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(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a lighting fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 shows a bottom perspective view of a lighting fixture of the invention.

FIG. 2 shows a cross section elevation view of the lighting fixture, taken through line 2—2 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 shows a cross section elevation view of the lighting fixture, taken through line 3—3 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 shows a bottom view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 shows a front elevation view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1, where the rear elevation view is identical thereto.

FIG. 6 shows a right side elevation view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1, where the left side elevation view is identical thereto.

FIG. 7 shows a top view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 shows a bottom perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the lighting fixture design.

FIG. 9 shows a cross section elevation view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 8, taken through line 9—9 of FIG. 8.

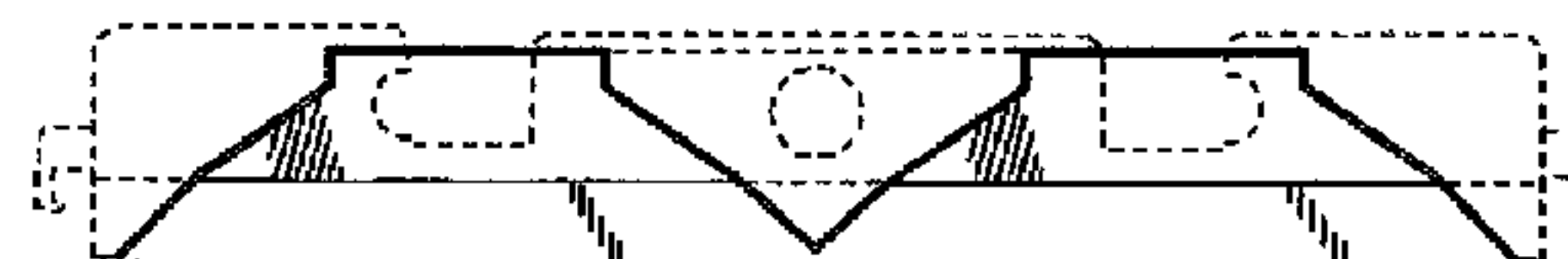
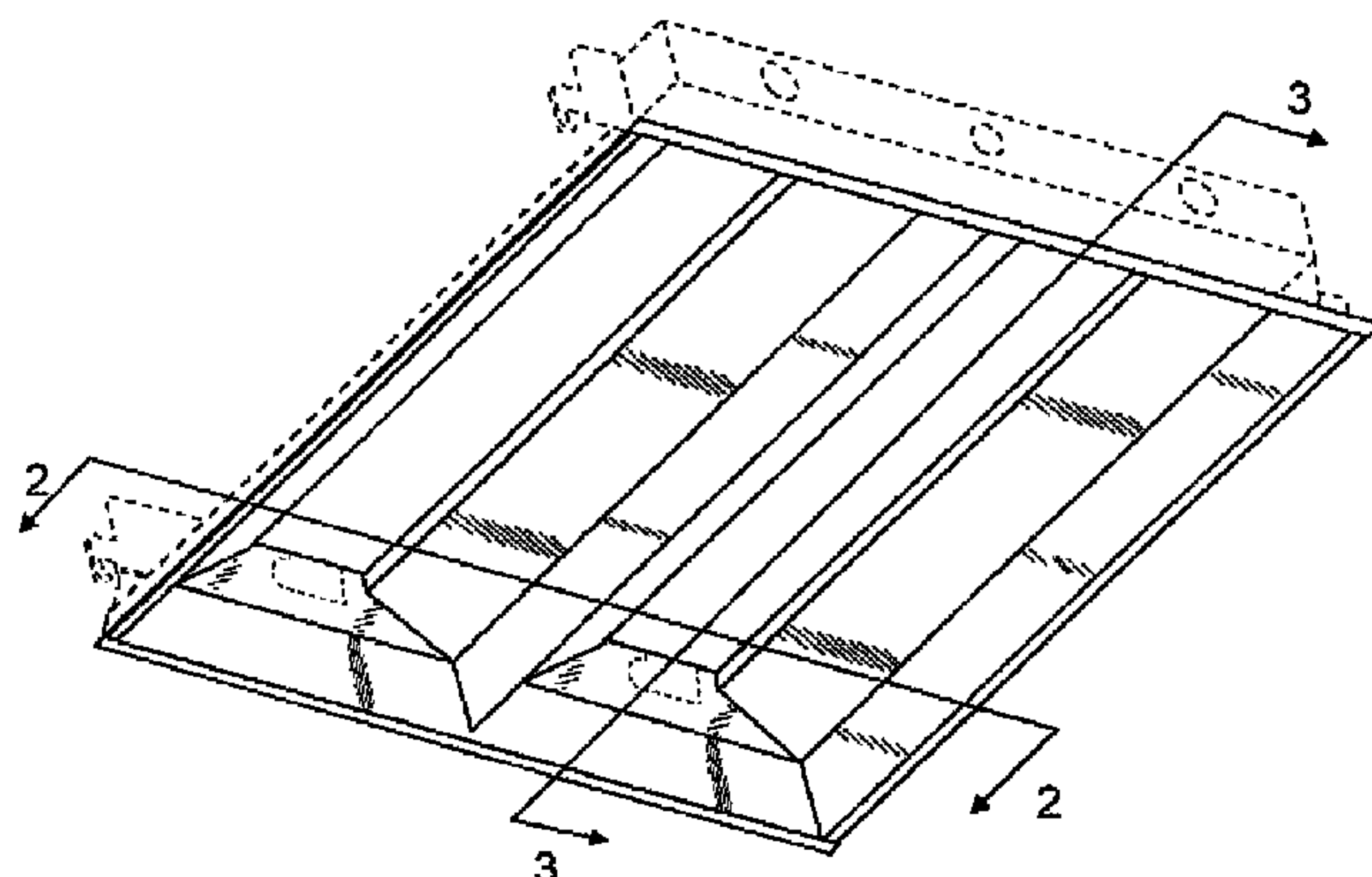
FIG. 10 shows a bottom perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the lighting fixture design.

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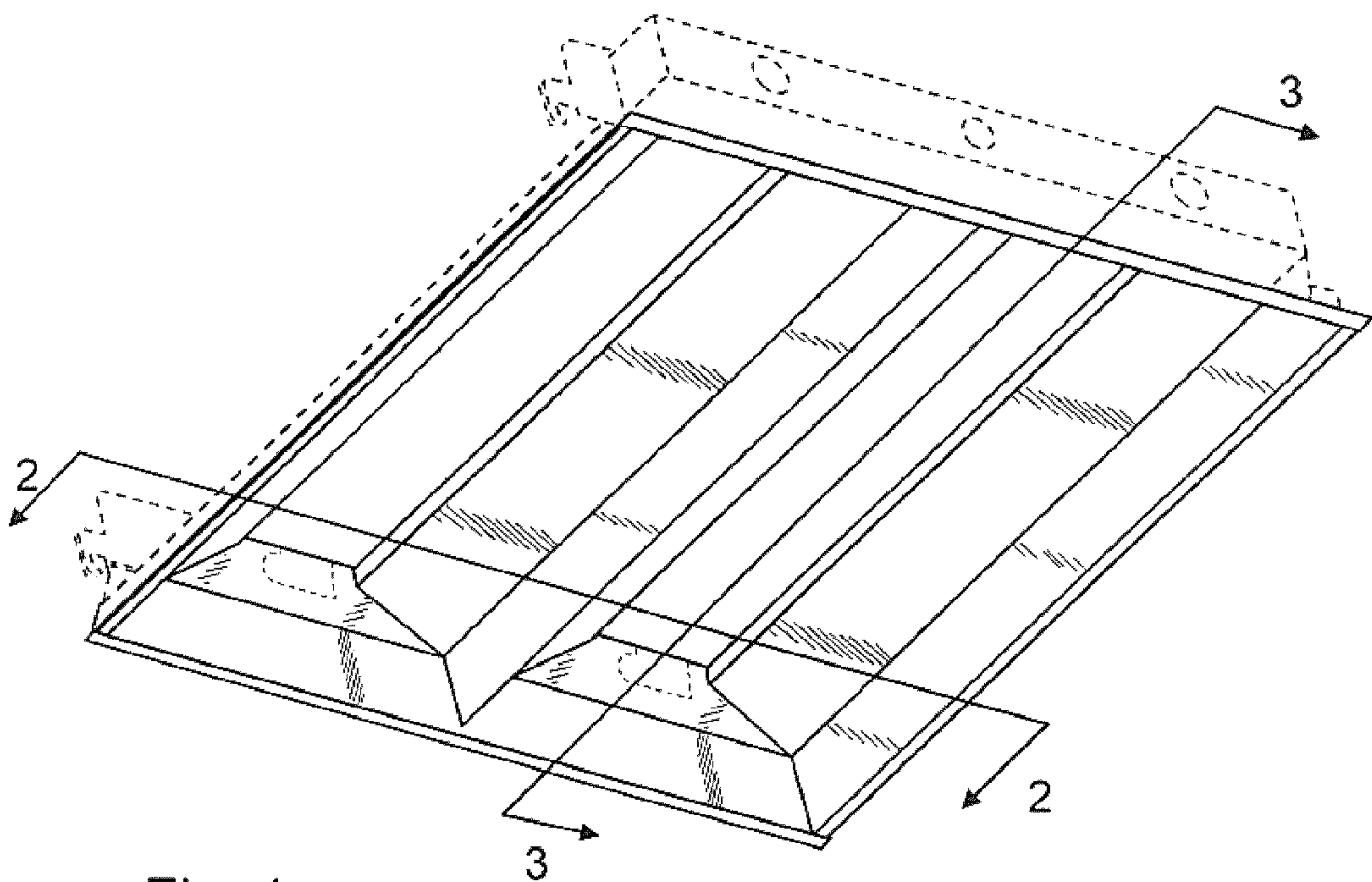

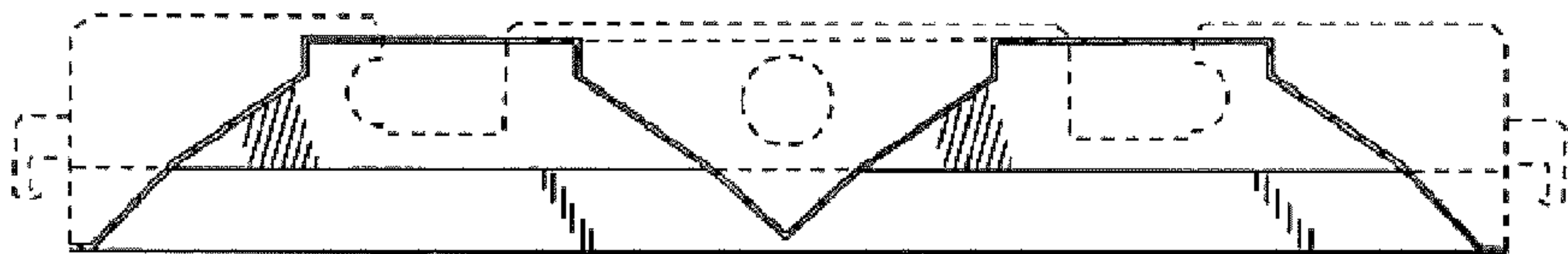

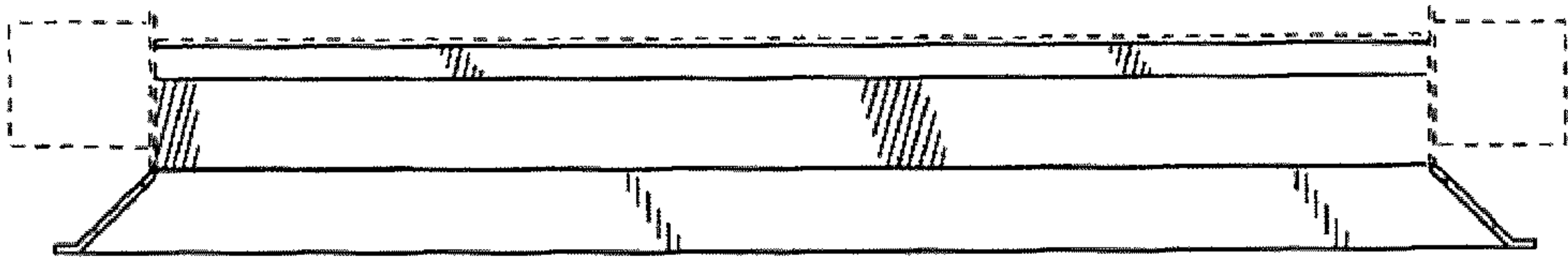

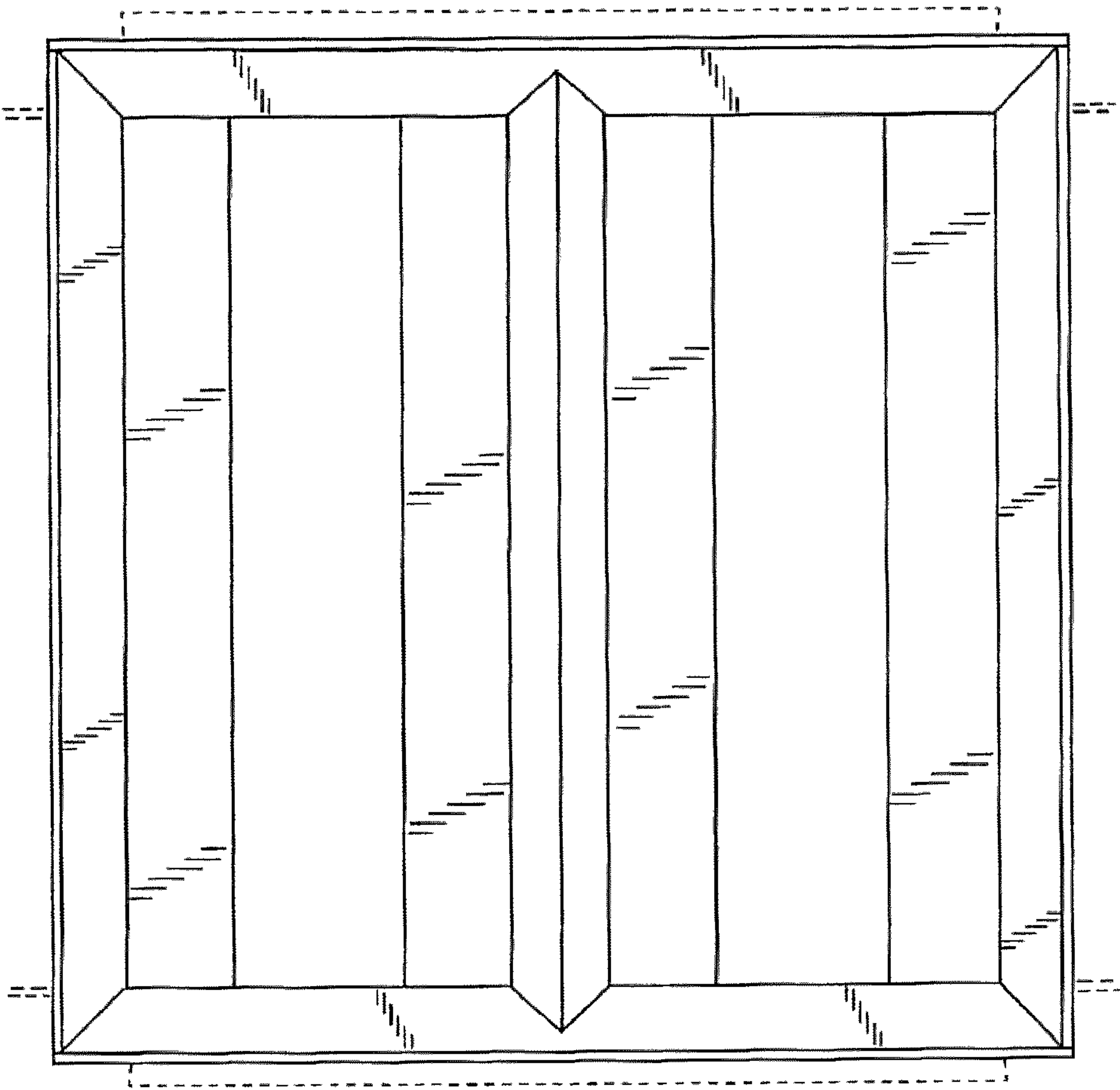

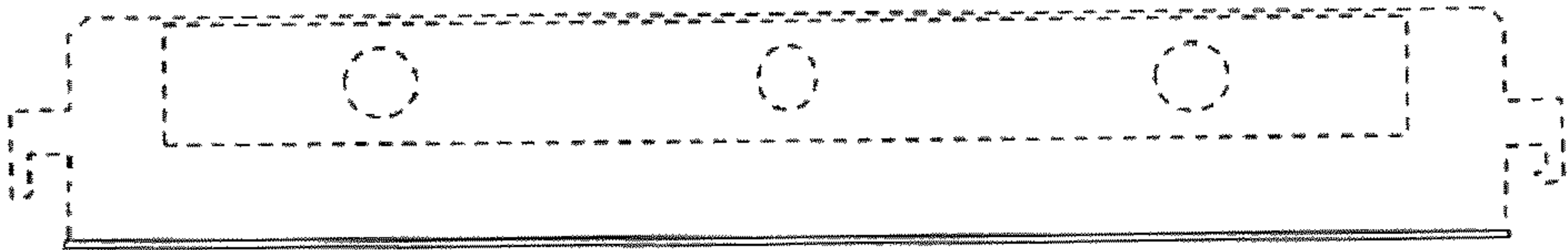

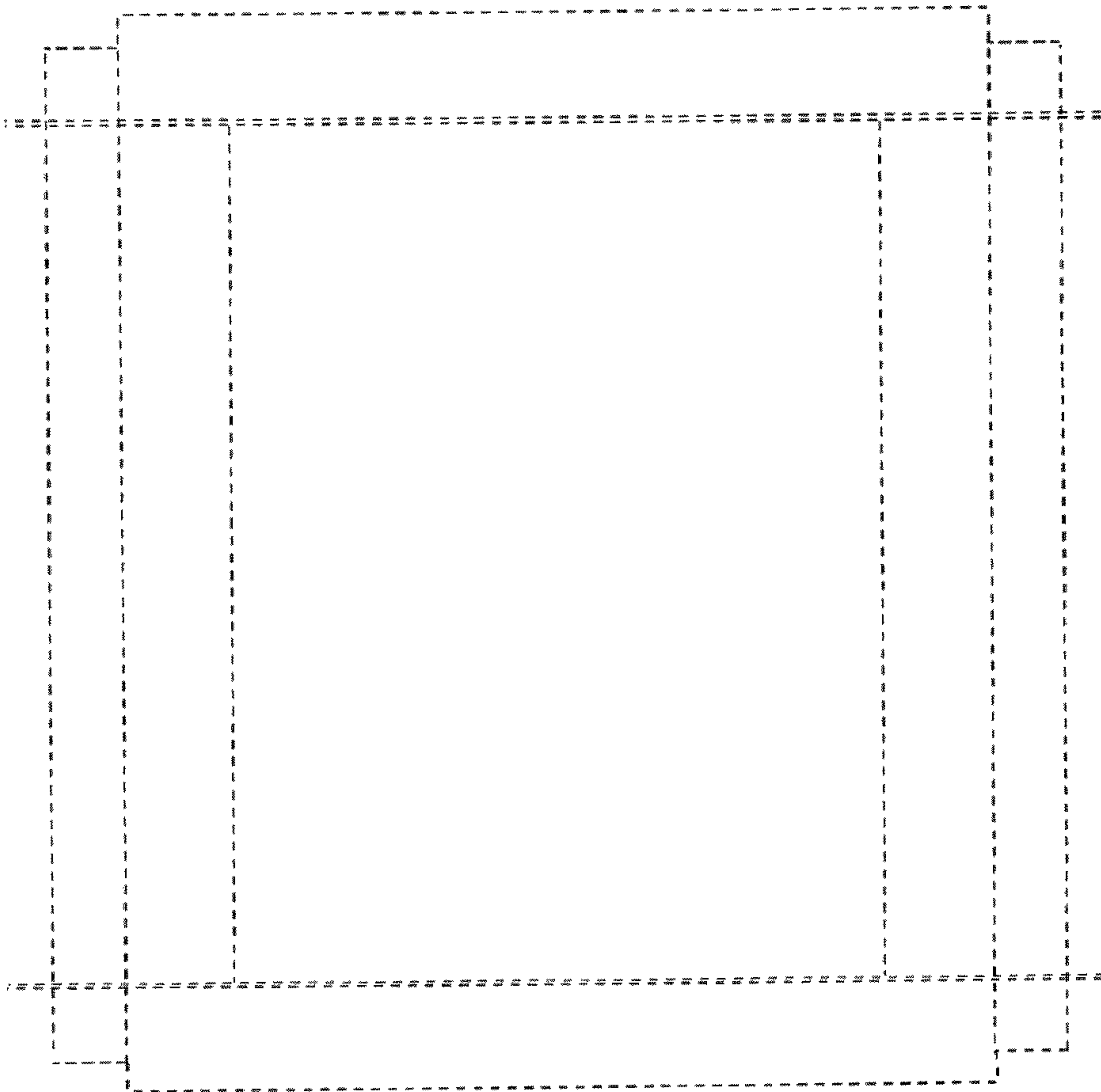
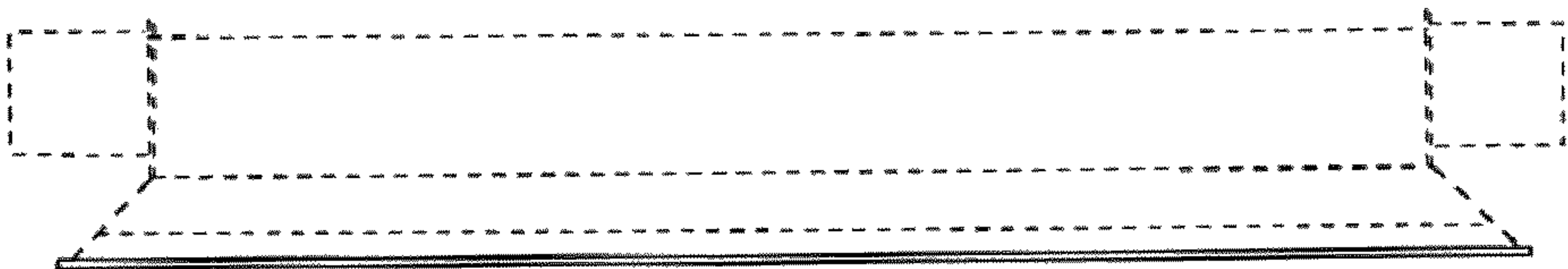

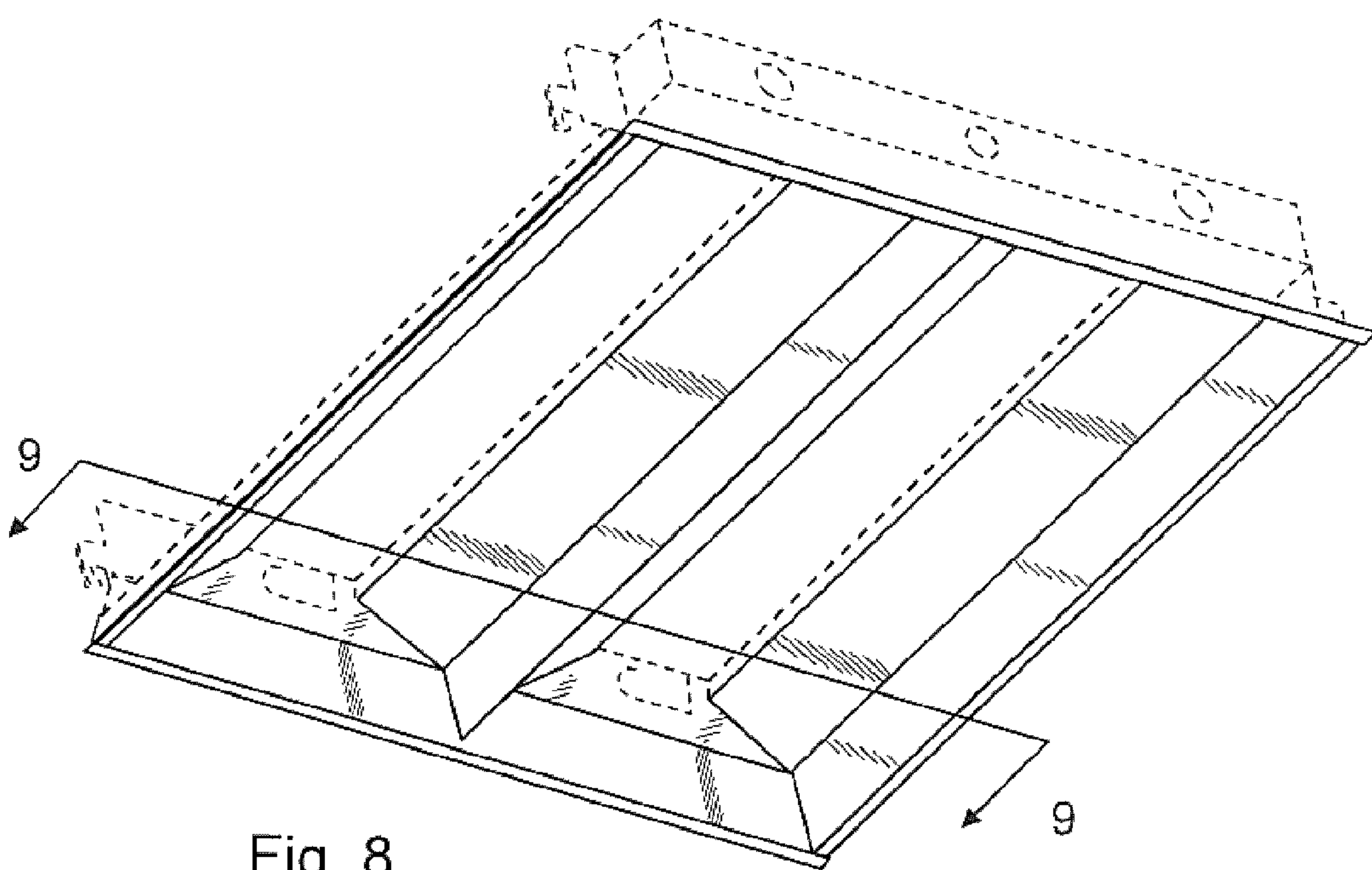

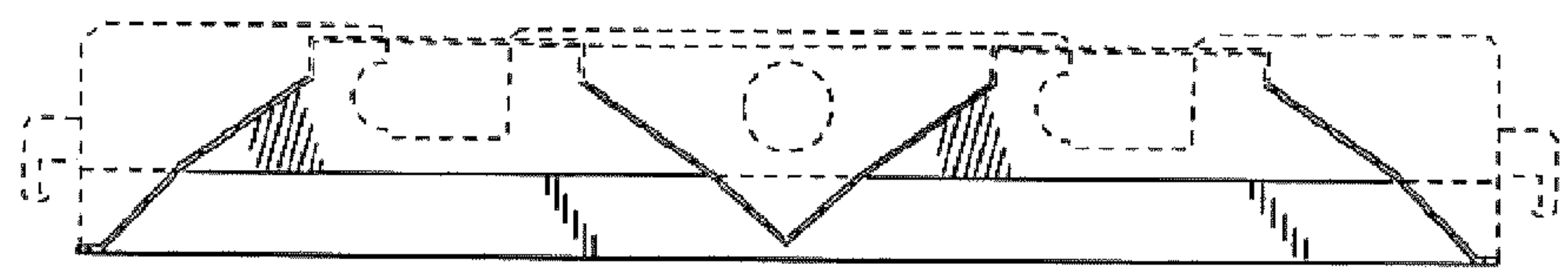

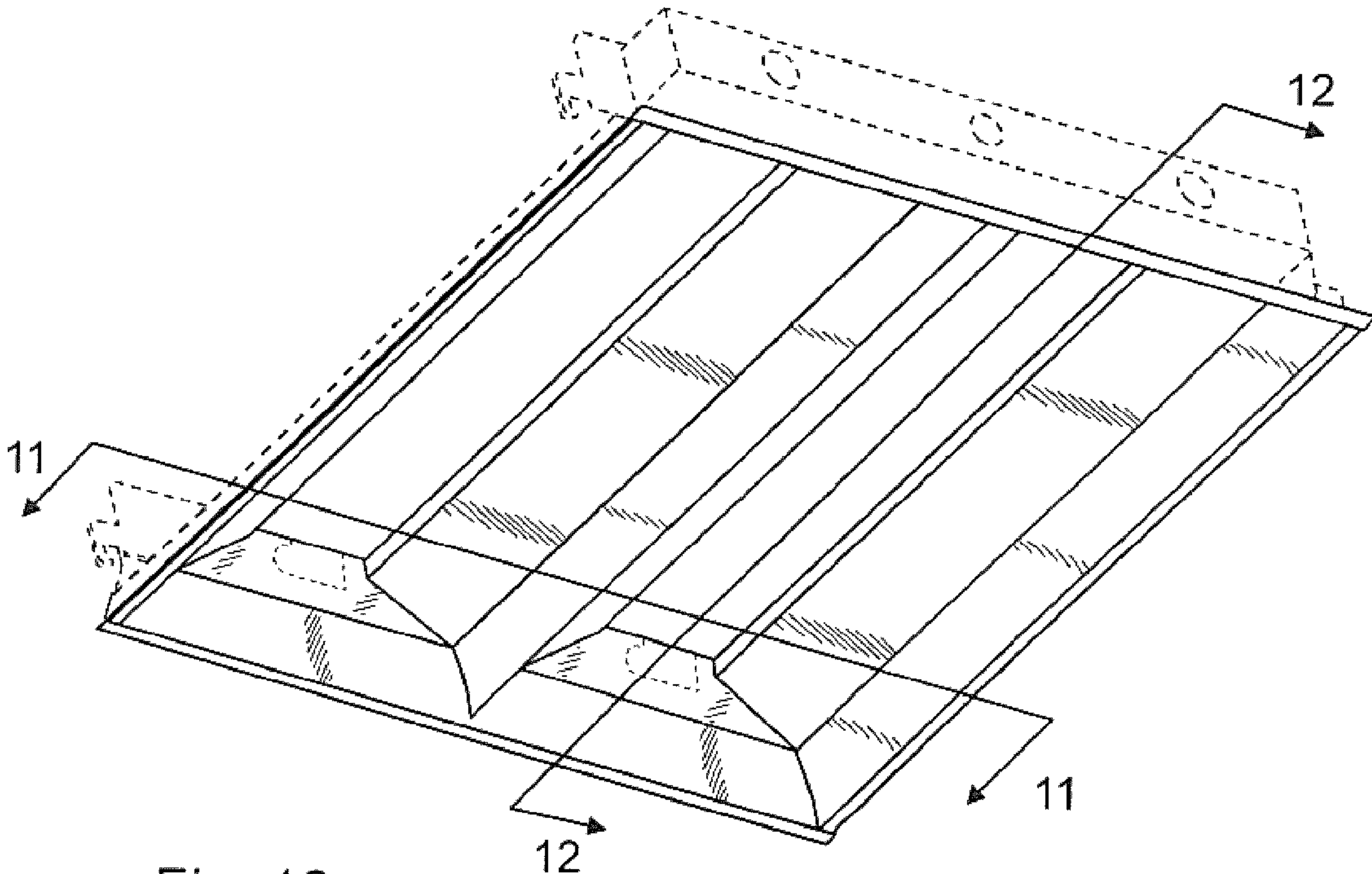

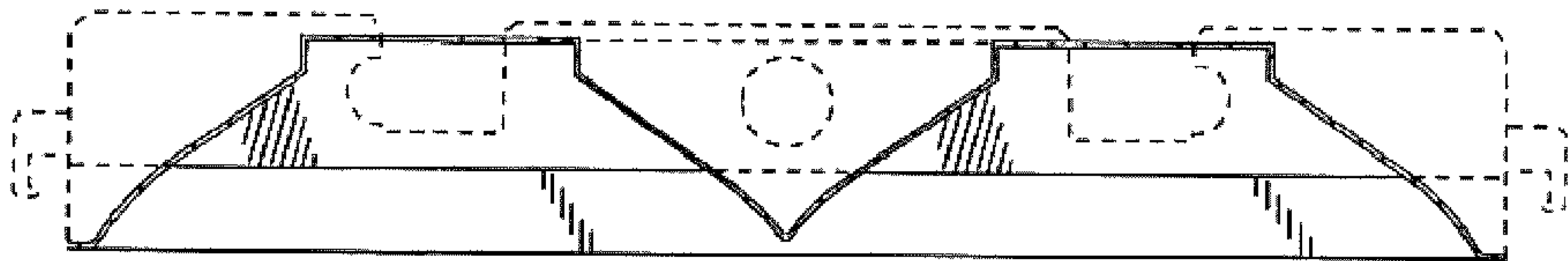

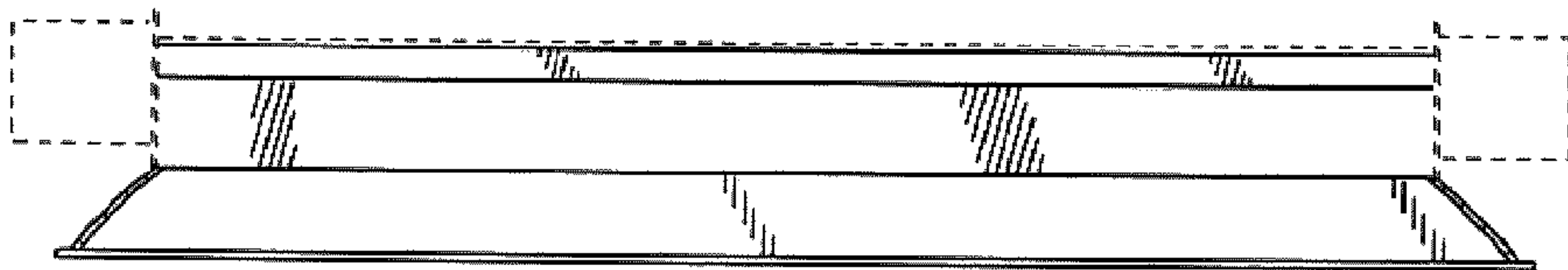
