The ornamental design for a pool table with eight pockets, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pool table with eight pockets showing our new design;

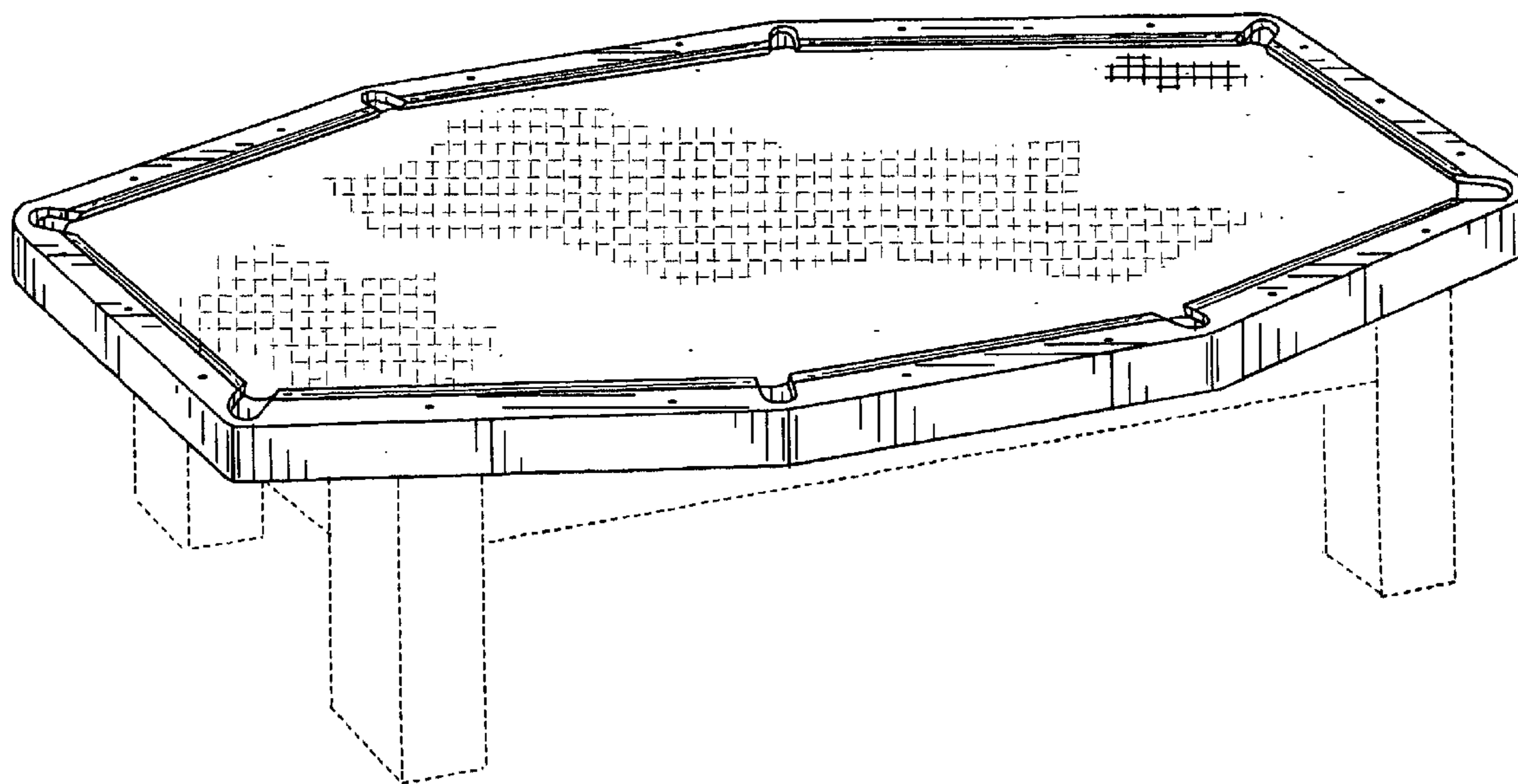
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom is flat and includes no ornamentality;

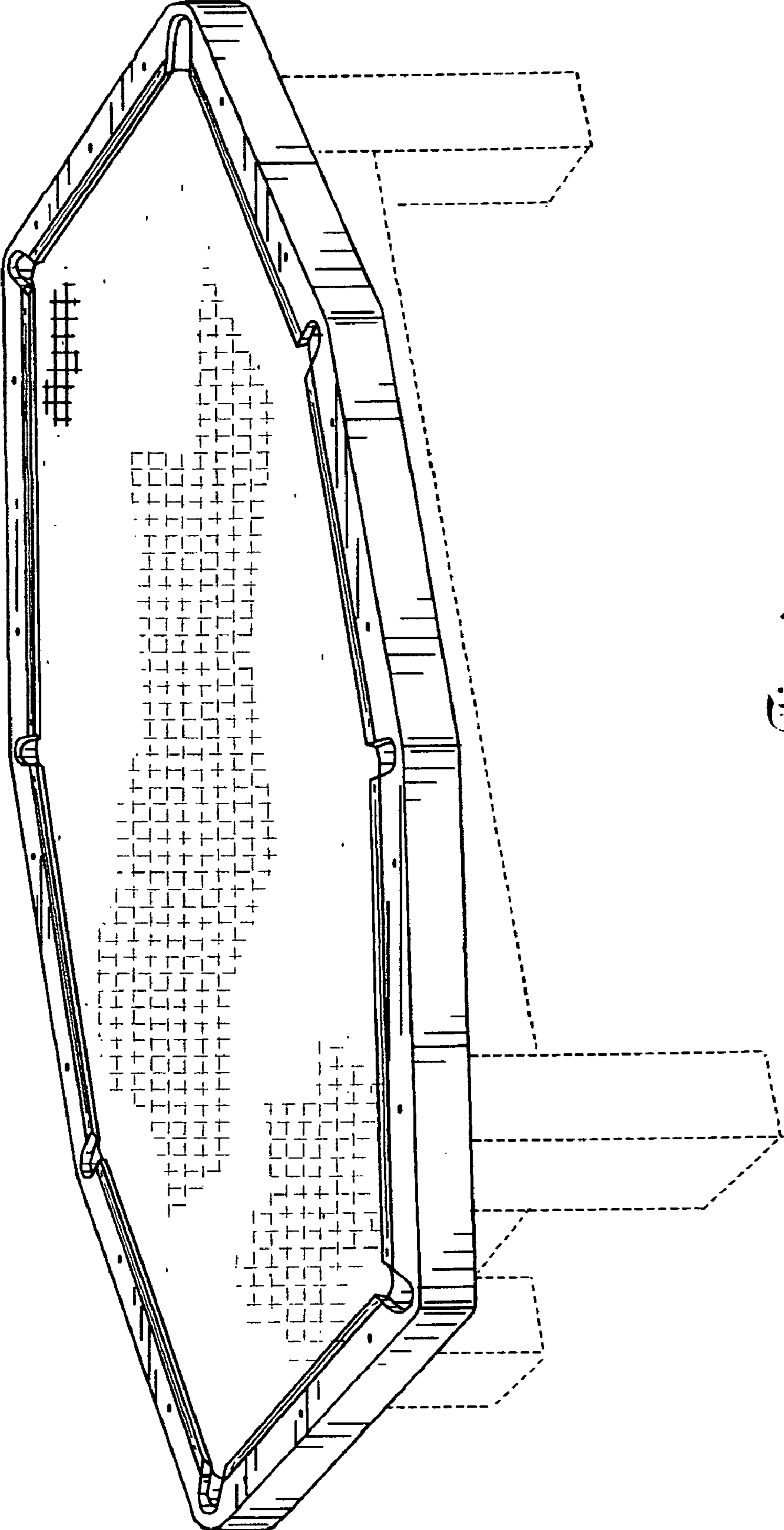
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation being a mirror image thereof; and,

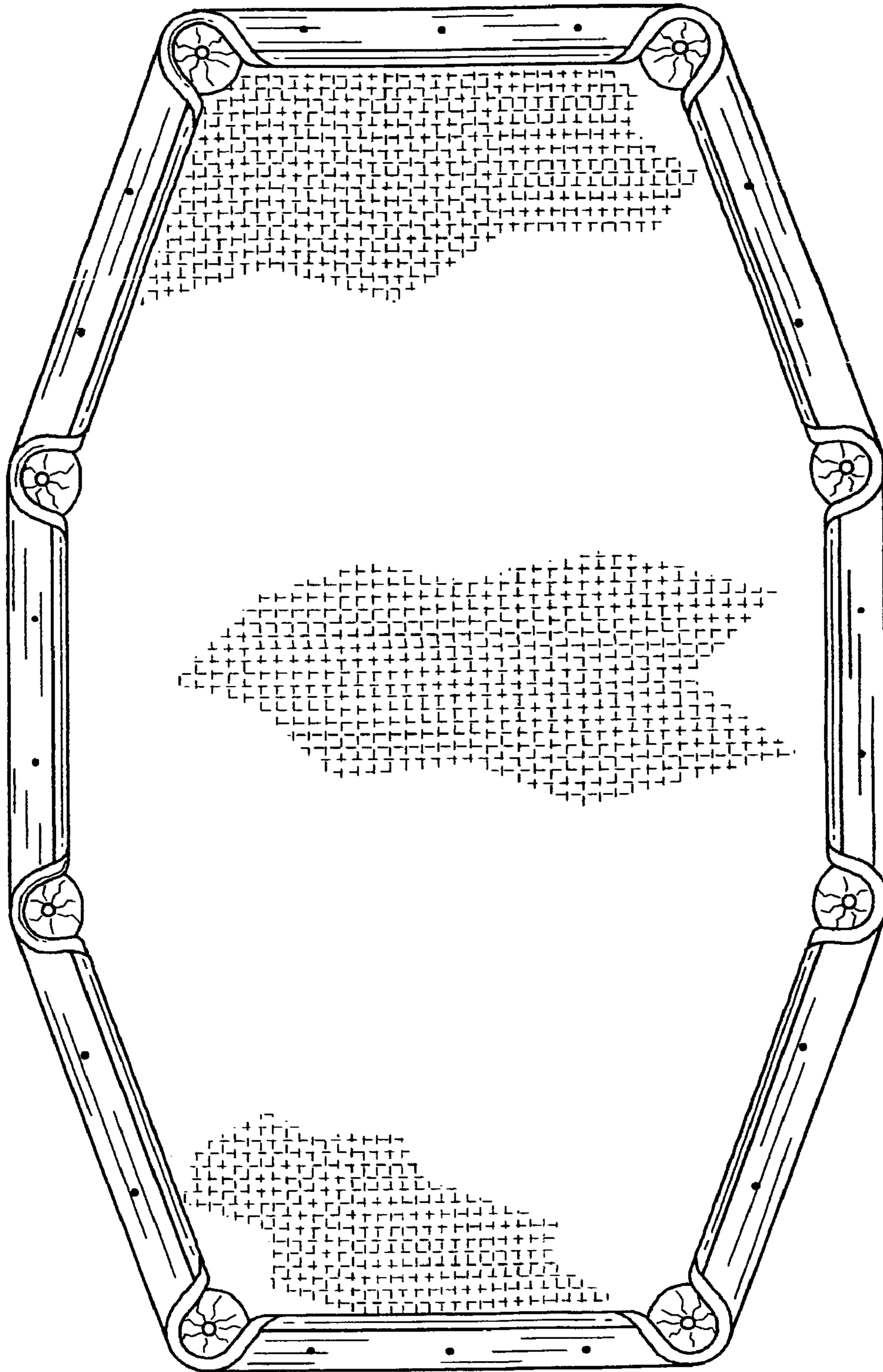
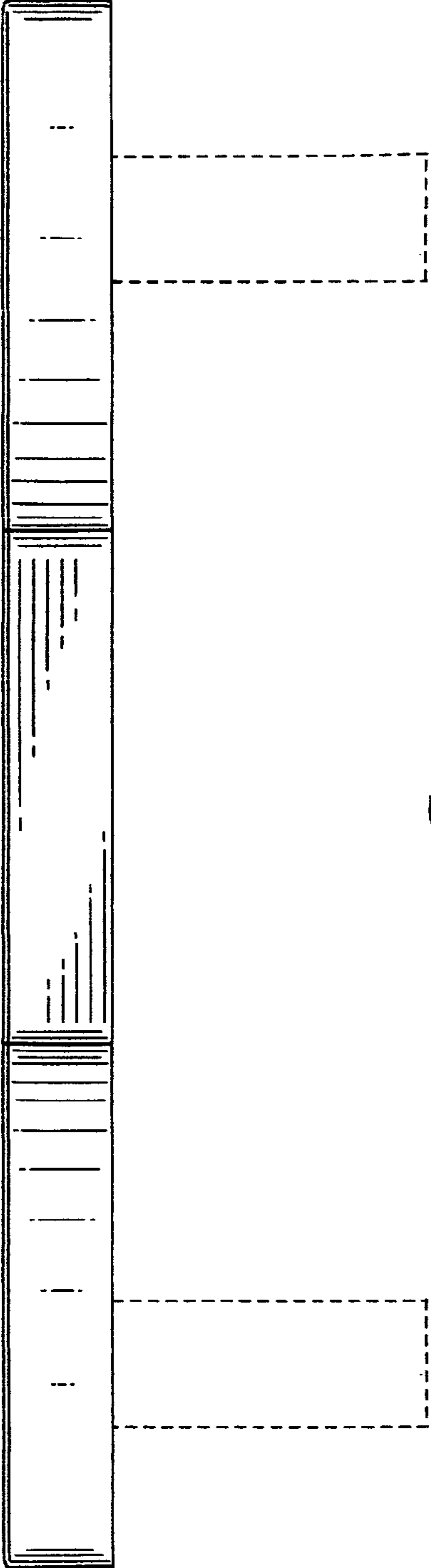
