(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an egg cradle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my ornamental design for an egg cradle;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the cradle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation of the egg cradle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the cradle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 5—5 in FIG. 4, the view showing the environmental elements of a toothpick in holder aperture and a support bar extending in another aperture;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the cradle shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the egg cradle shown in FIG. 1, the opposite side of which is a mirror image;

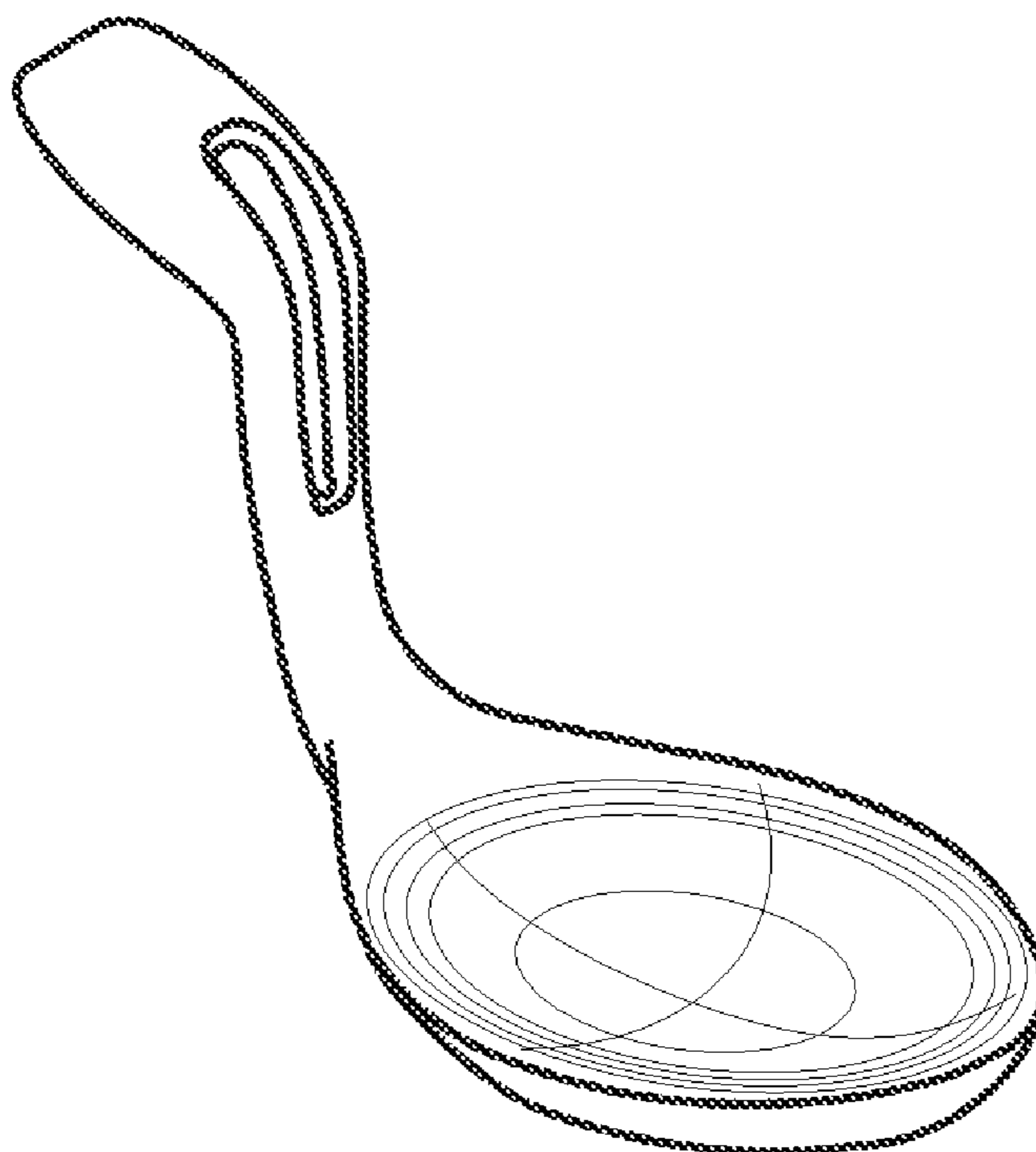
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the cradle shown in FIG. 1 with the addition of contour lines;

FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 9—9 in FIG. 8, the view showing the contour lines; and,

FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 10—10 in FIG. 8, the view showing the contour lines.

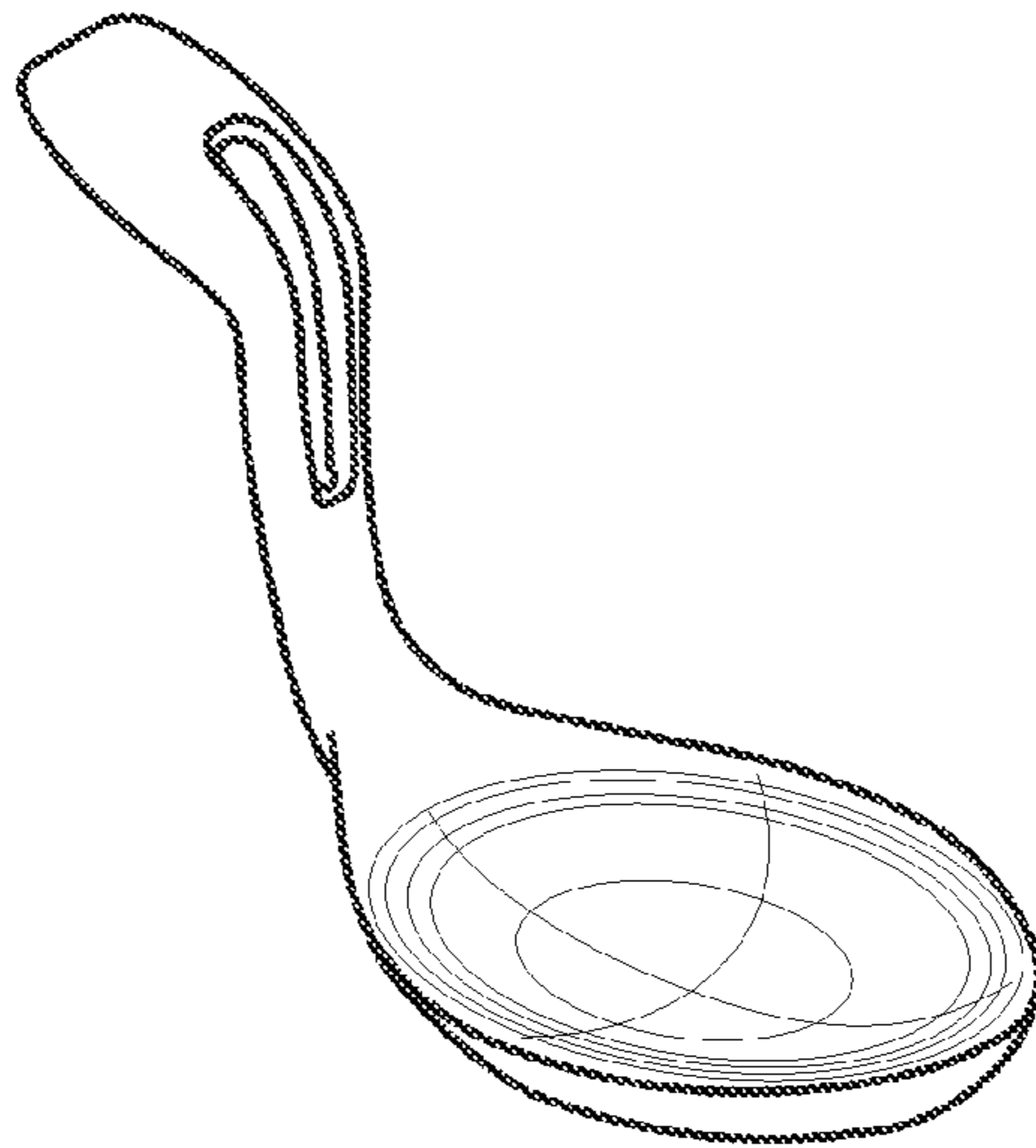

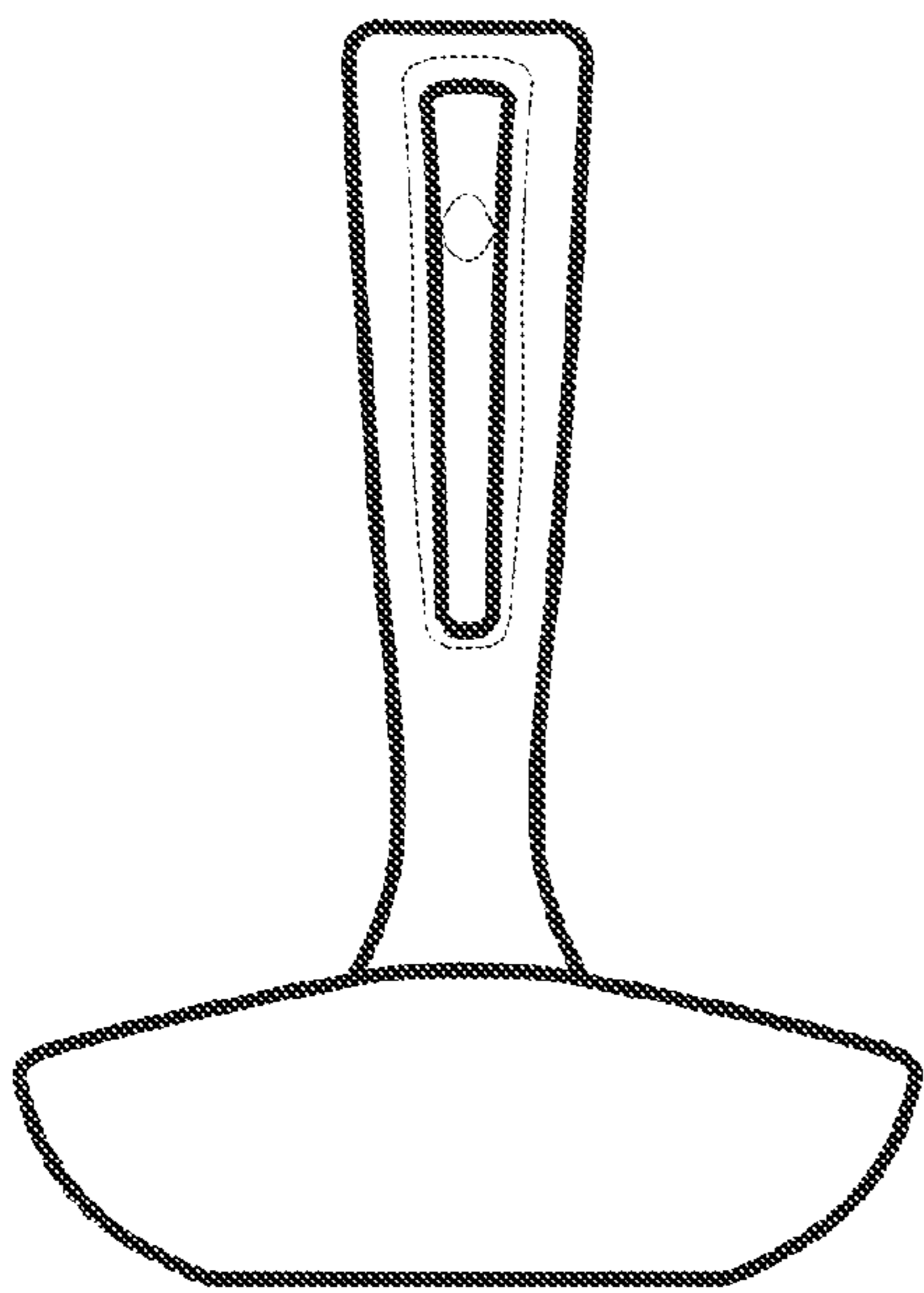

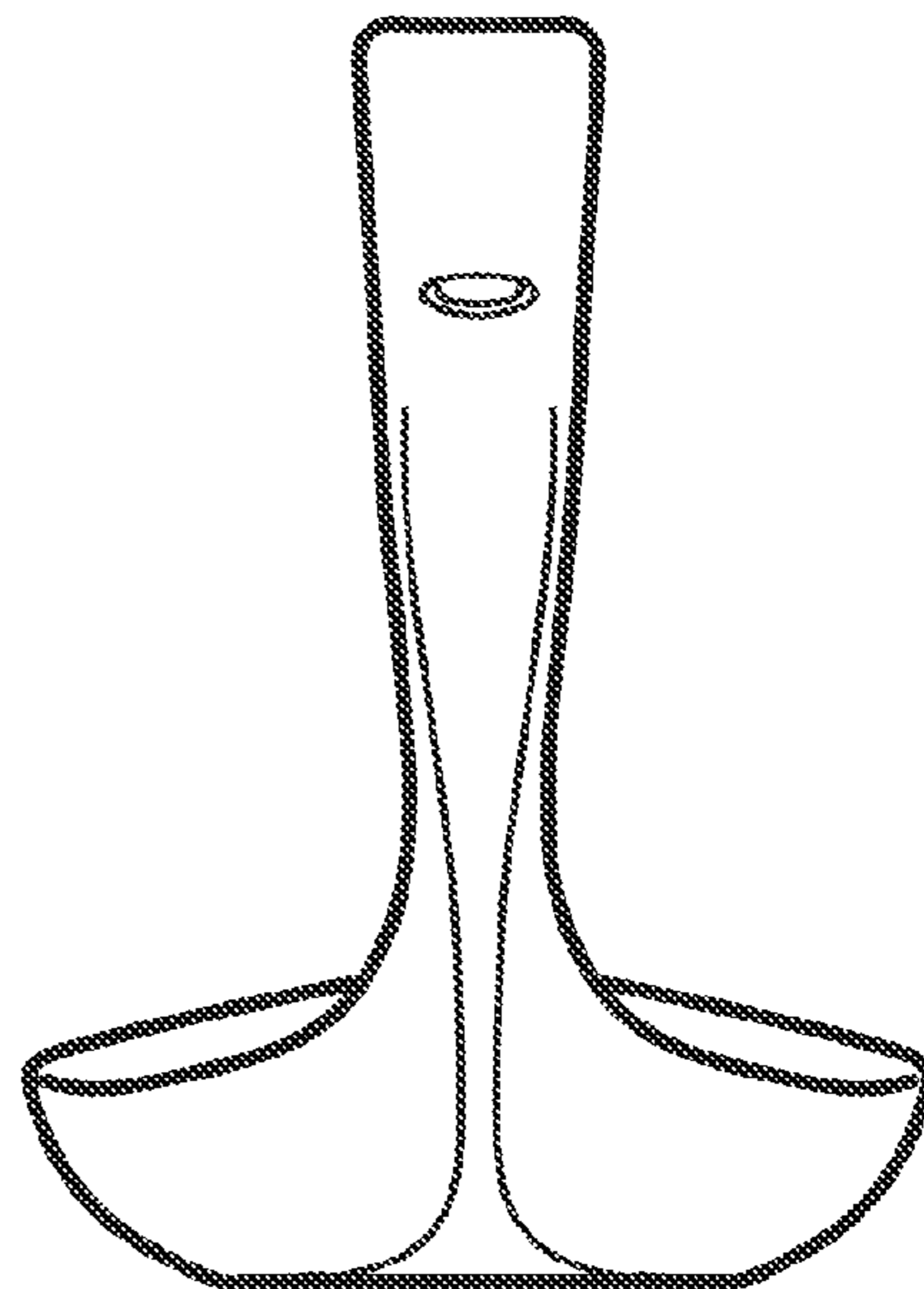

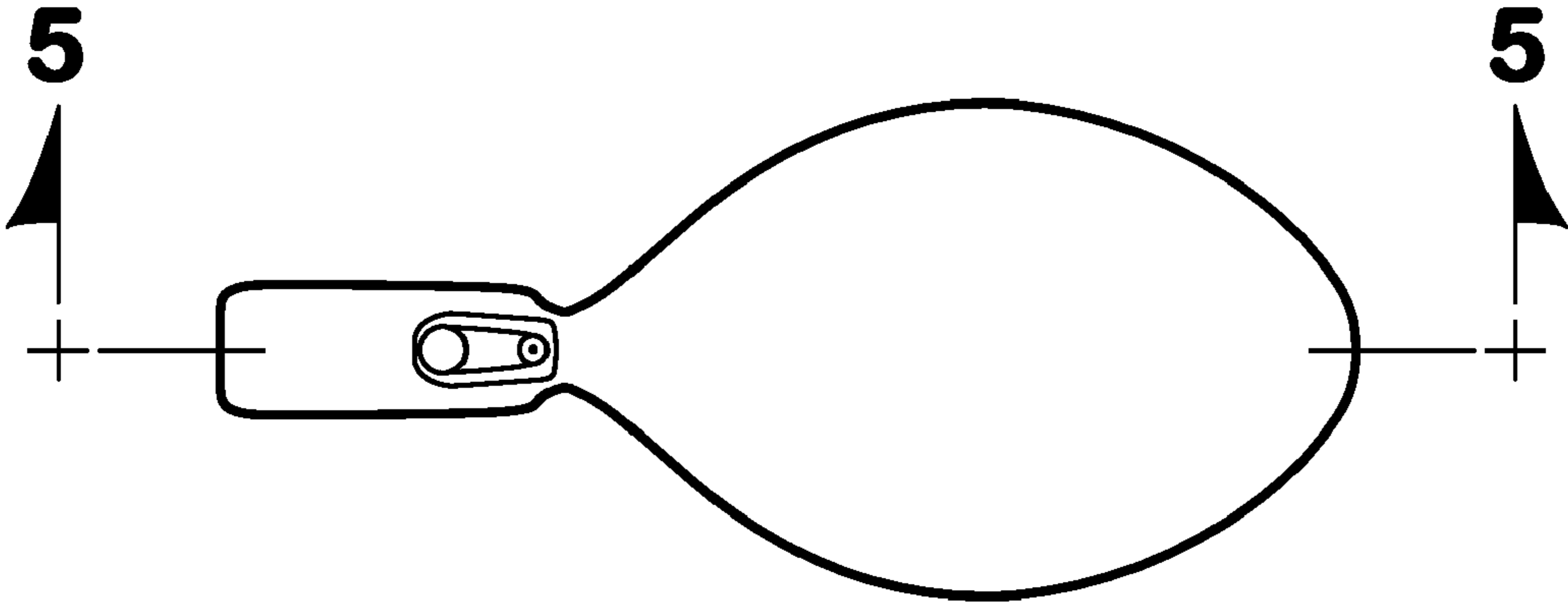

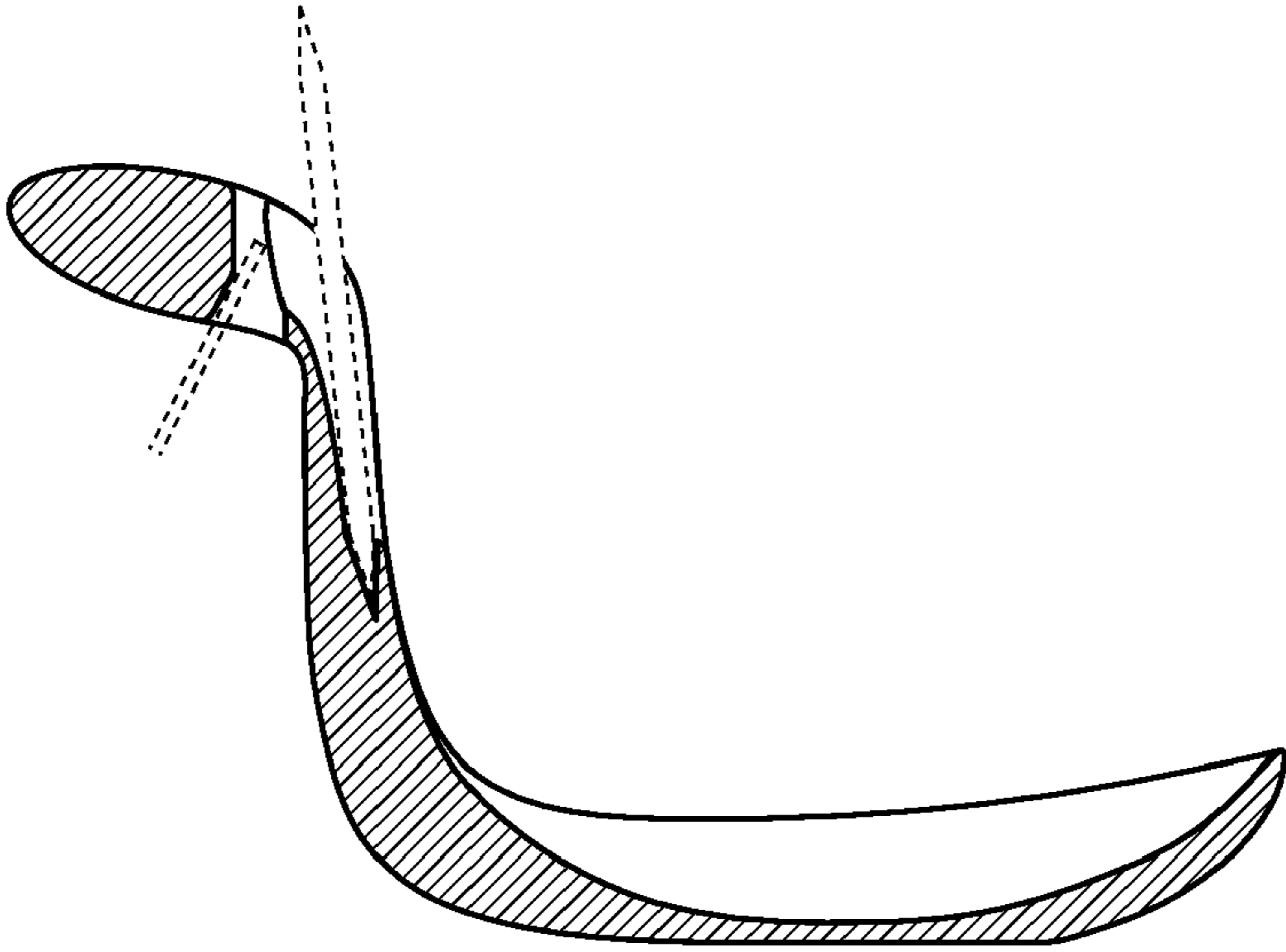

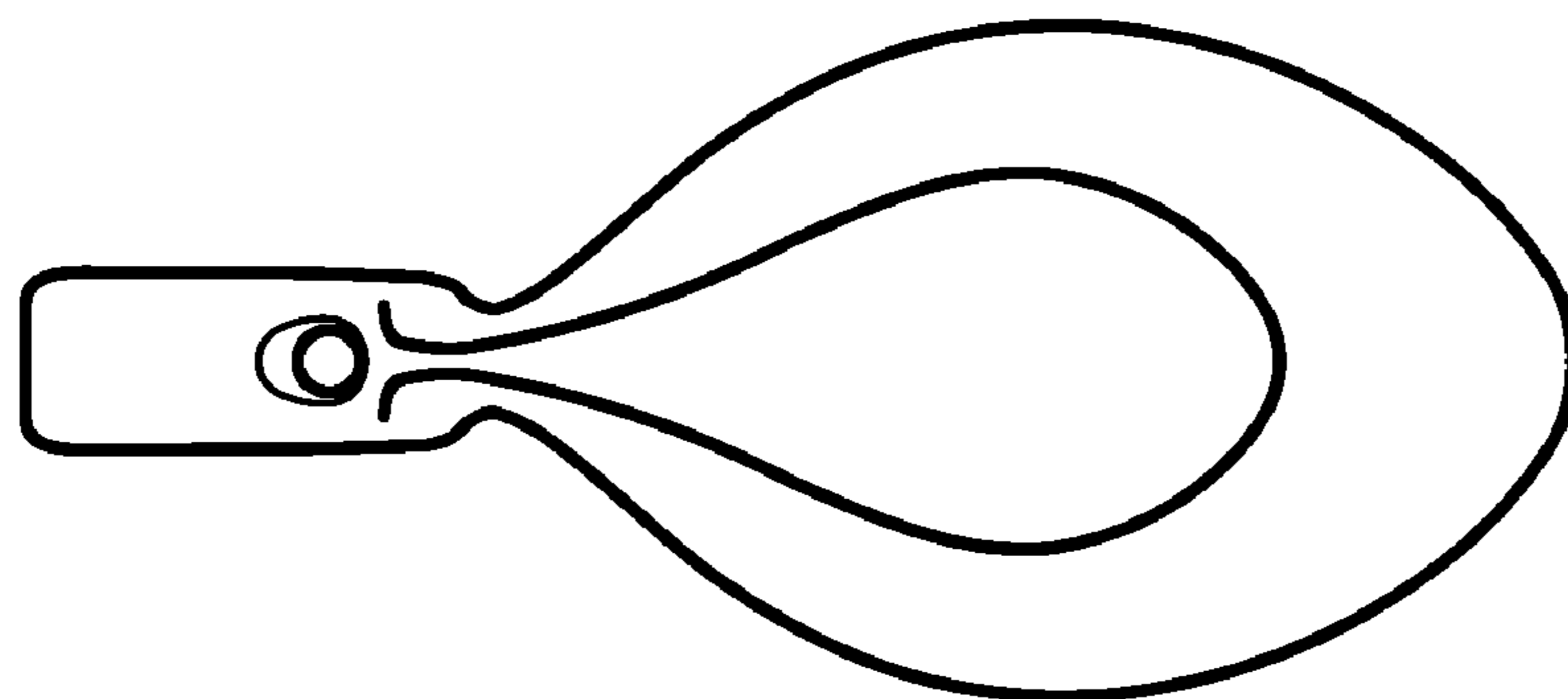

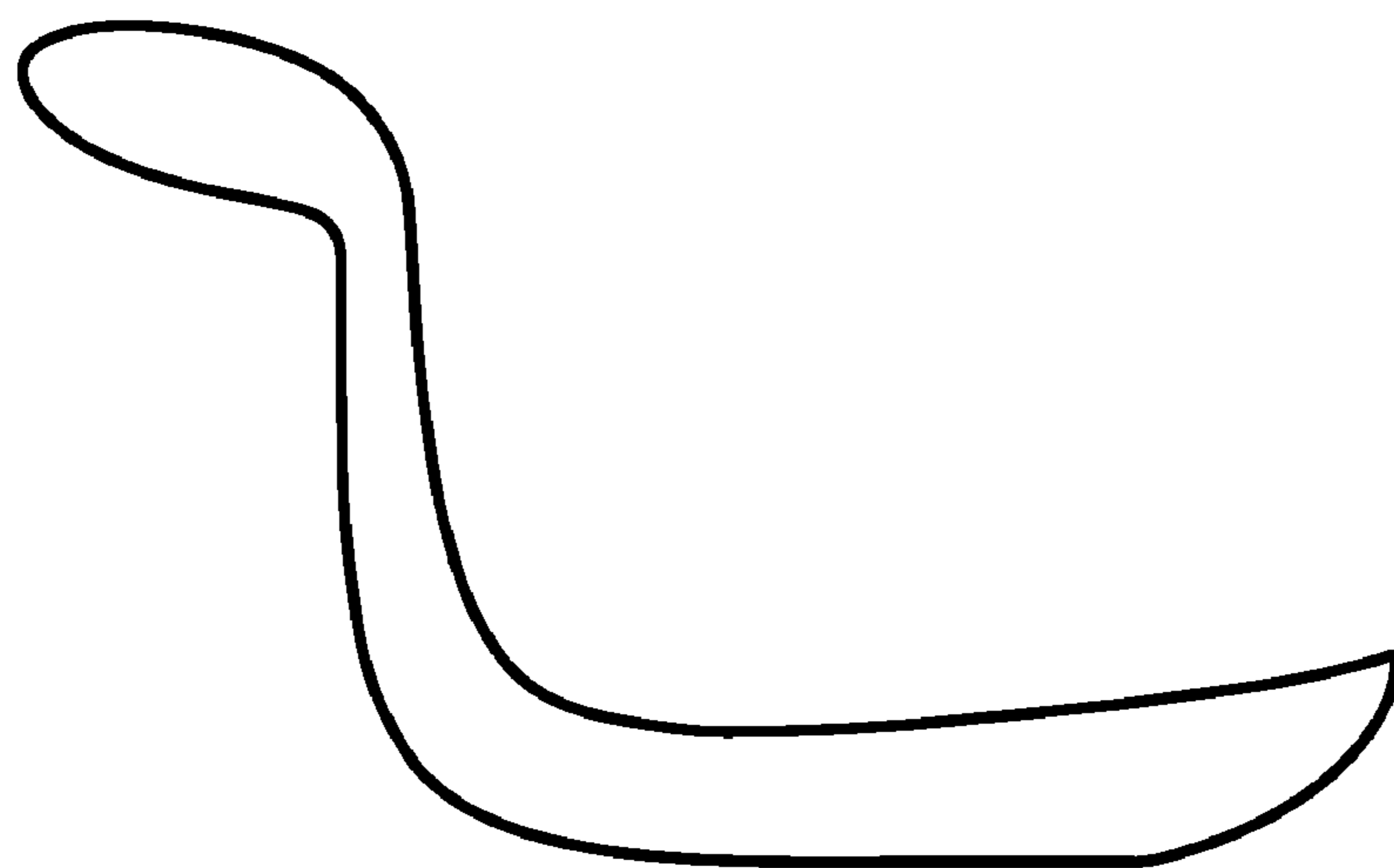

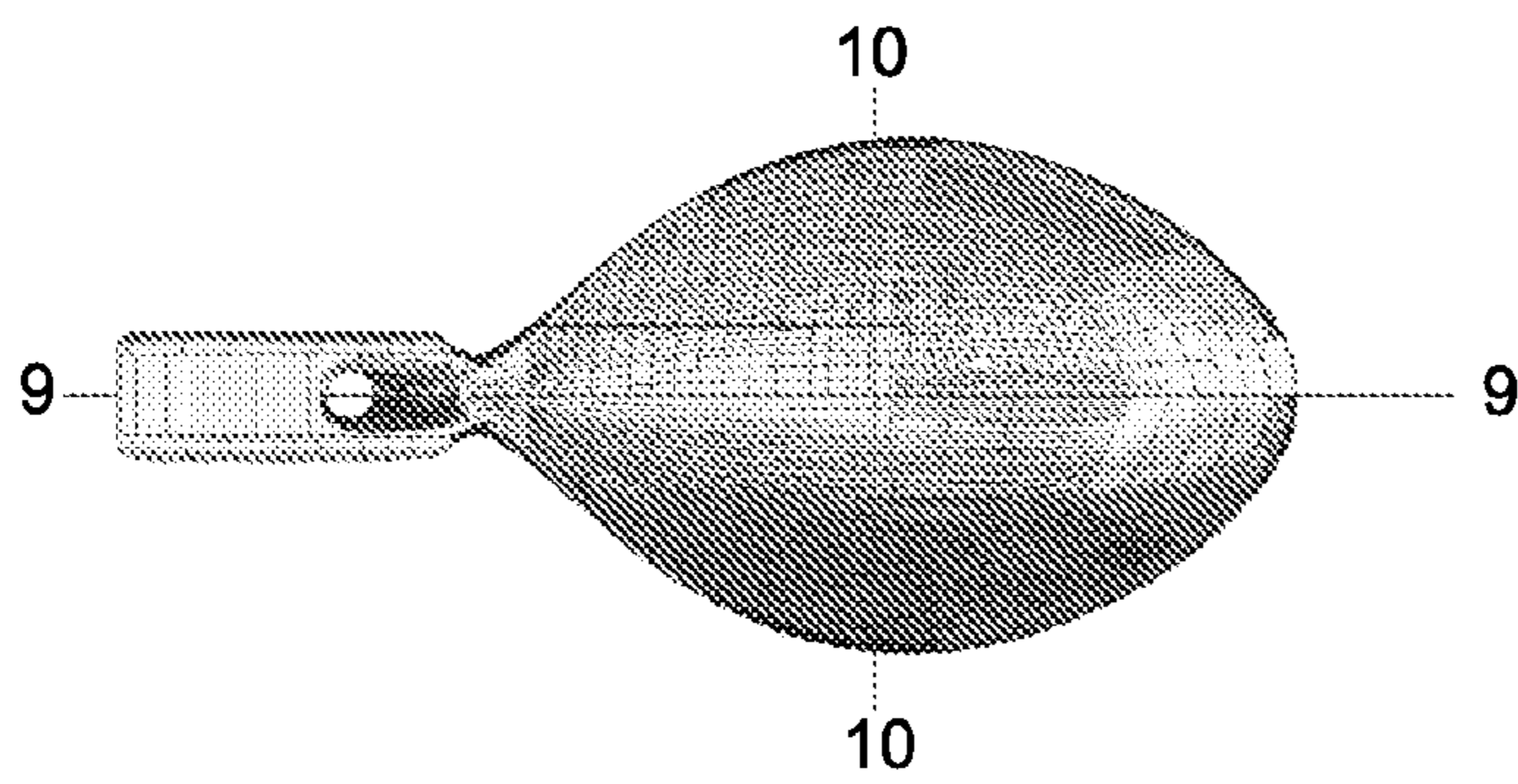

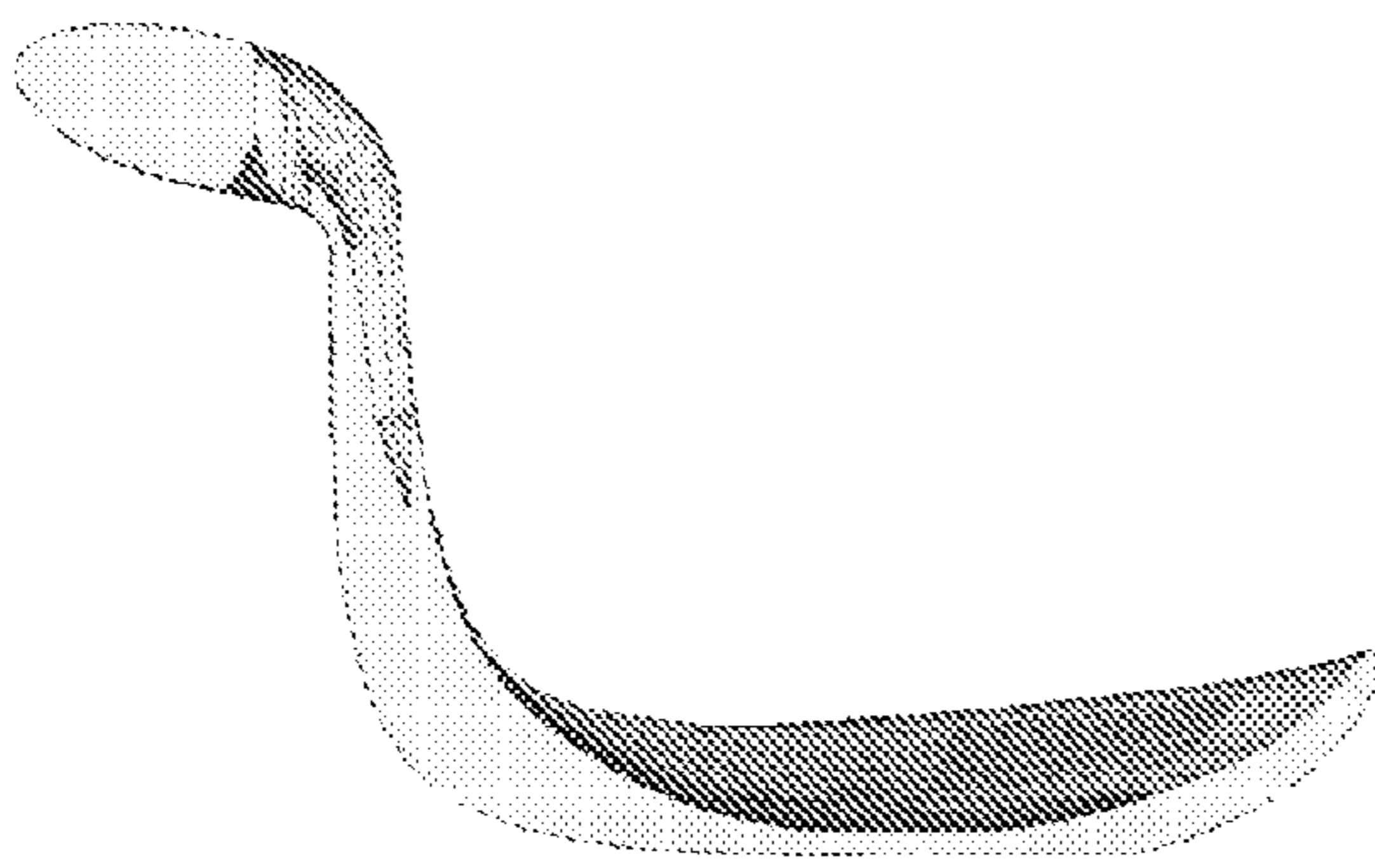

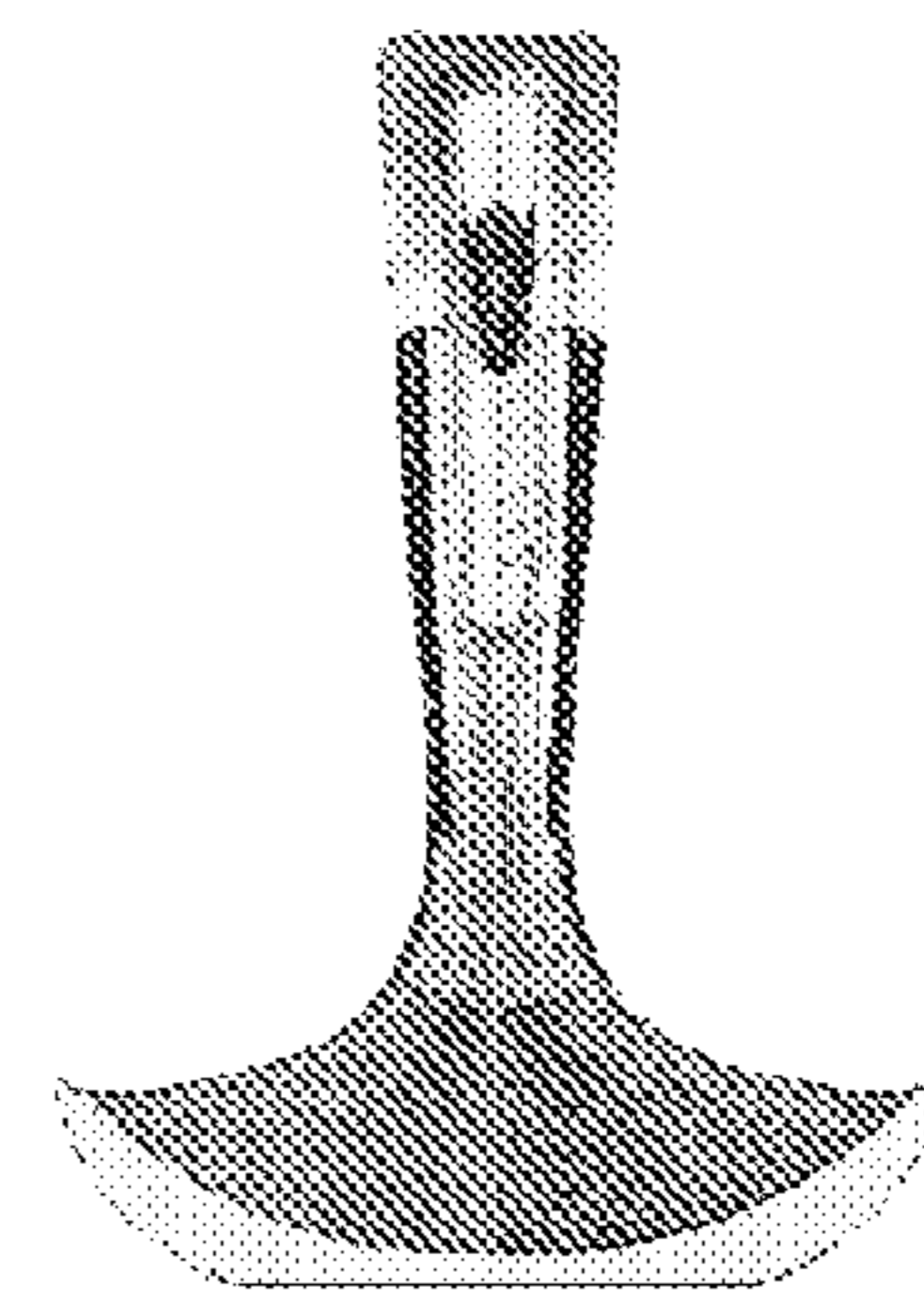
