DESCRIPTION

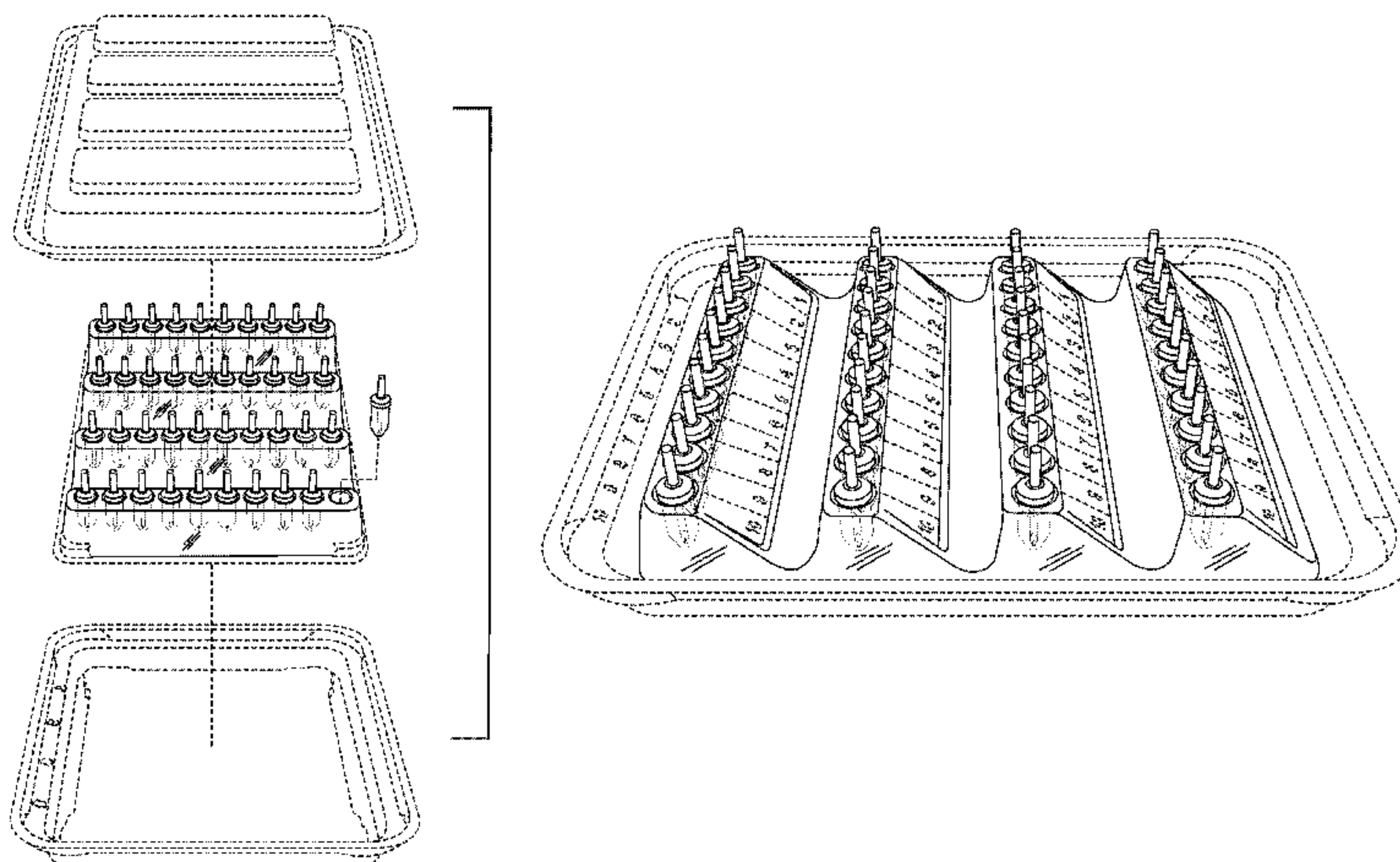
FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a skin testing device

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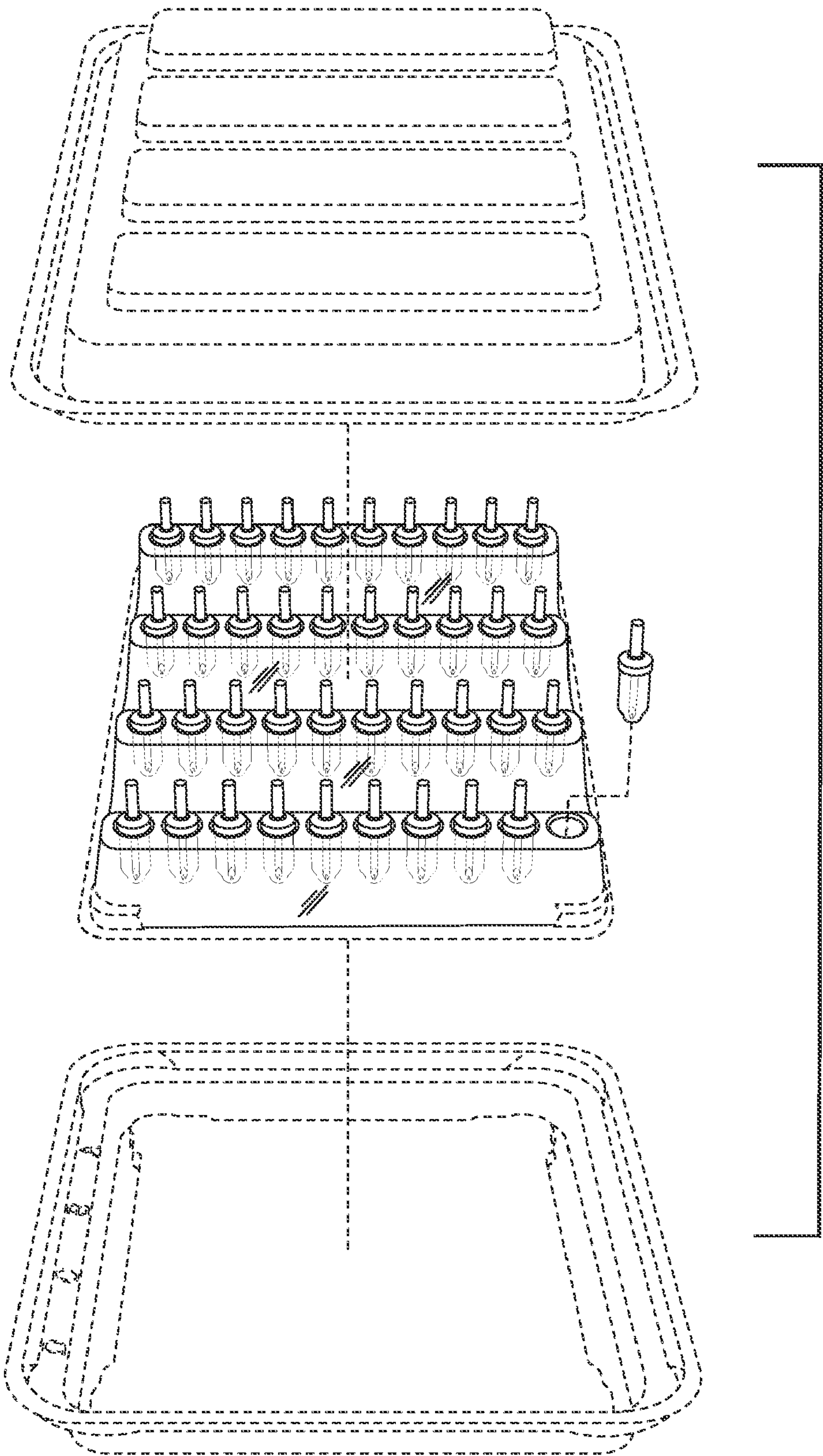

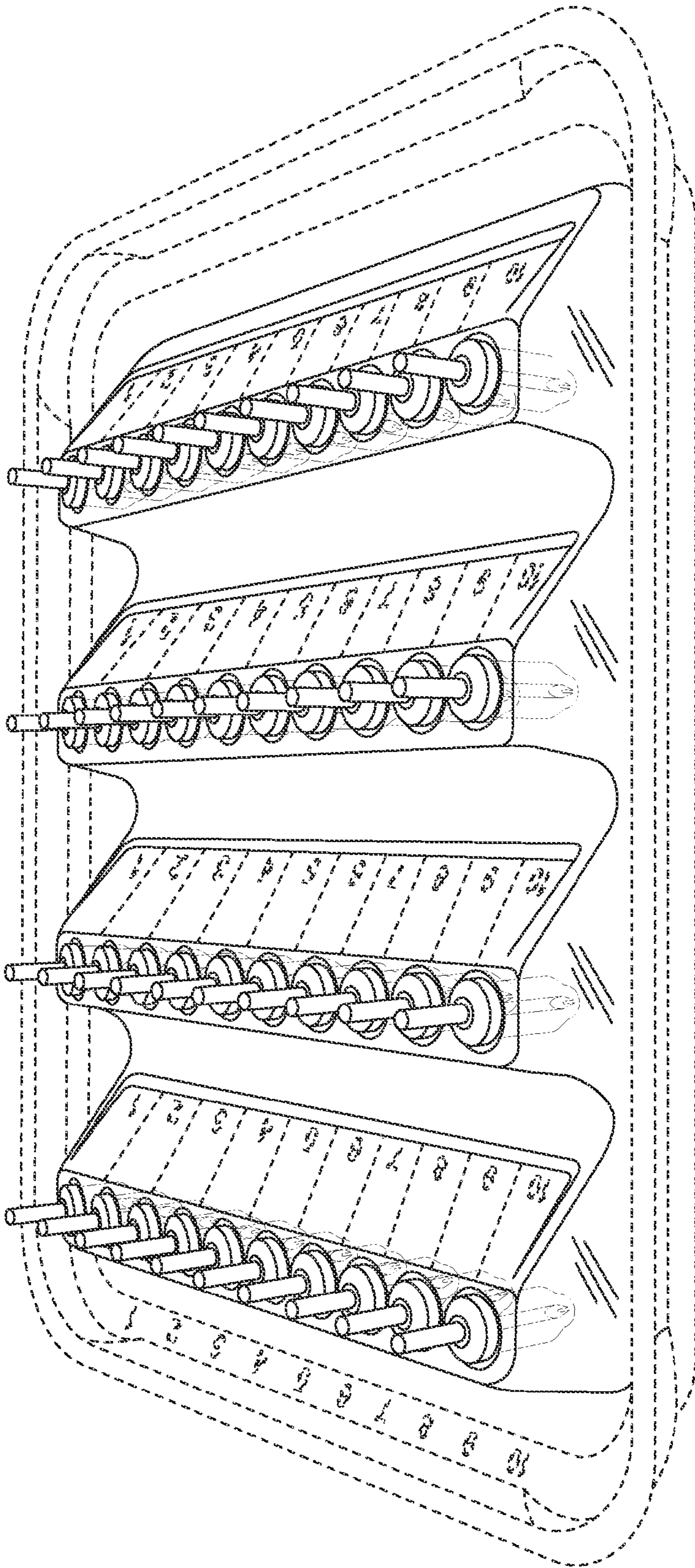

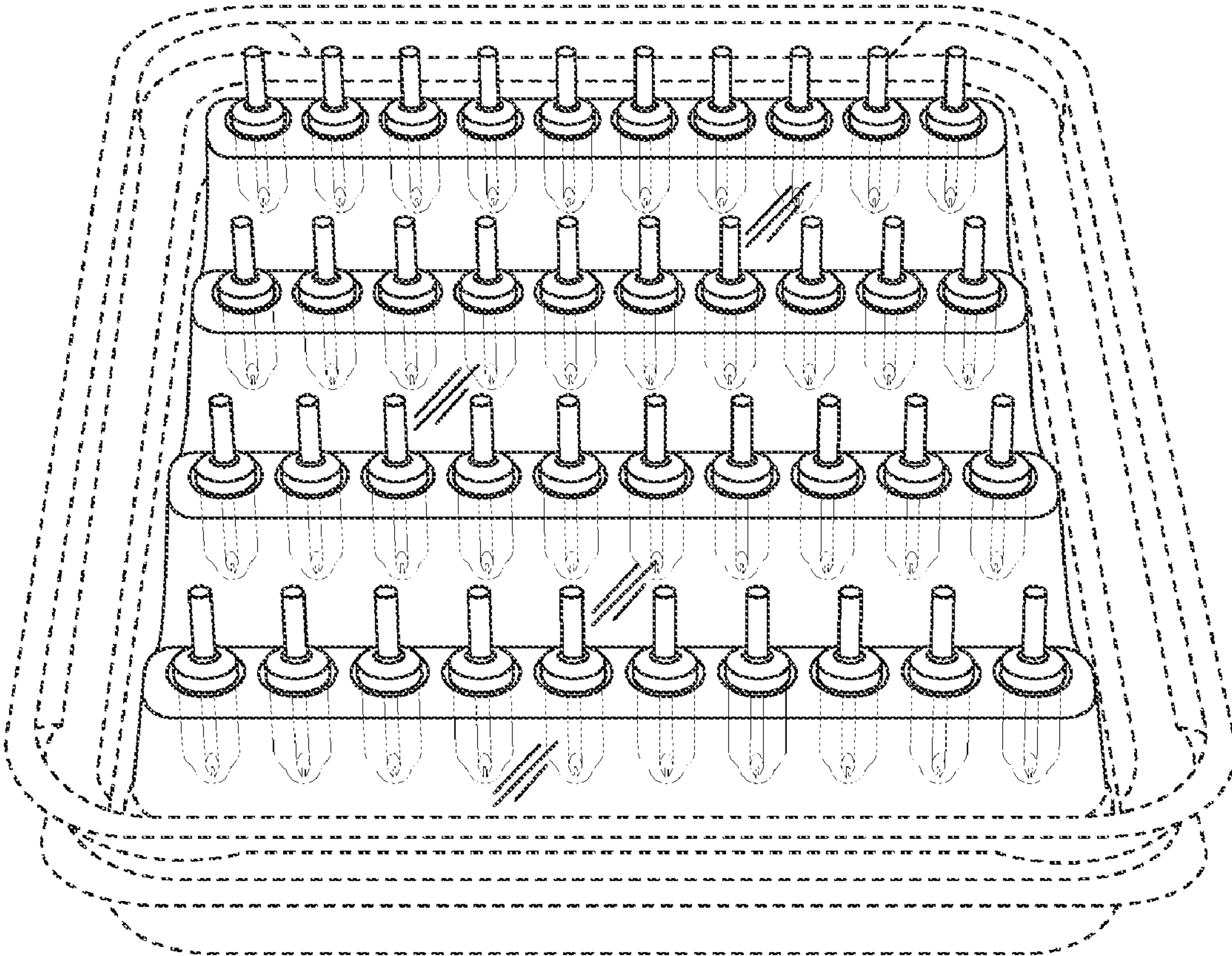
