blade.

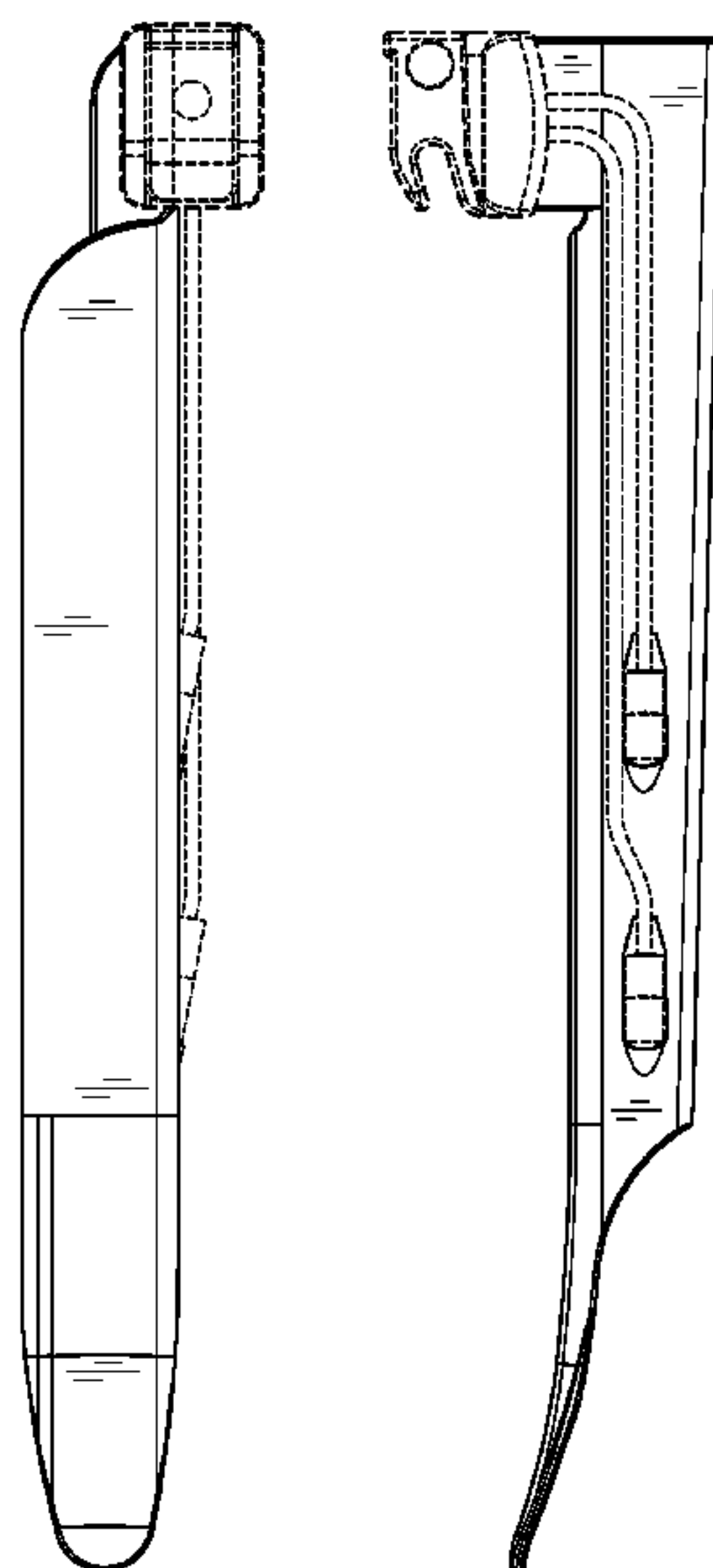
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the laryngoscope

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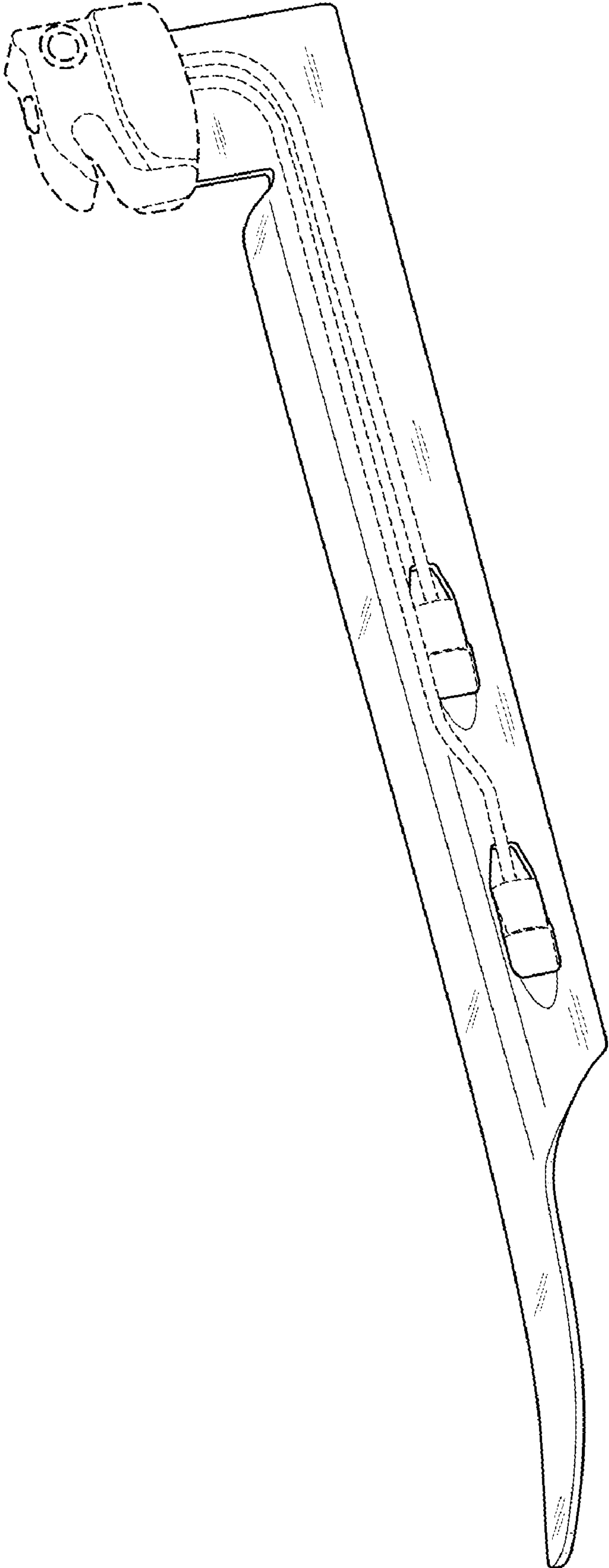

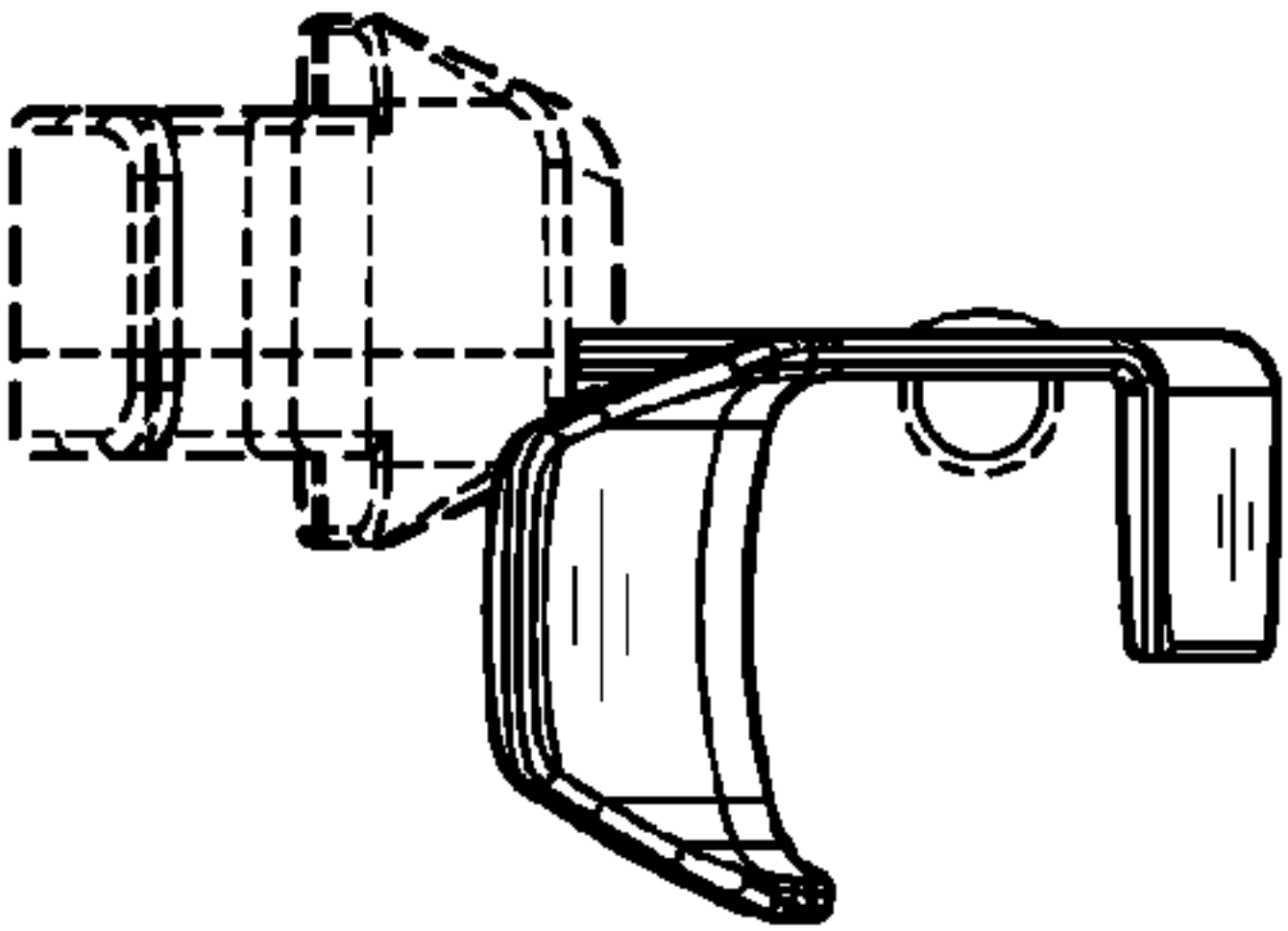
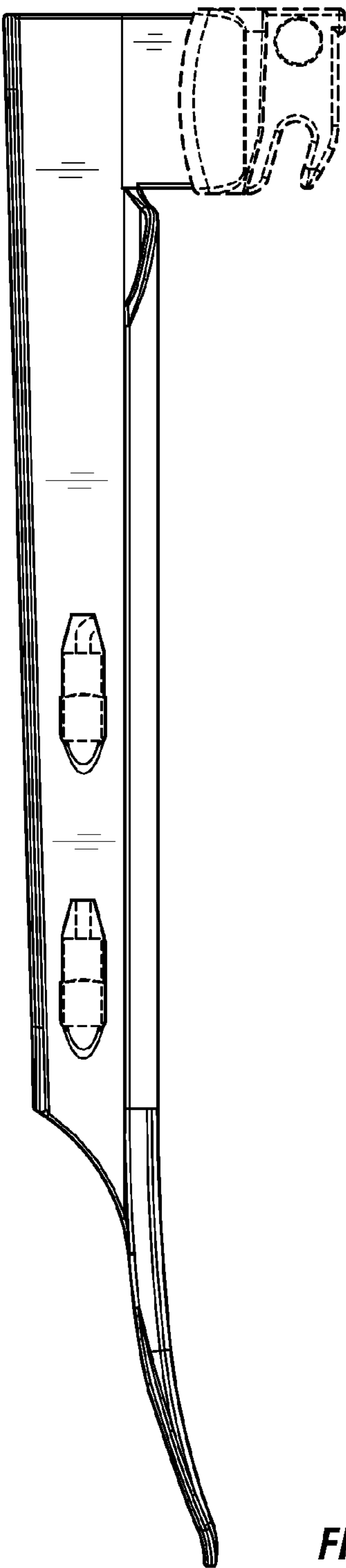
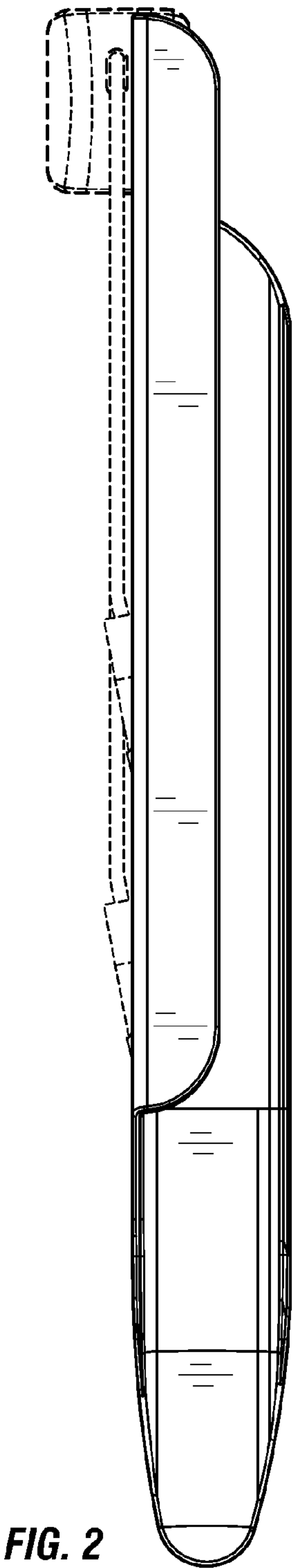
