FIG. 15 is a perspective view thereof with an eighth variant of the broken lines; and,

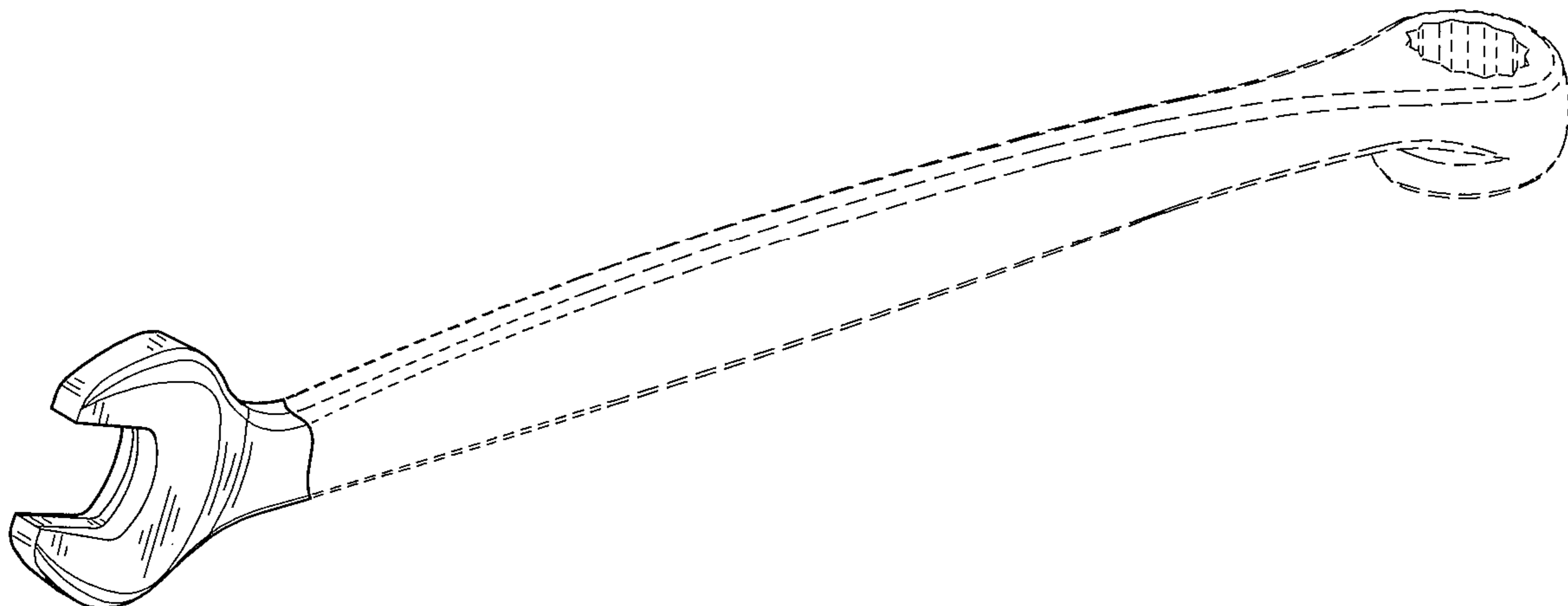
FIG. 16 is a perspective view thereof with a ninth variant of the broken lines.

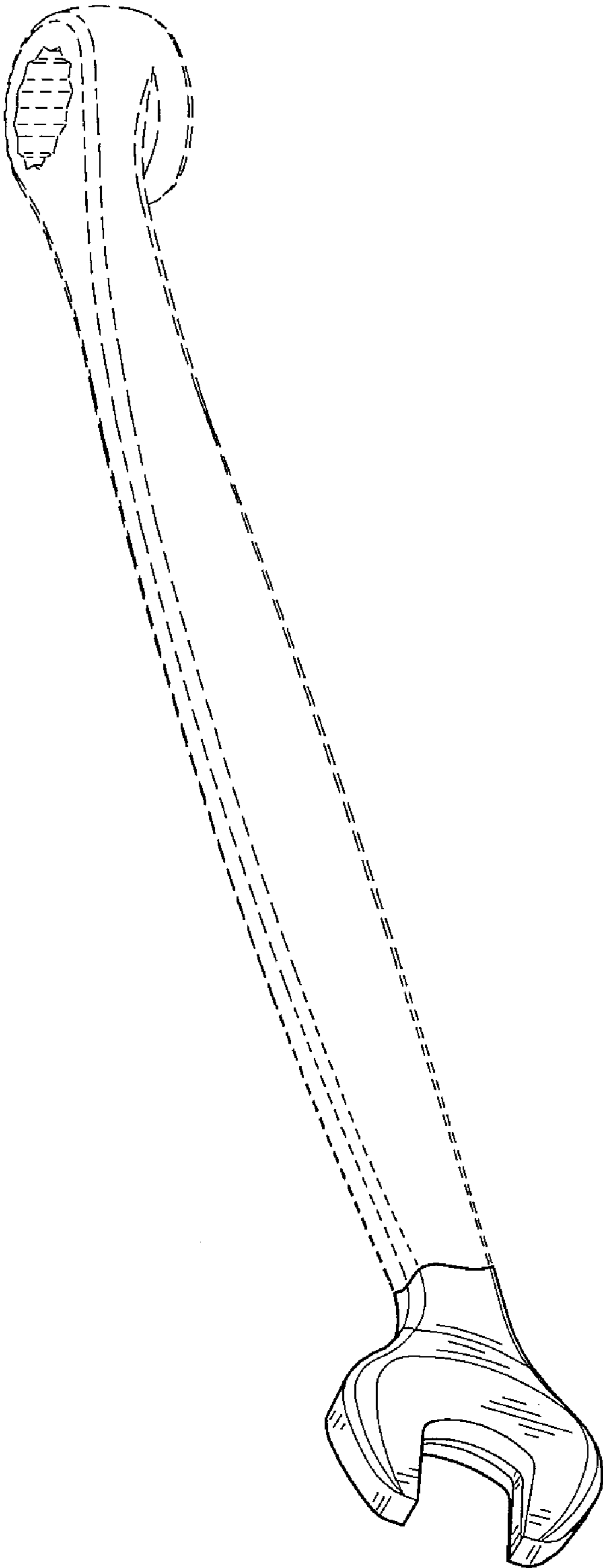

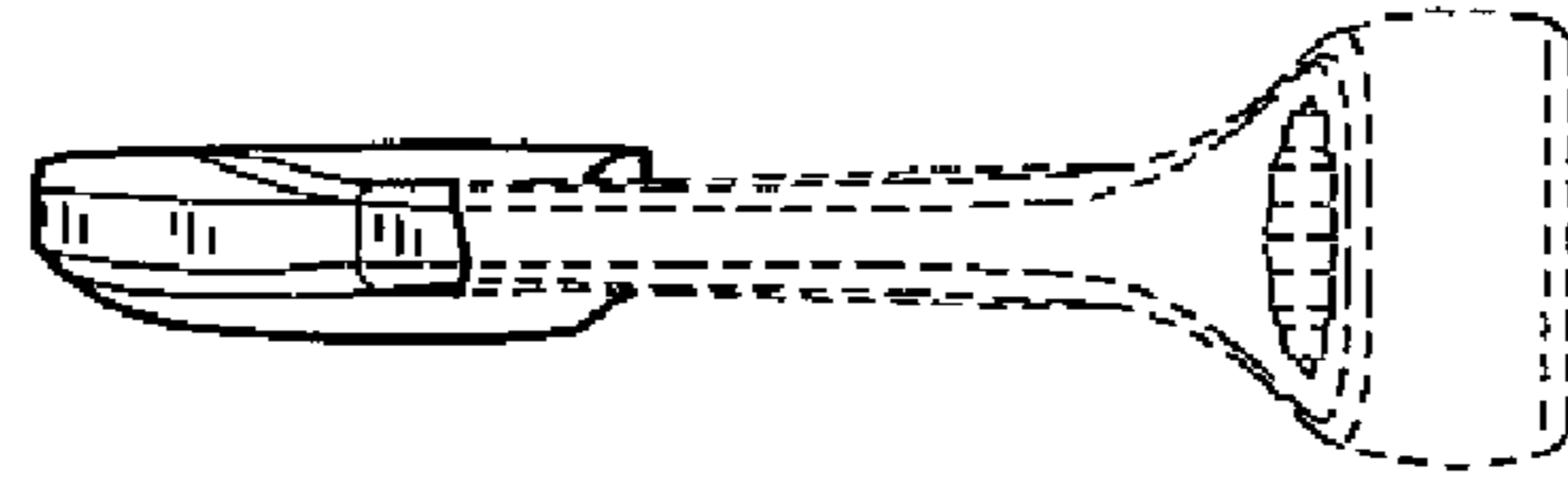

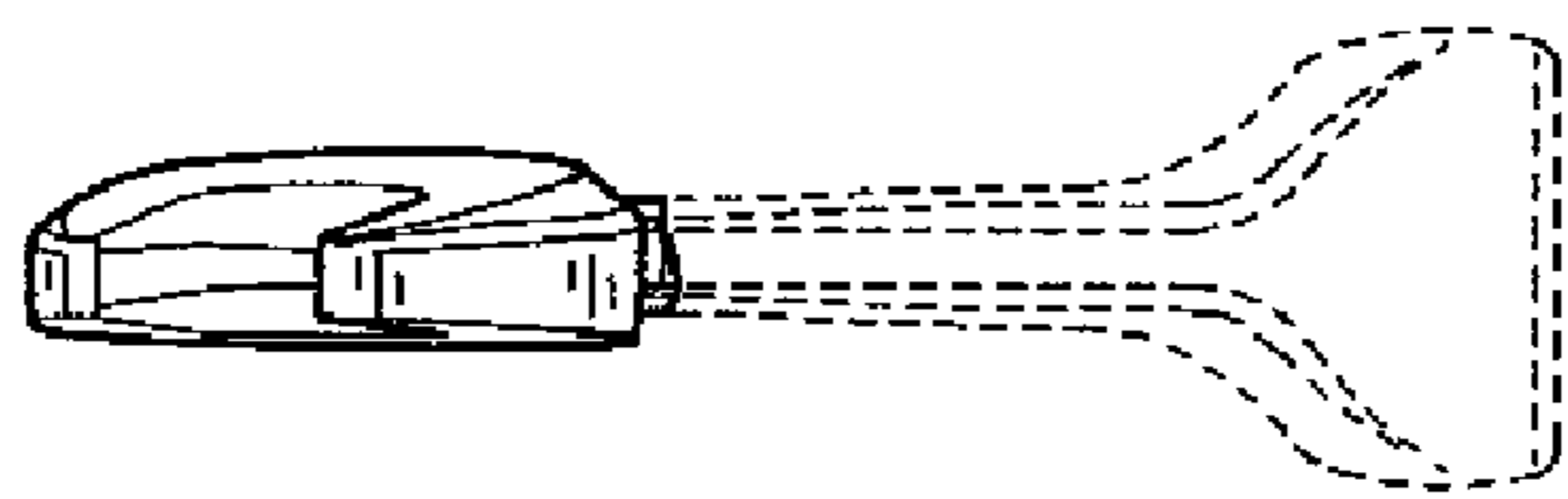

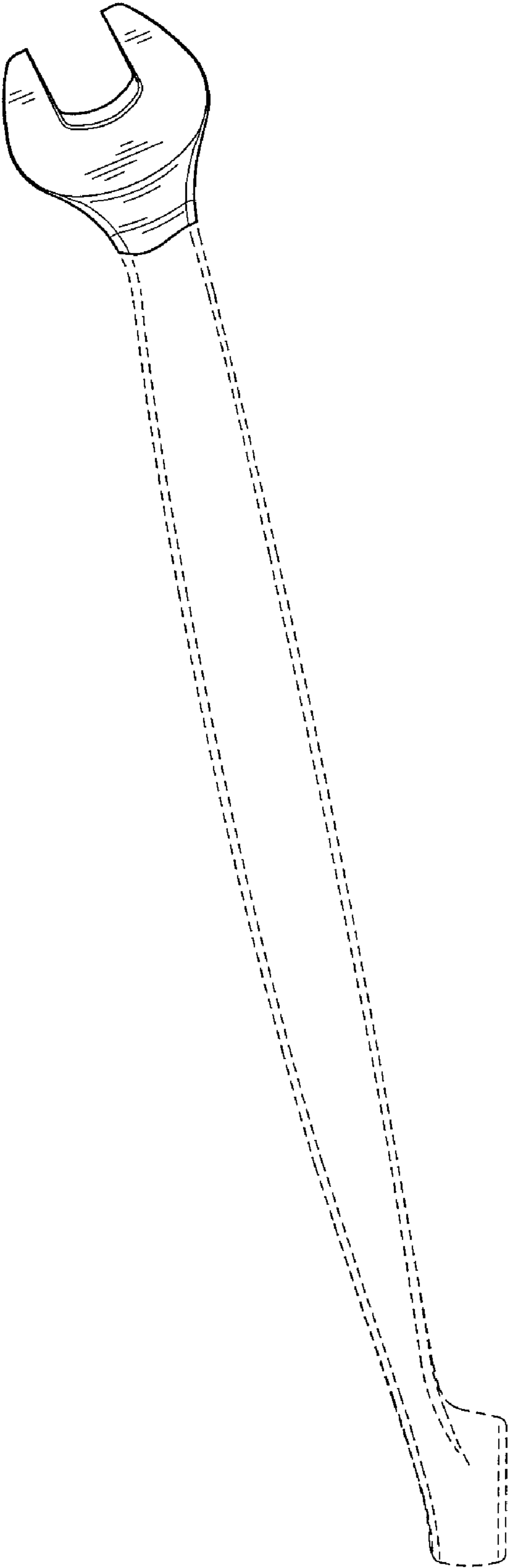

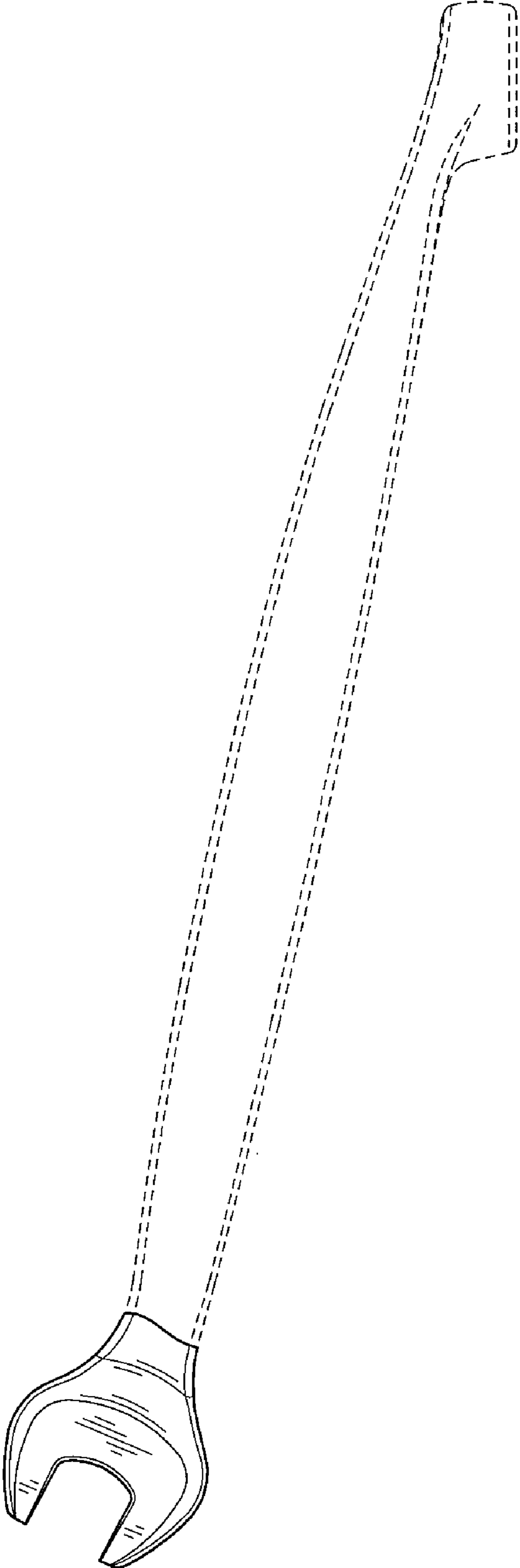

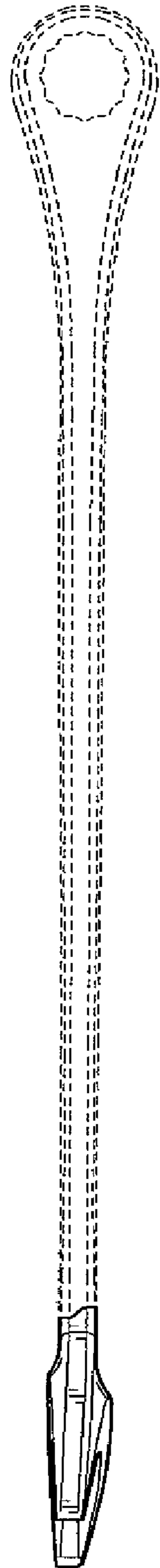

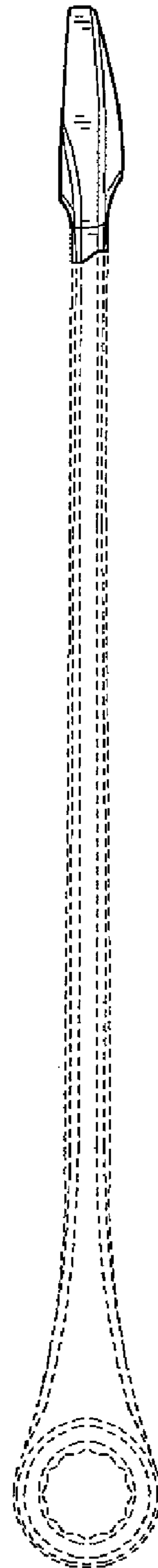

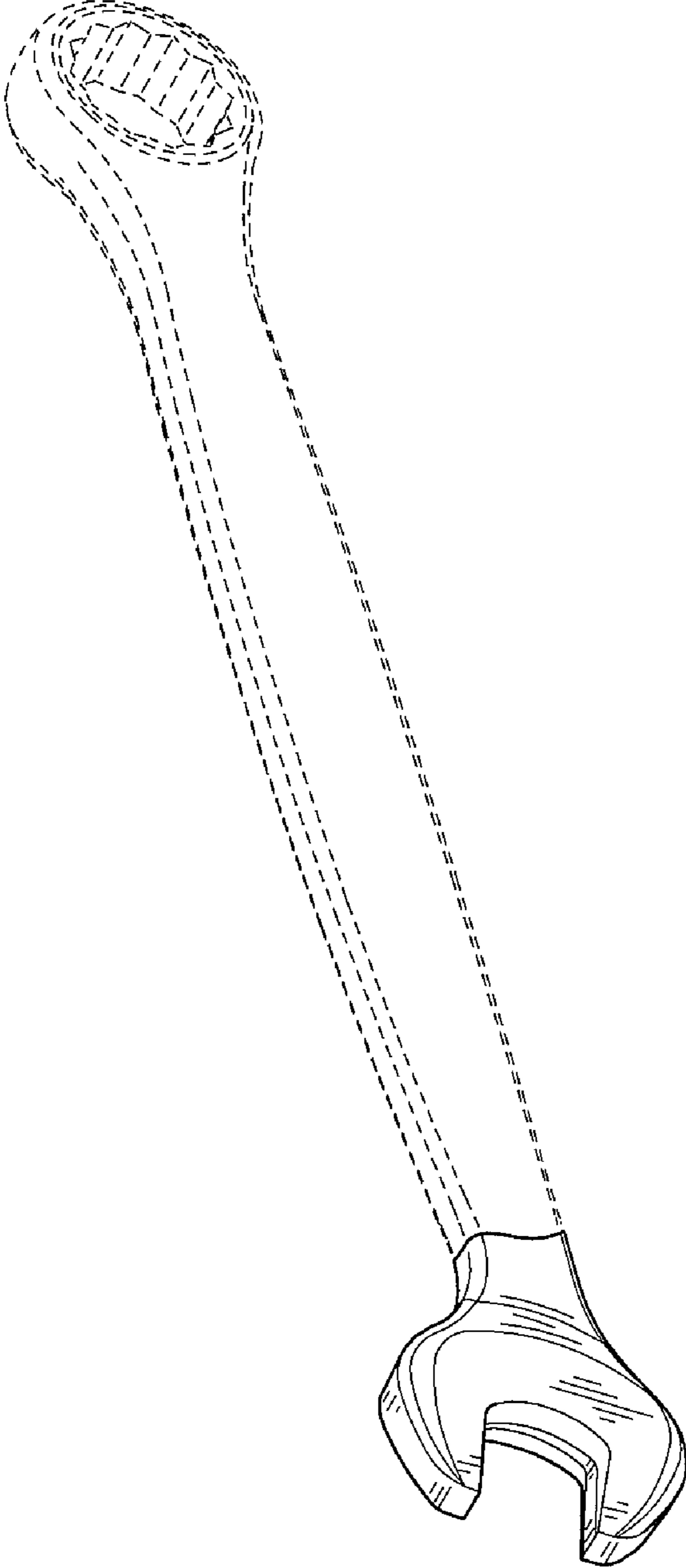

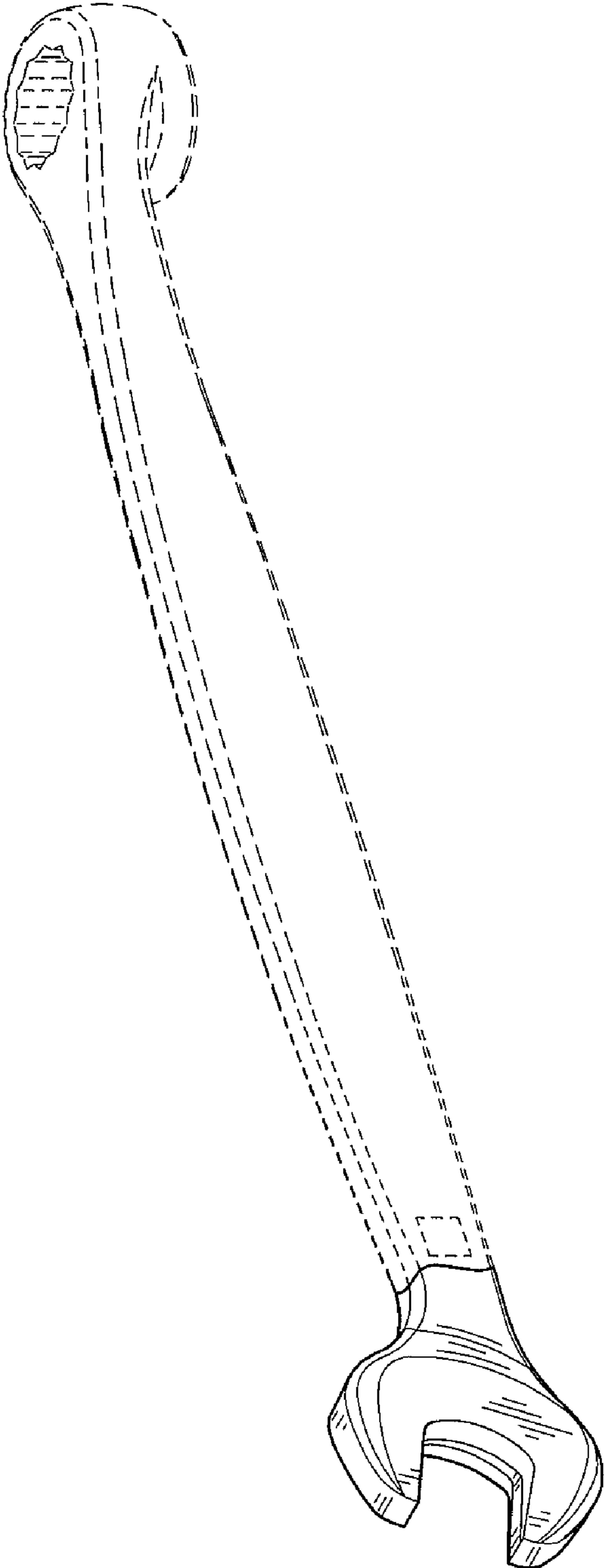

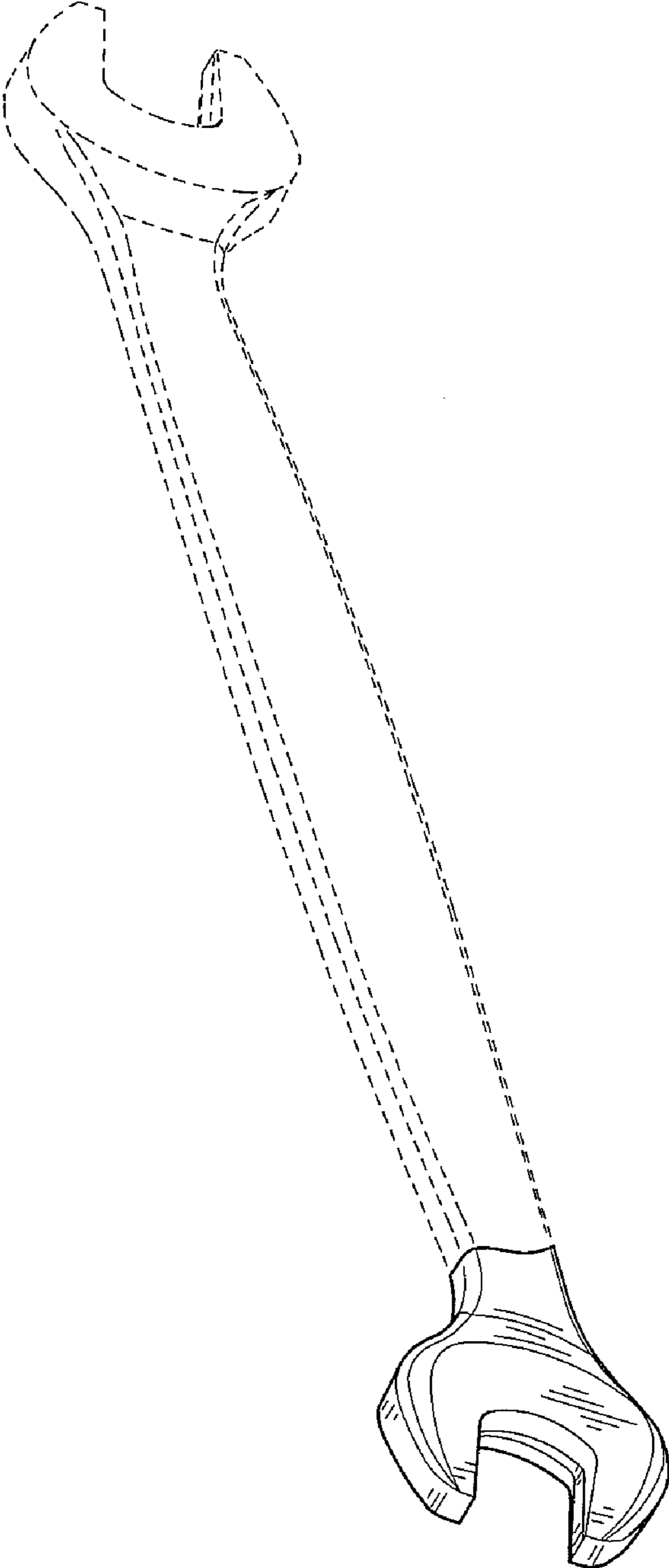

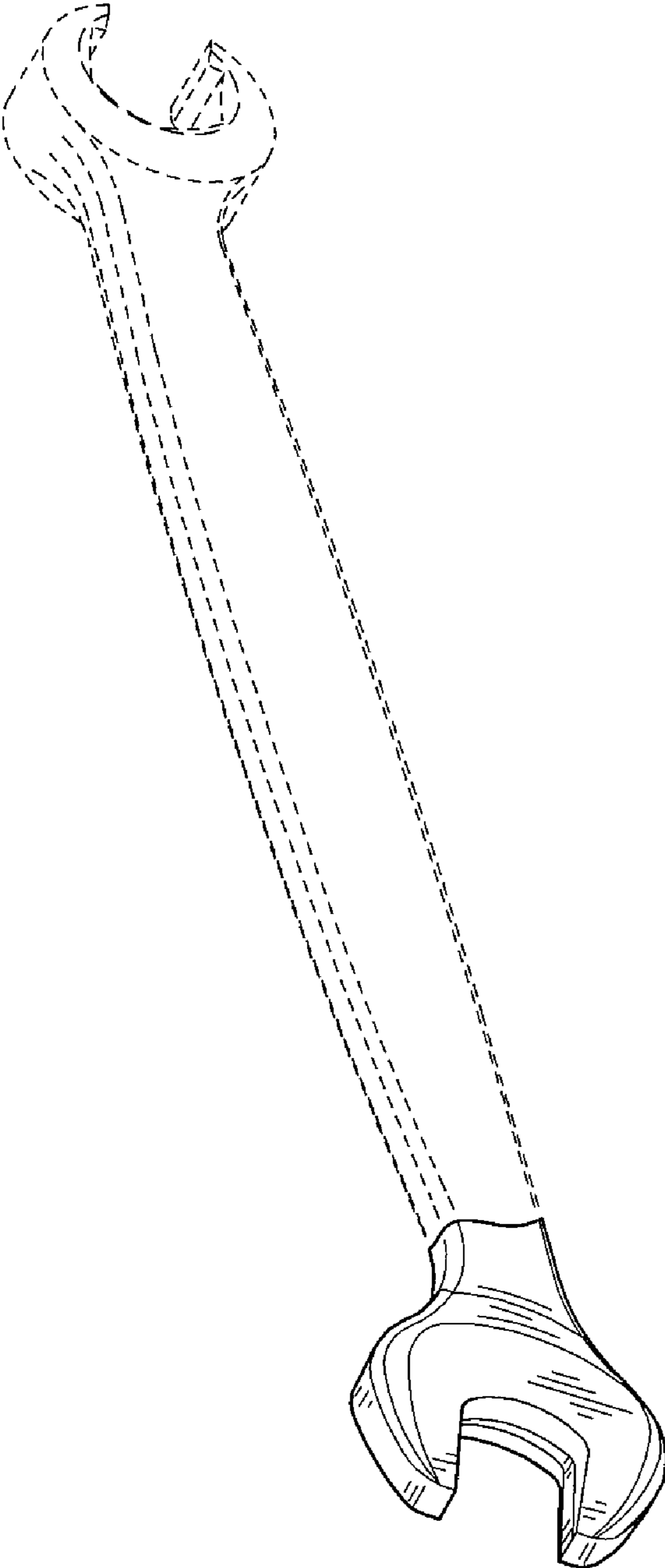

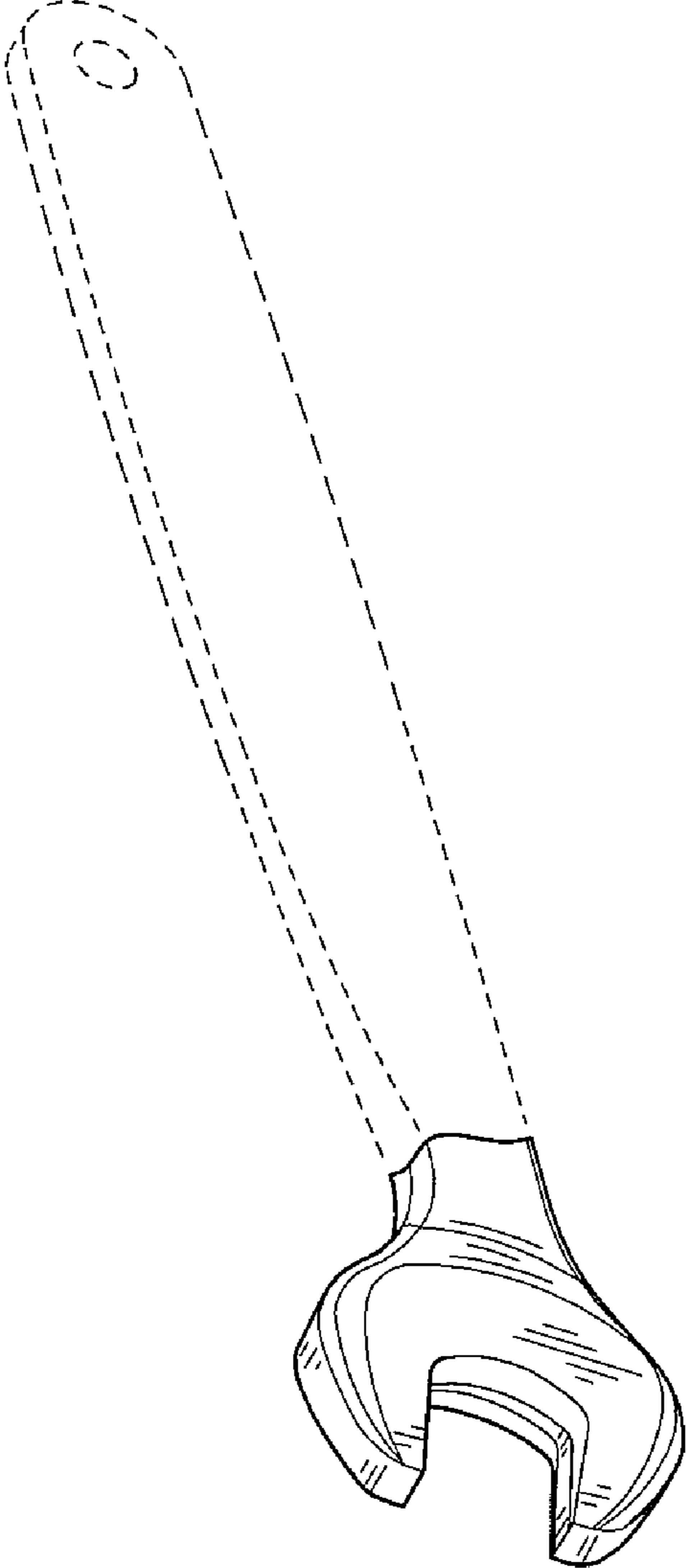

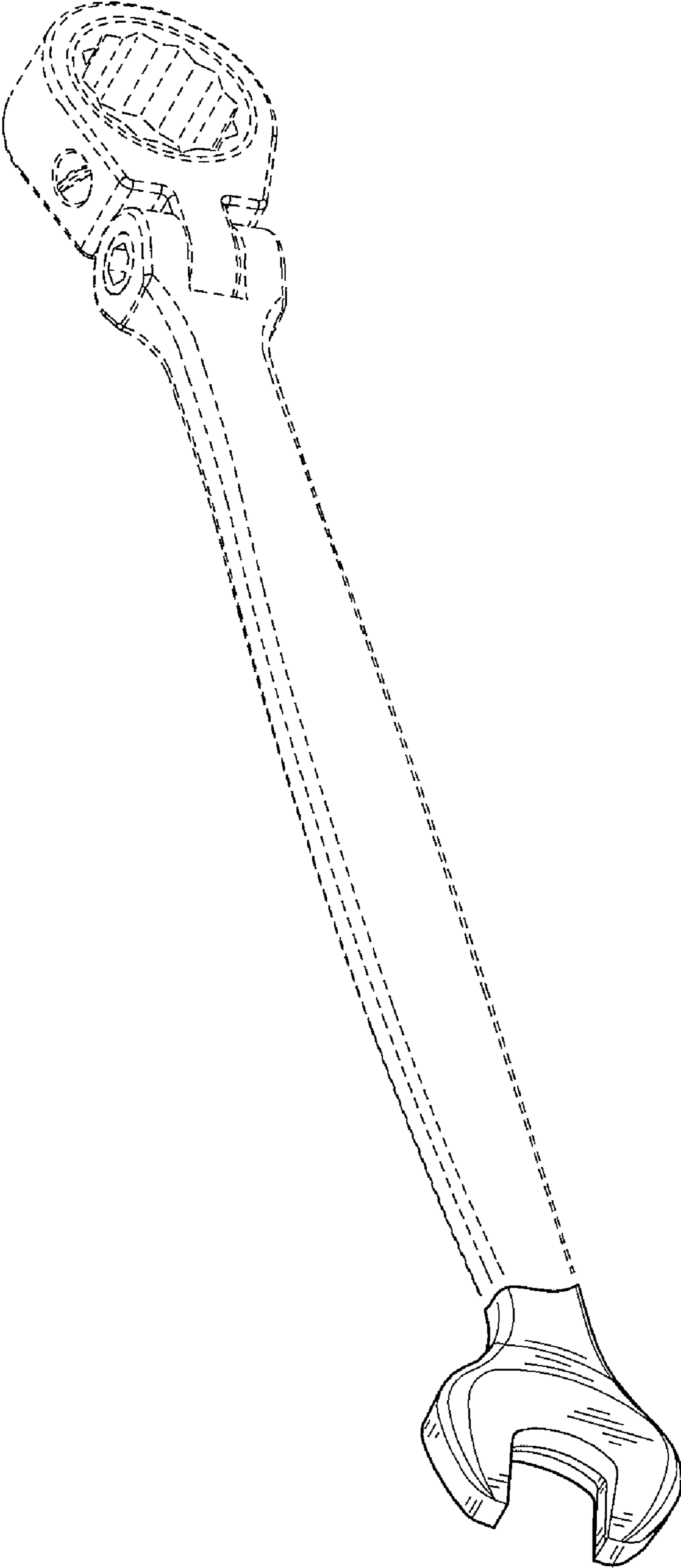

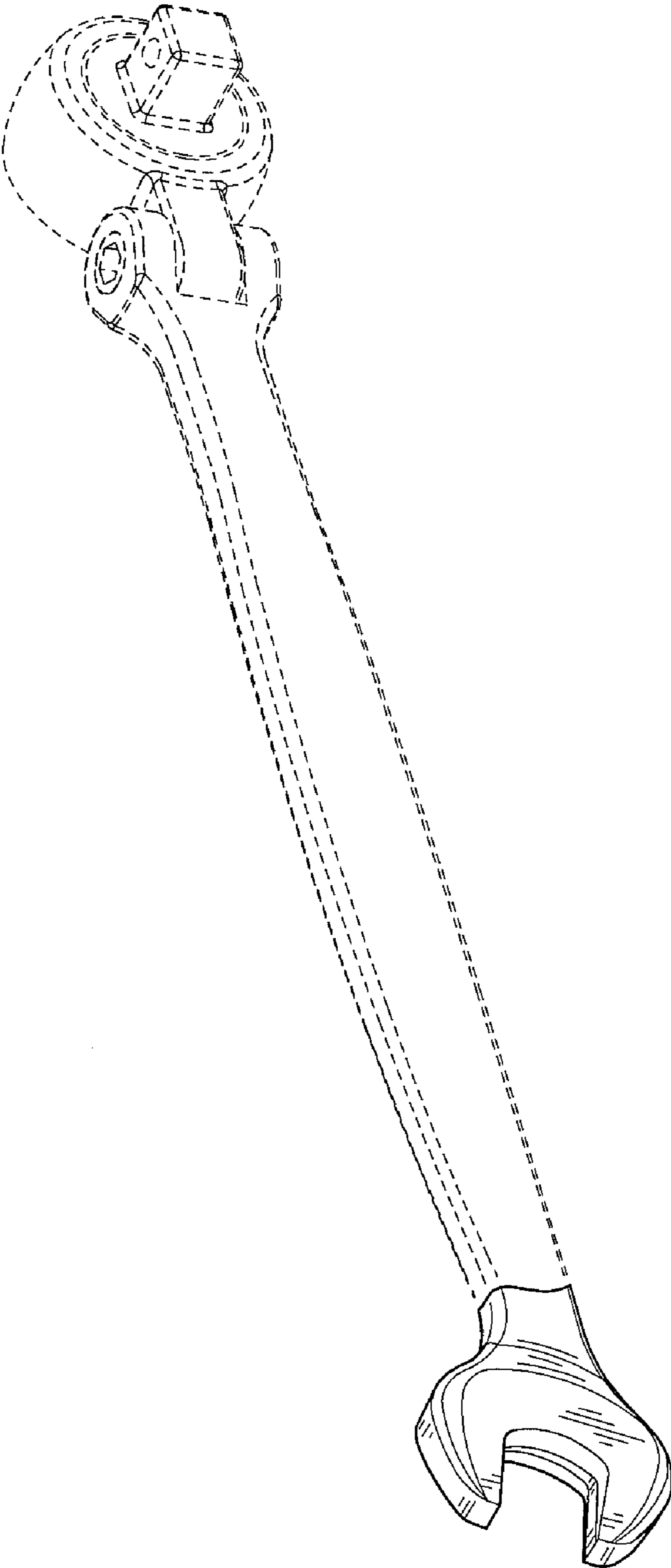

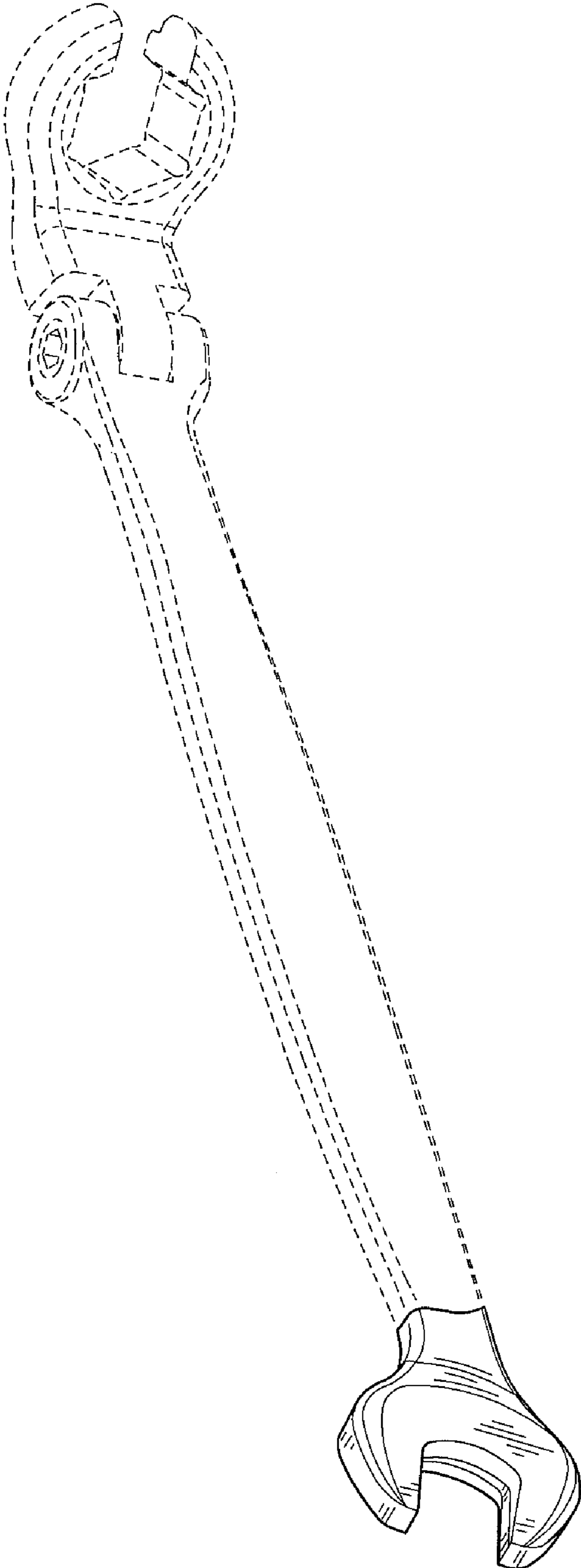

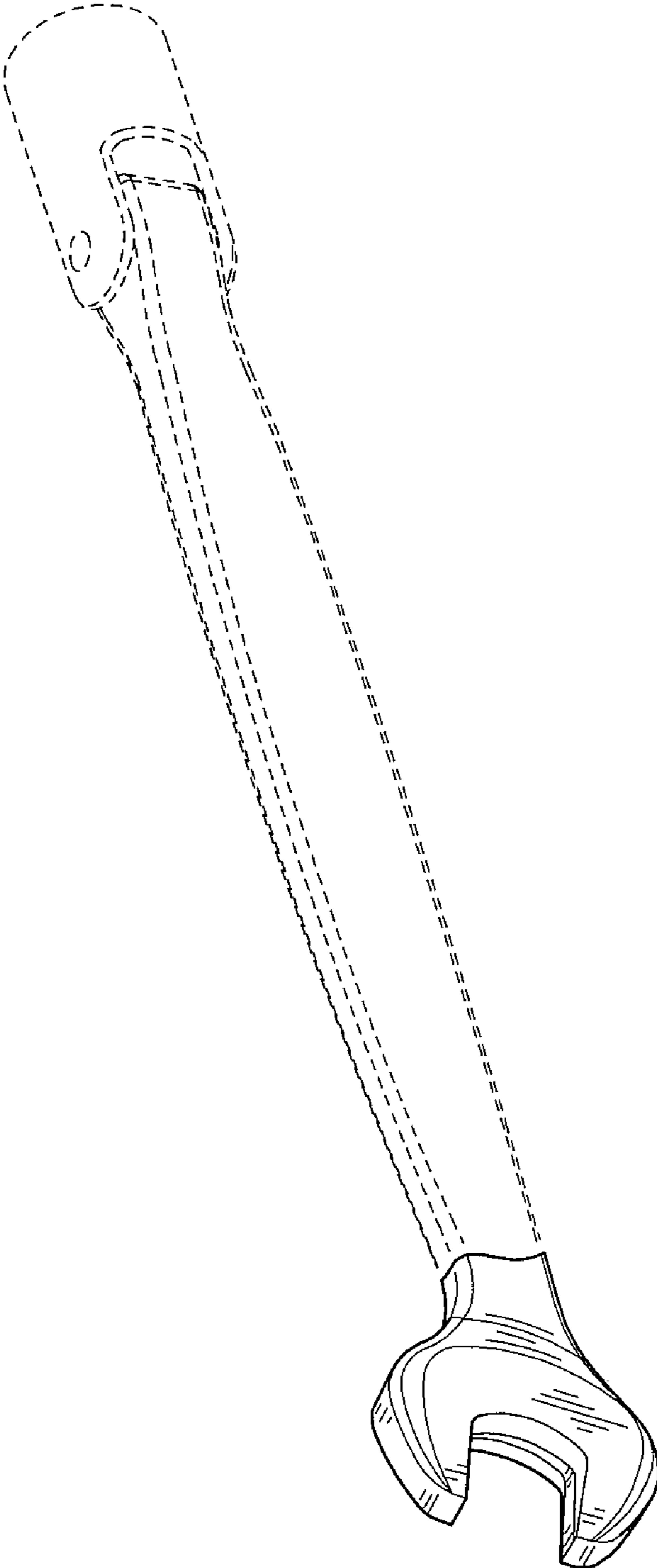
