FIG. 5 is a right side elevation thereof.

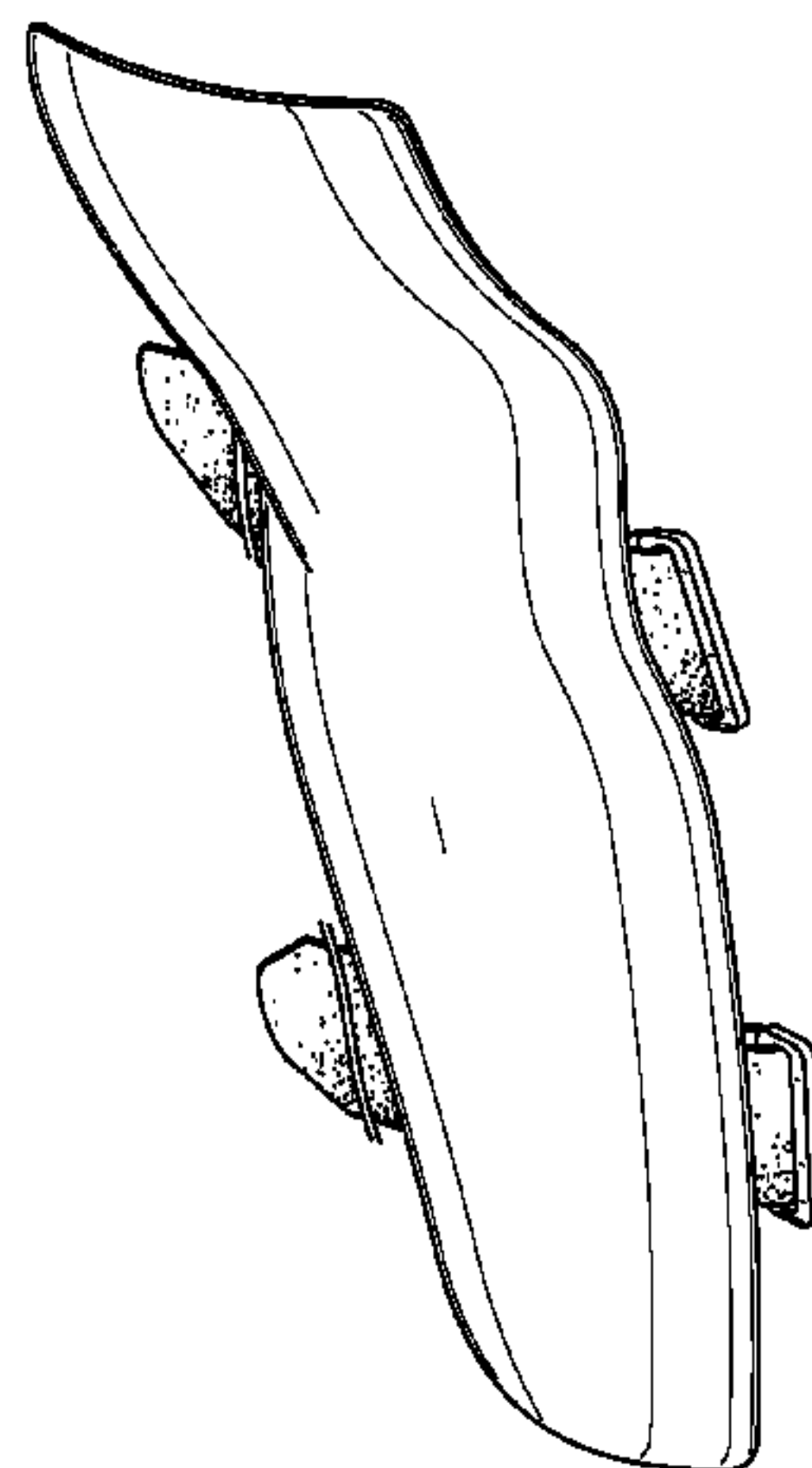
FIG. 6 is a top rear perspective view thereof.

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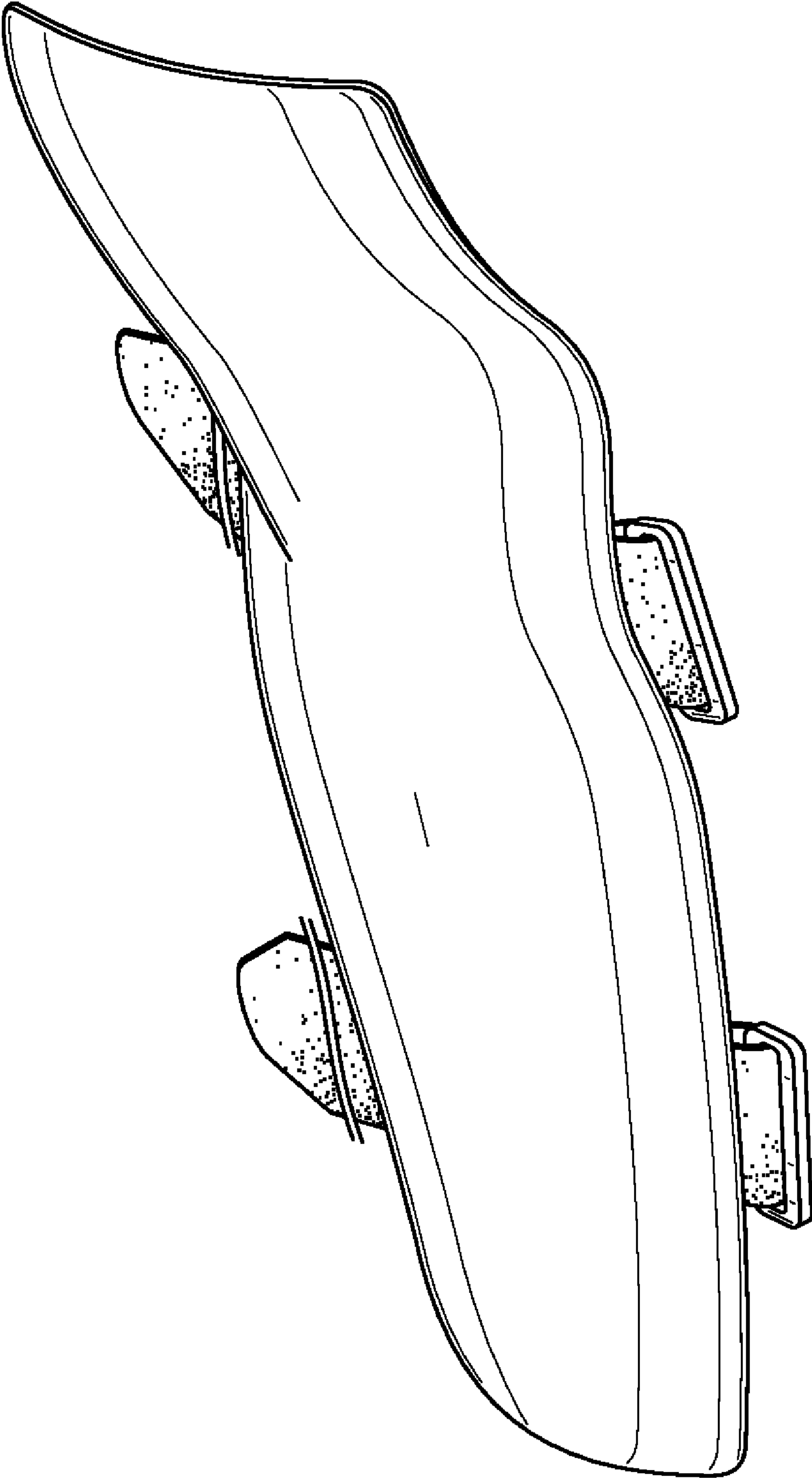

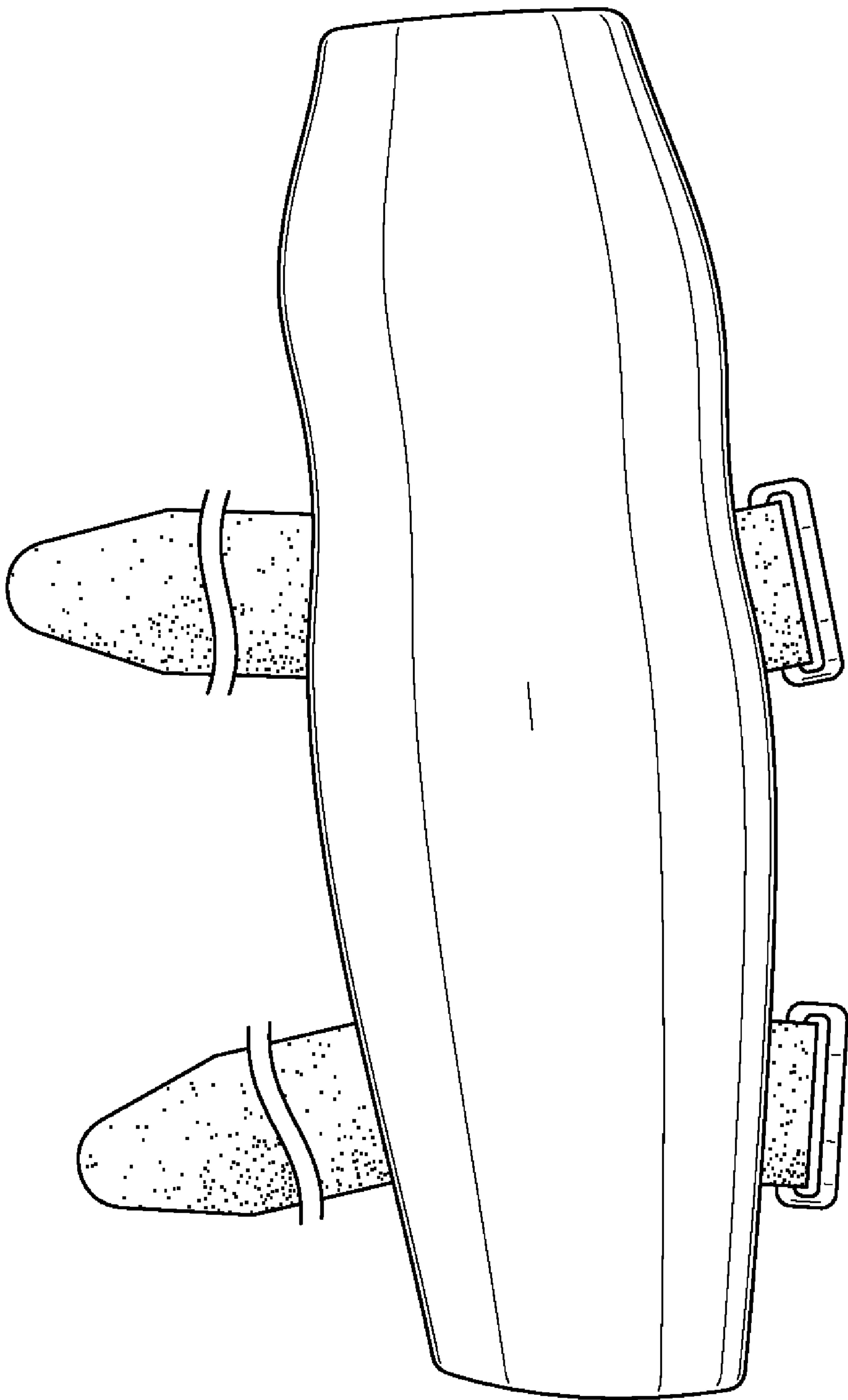

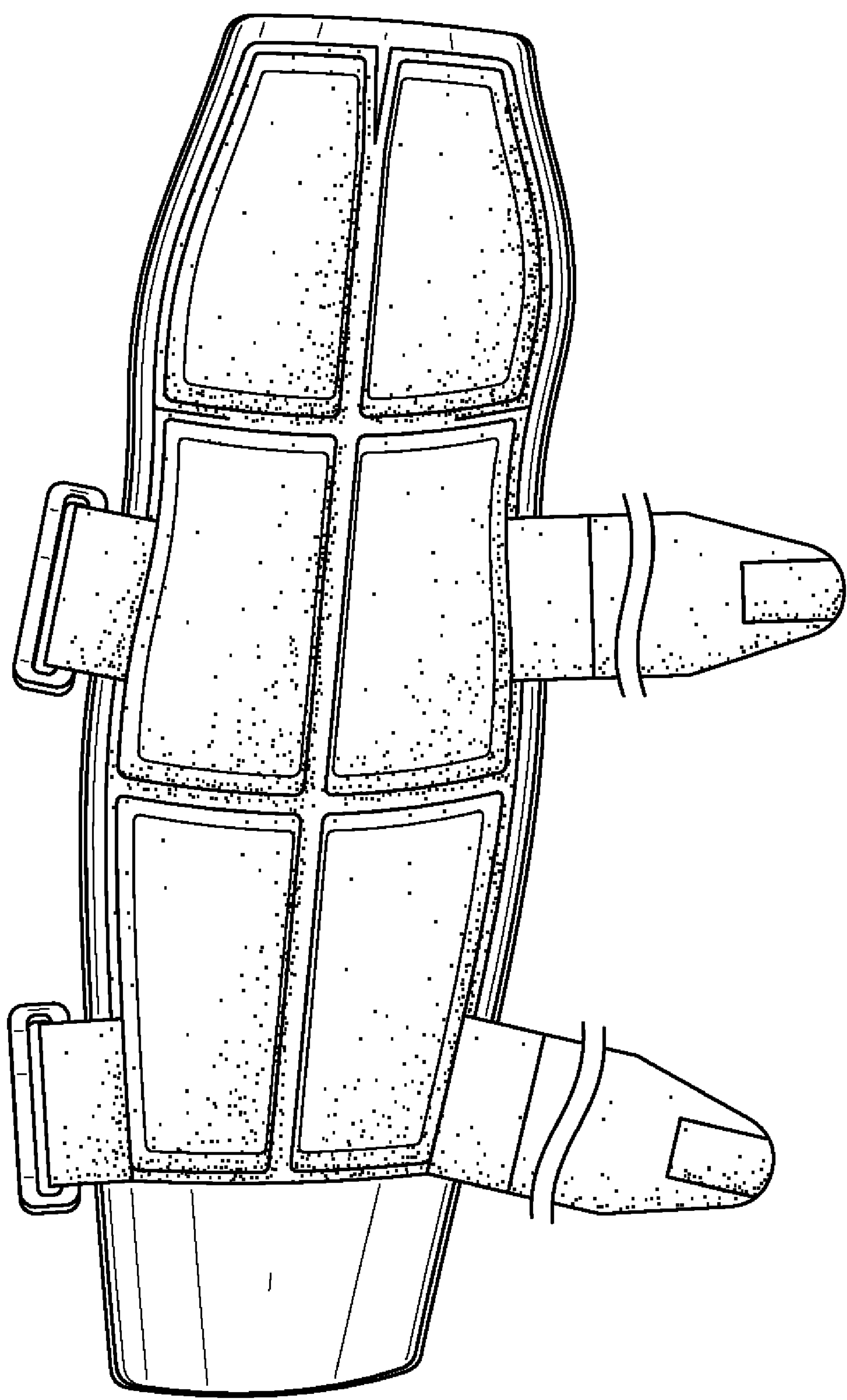

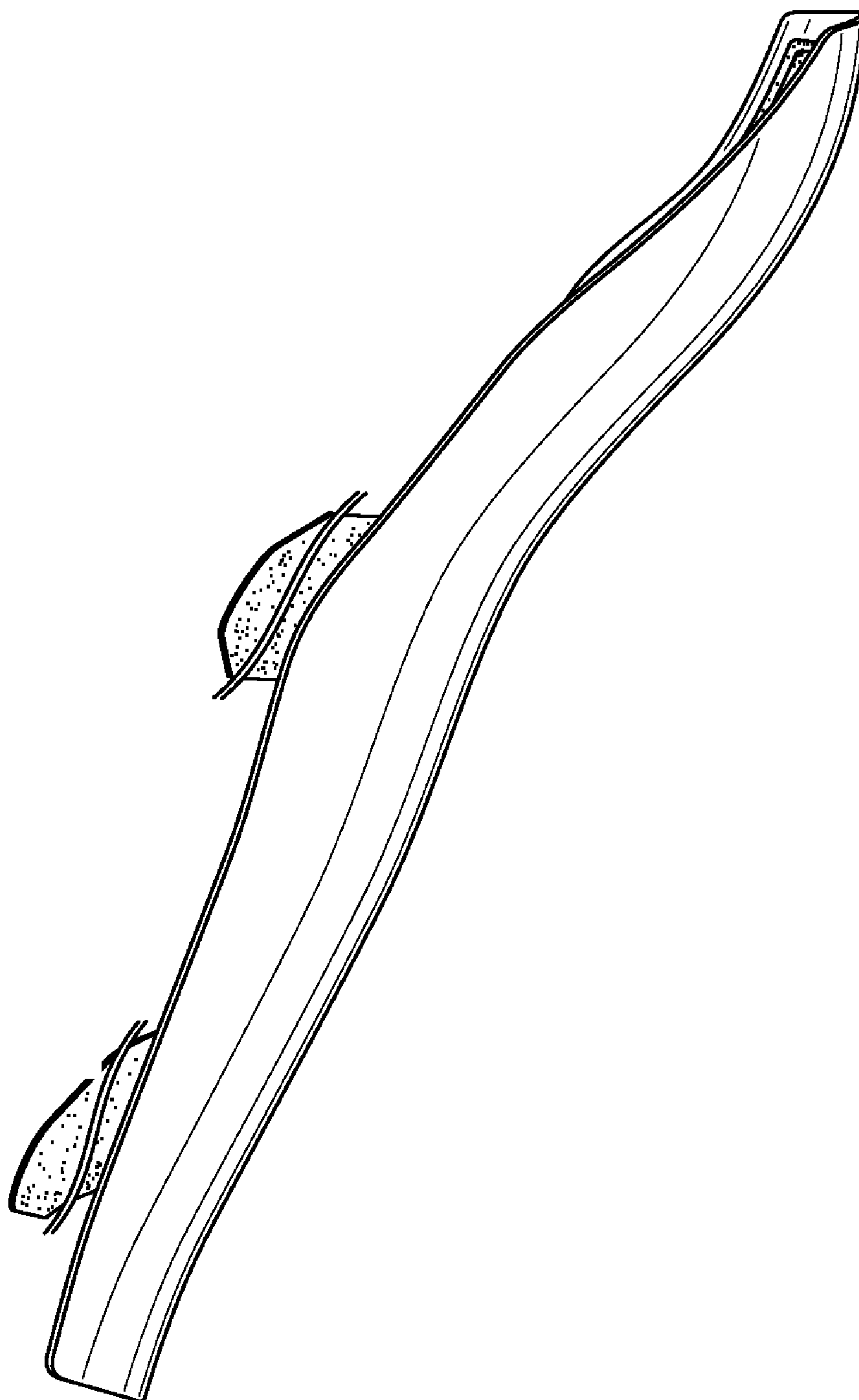

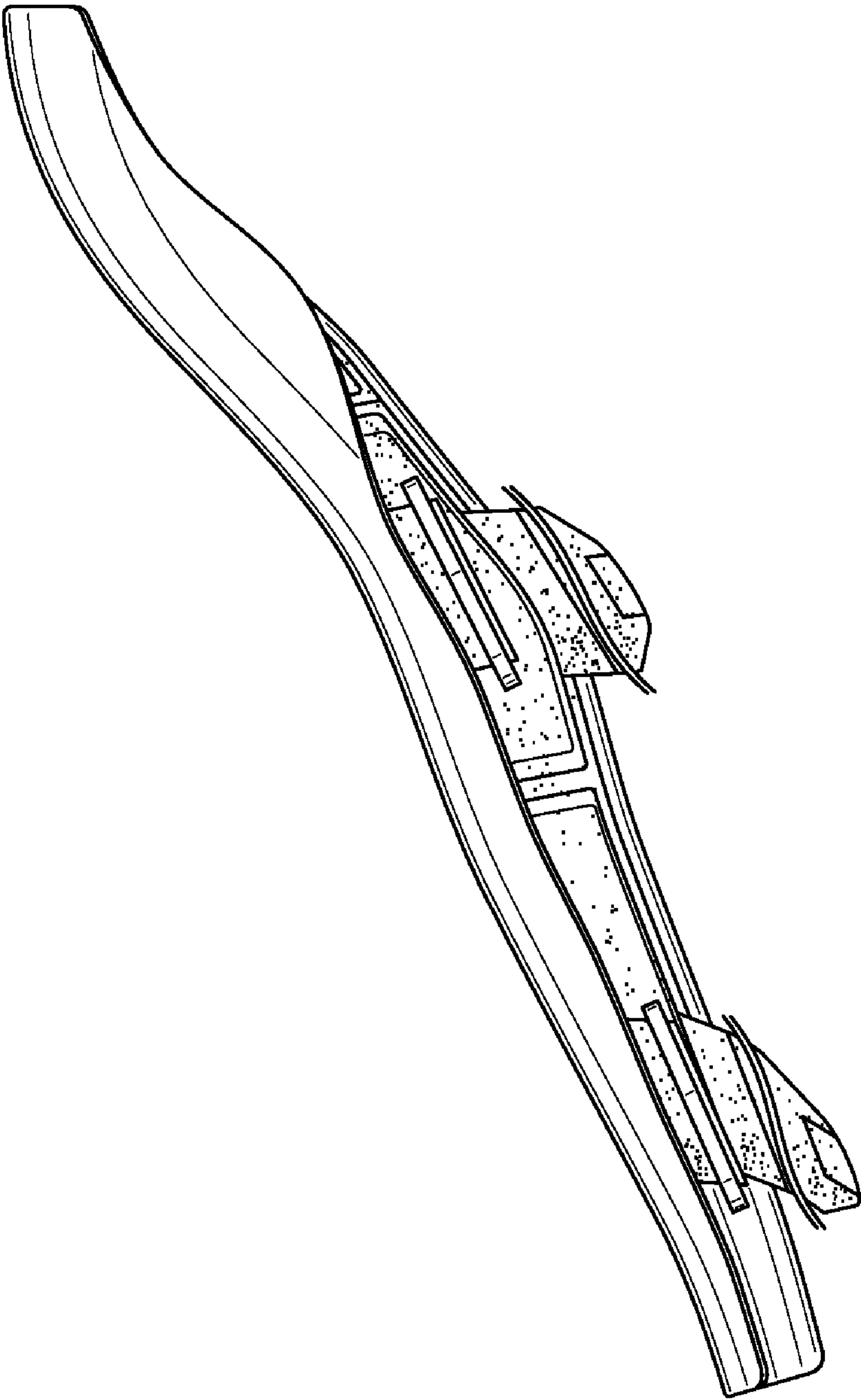

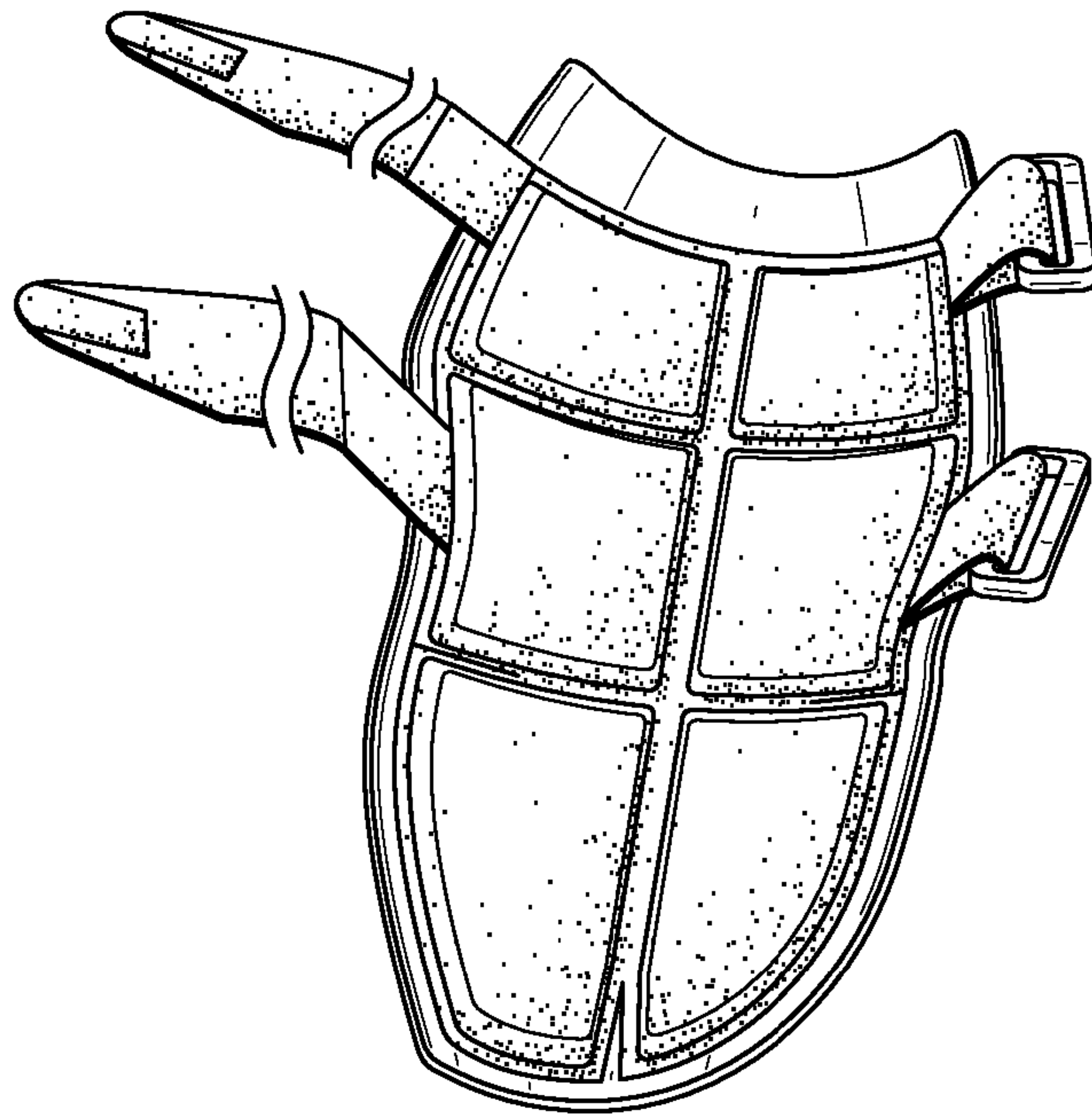

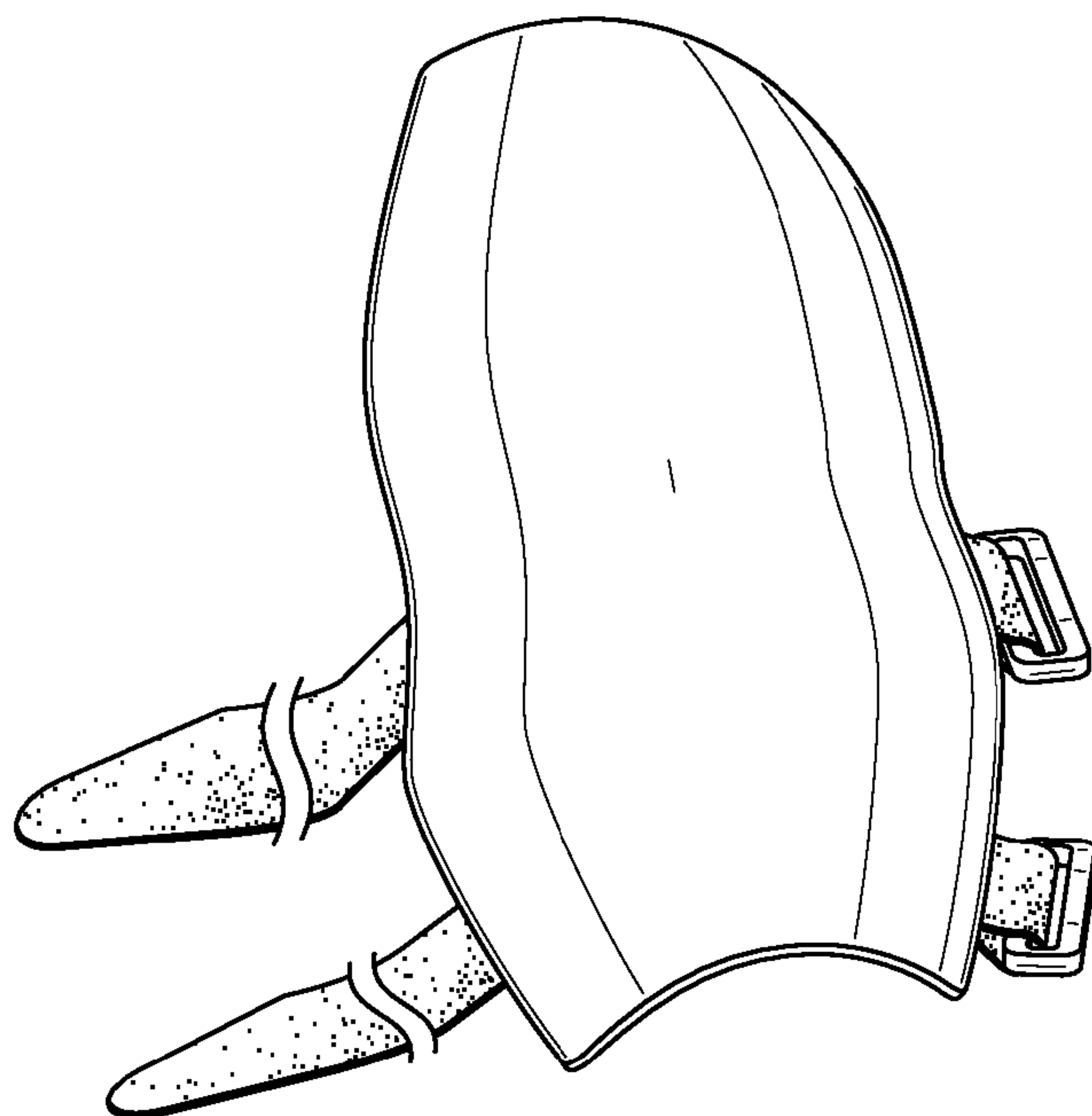

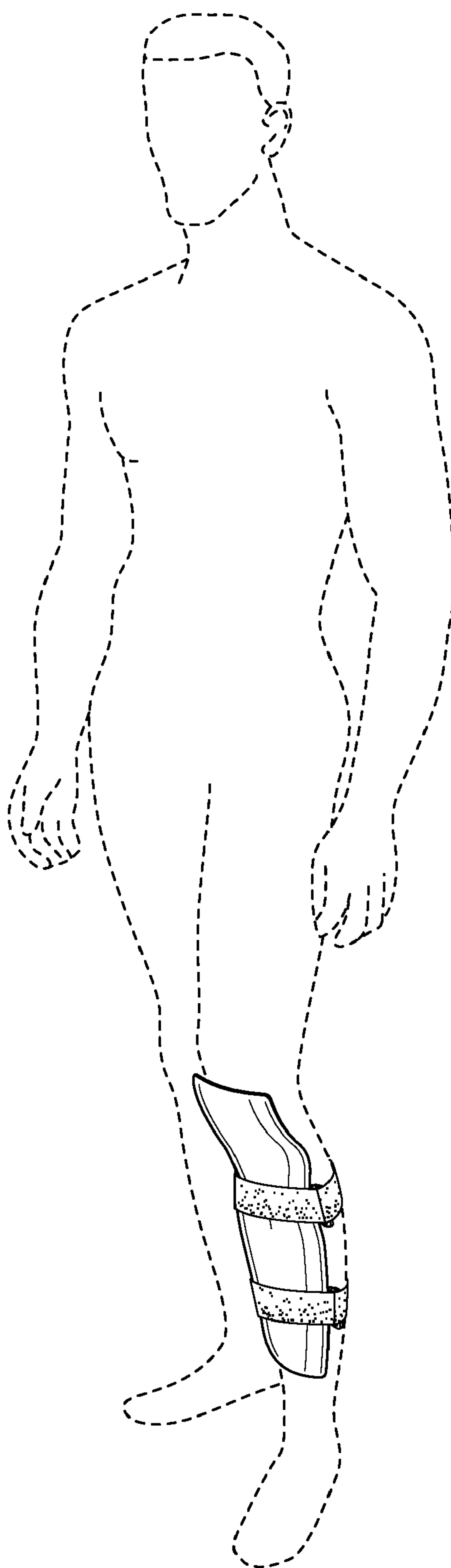
