DESCRIPTION

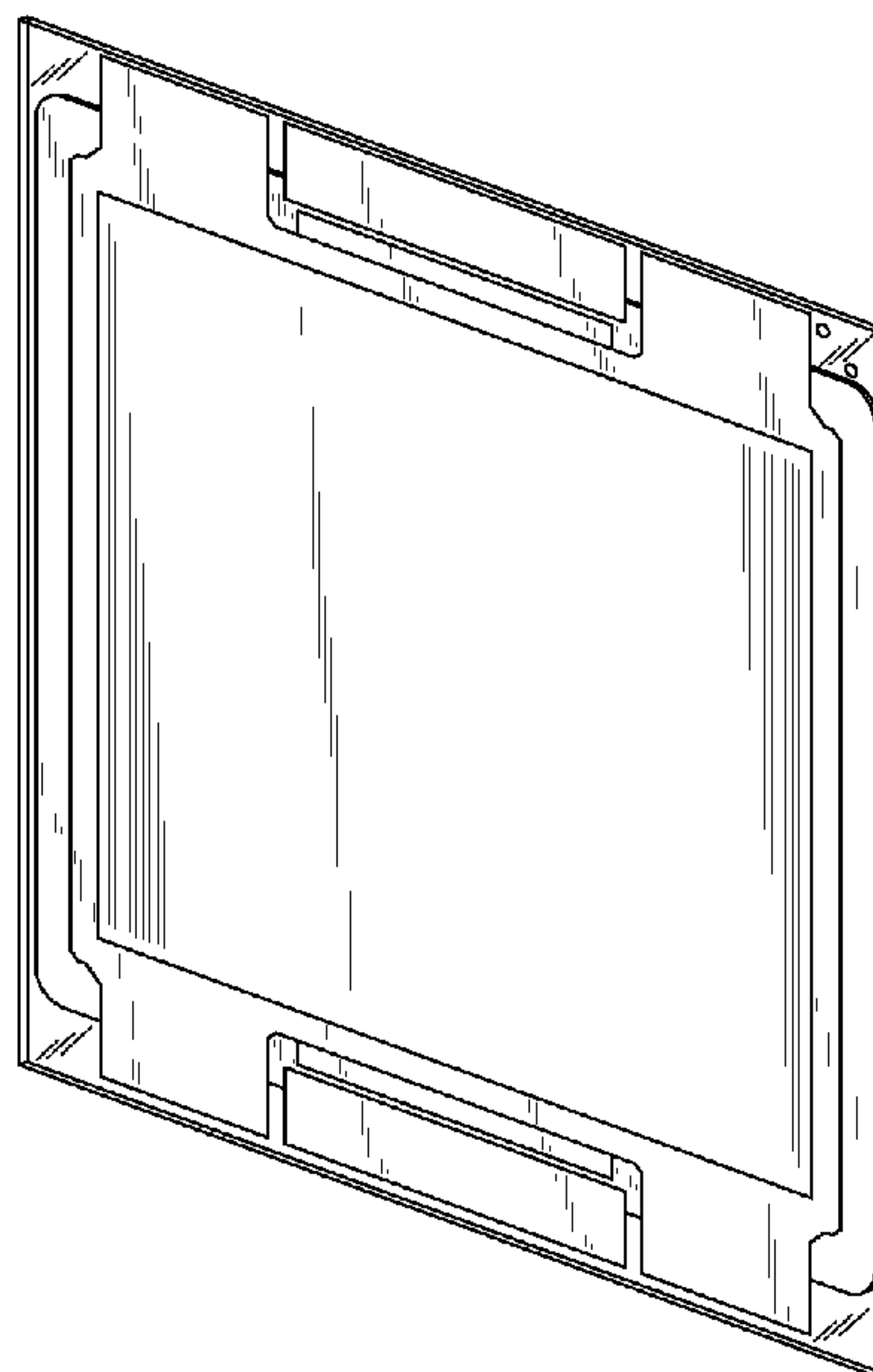

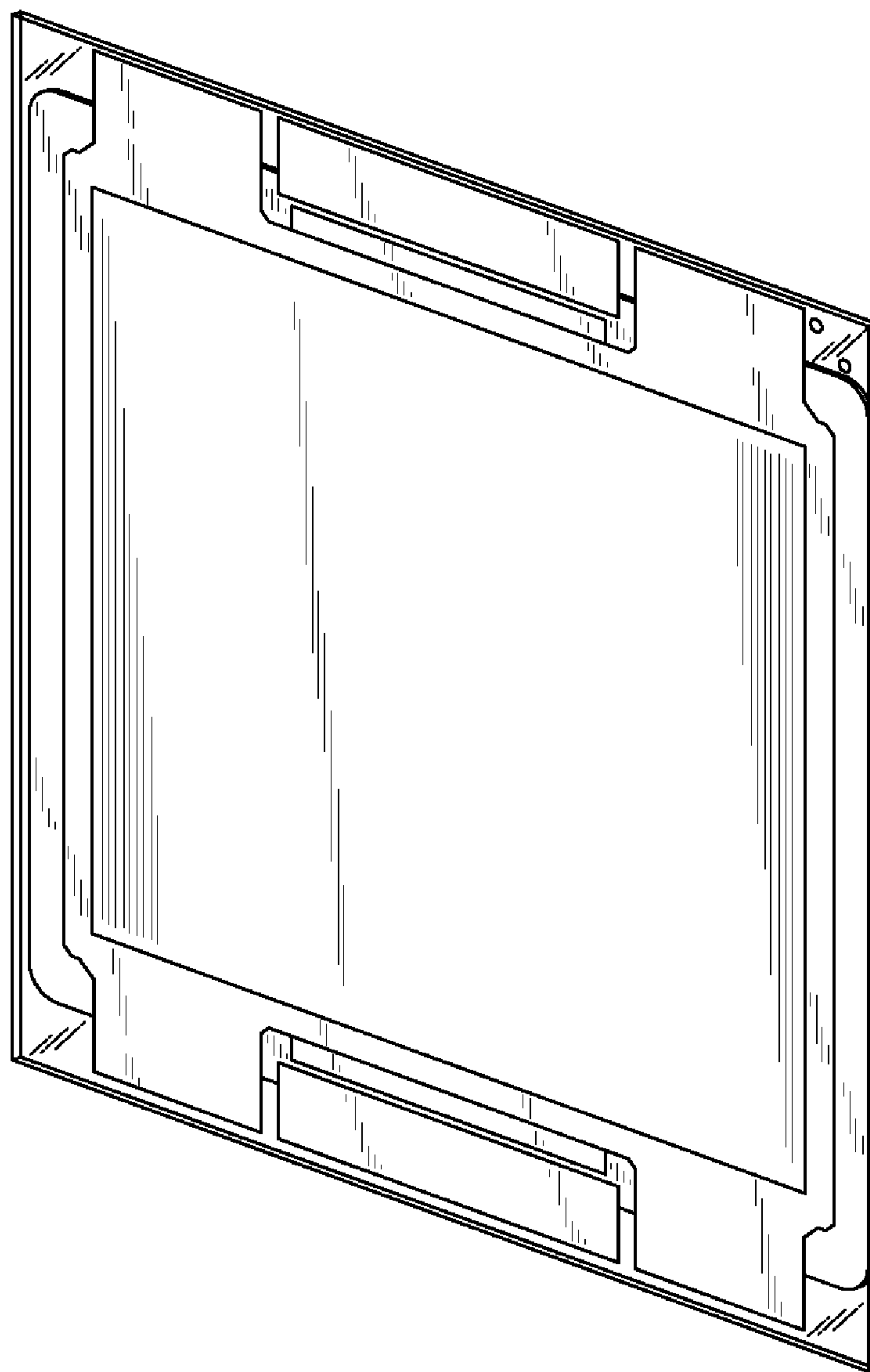

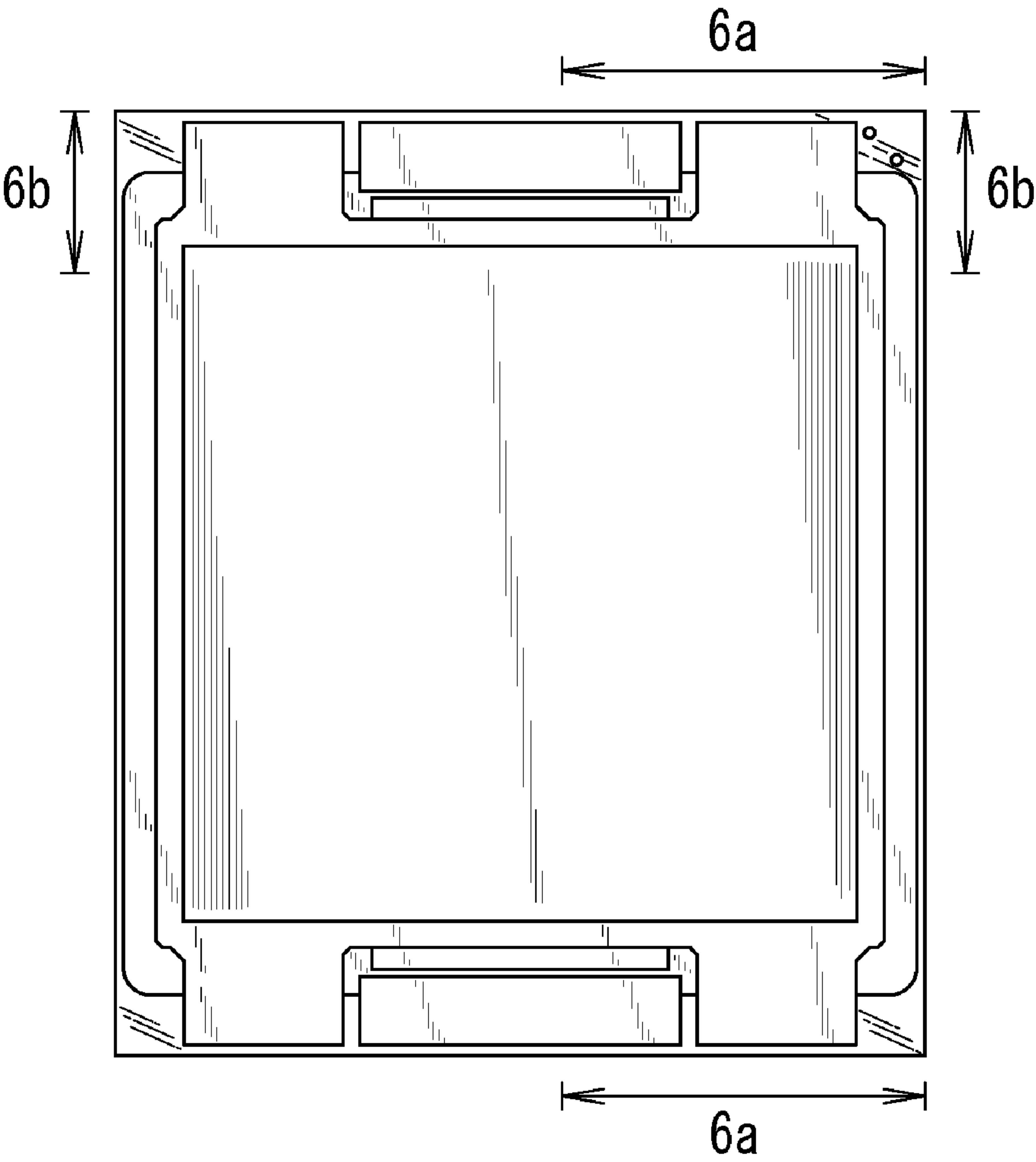

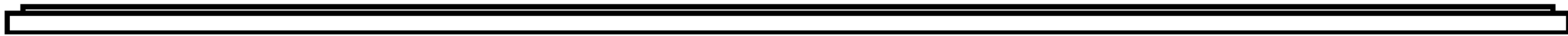

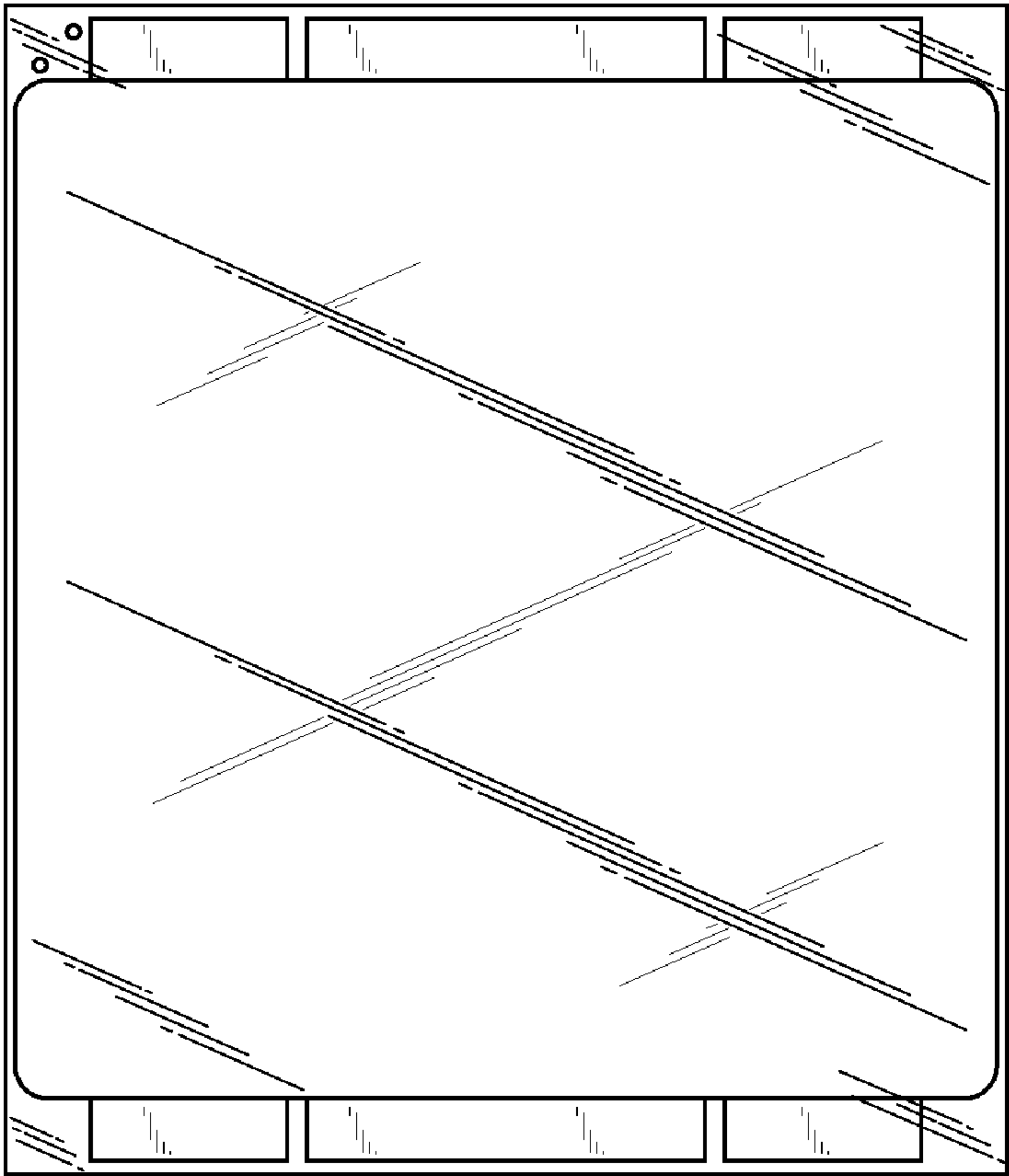
