DESCRIPTION

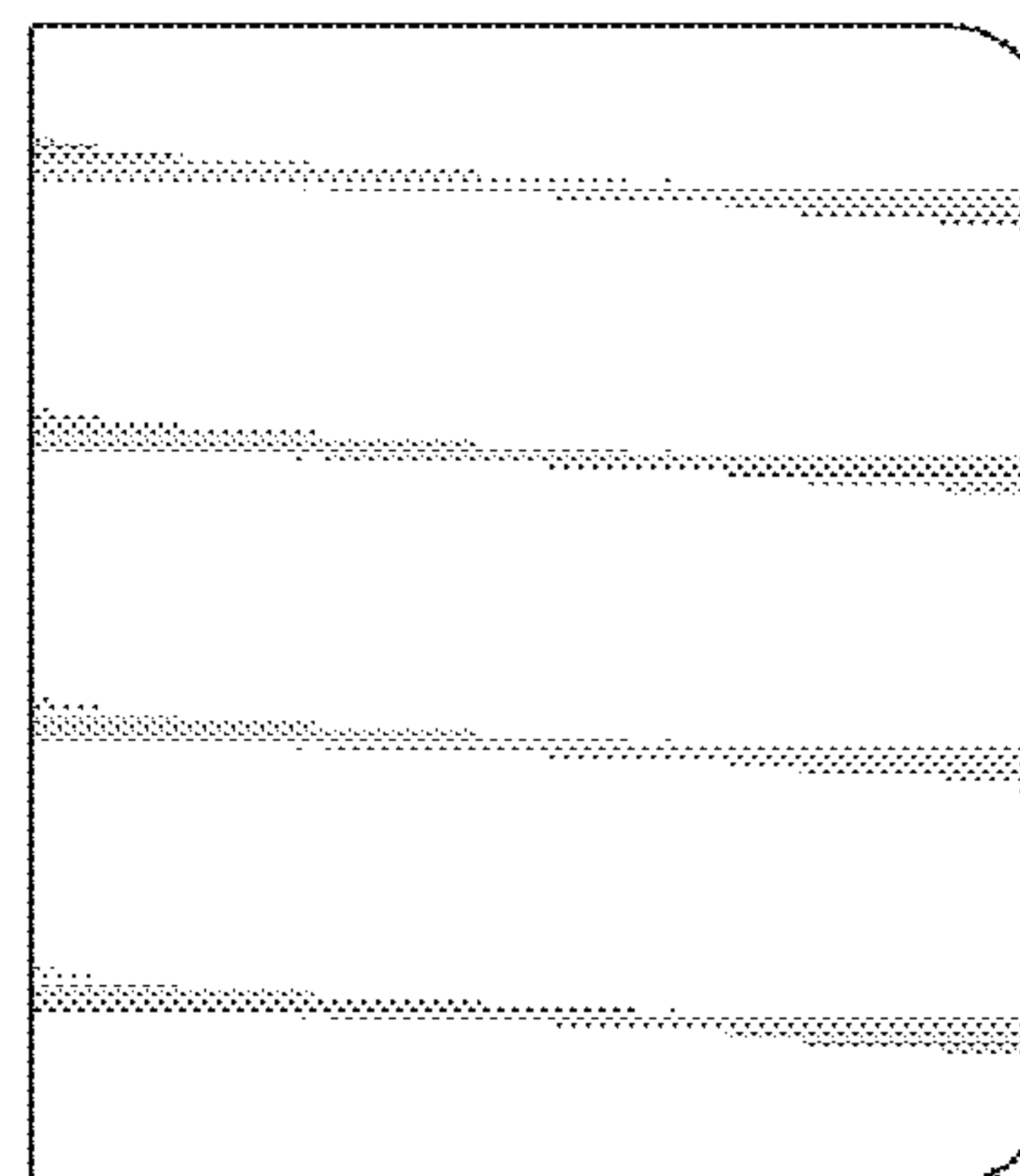
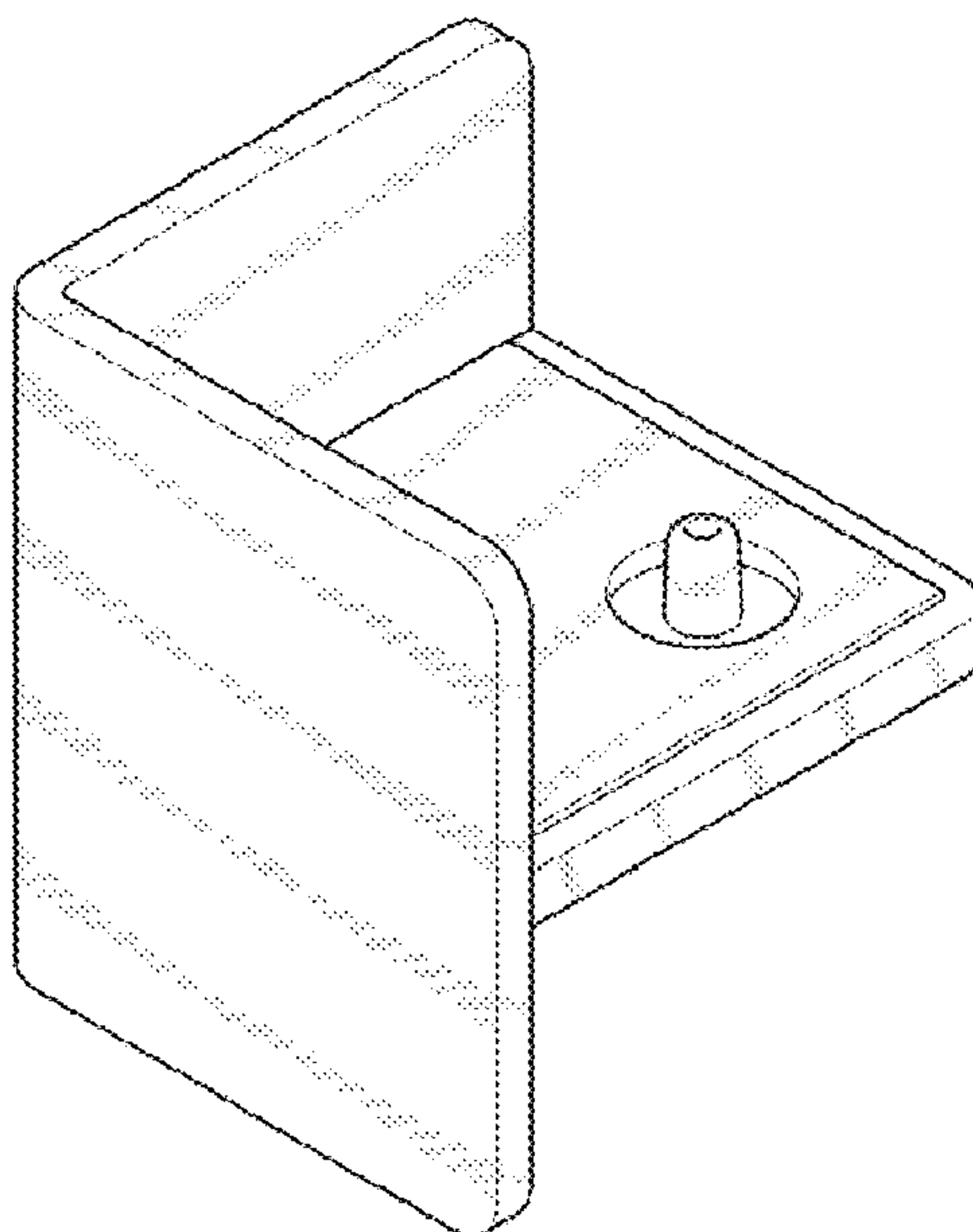

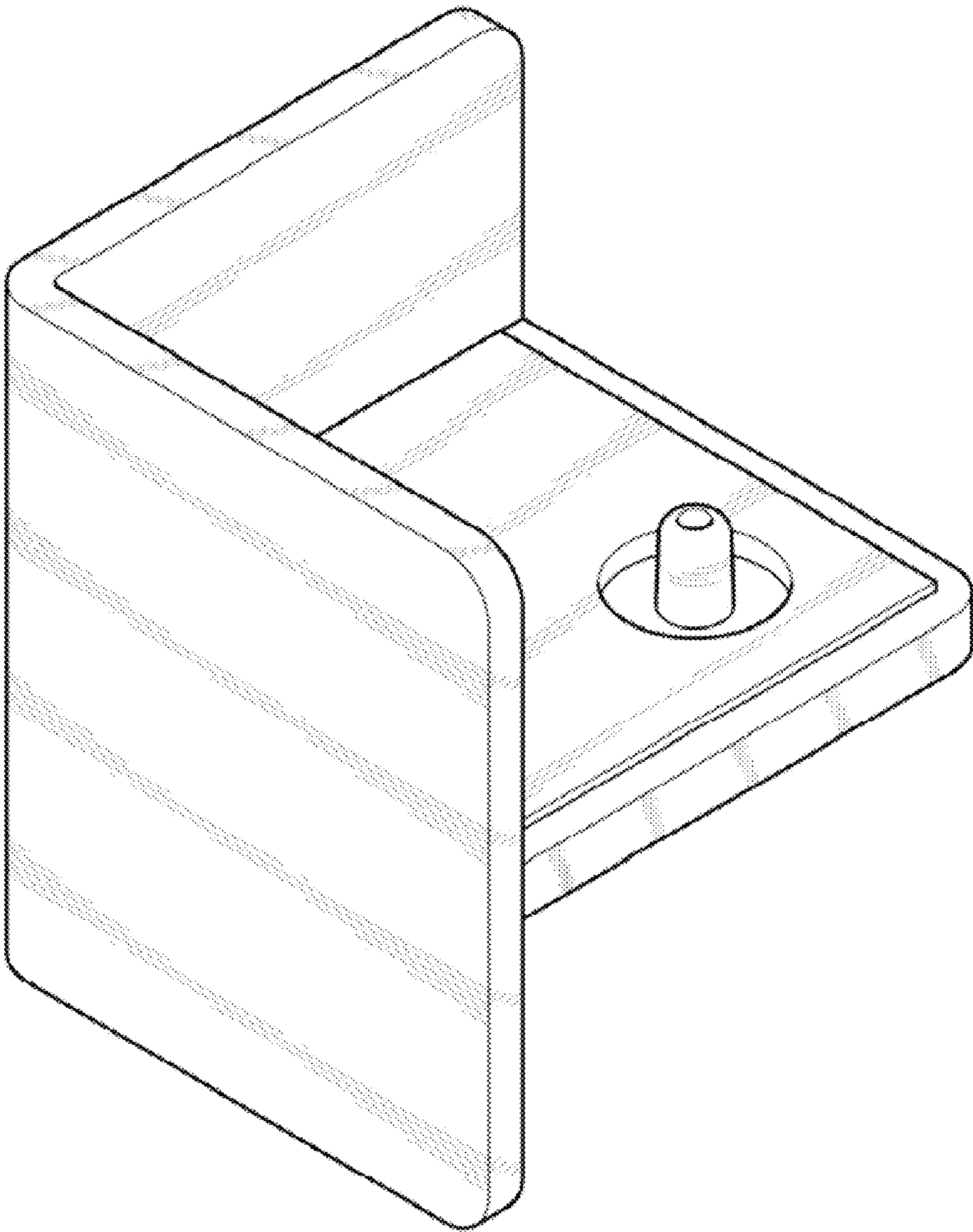

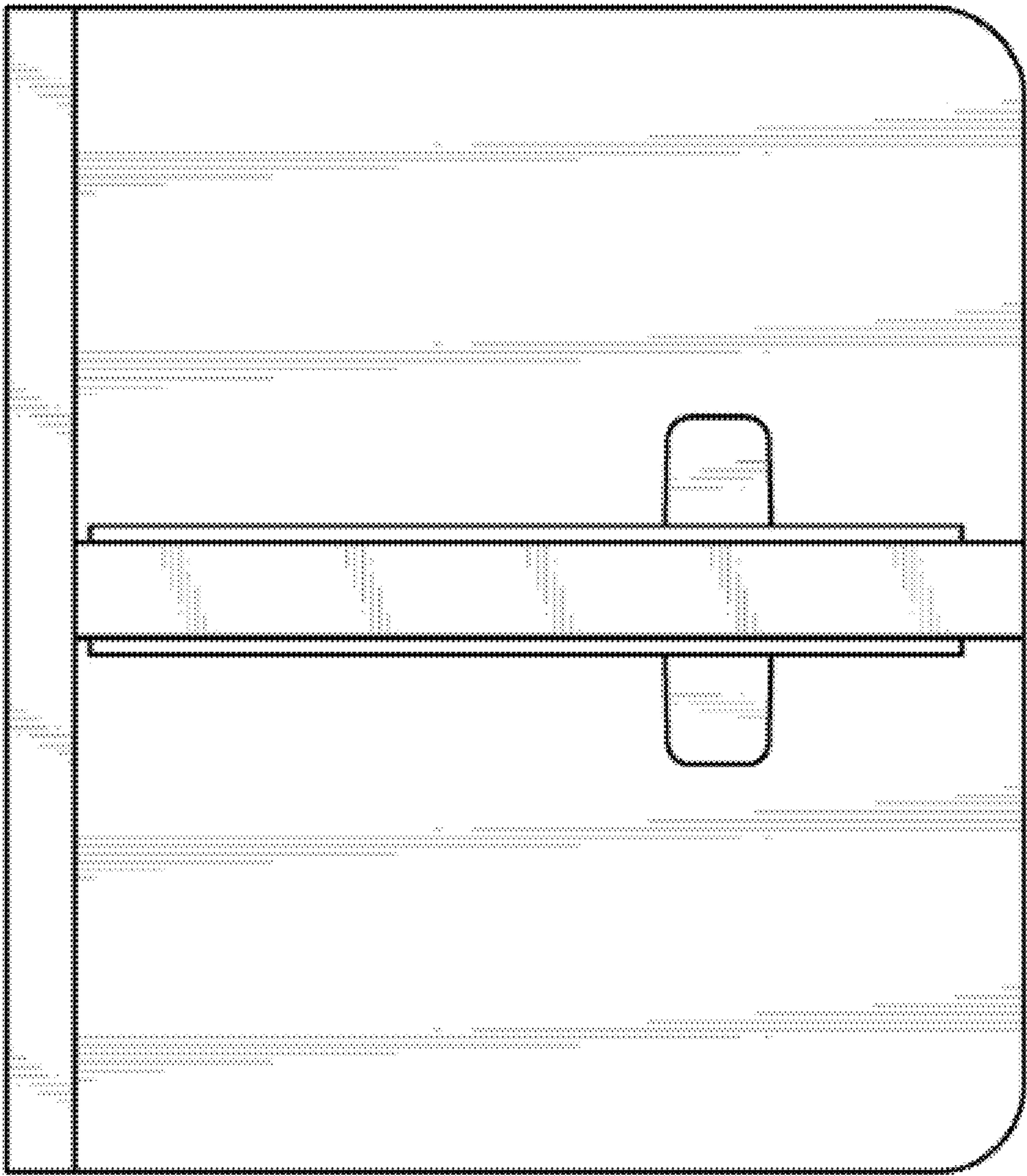

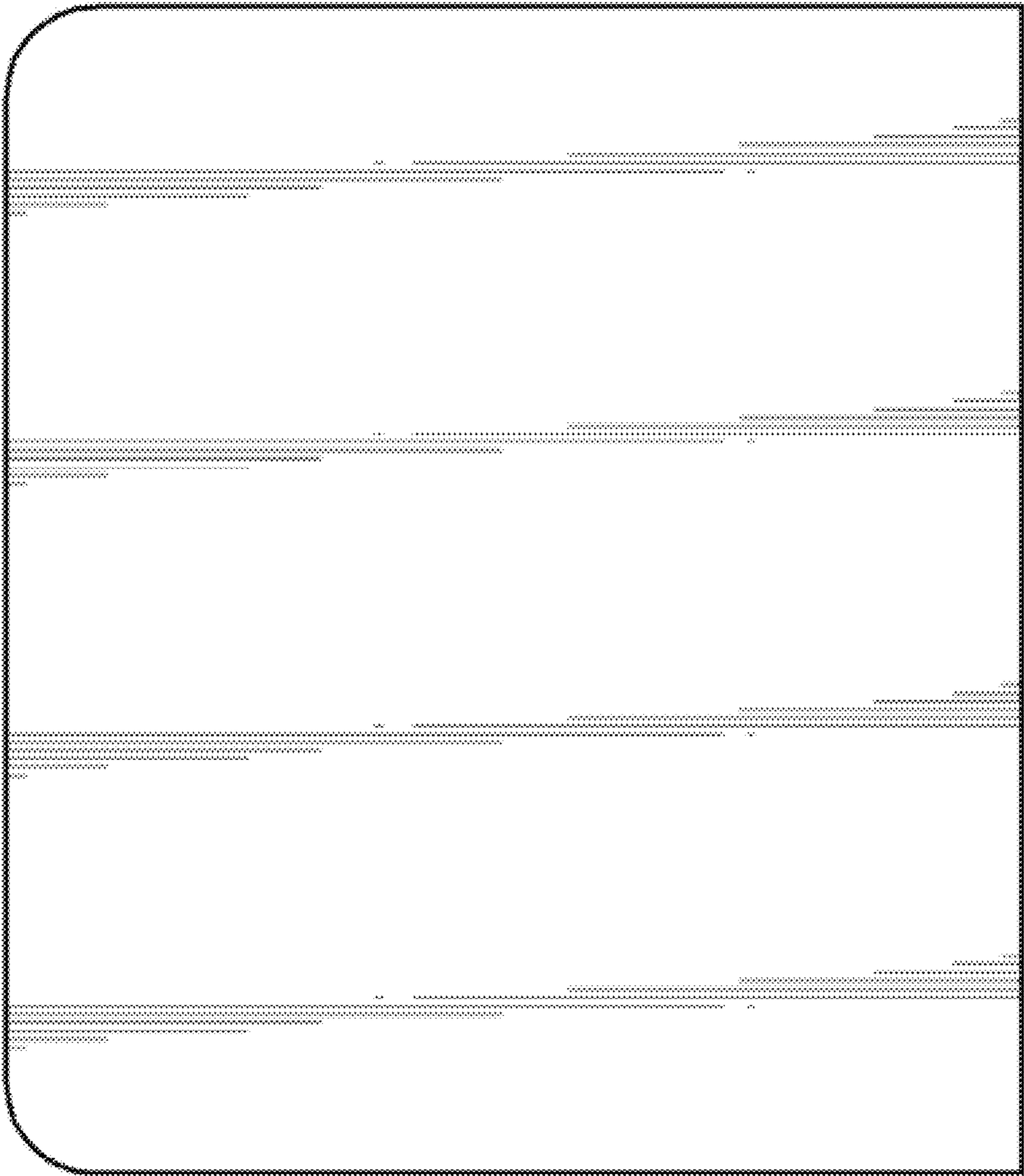

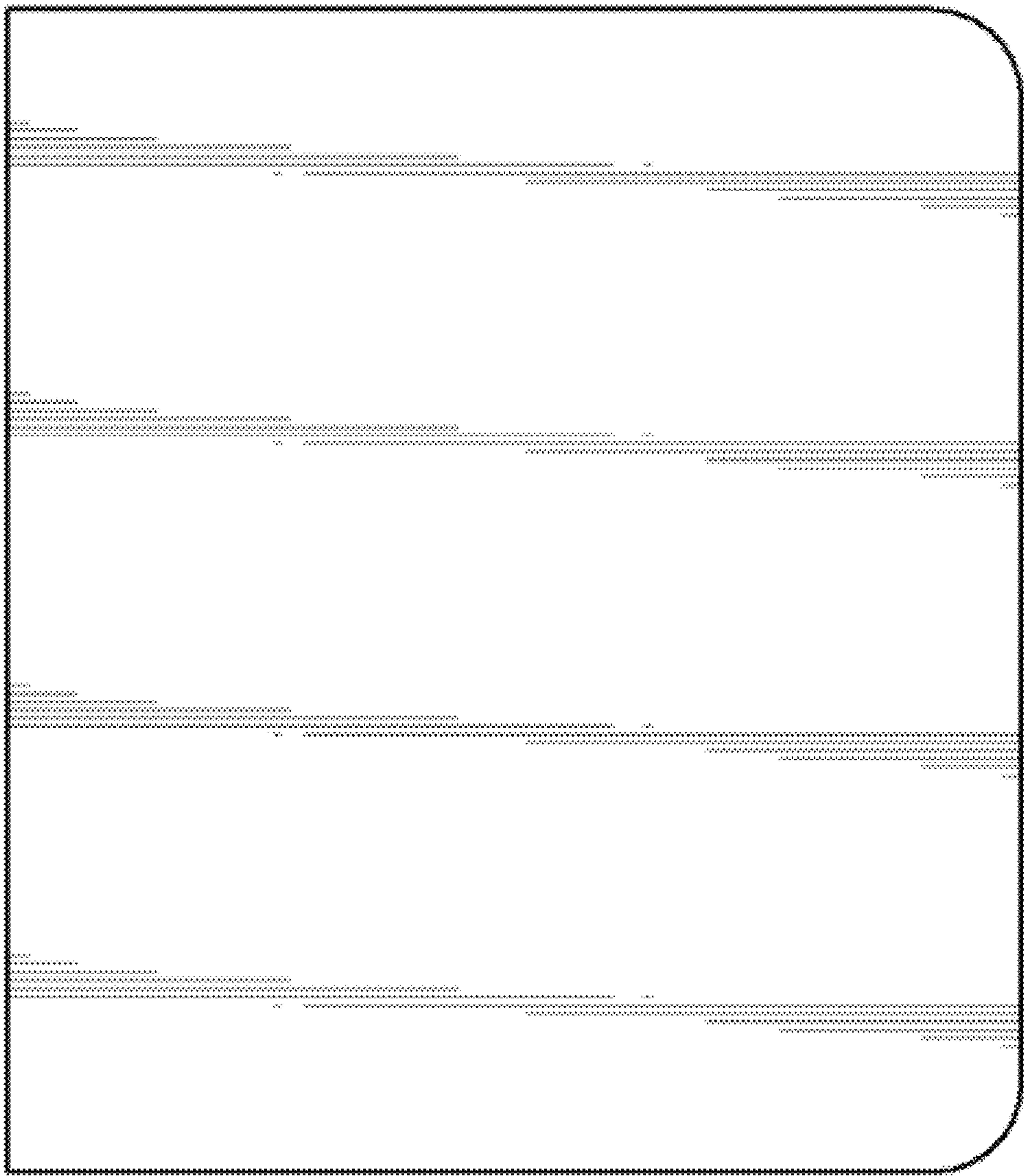

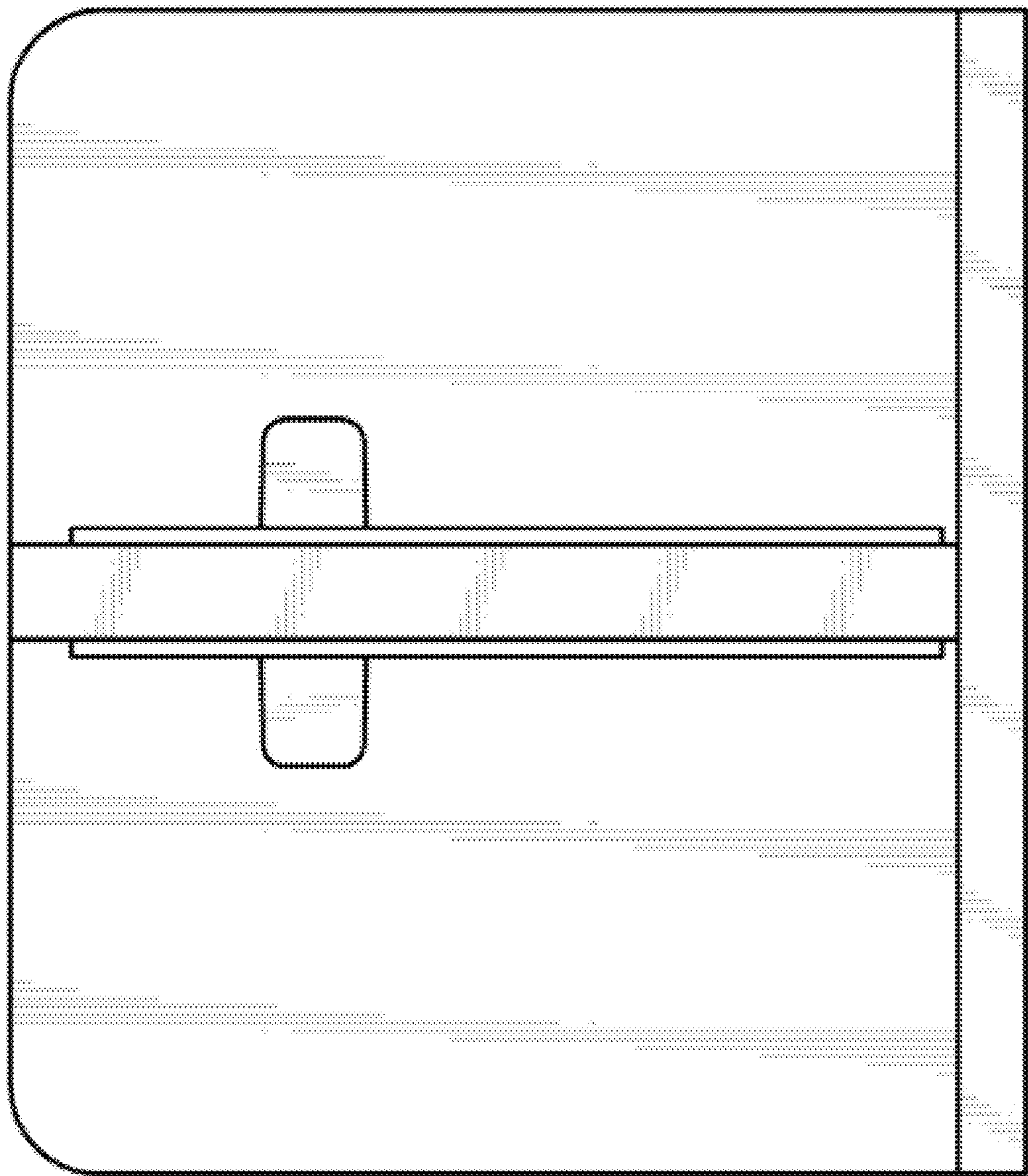

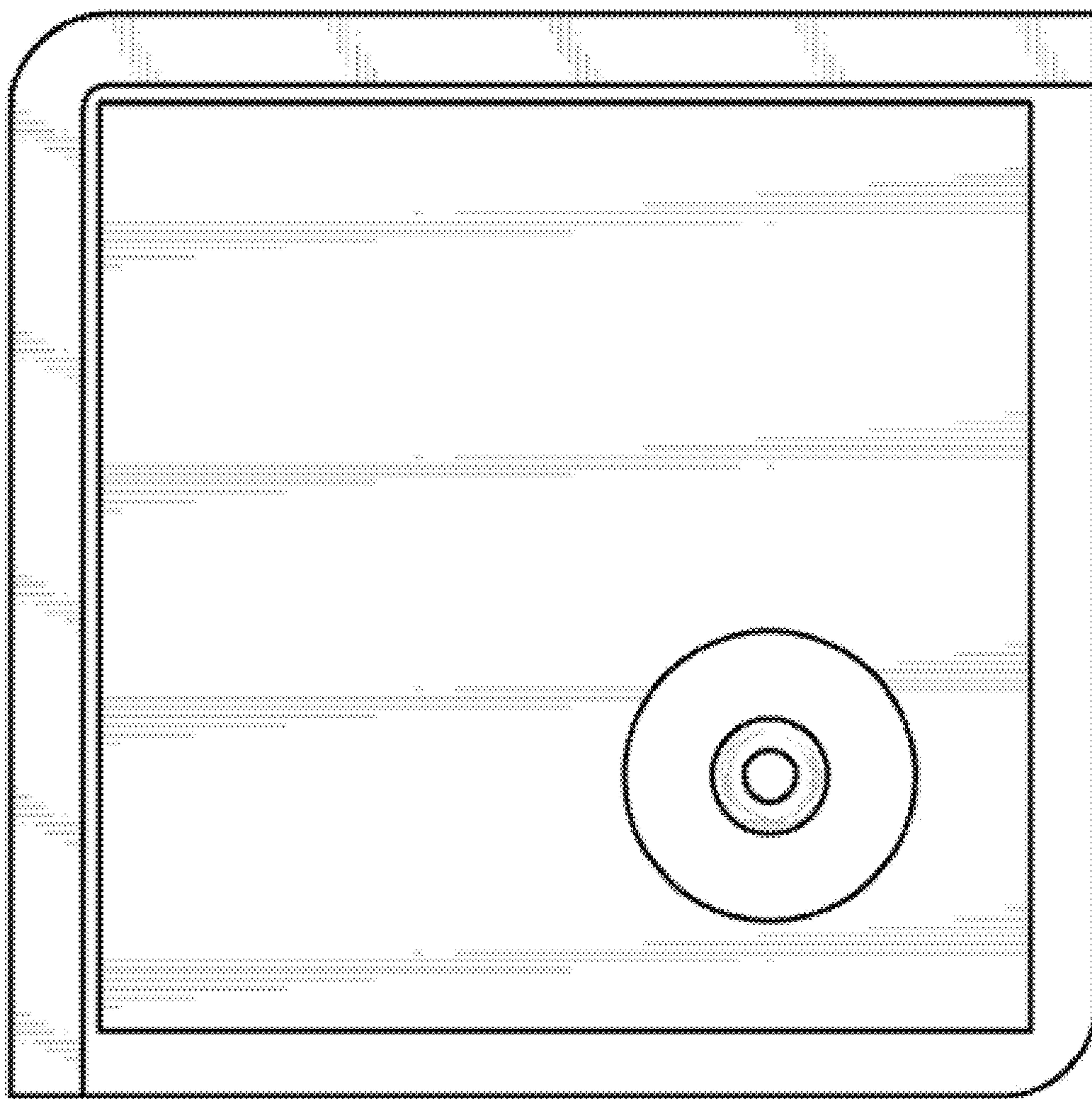

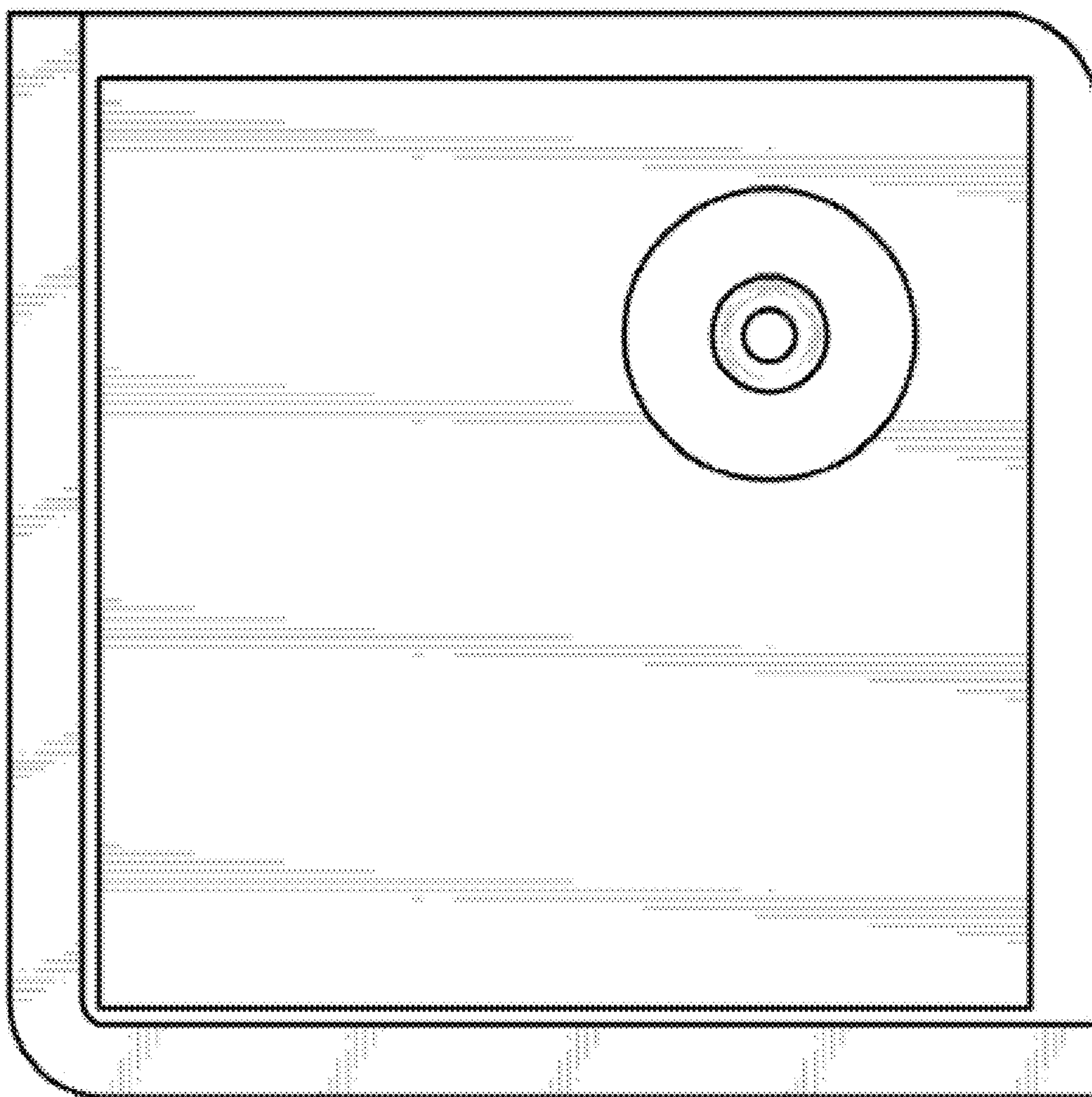
