FIG. 10 is a right side view.

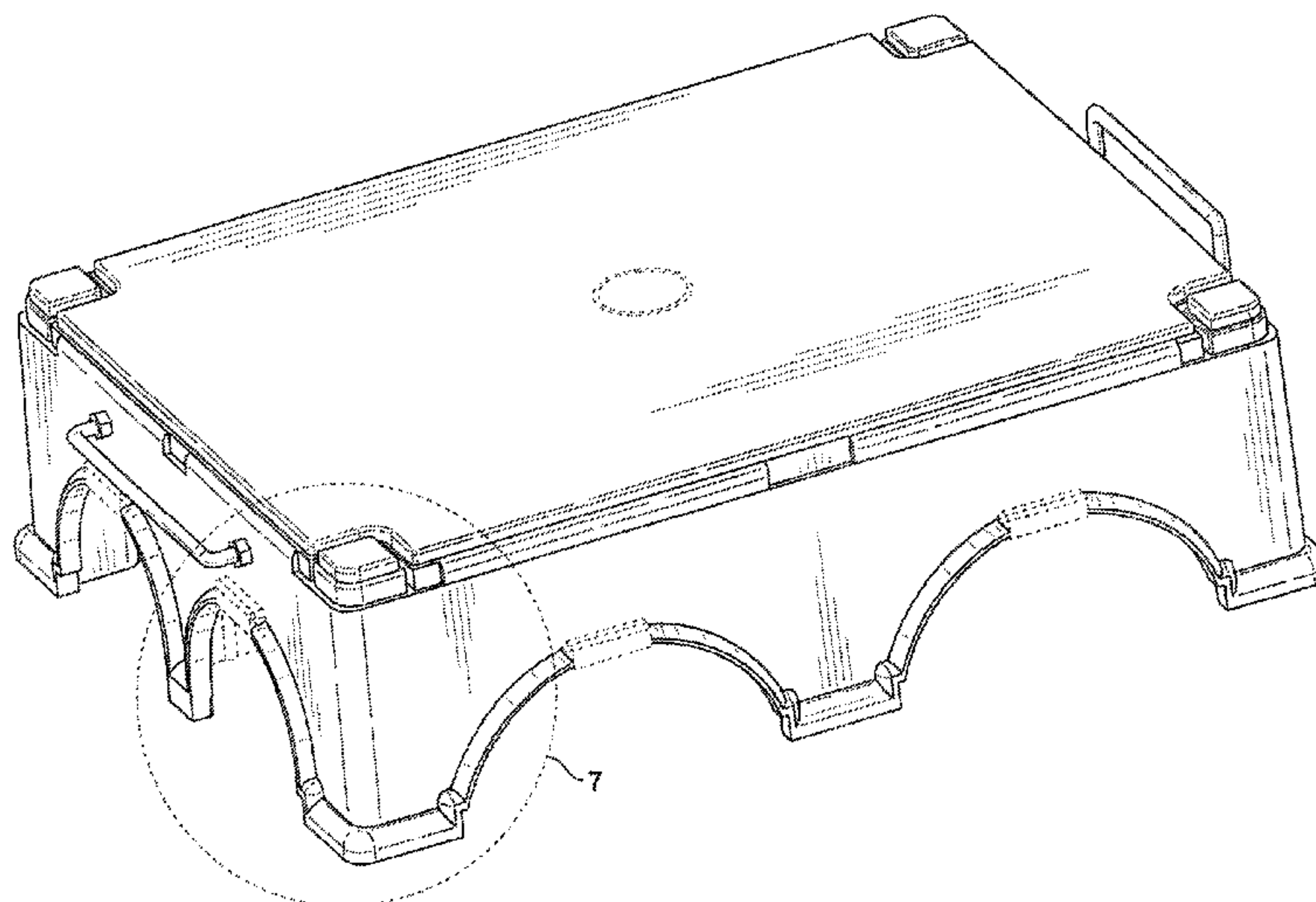
FIG. 11 is a rear view, the front view is a mirror image of the rear view.

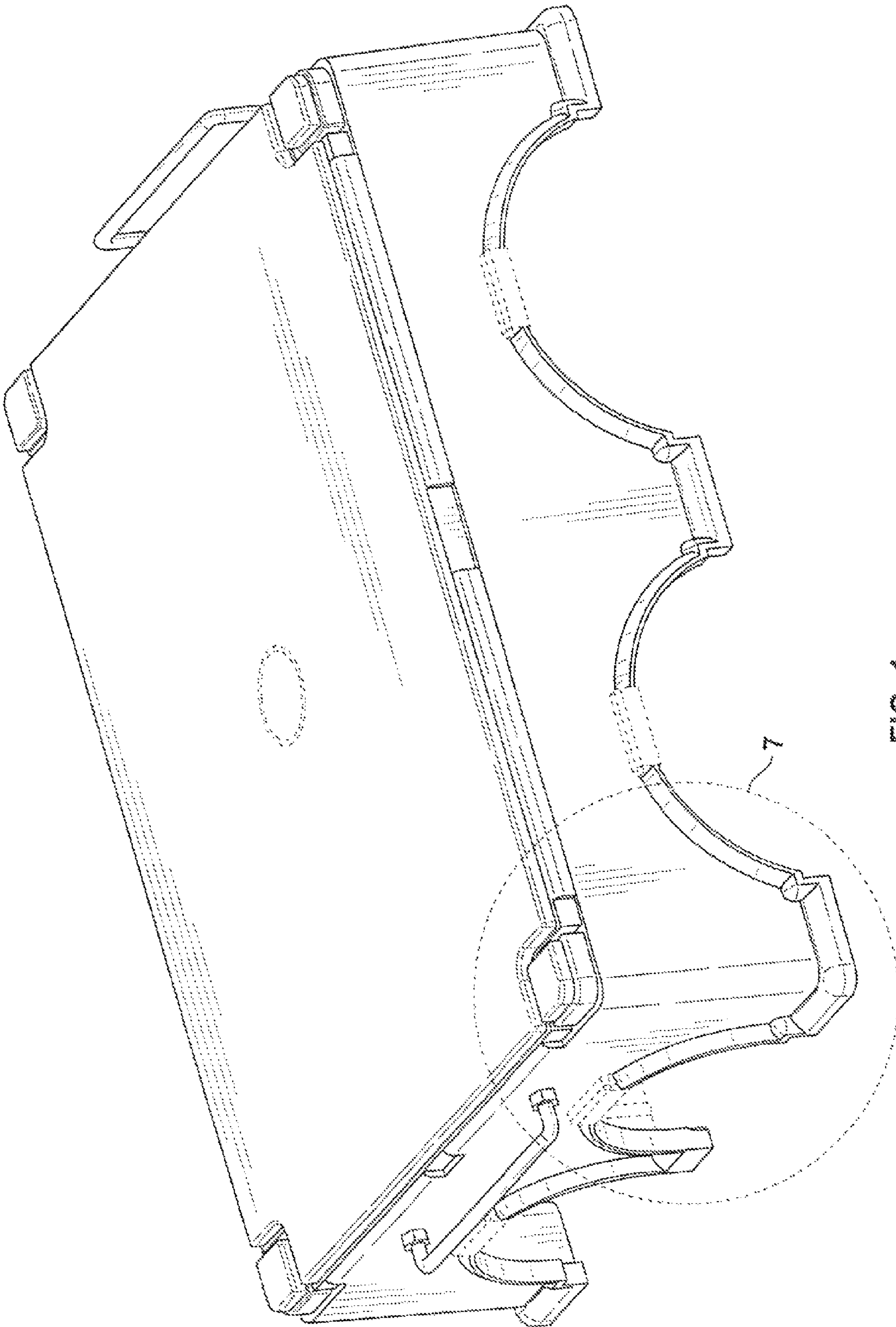

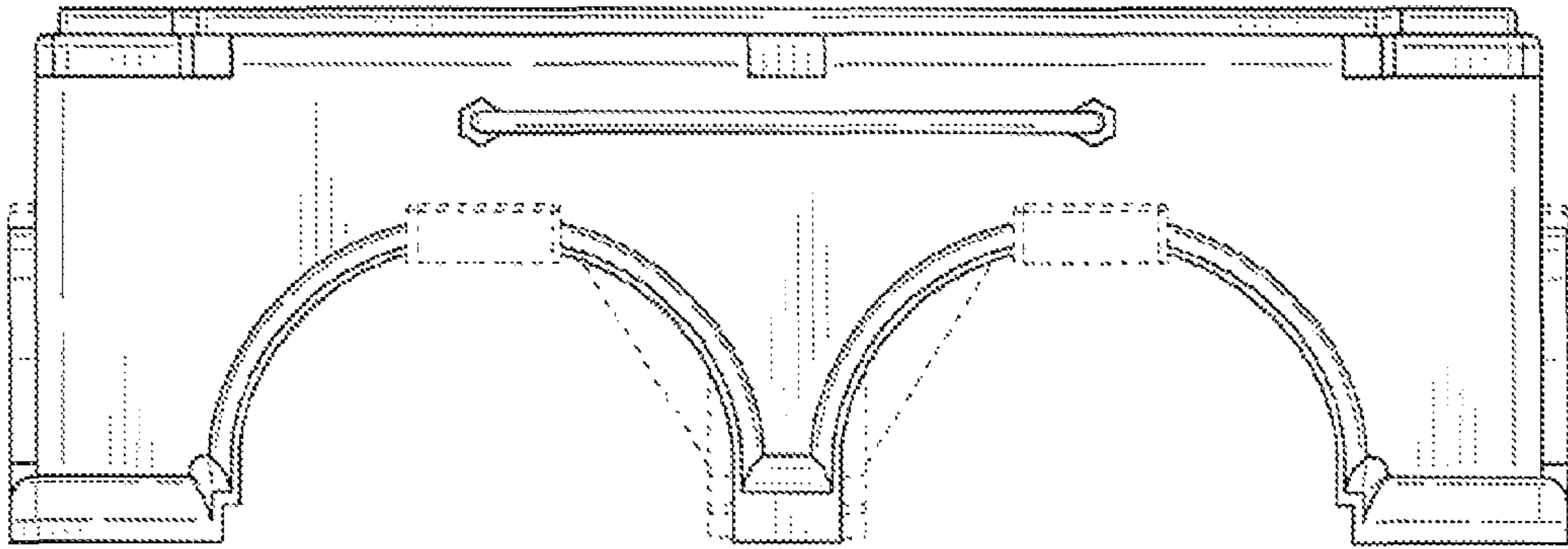

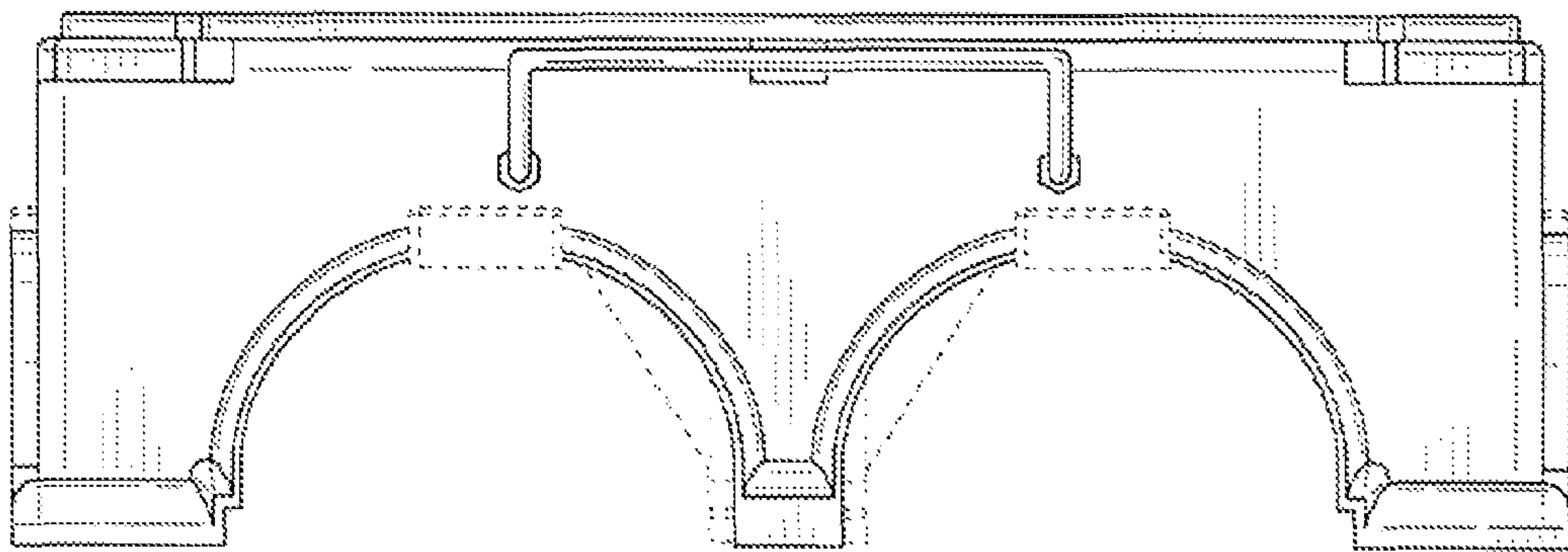

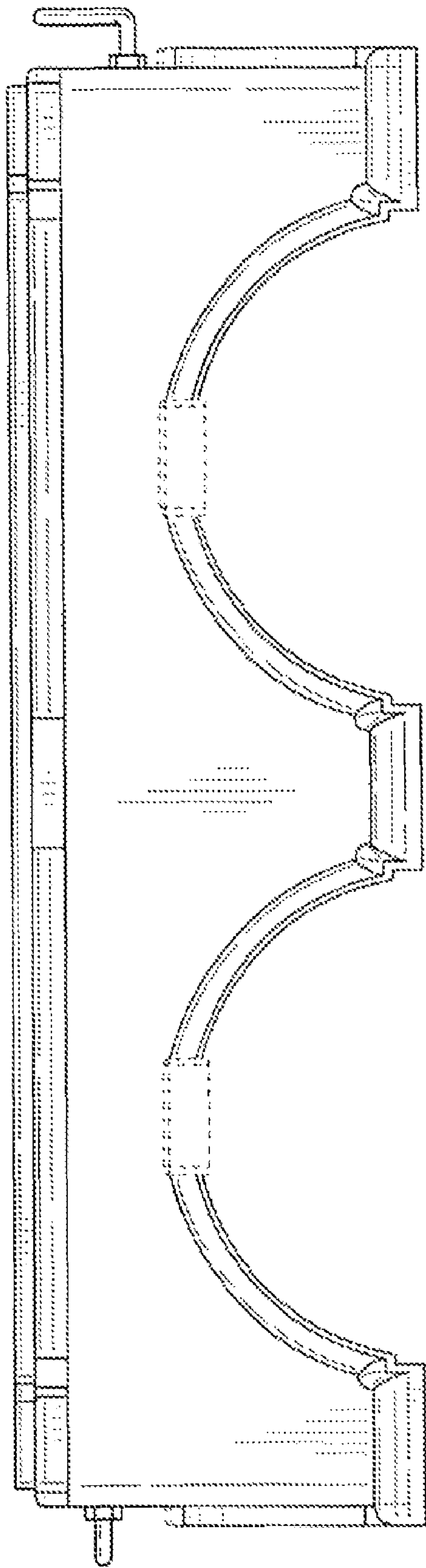

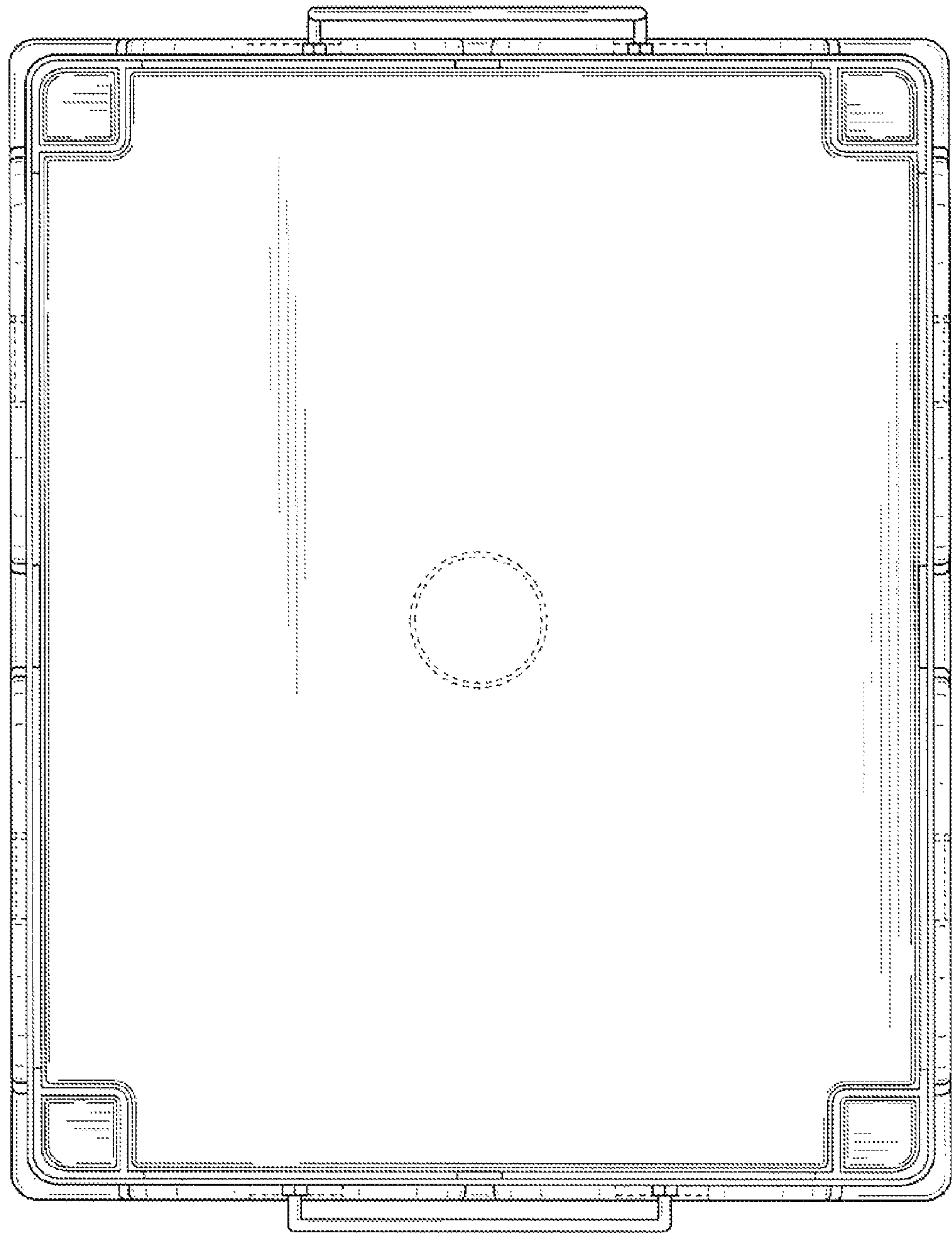

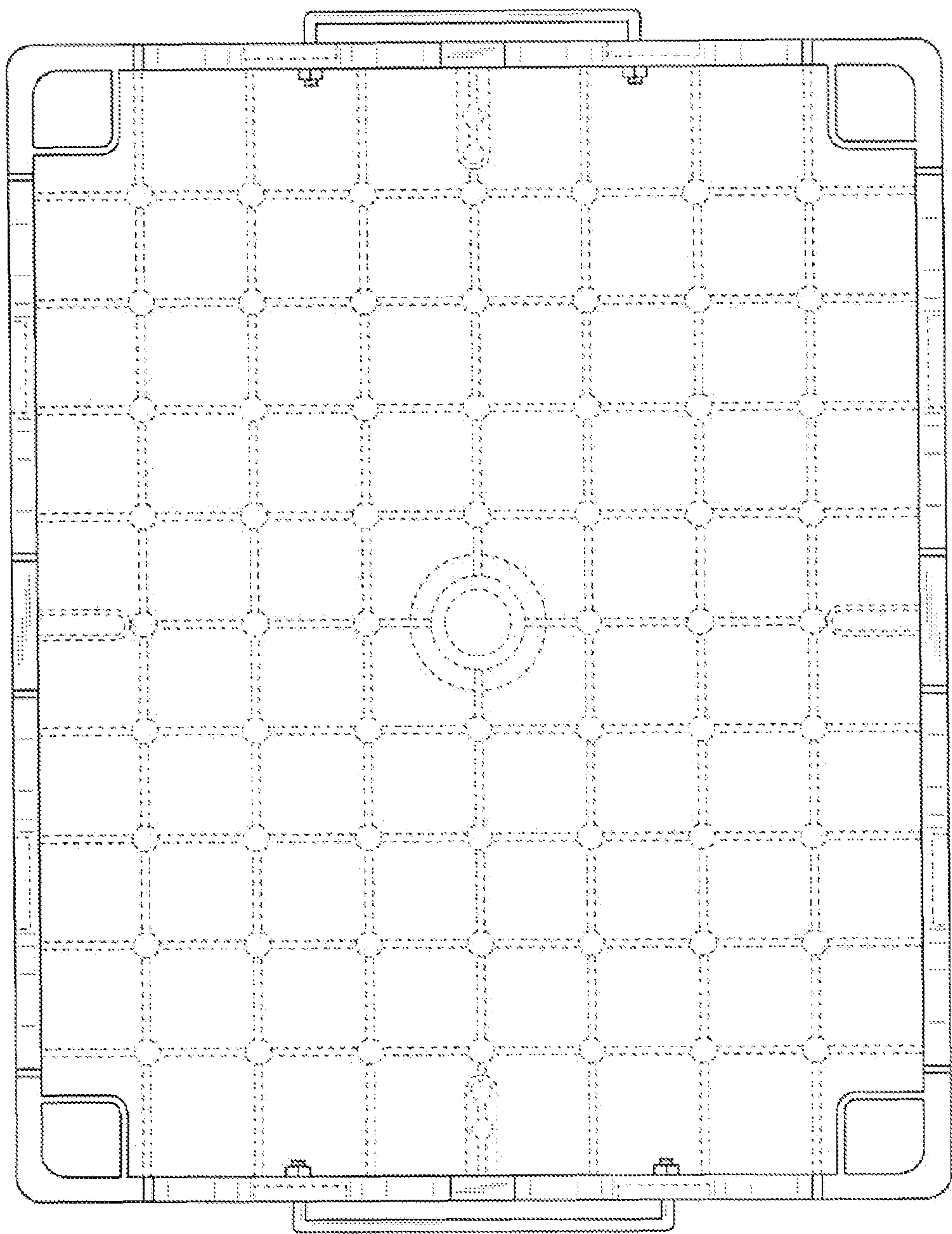

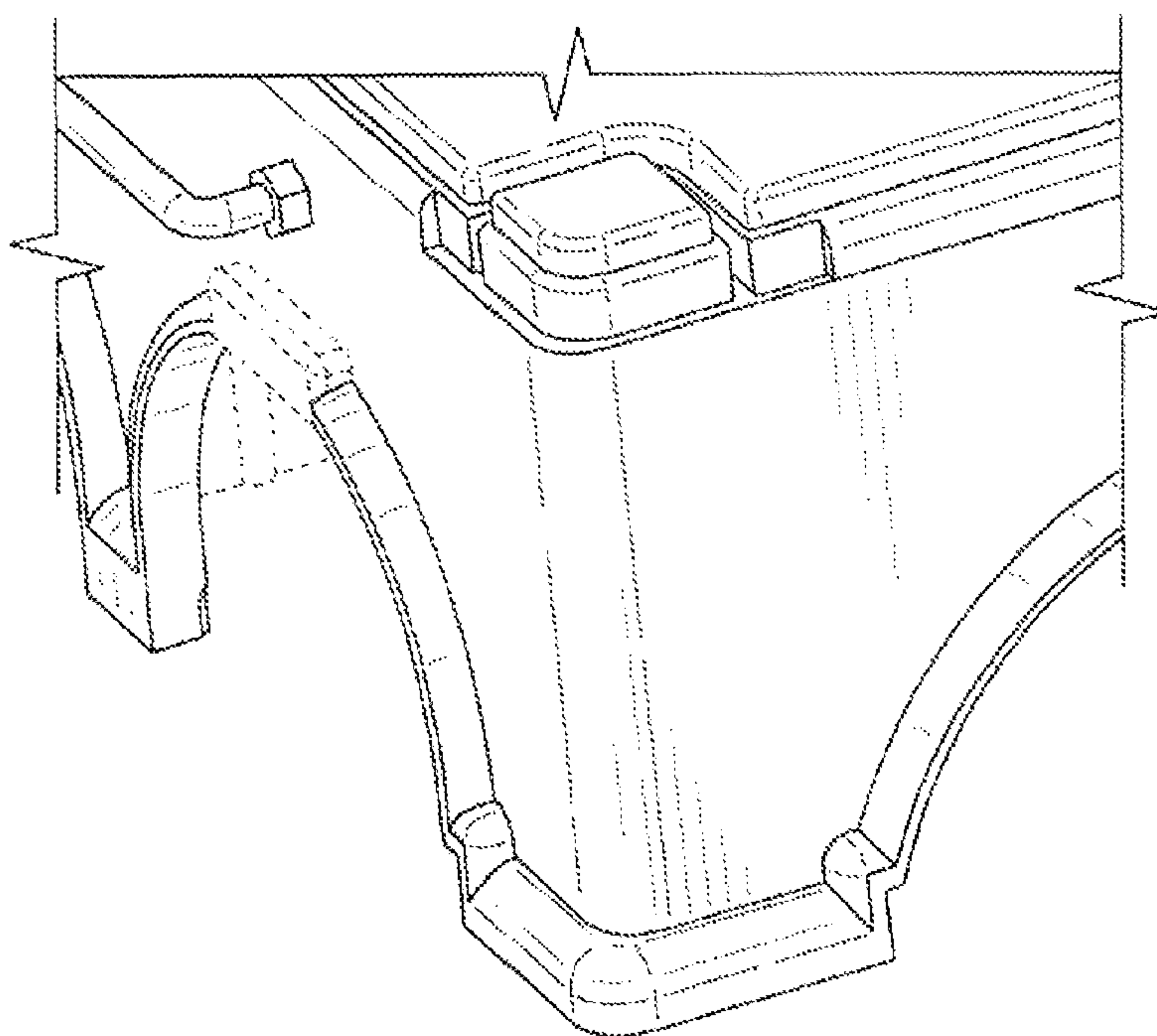

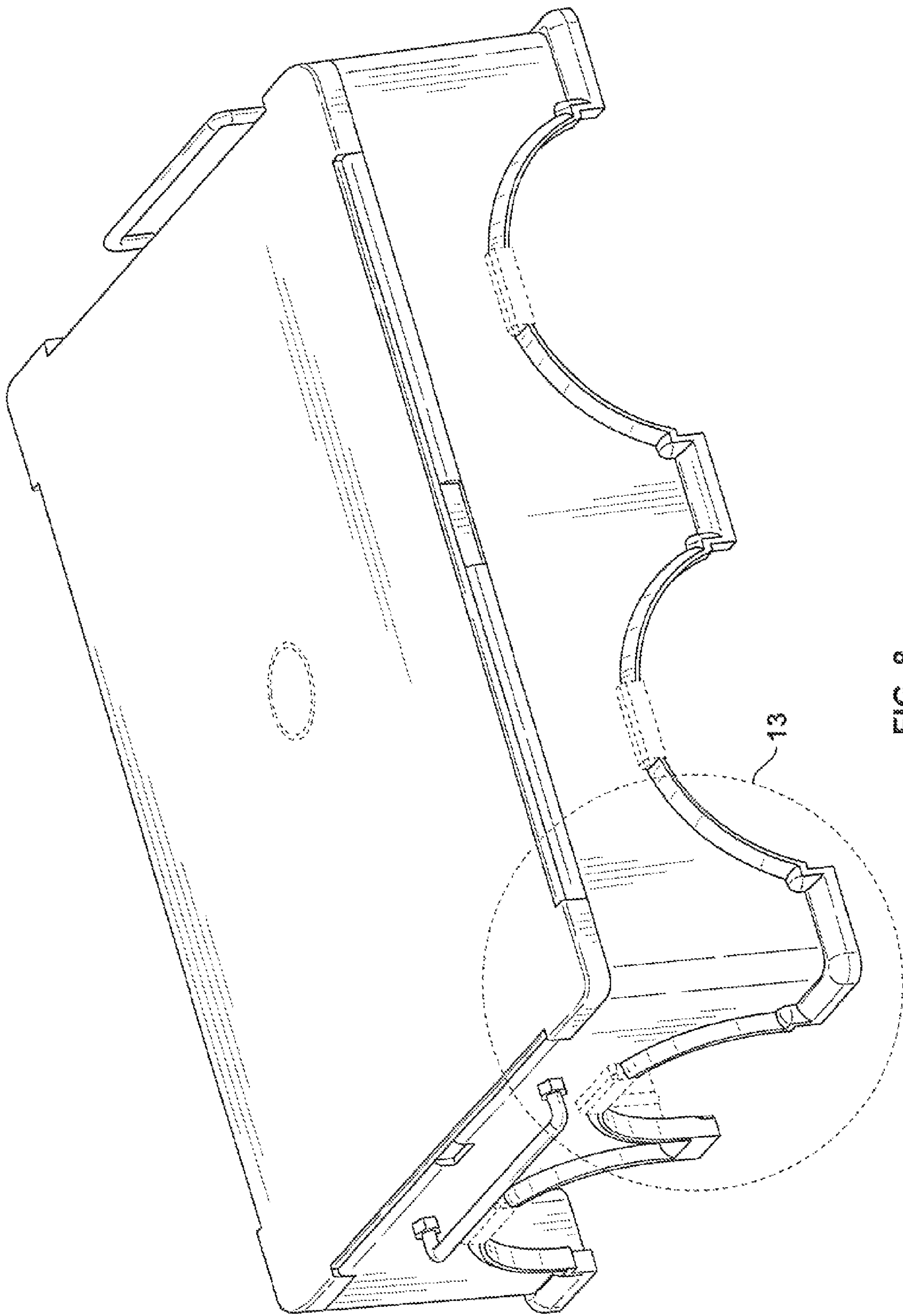

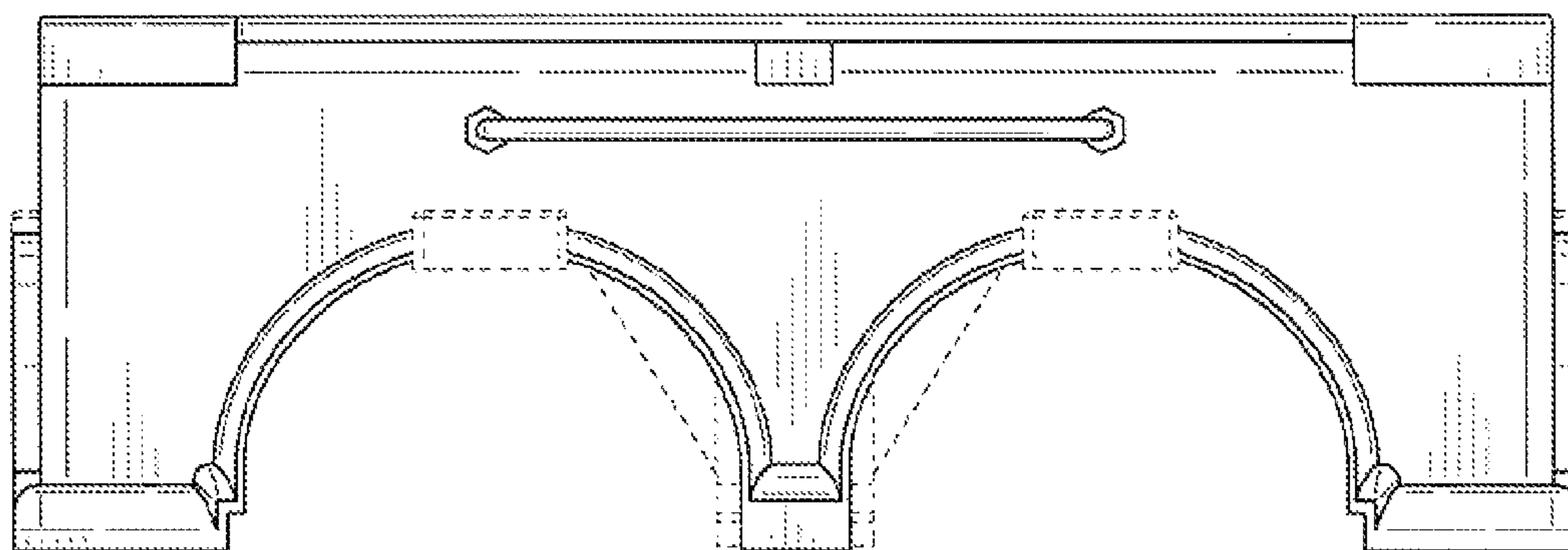

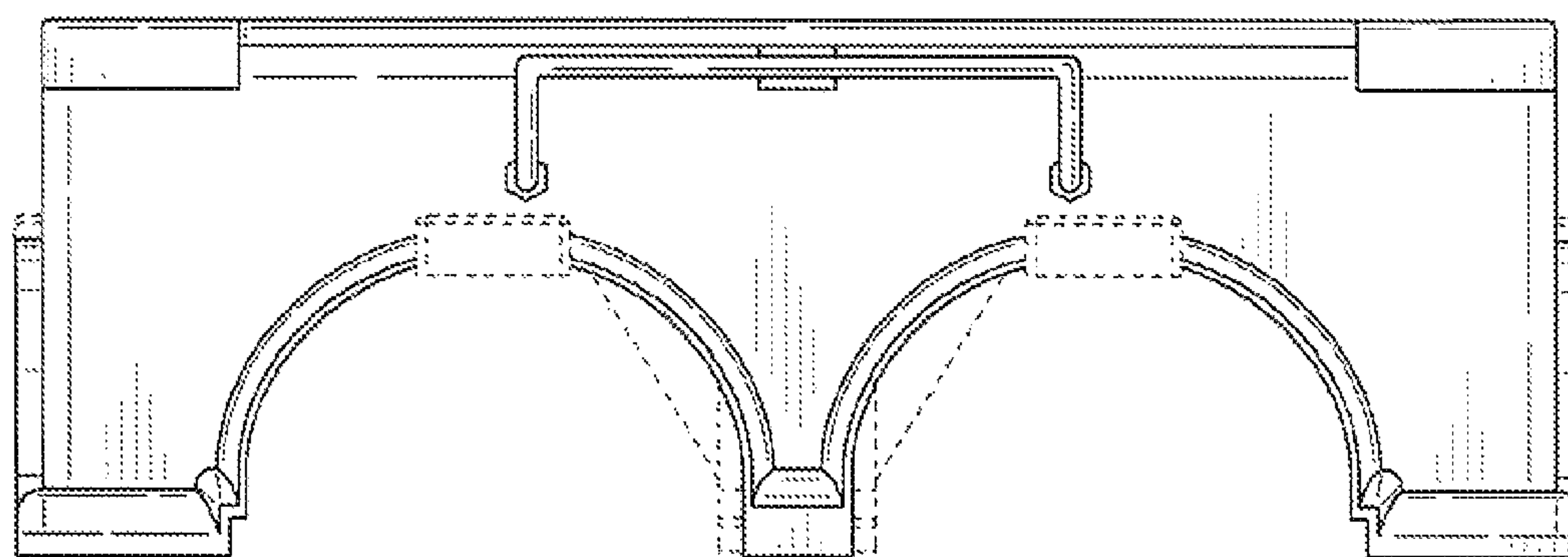

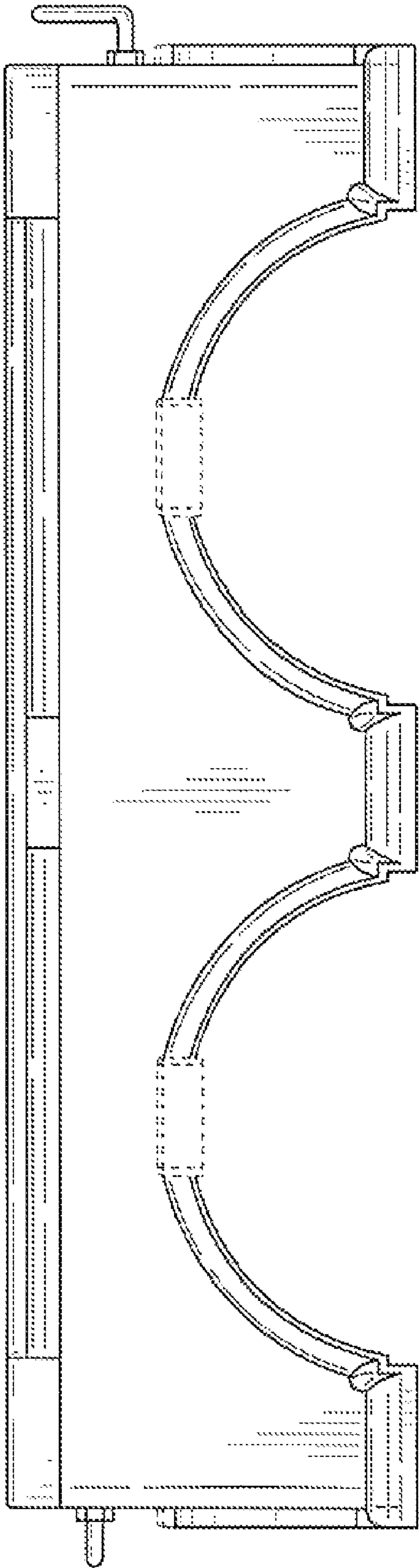

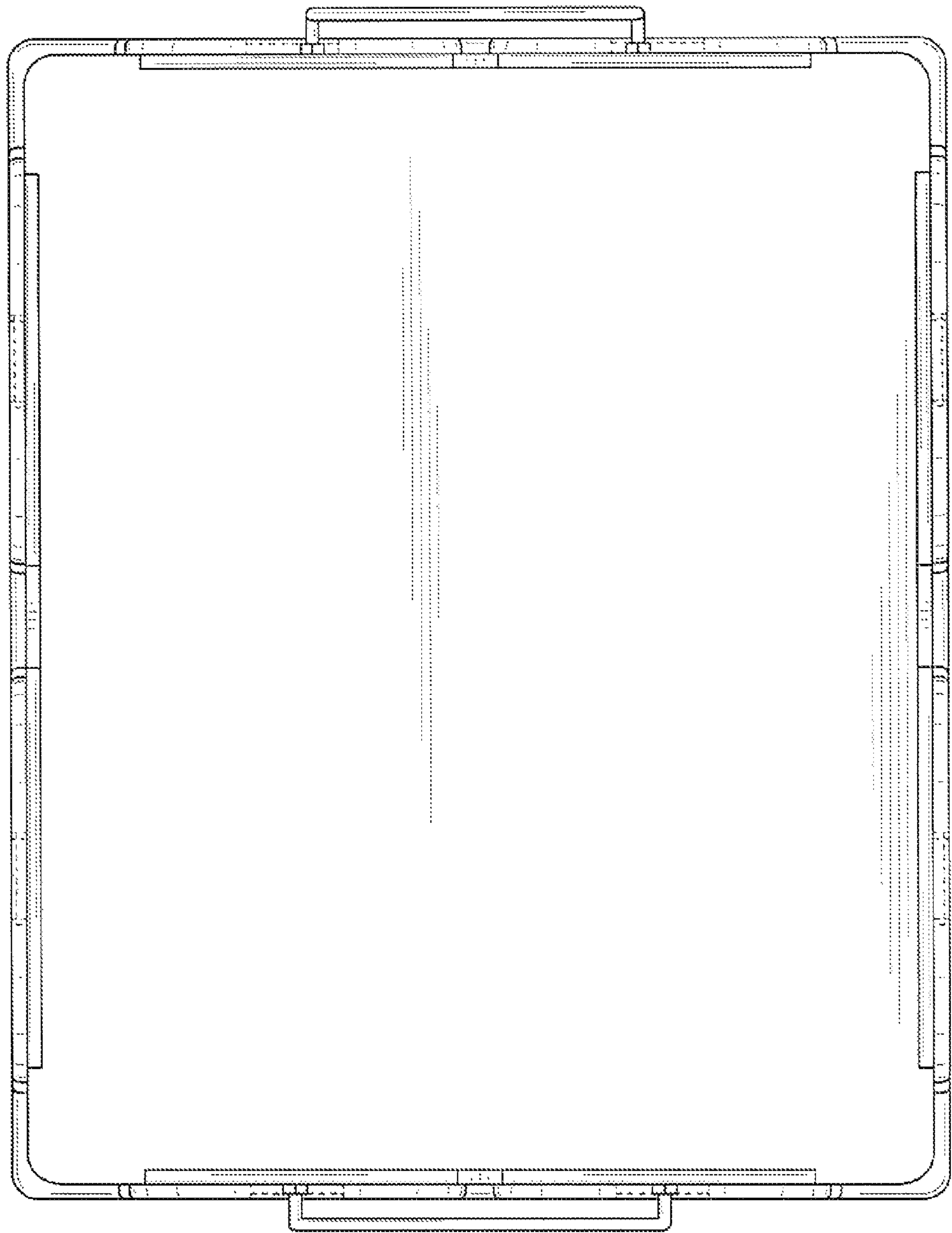

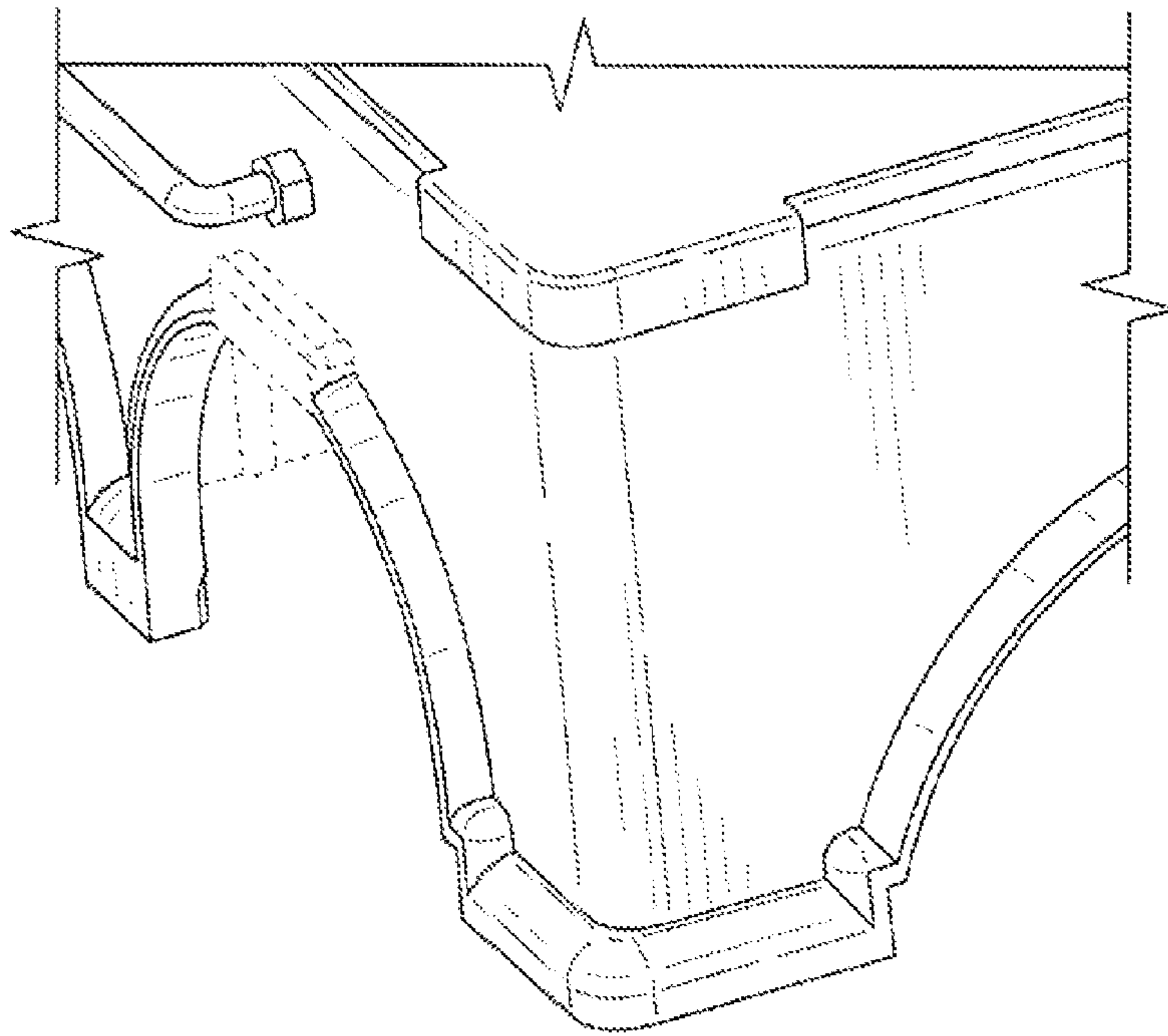
