FIG. 2 is a first side-view of the screwdriver;

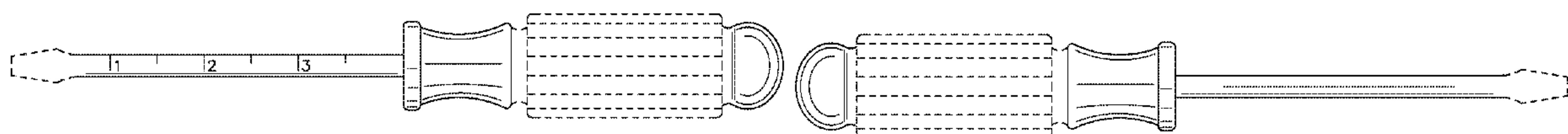
FIG. 3 is a second side-view of the screwdriver;

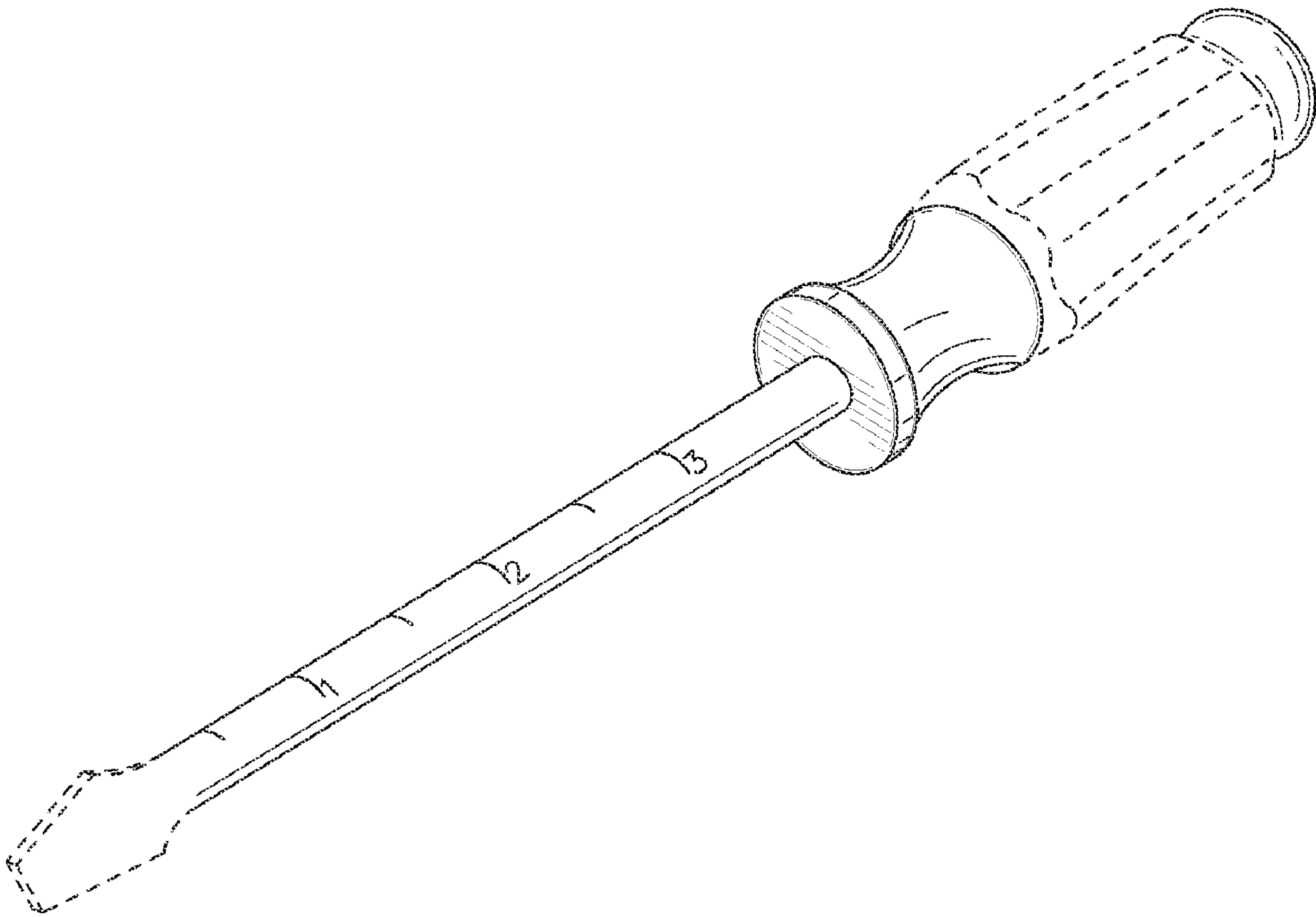

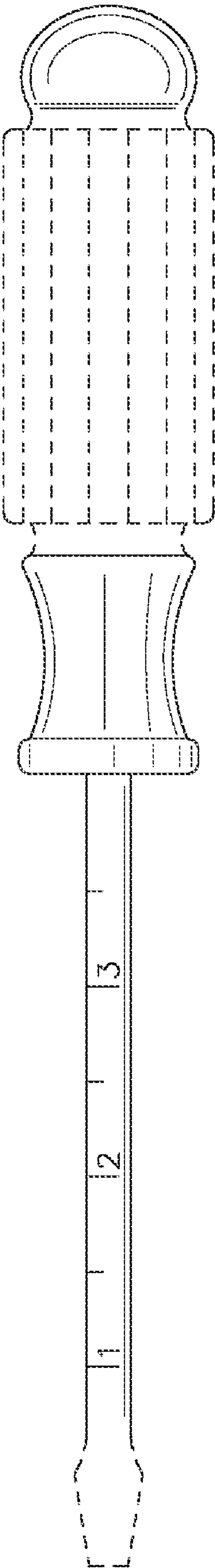

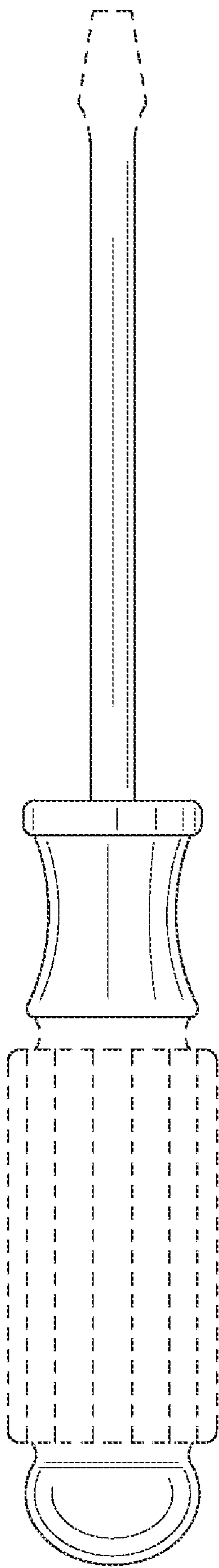

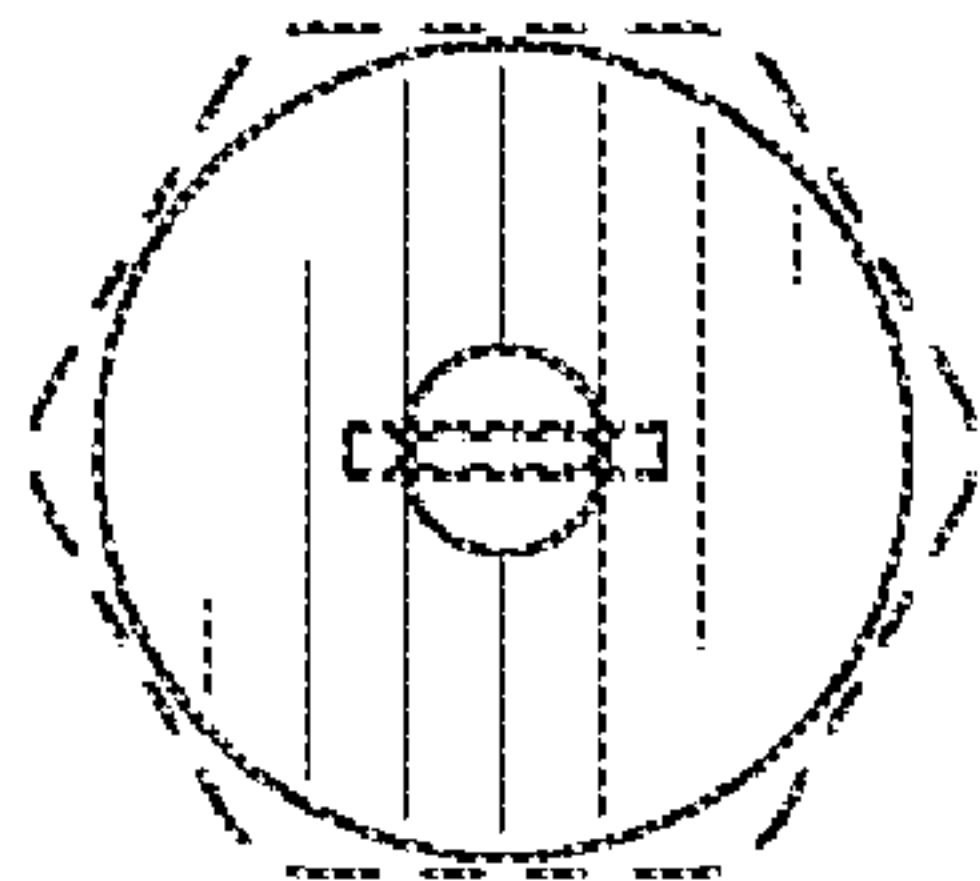
