FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the toilet step.

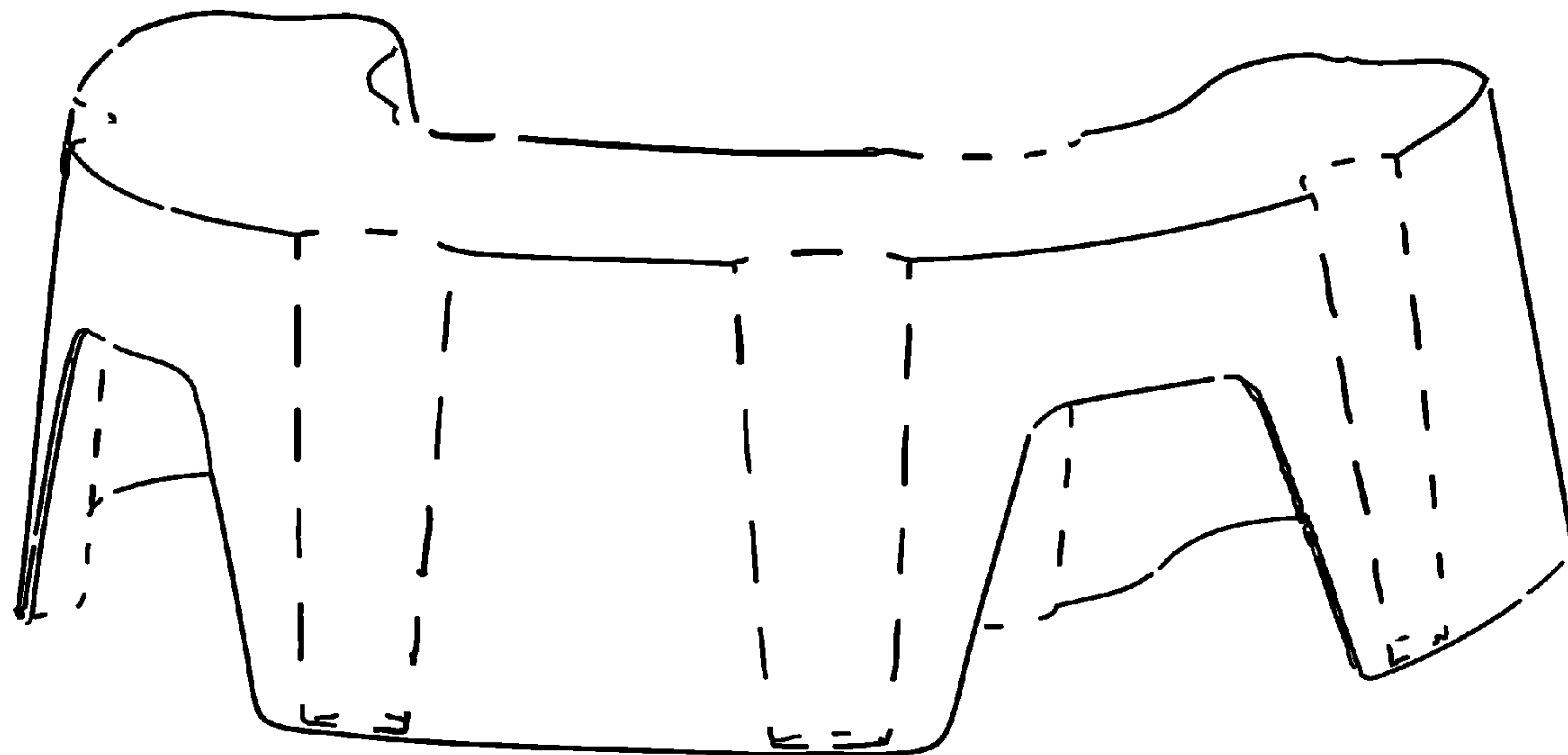
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the toilet step.

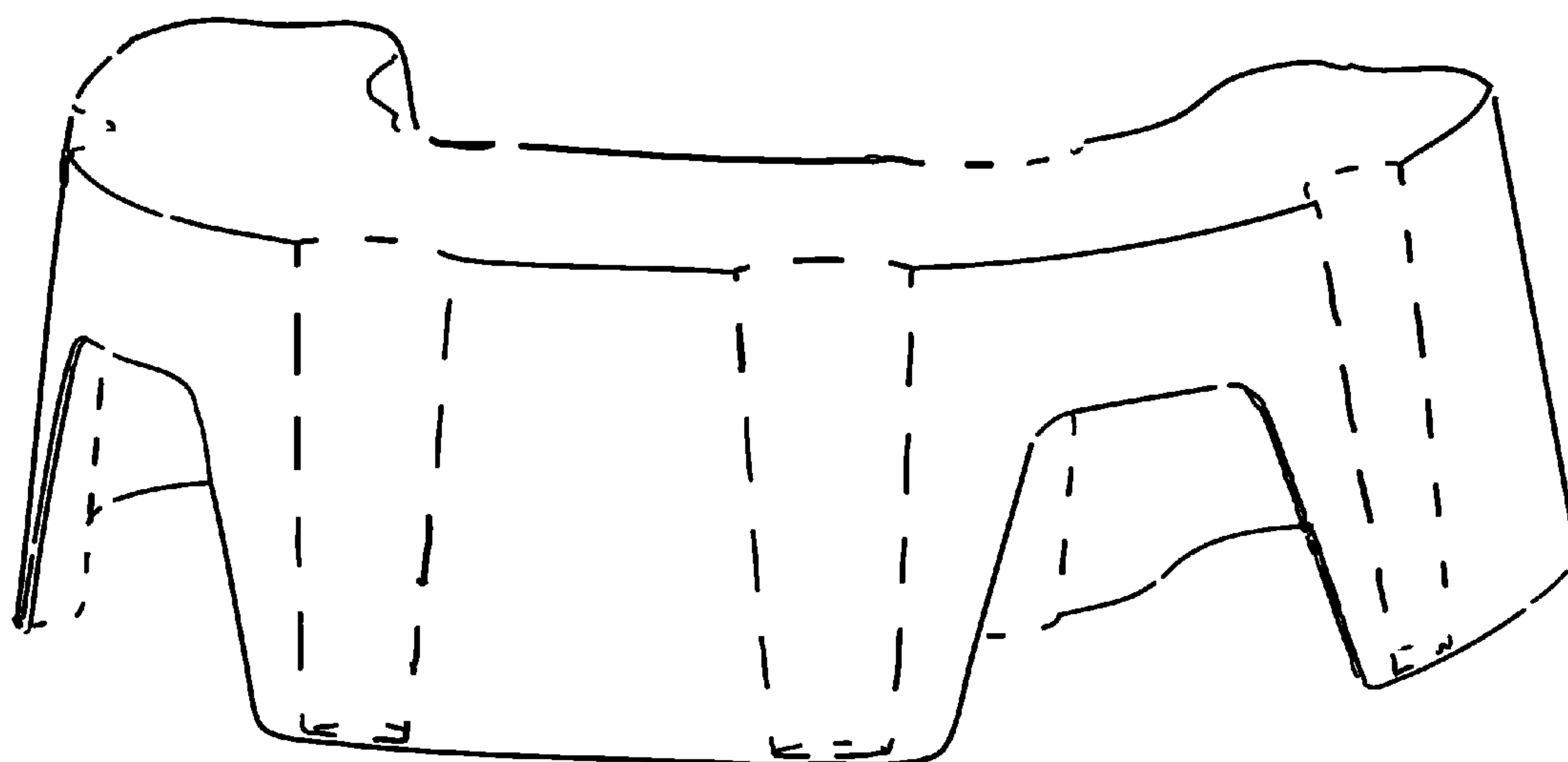

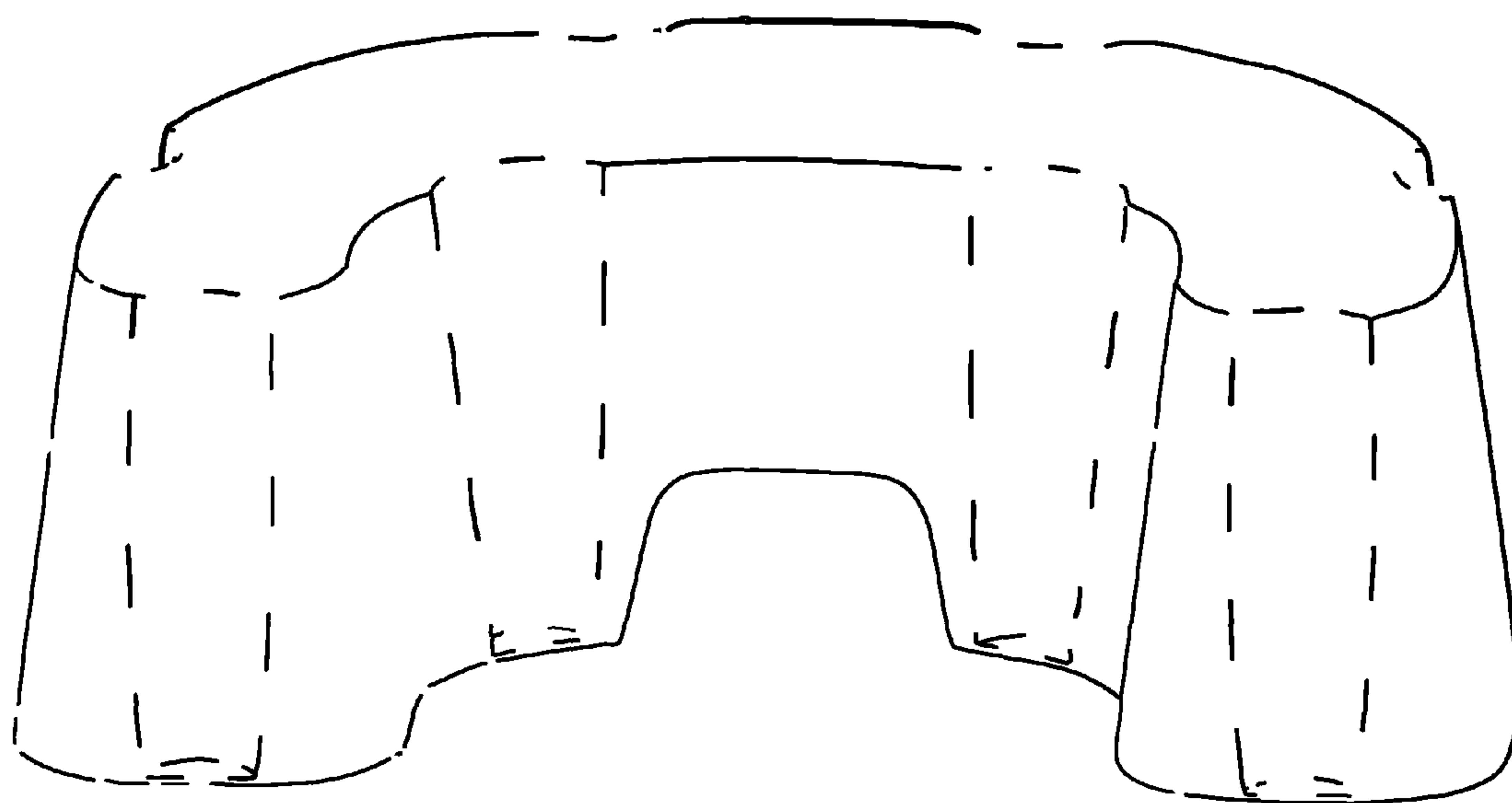

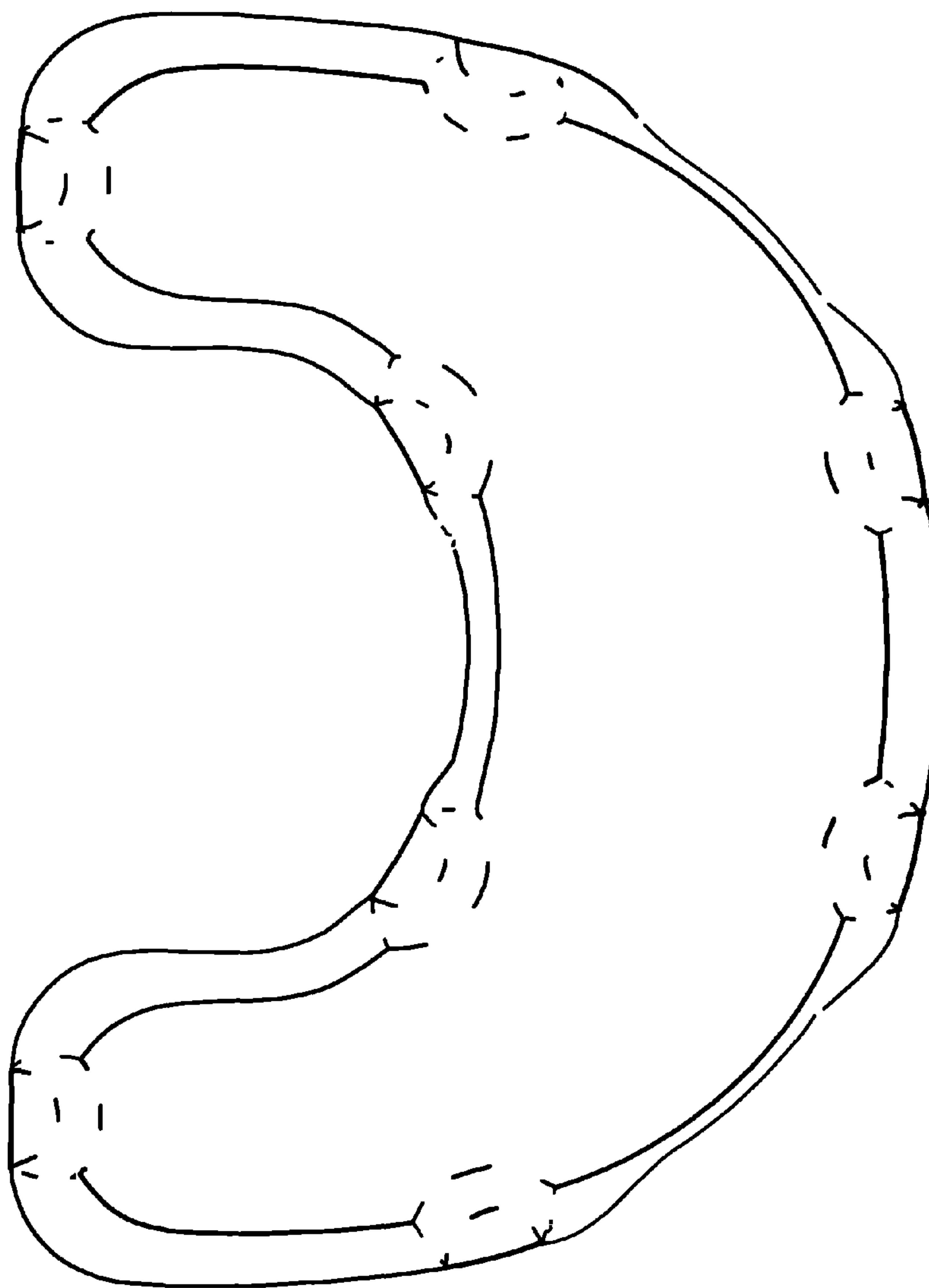

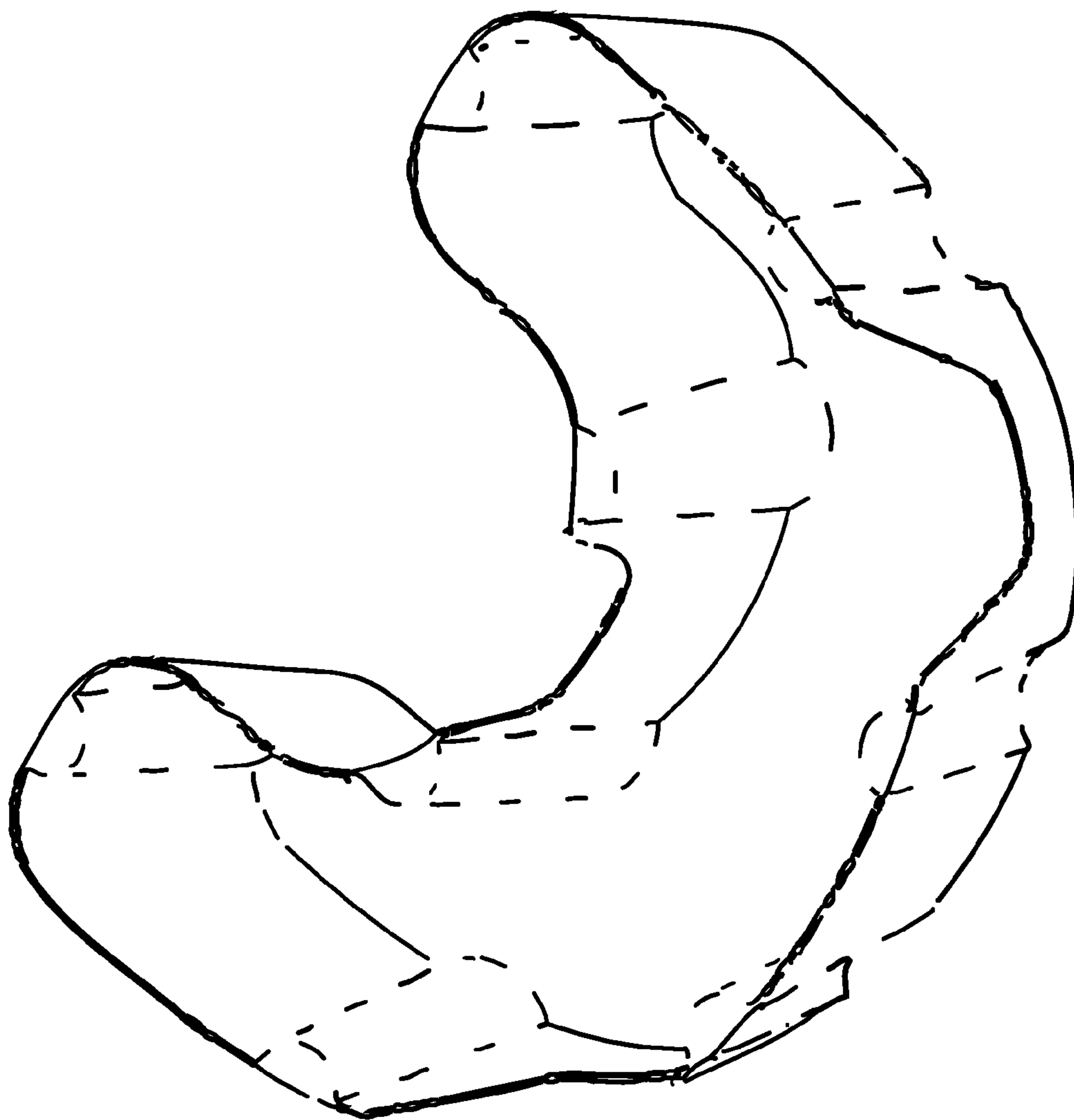
