(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a multipurpose hall, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a multipurpose hall incorporating our new design showing a reference legend to put the remaining figures in proper orientation;

FIG. 13 is a perspective view thereof taken from the back, right side as shown by arrow 13 in FIG. 1;

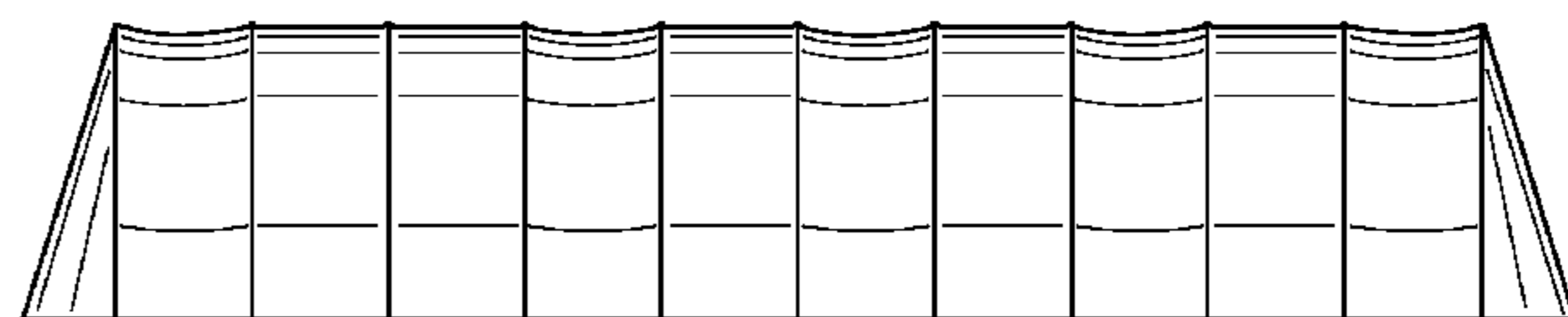
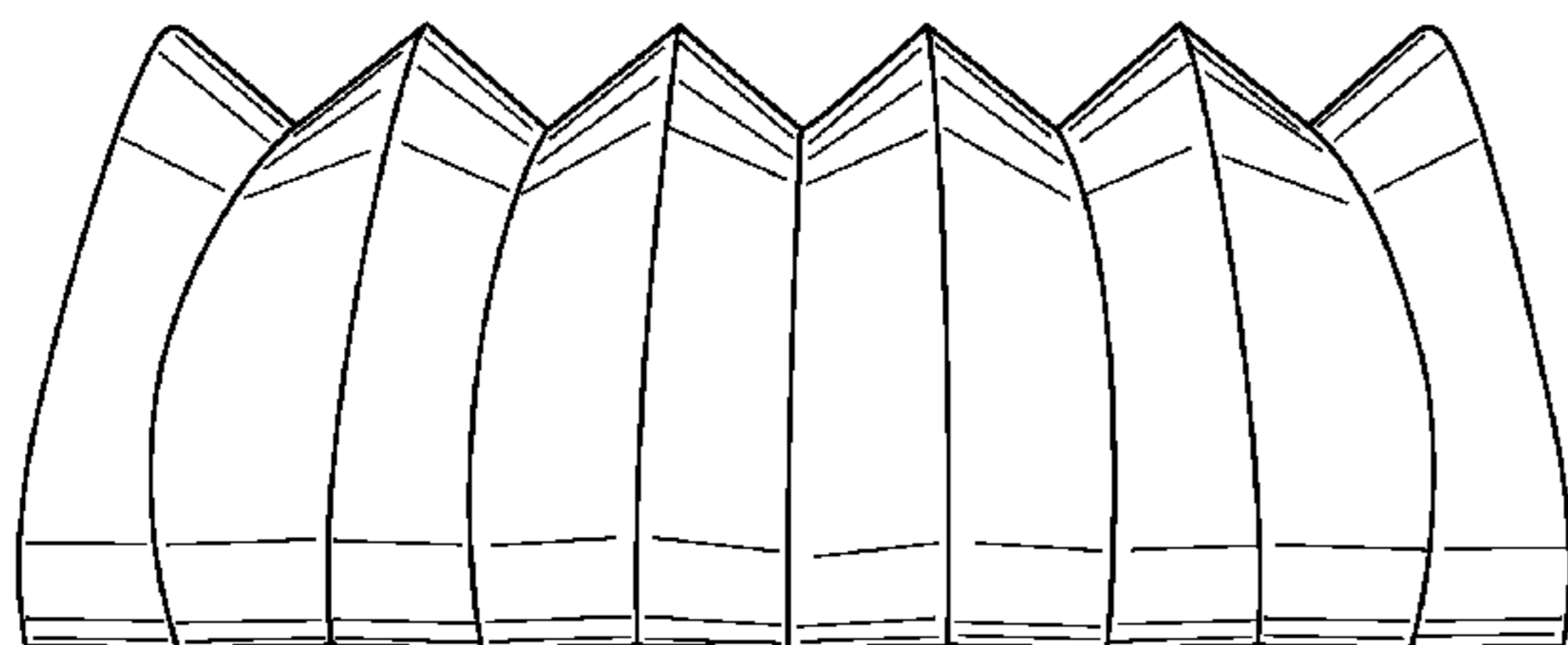
FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view thereof;

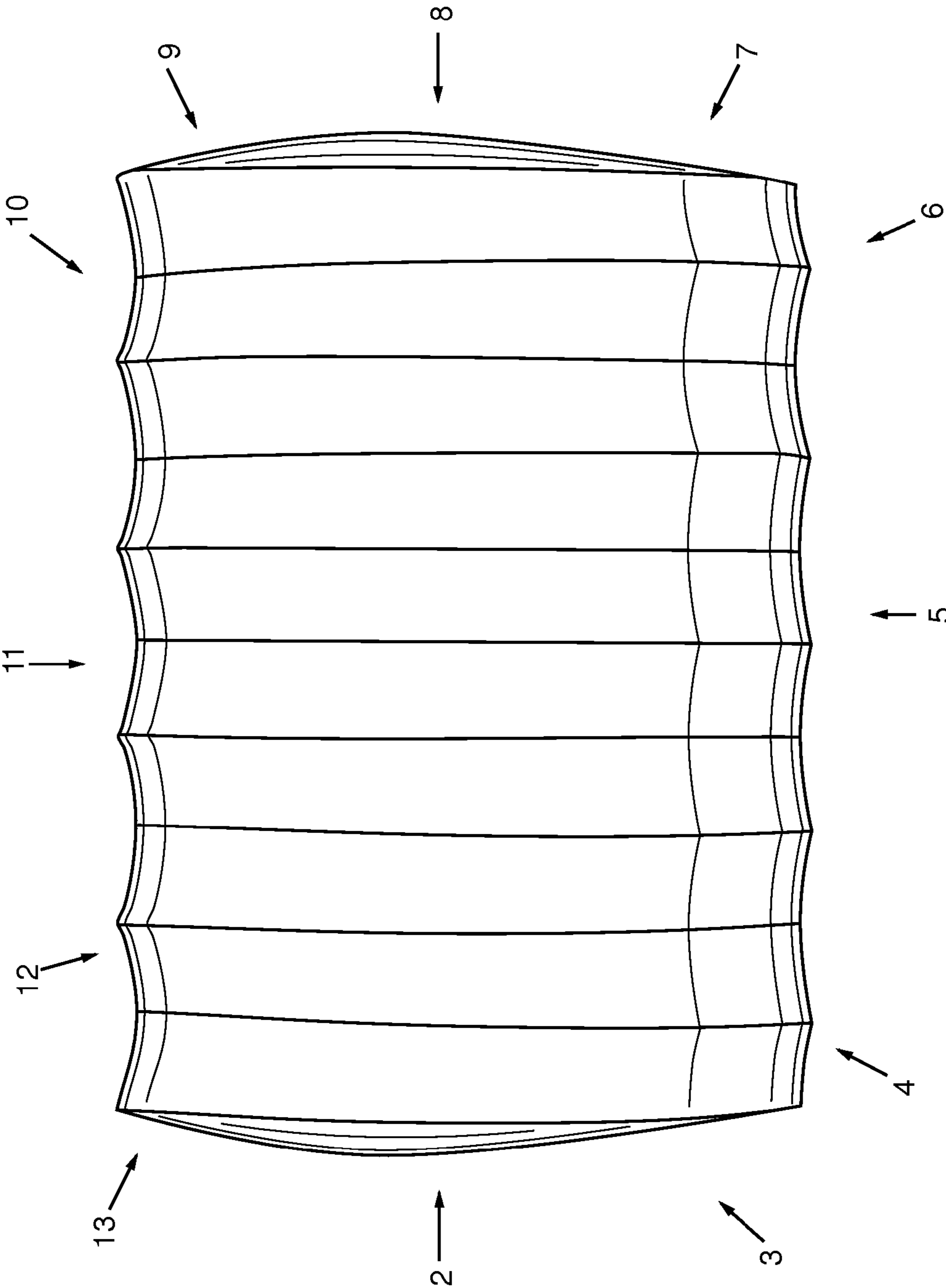

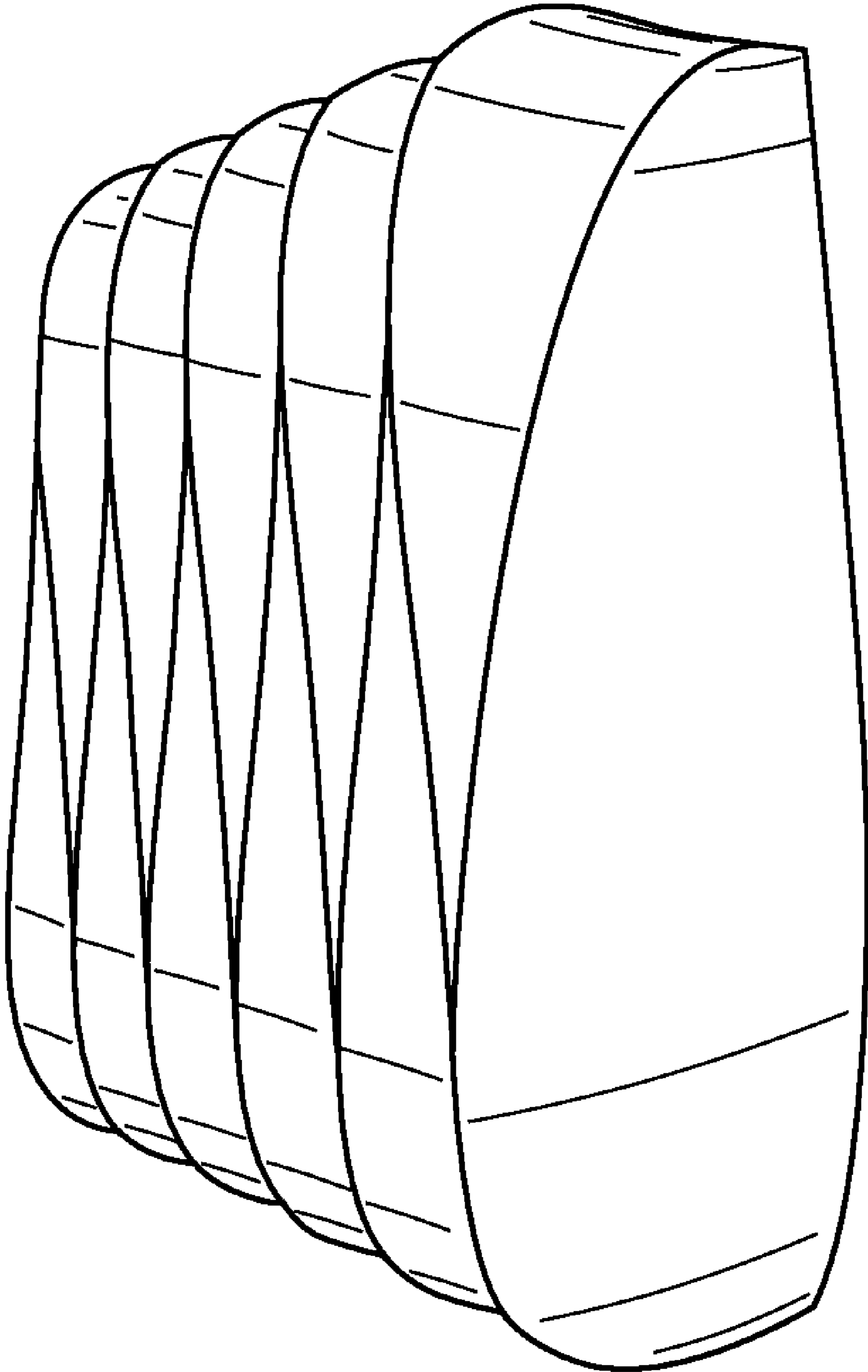
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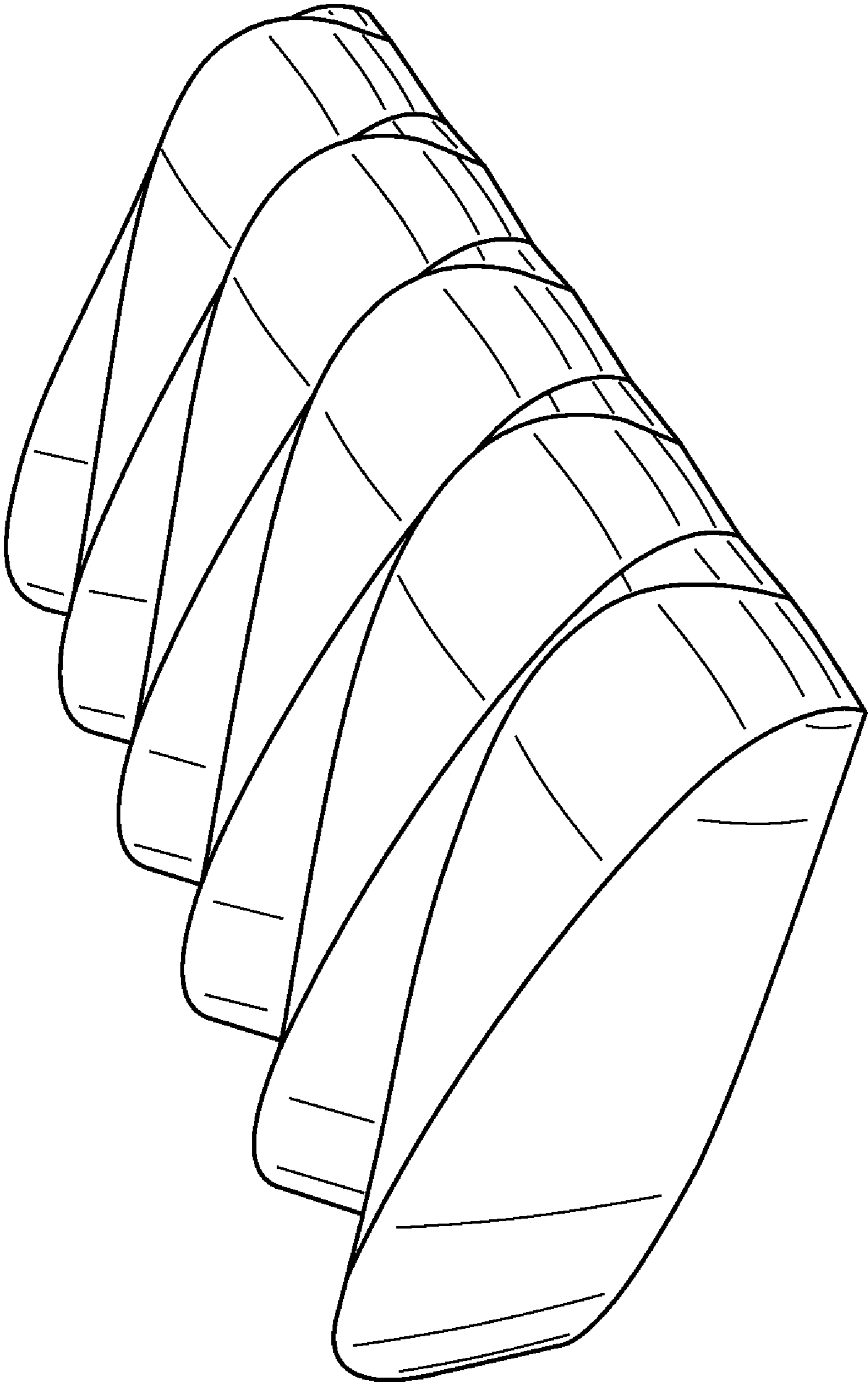

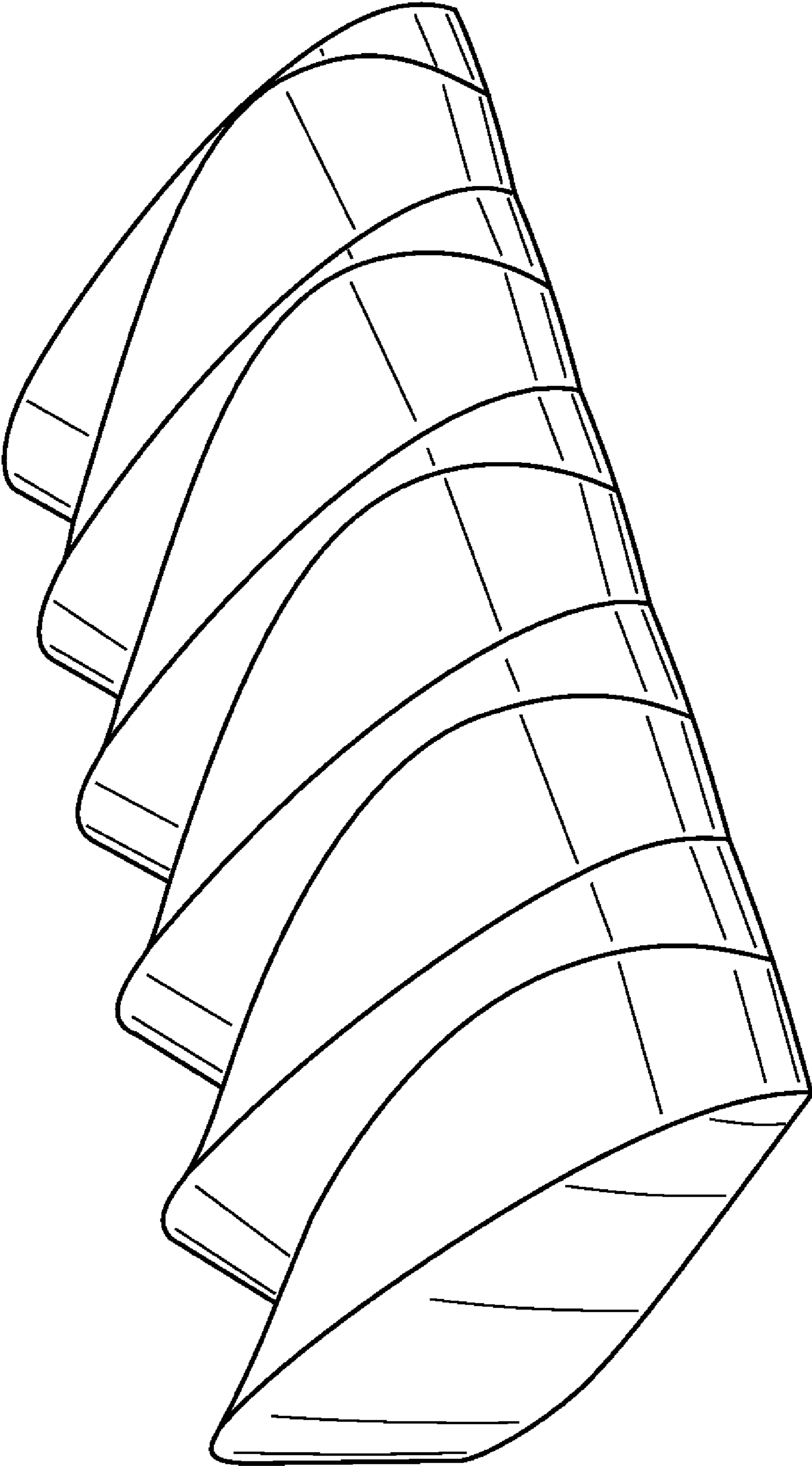

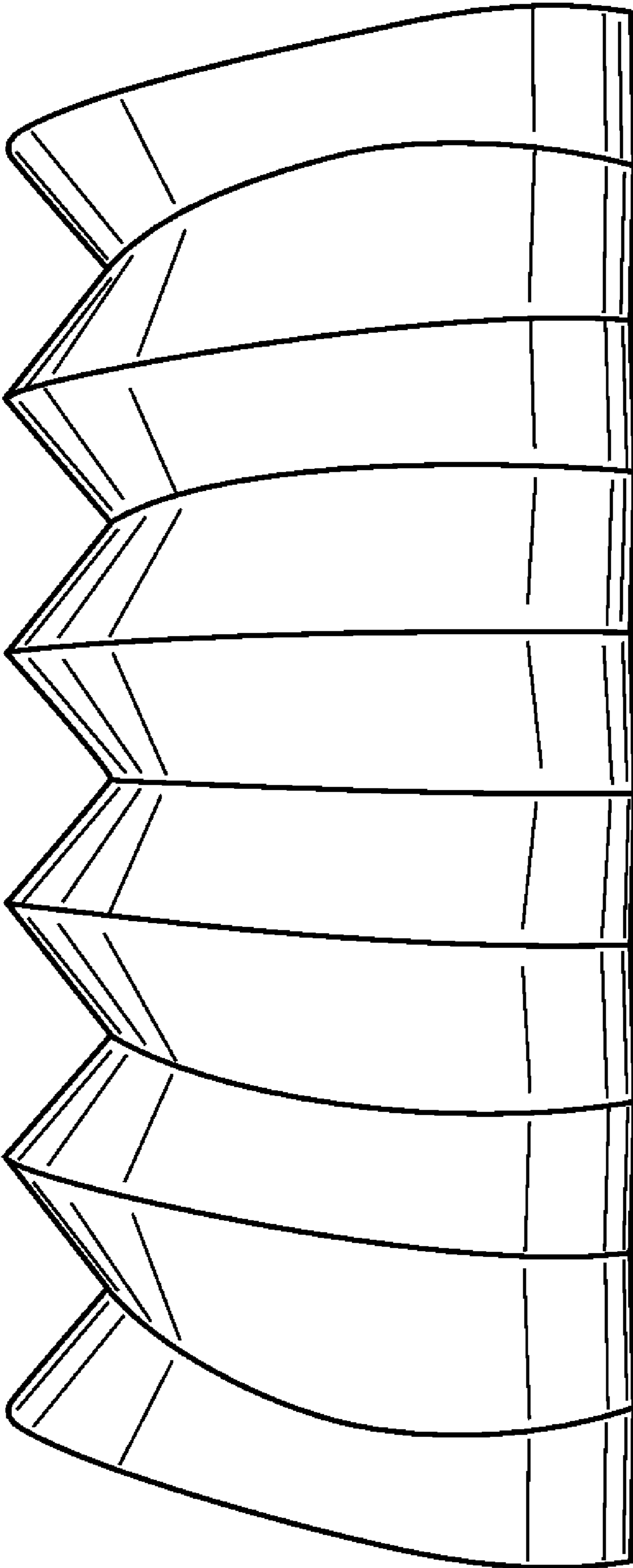

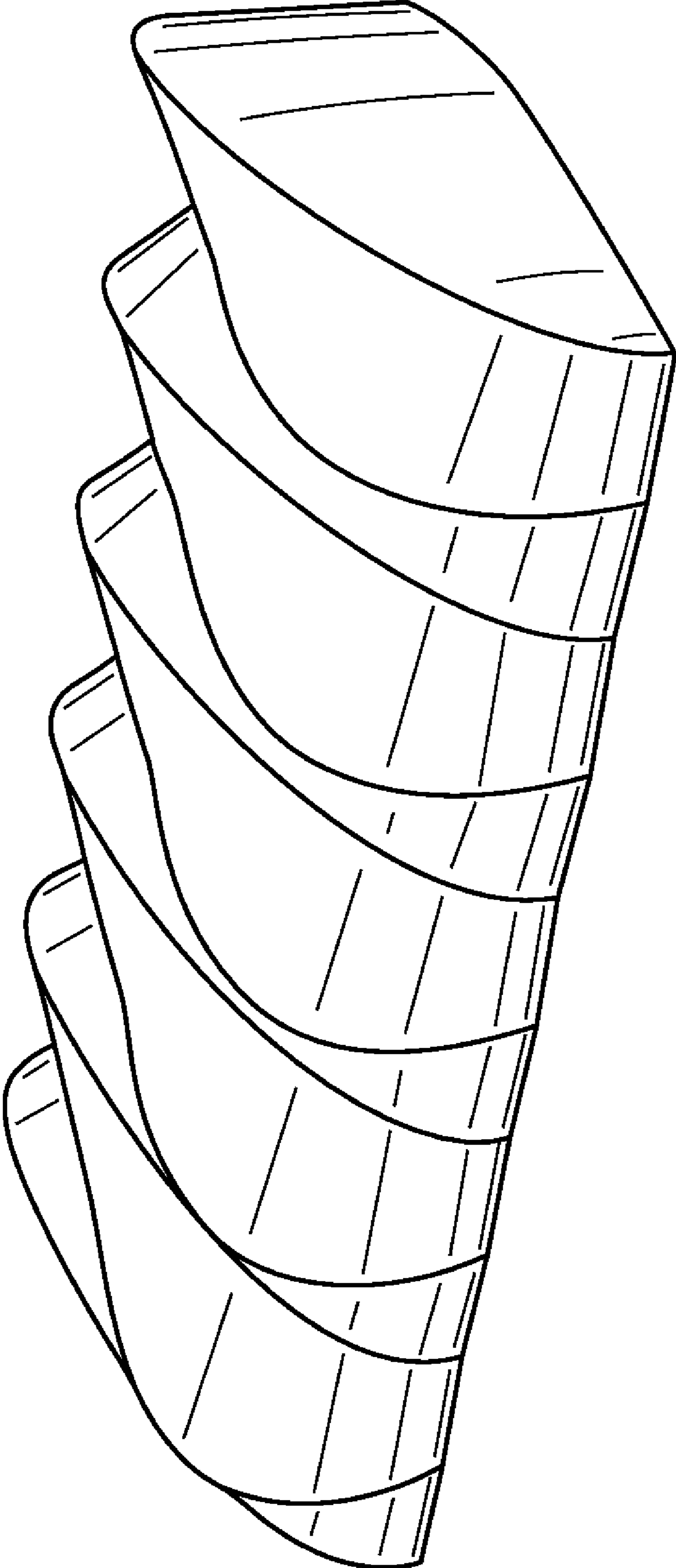

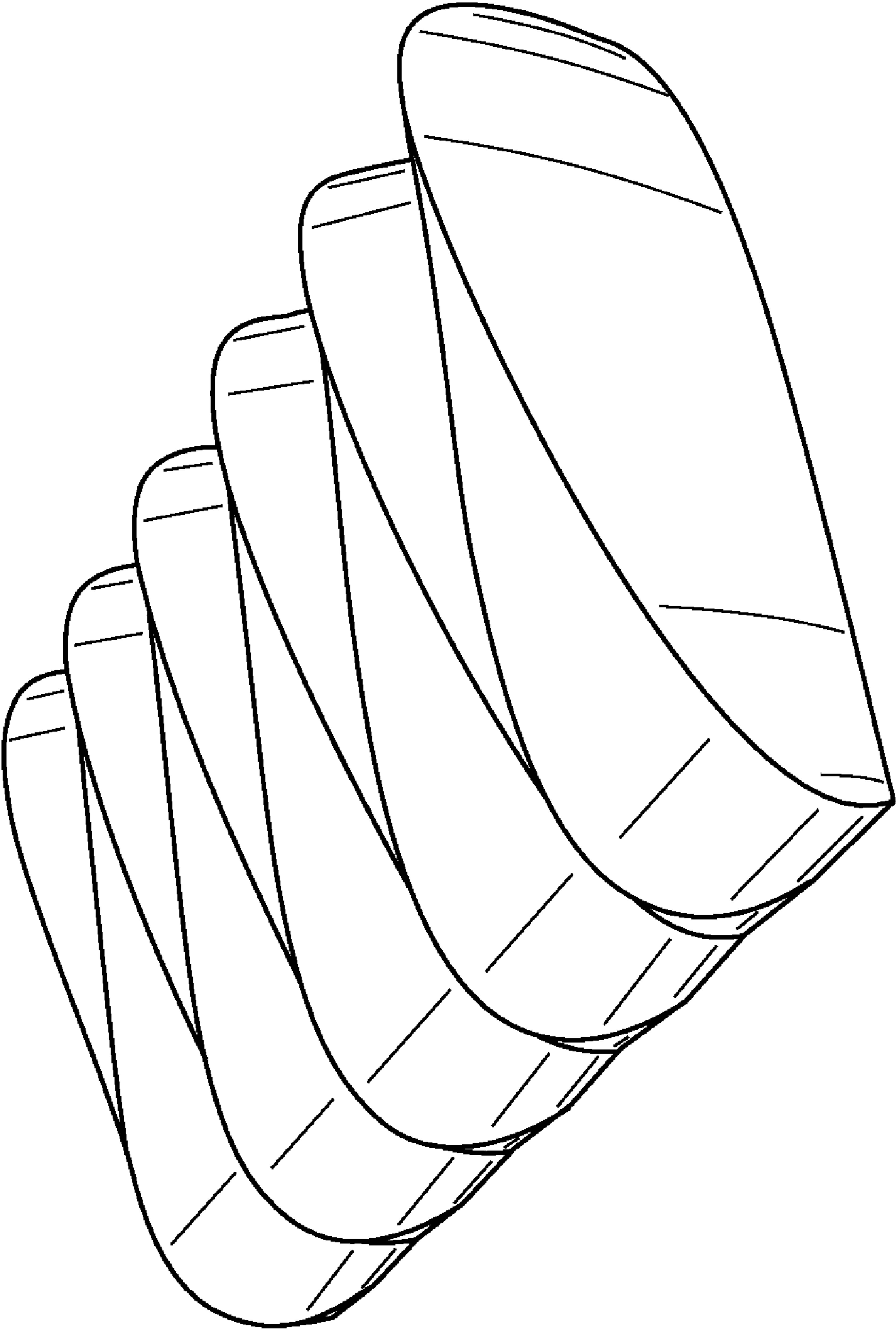

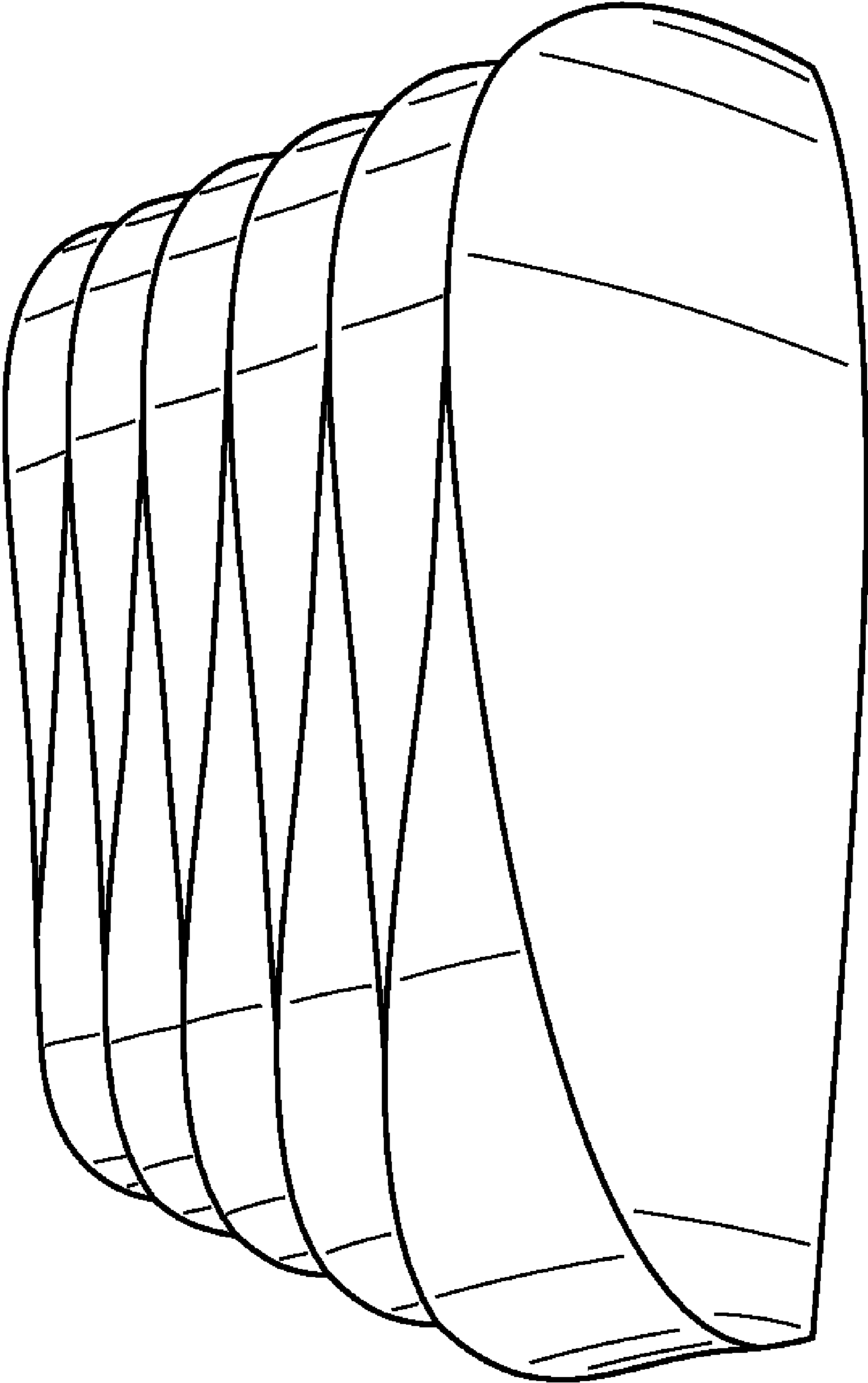

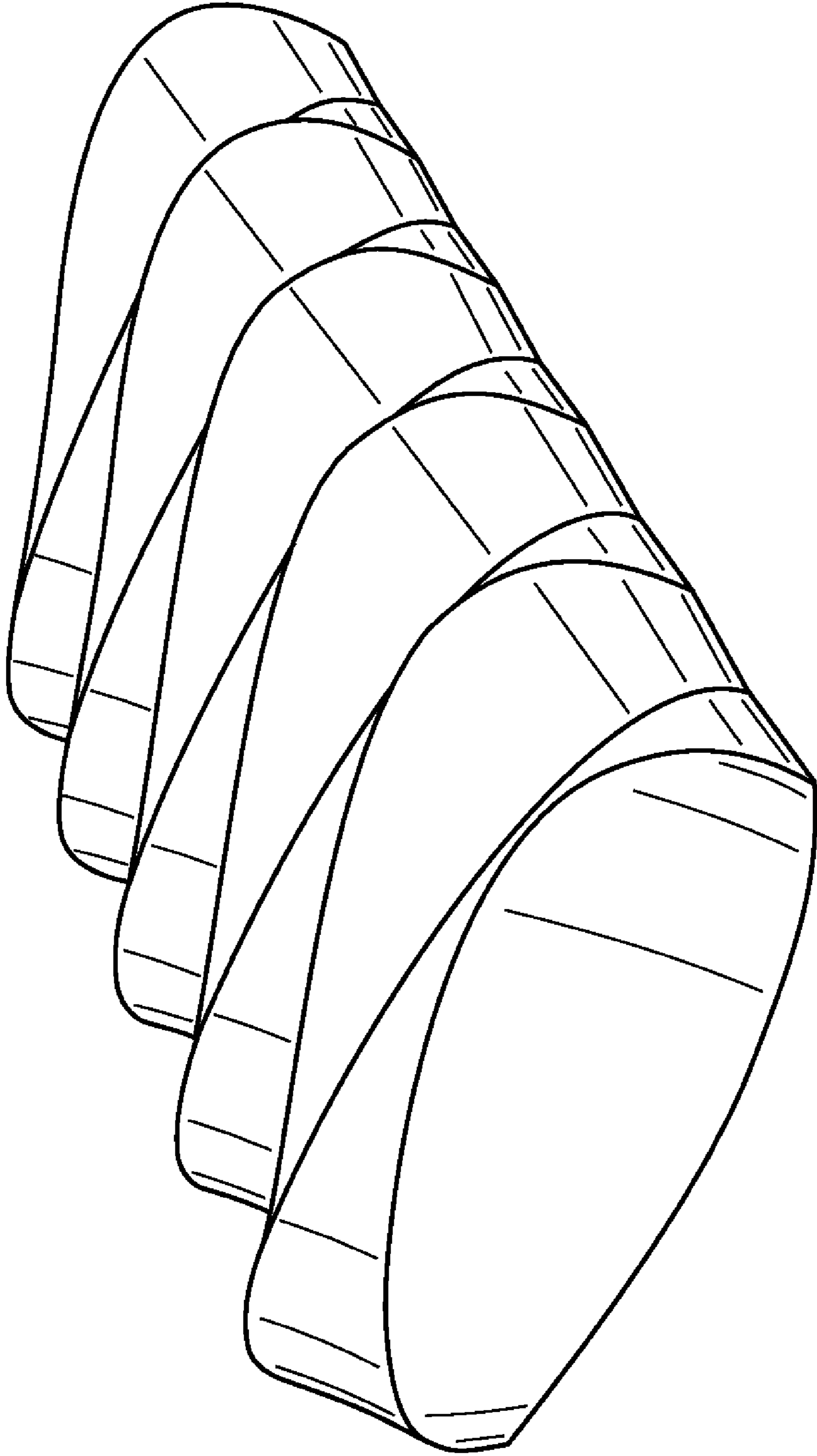




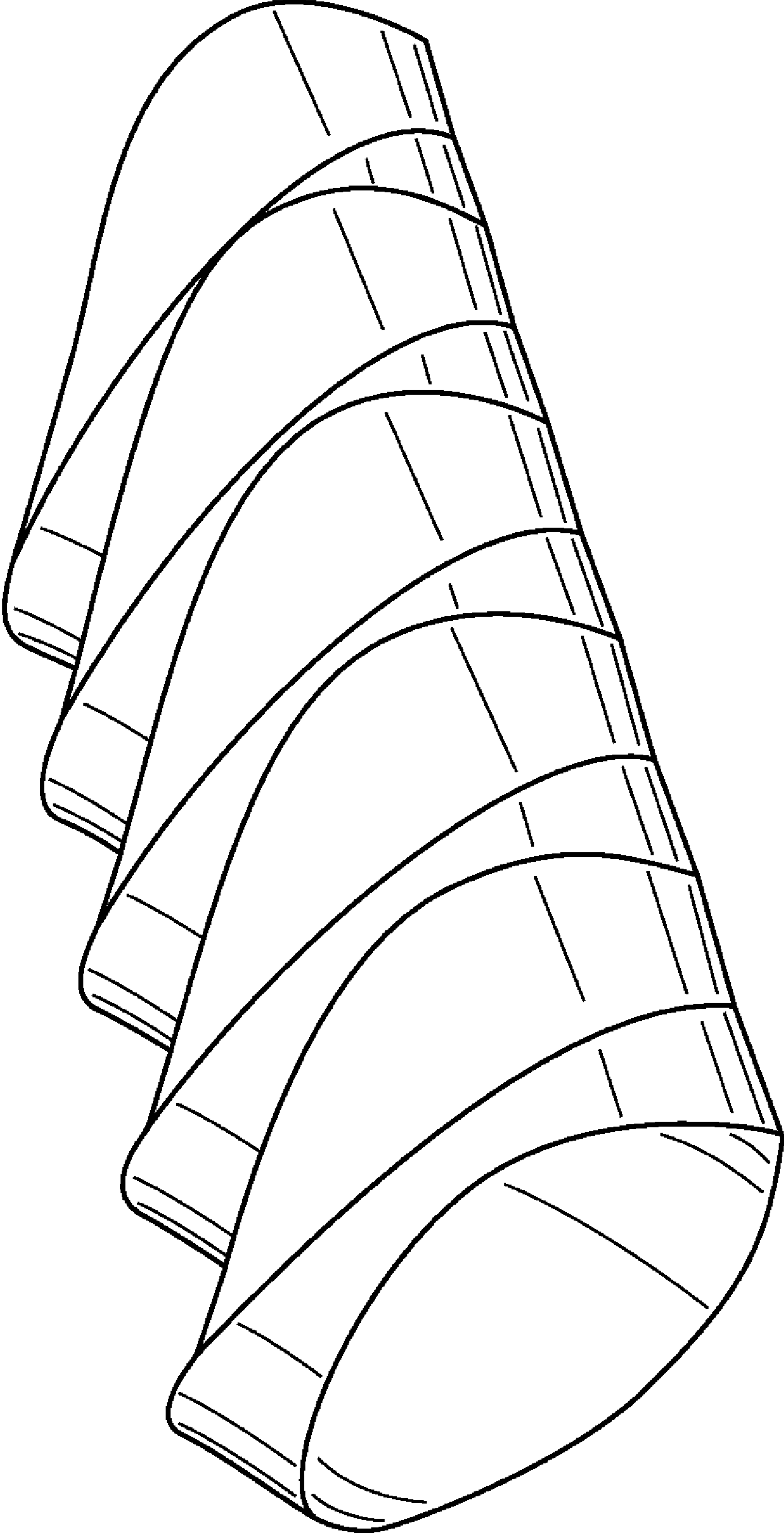

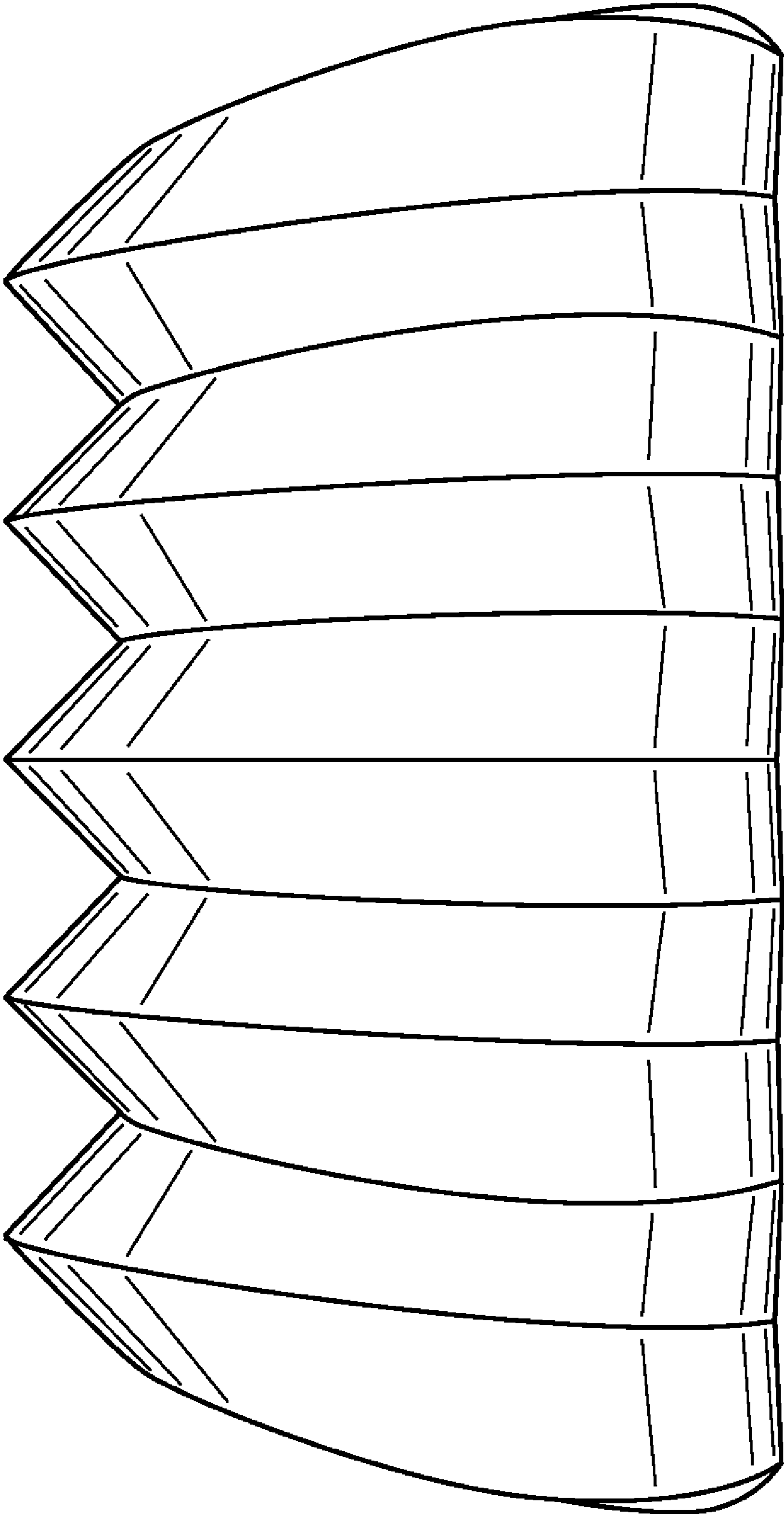

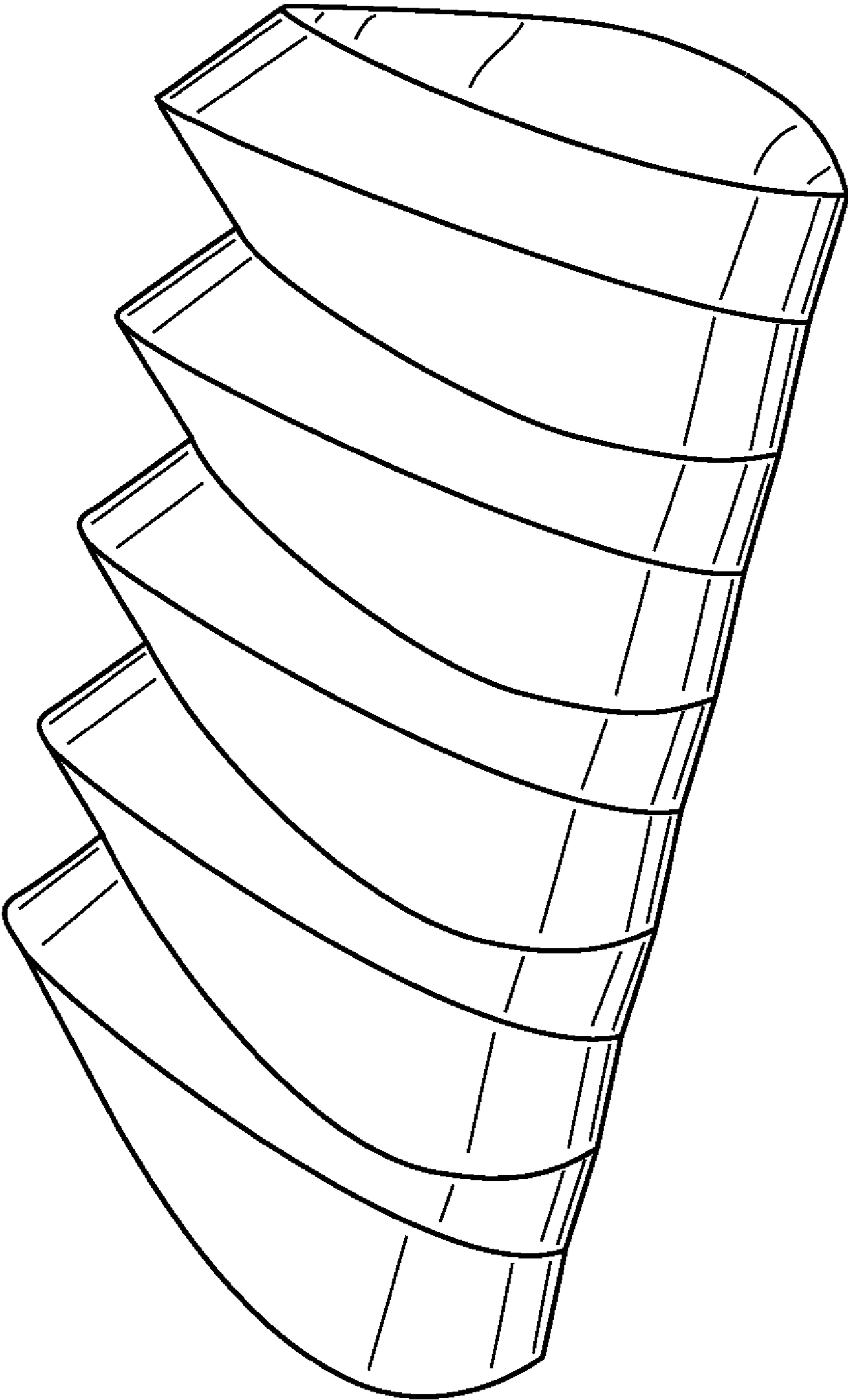

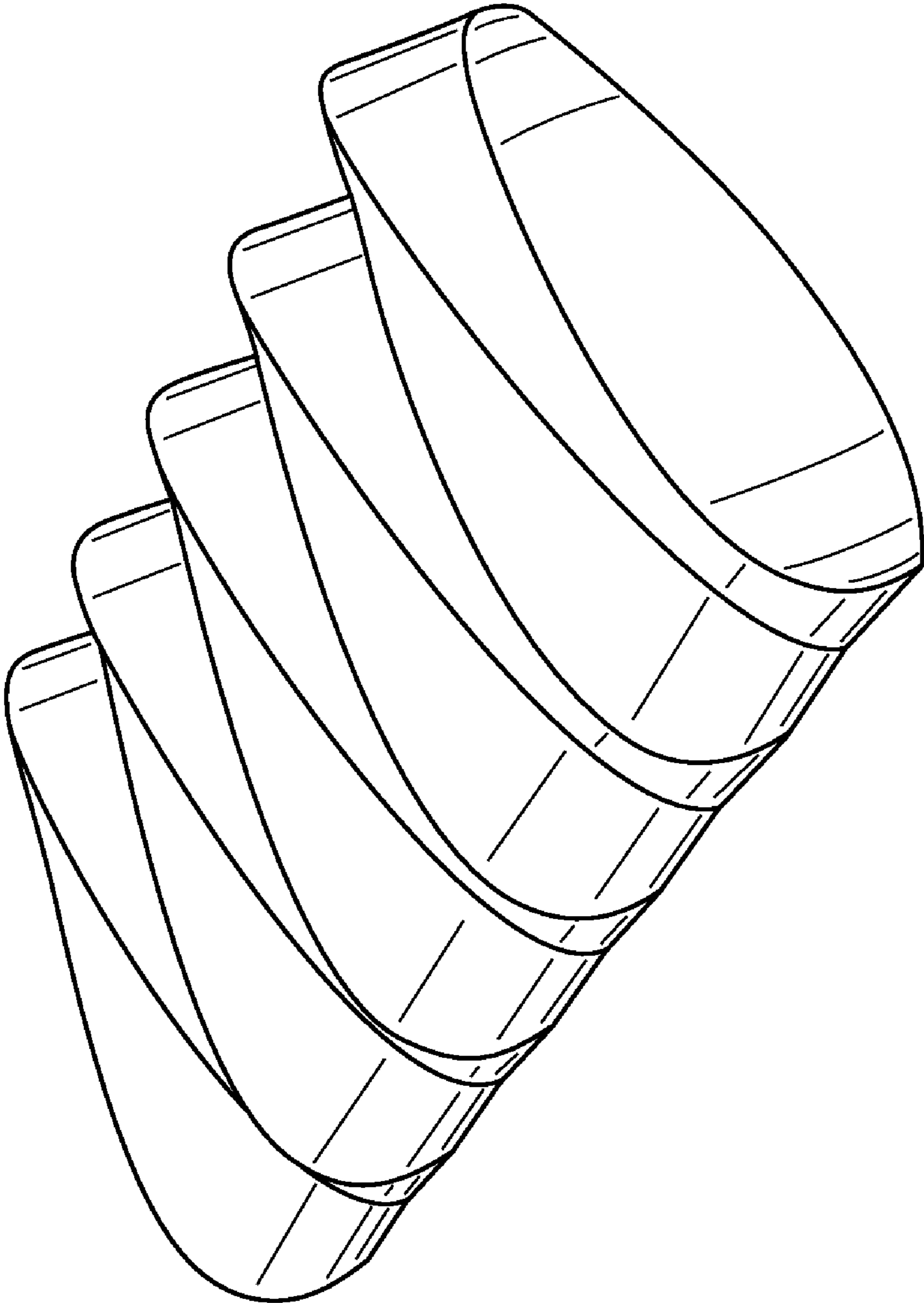

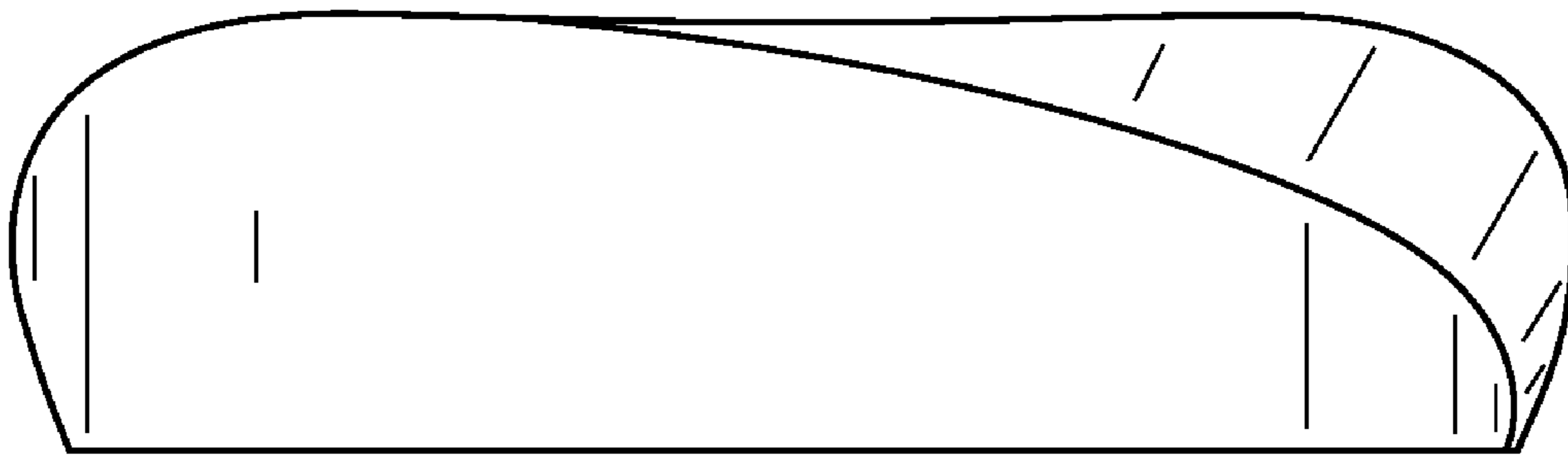

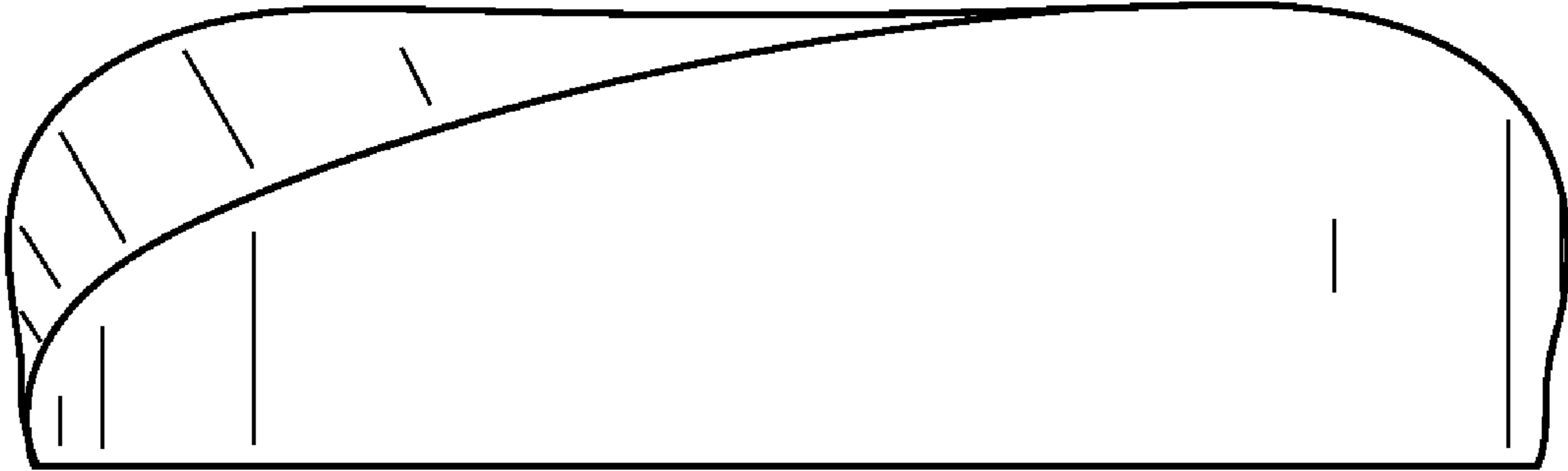

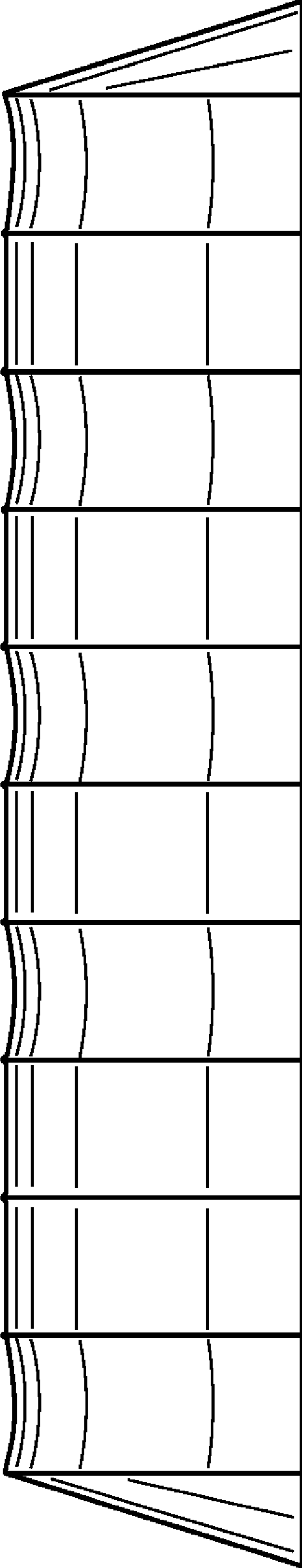


***Fig. 14***

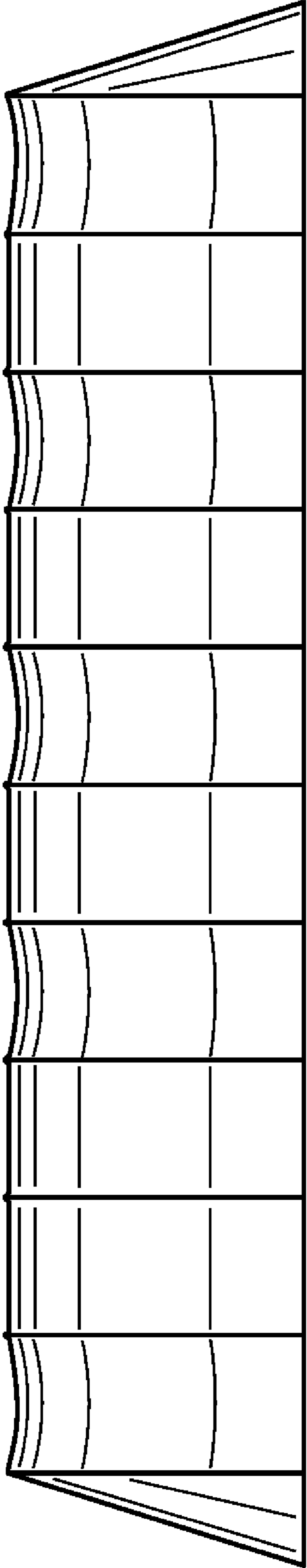




***Fig. 15***


