FIG. 9 is a first end view of the luggage of FIG. 8;

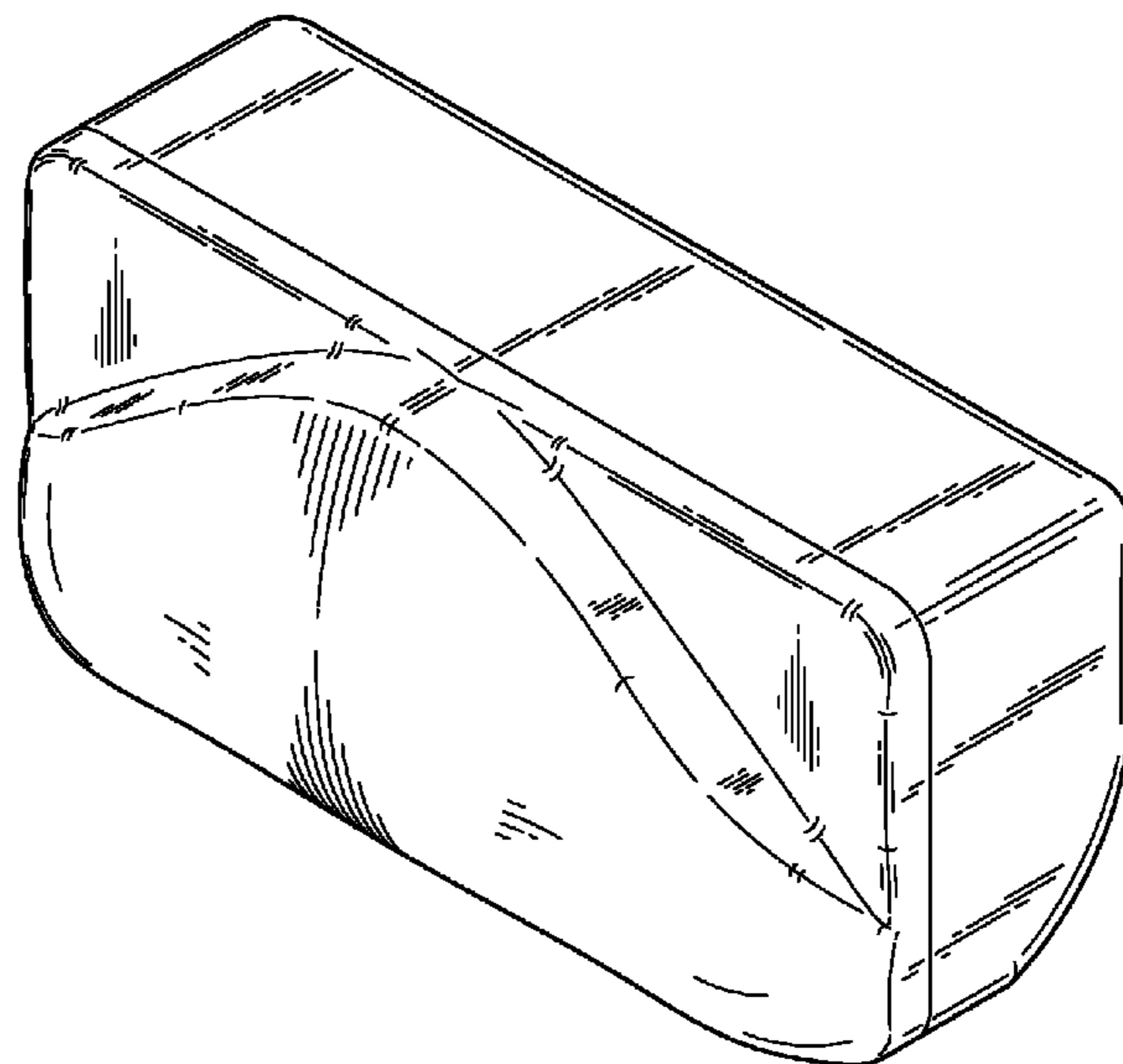
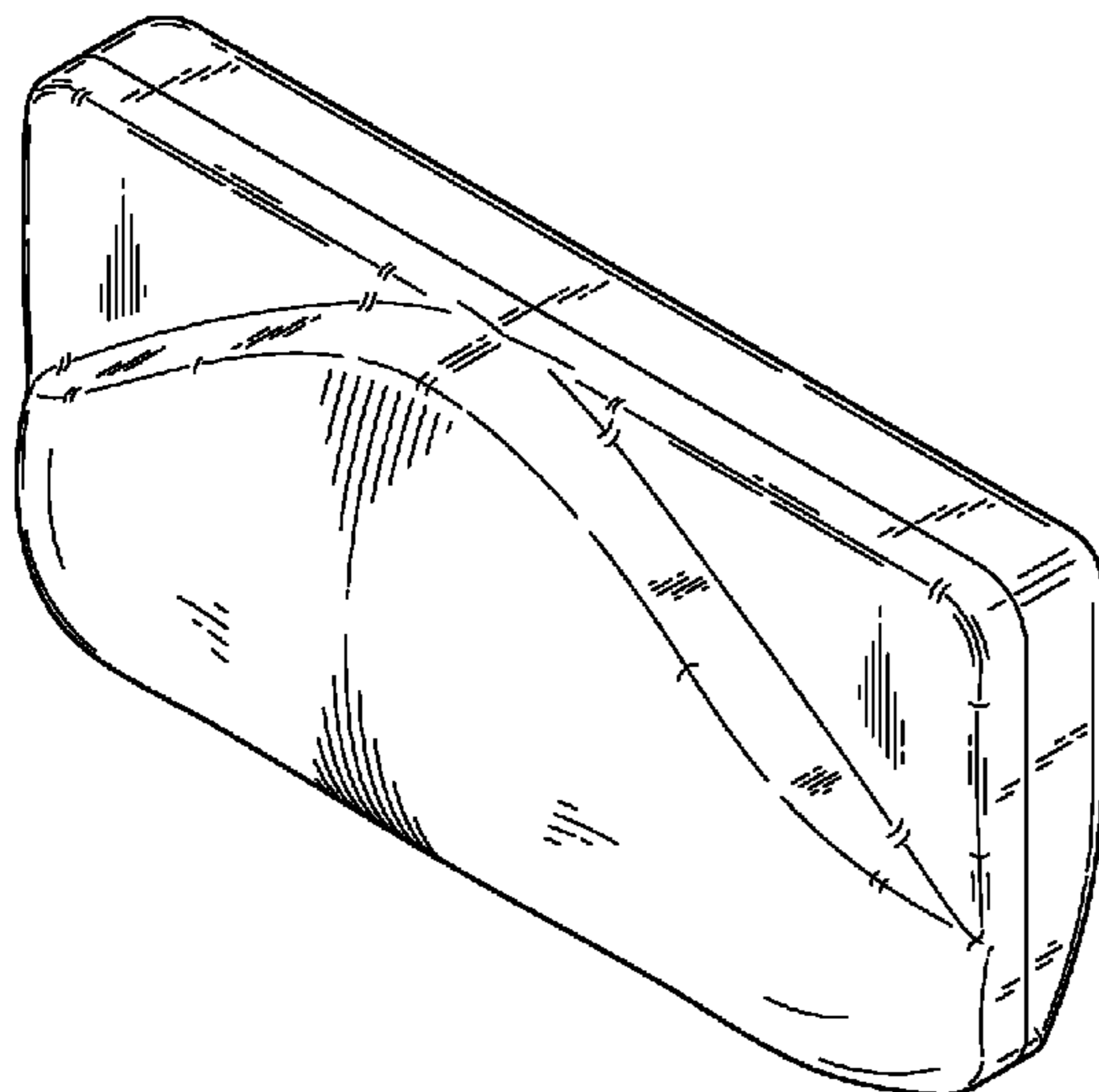
FIG. 10 is a second end view of the luggage of FIG. 8;

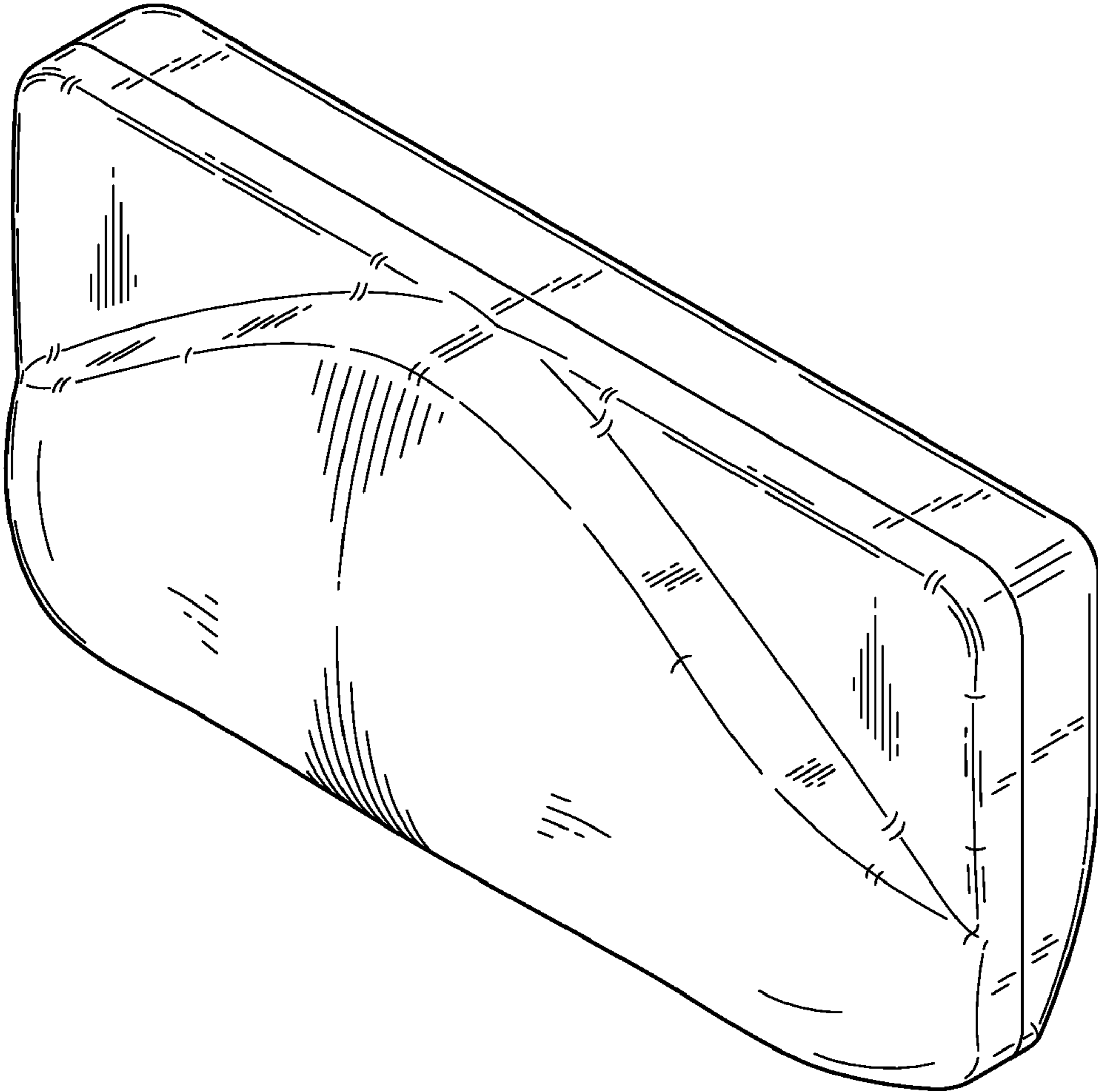

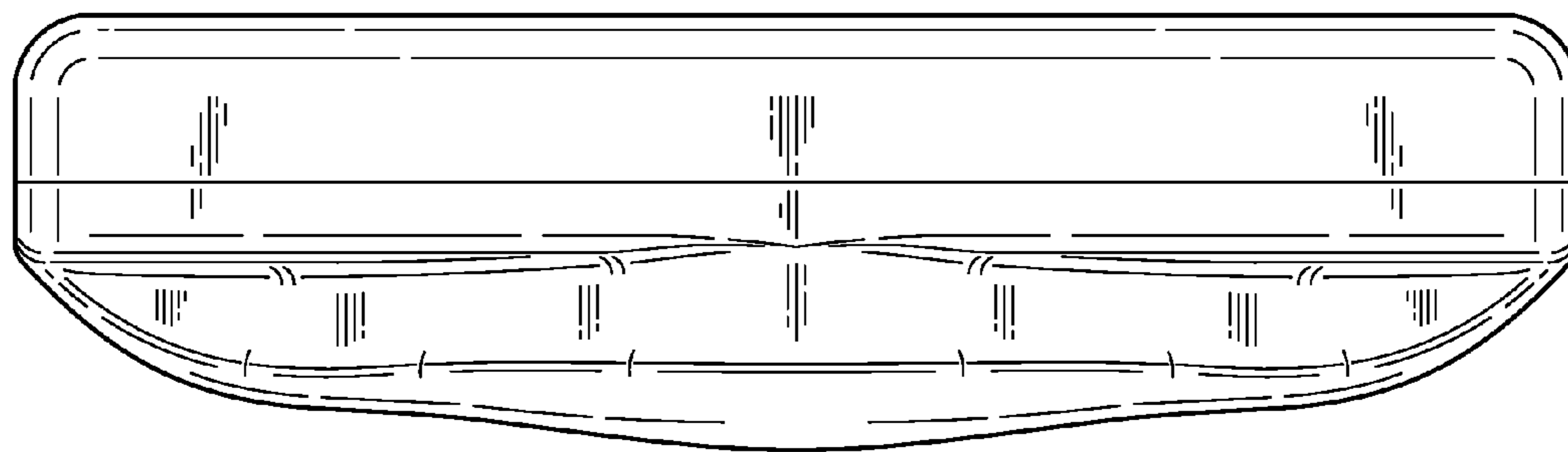

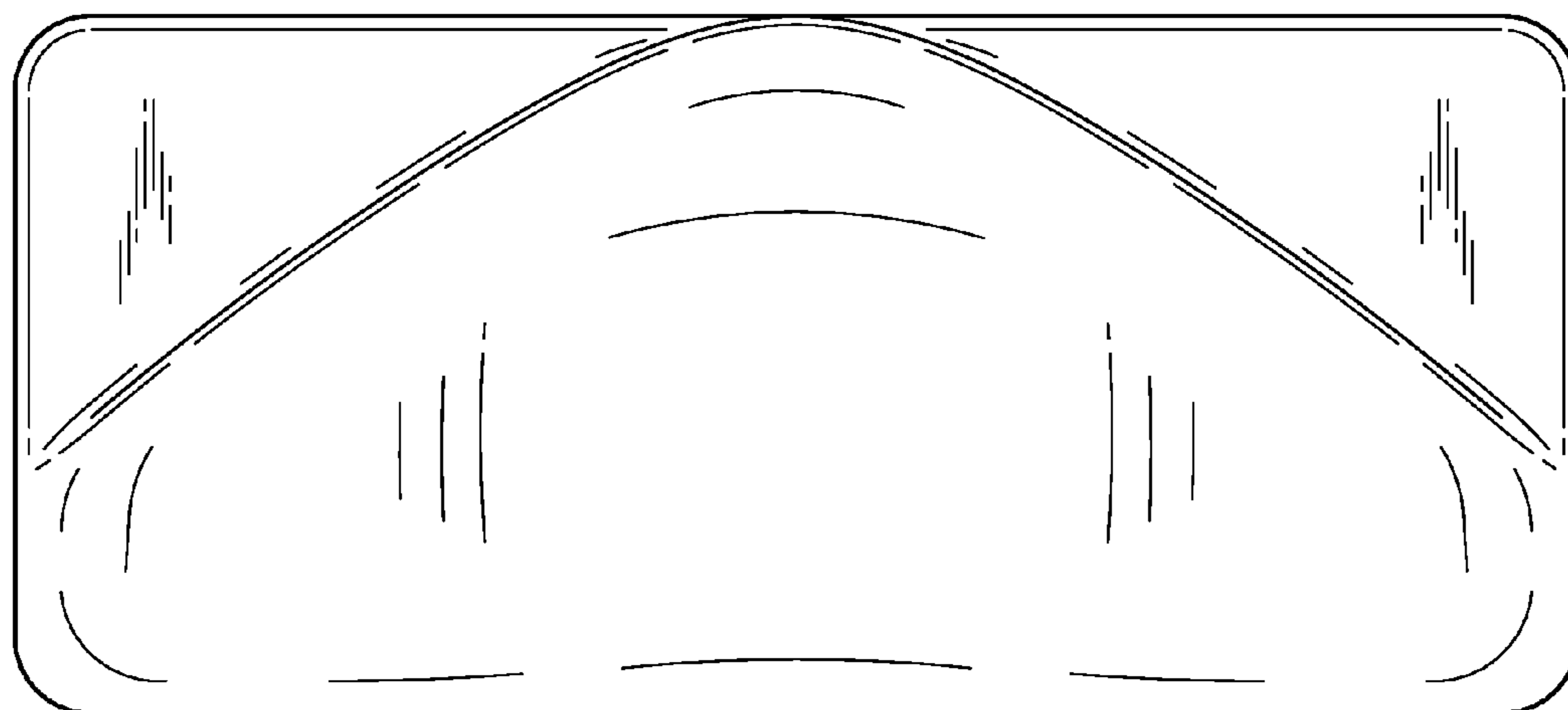

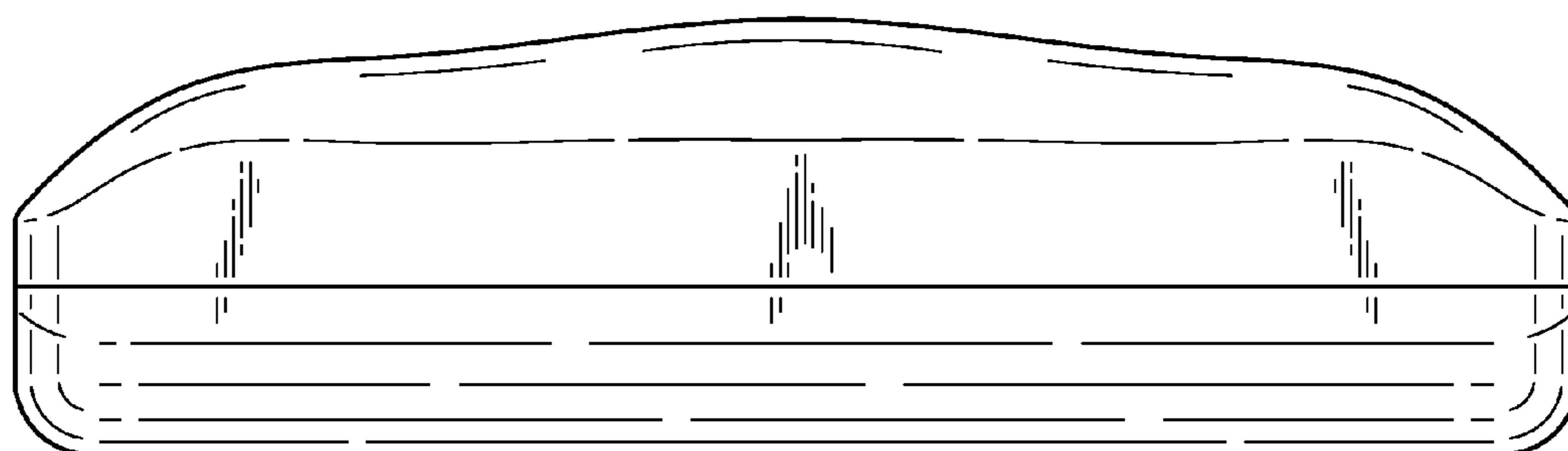

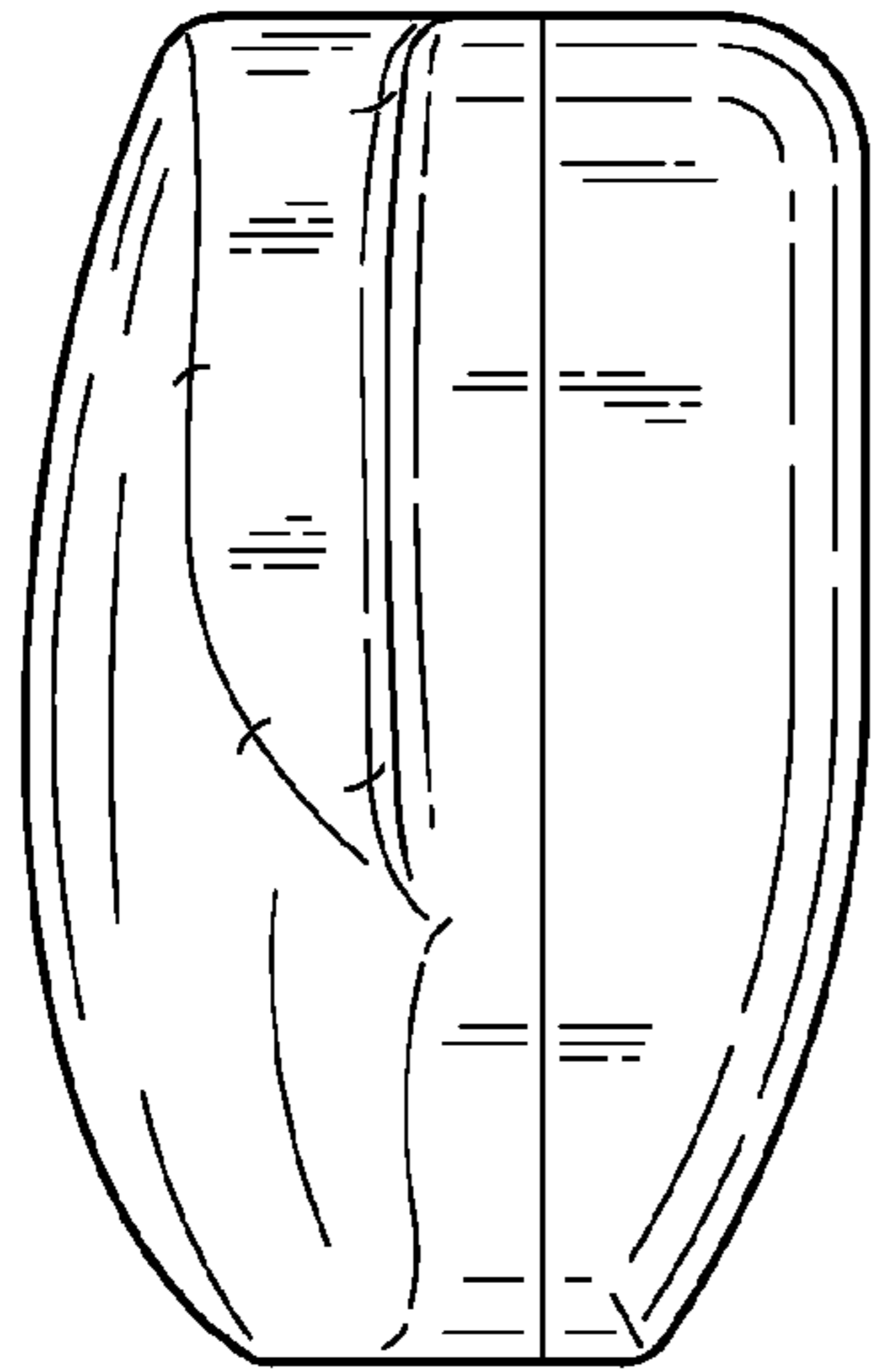

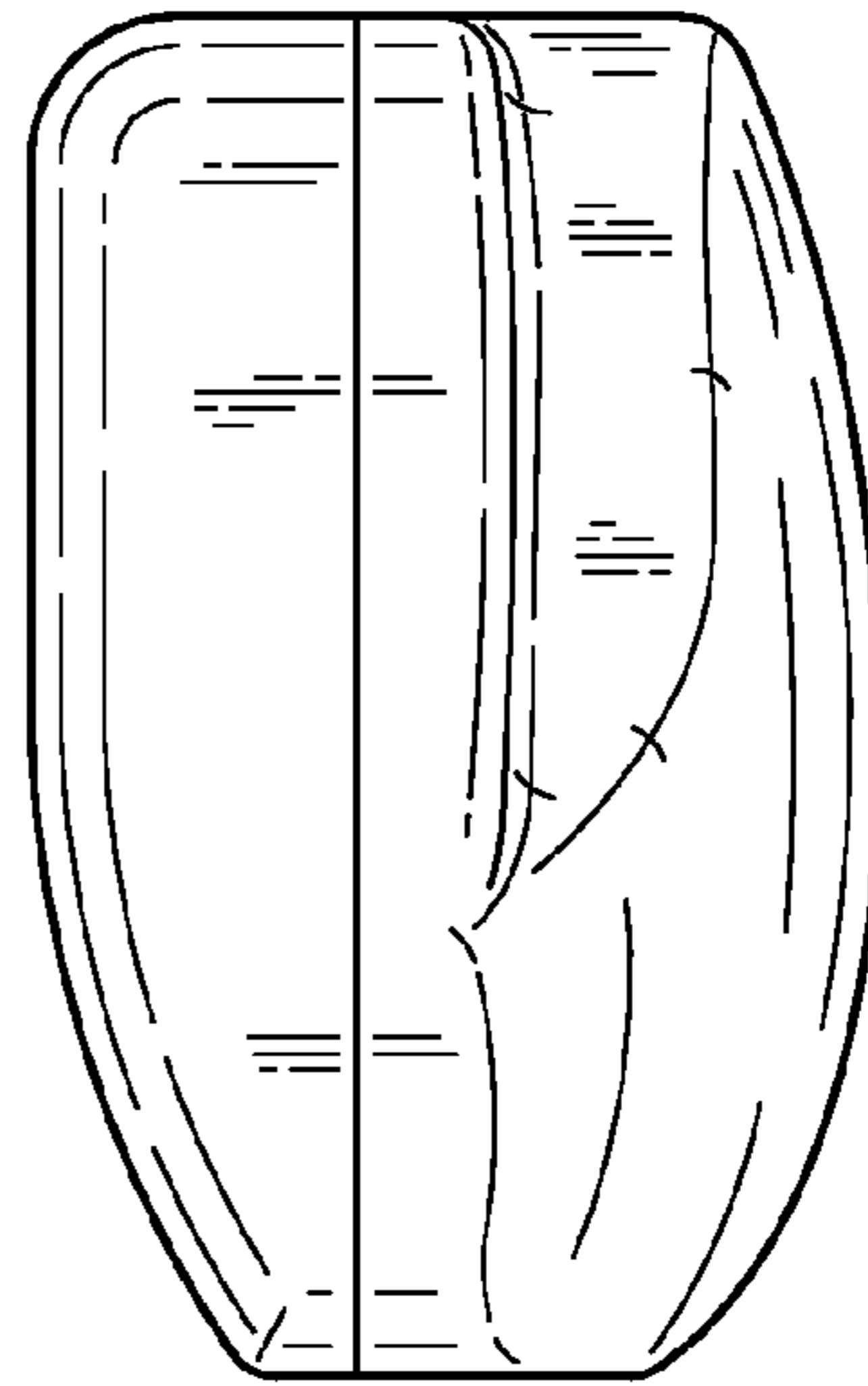

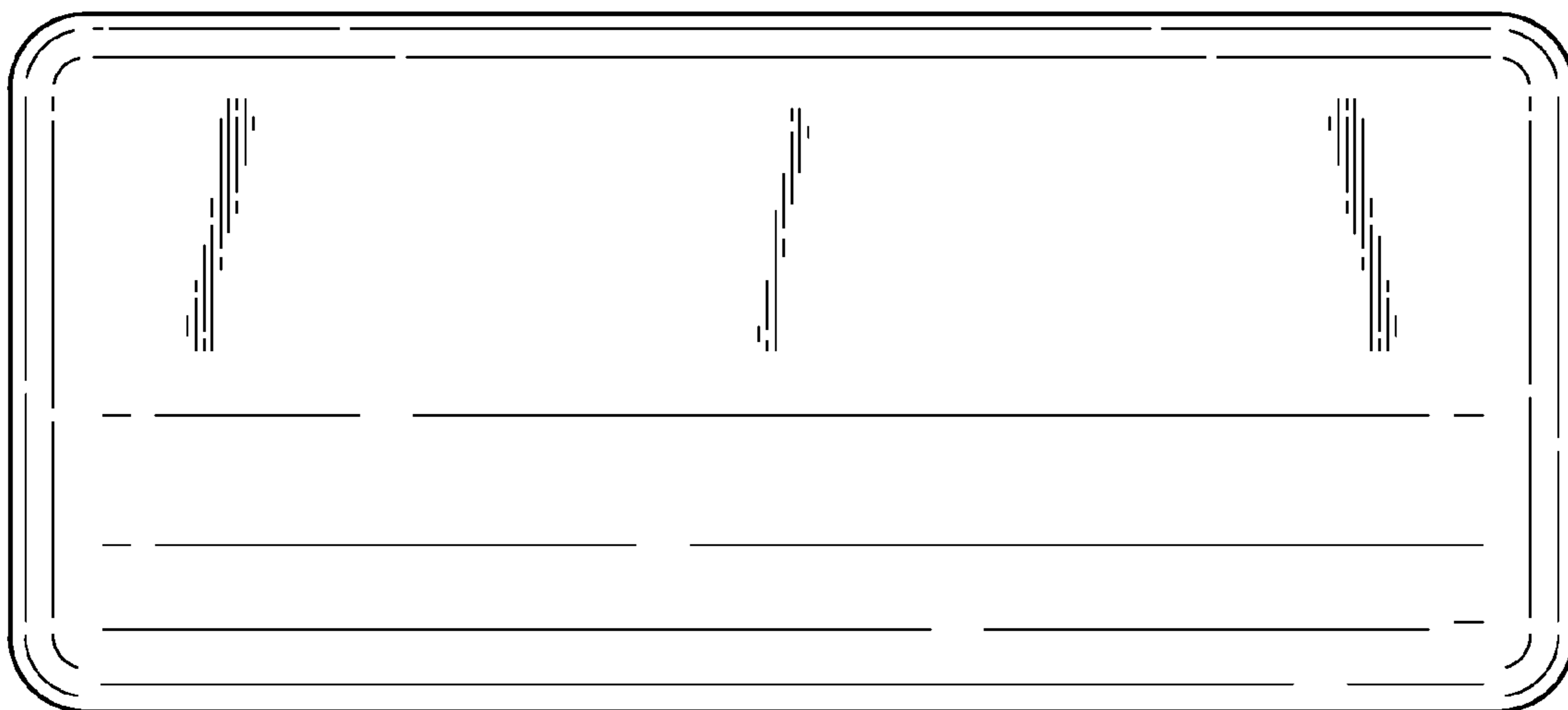

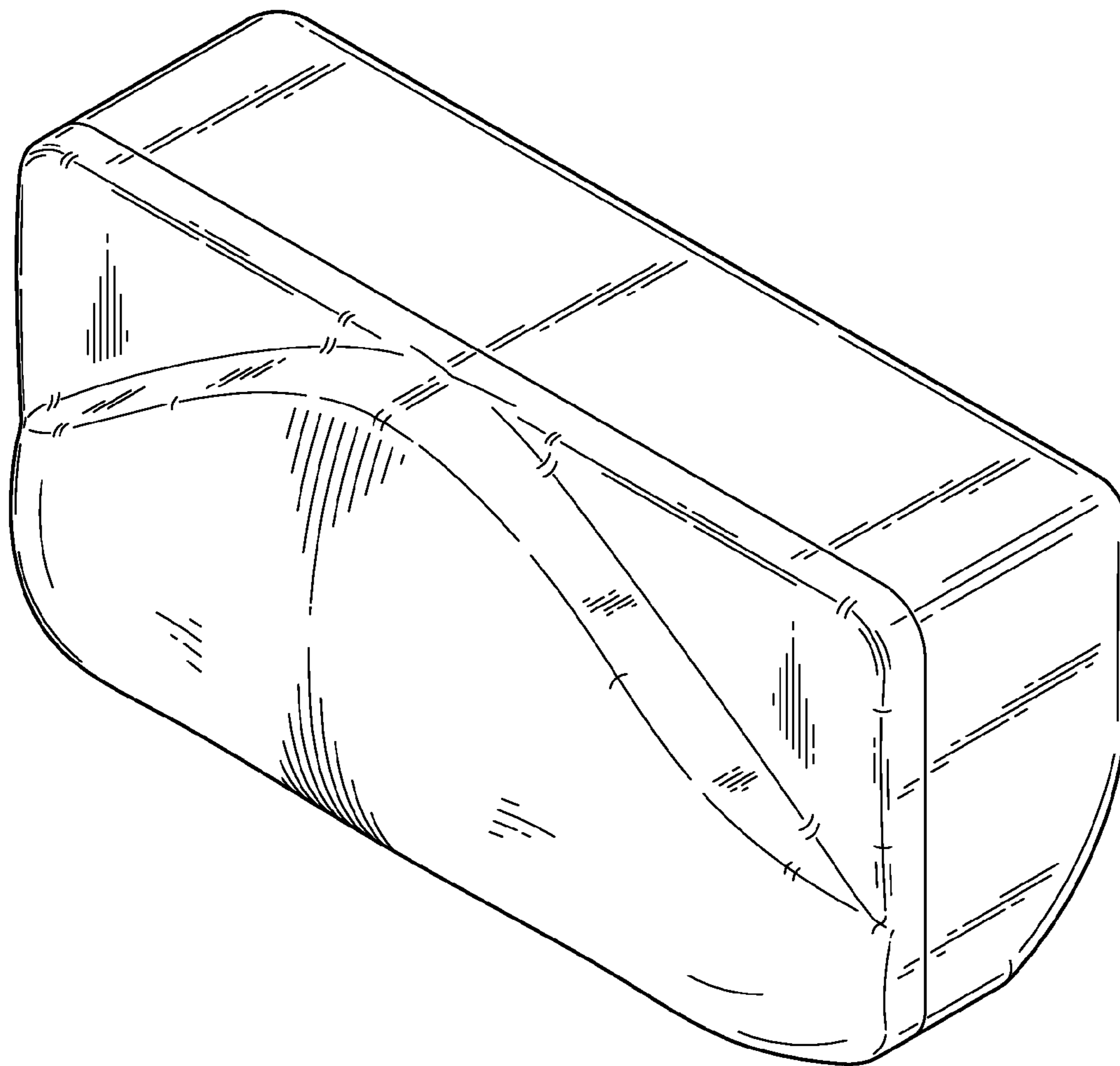

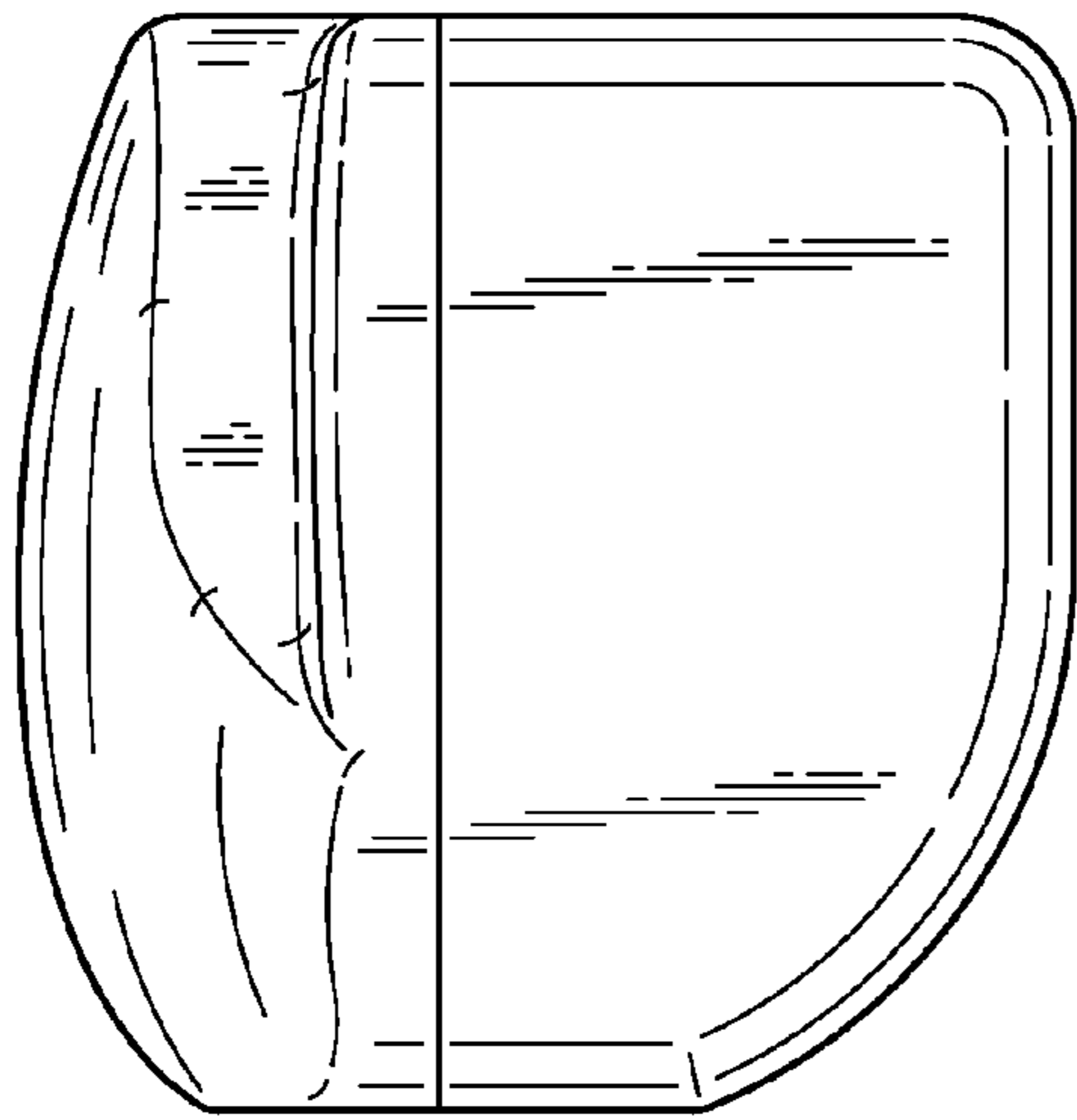

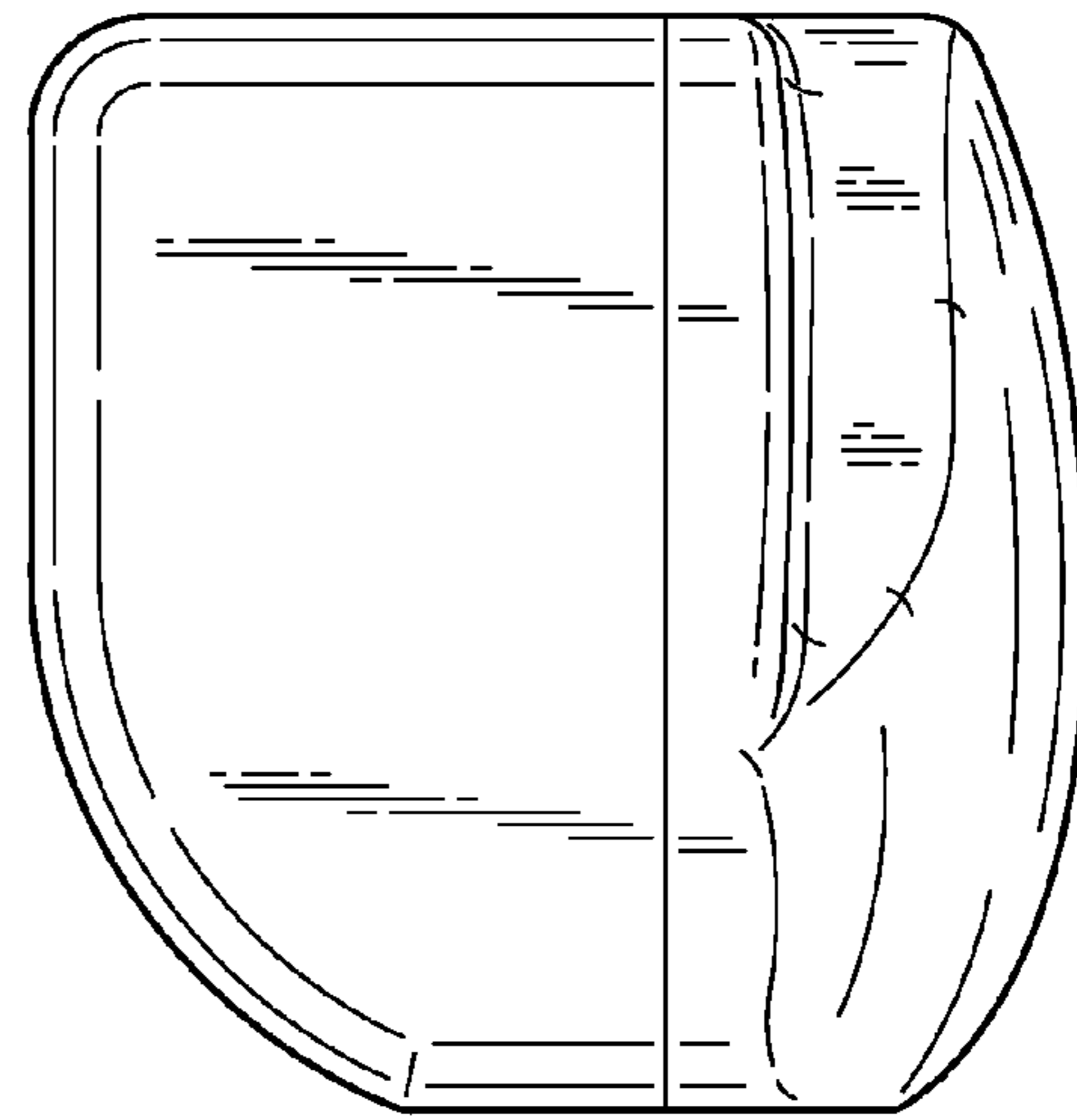

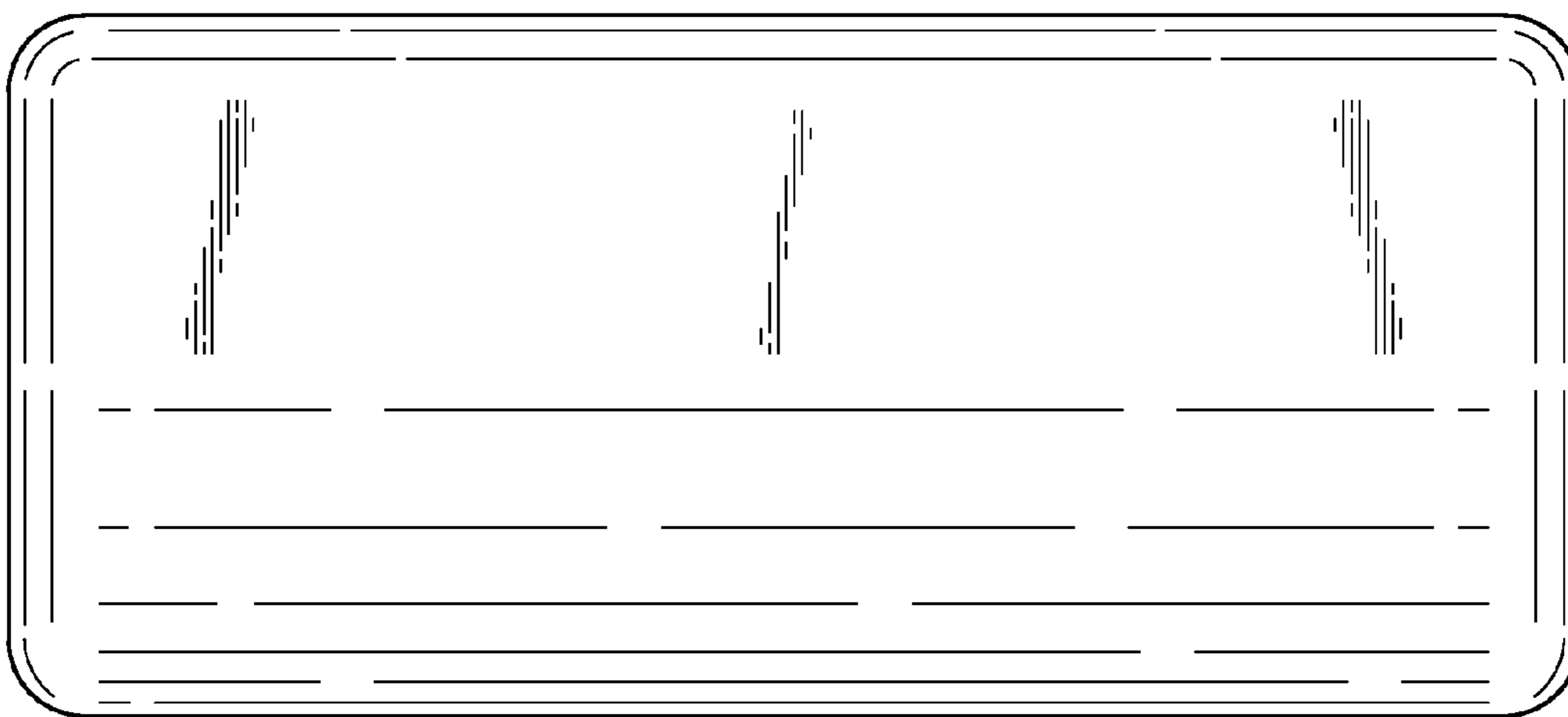

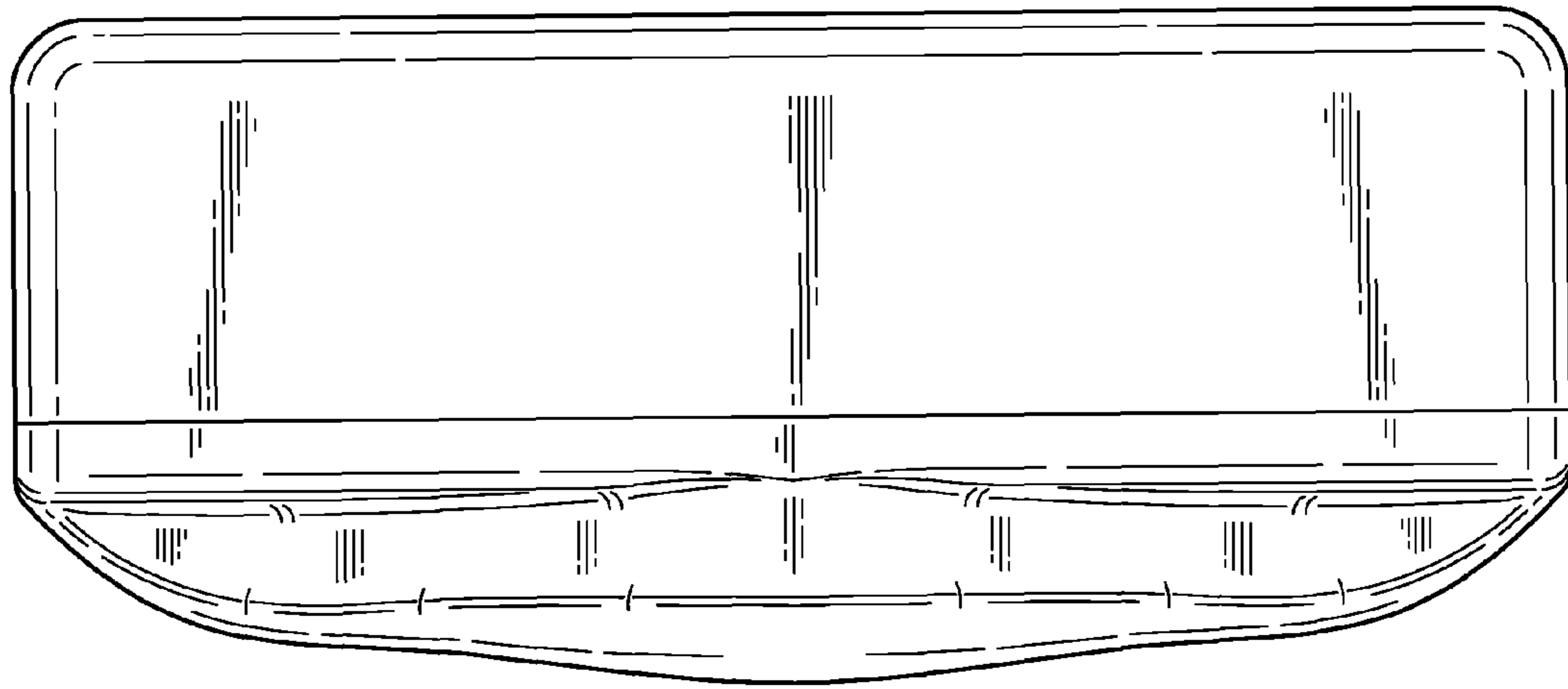

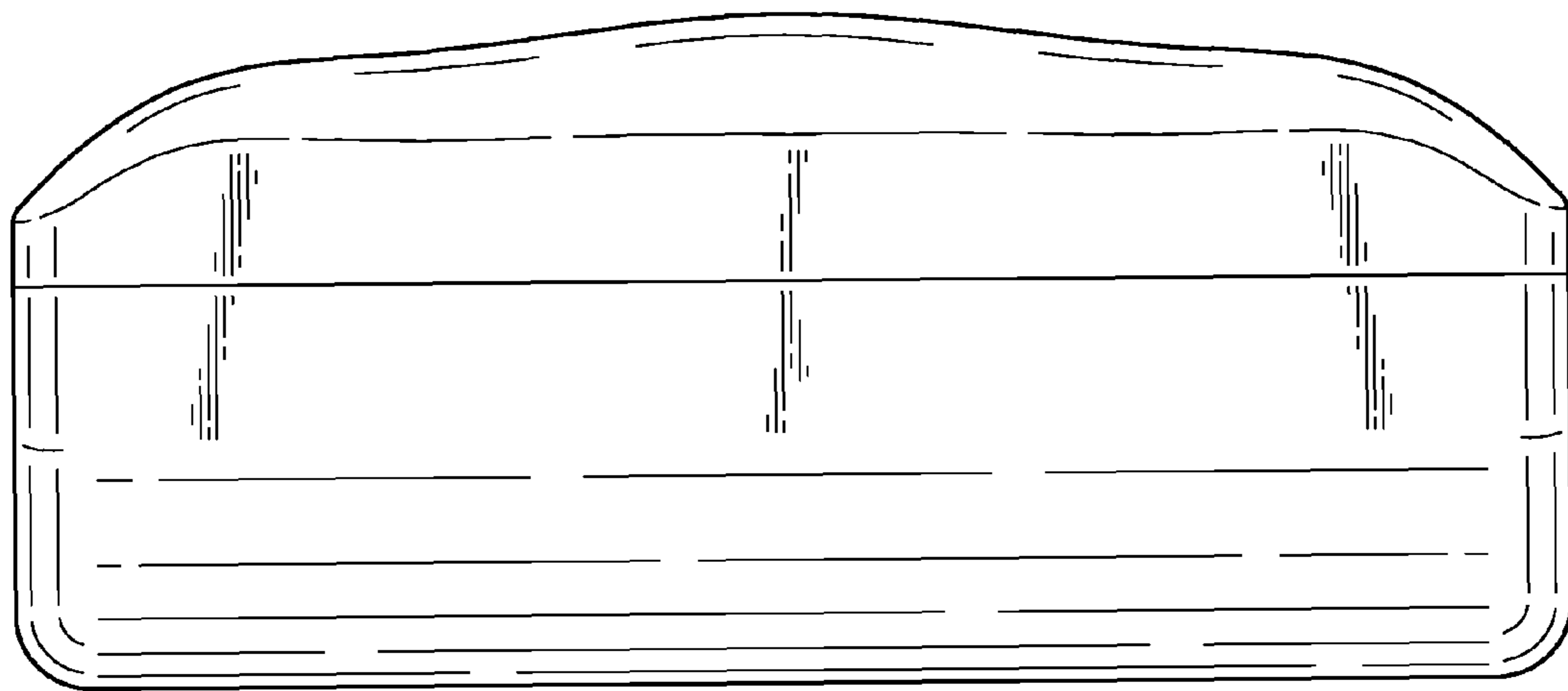
