FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the the bladeless air circulator;

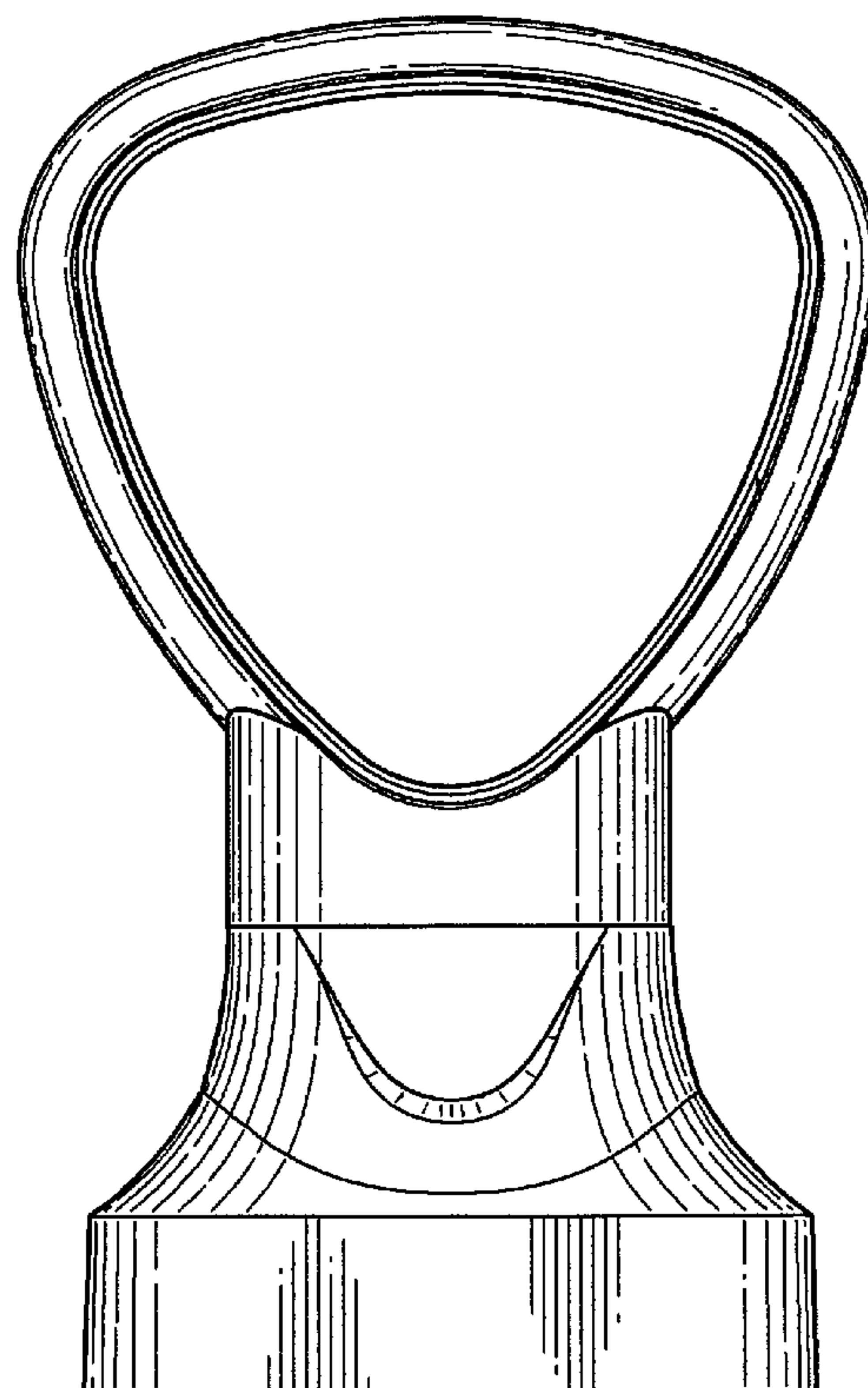
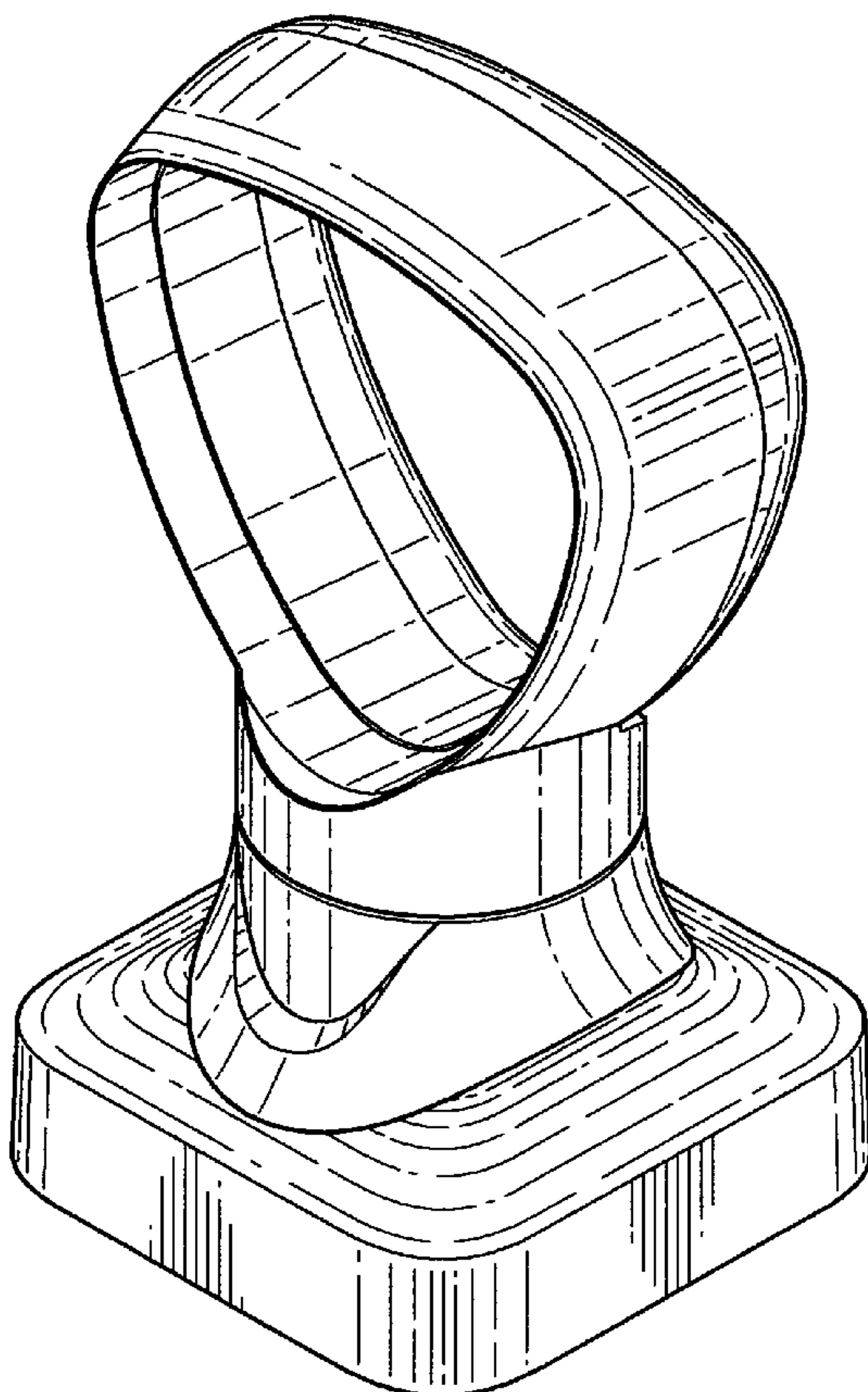
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the opposed side of the bladeless air circulator;

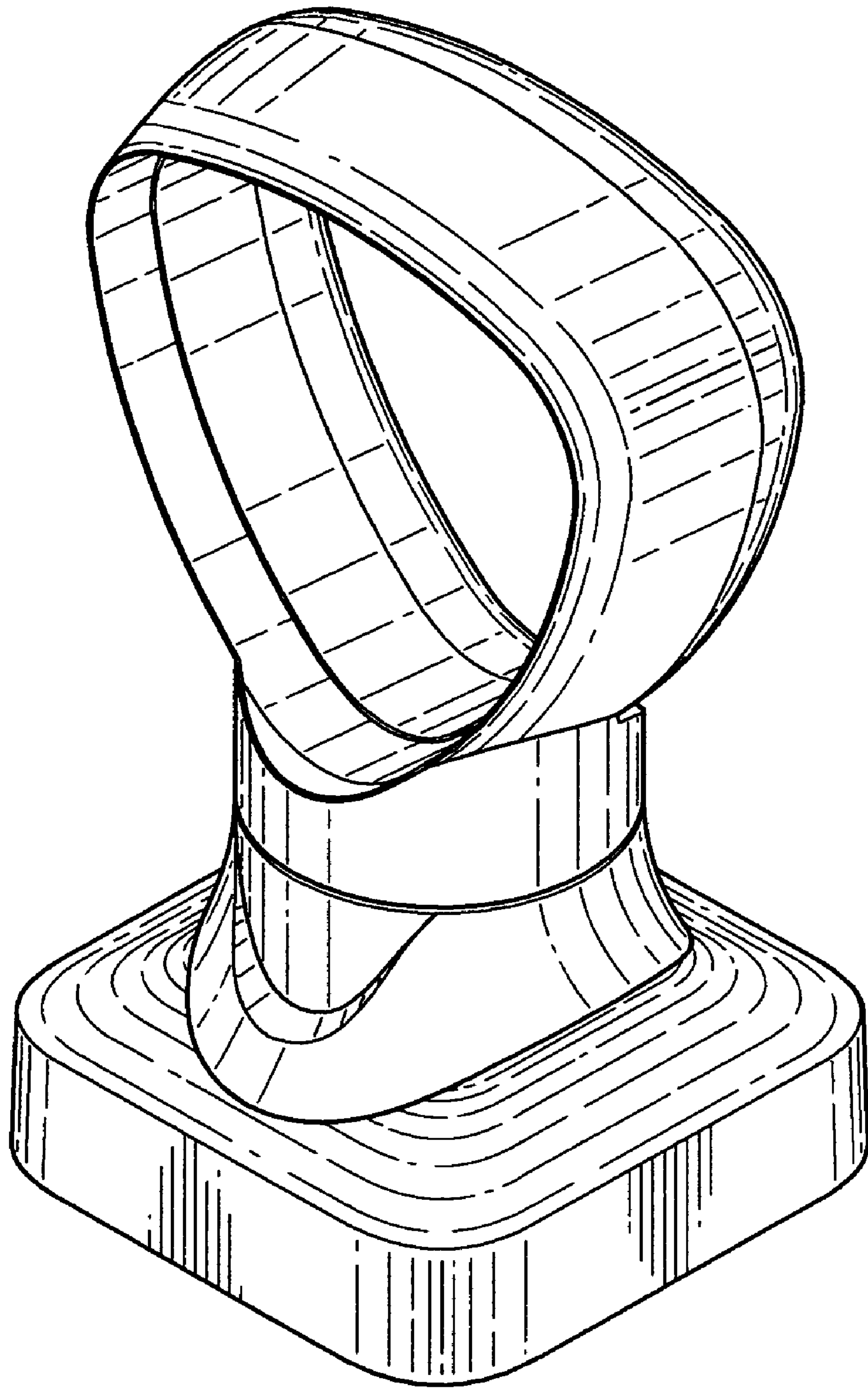

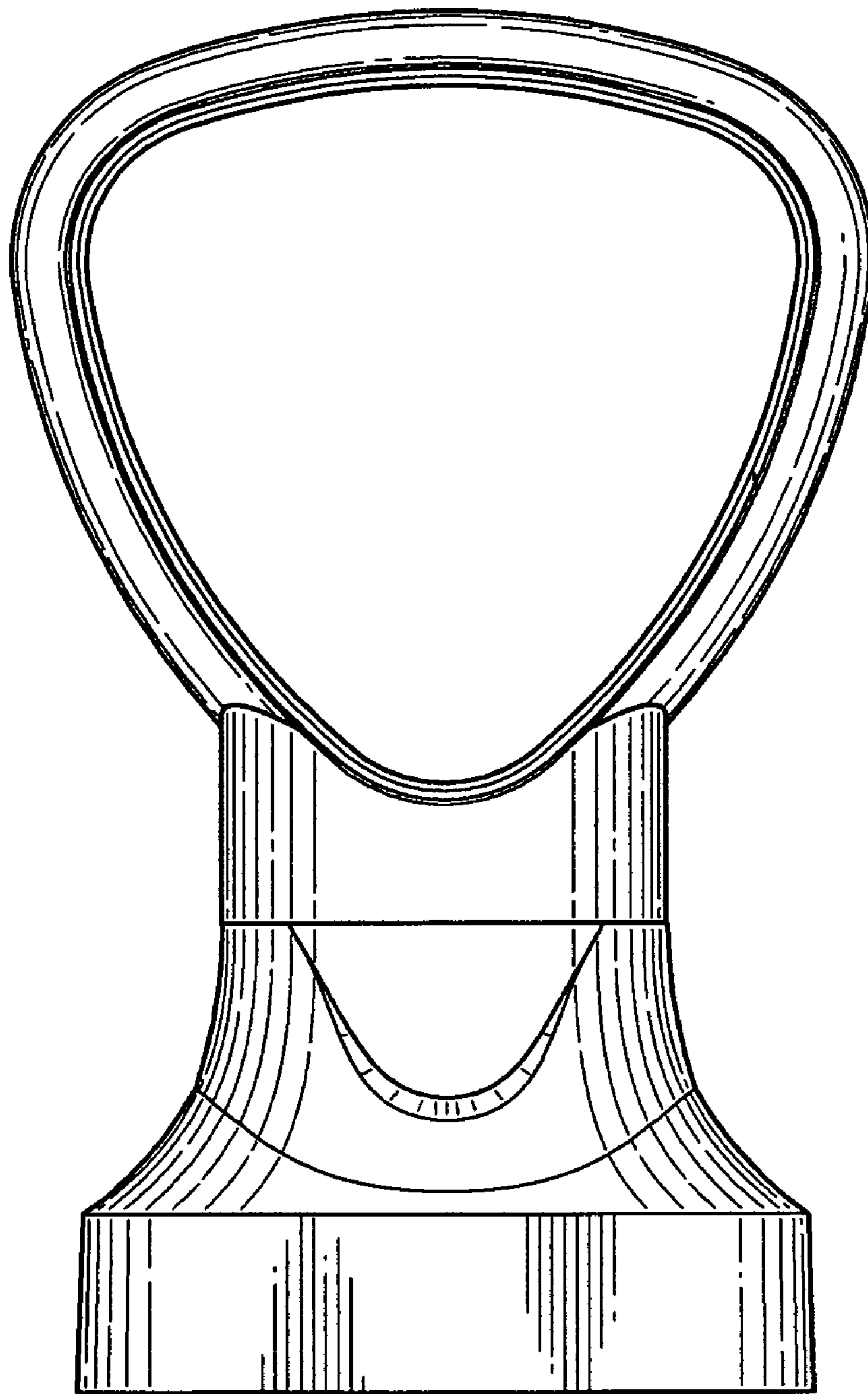

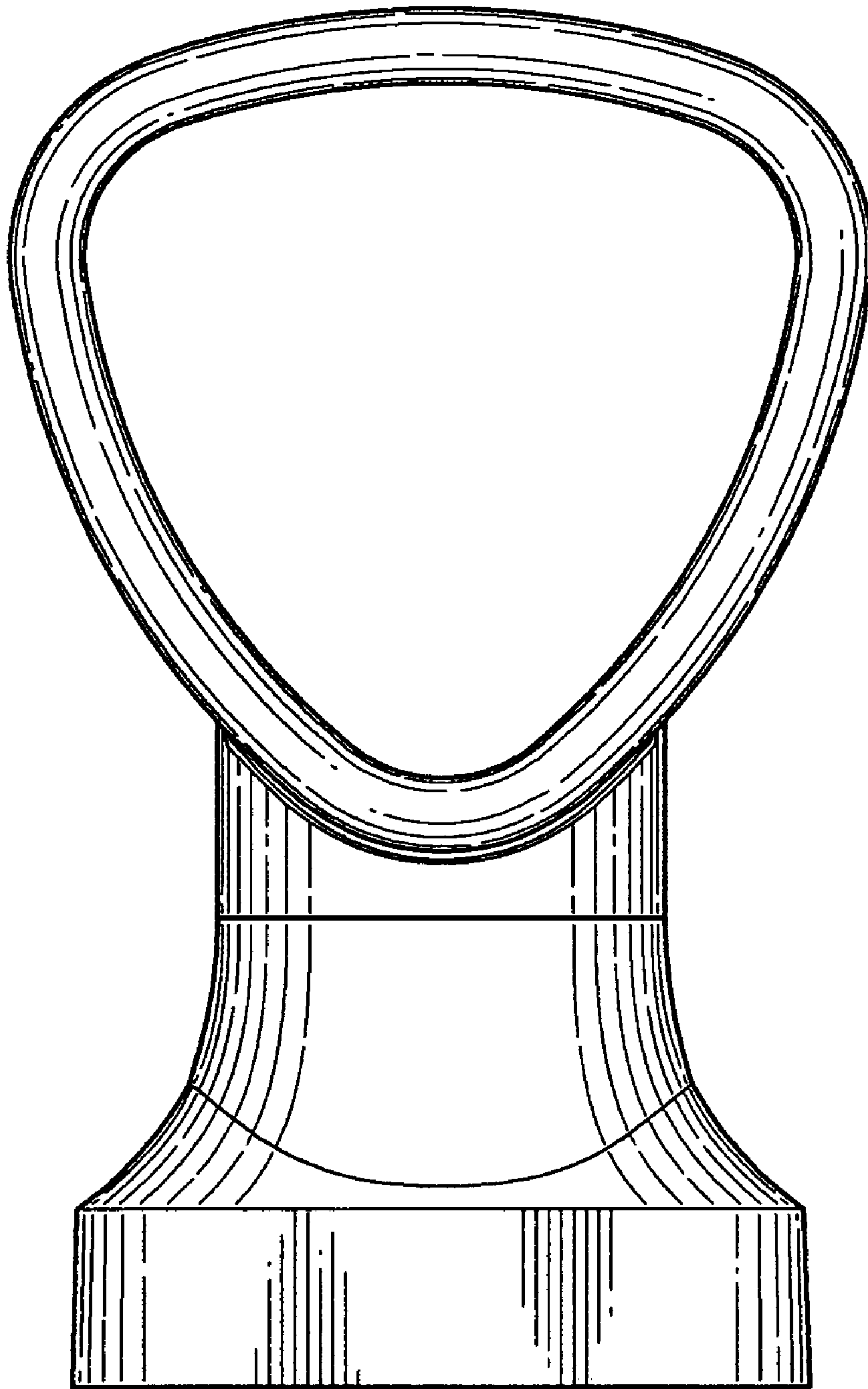

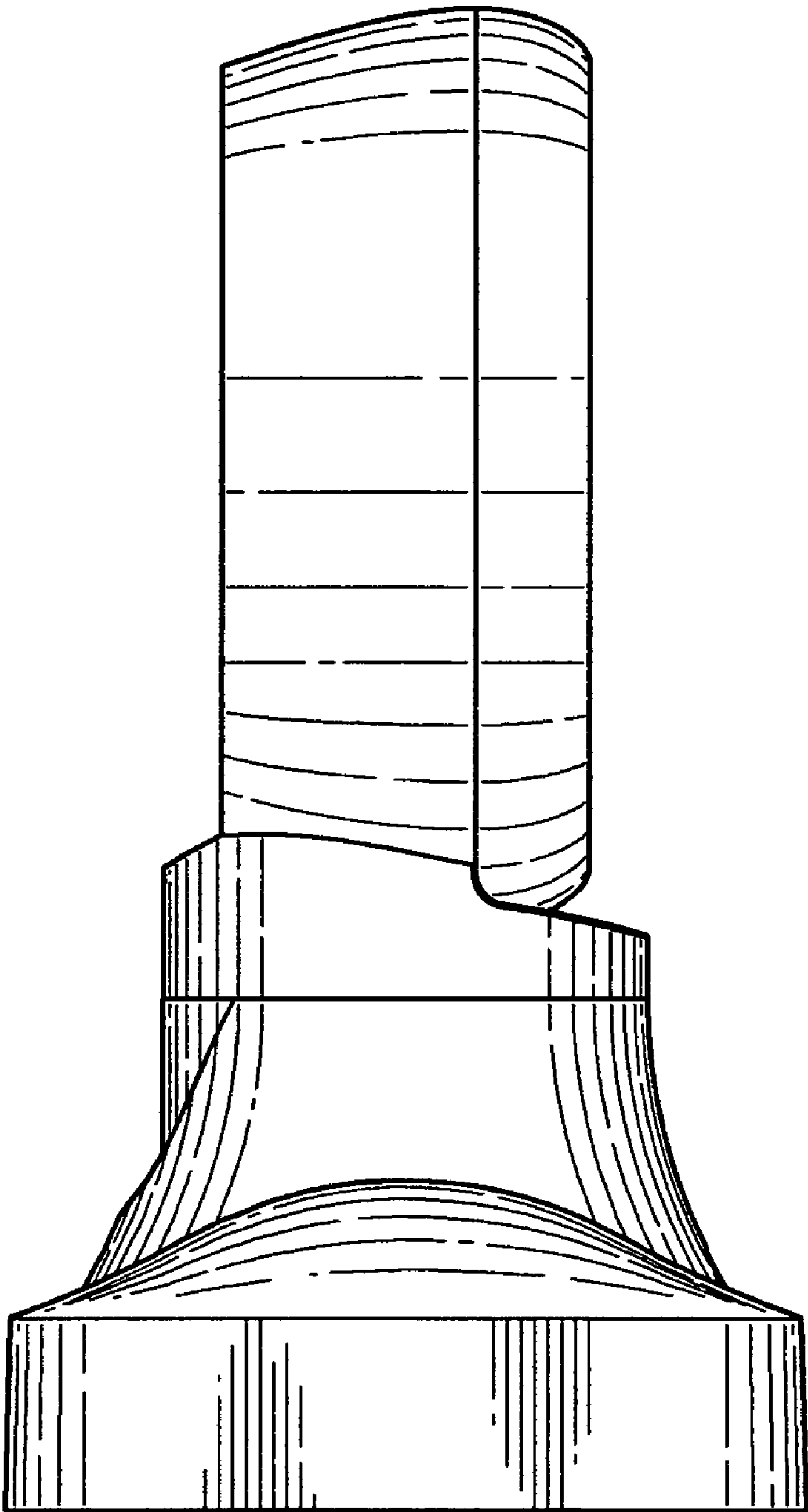

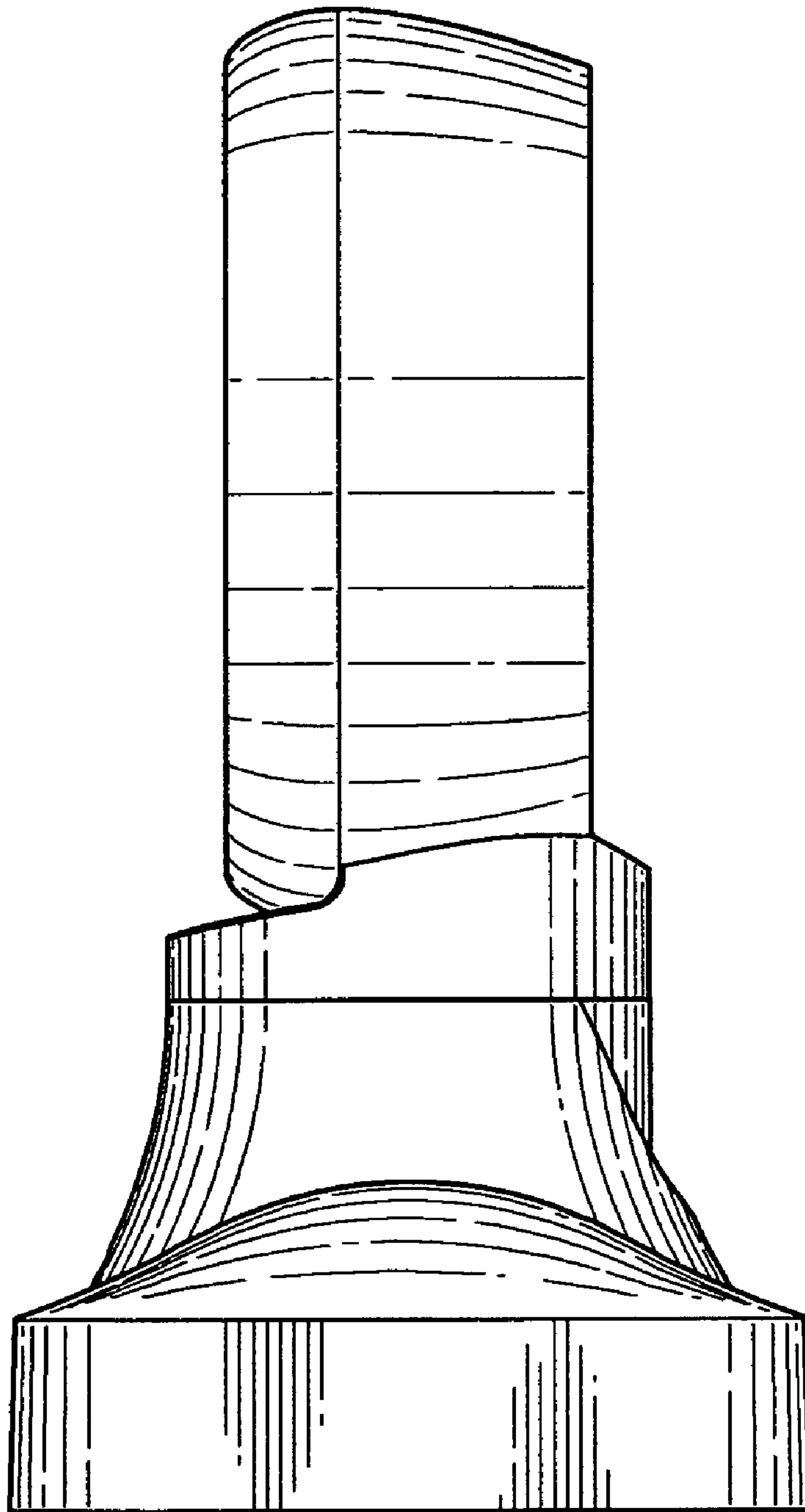

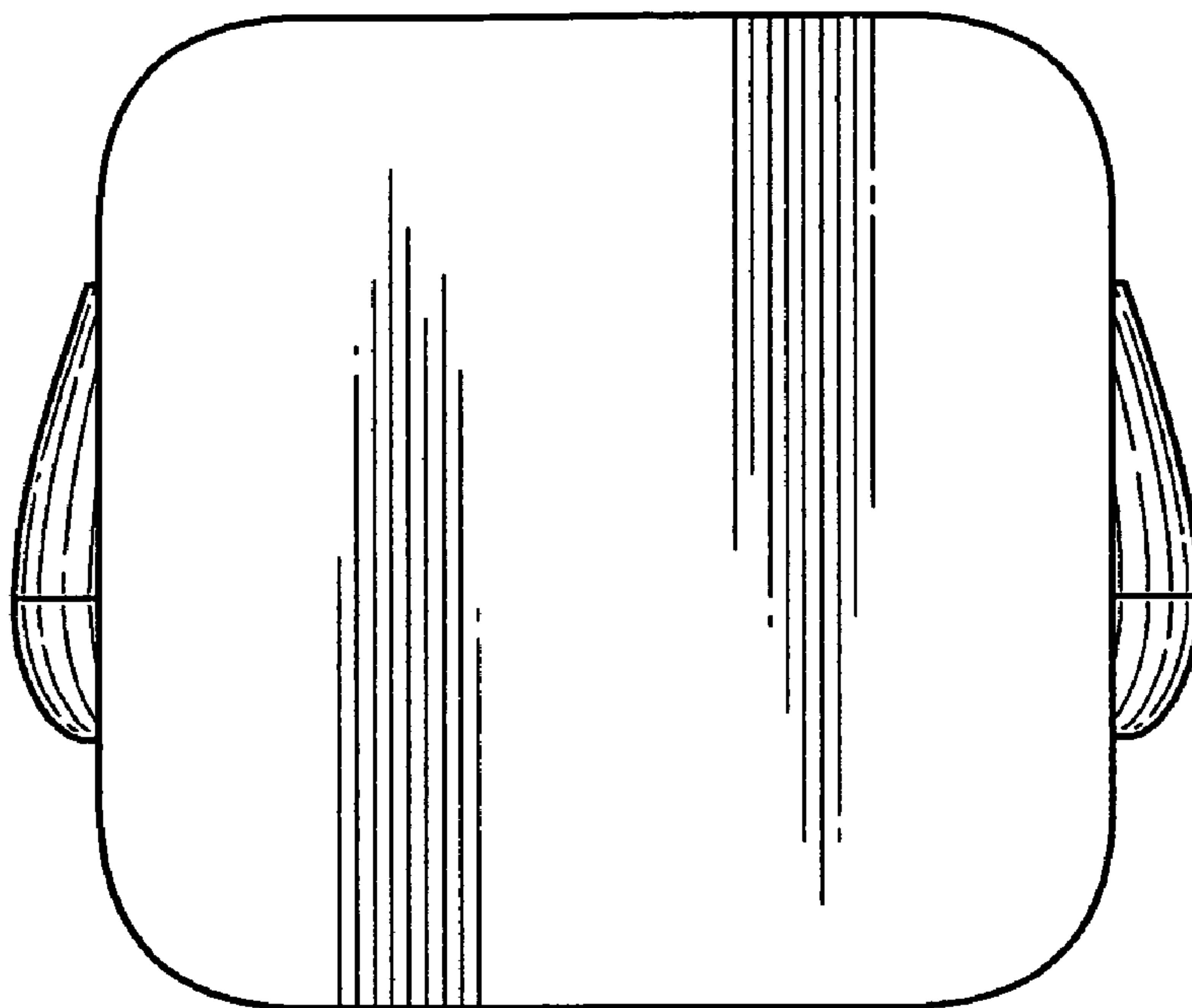

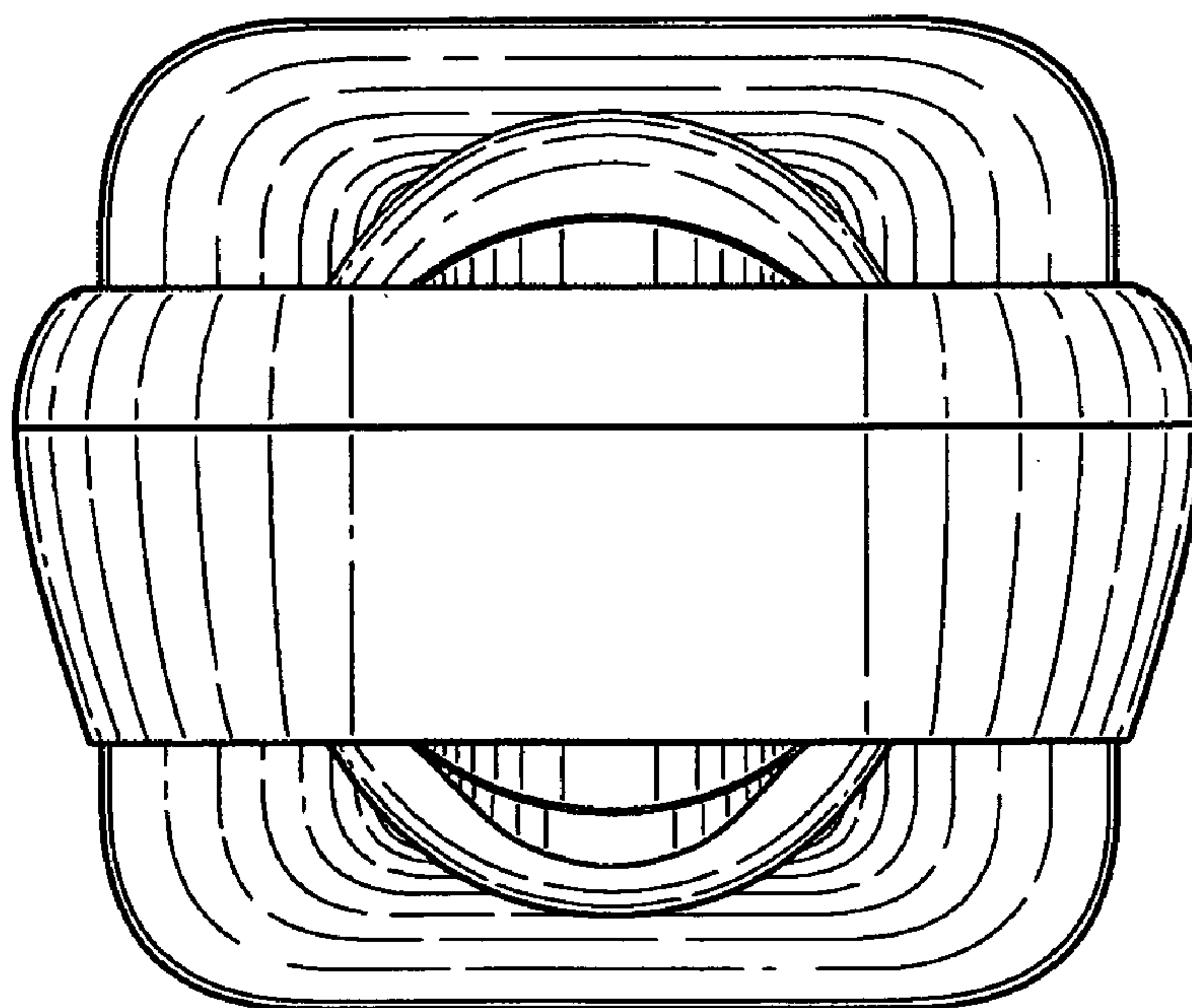

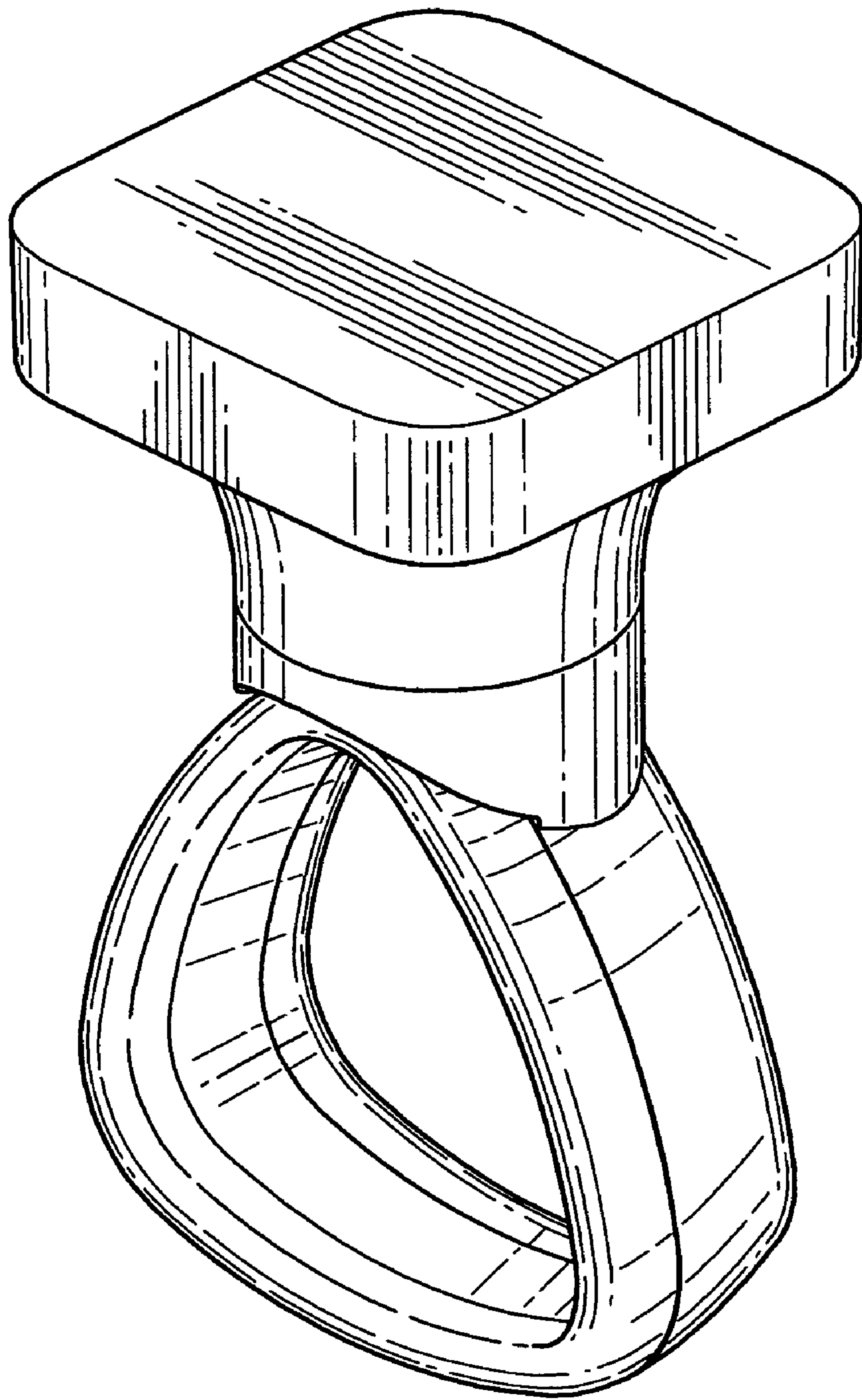
