(57) CLAIM

I claim the ornamental design for sports themed lingerie, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective of a sports themed lingerie, shown in the closed condition;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, shown in the opened condition;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a sports themed lingerie, shown in the closed condition;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof, shown in the opened condition;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof, shown in the closed condition;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the second embodiment, shown in the closed condition;

FIG. 8 is a left elevational view of FIG. 1, shown in the closed condition, whereas the right side elevational view is a mirror image;

FIG. 9 is a left elevational view of the second embodiment, shown in the closed condition, whereas the right side elevational view is a mirror image;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 1, shown in the closed condition;


FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the second embodiment, shown in the closed condition;


FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1, shown in the closed condition; and,
