(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a device for storing children's artwork, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a device for storing children's artwork, showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

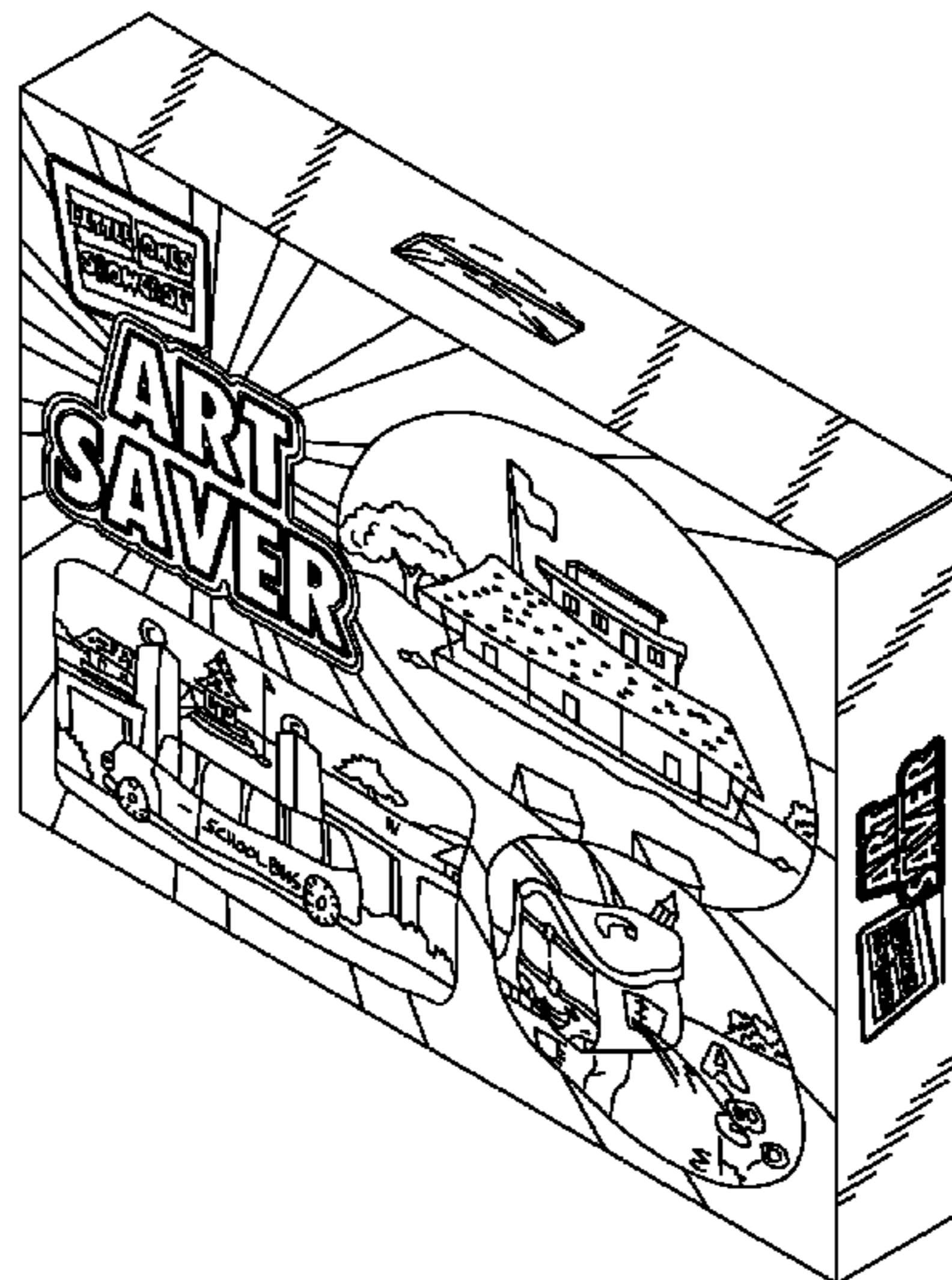
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

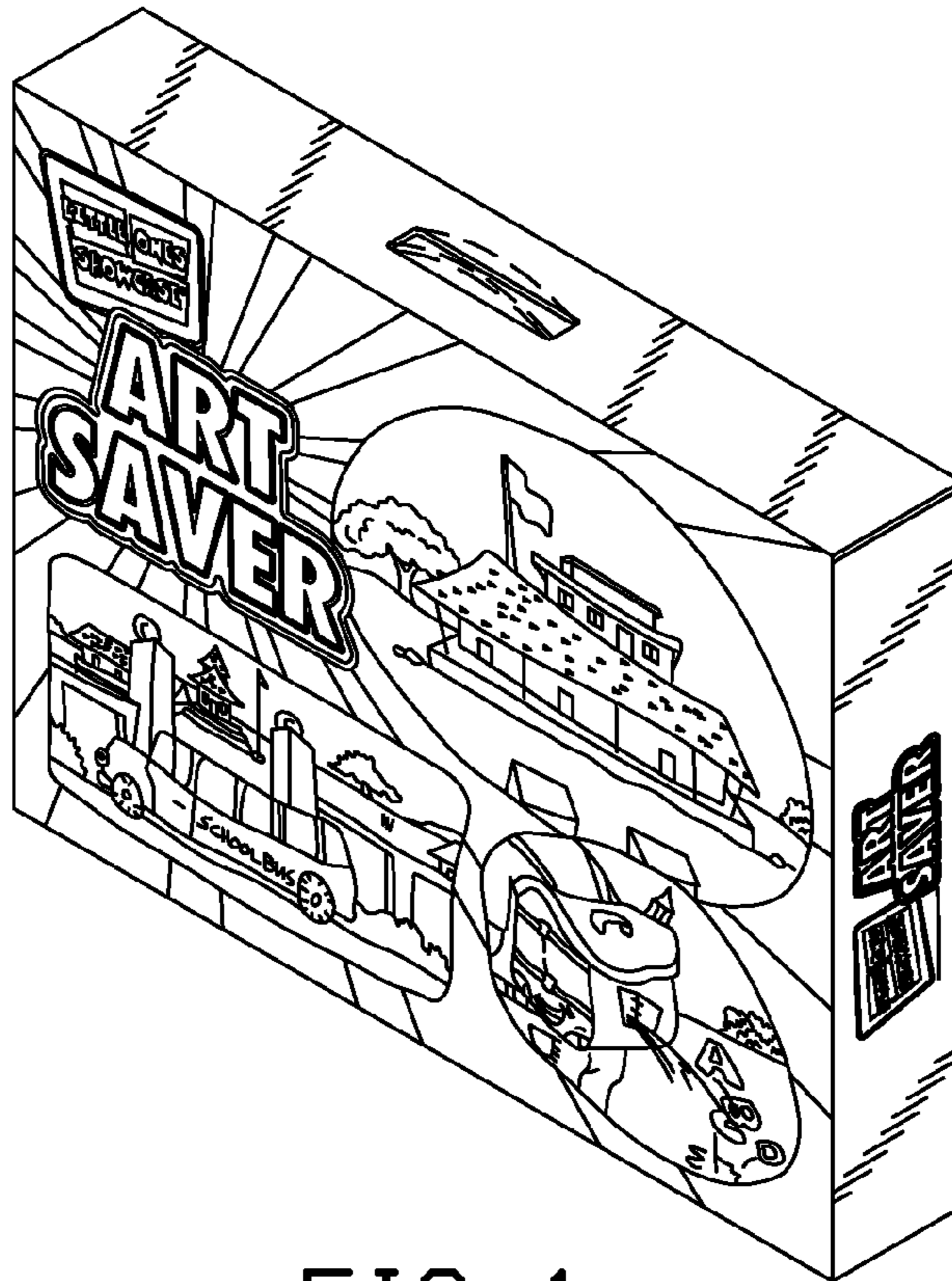

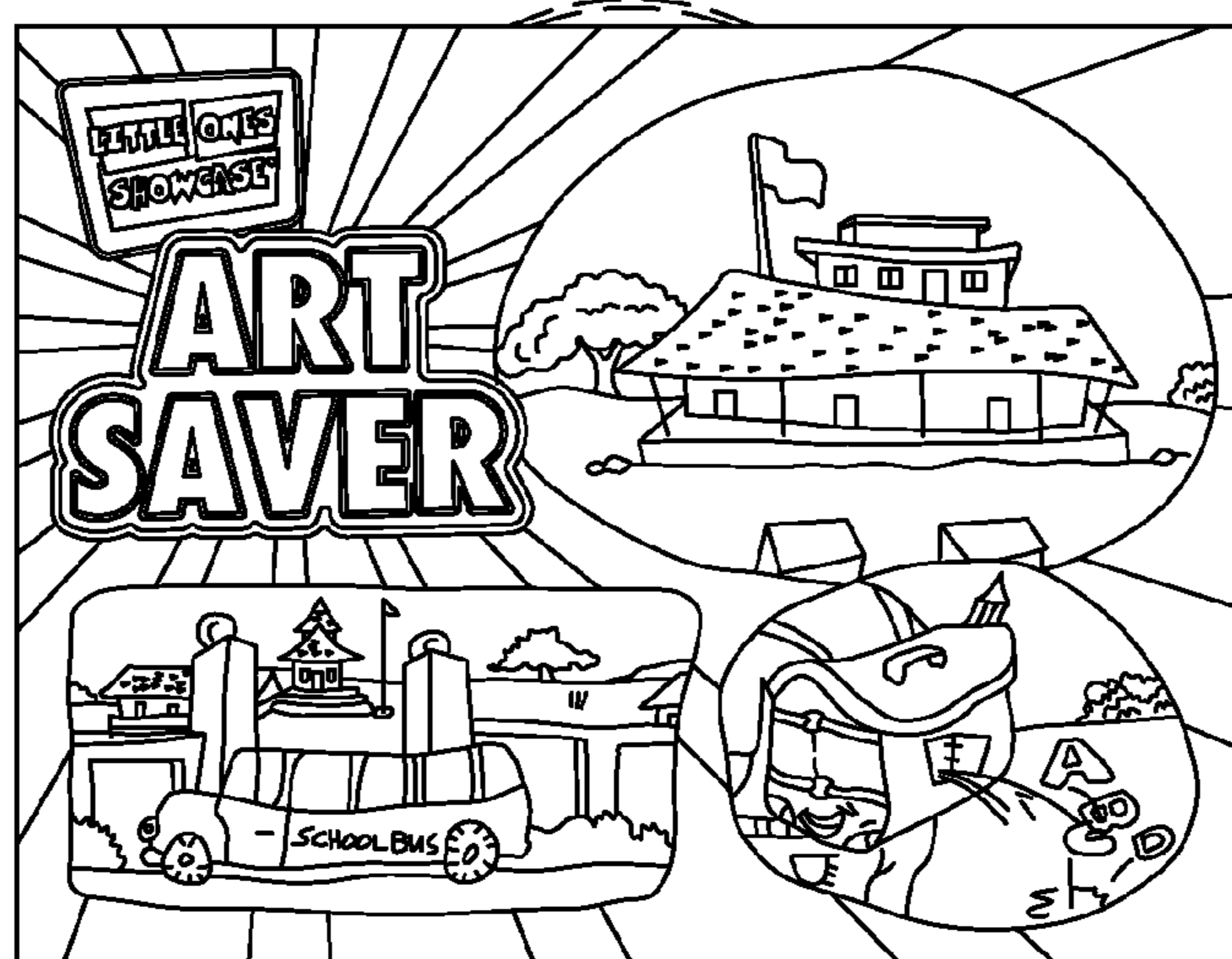

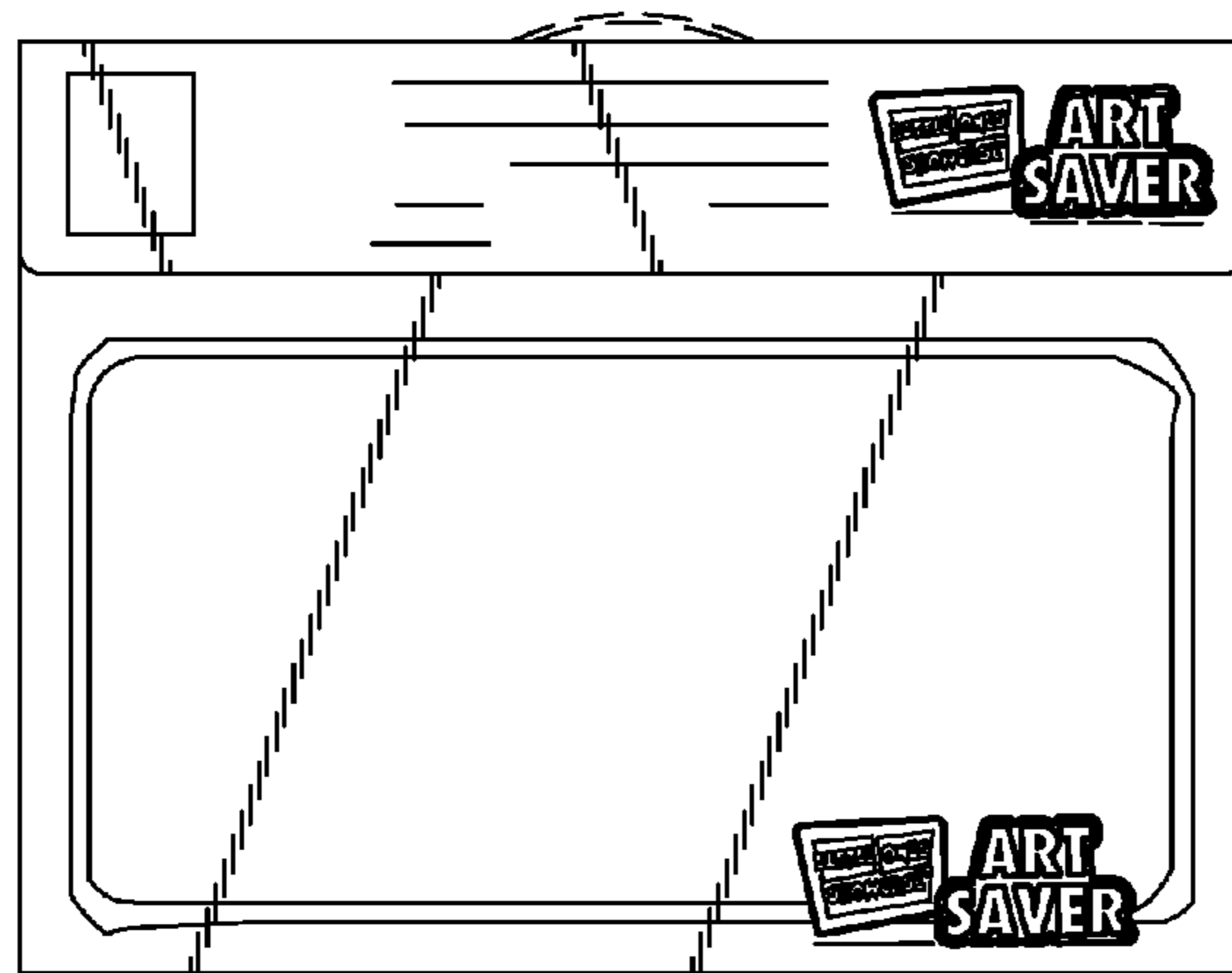

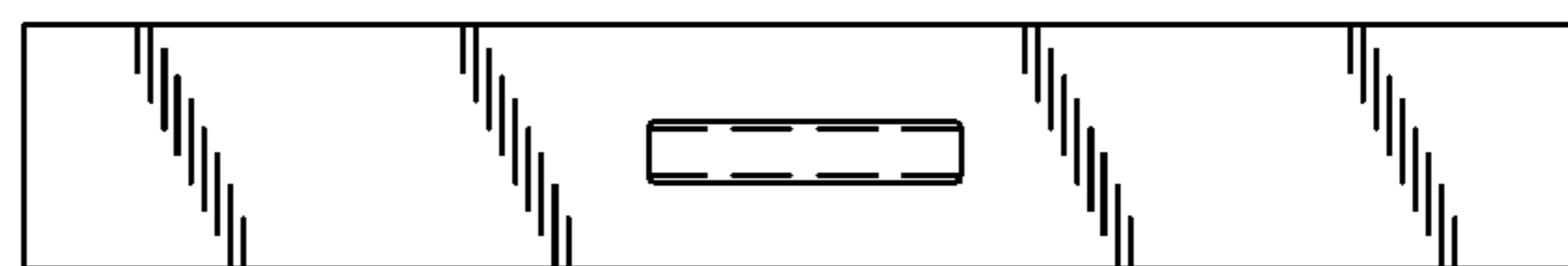

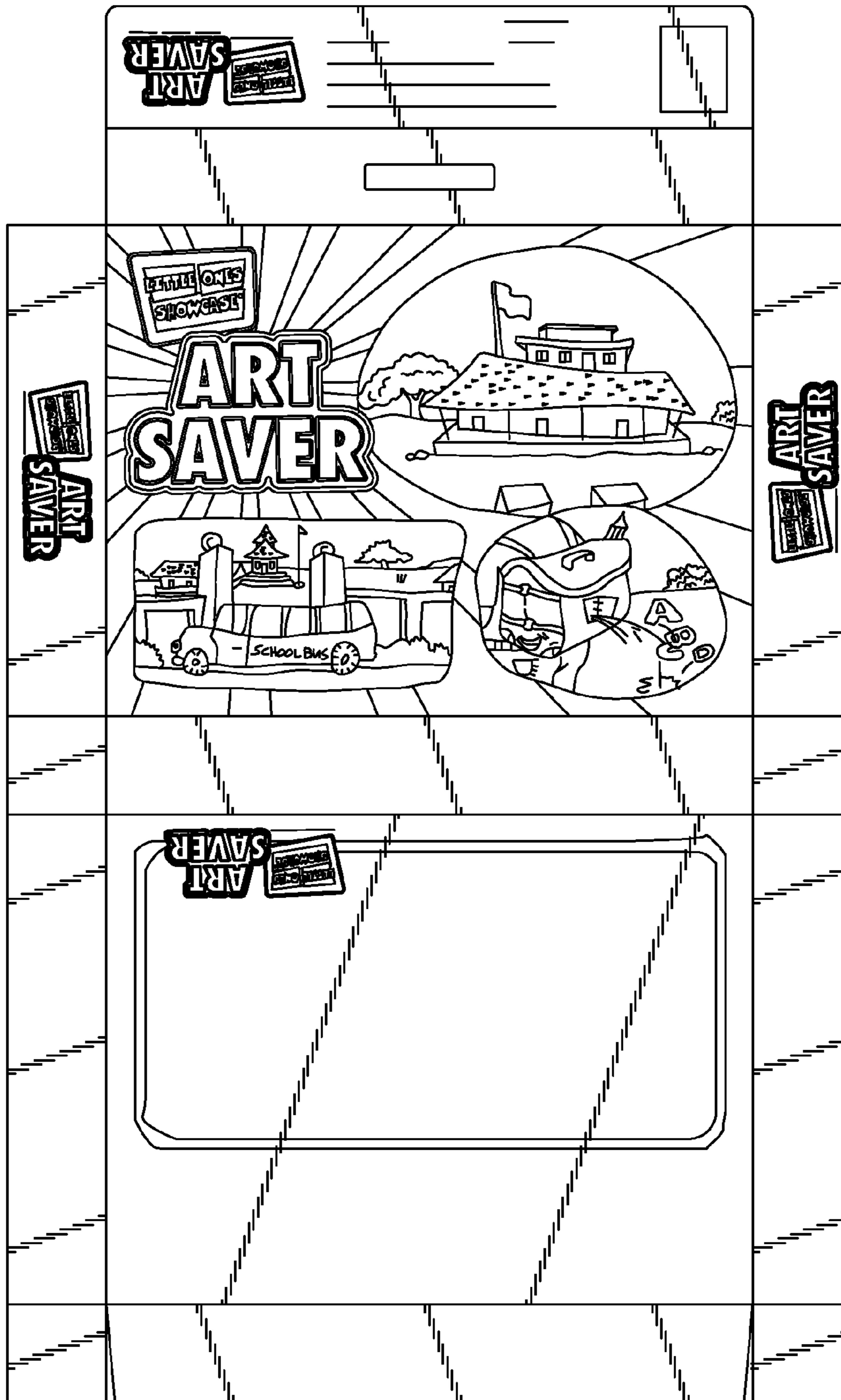
