FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of a truck body showing our new design;

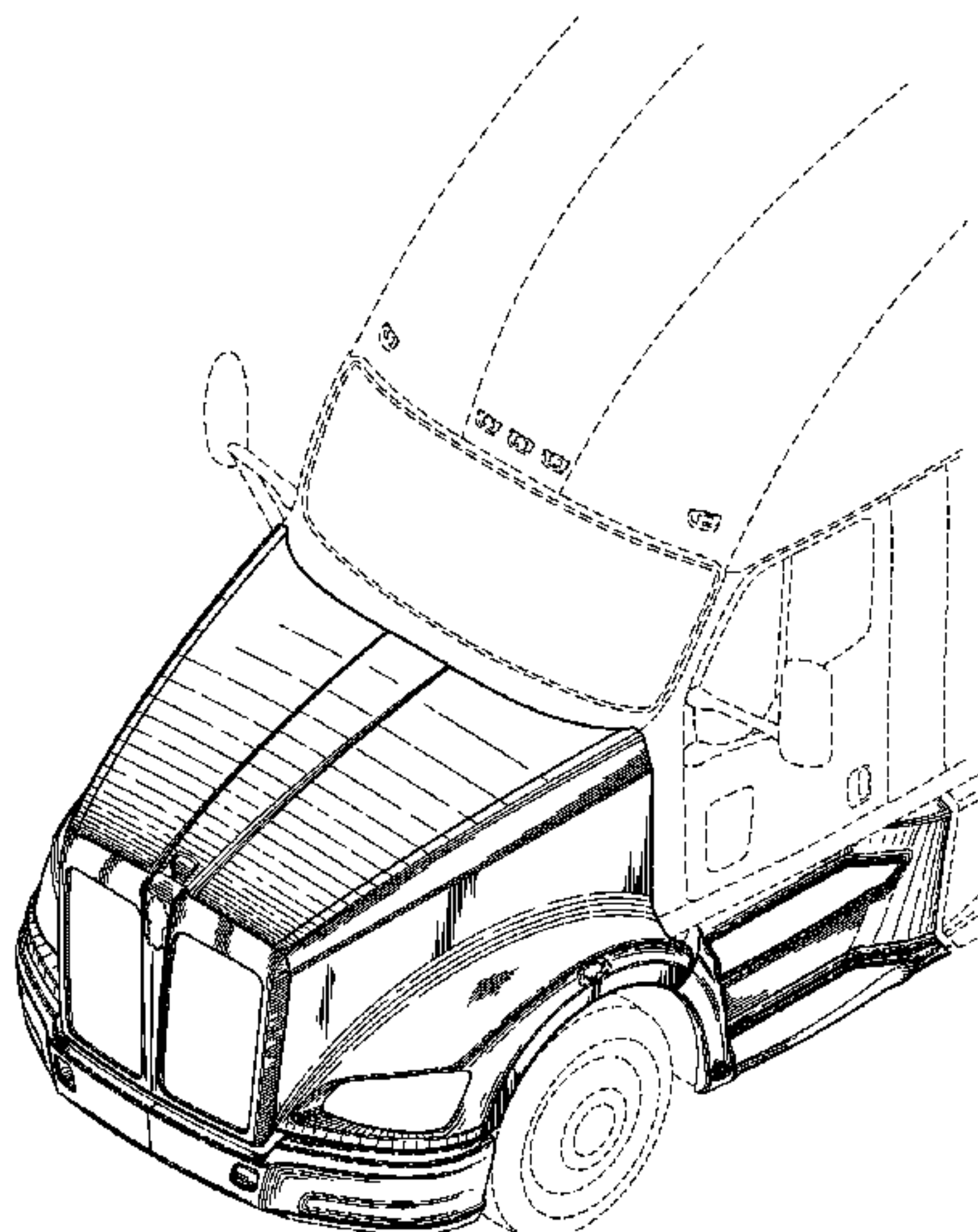
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the truck body of FIG. 1;

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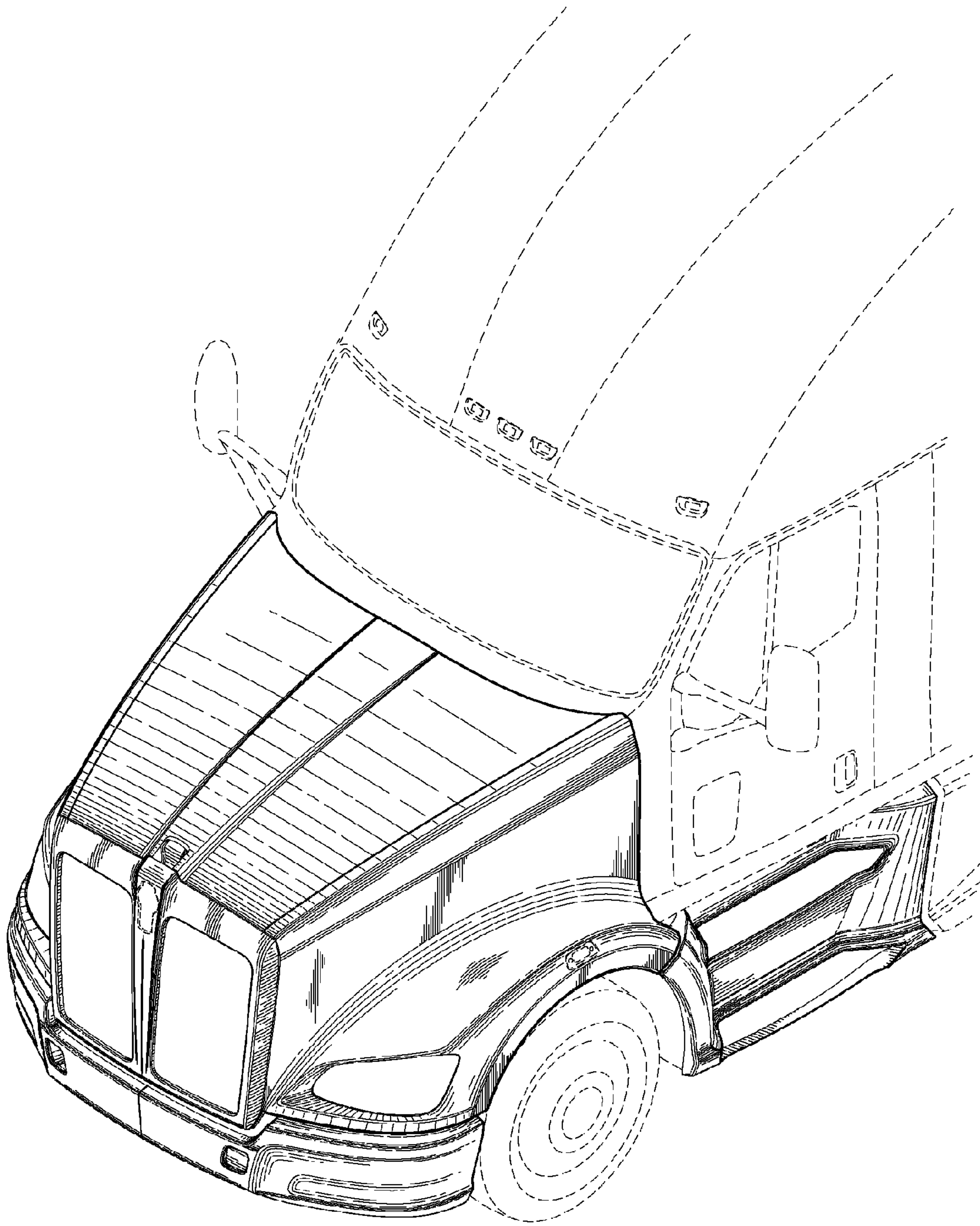

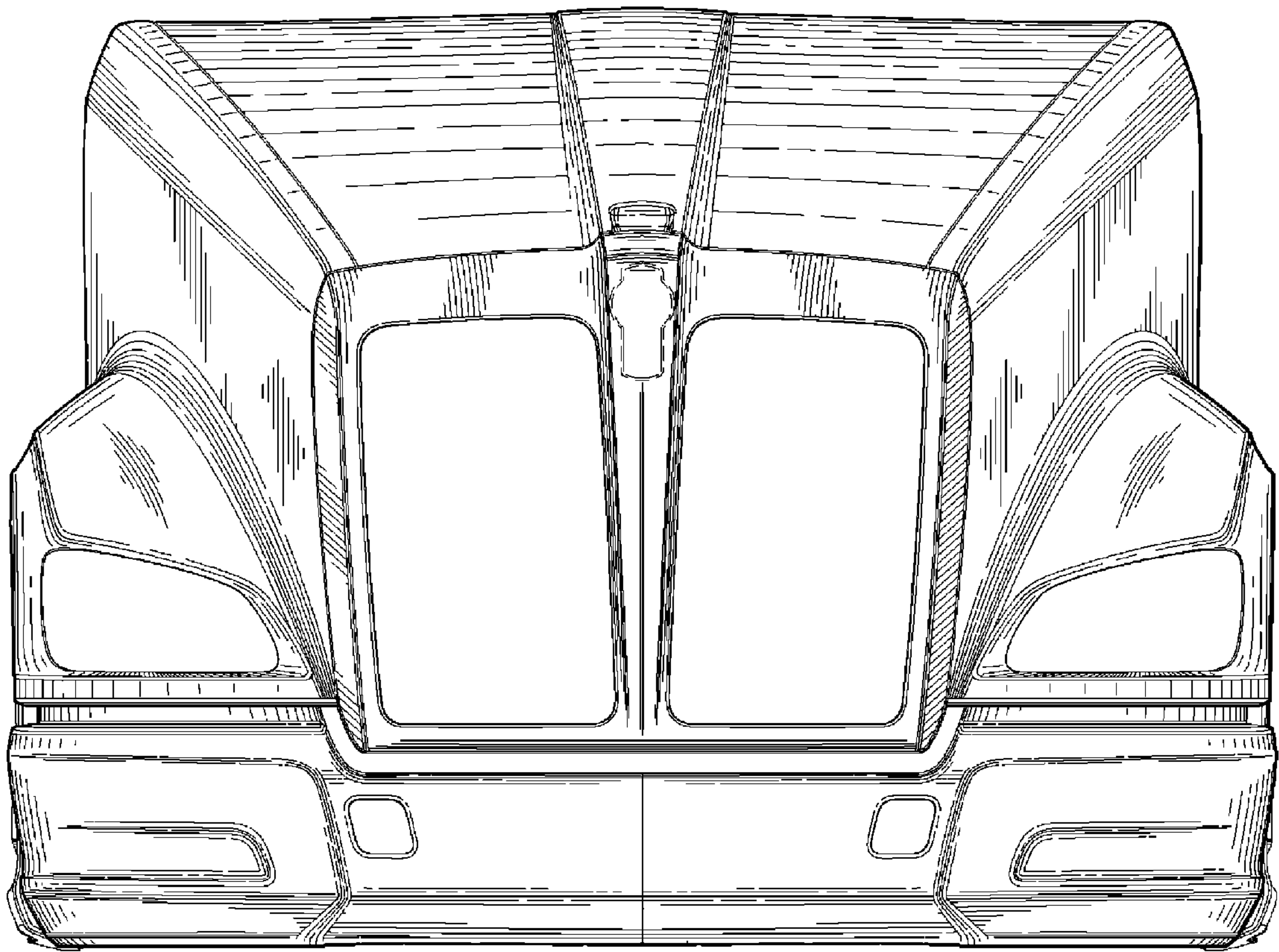

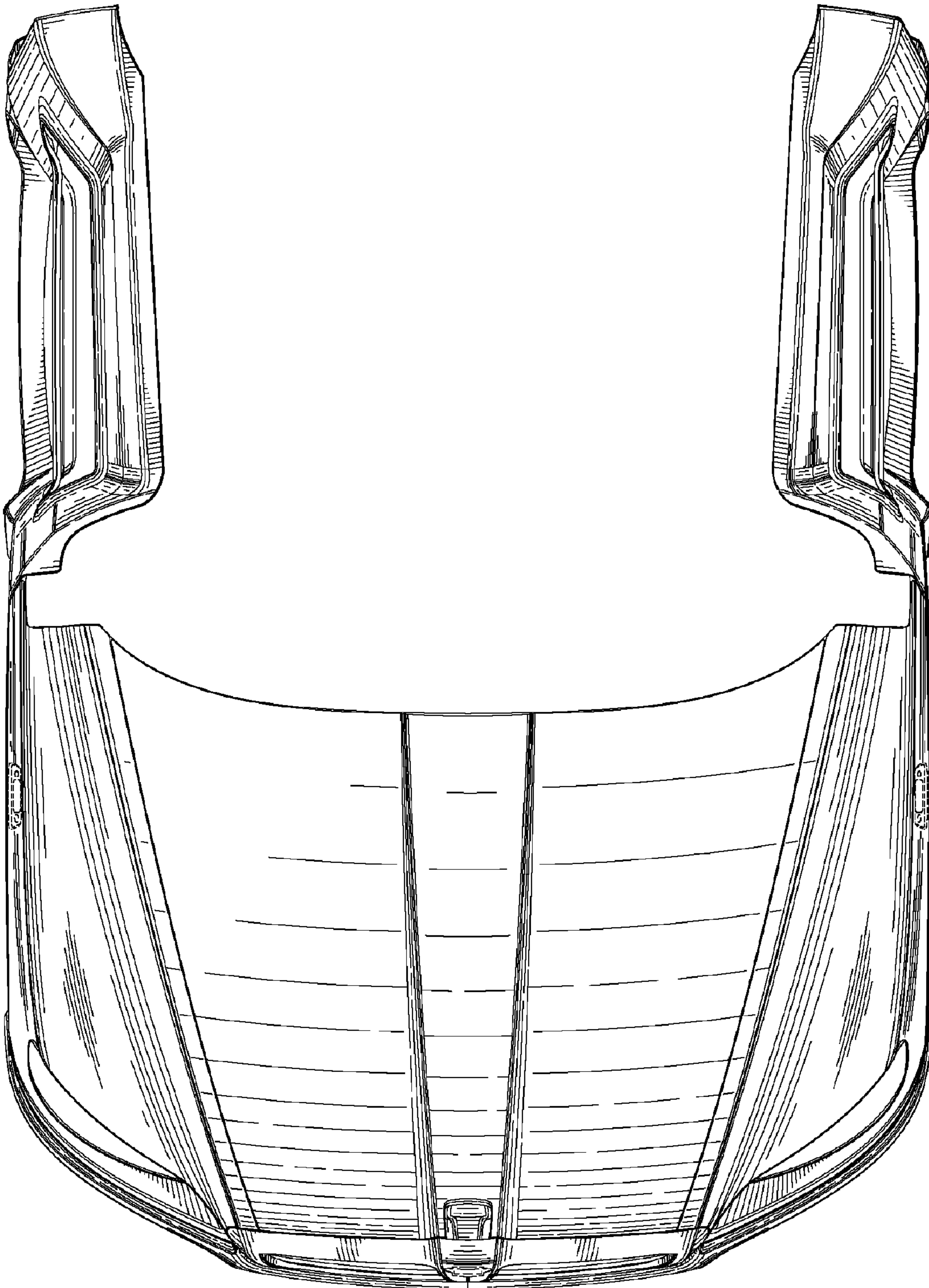
