(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a smoking system case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a smoking system case showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the smoking system case showing the new design;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a longitudinal section view thereof taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 6.

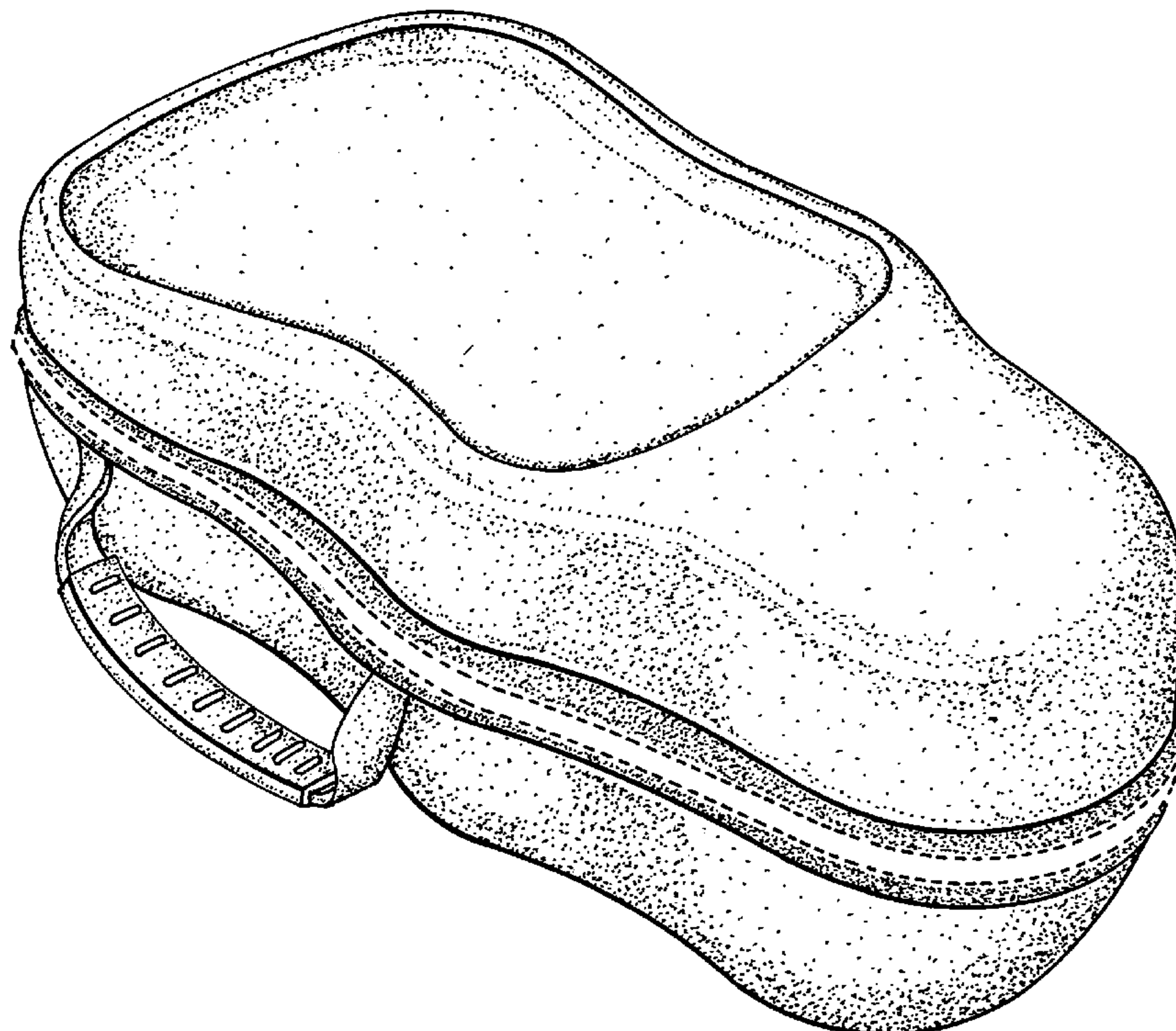
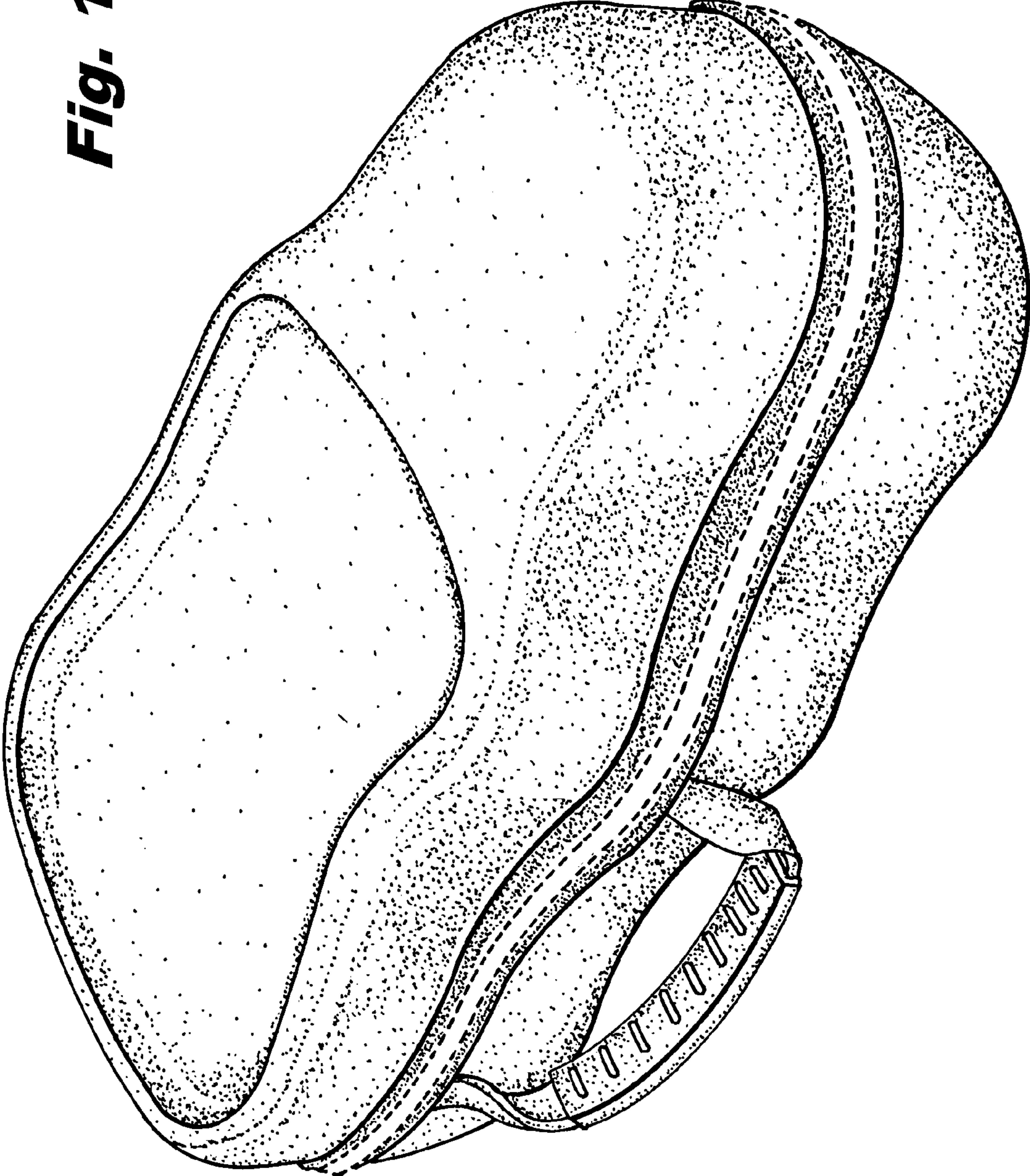

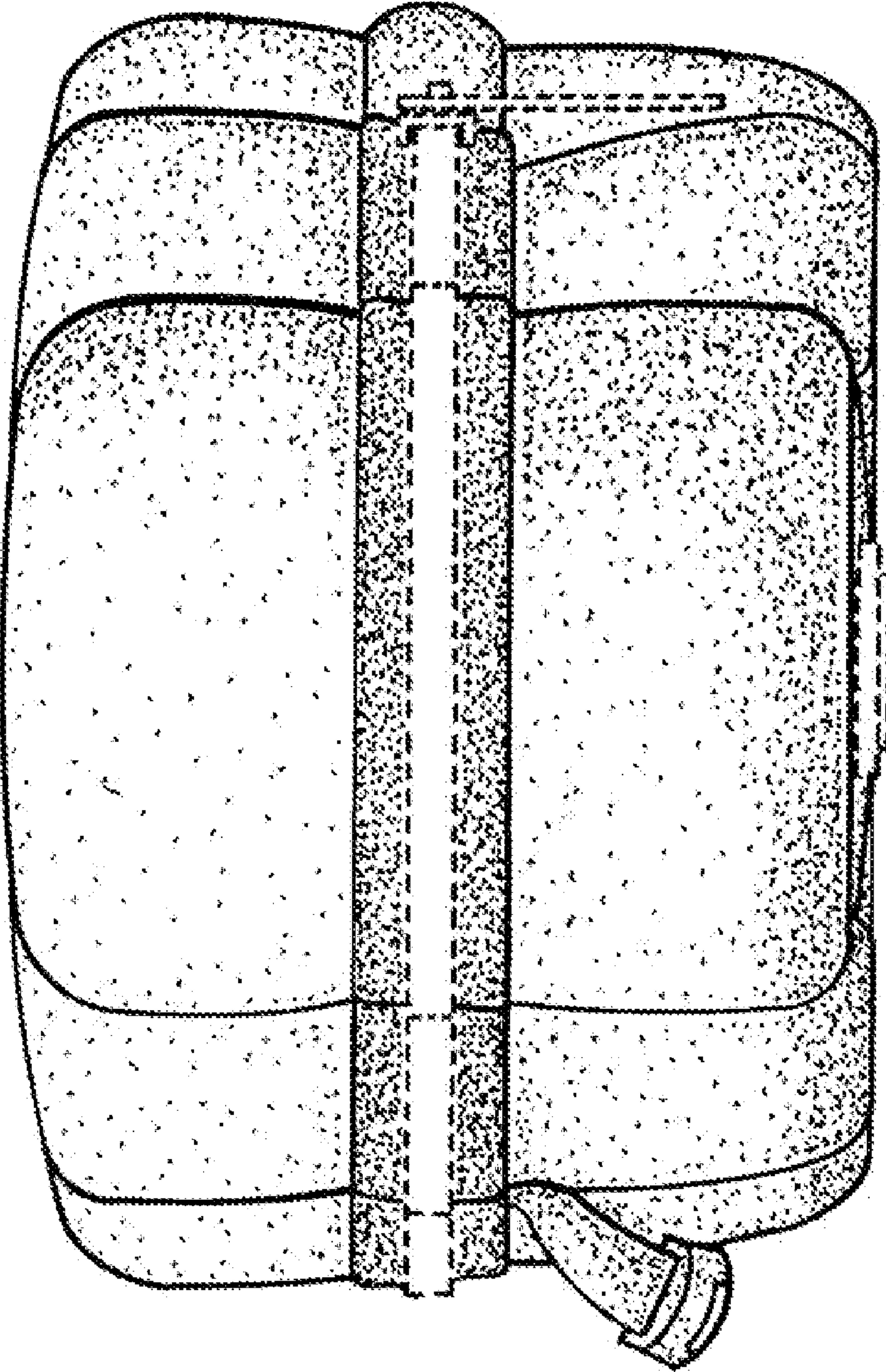

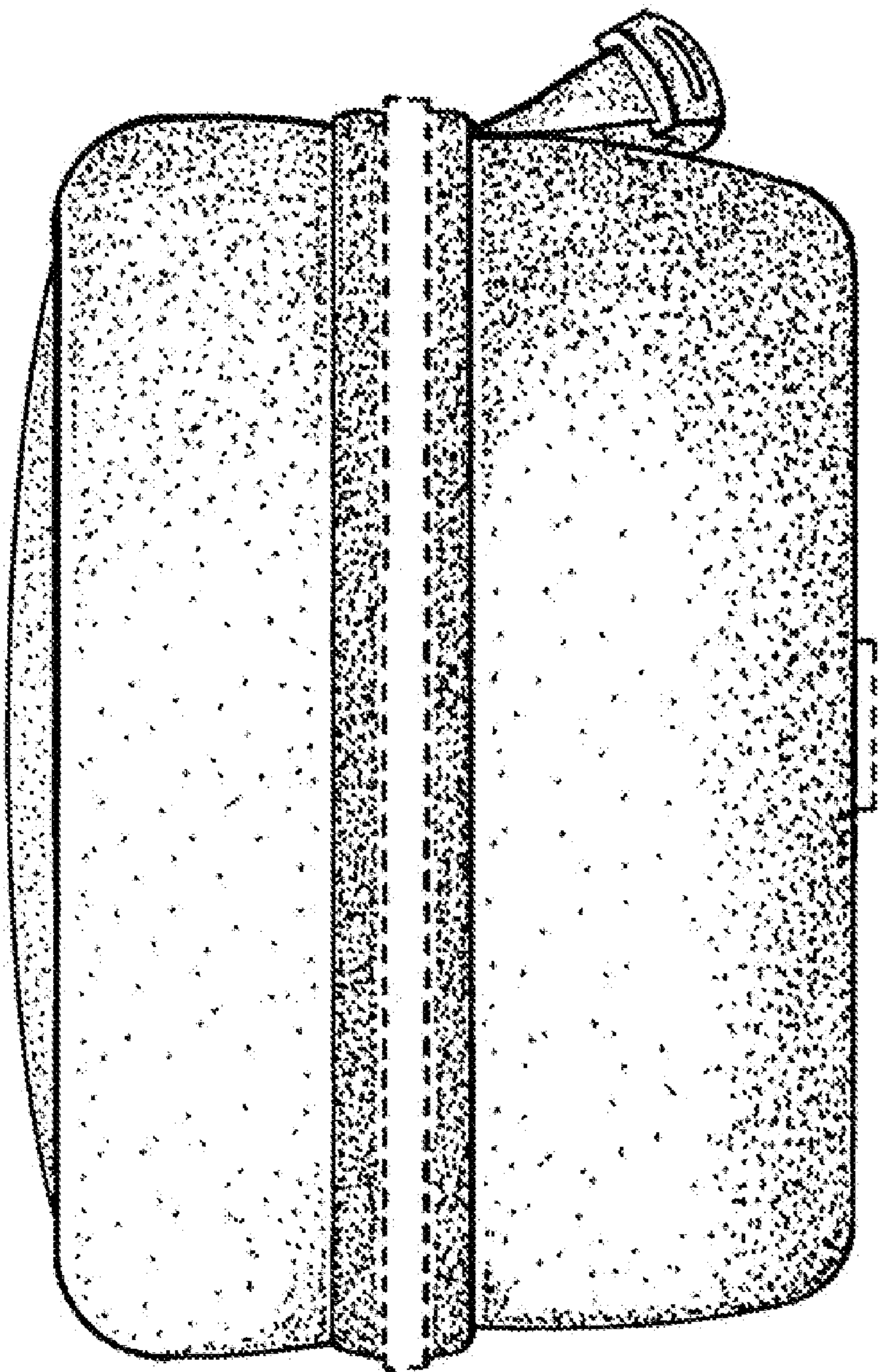

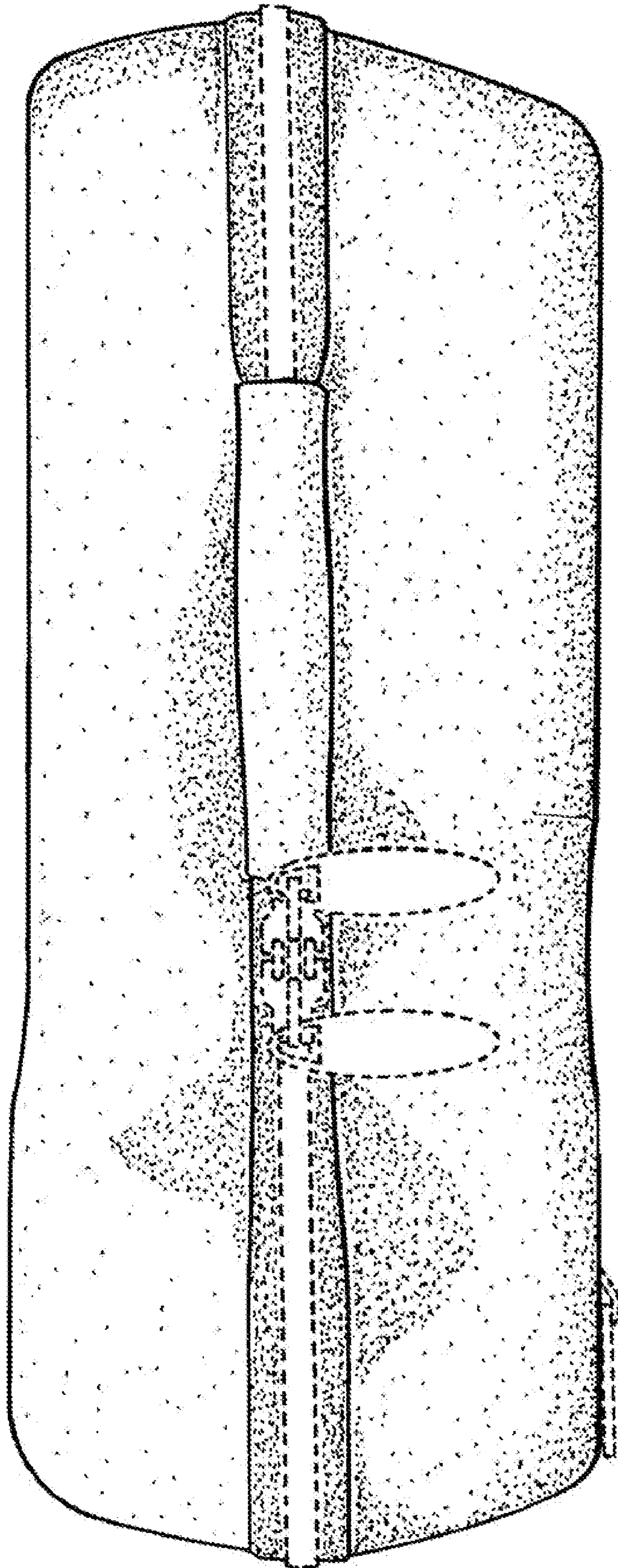
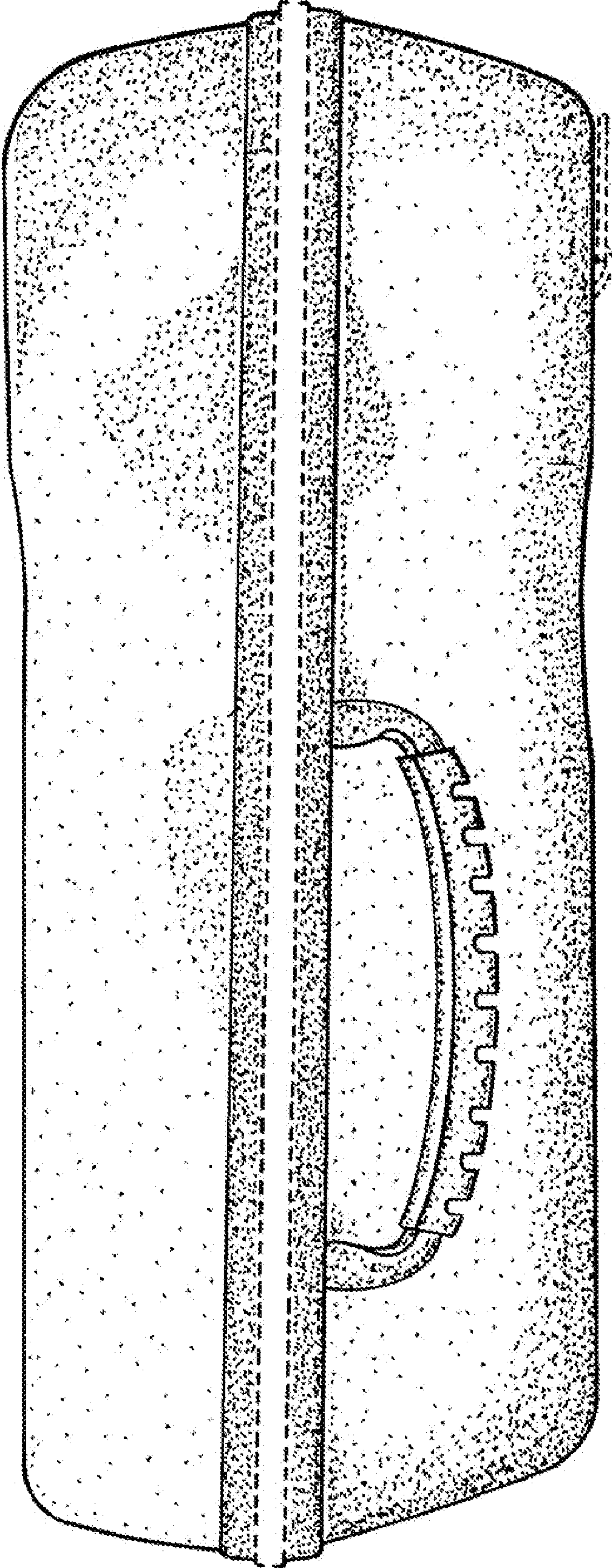

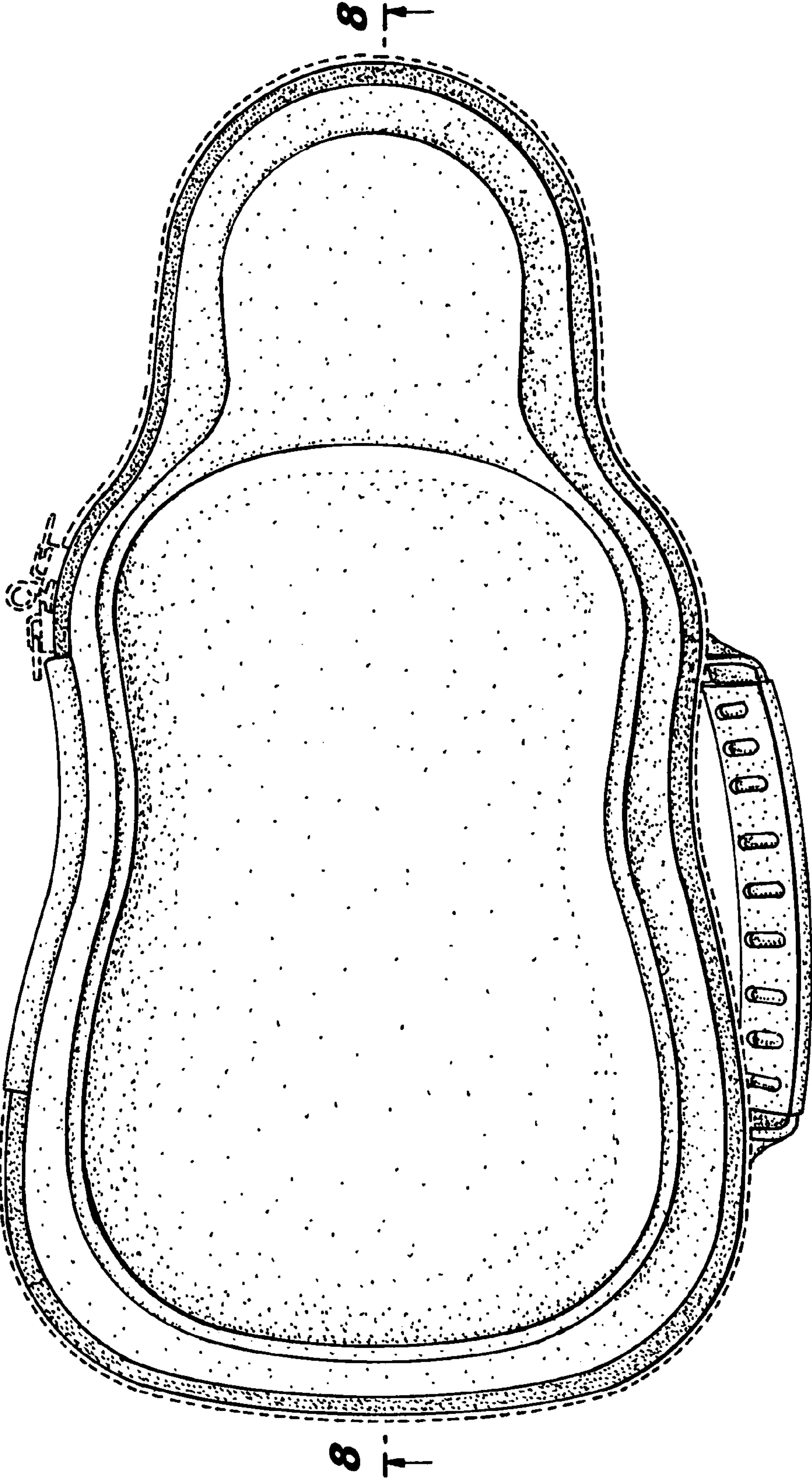

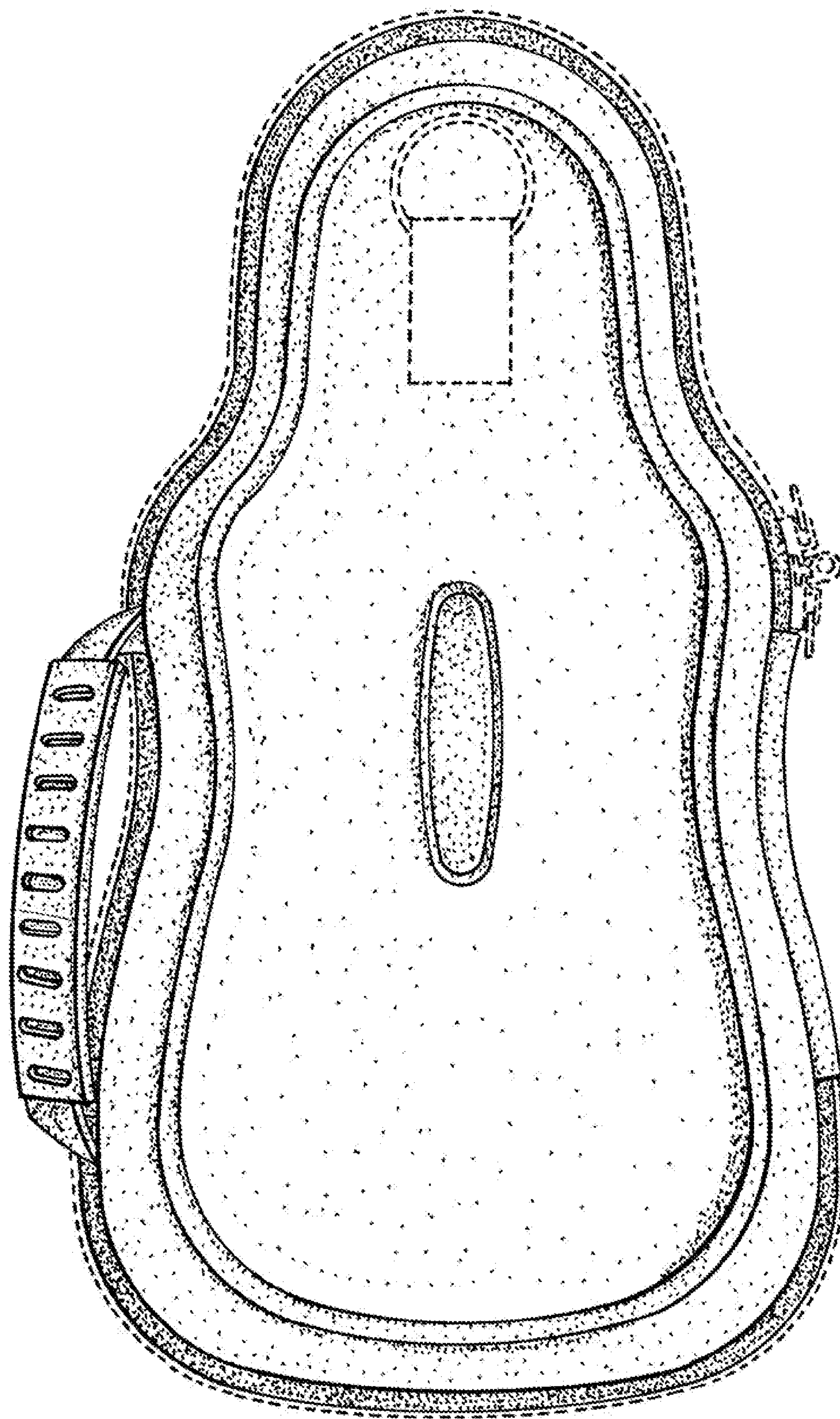

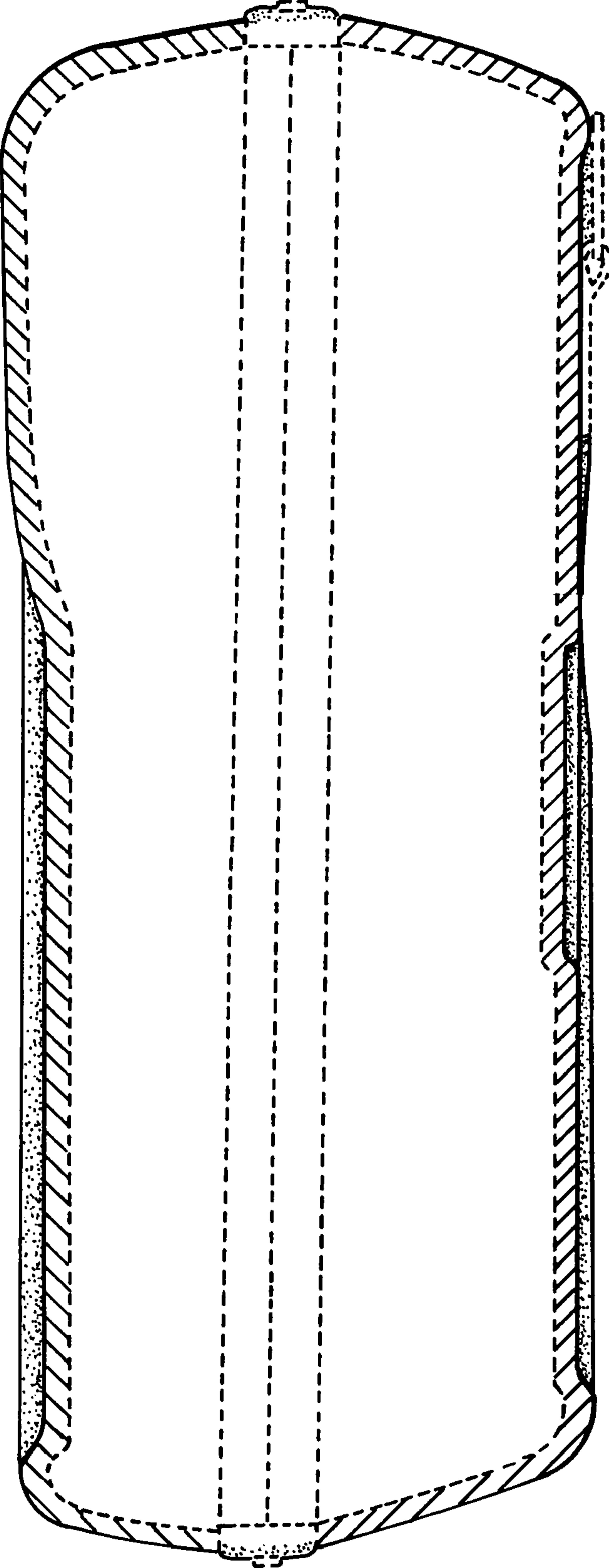
