FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the handle of FIG. 1.

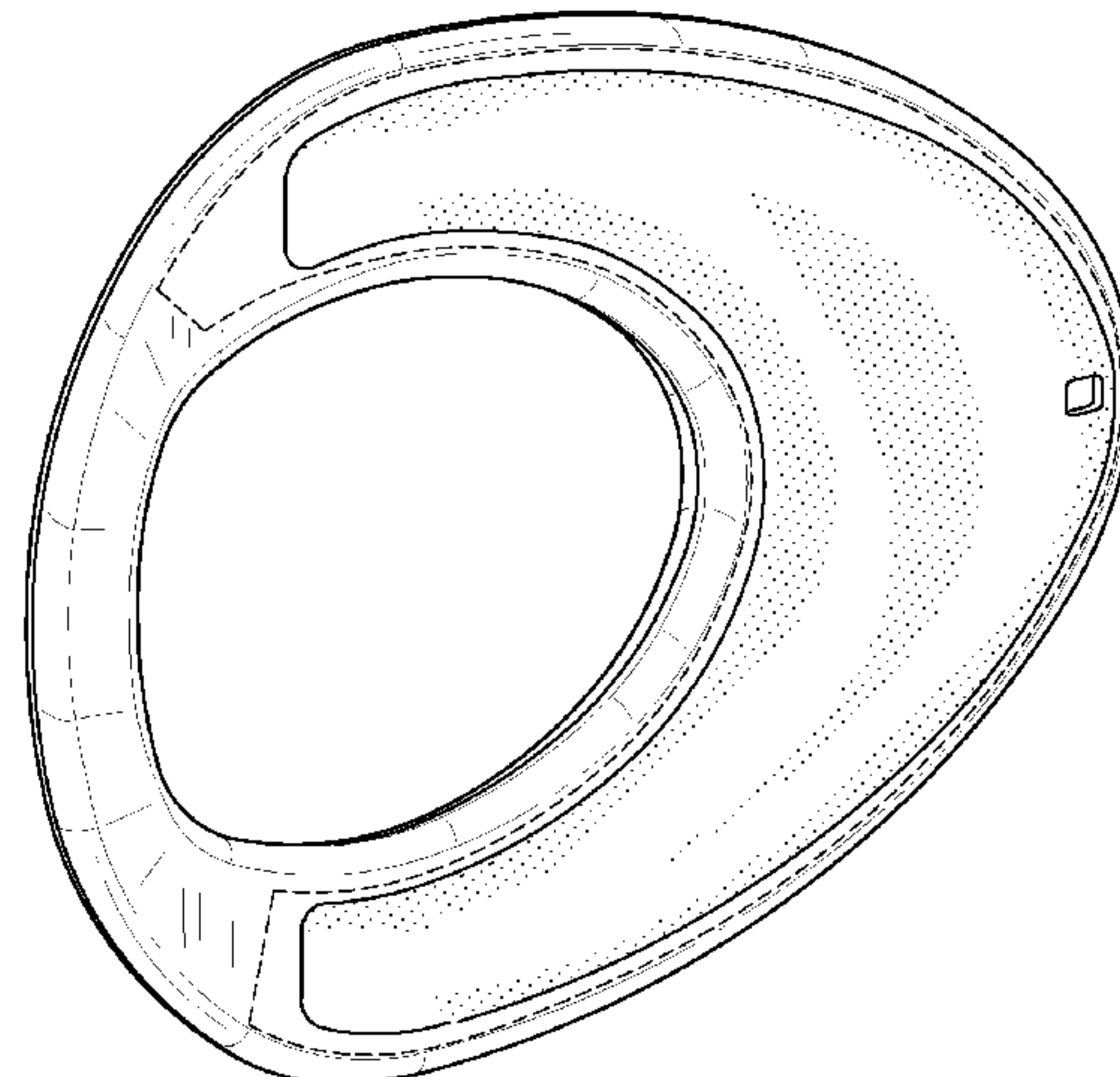
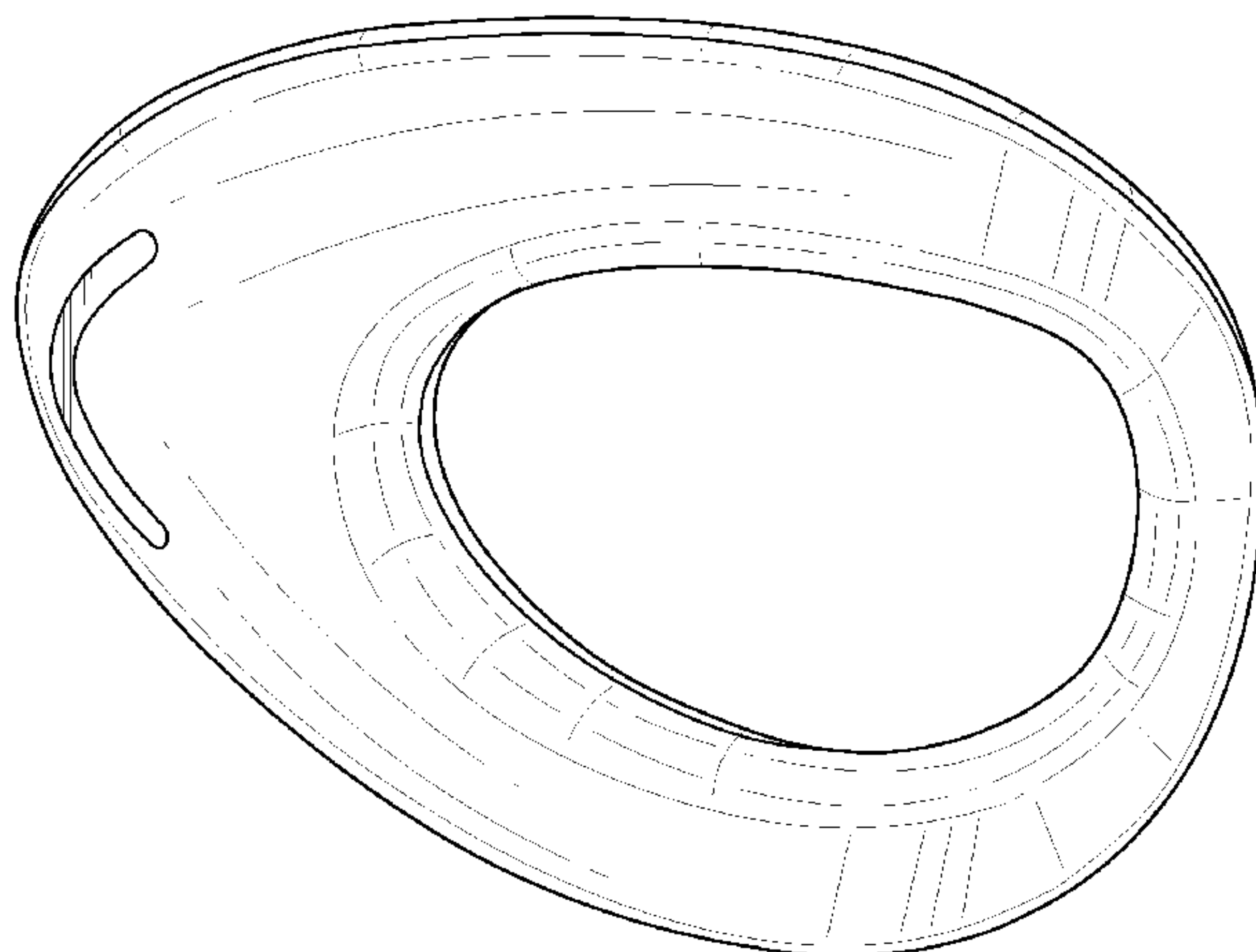
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the handle of FIG. 1.

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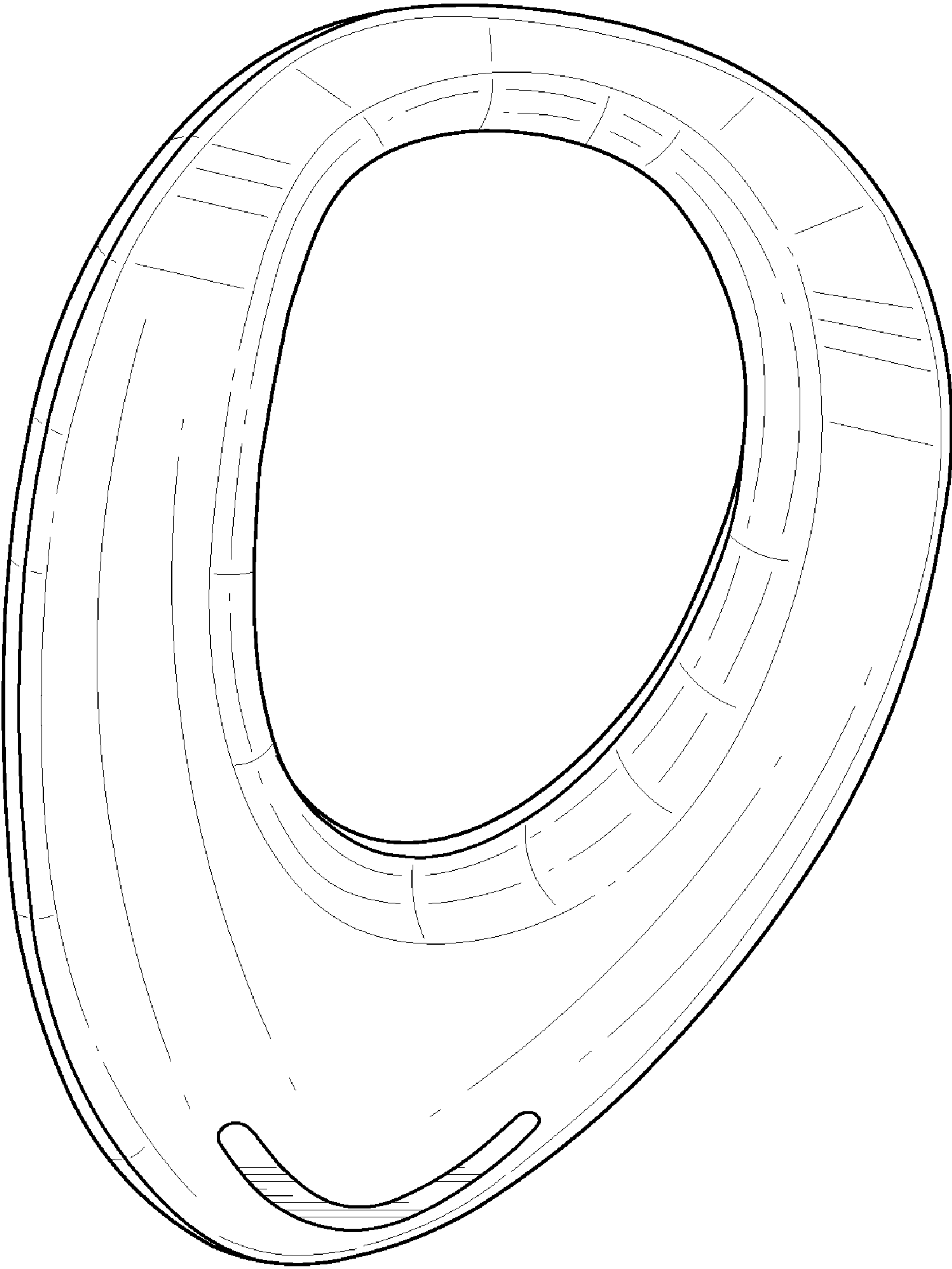

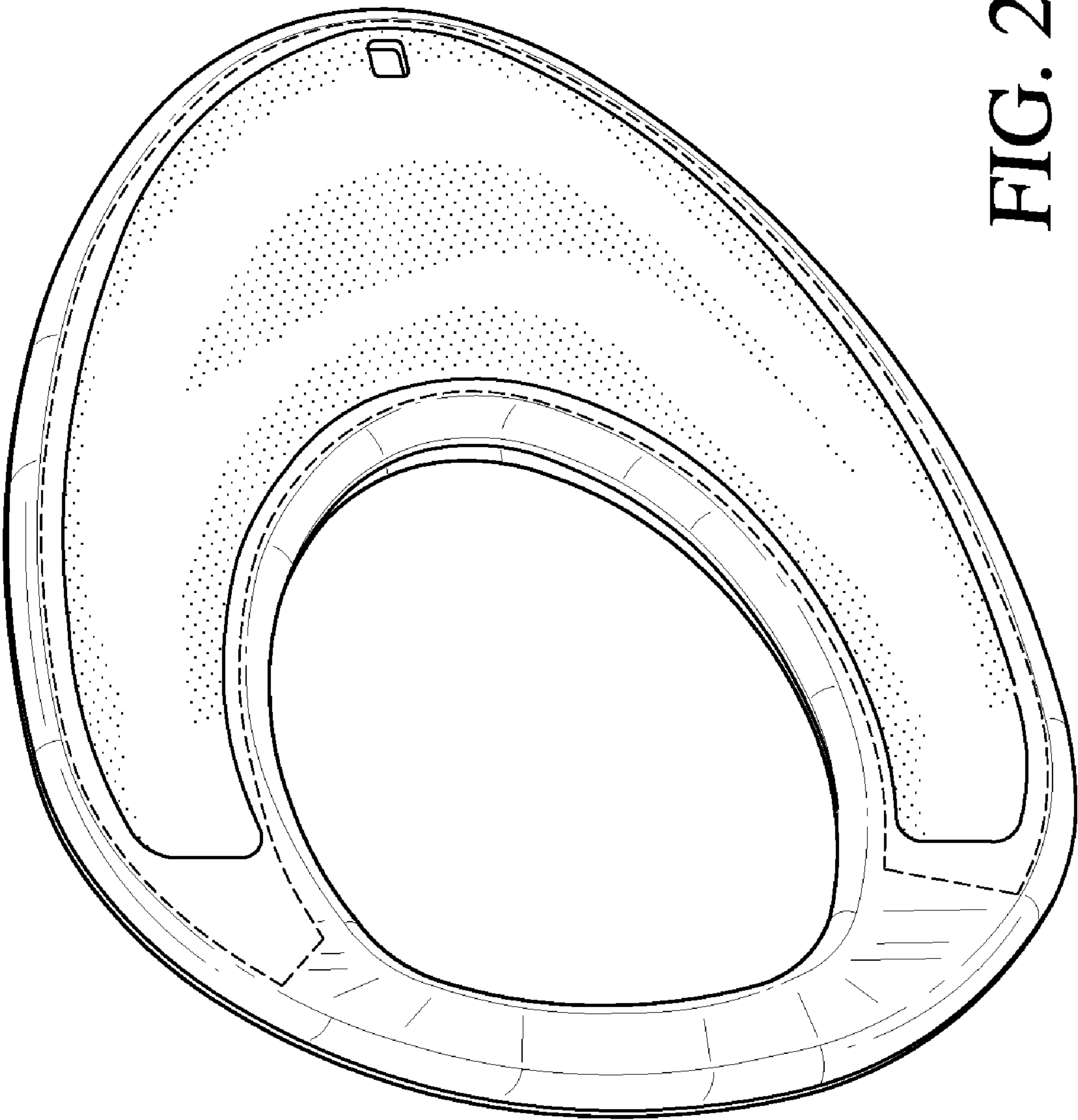

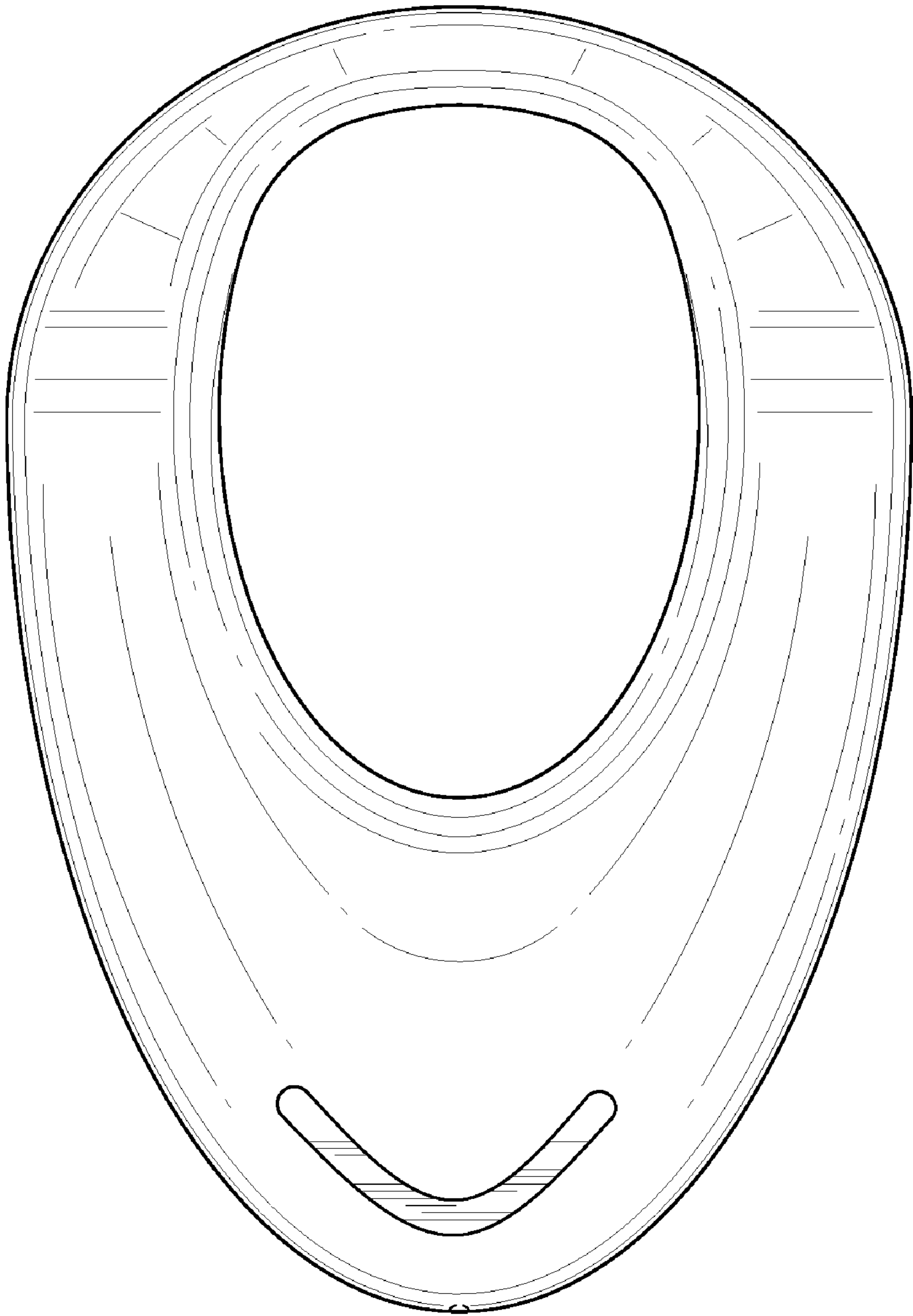

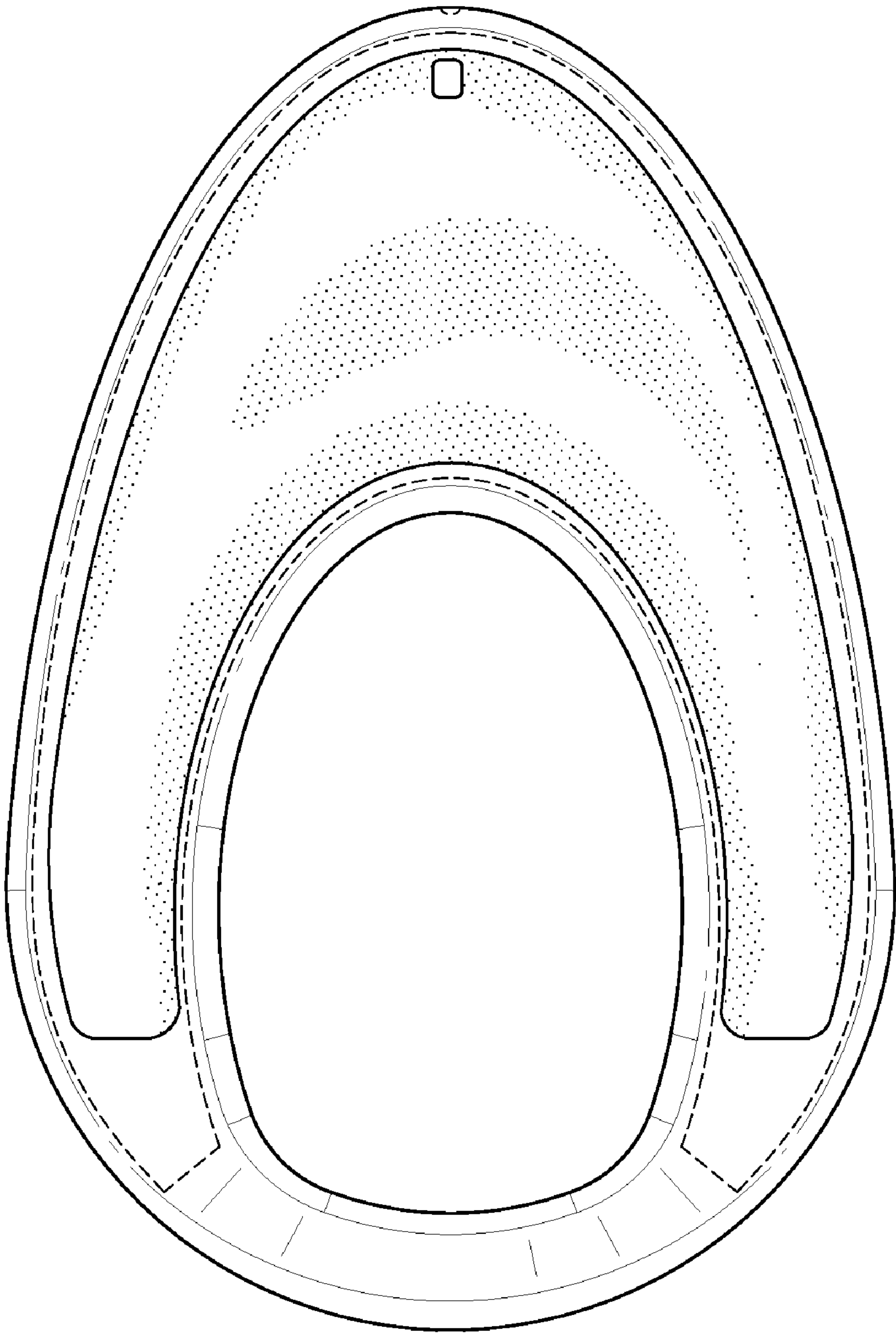

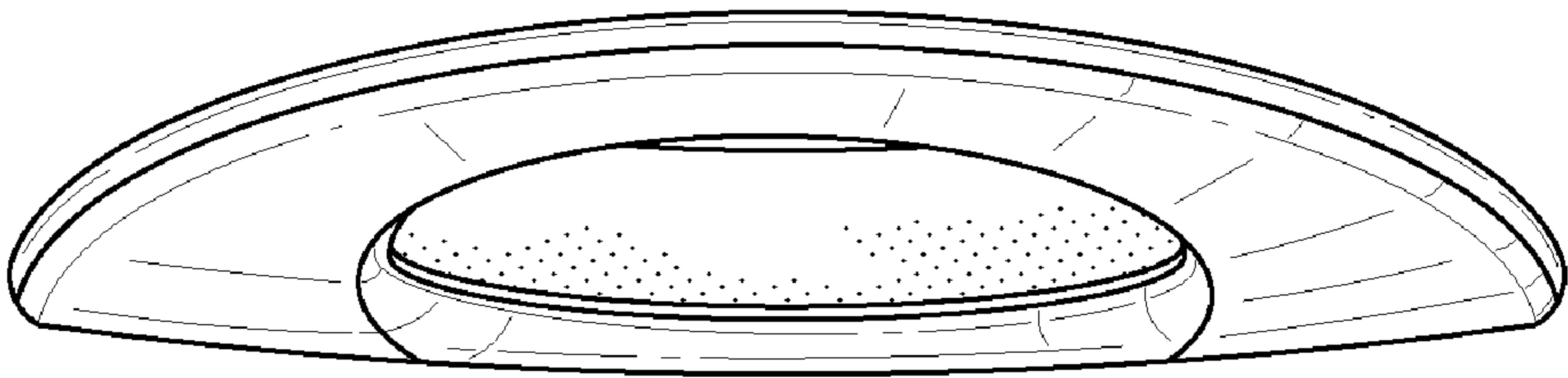

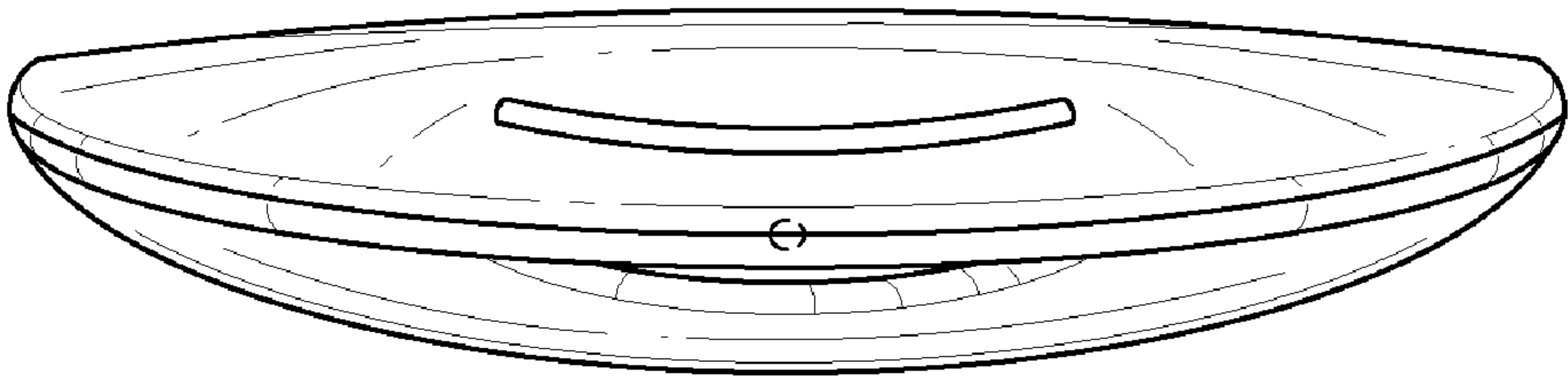
