FIG. 2 is a right elevation view of the decorative container of FIG. 1, the left side being identical thereto.

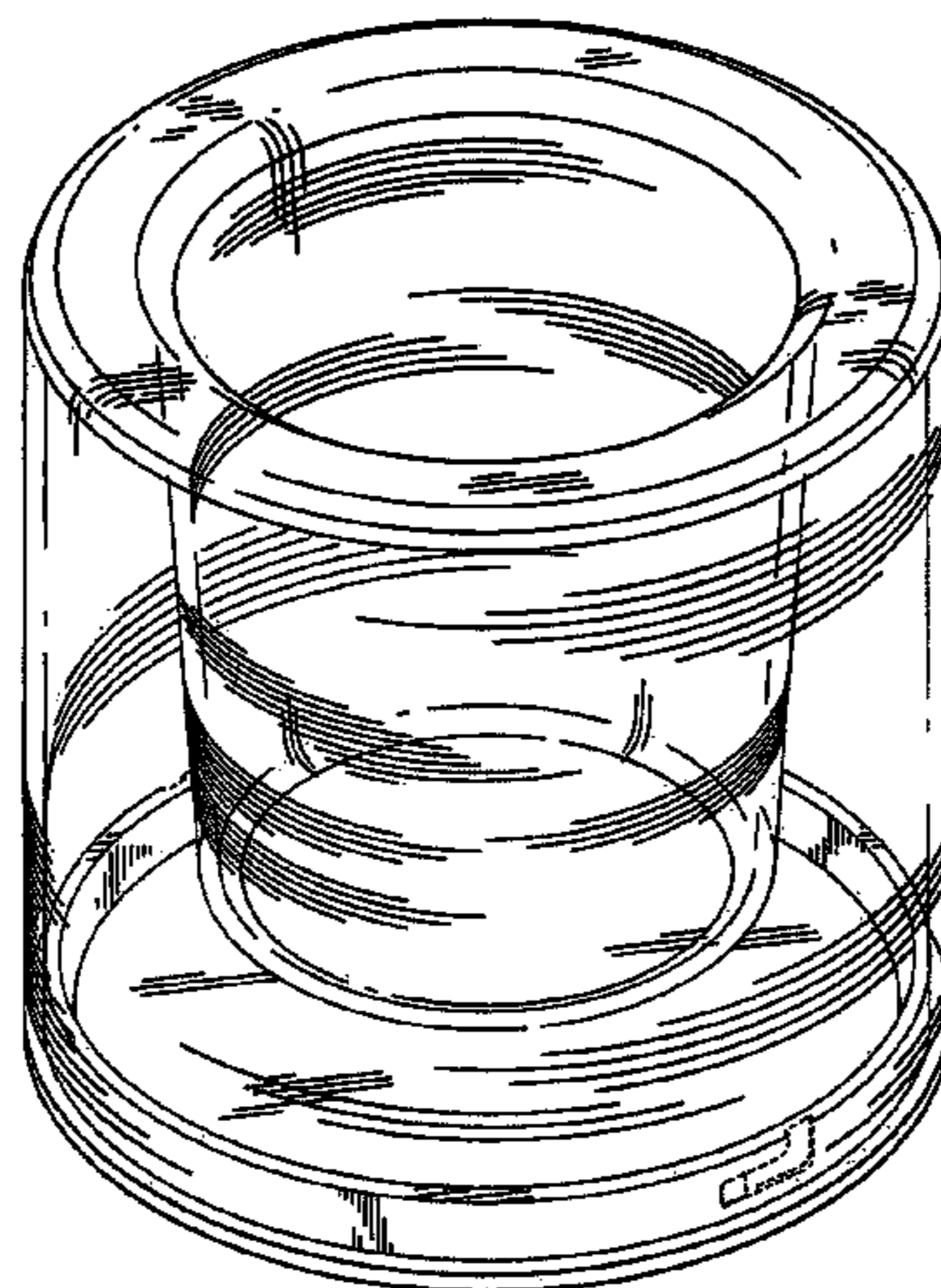
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the decorative container of FIG. 1, the opposite side being identical thereto.

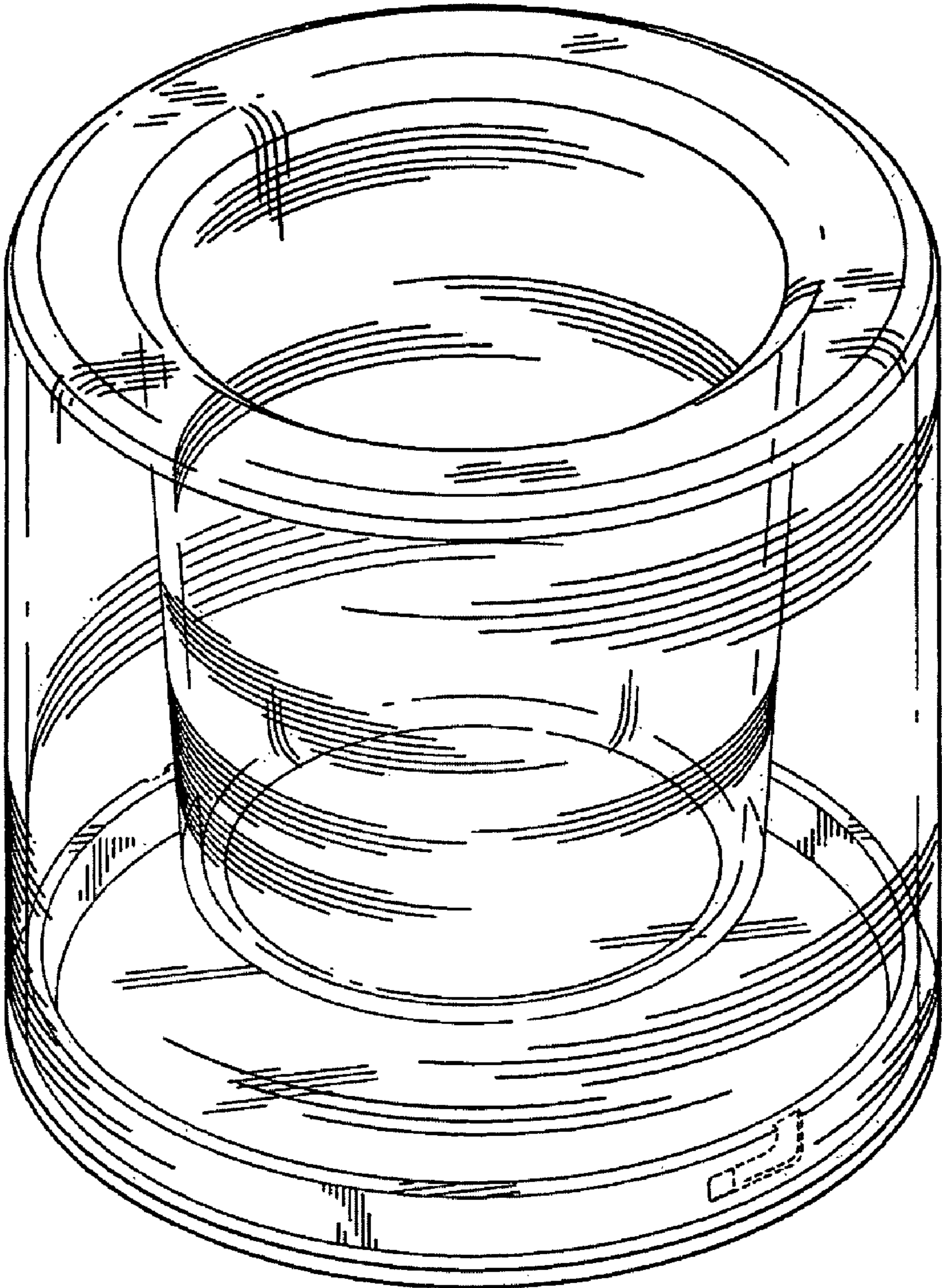

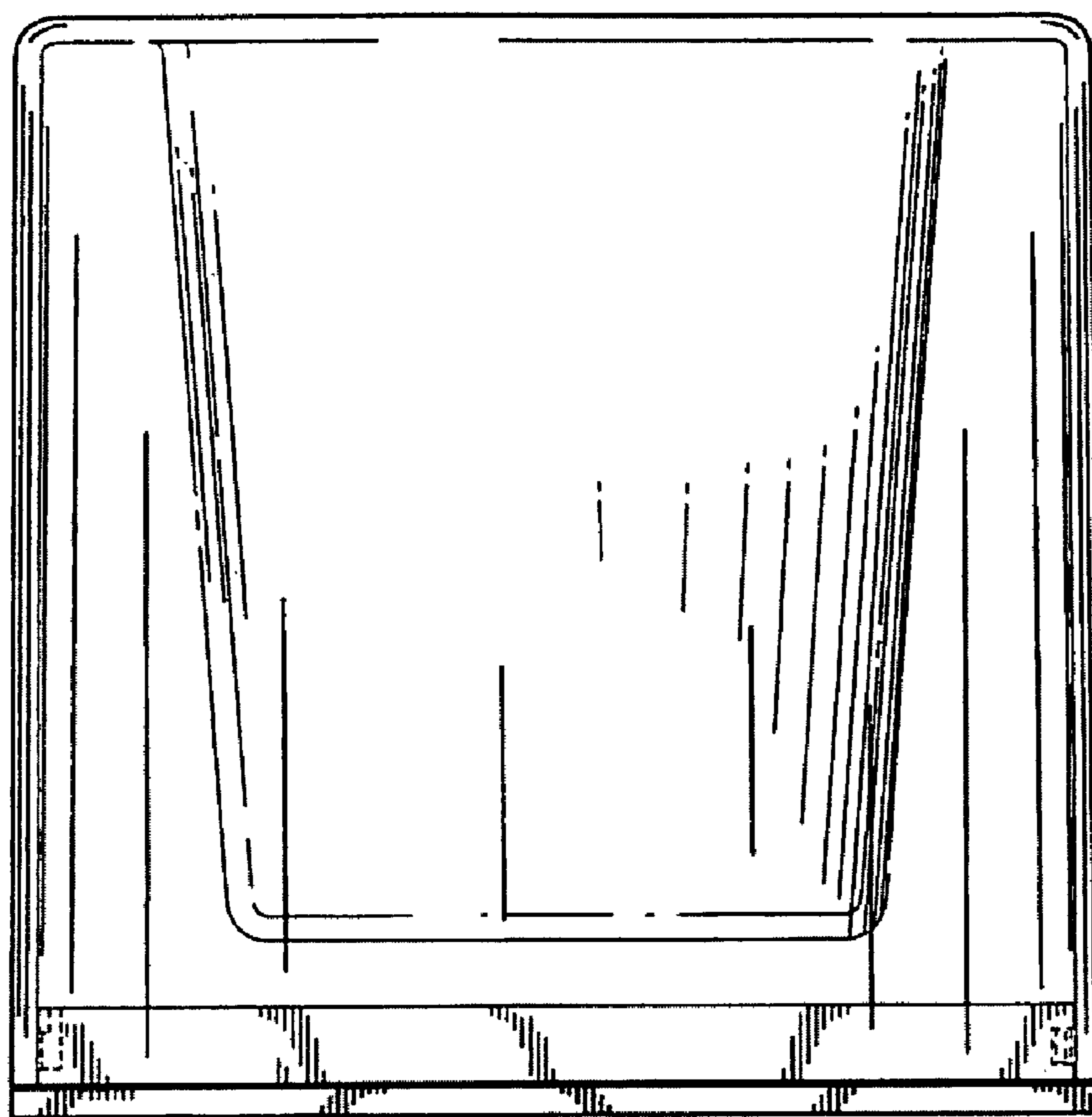

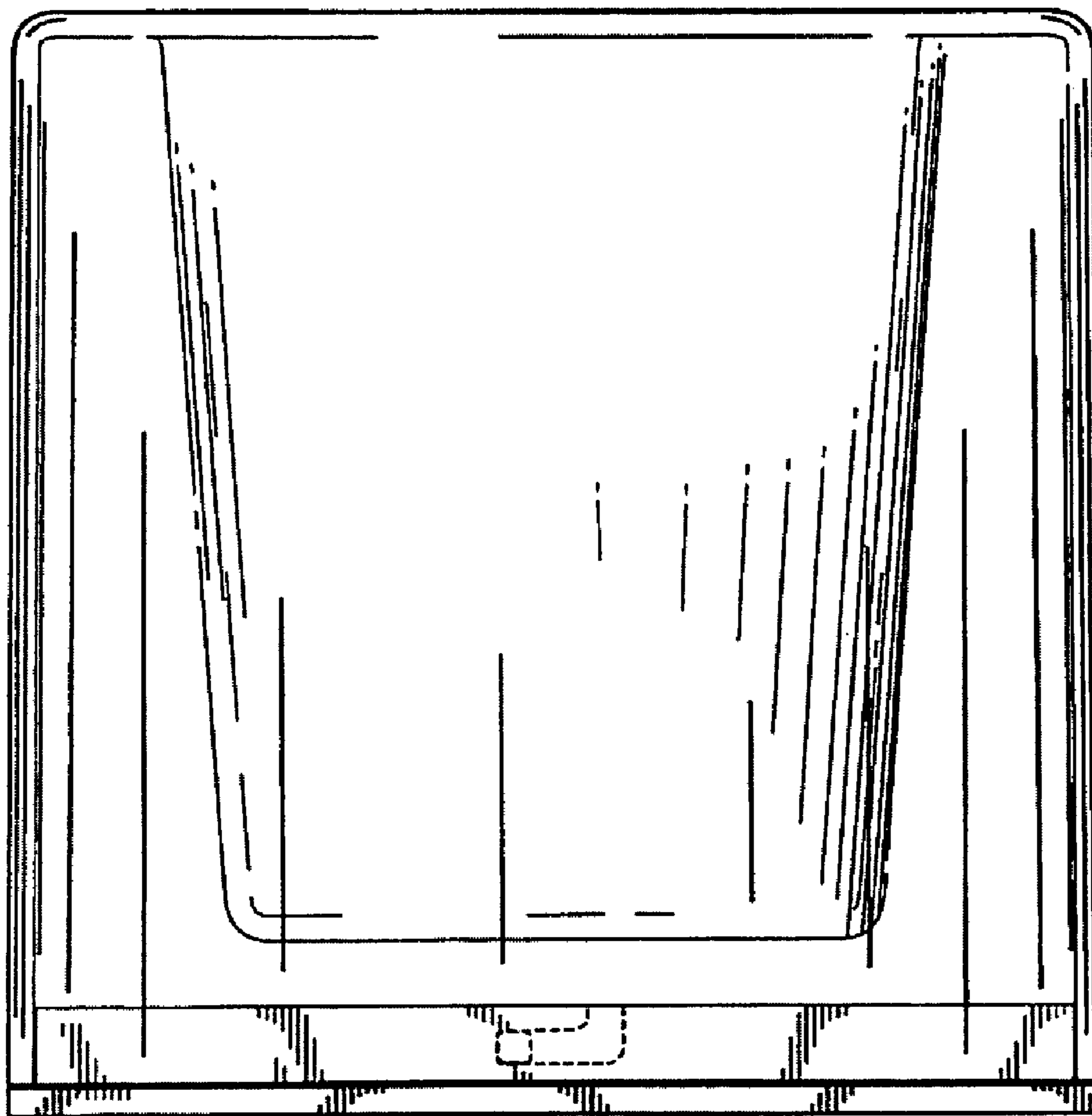

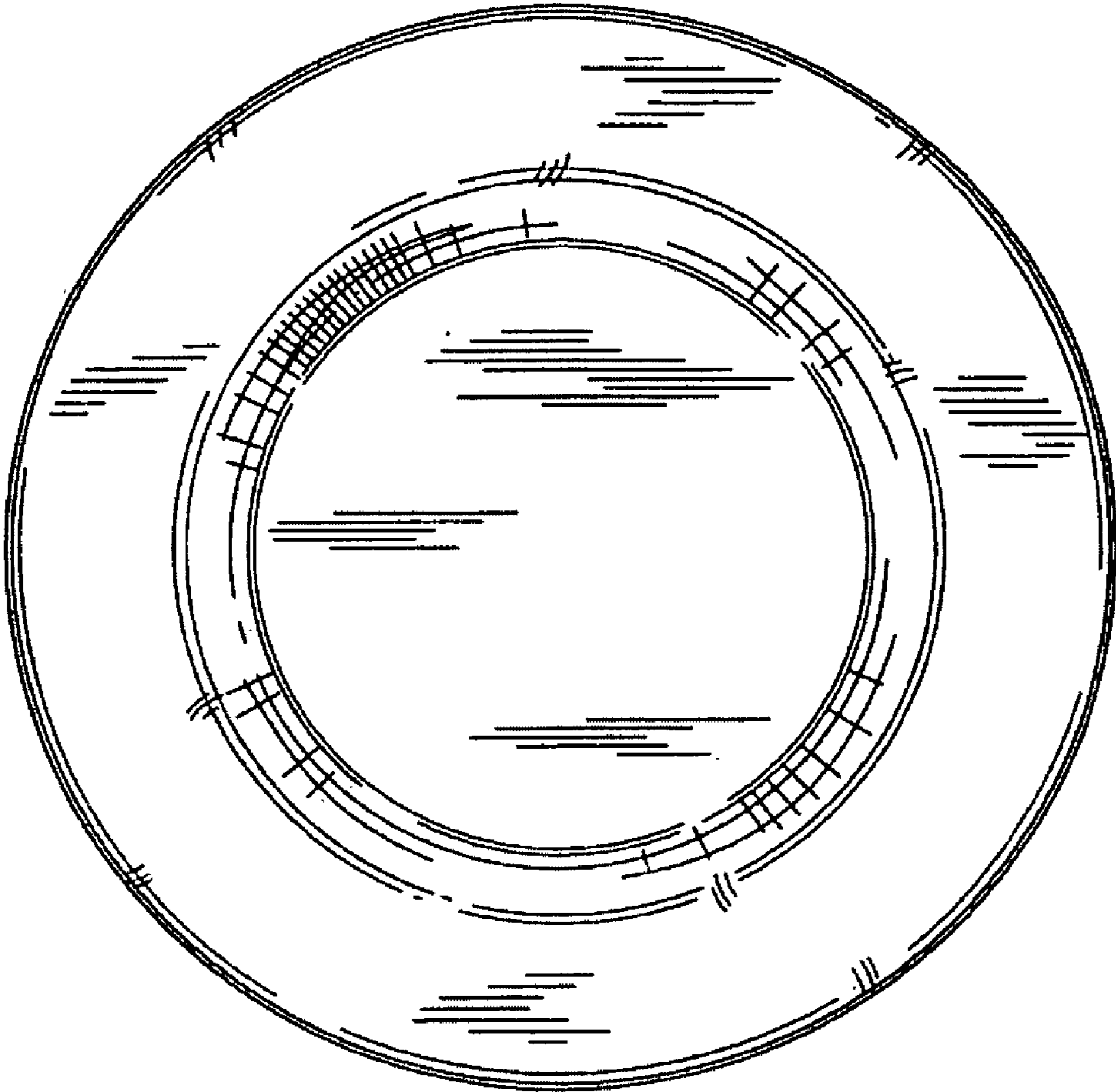

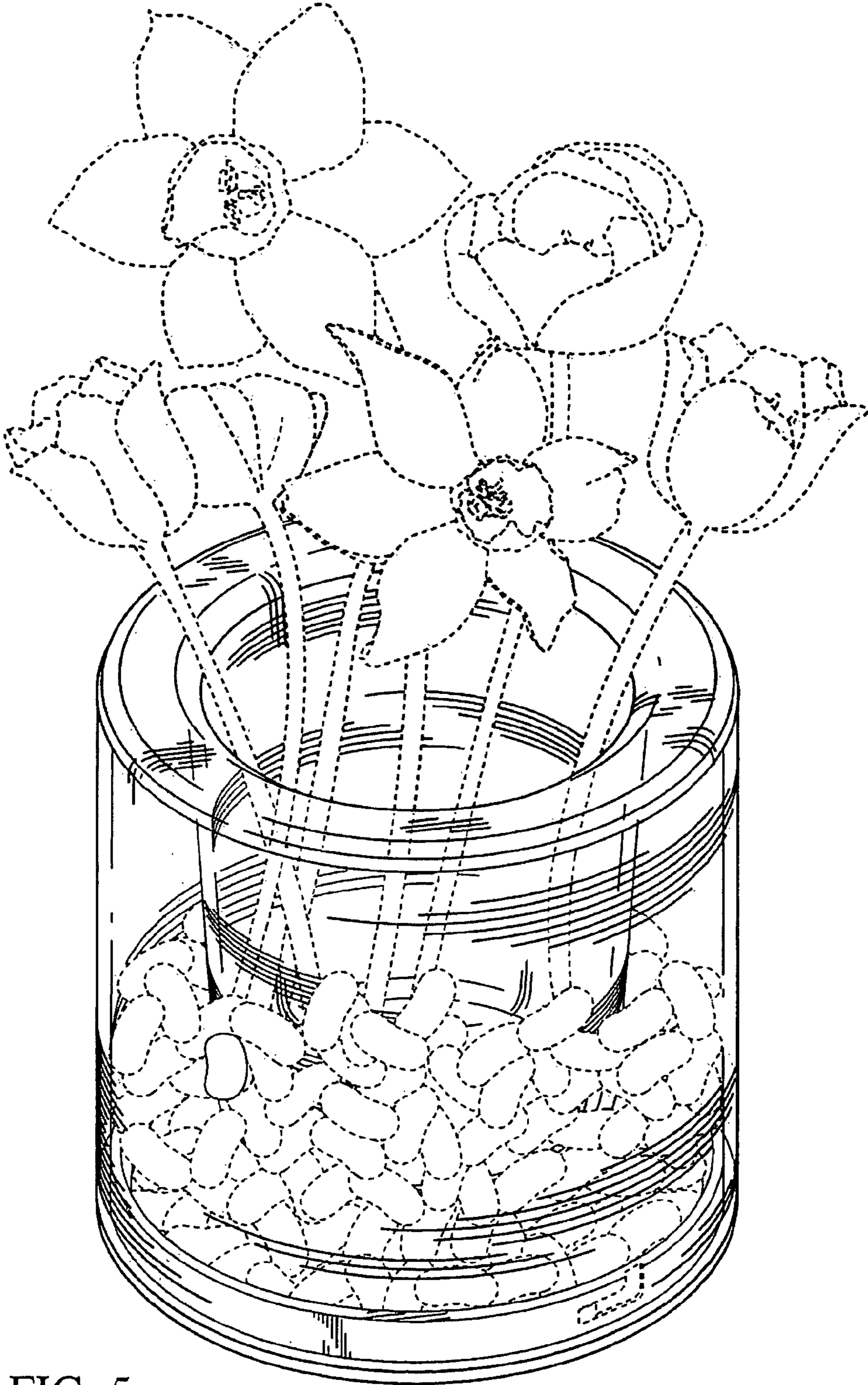
