

(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pair of gloves, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

- FIG. 1 is an elevational palm-side view of a left hand glove according to a first embodiment of the present invention;
- FIG. 2 is an elevational backhand view of the glove of FIG. 1 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 3 is an elevational thumb-side view of the glove of FIG. 1 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 4 is an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIG. 1 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 5 is an elevational palm-side view of a right hand glove according to the present invention;
- FIG. 6 is an elevational backhand view of the glove of FIG. 5 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 7 is an elevational thumb-side view of a the glove of FIG. 5 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 8 is an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIG. 5 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 9 is an elevational thumb-side view of the glove of FIGS. 1-4 and an elevational thumb-side view of the glove of FIGS. 5-8, being worn by a user according to the present invention;
- FIG. 10 is an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIGS. 1-4 and an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIGS. 5-8, being worn by a user according to the present invention;
- FIG. 11 is an elevational palm-side view of a left hand glove according to a second embodiment of the present invention;
- FIG. 12 is an elevational backhand view of the glove of FIG. 11 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 13 is an elevational thumb-side view of the glove of FIG. 11 according to the present invention;
- FIG. 14 is an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIG. 11 according to the present invention;






FIG. 15 is an elevational palm-side view of a right hand glove according to the present invention;

FIG. 16 is an elevational backhand view of the glove of FIG. 15 according to the present invention;

FIG. 17 is an elevational thumb-side view of a the glove of FIG. 15 according to the present invention;

FIG. 18 is an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIG. 15 according to the present invention;

FIG. 19 is an elevational thumb-side view of the glove of FIGS. 11-14 and an elevational thumb-side view of the glove of FIGS. 15-18, being worn by a user according to the present invention; and,

FIG. 20 is an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIGS. 11-14 and an elevational pinkie-side view of the glove of FIGS. 15-18, being worn by a user according to the present invention.

The gloves of FIGS. 1-8 and 11-18 are shown separately from one another for clarity of disclosure. The stippling in the drawings represents color contrast. The portion of a human arm shown in broken lines in FIGS. 9, 10, 19 and 20 illustrates the claimed design in use. The broken-line subject matter forms no part of the claim.
