**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a rear view of the avian garment showing my new design, with the cape shown as unattached to the body-wrapping vest;

FIG. 2 is, a rear view, with the cape shown as attached to the body-wrapping vest;

FIG. 3 is a front view illustrated as positioned on a parrot, with the cape shown as attached to the body-wrapping vest;

FIG. 4 is a front view illustrated as positioned on a parrot, without the cape attached to the body-wrapping vest;

FIG. 5 is a rear view illustrated as positioned on a parrot, with the cape shown as attached to the body-wrapping vest;

FIG. 6 is a rear view illustrated as positioned on a parrot, without the cape attached to the body-wrapping vest; and,

FIG. 7 is a front view with the cape shown as unattached to the body-wrapping vest.

The broken line showing of a bird is for environmental illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The portions of the garment depicted in black are actually black in color.

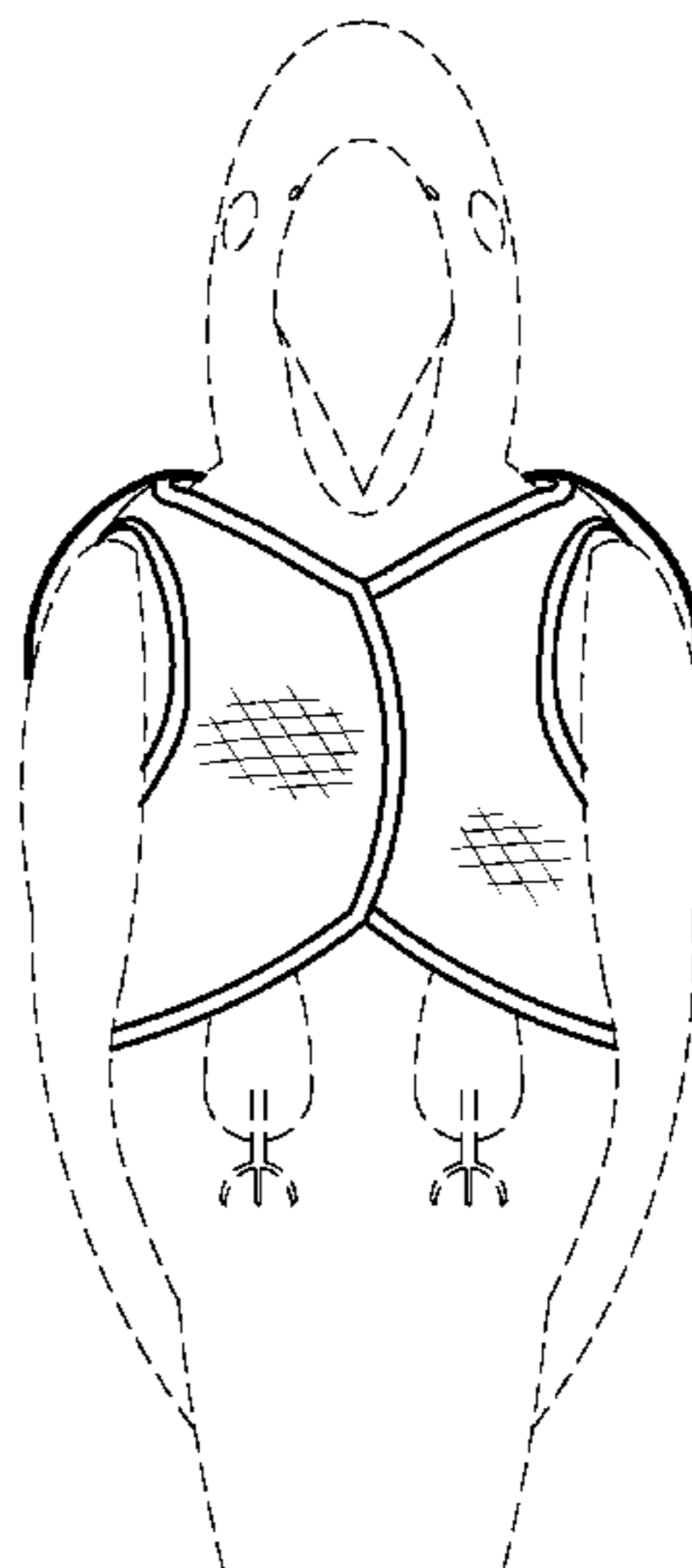
The avian garment is virtually flat and of no substantial thickness.

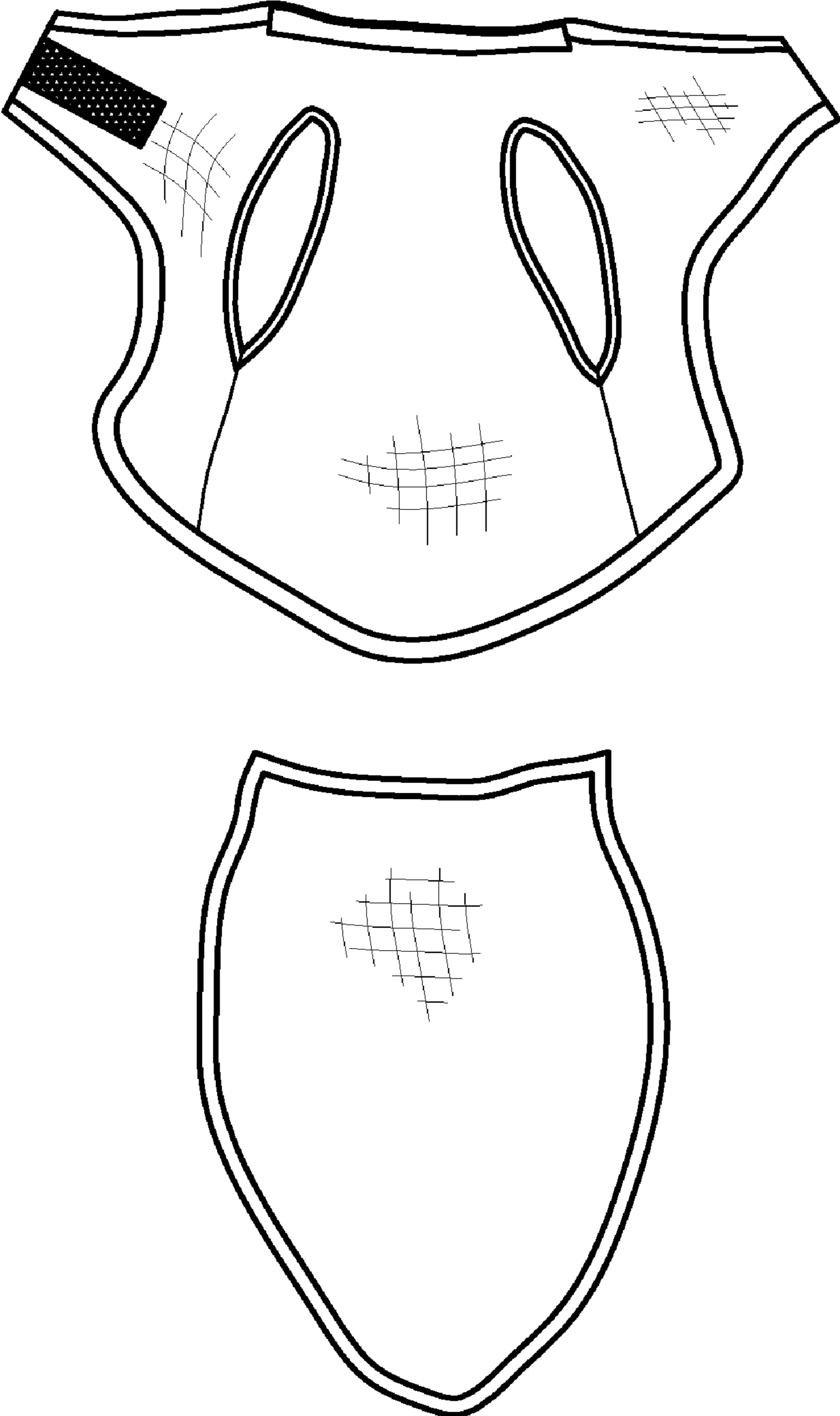
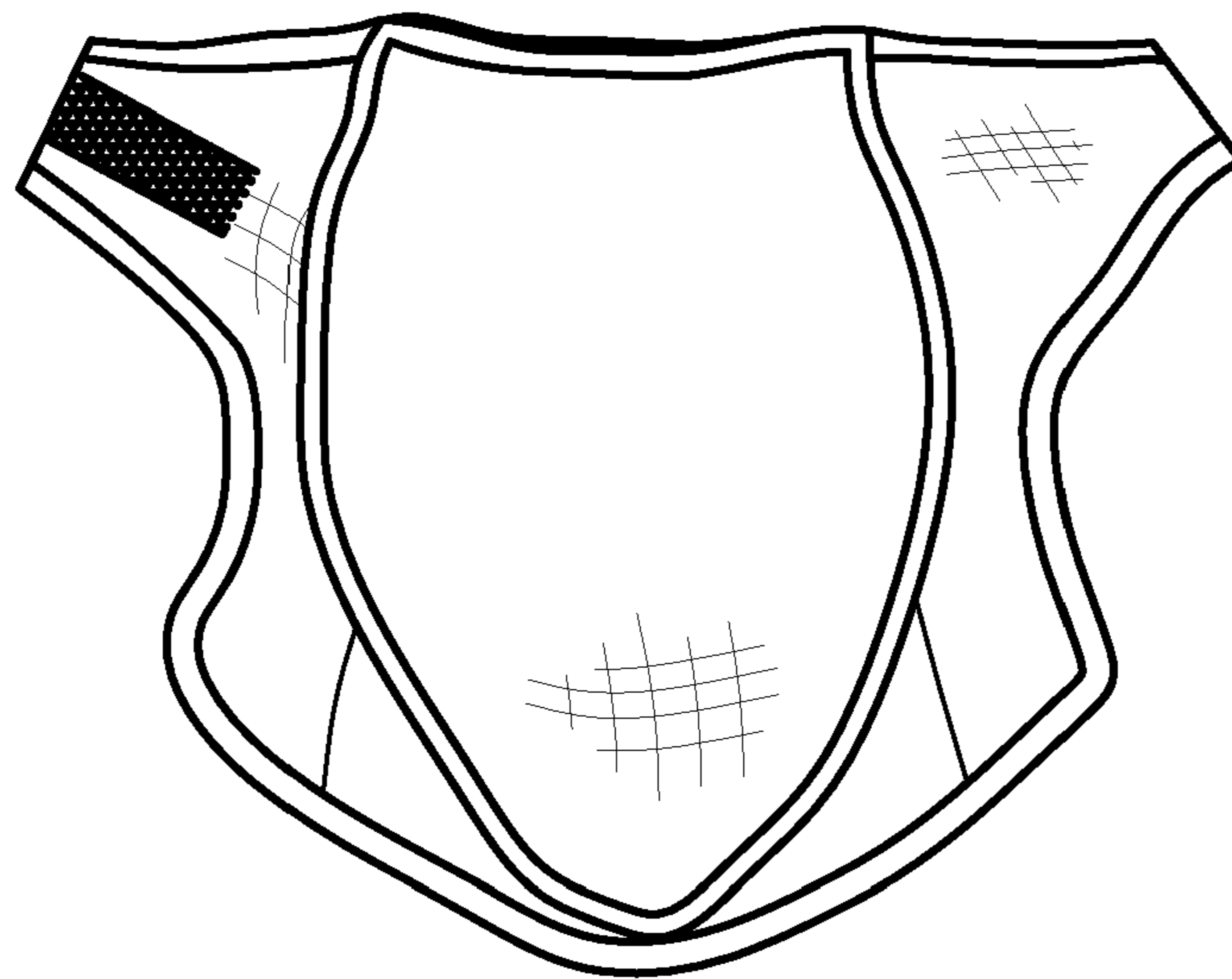
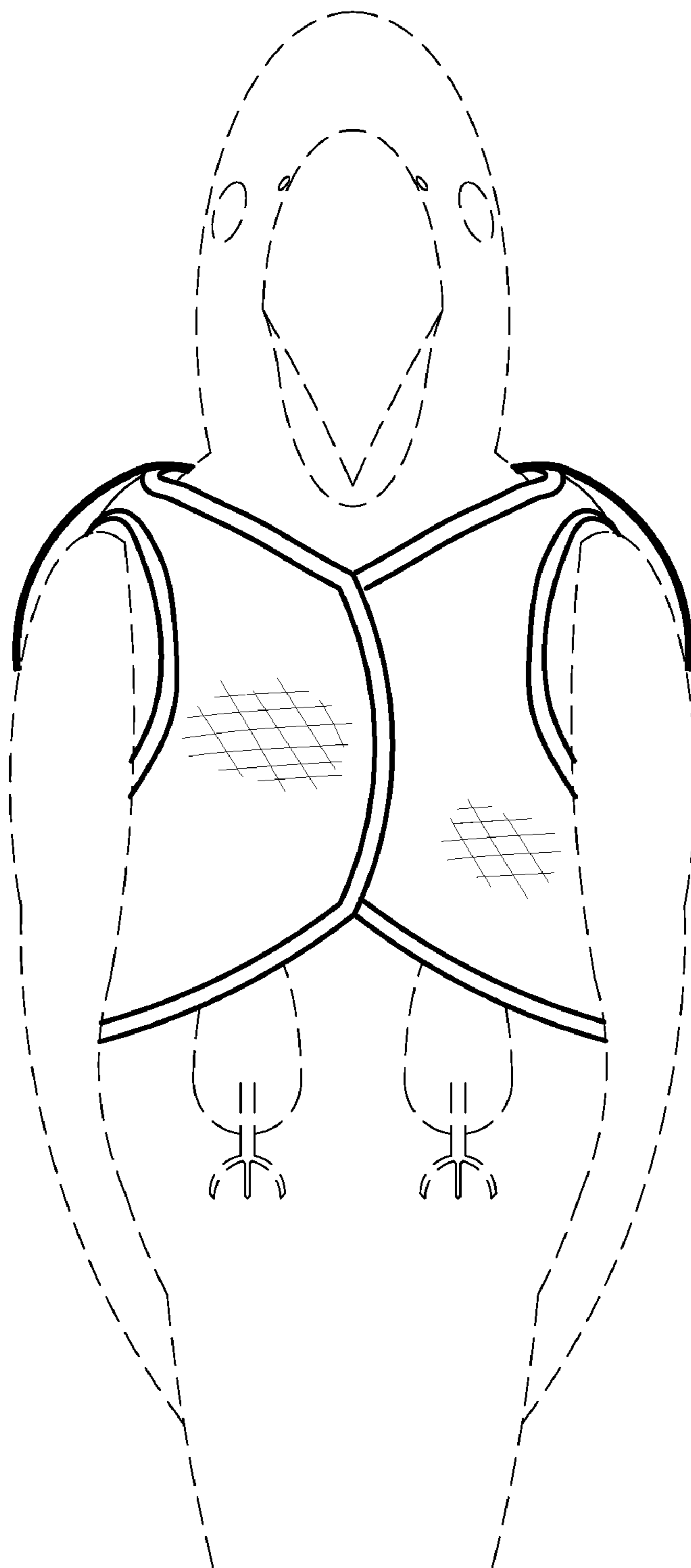


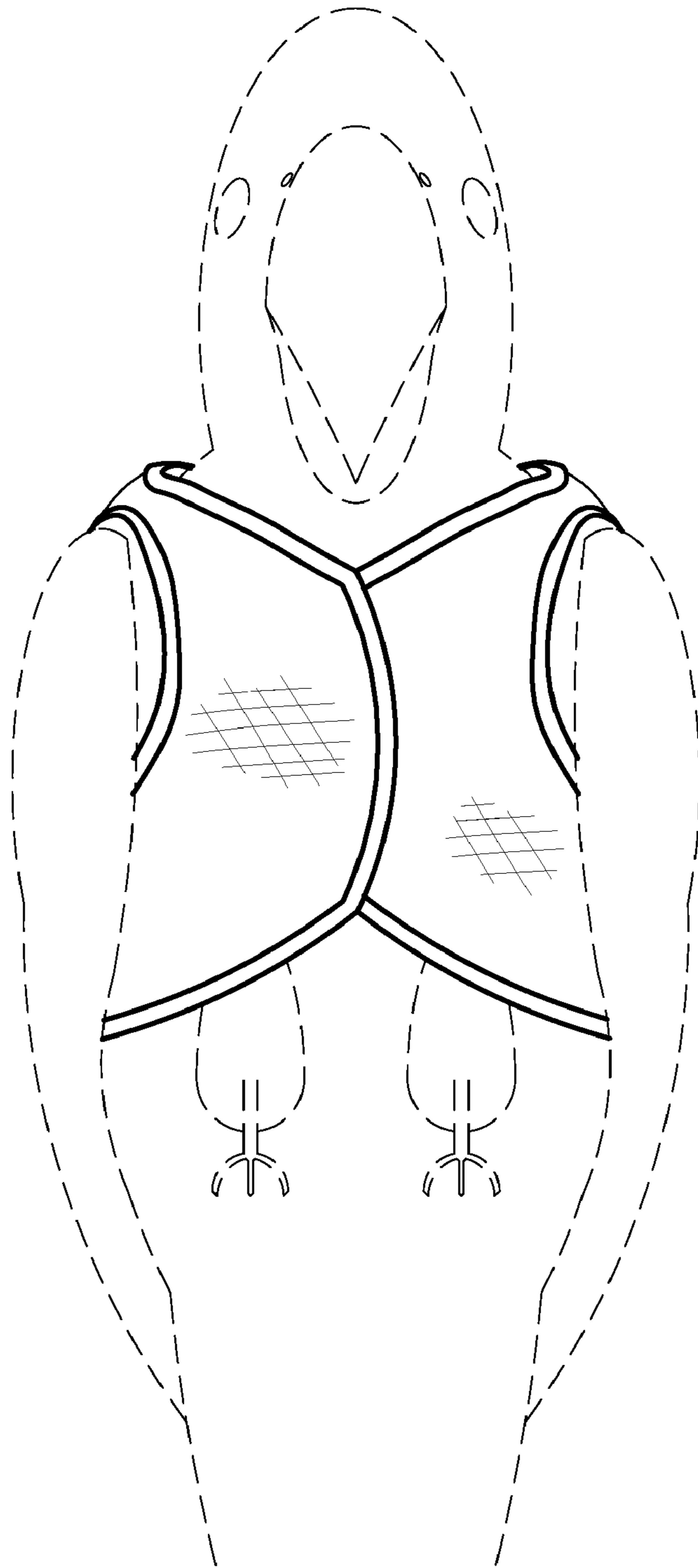

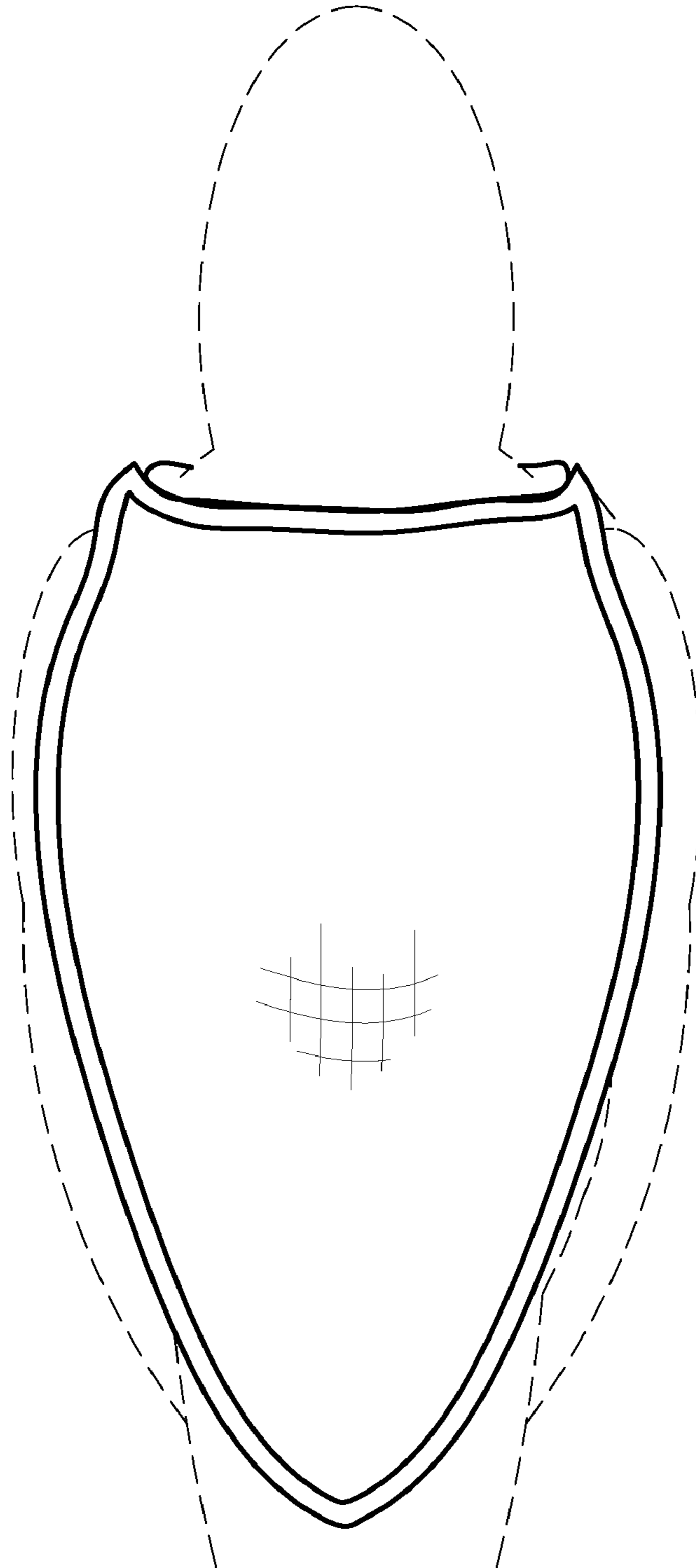

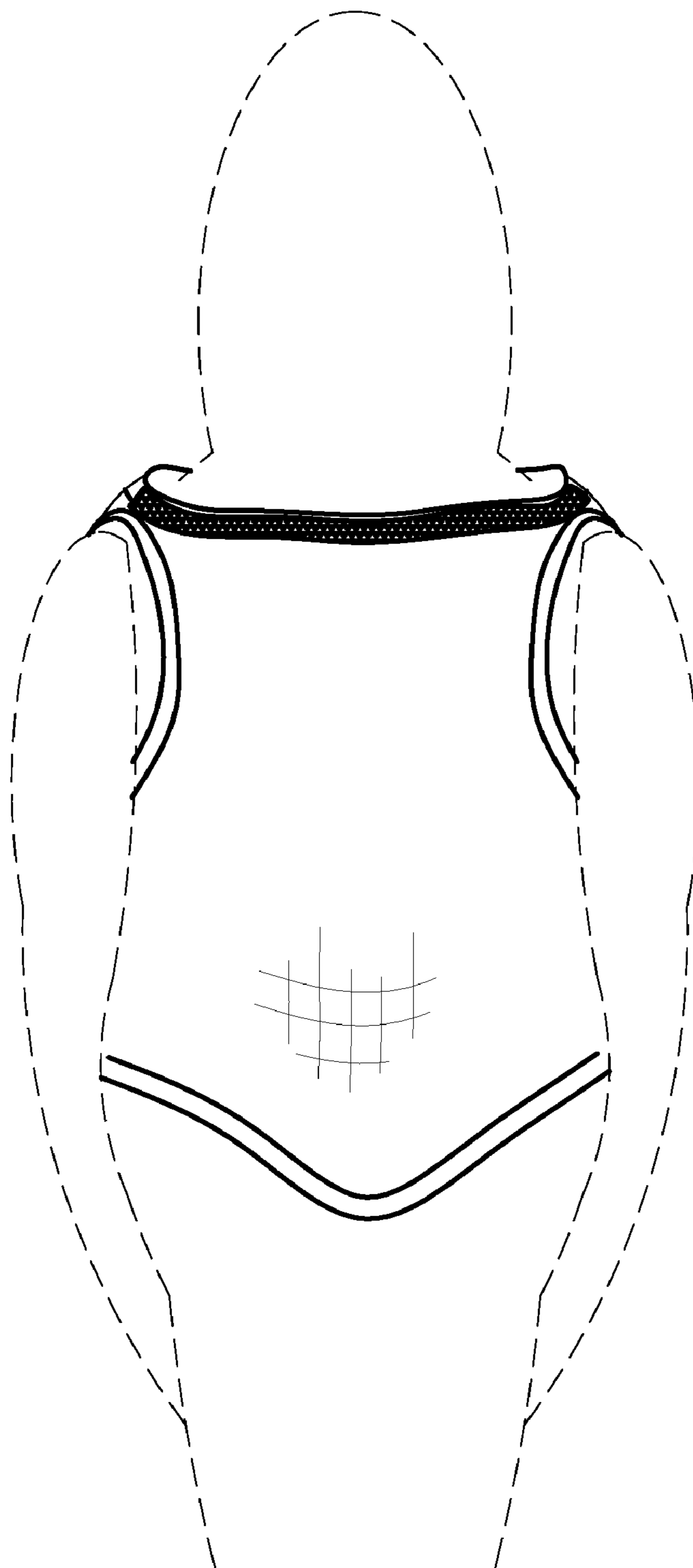
