(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a food inhaler, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 5 shows a bottom view of the design.

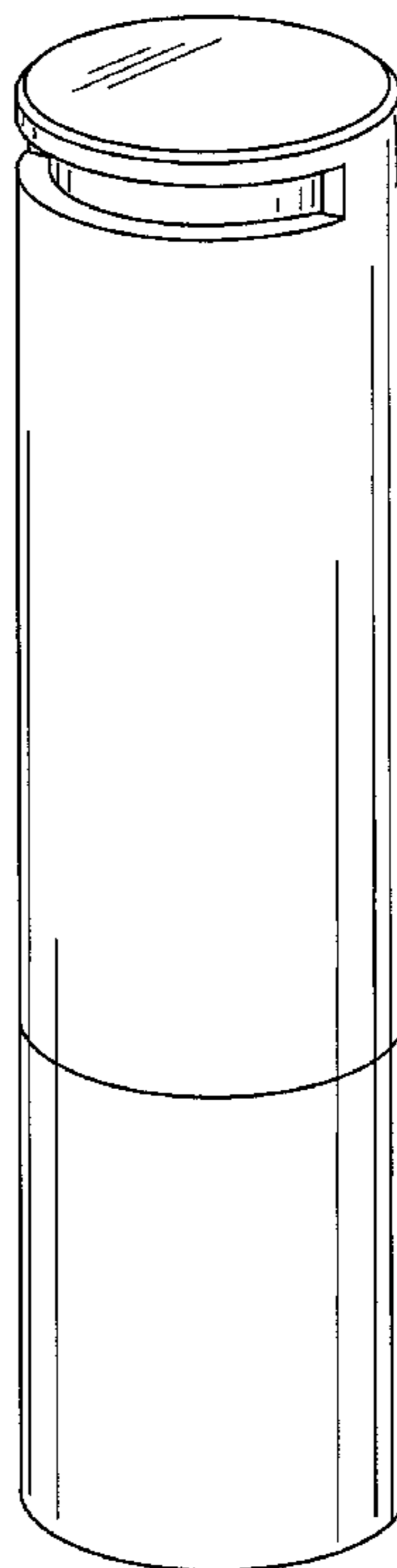
FIG. 6 shows a right side view of the design.

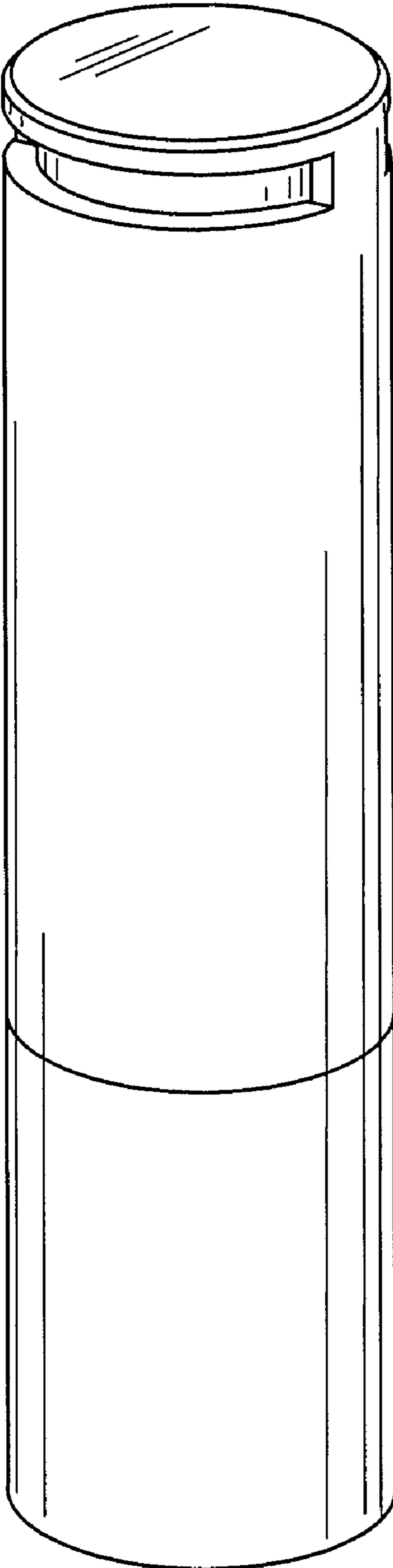

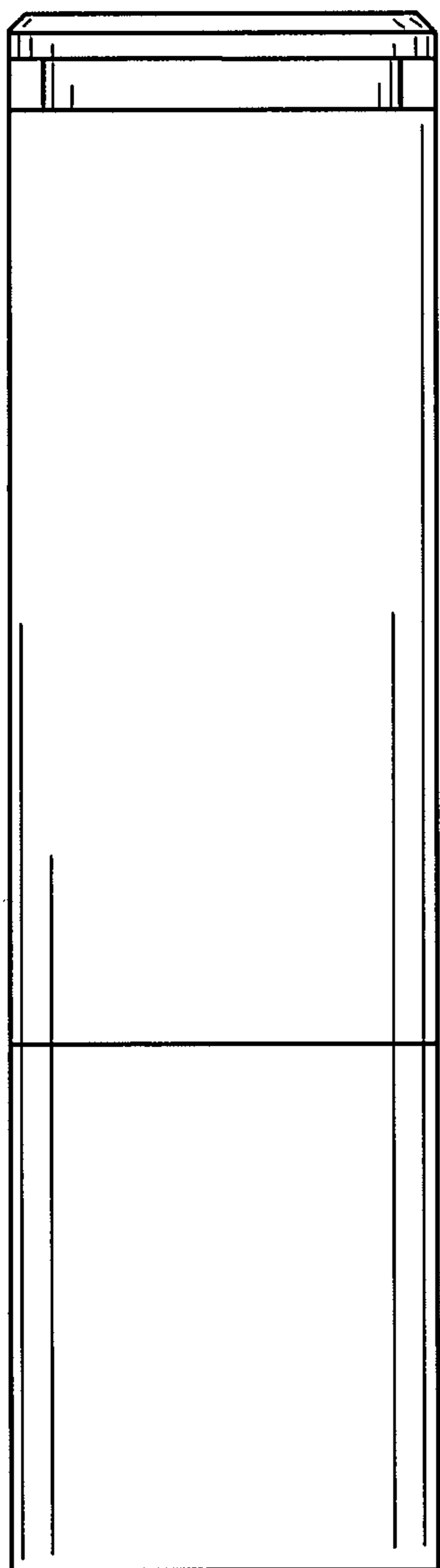

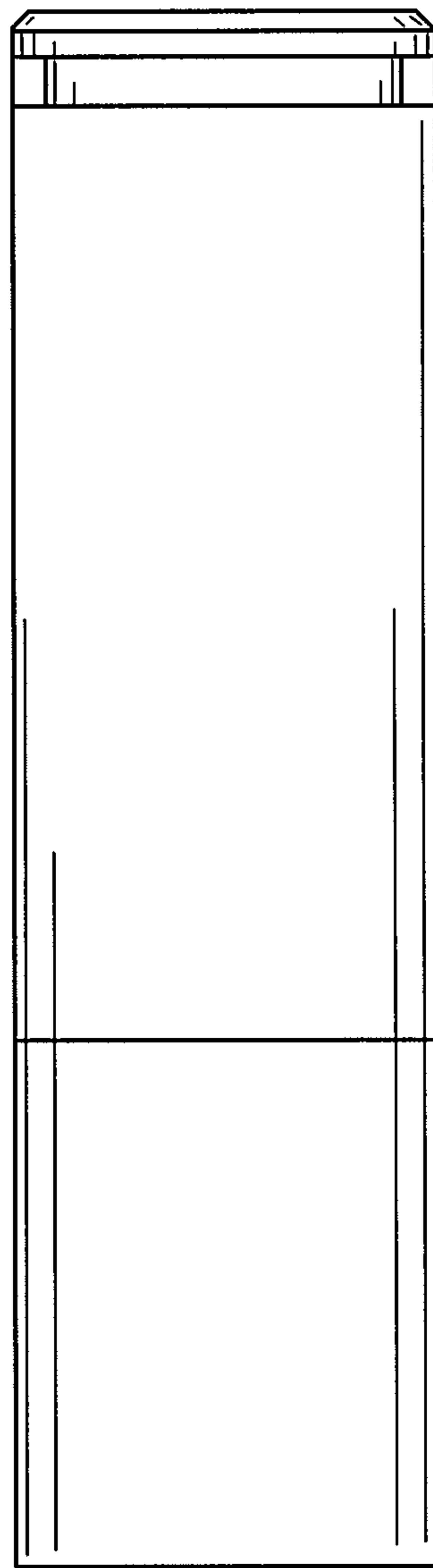

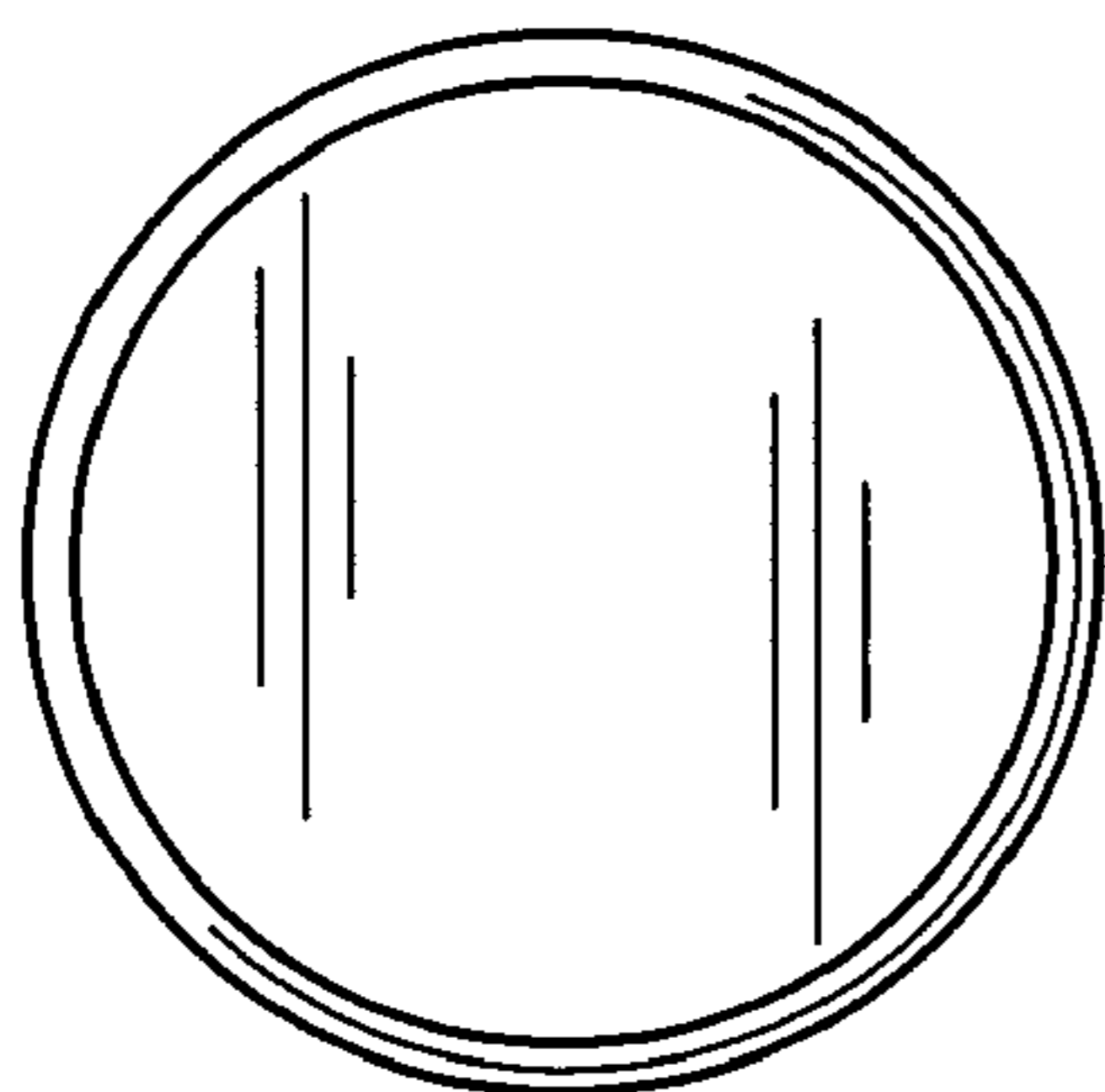

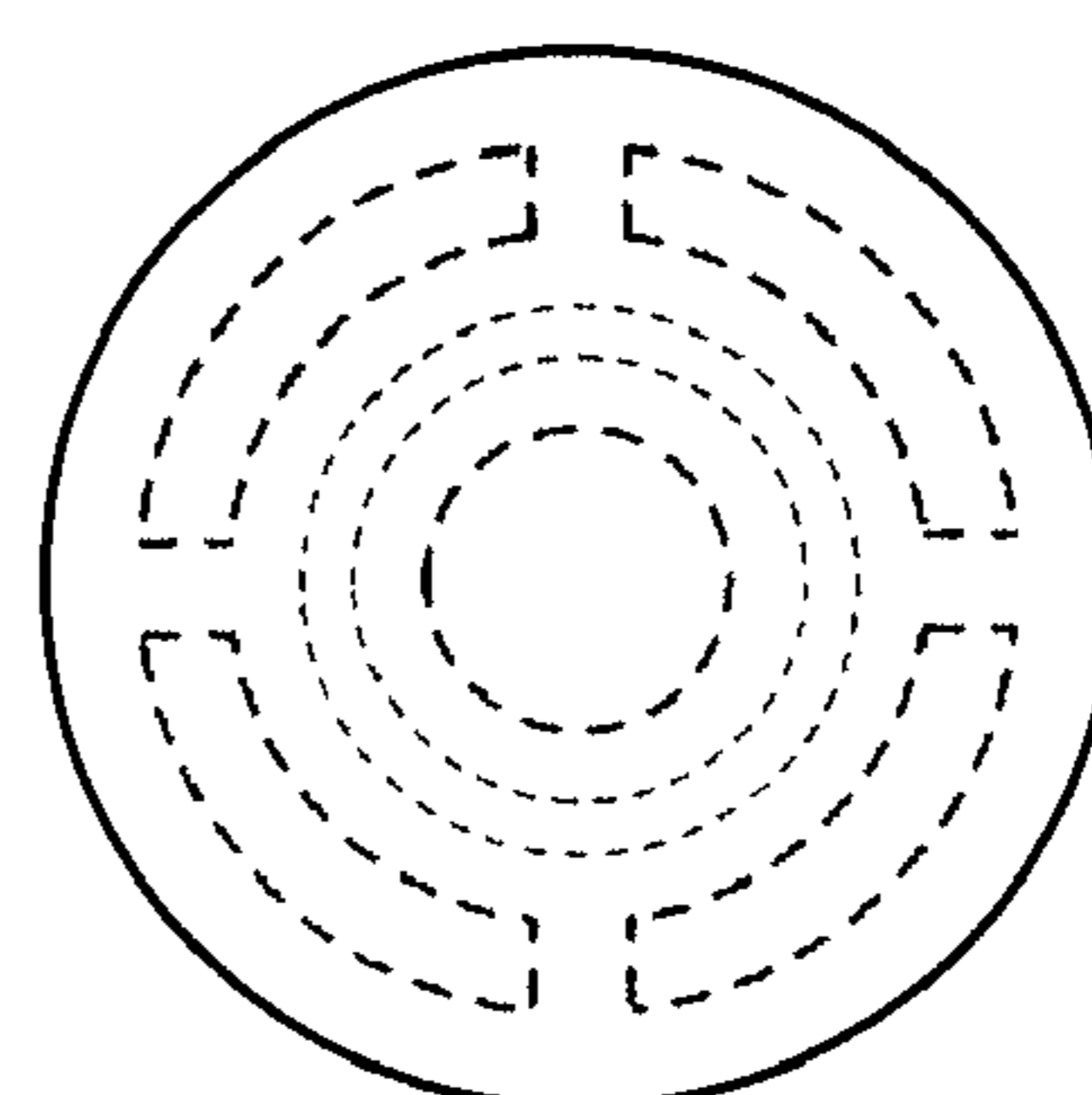

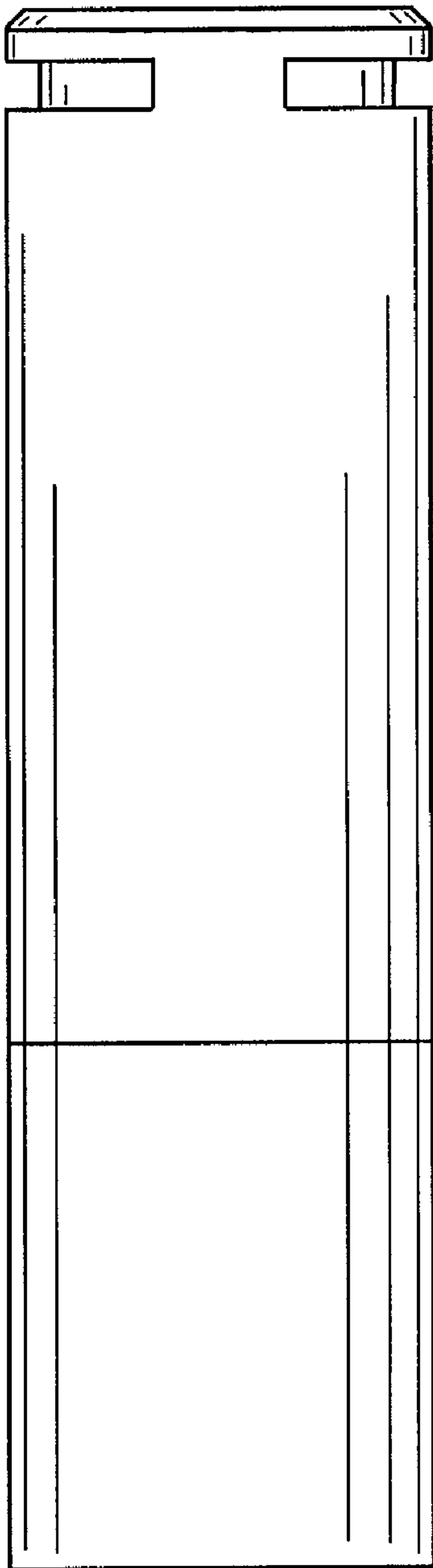

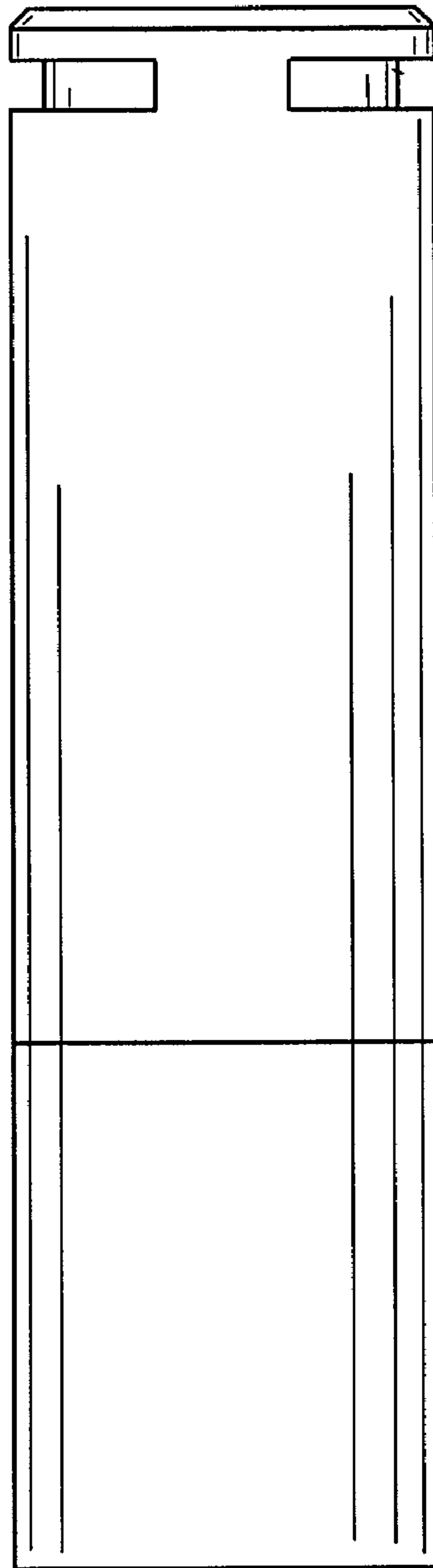

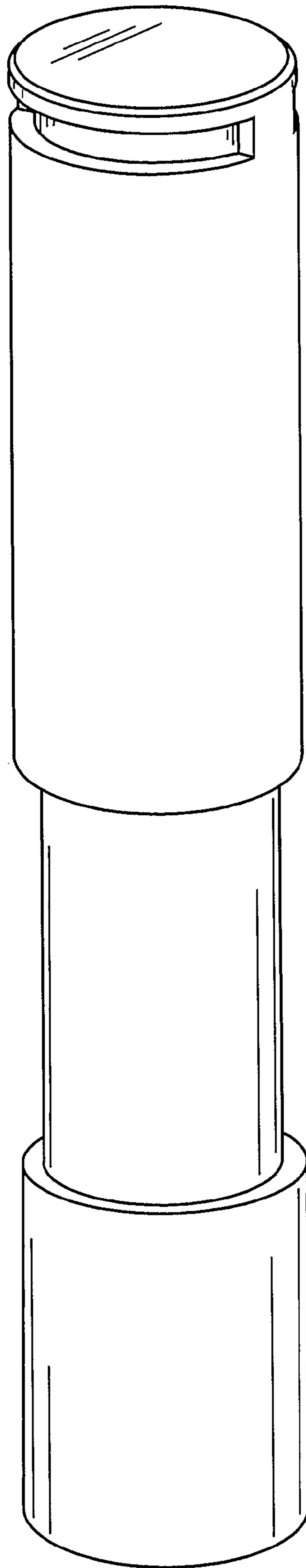
