(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a dispenser, as described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first dispenser showing the design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the dispenser in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side view of the dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a back view of the dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a dispenser showing the design which is a variant of the dispenser of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a front view of the dispenser in FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a left side view of the dispenser of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a right side view of the dispenser in FIG. 8;

FIG. 12 is a top view of the dispenser of FIG. 8;

FIG. 13 is a bottom view of the dispenser of FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 14 is a back view of the dispenser of FIG. 8.

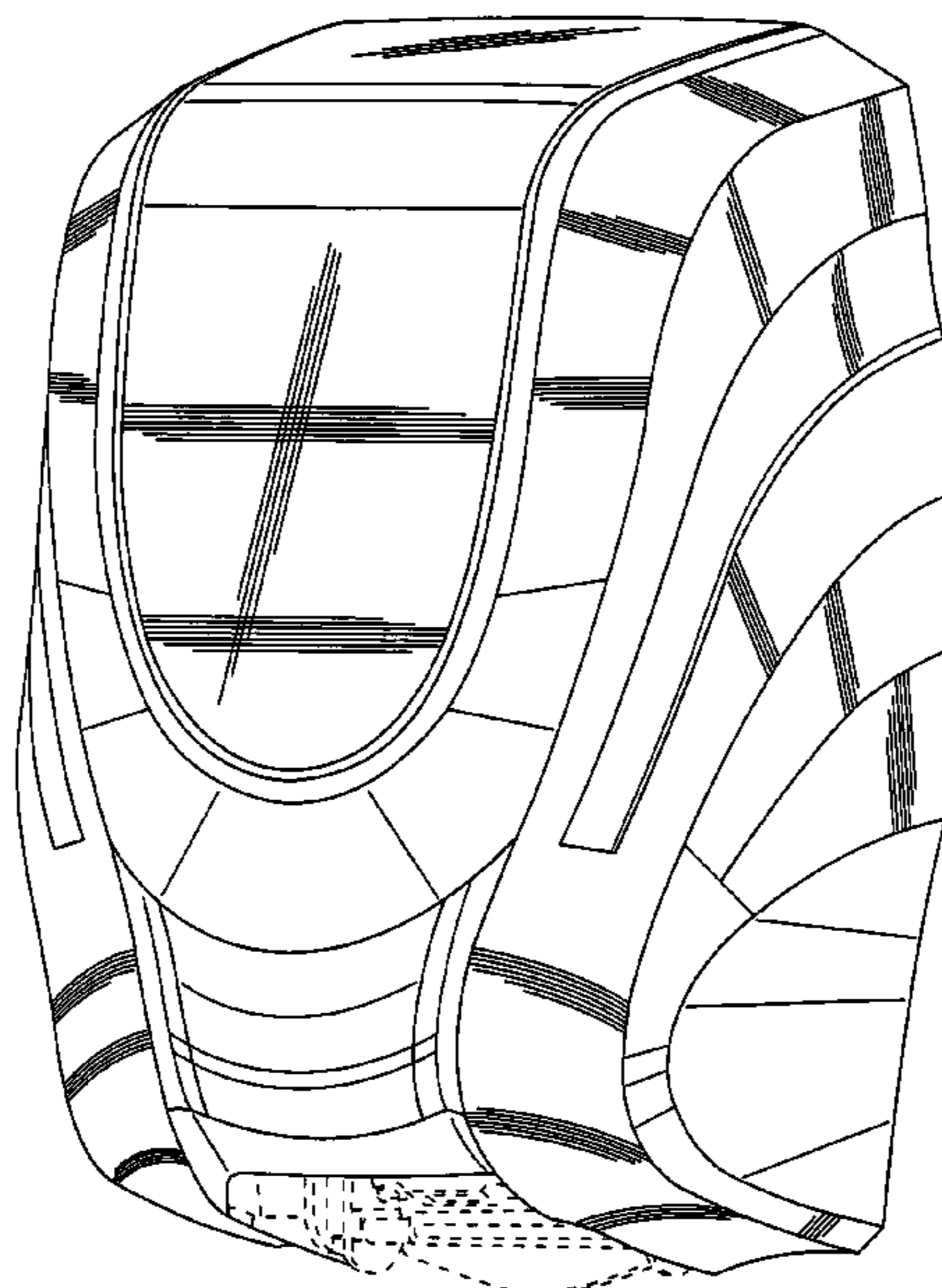

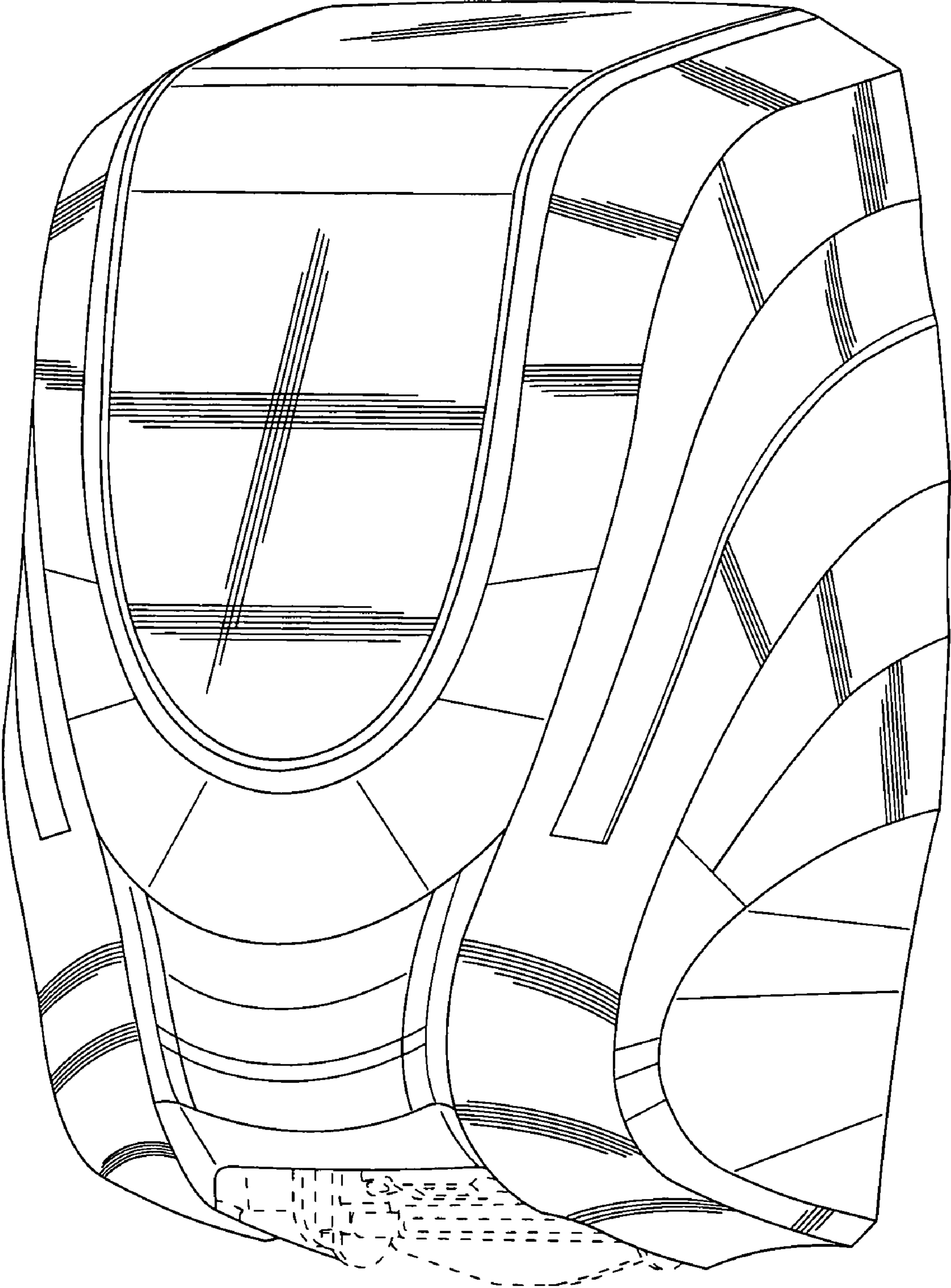

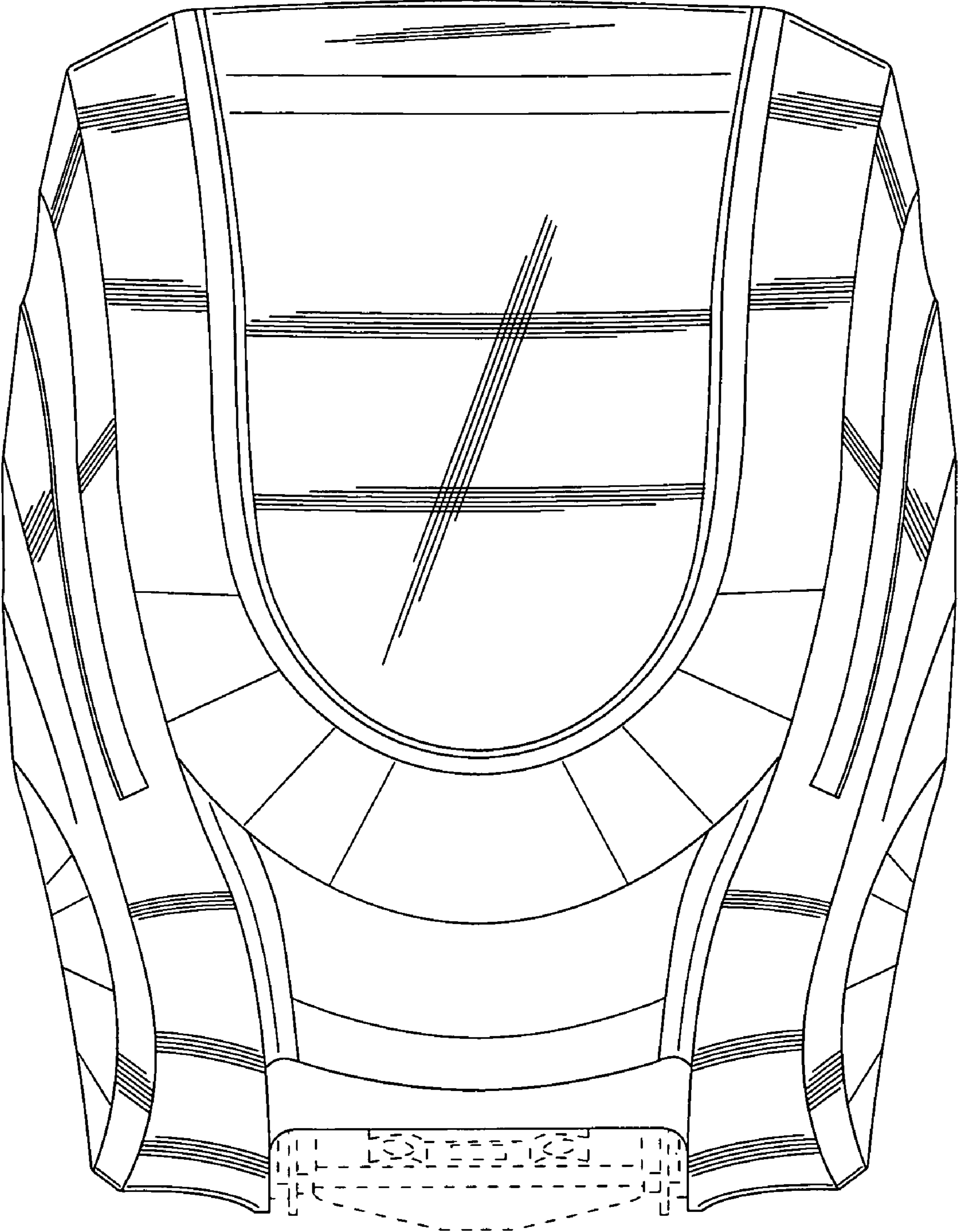

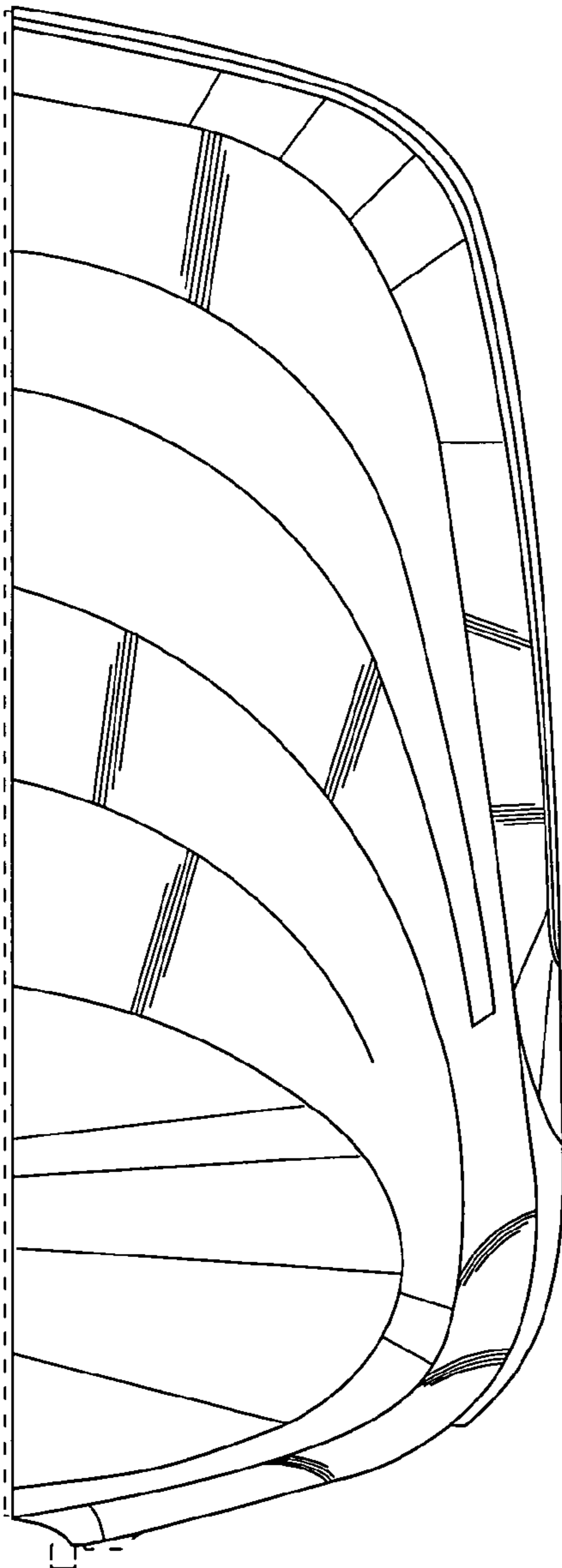

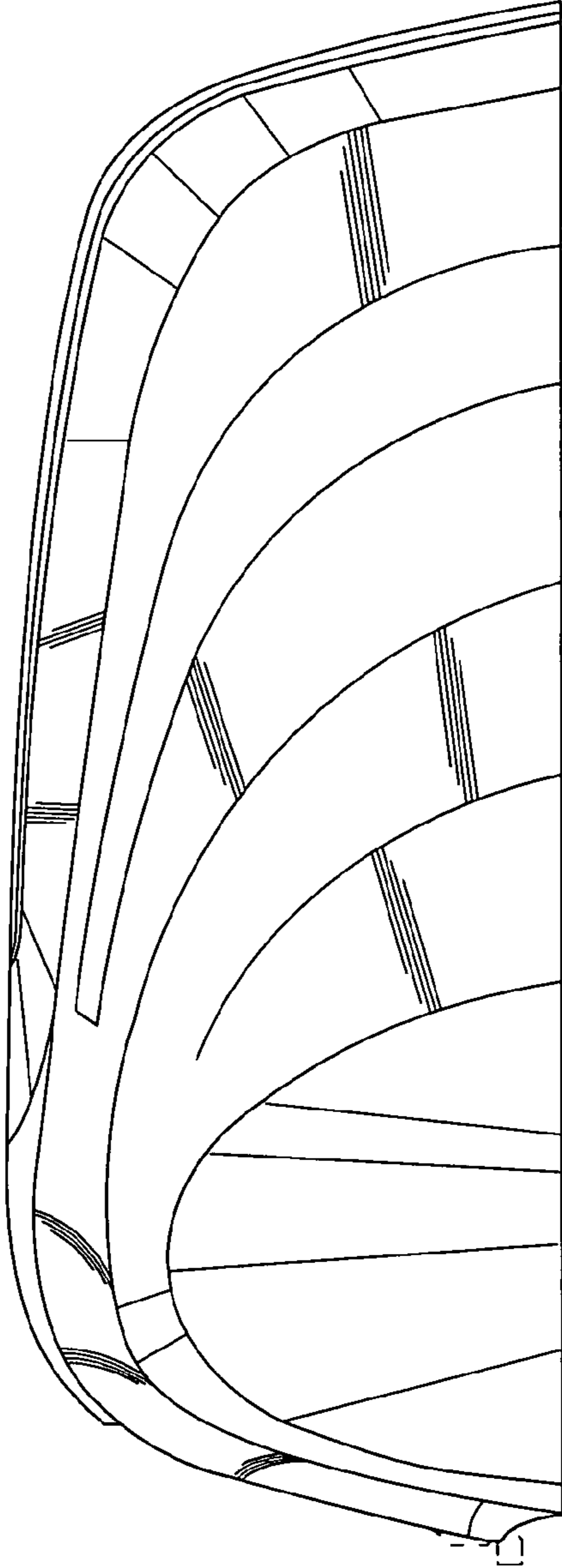

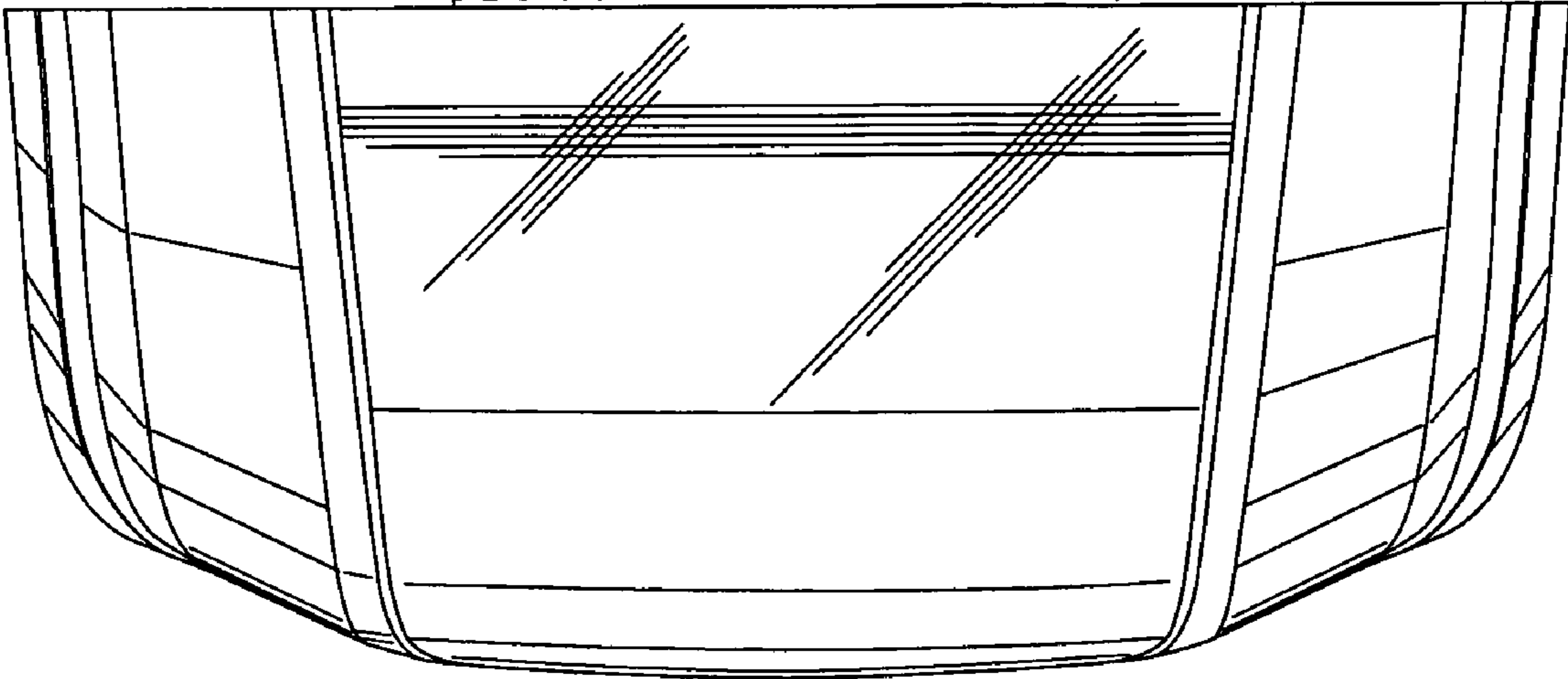

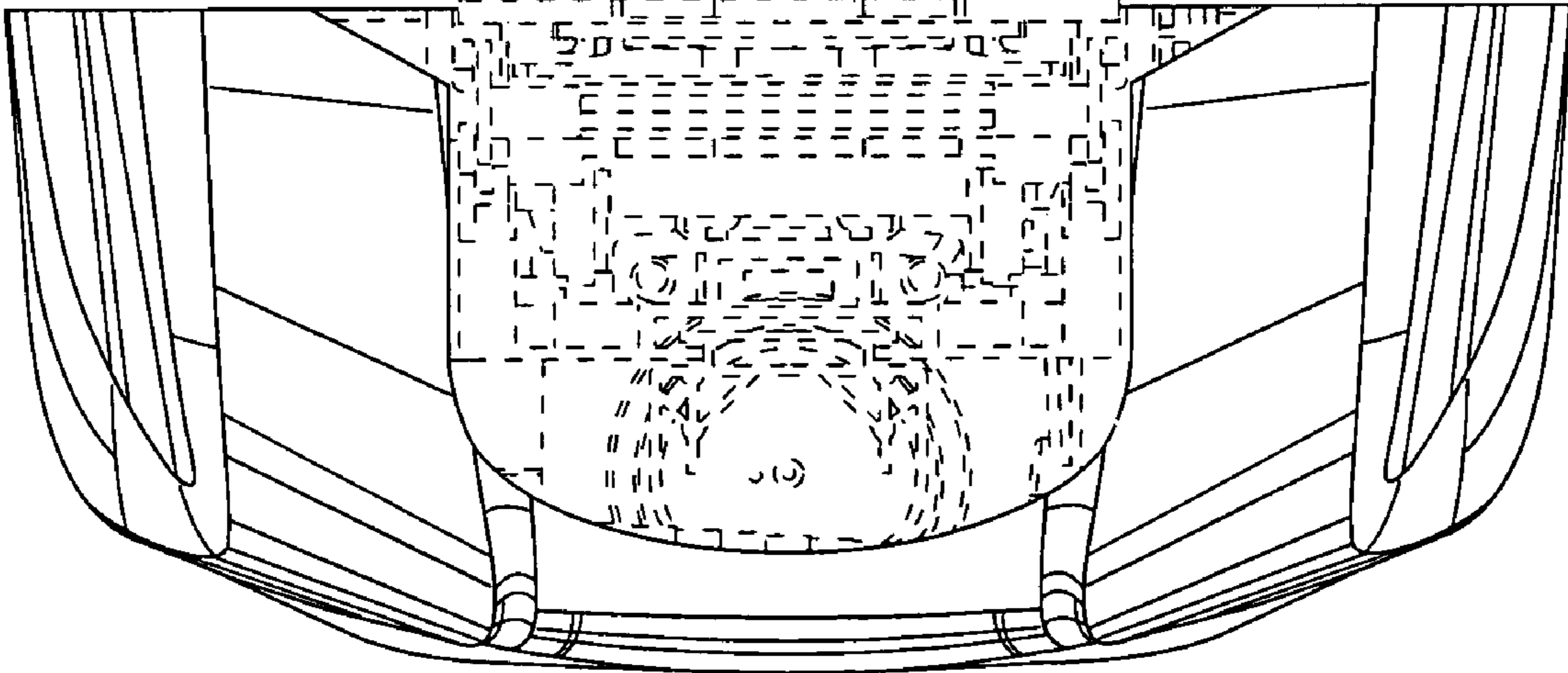

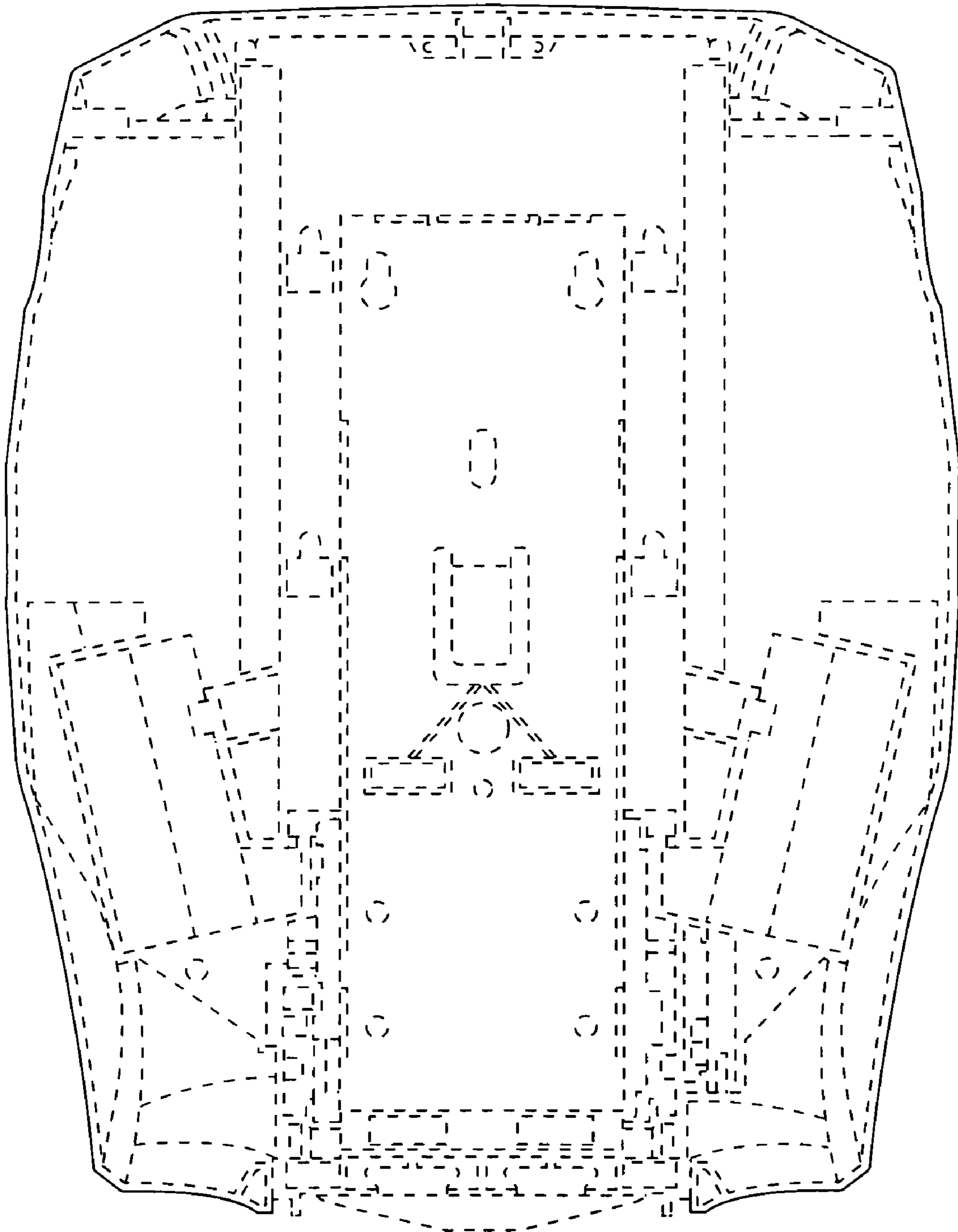

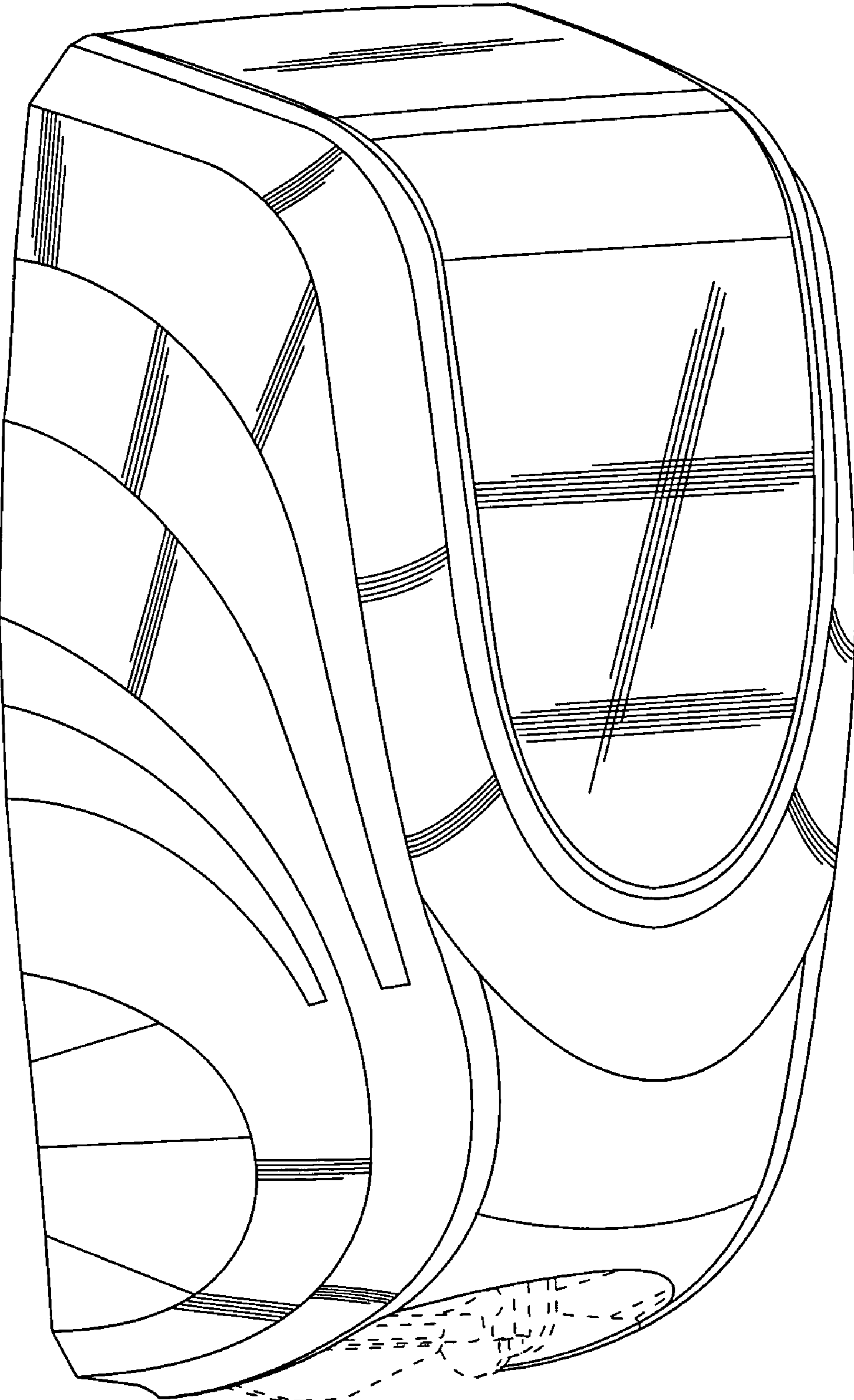

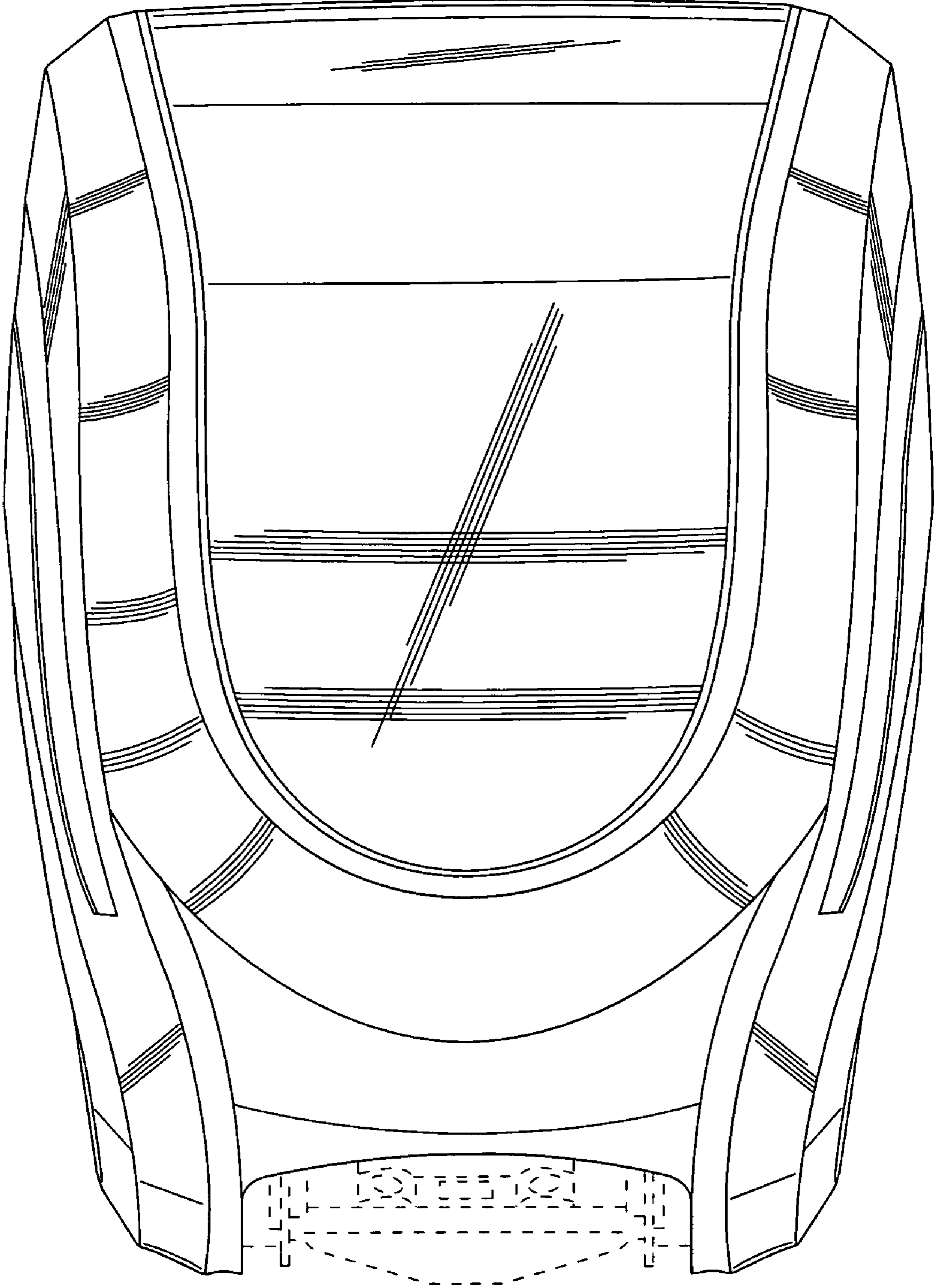

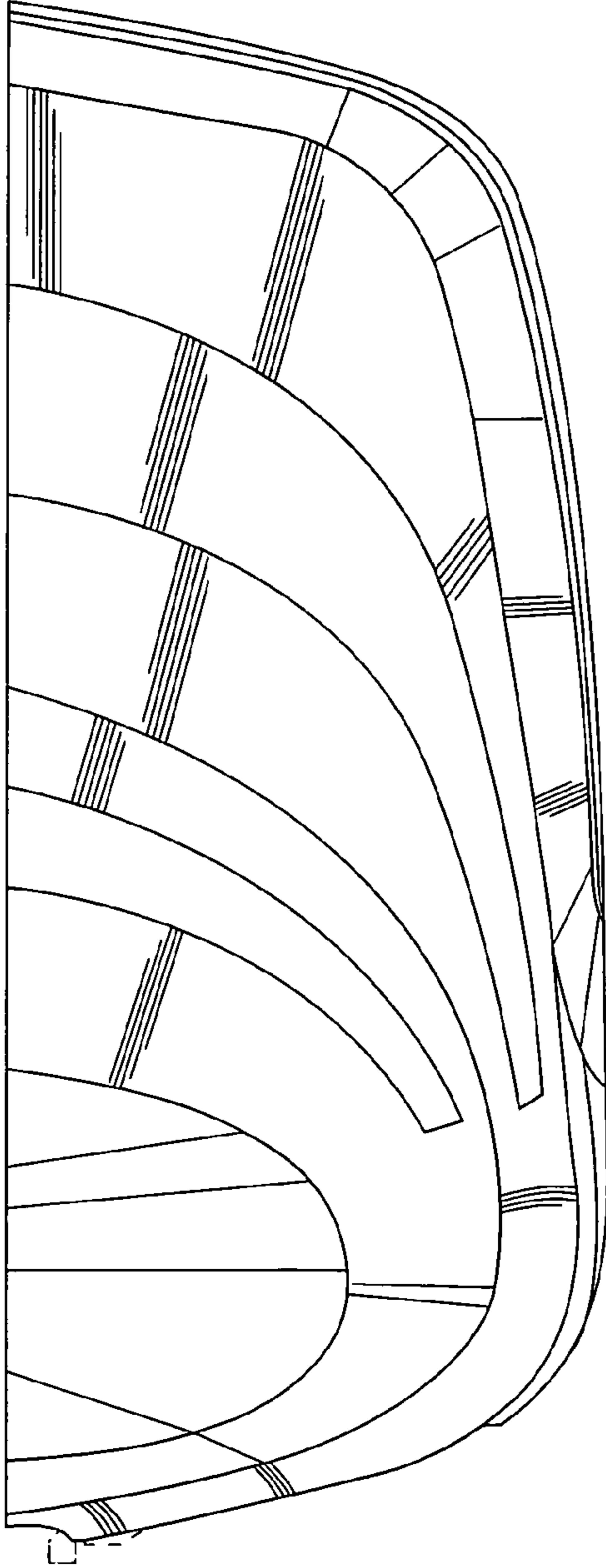

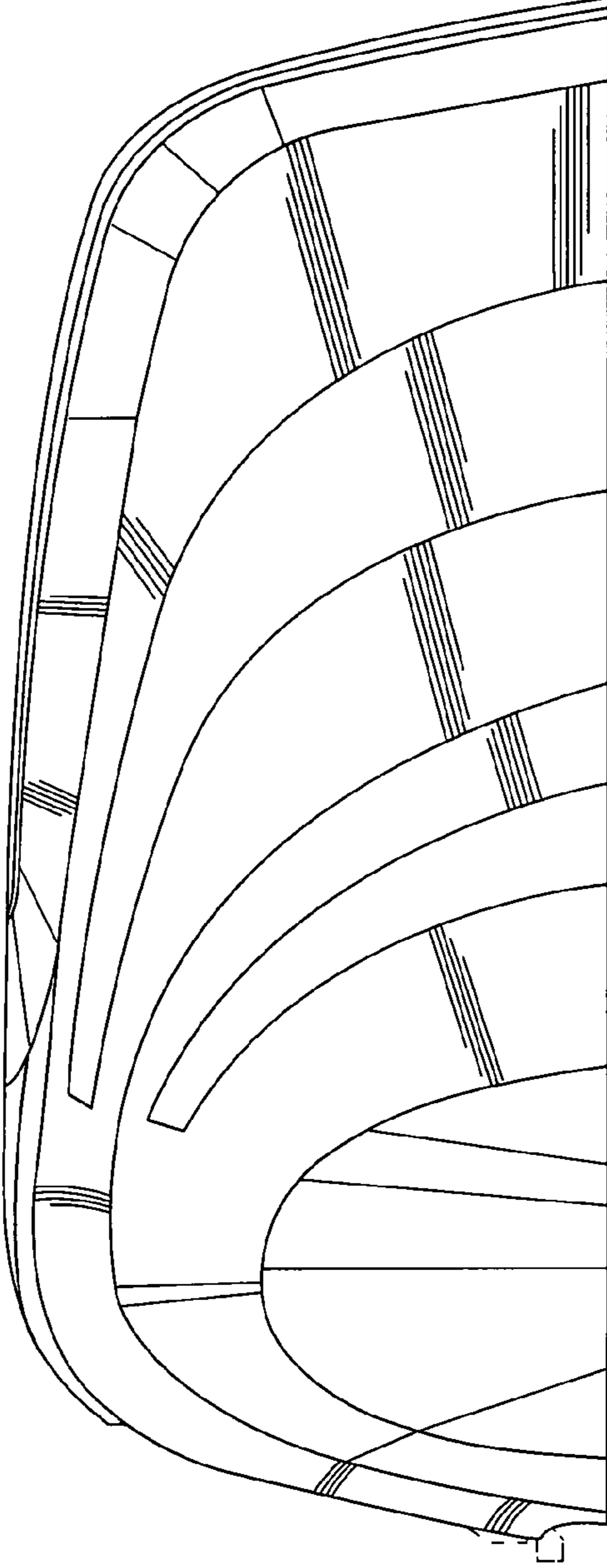

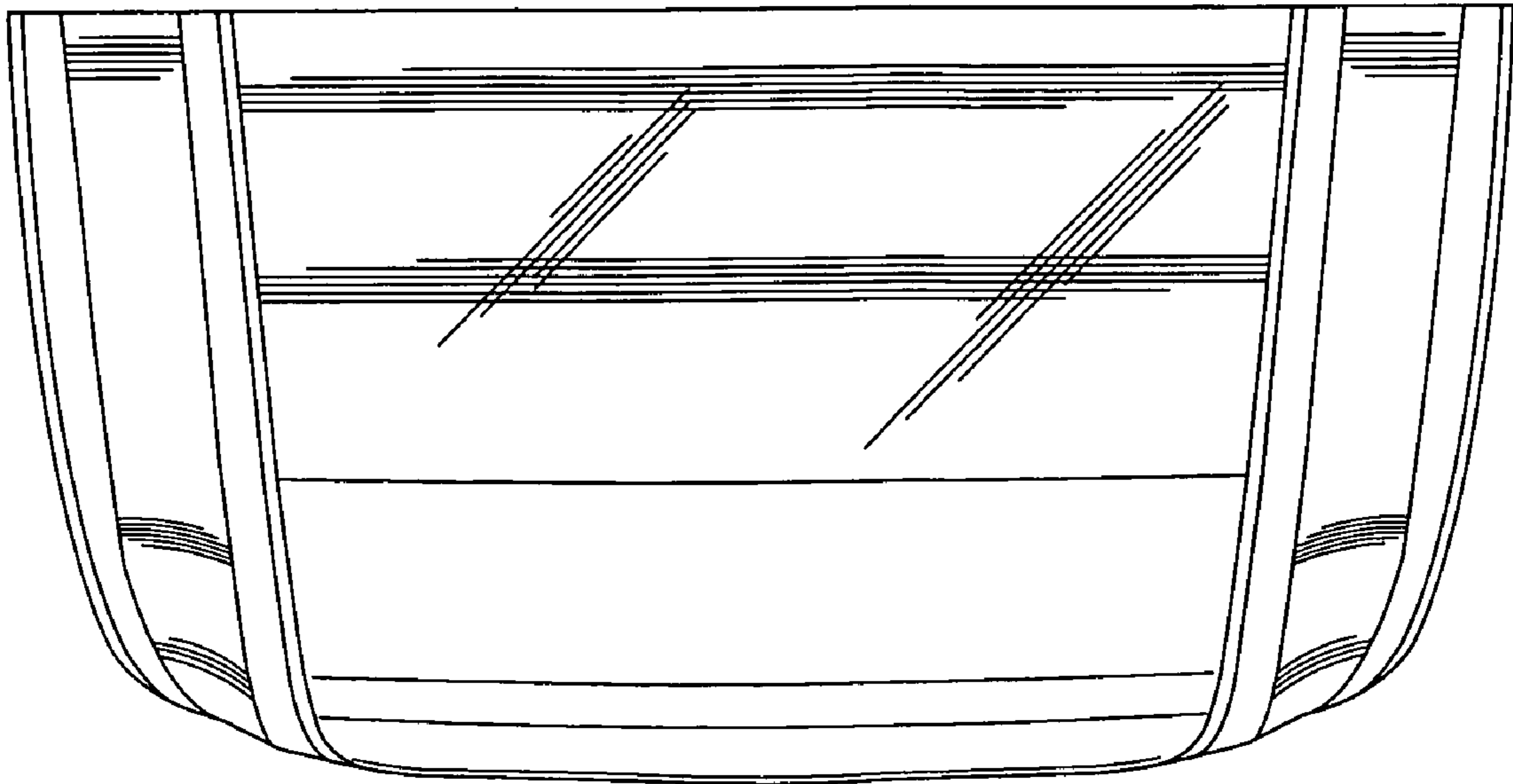

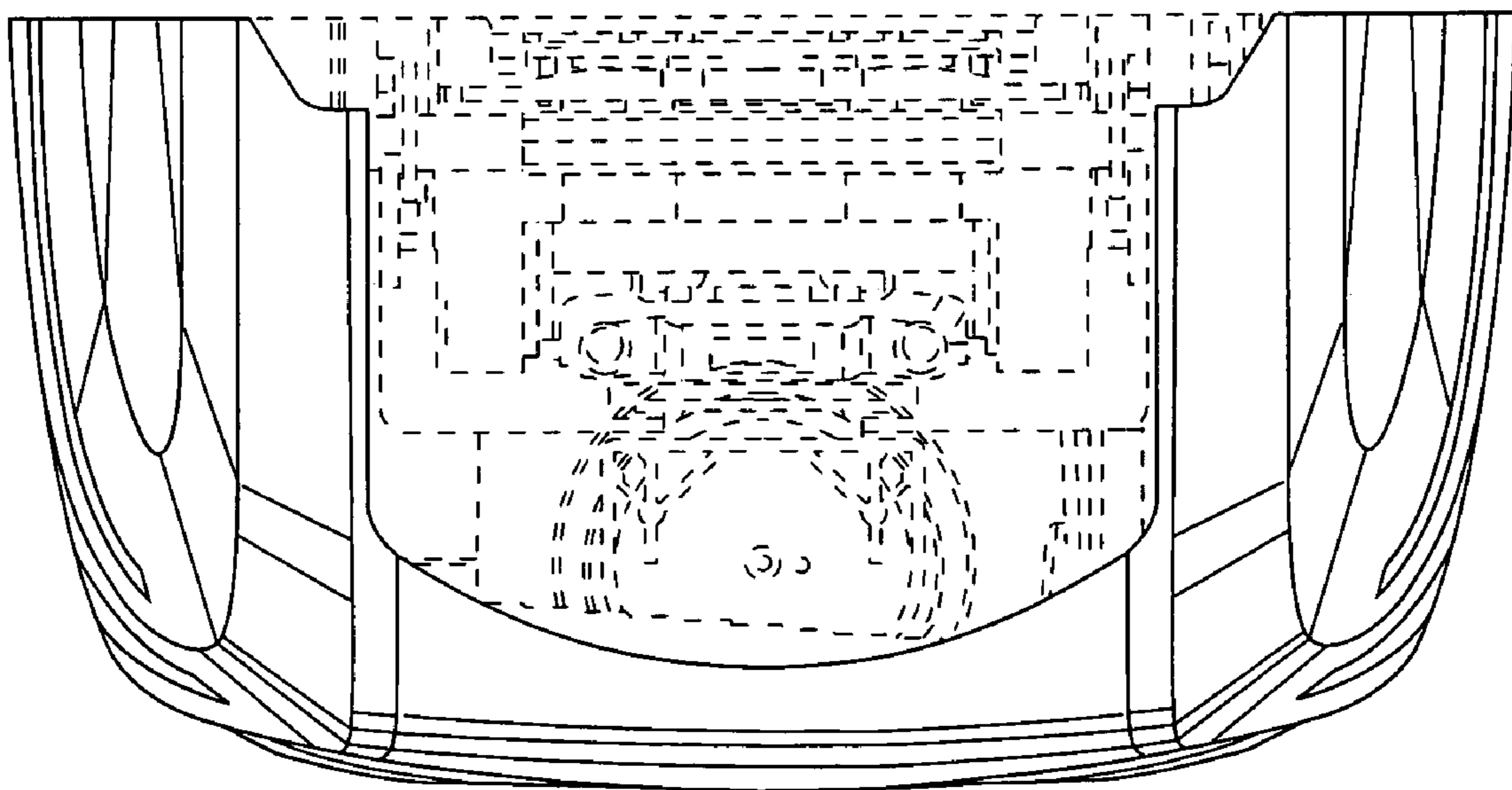
