FIG. 1 is a top view of a first embodiment of the food item, according to the present invention.

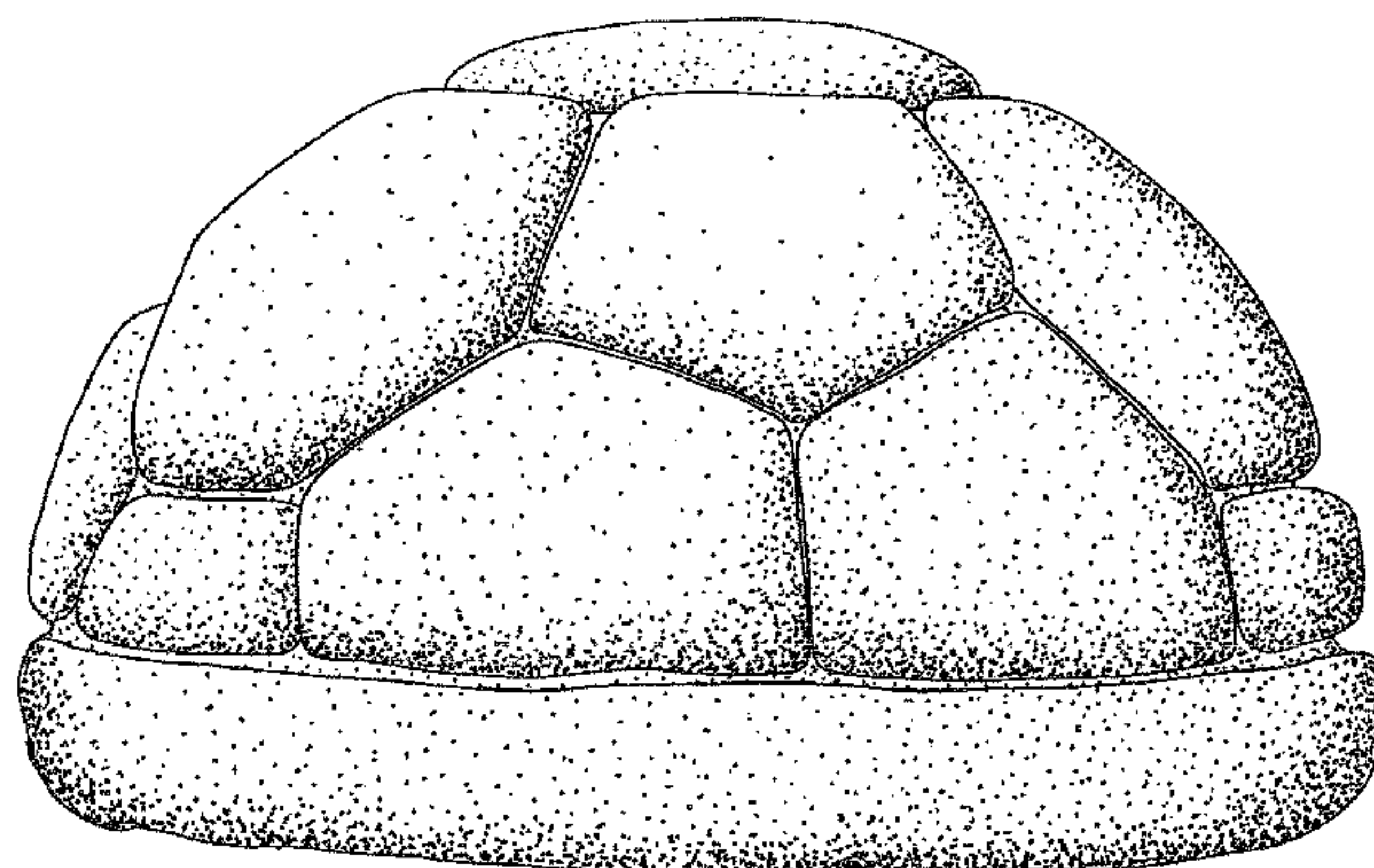
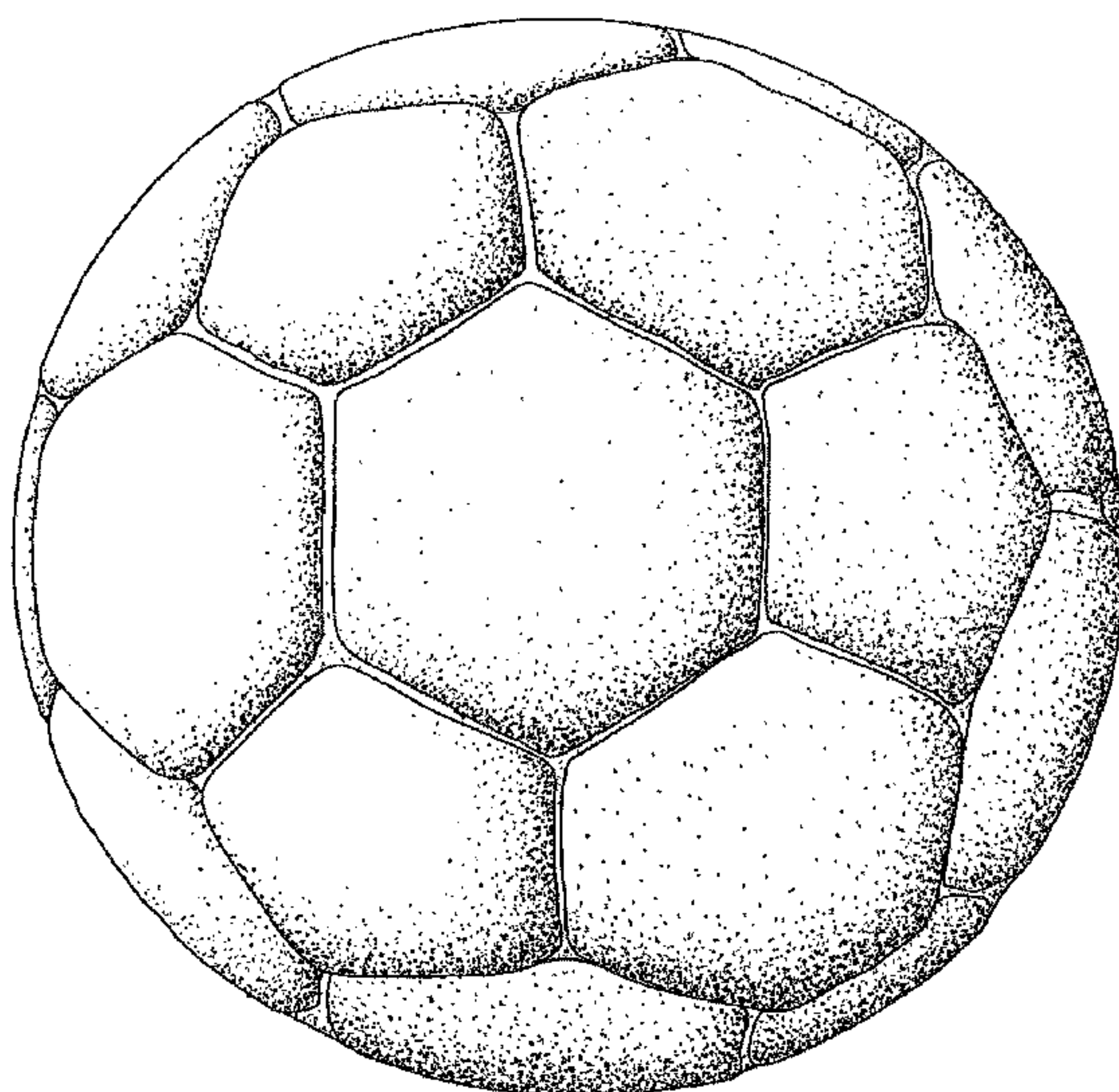
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof.

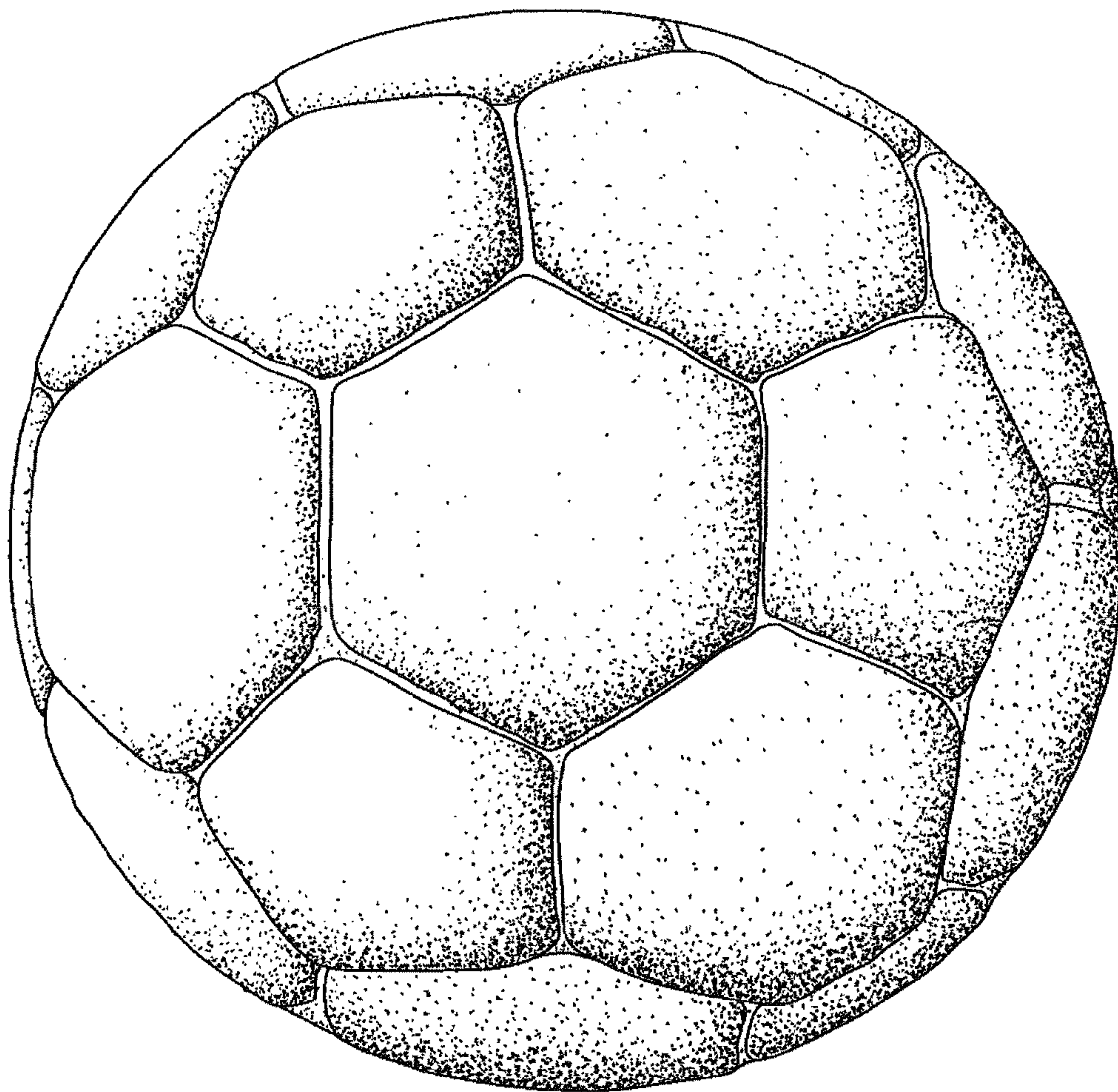

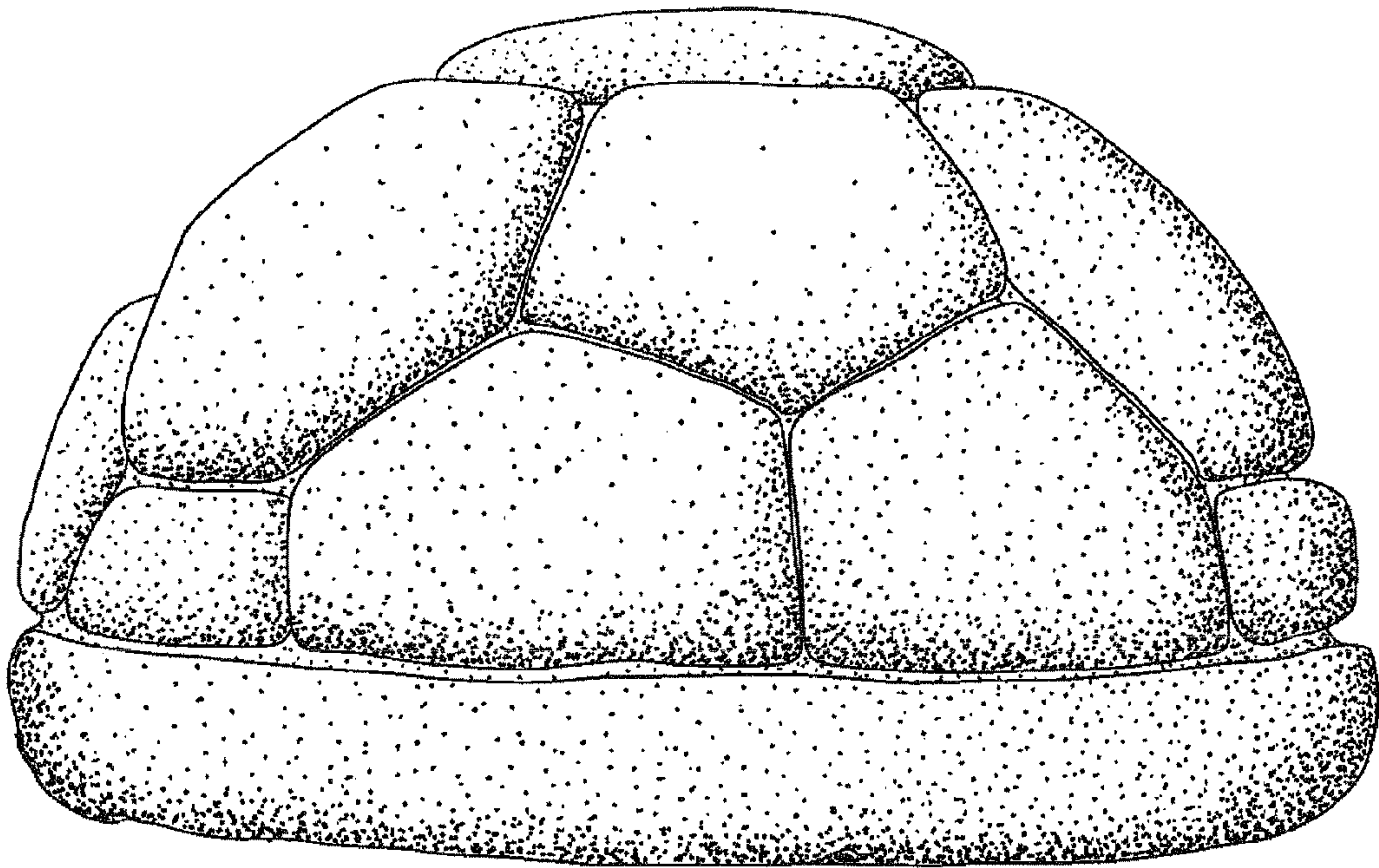

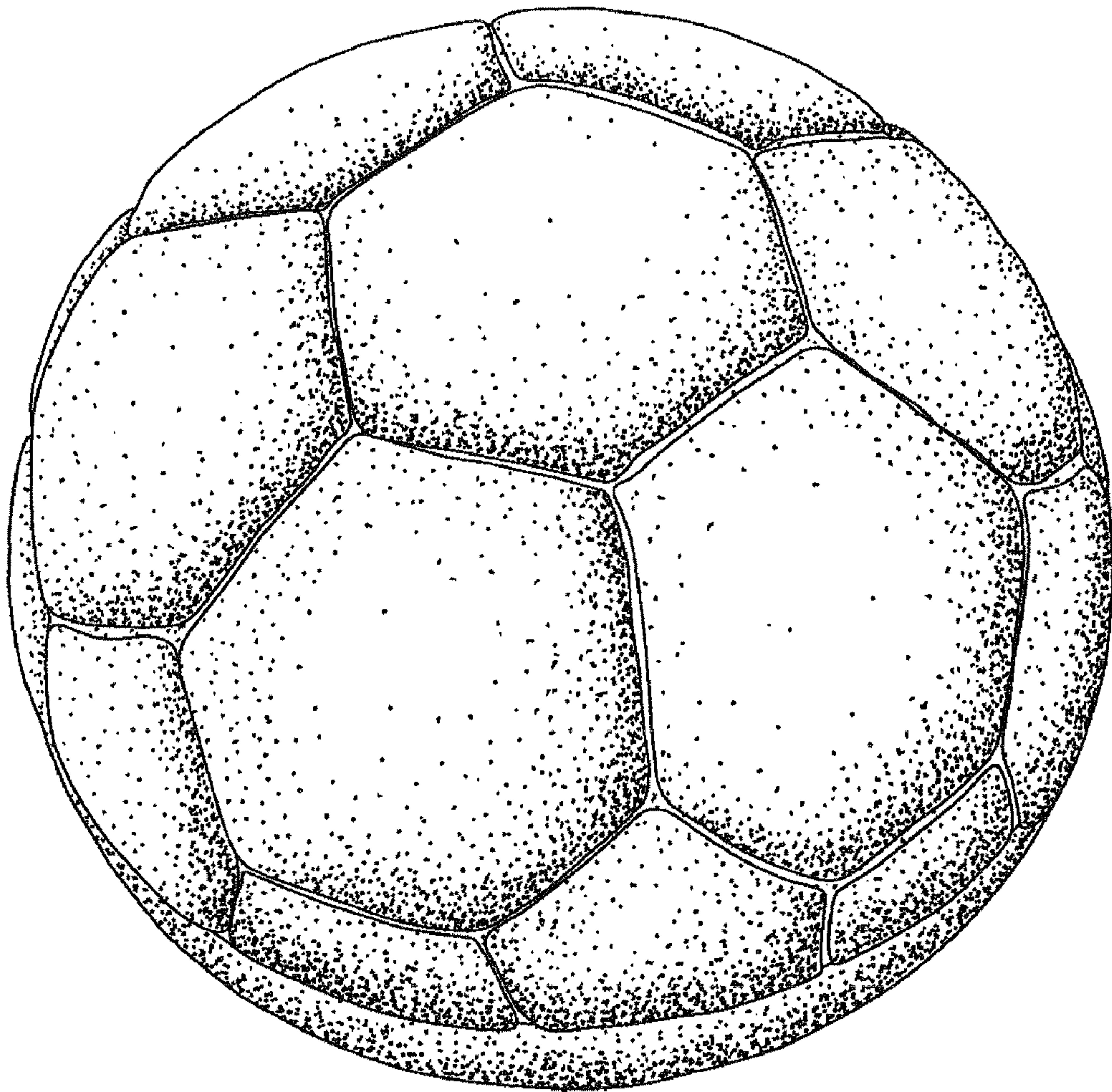

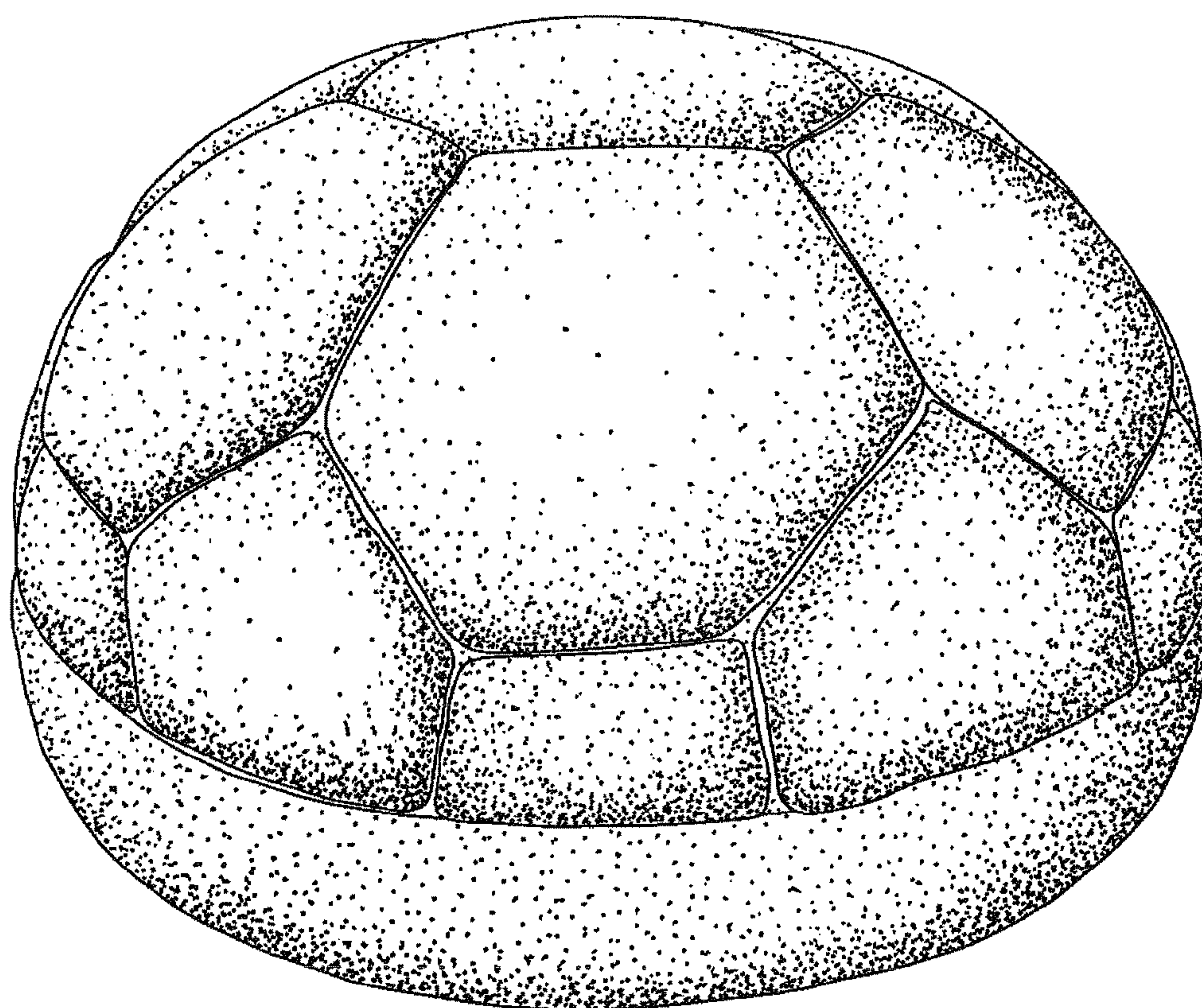
