FIG. 12 is a side view thereof;

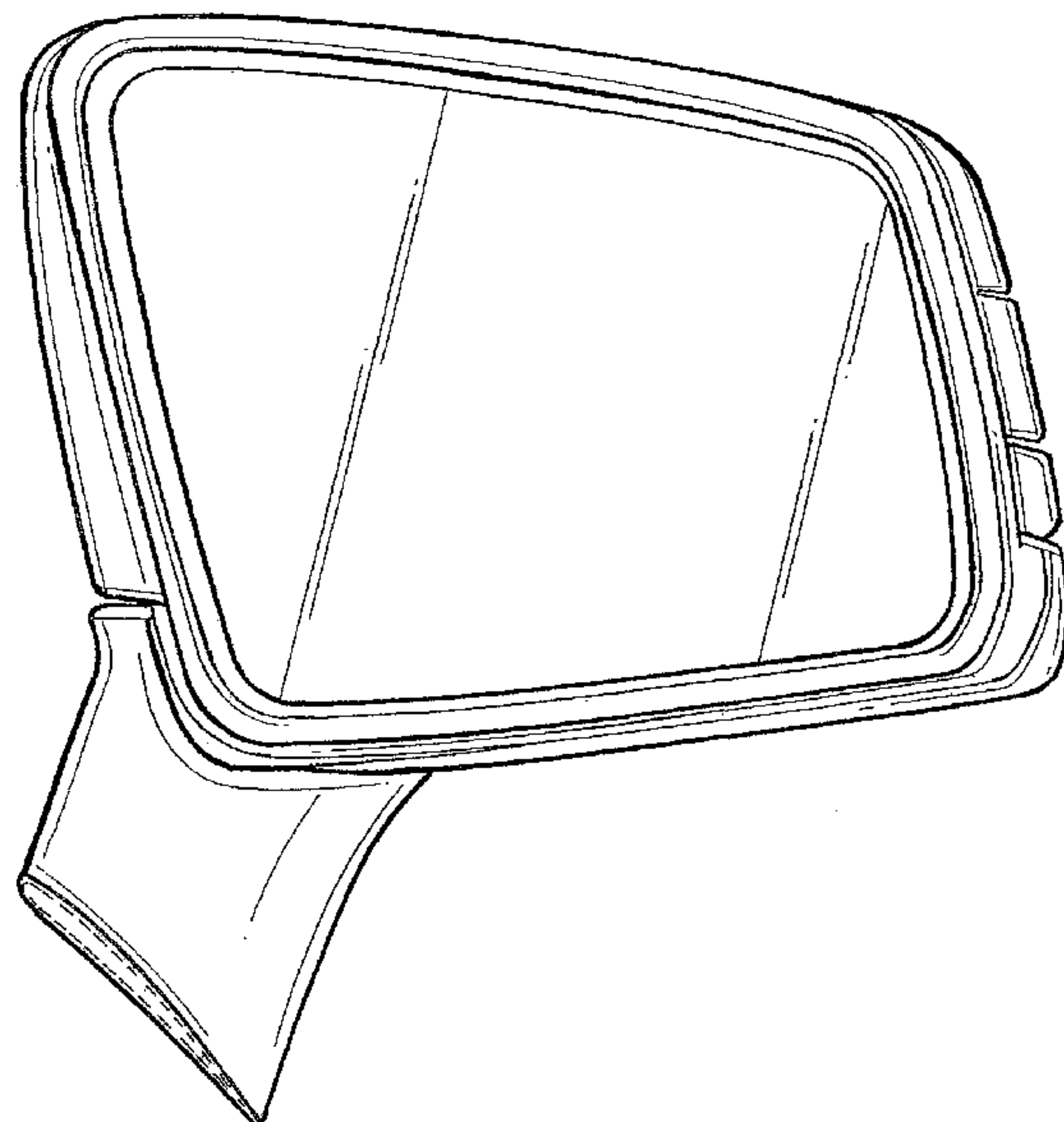
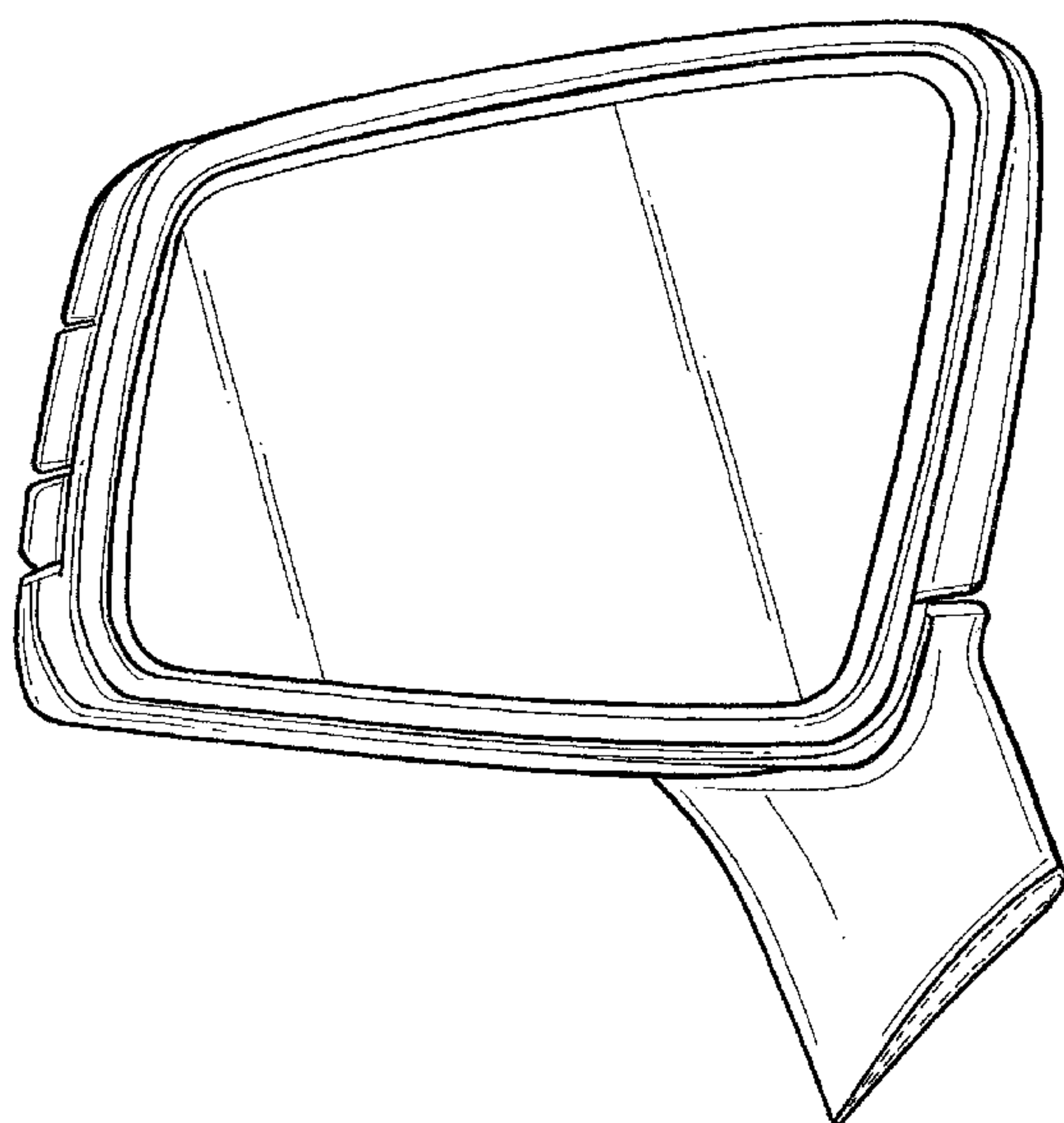
FIG. 13 is a top view thereof; and,

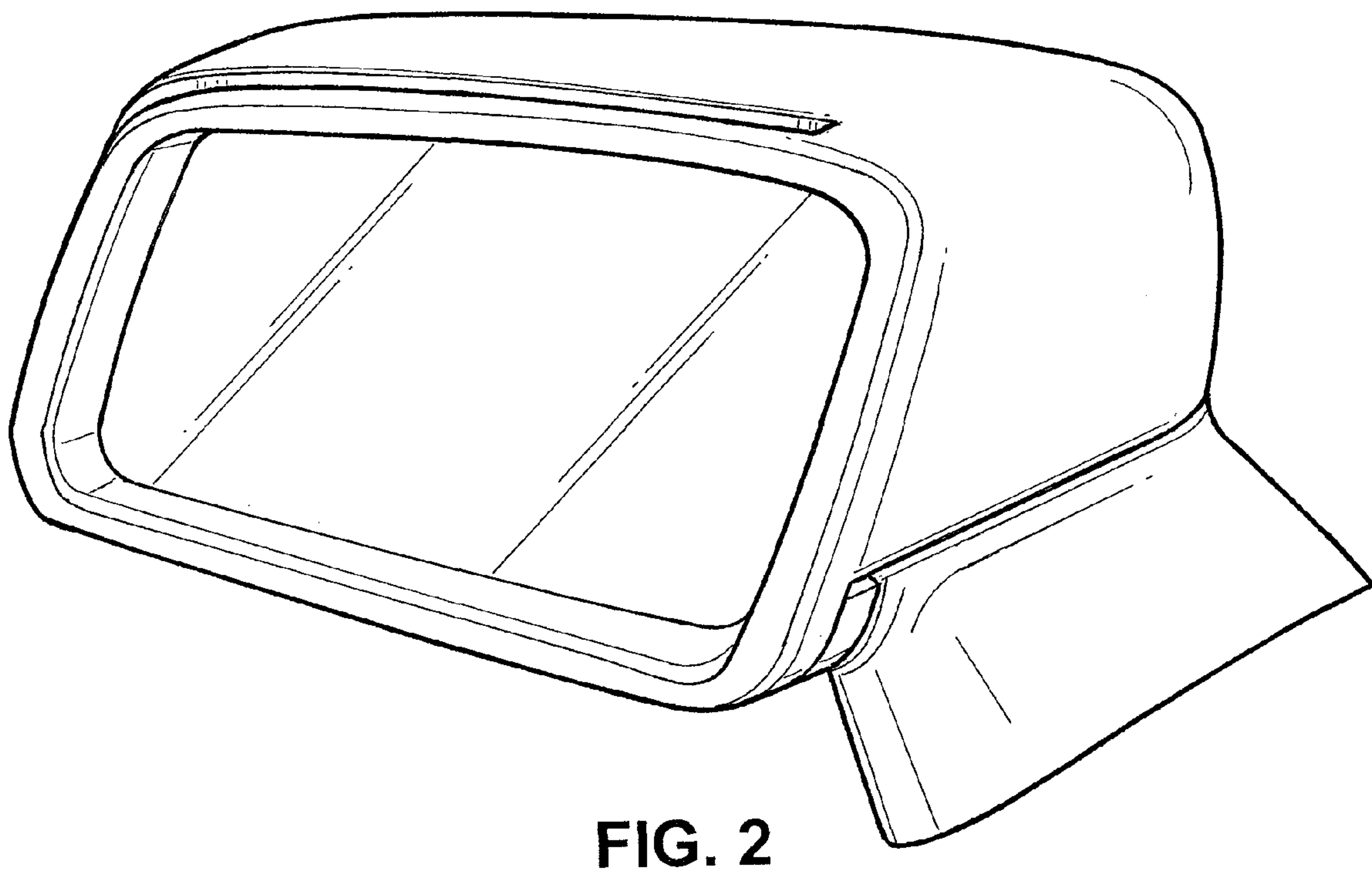
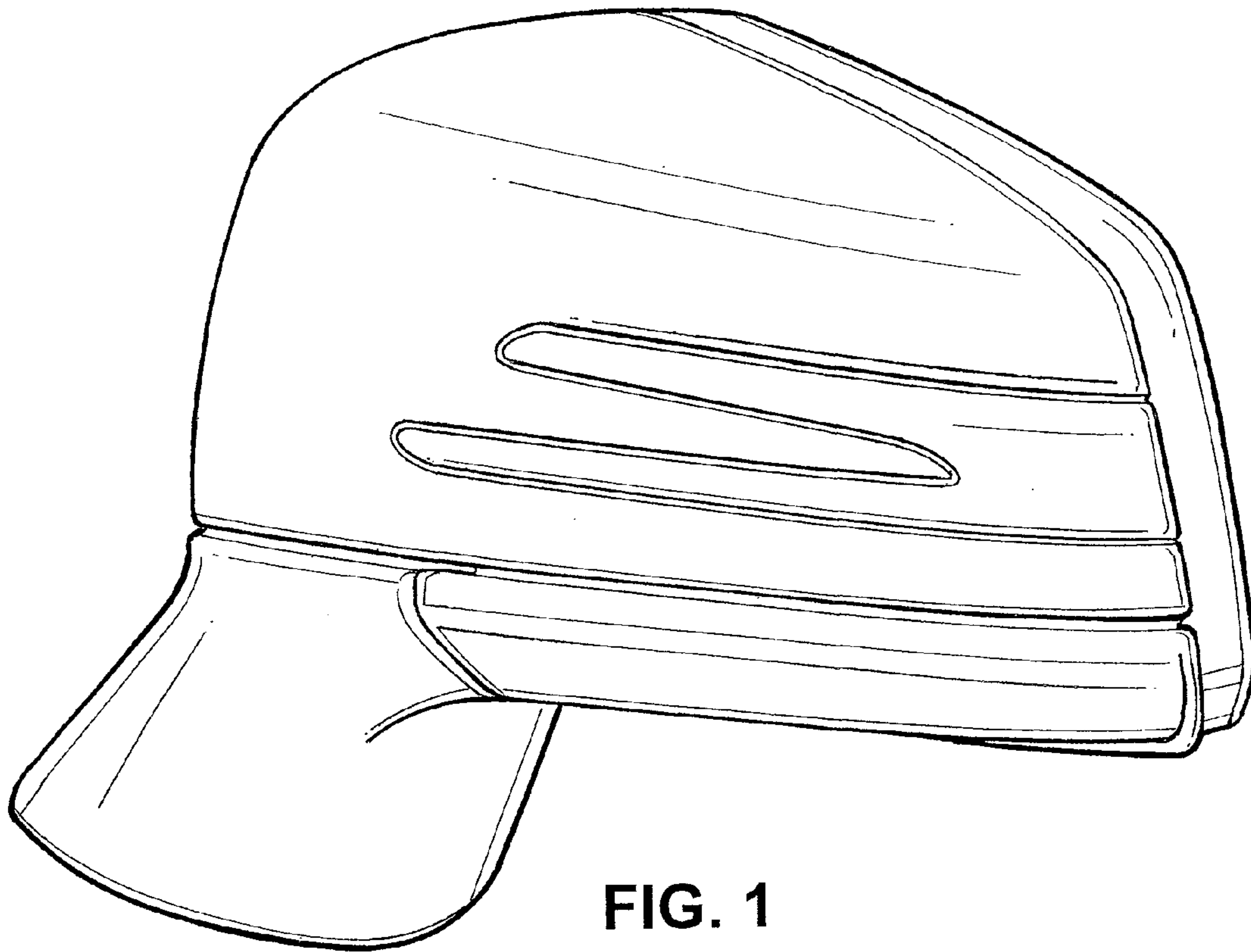
FIG. 14 is a side view thereof.

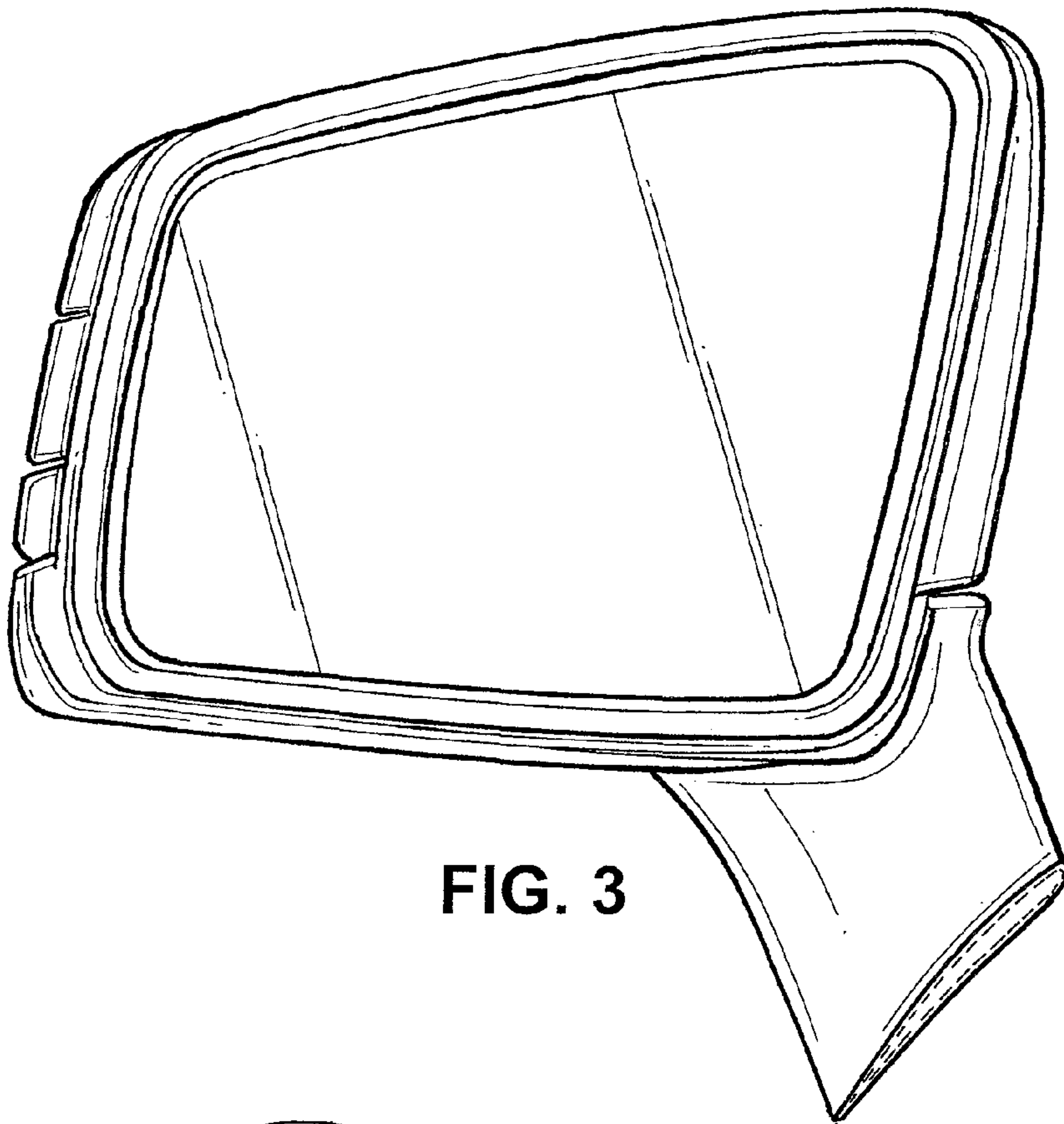

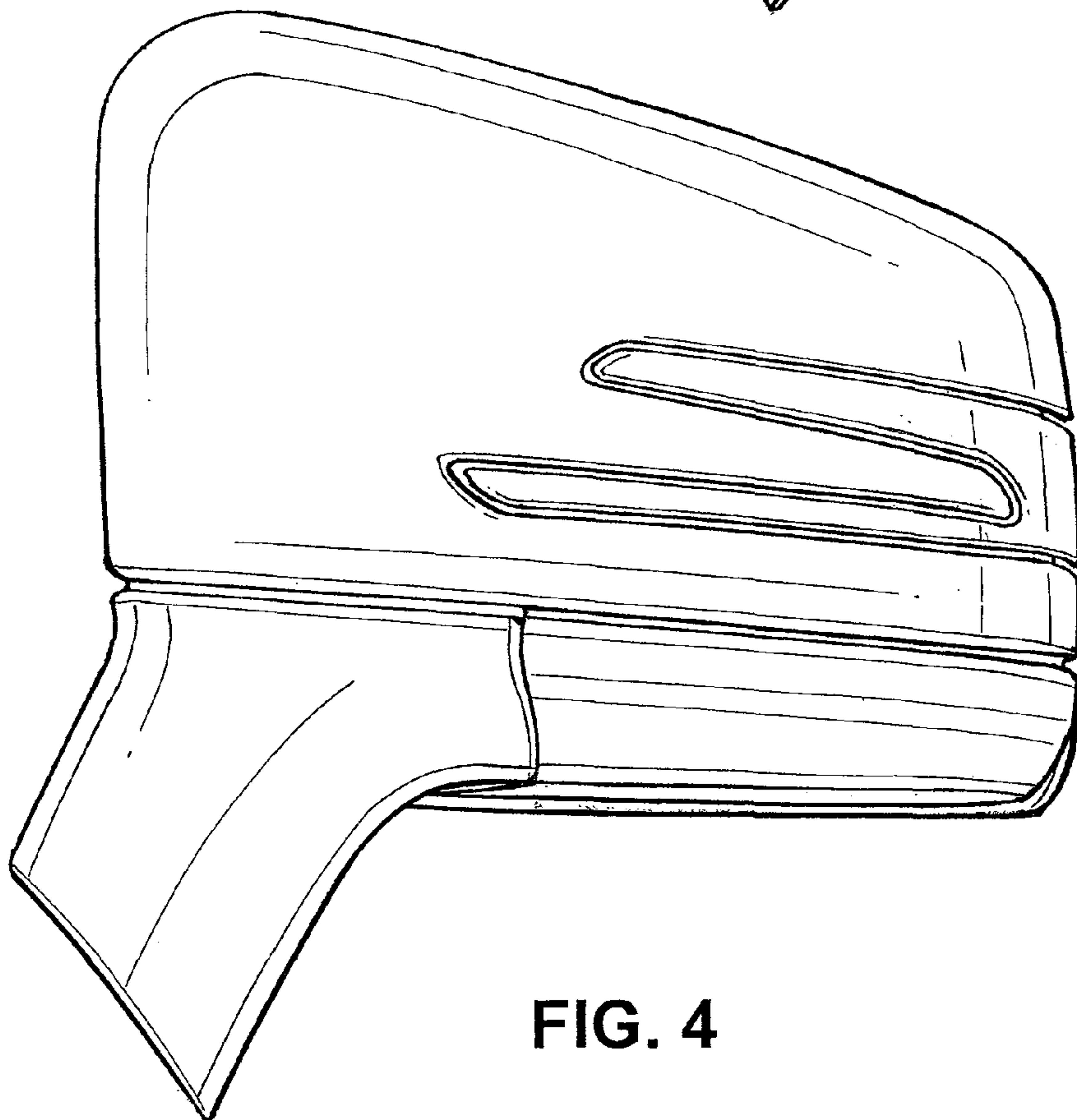

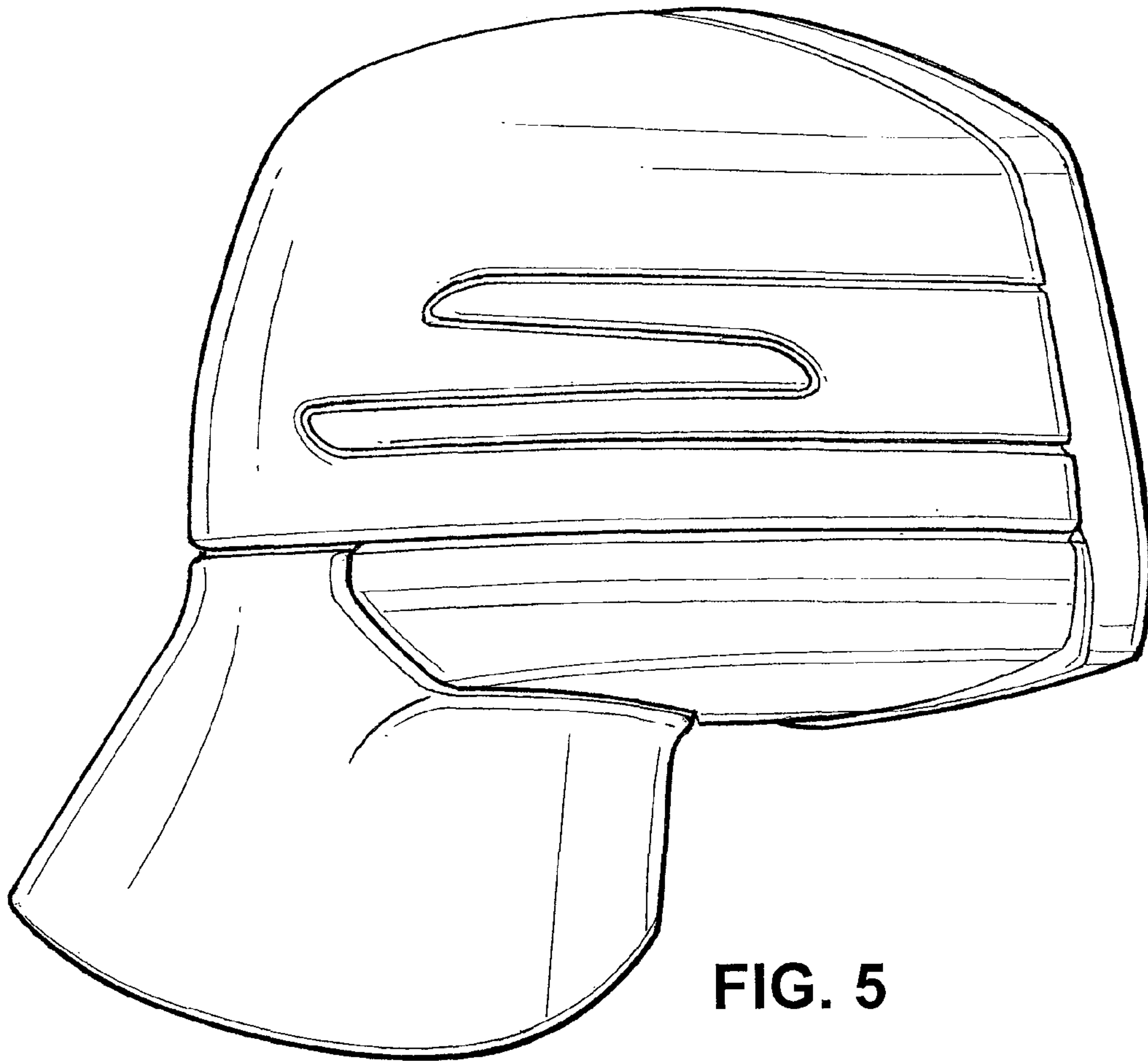

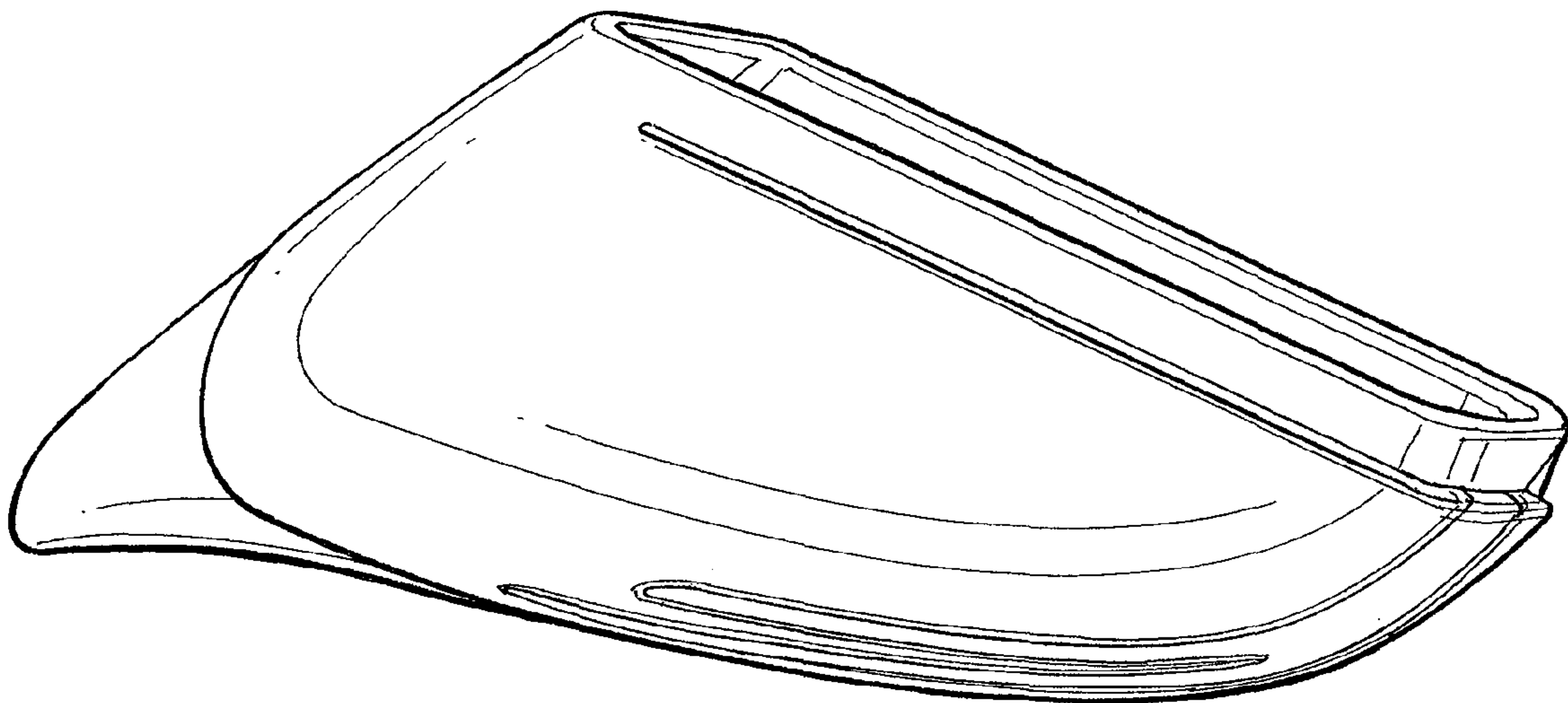

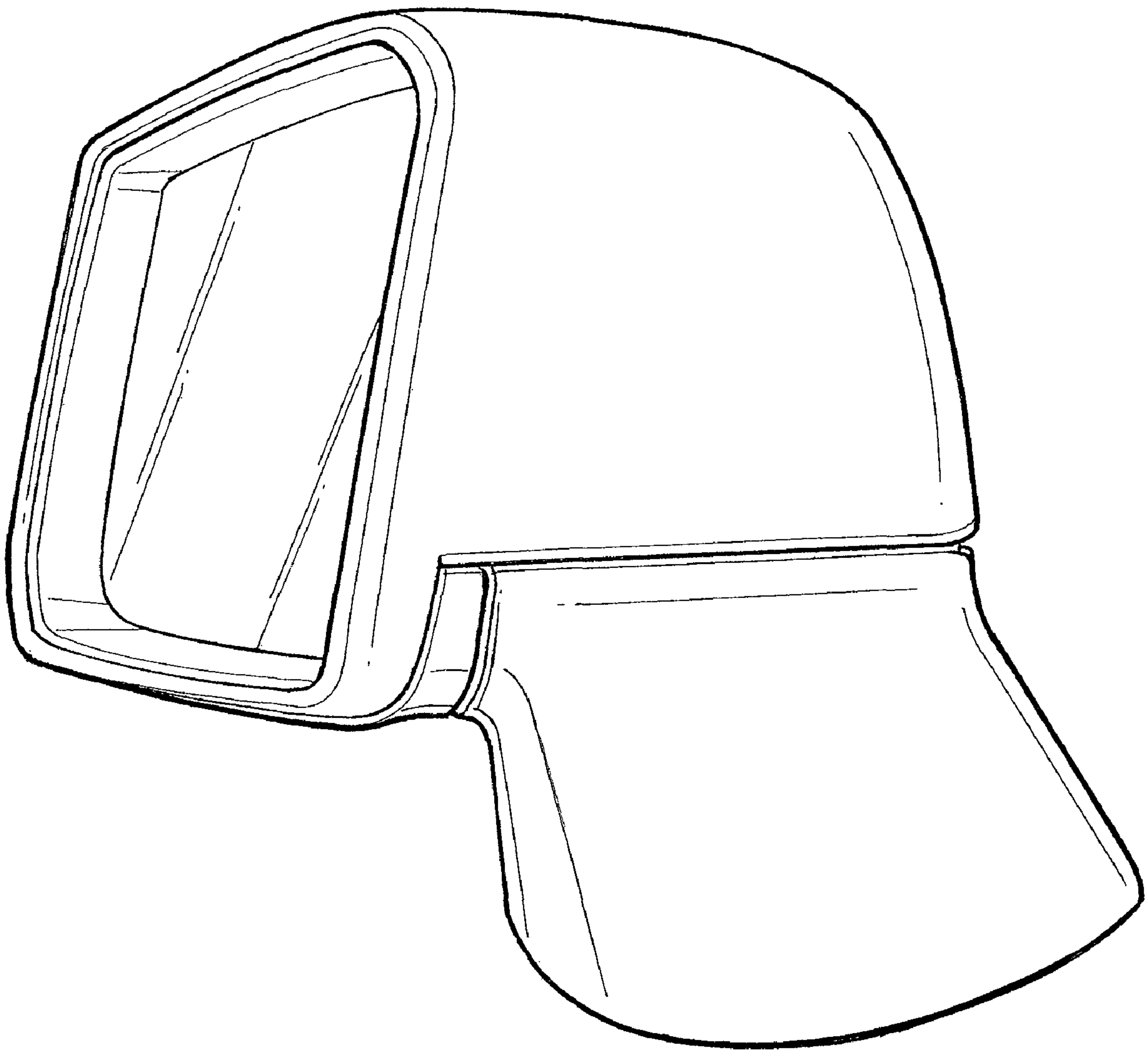

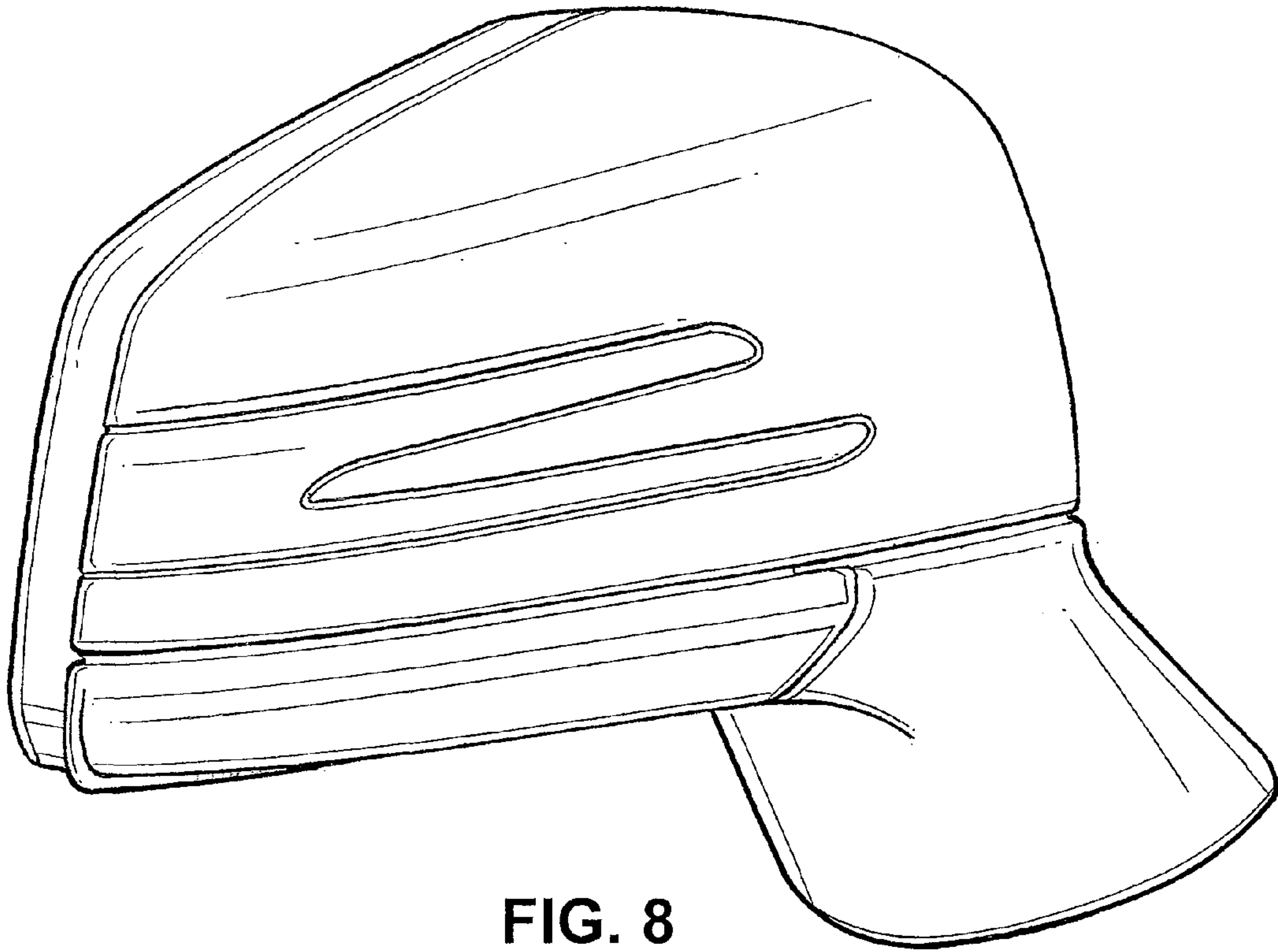

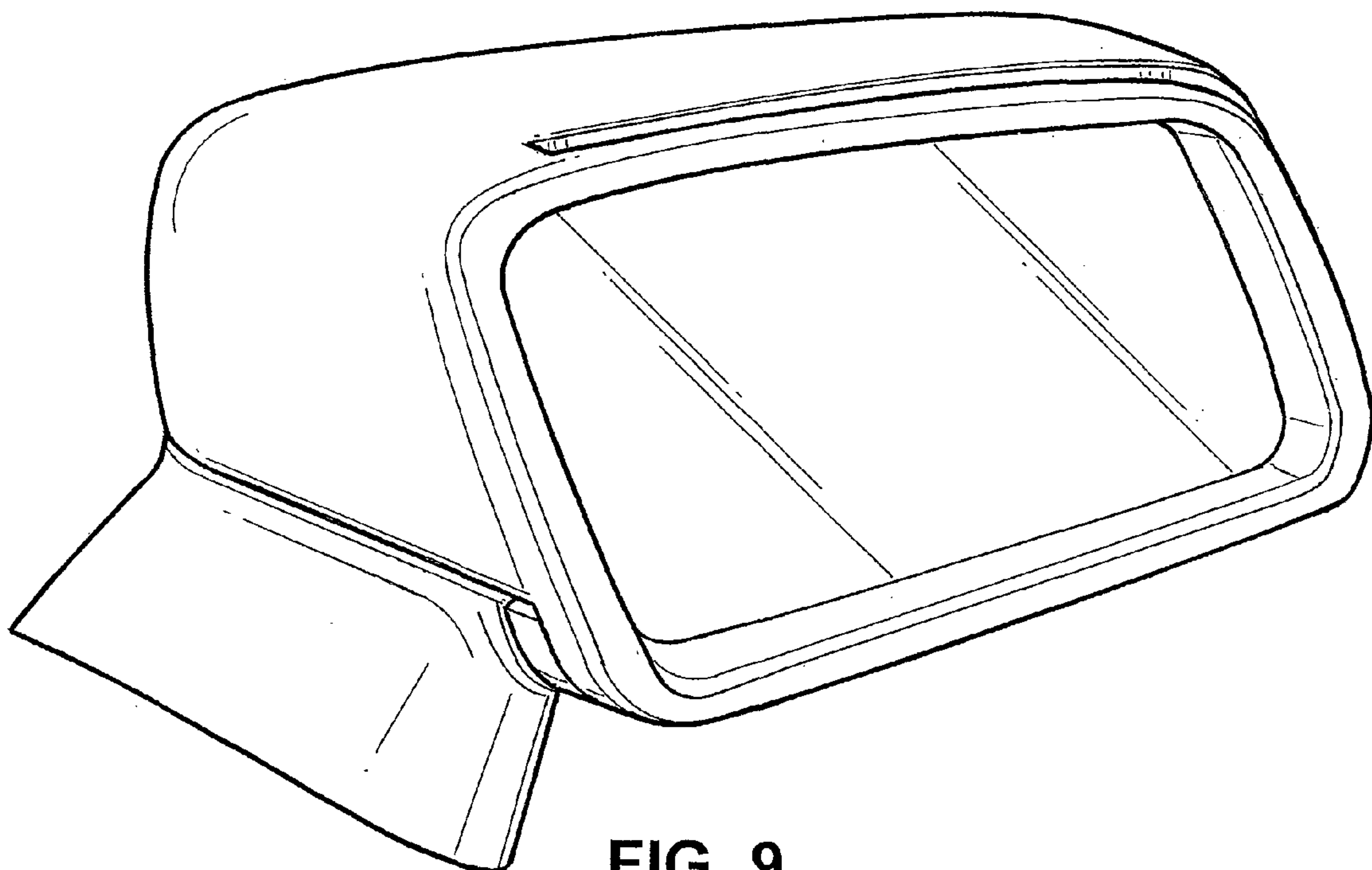

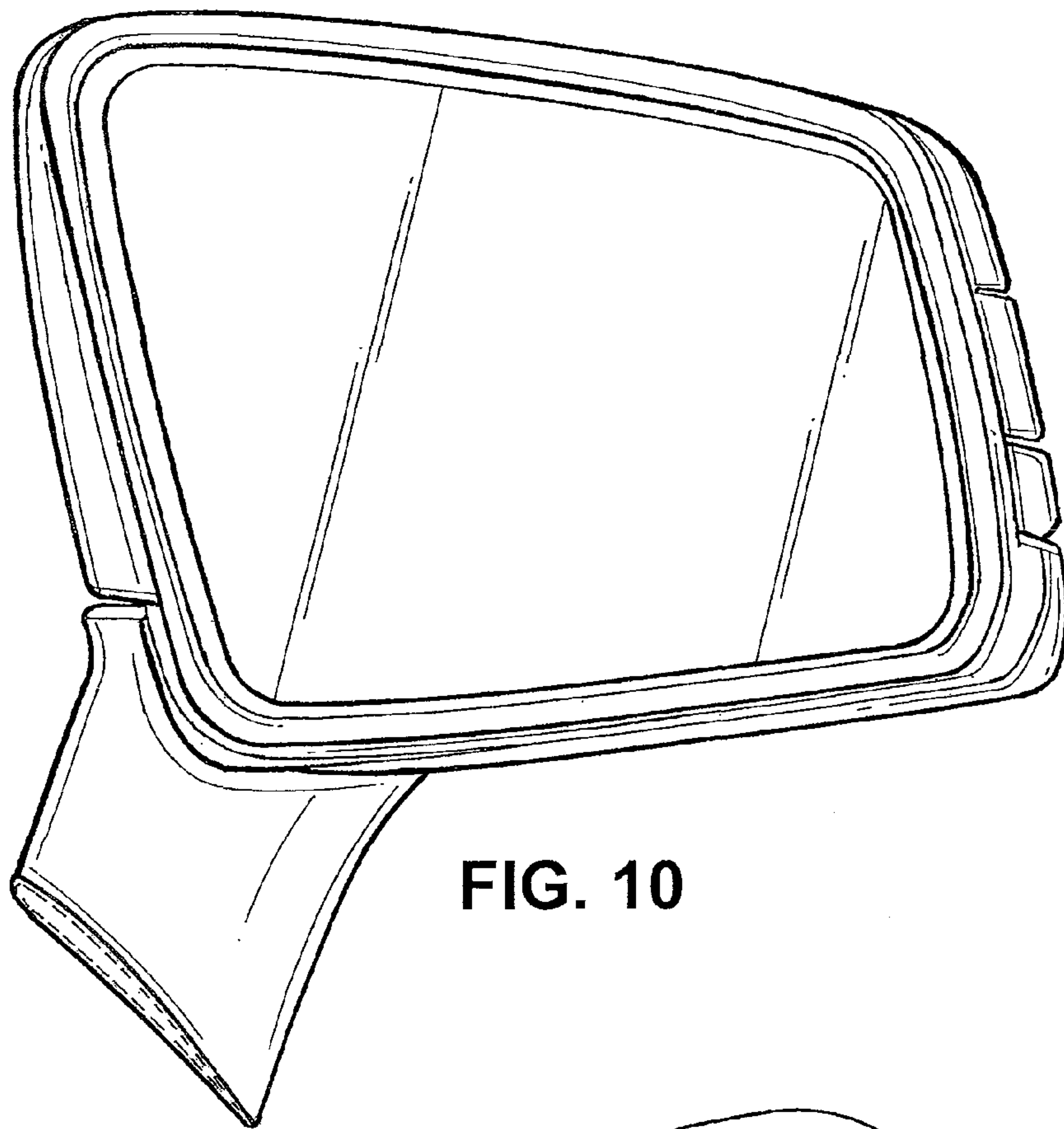

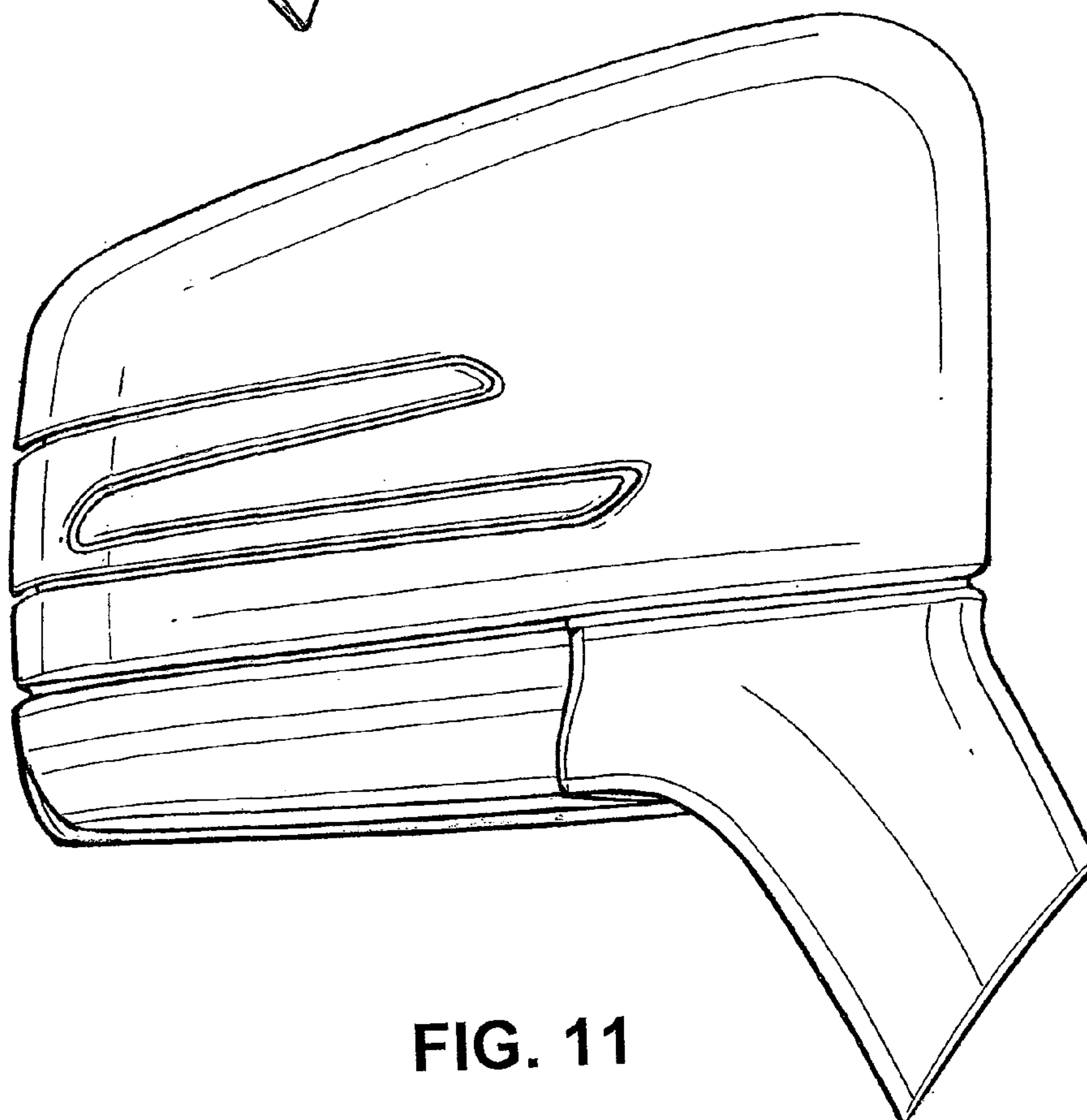

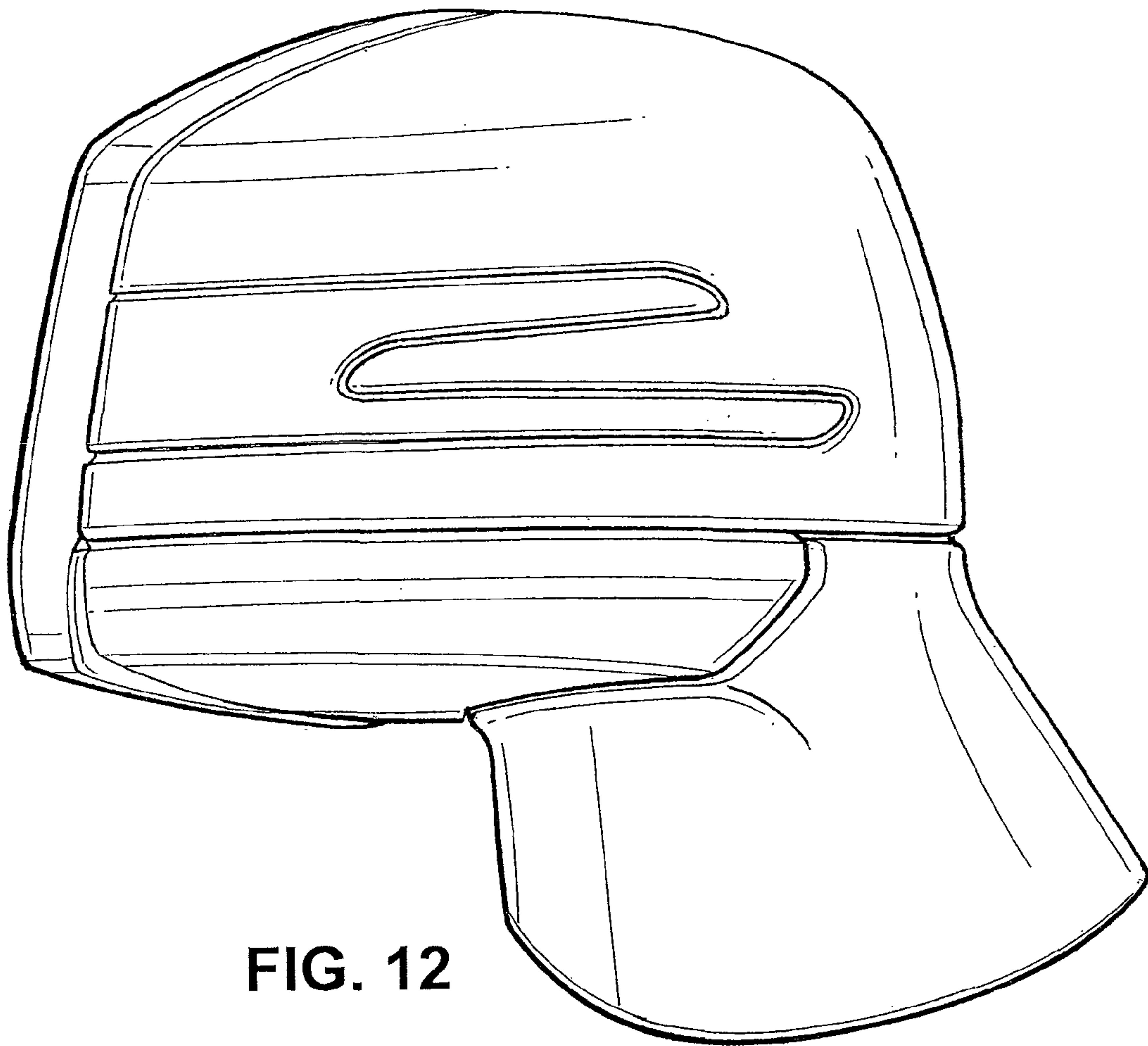

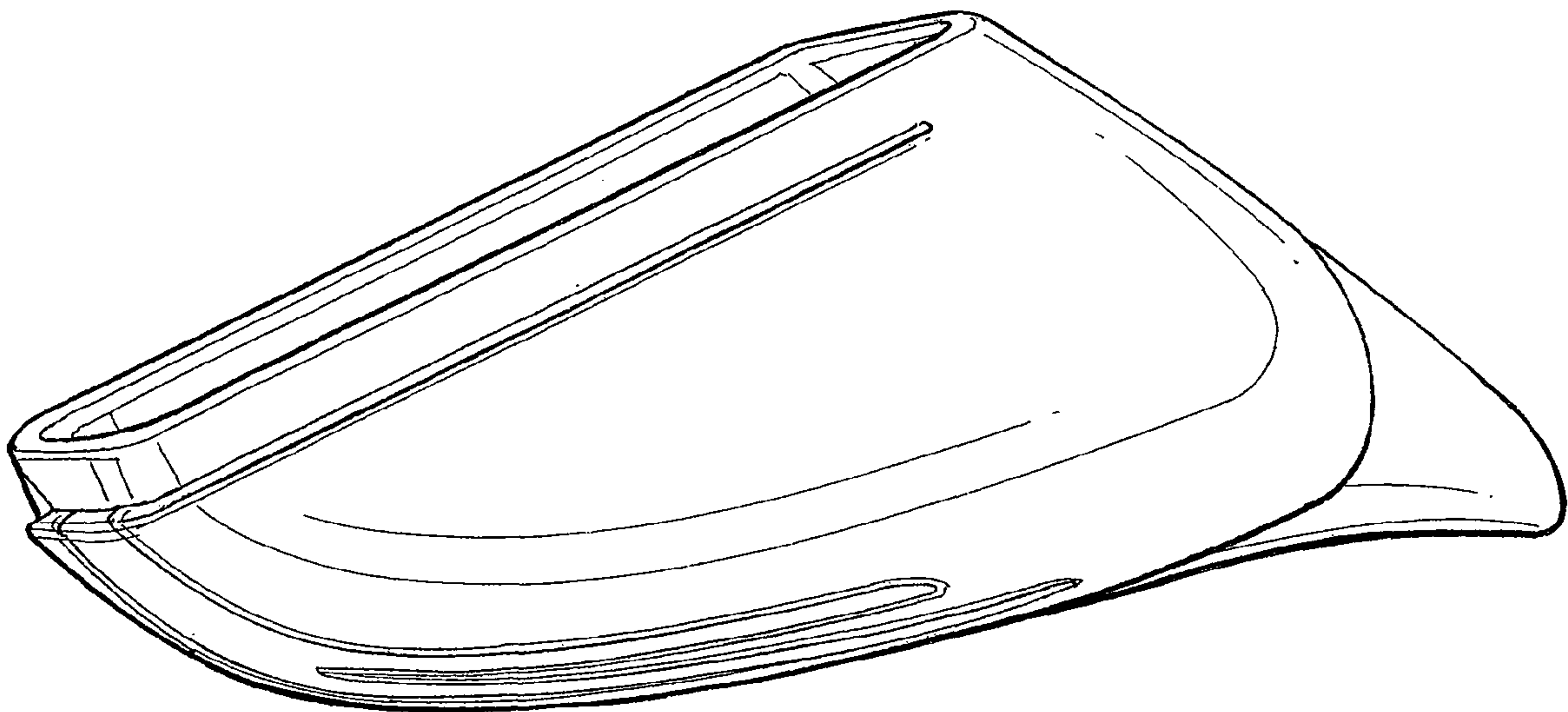

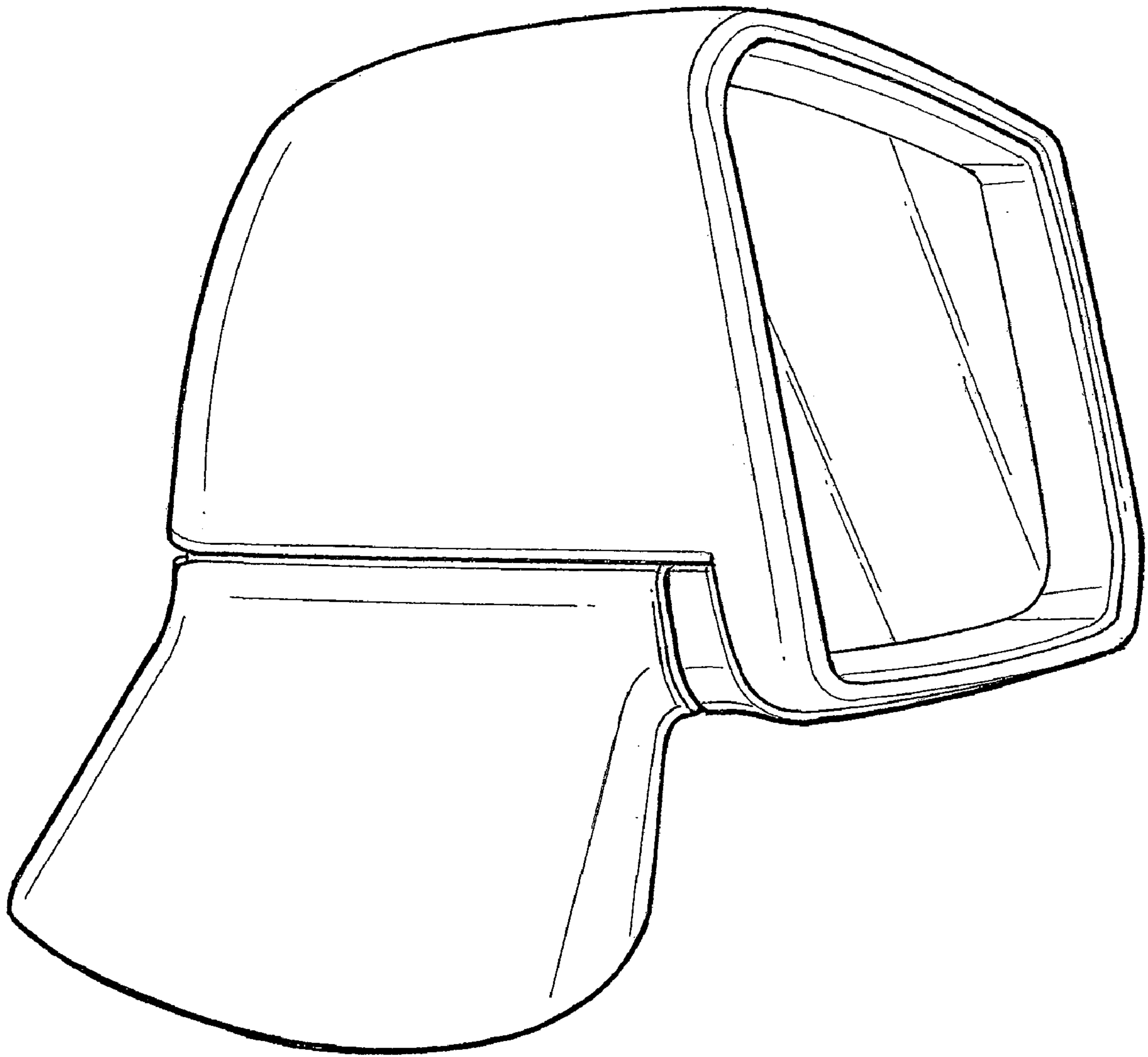
