DESCRIPTION

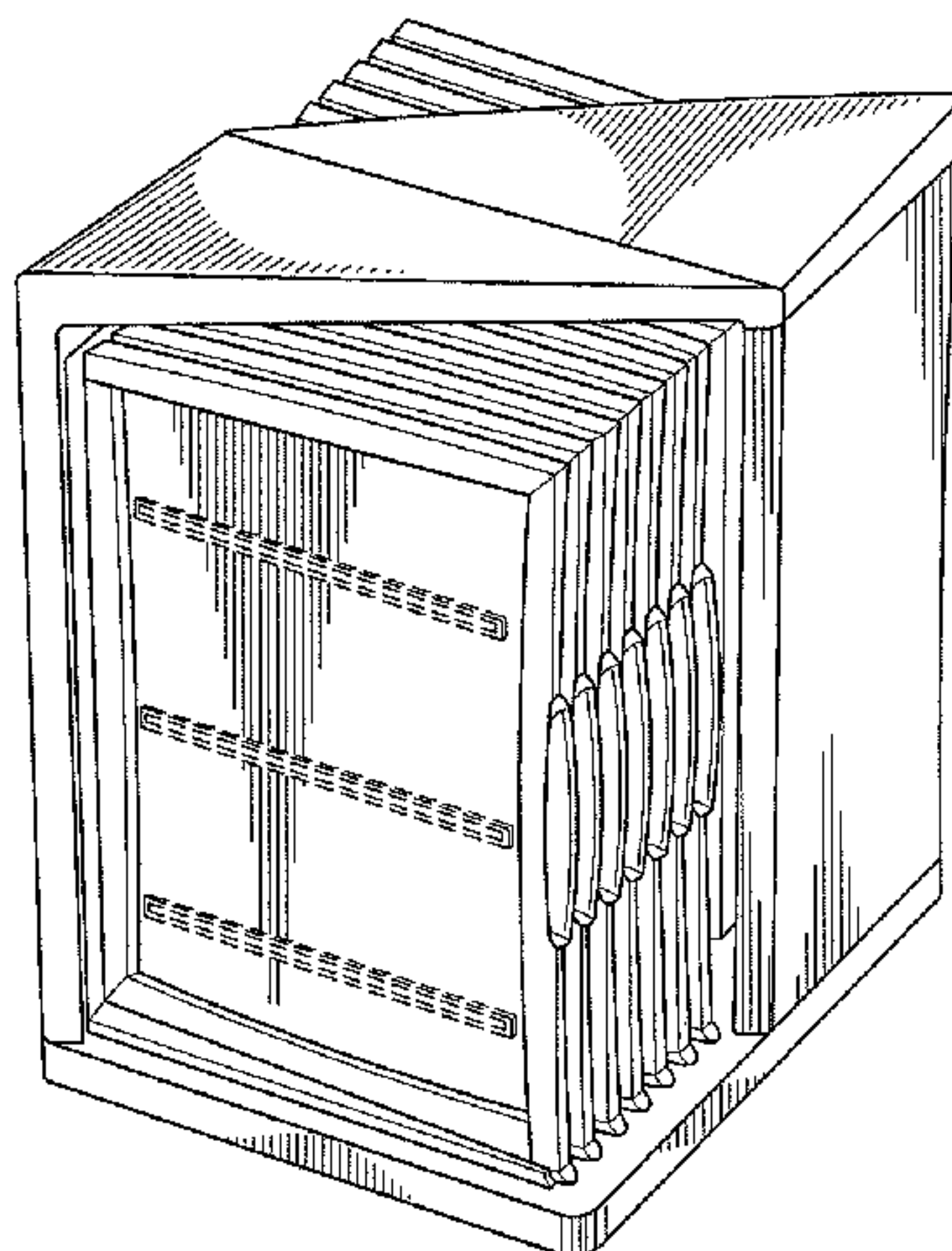
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the exhibition stand with all display panels in a closed position; and
FIG. 2 is a side view of the exhibition stand with all display panels in a closed position.
FIG. 3 is a front view of an exhibition stand, with some display panels in the front and back in an open position;
FIG. 4 is a top view of the exhibition stand in the position shown in FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the exhibition stand in the position shown in FIG. 3;
FIG. 6 is a front view of the exhibition stand with only some front panels open and the back panels closed; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the exhibition stand in the position shown in FIG. 6.
The broken lines in the figures illustrate unclaimed portions of the design.

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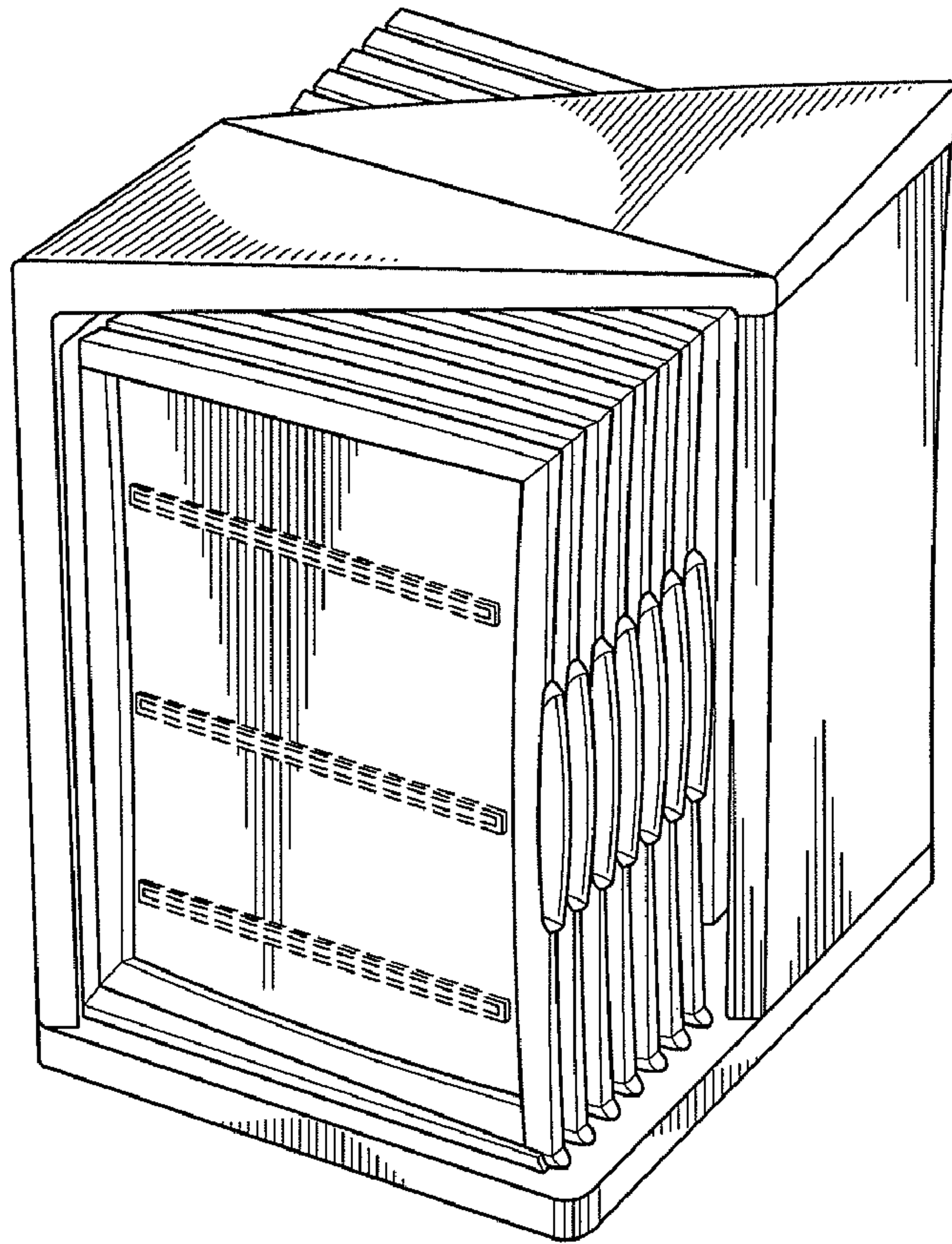

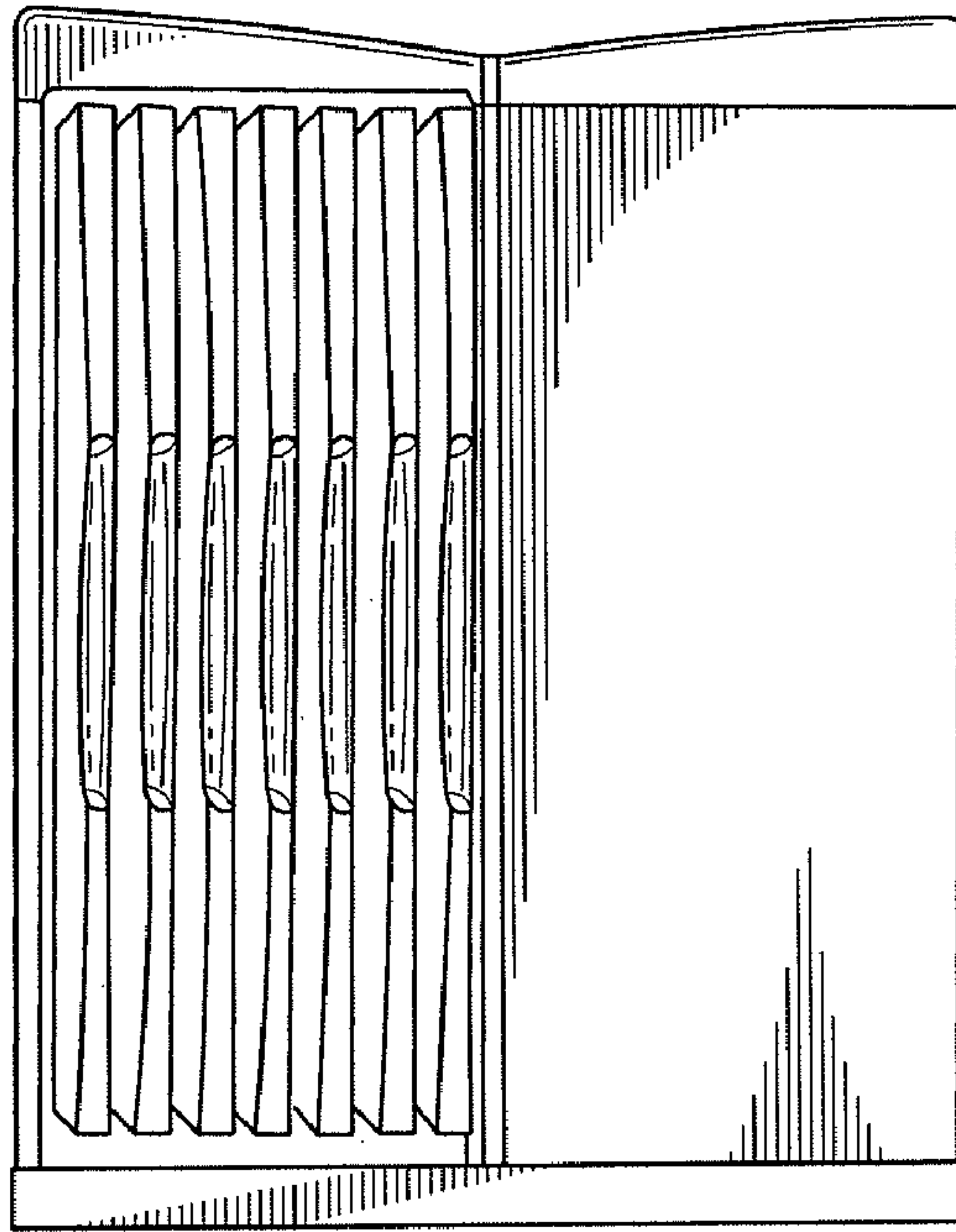

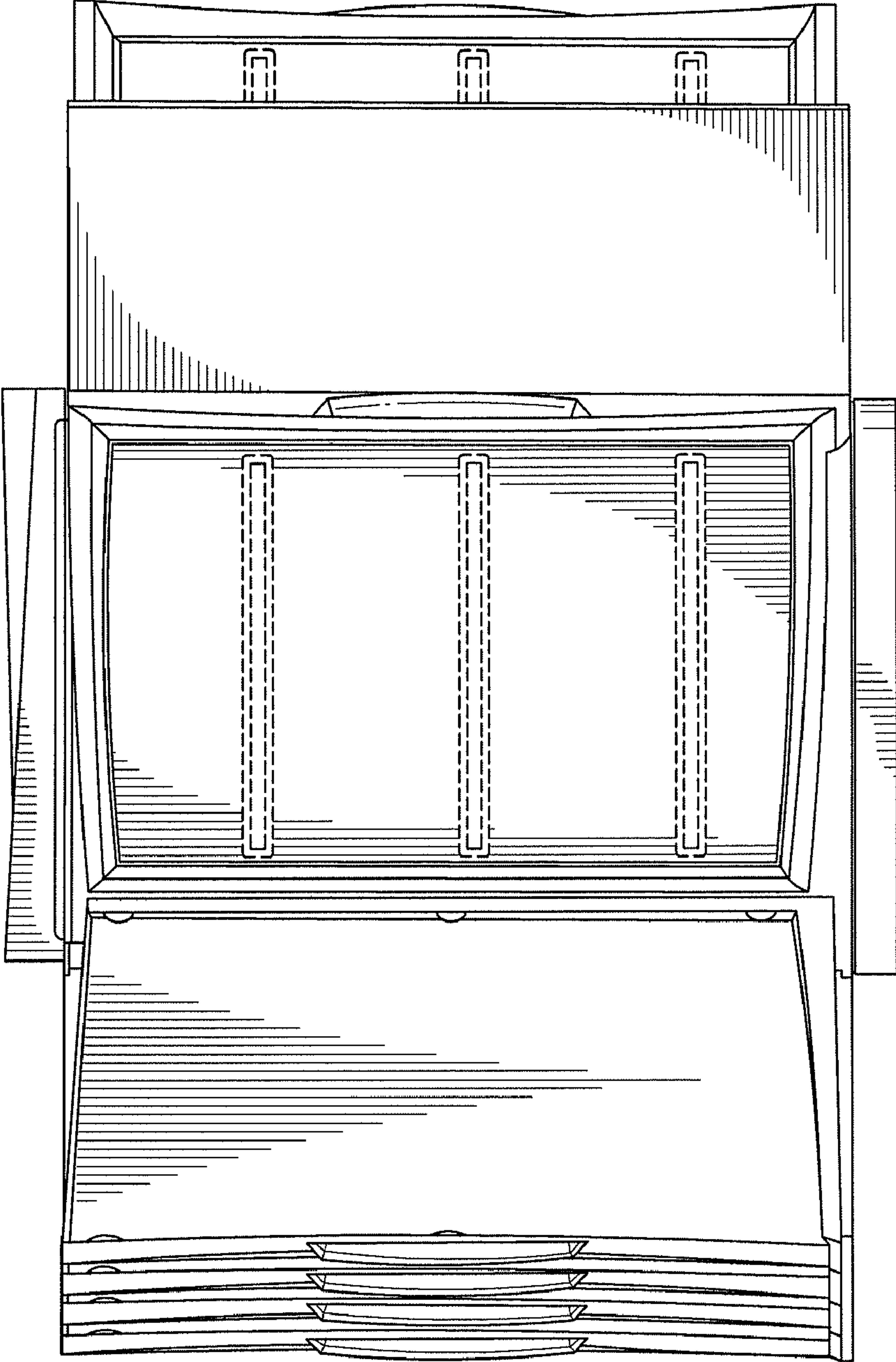

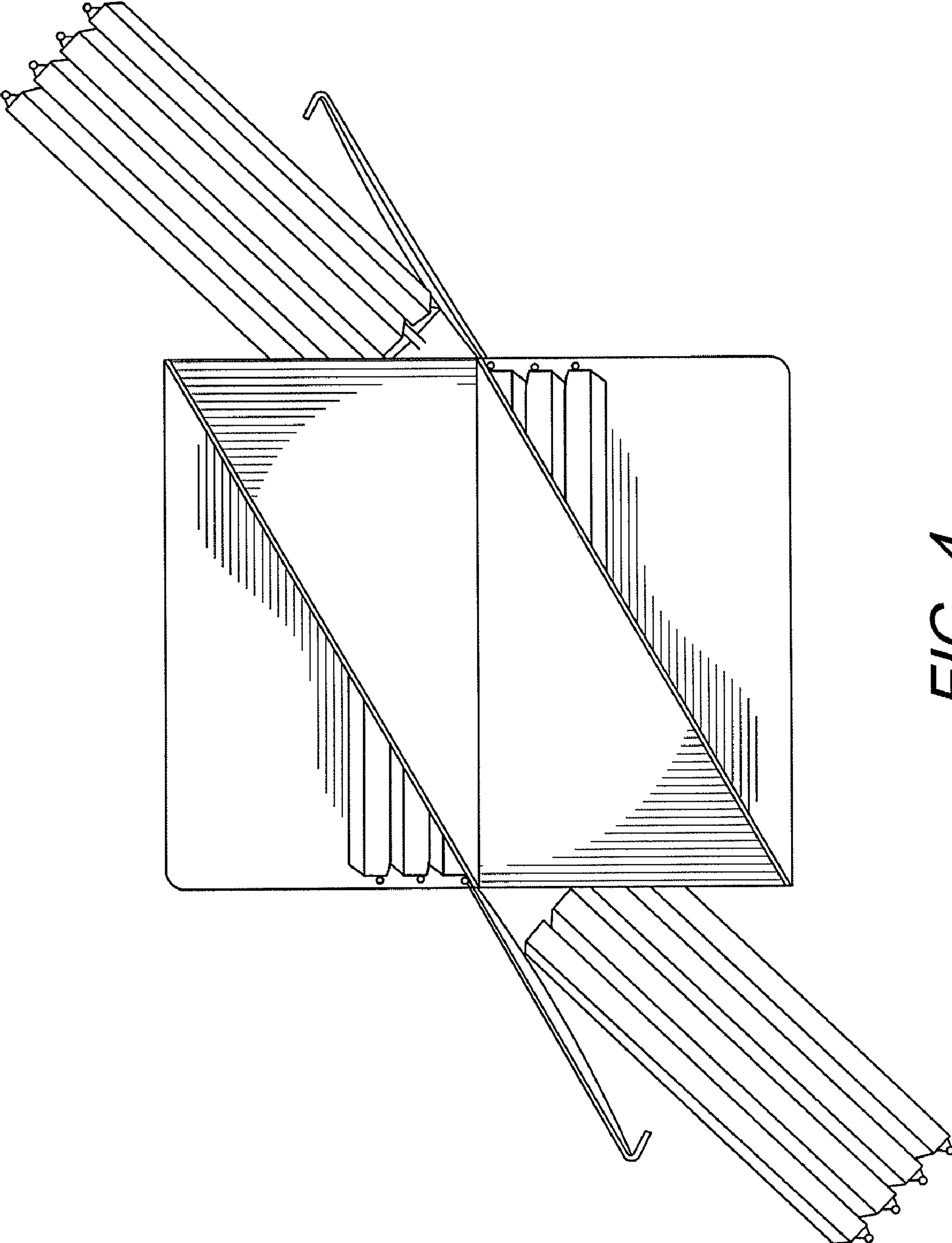

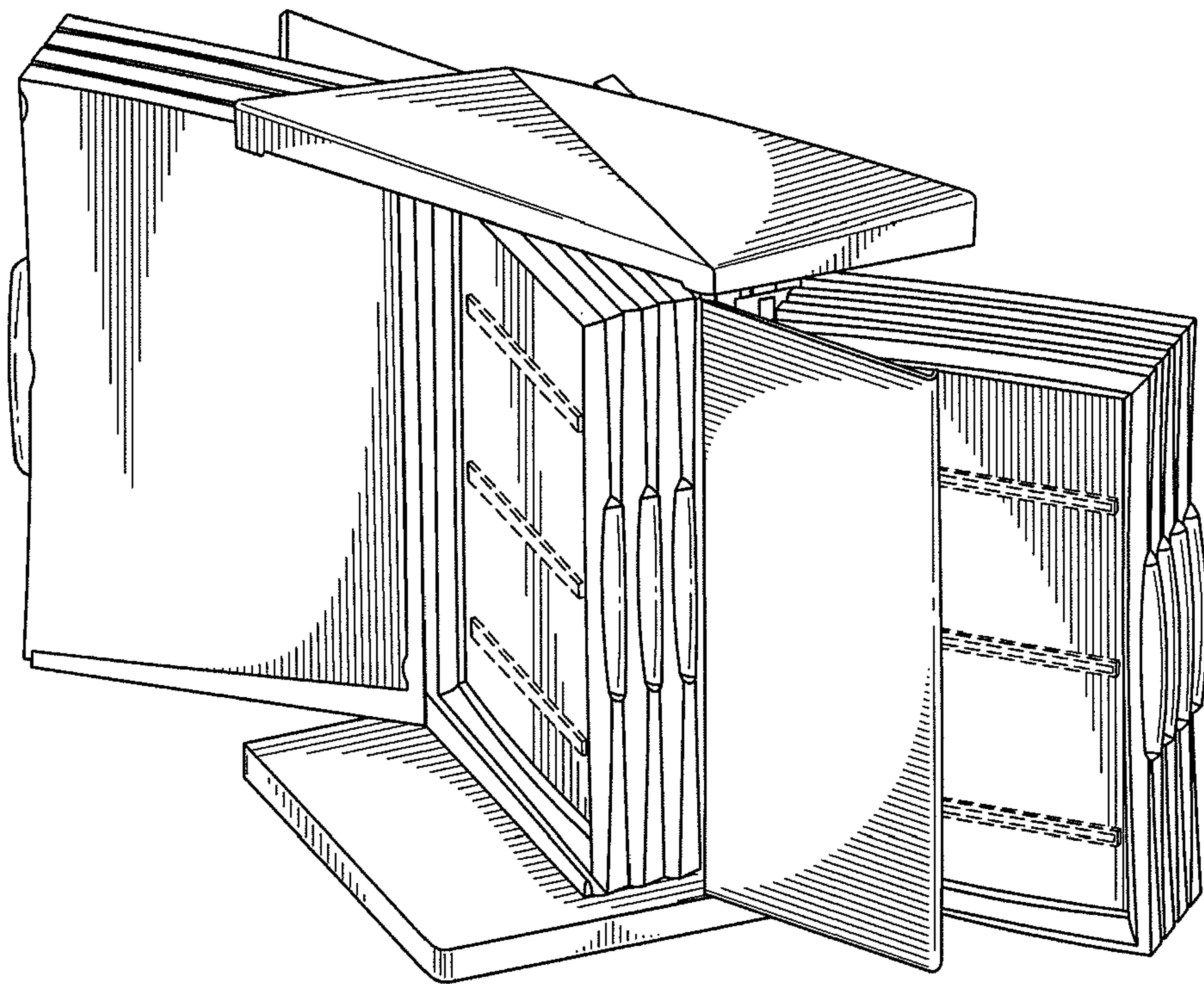

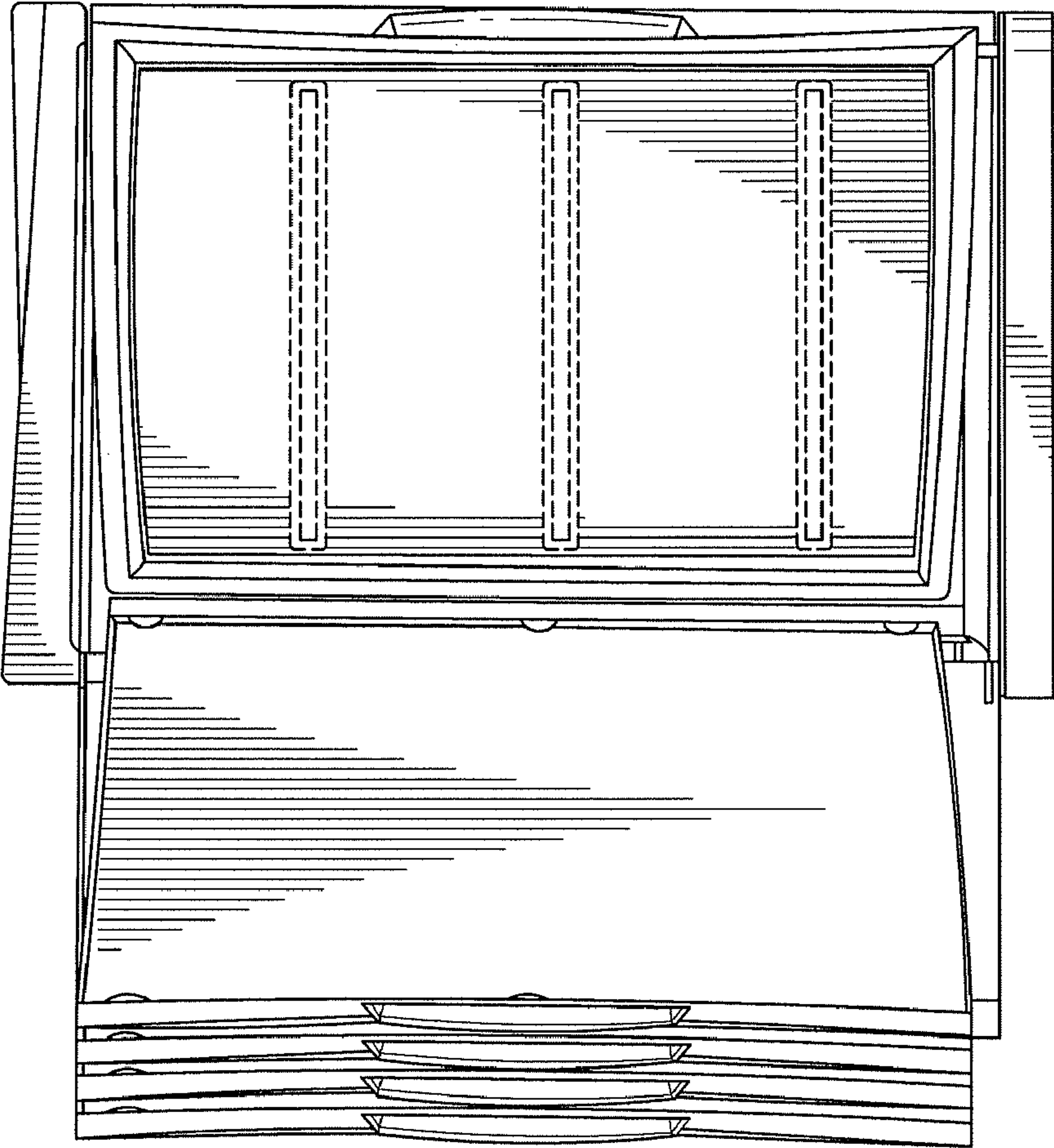

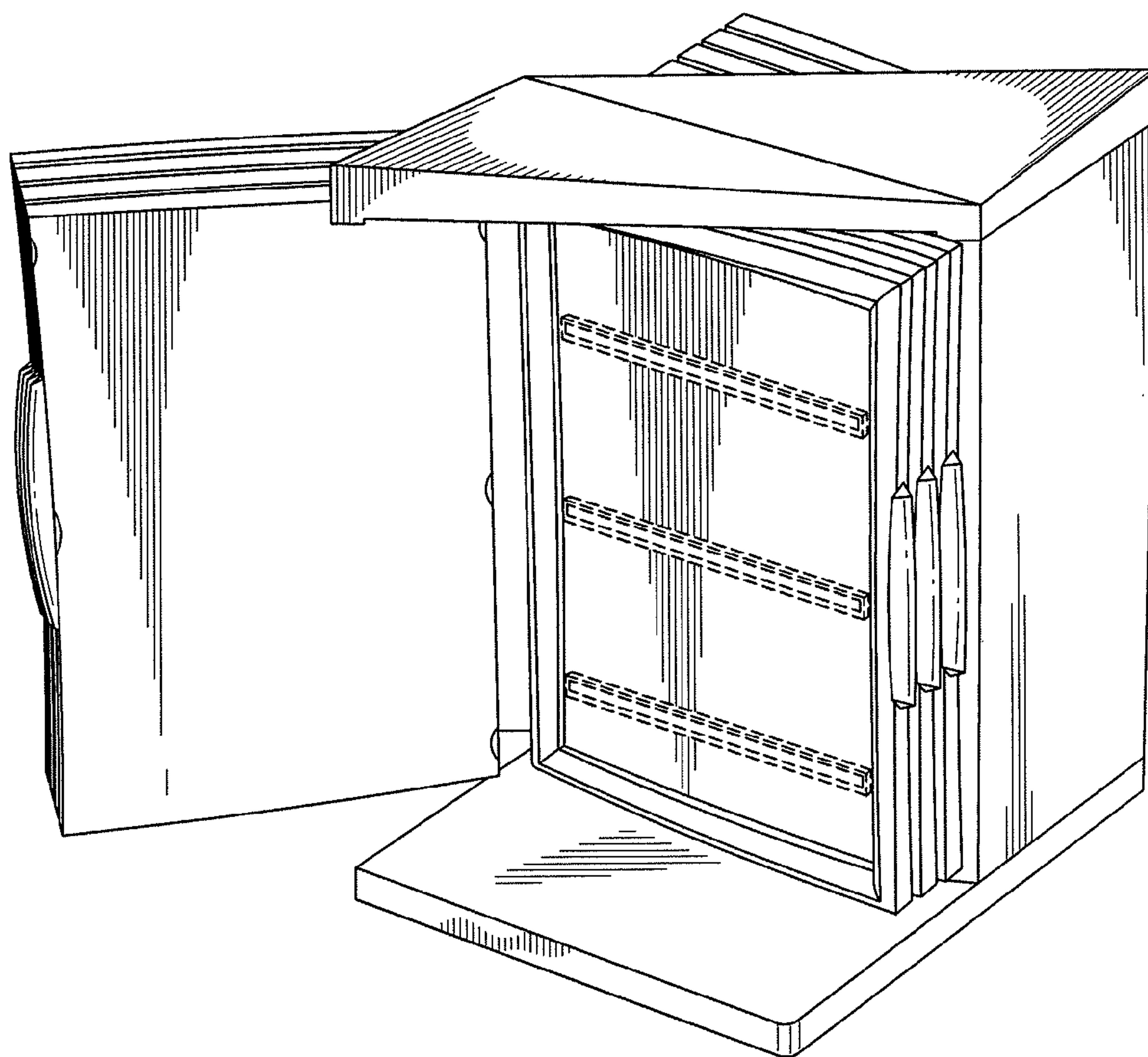
