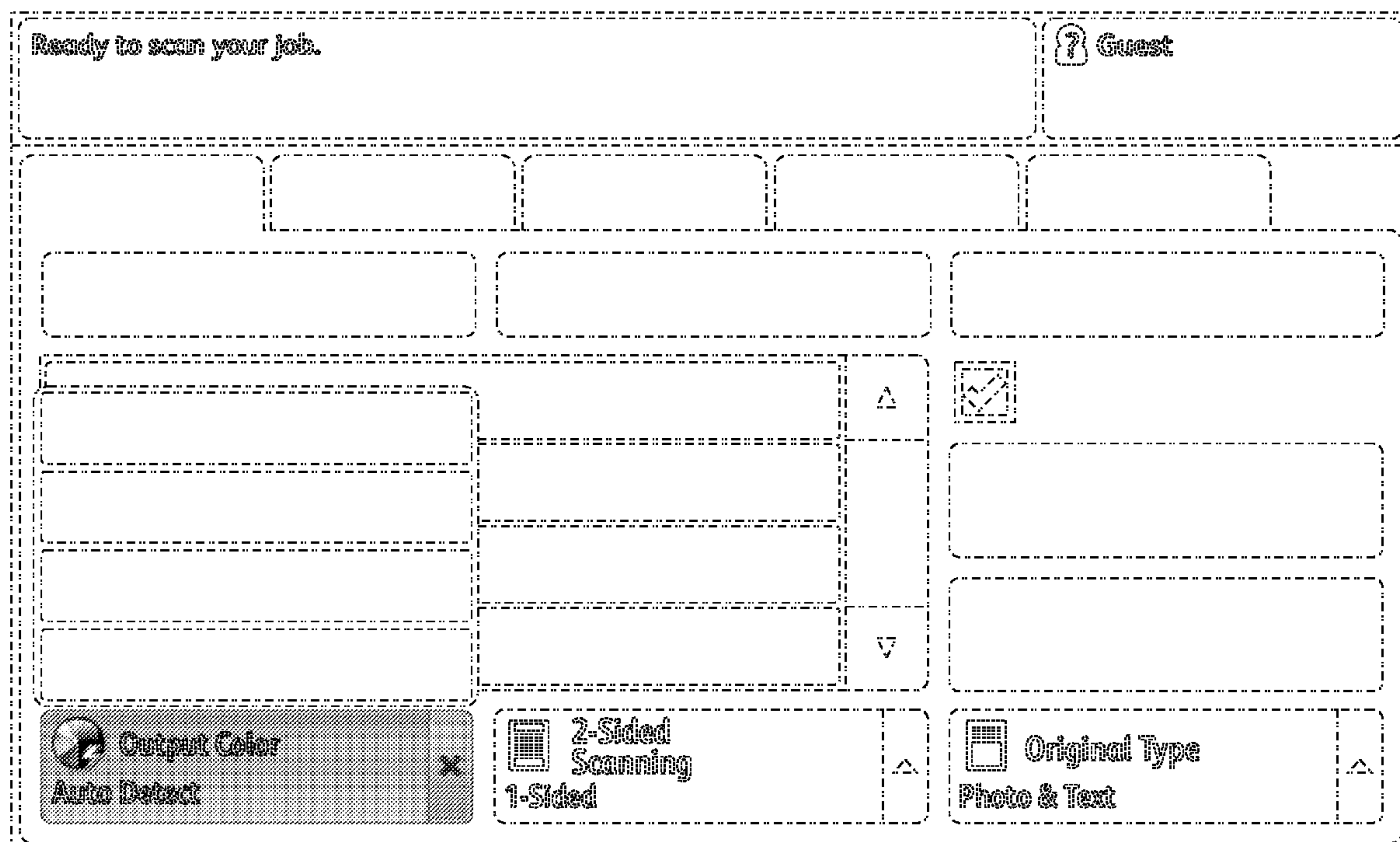
The ornamental design for a menu bearing button for a touch-based user interface for a display screen, as shown and described.
