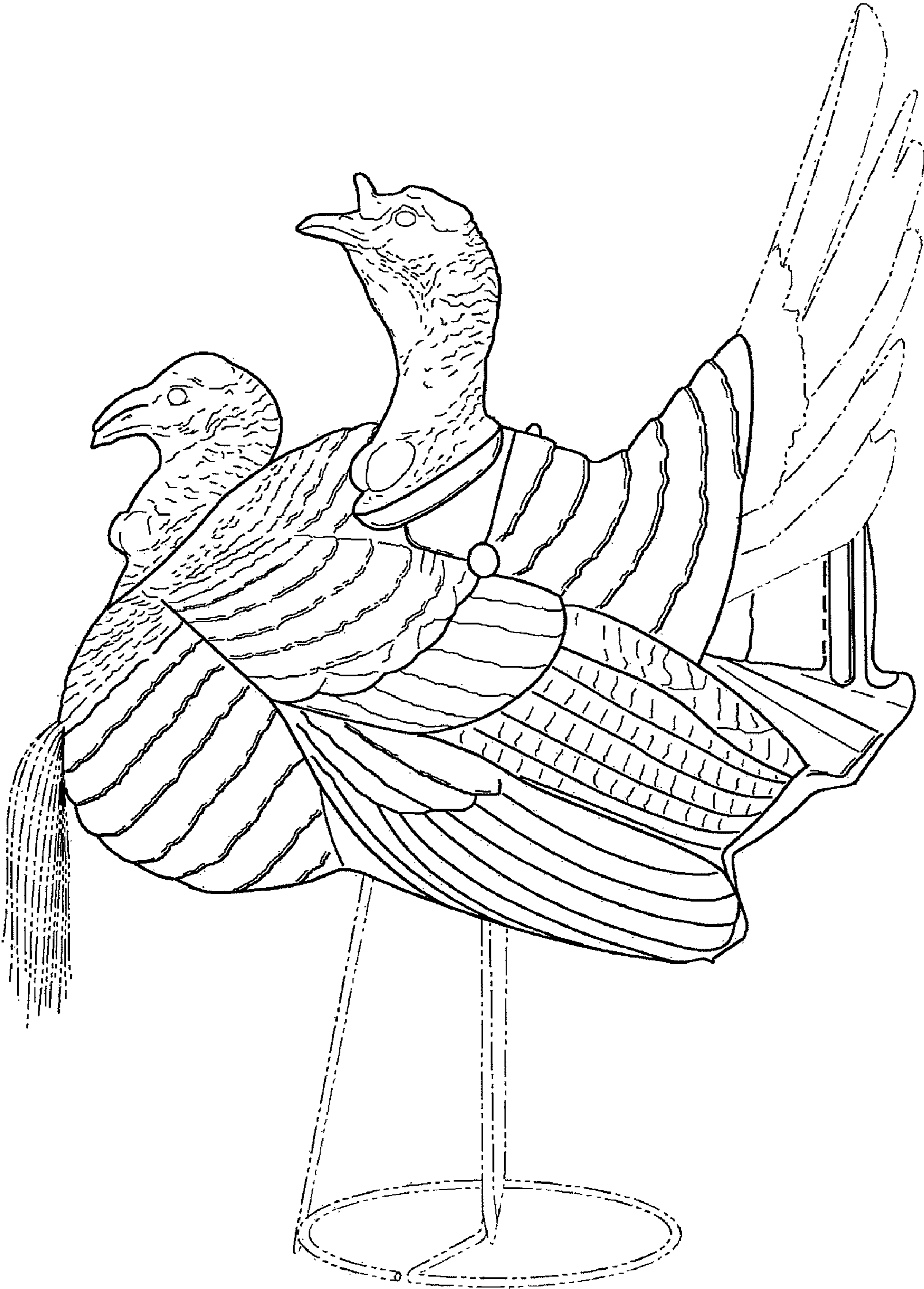

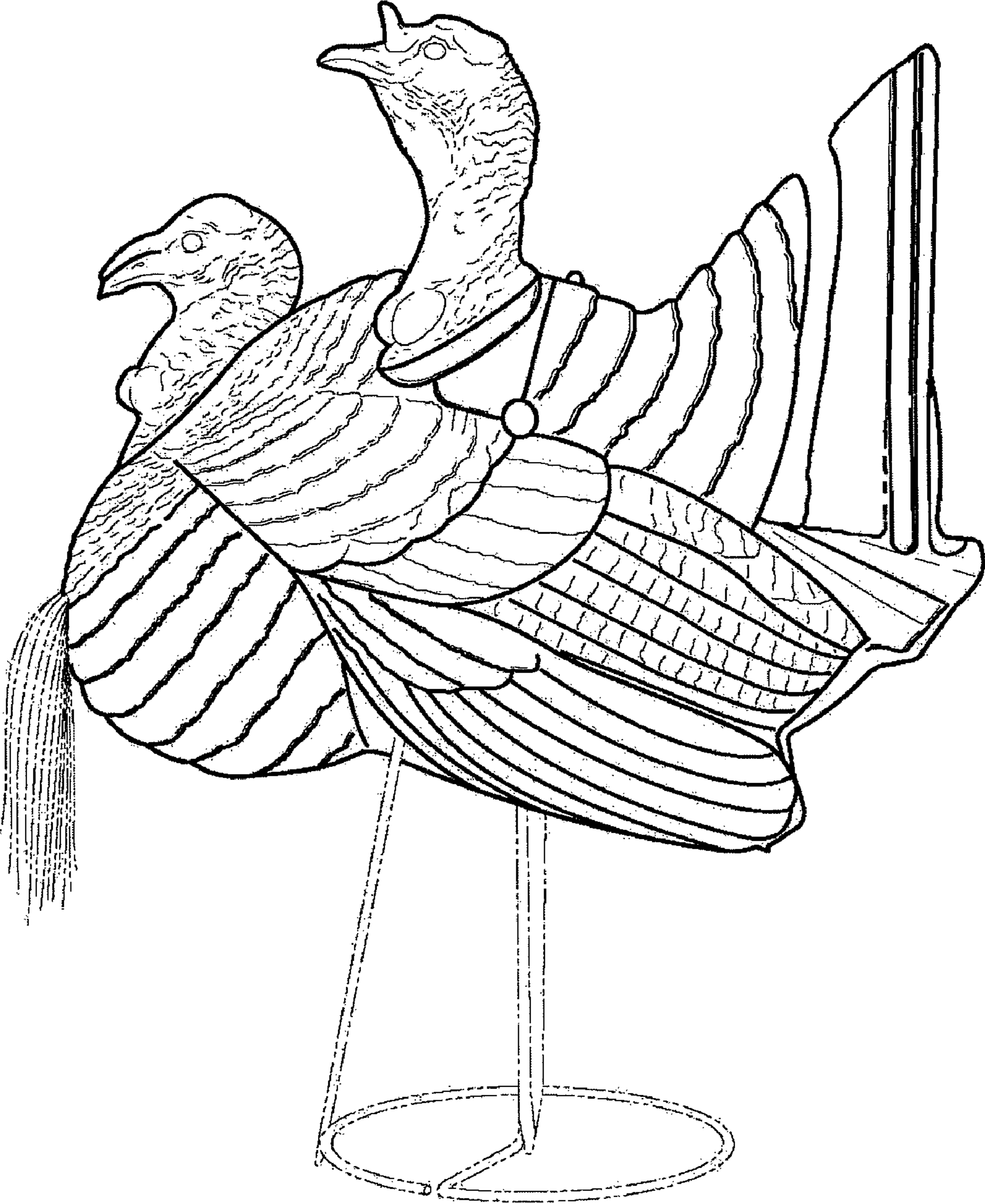

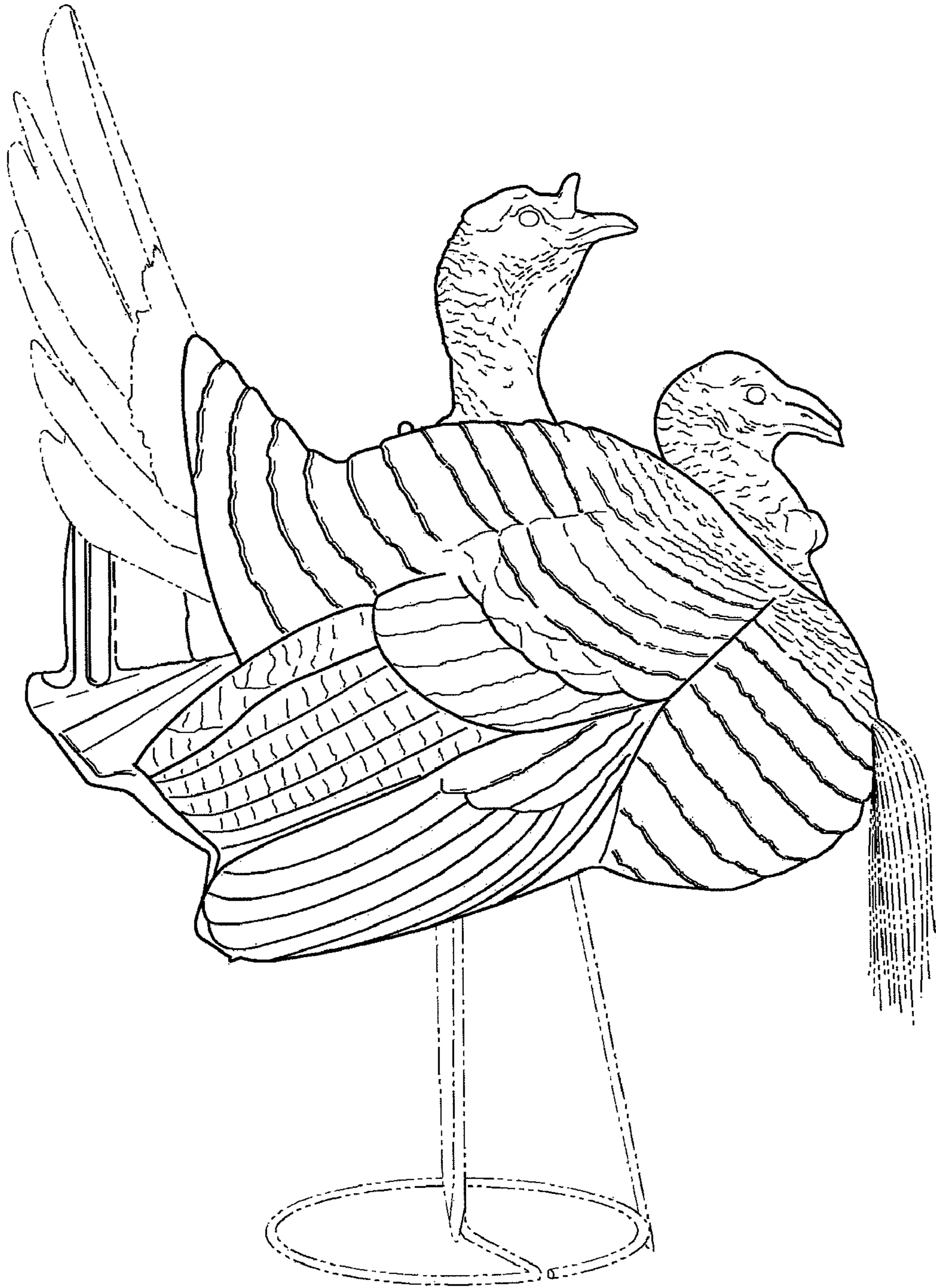

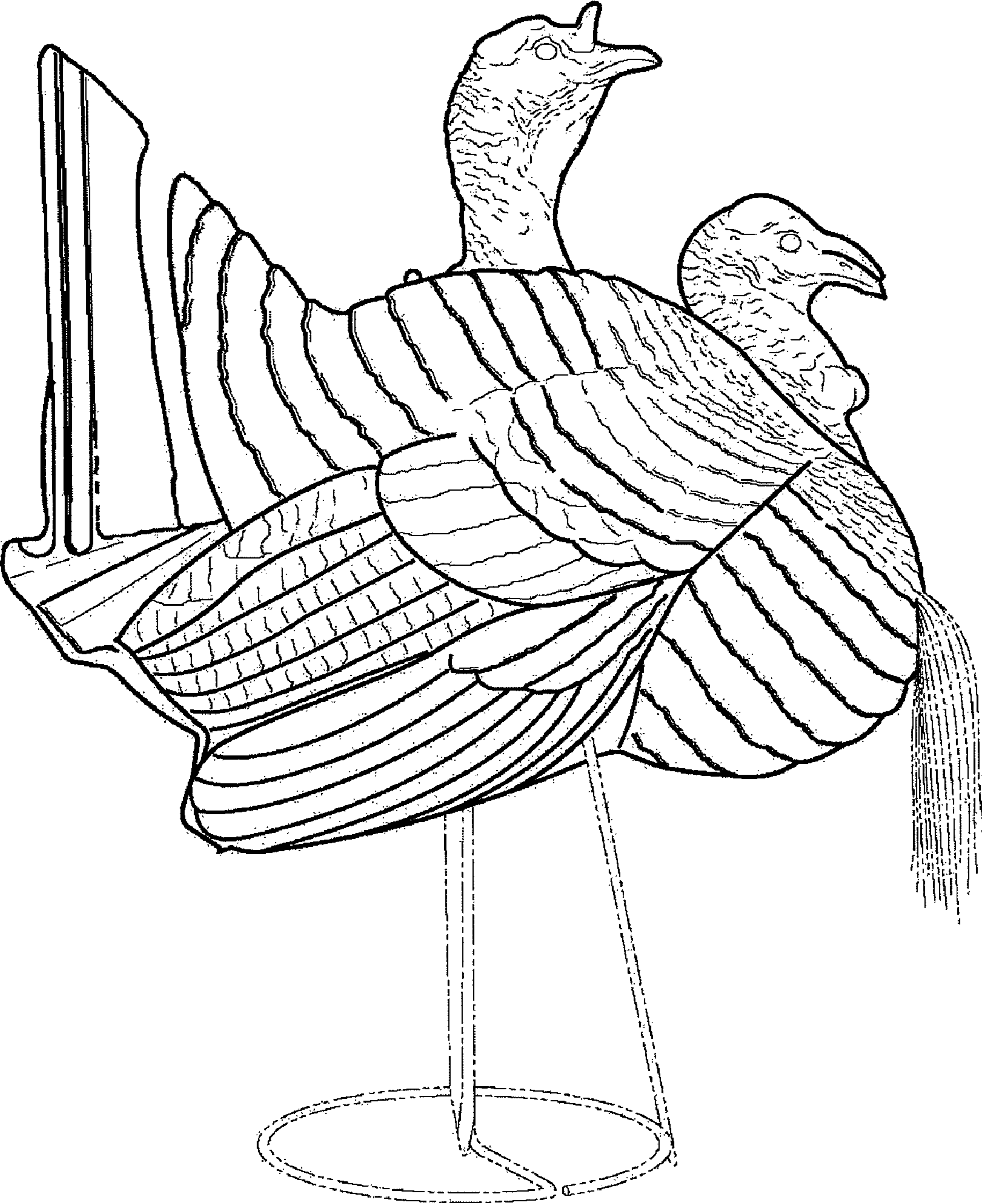

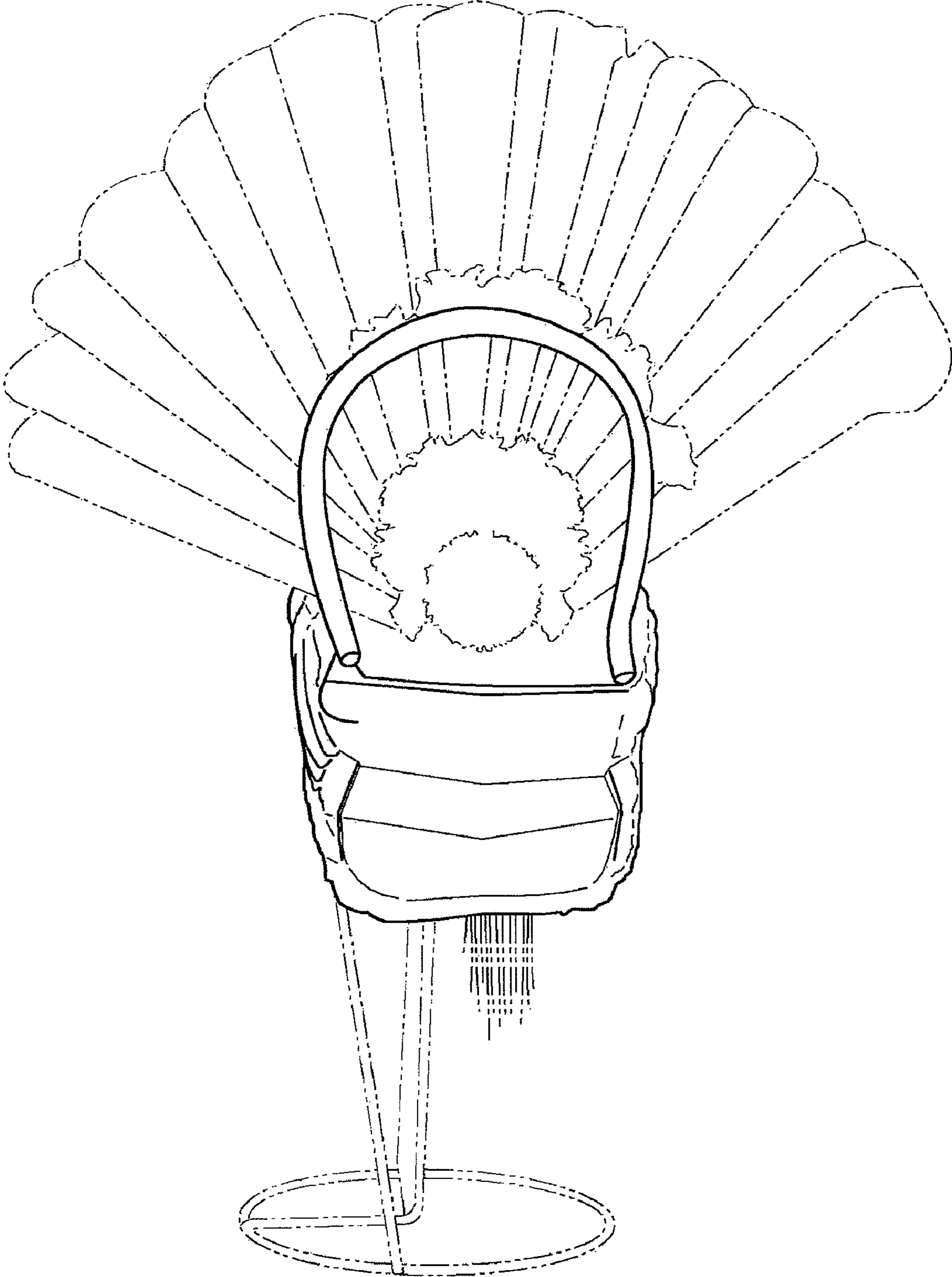

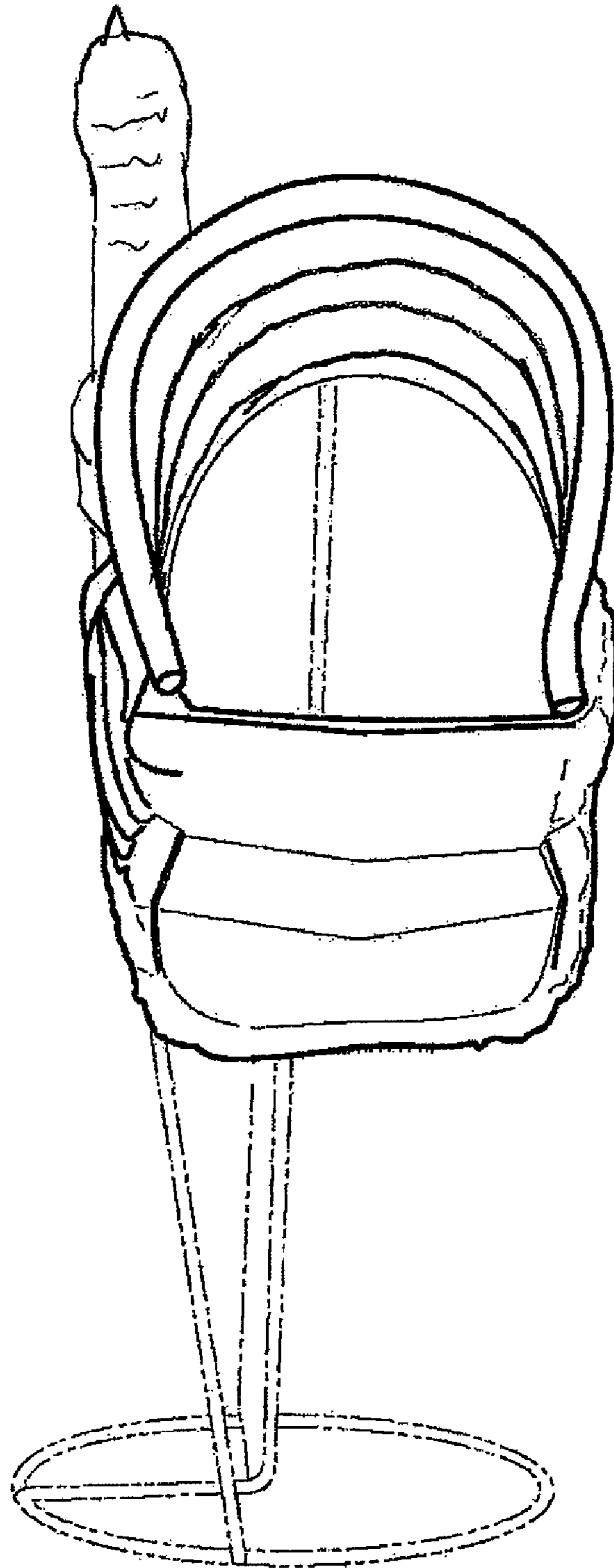

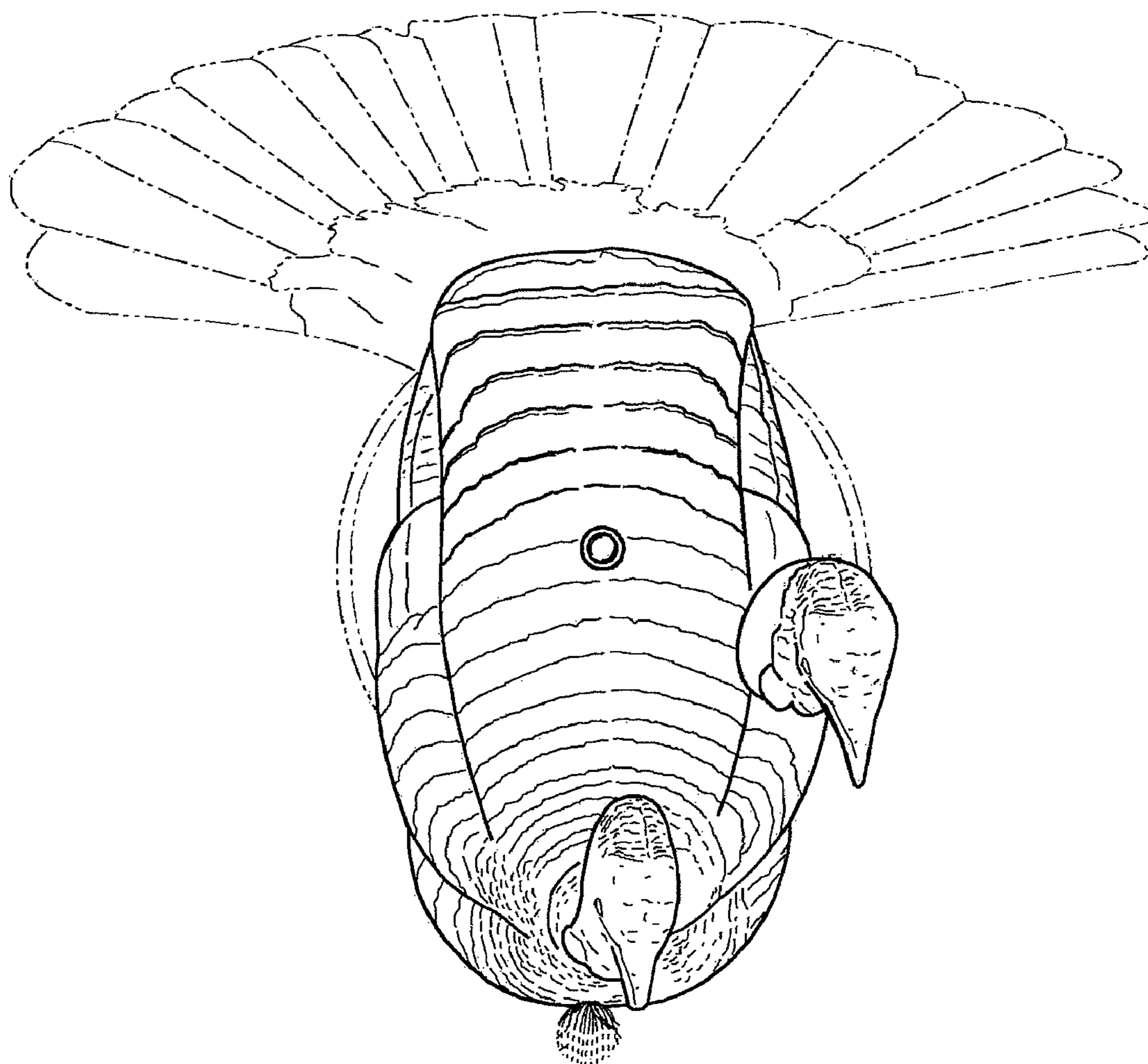

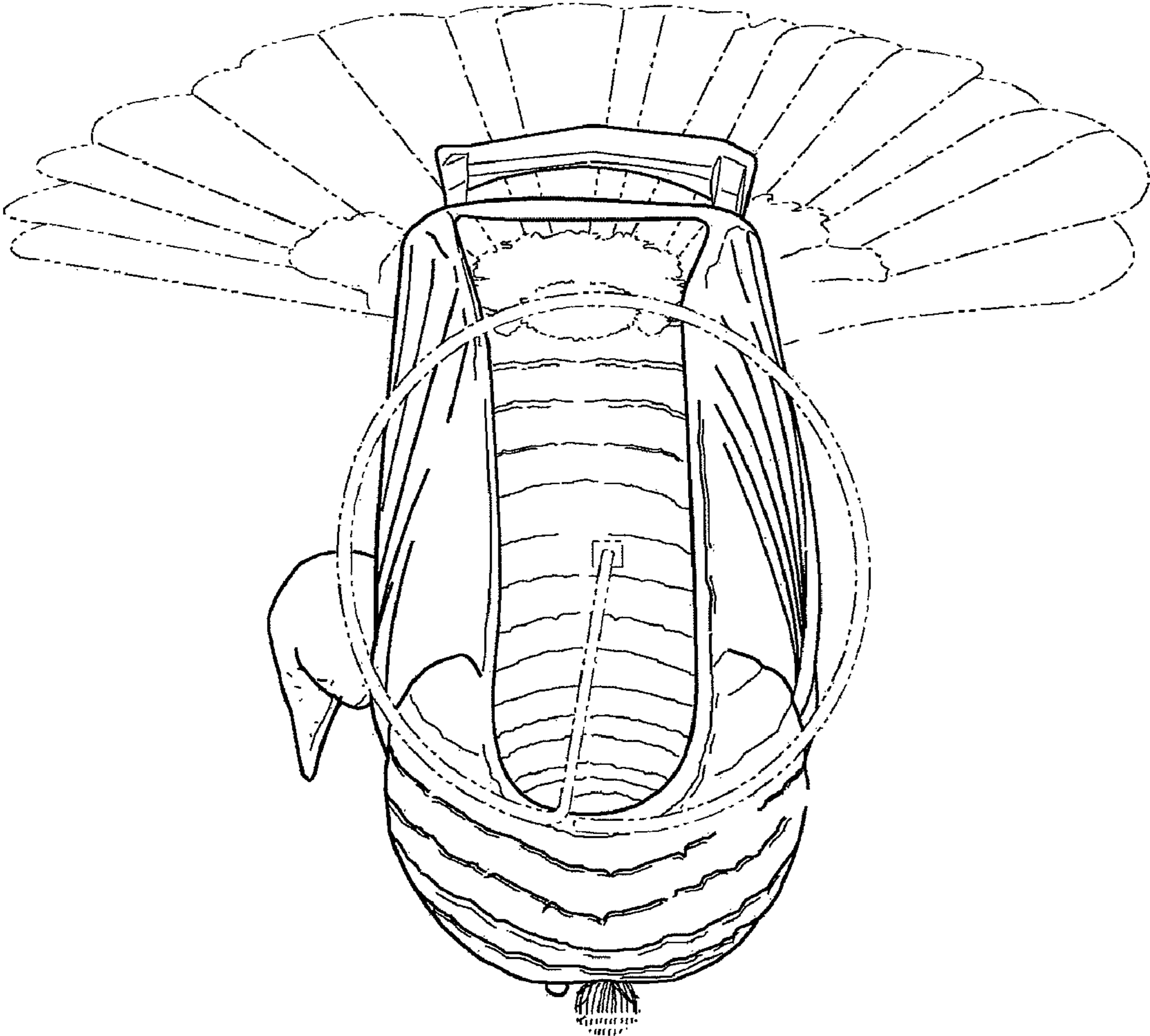

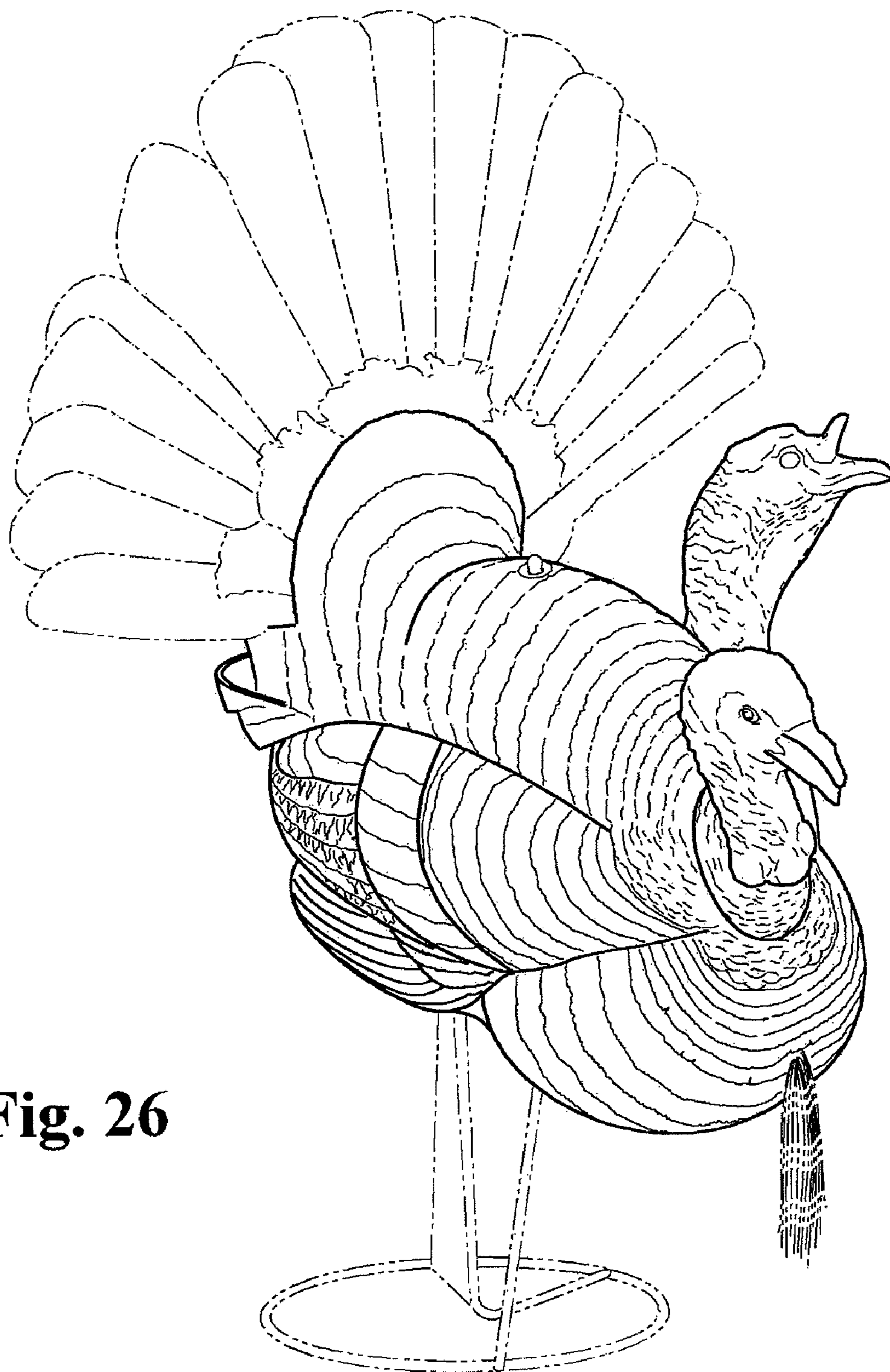

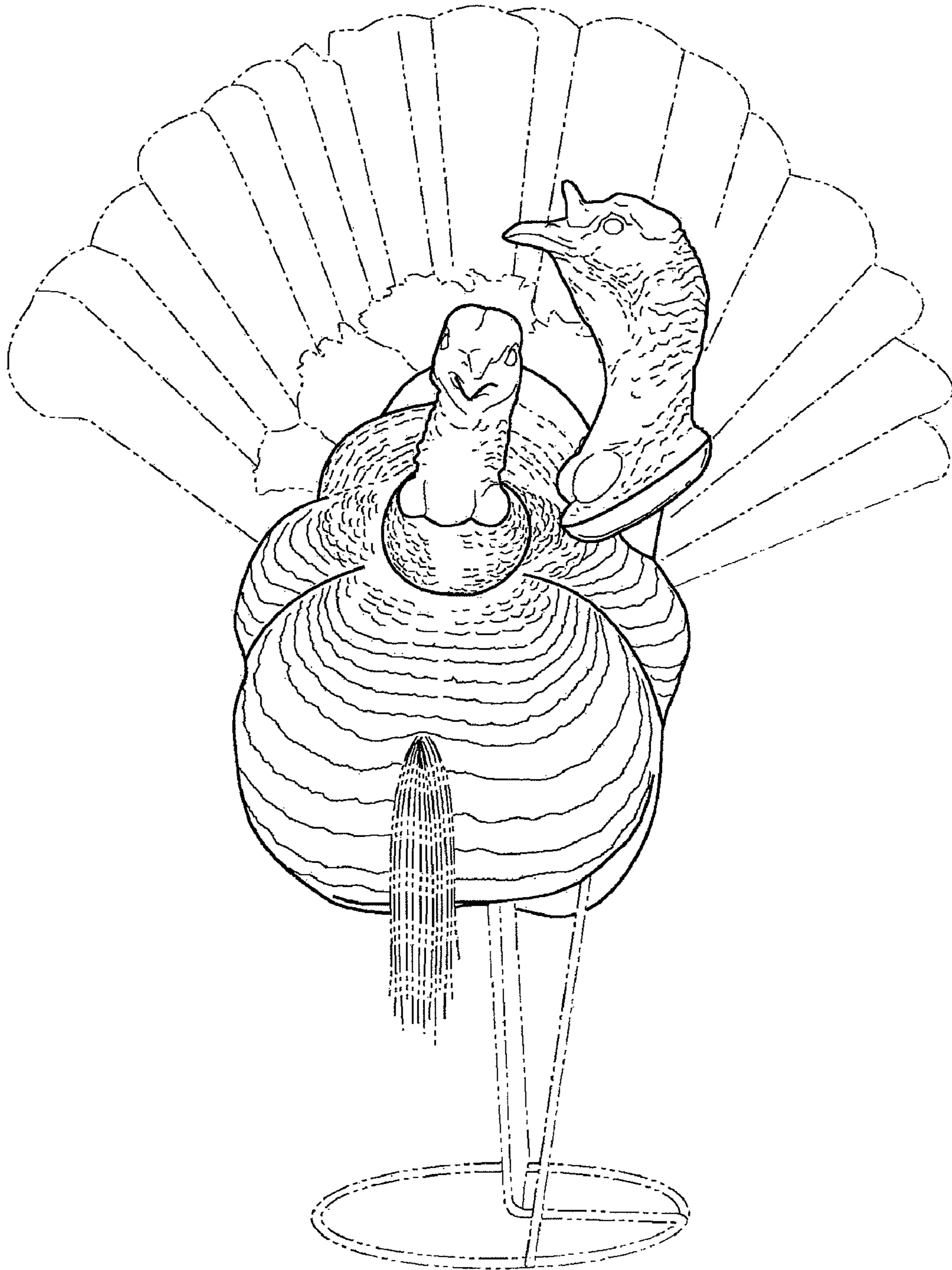

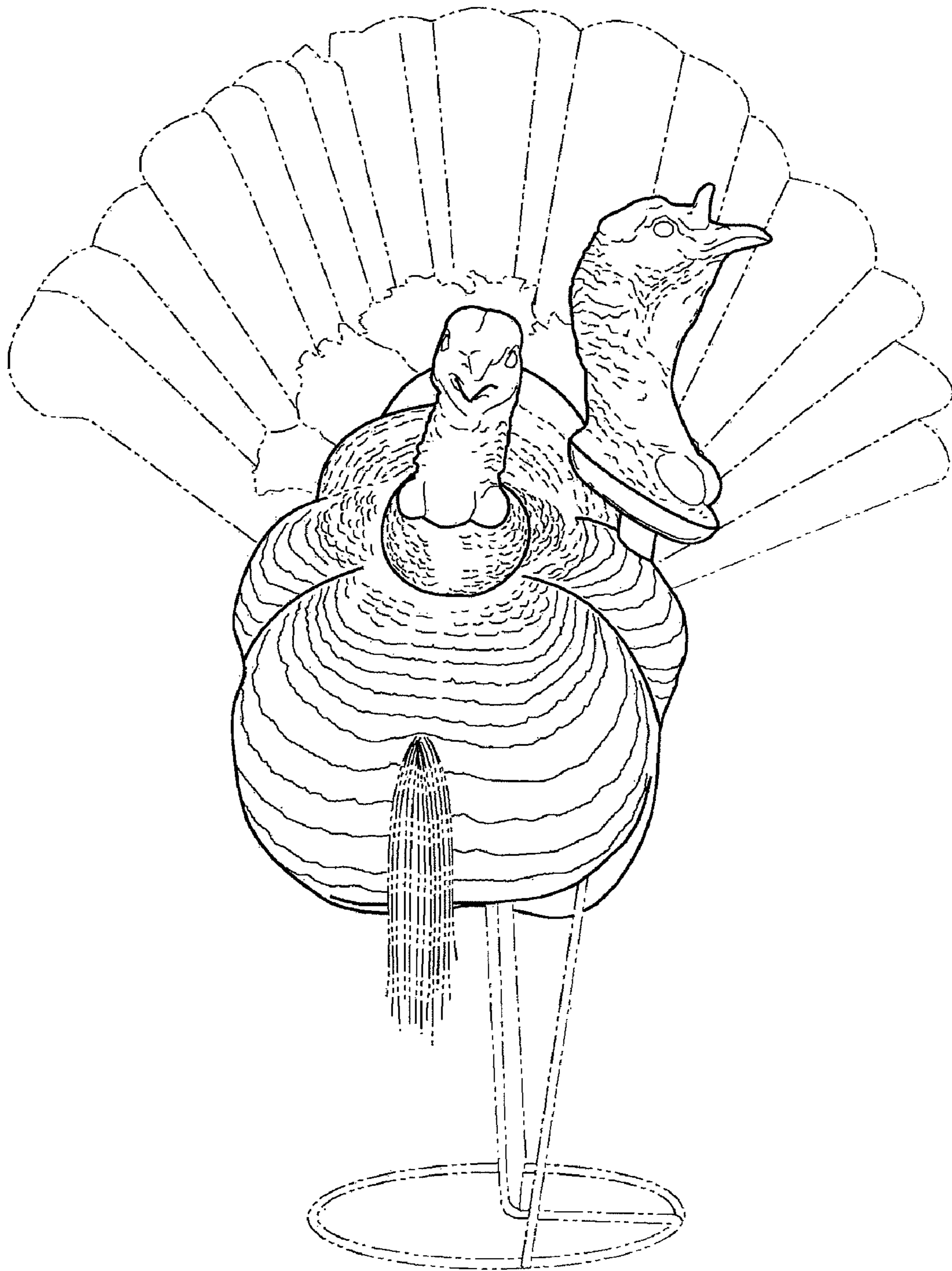
